Tom Charters on the origin of the Breeders Crown

Four decades ago, the birth of the championship series was a story of foresight and perseverance.

As The Meadowlands prepares to play host to the finals for the 41st edition of the Breeders Crown, Hambletonian Society executive vice president Tom Charters spoke with HRU about how the year-end championship series got its start.

According to Charters, the idea for the Crown was hatched on the Lexington, KY, social scene.

"The original idea was called the Breeders Championships," Charters said. "We've got the document at the [Hambletonian Society] office.

John Cashman worked with Curt Greene and Hambletonian Society secretary George Alexander to draft the aforementioned document.

"Fred Van Lennep [owner of Castleton Farm] was very involved socially with the thoroughbred scene and John Gaines, of course, had a background in harness racing before he got so deeply involved in thoroughbreds," Charters said. "His father was Clarence Gaines who is enshrined in the Hall of Fame in Goshen, owned Gainesway Farm [which was] originally a standardbred farm, and was a good owner for among others, Frank Ervin and John Simpson, Jr.

"And John Gaines came up with this idea [for the Breeders' Cup for thoroughbreds] that started circulating among the cocktail circuit around the Lexington area. And Mr. Van Lennep went to John Cashman [general manager of Castleton Farm] and said, 'We ought to try to do something like that."

Van Lennep sent a letter to then Hambletonian Society president Max Hempt saying that harness racing needed a championship Dave Landry

program and that the Hambletonian Society should own and operate it.

To say there were a lot of moving pieces in play, especially in those early days, would be an understatement according to Charters.



But, as they say, timing is everything and that definitely was the case for both Charters and the launch of the Breeders Crown.

As the idea for the Crown was being nurtured, Charters was halfway around the world, finishing up a gig working in Macau. Upon his arrival back in the States, Charters was contacted by his former boss.

"I got a phone call from Delvin [Miller] and he said, 'Did you get my Christmas card?" Charters said.

In that card that Charters had not yet received, Miller had told him, "Don't do anything about a job until you talk to me."

Miller explained that the Hambletonian Society had a new project and that they were looking for someone to head it up and that he thought Charters should apply for the job.

So, Charters went down to Pompano for what he thought was a job interview.


"Cashman came in and started telling me all the things I had to do," Charters said. "I said, 'Don't I have to interview?' He said, 'No, you've got the job.' So, that's how I got the job."

In 1984, Charters was named the executive director of the Breeders Crown. Ten years later, Charters rose to the position of executive director of the Hambletonian Society, and then four years after that, was elected the Society's president and chief executive officer; a position he held until he passed the torch to John Campbell in 2017.

Although it may run like a Swiss watch now, there were definitely a few bumps along the road before the first Crown race crossed the finish line.

Some ground work had already been laid prior to Charters arrival on the Crown scene.

"By that time, they had hired a group called Robert Landau [Associates] who was the agency for the Breeders' Cup also," Charters said. "Landau was a big agency. They had two floors in the Chrysler building [in Manhattan]."

Landau's high-profile clients included Major League Baseball, the National Basketball Association, Burger King, Miller Brewing and Ford.

Despite the fact that everything looked to be going well in the months leading up to the first Breeders Crown race at The Red Mile, Charters had a nagging thought in the back of his mind.

"I know that in the midst of great joy, tragedy lurks around the corner," he said. "I forget who that's a quote by, but it's a good definition that I always think about for what could go wrong."

It turned out that Charters' thoughts were pretty on point.

"About two weeks — and maybe even less time than that — before the first Breeders Crown in Lexington, Robert Landau went bankrupt," Charters said. "We had signed the contract, but we didn't have any money to pay for TV. All the money went to Landau, and Landau went down a black hole.

"So, the Society had an emergency meeting and about 10 directors of the Society stepped up and pledged their own money to keep the Breeders Crown afloat. And one was Castleton Farm, Mr. Van Lennep, who pledged about half of it and everybody else pledged \$10,000 or so across the board.

"I would say they are one of the few boards that would have done that and they also needed more than that, so Mr. Van



Lennep went on behalf of the Breeders Crown to get money from the USTA. I forget exactly how much, but they gave us a sizable amount, too, to keep it afloat.

"So, there were a lot of groups that pitched in, which in retrospect, it was a pretty good investment for 40 years. The logo hasn't changed. The concept hasn't changed. The format has changed a little. But it's here because of the support of the directors of the Hambletonian Society and the hard work that they devoted to it. A lot of times I was just a passenger. I mean, it had momentum of its own, just like a horse. And enough people believed in it, including the stallion owners."

Something else that hasn't changed in four decades is the Breeders Crown logo, which was a collaborative effort between sports marketing executive Mike Letis and artist Barbara Rosenwach. Letis, along with his partner, Mike Trager, represented the Crown. The pair had left Landau to form their own company before Landau went belly up. Rosenwach was able to translate Letis' vision, creating the horse, based on a USTA photo of Niatross, along with the crown and a unique typeface. Rosenwach also created the logo for another client of Letis and Trager, the Breeders' Cup.

Charters clearly remembers Letis and Rosenwach designing the logo.

"The one point in the discussion where we probably made a poor decision was when we decided to leave out the apostrophe after the 's' in Breeders Crown because it looked better purely for design purposes," Charters said. "What was good design, was poor punctuation."

In regard to the supportive breeders in those early days, Charters had a story that involved three major farms, Van Lennep's Castleton, John Simpson of Hanover Shoe and Alan Leavitt's Lana Lobell.

"John Simpson, Fred Van Lennep or John Cashman, and Alan Leavitt rarely spoke, let alone got in the same room and planned something," Charters said. "Andy Grant used to tell me that he considered one of the high points of his contribution to racing was that he got all three of them in a room to work together. That's what made [the early Breeders Crown] work; they supported it and they got other breeders to support it."











Winbak tops Ontario Sires Stakes breeders for 10th time in 12 years

For the 10th time in the past 12 years, Ontario standardbred juggernaut Winbak Farm claimed top breeder honors in the Ontario Sires Stakes program.

The renowned North American breeding operation saw its 2024 class of OSS competitors pace the field with \$1,250,658 banked across a combined 216 starts.

"We take great pride in it," said Winbak Canada farm manager Pat Woods. "We have a lot of Ontario-breds, and we try to raise them the right way to make racehorses that show up on the racetrack.

"Achieving the top honor is something we're definitely very proud of."

Some 239 breeding outfits sent out at least one starter during the five-month OSS series, which officially closed the book on its 50th anniversary campaign with Gold Super Finals night on Oct. 12 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Although none of the eight big-money bouts went to a Winbak alum, the powerhouse Ontario nursery was still well-represented on the podium.

Wickedpace (2-year-old pacing filly), Sterling Choice (2-year-old pacing colt), and Best Night Ever (3-year-old pacing colt) each finished second in their respective events, while 2-year-old trotter Rising Interest rounded things out with a third in race 5.

Trained by Paul Cameron, Wickedpace produced the highest earnings total ever recorded by a Winbak-bred horse in OSS competition (\$230,000; 5 2-3-0 line).

"They all came out of their seasons on a high note," said Woods. "I think a lot of them will probably end up being turned out and prepped for either their 3-year-old season or as a seasoned racehorse like Best Night Ever."

For the Newtonville, ON native, the stellar showing from this year's crop inspires even greater confidence in Winbak's already well-established offering.

"For us, it gives us a lot of optimism for next year that we'll have a strong group of horses representing Winbak Farm," he said. "It's great when our yearlings do well at the racetrack because it means horse people will come back to look at our other offspring at the London sale, or Harrisburg, or Lexington."

Woods was able to observe this first-hand at the recent London Classic Yearling Sale (Oct. 15-16 at The Western Fair District), which saw a total of 246 yearlings sell for just over \$7 million (\$7,015,000).

"When speaking to the buyers, there was a lot of optimism about the Ontario-sired program, about the quality yearlings that were being sold pedigree-wise and stallion-wise," said Woods. "It was encouraging to hear from a breeder's point of view."

That elite Winbak pedigree was on full display throughout the OSS program.

On the pacing side, two of the farm's Ontario standing sires, McWicked (second) and Betterthancheddar (fourth), ranked inside the top five in total earnings.

The former's offspring netted \$714,299 from 130 starts, while the latter's reeled in \$648,222 between 78 starts.

In the trotting discipline, Archangel's youngsters generated the fourth-highest earnings total of \$420,170.

My MVP (\$75,469) and Trixton (\$37,815) followed in 12th and 13th, respectively.

"When you stand nice stallions like we're lucky to have, success seems to come along with it," said Woods. "We strongly support the stallions that we have at the farm, and that translates onto the racetrack with desirable results."

Winbak's ability to thrive in a highly-competitive Ontario market speaks volumes about the Inglewood-based outfit's unwavering commitment to its craft.


Despite all vying for the same pieces of the pie, Woods views the healthy competition as a bonus for both the industry and horse people, alike.

"We're all friends and colleagues," he said. "We wish them as much success as we have, but we all still try for the same stallions. We make bids and pitches and try to land top stallions to improve our programs and our breeding farms.

"I think that competition also translates into some of the top owners — knowing that they'll have success by standing their stallions here in Ontario."

And going by the recent performance of Winbak's Ontario standing sires, it's easy to see why.

Another integral, and perhaps overlooked aspect of the farm's continued dominance is its penchant for producing racehorses that make waves across multiple marquee jurisdictions.

And for Woods, a lifelong horseman who's remained an integral part of Winbak's Canadian operation since 2018, it's all about the team.

"Our biggest thing is it's not just one person that takes credit for everything that happens here at Winbak, it's a whole team that works together to ensure our horses are raised properly, fed properly, prepped properly so that the people who buy from us get quality individuals that they can turn into successful racehorses," said Woods. "It's our team that works together to make Winbak's product happen."




Since this is a column usually devoted to harness racing, let's start with it and then move on to some of your other interests. How did you develop your interest in our sport?

"I was first taken to the runners at Belmont Park when I was only 6 years old. I was first challenged by the mathematics involved in trying to pick winners. I've been interested in trying to solve math puzzles all of my life. I first went to college at Carnegie Mellon near Pittsburgh. While there I took courses in creative writing and philosophy. I started going to the races at The Meadows. At the time, The Meadows had a full-time harness racing show as part of their daily racing program. I would regularly appear on it as a color commentator. I would also sub for Roger Huston calling the races when he was not able to be there. All the while I was still going to school. I loved calling the races. I still do.

"I eventually landed a job calling races at a racetrack called Lakeshore Meadows. Lakeshore Meadows existence was unfortunately short lived. I also trained a few horses which were racing at The Meadows. You might get the idea that I am

somewhat of a wanderer. You would probably be right. All my life I've tried to and usually succeeded at doing more than one thing at a time.

"From 1995-98 I was the regular race caller at Hoosier Downs. I then attended Law School at the University of Michigan from 1998-2001.

"I eventually returned to New York. I joined the real estate business which had grown into an empire under my grandmother. She passed in 2001. My grandmother was a real estate savant. She was probably one of the greatest real estate entrepreneurs in the history of the City.

Were you ever a gambler, betting on the horses?


"Of course. I've been a problem solver all of my life. At least, I've tried to solve problems. There were times where I was successful at betting — other times when I wasn't near as good at it."

When Jeff Gural rescued The Meadowlands from oblivion in 2010, you were among those who joined him in that venture.

"That is true, but actually I was involved in track ownership with Jeff before that — first at Vernon Downs in 2005 and shortly thereafter at Tioga Downs. Both those tracks have proven to be good investments, but unfortunately not because of harness racing. Tioga now has a full casino which makes it profitable. Vernon has the slots in addition to racing. We were able to sell our interest in Vernon at a decent price and still retain management rights. Although I cannot say that The Meadowlands is exactly flourishing, I can say that it is doing significantly better than it was because of sports betting."

Let's move on to the law. You are a lawyer who has passed the bar in New York but you have never practiced?

"Yes, I suppose you can say that. I loved the law, but I could not find an area of it that I liked enough to do it even remotely on a full-time basis. I've attended more schools than the average guy. I started out at Carnegie Mellon, then I went to the University



of Michigan and then went to NYU from where I wrote the bar exams. The one constant through all of my education has been race calling. At first thought, I'm not sure at how many tracks I've called races — The Meadows, Lakeshore Meadows, Hoosier Park, The Meadowlands, Freehold and this past year at Oak Grove in Kentucky."

You have recently taken to writing. You have an article in an upcoming edition of Hoof Beats magazine?

"I suppose it was about time that I put some of my education in creative writing learned at Carnegie Mellon to use. I have an article coming up in that magazine on 22-year-old Marvin Luna, a young man who I consider to be a budding superstar in the sport. He was the leading driver at the Oak Grove race meeting in Kentucky.

"He went to a very good school, that of Tony Alagna, where he developed into a very good horseman. Tony started using him for educational purposes (both for the horses and Marvin) with some of the royally-bred youngsters in his stable. In the last couple of years, Marvin has gone out on his own. He races mostly in Kentucky and Indiana, where he gets drives from many of the top stables when they become available. If we had more young

people with the positive enthusiasm of Marvin in the sport, we would be a be in a better place."

You have recently become a regular at the amateur races at The Meadowlands.

"I started my hands-on apprenticeship in the sport jogging horses at The Meadows. I then progressed to training a few. Since then, I've occasionally driven, usually only the horses that I've owned and trained. Since the startup of the amateur series at The Meadowlands, I've been driving more regularly, usually with horses trained by Symon Spicer. I know that I'll never be good enough to compete against those who do it for a living. Having said that, I do think that I now drive better than I ever did and I like to think my driving skills keep improving."

Which is your favorite horse?

"Without a doubt that would have to be Enough Talk. The old guy is the type of horse that people dream of being associated with. He was a true free-for-aller who took me to places I could only dream of ever going. There are very few people who are blessed enough to have an association with a horse as good as he was."



You are also a farmer?

"I suppose you could say so. We own a small farm in Flemington, NJ, where we raise chickens, cattle and lamb for limited consumption; basically, only for our family and friends."

Can you tell us about your musical skills?

"I write music and sing and play what I, as well as other people, write. I perform fairly regularly at The Bitter End in Greenwich Village in the City. I've also performed at The Winery. I don't know how good I am at it, but it's something I enjoy and really love doing."

Do you have a day job and if so, what is it?

"I really don't know how to answer that. I am one of the individuals involved in a New York City real estate business built by my late grandmother. She was a genius at what she did. Unfortunately, New York real estate is hurting right now. There is probably more vacant office space in the city than there has ever been. I suppose this is because of the effects of COVID, where many people began working from home. Another factor is that many companies have moved to more tax friendly states such as Florida, Texas and Delaware. Yet regardless of these problems, one of the puzzles about the City is that they keep building new places just as much as ever."



Trust your horse


"Until one has loved an animal, a part of one's soul remains unawakened." Anatole France

HRU recently published five chapters that told the tale of a crotchety old bachelor who developed an emotional attachment to a pair of unraced harness horses. The primary theme was a lonely veteran farmer, a man familiar with commercial livestock, who allowed a pair of discarded harness horses to become pets. At this stage of his life, the connection between this human and his equine pals provided a sense of companionship and emotional support.

The depth of love people develop for their animals is unsurprising to some of us. We understand the intelligence and sensitivity of horses can lead to deep bonds just as it does for dogs and cats. Horses recognize their owners, respond to their voices, and show affection, such as nuzzling or following them around. Owners and horses can find mutual trust and affection.

The fictional story also touches on a complex philosophical question concerning the difference between a commercial pig and your pet dog. Humans assign different statuses to different species due to cultural and moral frameworks. We adore our puppies and pets profoundly and give scant thought to the millions of piglets.

What status would you assign to the horses in our sport? Buyers purchase yearling for commercial purposes, not for pets. Buyers are not spending a hundred thousand dollars on a pet. Turning the page on an unproductive racehorse is part of the business. Owners and trainers eventually compartmentalize their feelings for their horses. They must, or they will soon have hundreds of expensive pets. Racehorses arrive and depart every year, sometimes monthly, making it difficult to track the future of every horse. The movement of horses is not cruelty, merely business. On the other hand, when funding and space are available, racehorses can transition to pets, possibly even productive pets.



The story Abandoned Horses focused on a specific problem with beloved pets – what happens to animals when they outlive their owner? Writing a story and creating a scenario with a happy ending is easy. In real life, the aftercare of pets is more complex, especially when the animals weigh a thousand pounds. As with most topics, there are many layers to animal aftercare for pets, ranging from simple to complicated and expensive.

For most of us with a beloved pet that we may not be able to care for, our first course would probably be to ask a trusted friend or a relative, "Take care of Smokey for me." This request is understandable for an elderly cat but not as doable if Smokey is a young horse. A casual conversation is a starting point, but specific instructions from the owner are helpful.

Owners can leave instructions and money for the care of their animals in a will. Animals are property, which makes a will possible for animal aftercare. However, time is involved in settling estates, and enforcement is problematic. For example, a paragraph may state, "To my brother Ralph, I leave the care of my beloved horse, Smokey, and \$25,000 for expenses." A simple will may or may not work out as planned. Ralph could take the horse to a slaughterhouse and spend the money on a Tahitian cruise.

The safest, but costliest, method to ensure Smokey's fate in case one becomes incapacitated is to establish a trust. Every state has a statute permitting pet trusts, which are detailed legal documents indicating care for animals and expected expenses. The difference between a will and a trust is that a trust has enforceability and includes several parties. The grantor establishes the trust and pays the money. The caretaker manages the money. An enforcer will faithfully follow the terms of the trust.

We will always have a surplus of racehorses needing homes. Many rescue organizations follow the concept of repurposing our harness horses for other equine disciplines. Repurposing and retirement homes for horses are excellent and worthy of support. Finding additional ways to lengthen the happily ever after for our horses is challenging. Subsequent columns in this space will look at a few unorthodox ideas for placing that harness racehorse you can't seem to say goodbye to.

Emoticon Legacy and **Maximus Mearas S** emerged the victors from a pair of \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings on Friday afternoon (Oct. 18) at The Meadowlands.

In the first of the division's contests to qualify for next week's Breeders Crown final, Emoticon Legacy — one of four across the track leaving the gate — settled into the catbird seat by the :27.4 first quarter and never left the inside path. He saved ground through middle fractions of :55 and 1:24 before passing race-leader Meshuggah and first-over challenger Hidalgo. Emoticon Legacy slid up the pylons to the win by 2½ lengths in a 1:52.3 mile.

"He's still a little green," said winning driver Louis-Philippe Roy after the race. "He doesn't do well racing in front. I was hoping to get room on the inside because he was trotting well and I know he has a pretty good kick in the end."

Emoticon Legacy paid \$7.60 to win.

Making the final from elimination 1 were Meshuggah, finishing second; Hidalgo in third; Memento Mori in fourth and Tactical Dynasty, who secured the last berth as the highest-earning fifth-place finisher from both eliminations.

Prohibitive favorite Super Chapter was beaten by 7-1 outsider Maximus Mearas S with a strong stretch move by driver Scott Zeron late in the stretch of the second Breeders Crown elimination.

Maximus Mearas S left swiftly off the gate before giving way to an early brush from the 8-hole leaving Happy Jack B. Maximus Mearas S stayed right behind that one while Monserrate followed in third. Super Chapter, fourth after the :27.2 first quarter, fired to the outside to pass them and take full command of the race towards a :56.3 half. Though Super Chapter opened real estate from the rest to three-quarters in 1:24.4, Maximus Mearas S left the cones for an all-out attack that Zeron pushed until his steed had enough to get to the wire first by a head.

"He lacks experience," Zeron said after the race, "[but] mine maintained his tail today."

Lucas Wallin trains the son of Chapter Seven out of the Cantab Hall mare Darling Mearas S. Maximus Mearas S earned a new speed mark with the 1:52.4 victory.

"He's graceful with good strides," Zeron said, "and now it's just a matter of how fast he really can go."

Maximus Mearas S spiked his bankroll to \$84,795 in his first season of racing for owner Kjell Magne Andersen. His breeder is Snogarps Gard Inc. and he paid \$16.40 to win.

Also getting berths in next week's championship final were Super Chapter, finishing second; Blank, getting the show spot; and fourthplace finisher Go Dog Go.

Elimination winners Emoticon Legacy and Maximus Mearas S earned draw protection between

posts 1 through 6 for the Breeders Crown final next Friday (Oct. 25). The nine finalists from Friday's eliminations will join Maryland, earning a bye with his victory in the Peter Haughton Memorial at Harrah's Hoosier Park earlier this year, in the final.

Track record for Captain Optimistic; Swingtown springs to victory in Breeders Crown elims

"Double D" Dexter Dunn scored winning marks in a sweep of the \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings on Friday afternoon (Oct. 18) at The Meadowlands, registering a track-record mile with **Captain Optimistic** and a minor surprise with **Swingtown**.

Captain Optimistic cleared the lead, rolled and refused to lose in a track-record 1:49 mile in winning the first Breeders Crown elimination for freshman pacing colts and geldings.

Dunn darted Captain Optimistic for the front from the outermost post in the octet and landed at the pylons before a :27.2 first quarter. On the point, he coasted to a :55 half while Louprint patiently pulled outside from fourth to front stablemate Sippinonsearoc in an outside charge through the final turn. Captain Optimistic remained steady under pending siege through three-quarters in 1:22.1 and defended the helm from a three-pronged attack from Ron Burke trainees in the stretch. Dunn kept


asking and Captain Optimistic kept finding as his headpole popped off while keeping his head down to hold his ground and take a half-length victory over pocket-sitter Railroad Station. Louprint fought for third from Sippinonsearoc and Papis Pistol followed to complete the top five.

"With that wide draw, we had to get handy," Dunn said after the race. "He got across pretty easy and he felt good on the front; if one of the other ones wanted to come, I would've been happy with that. He got through that last turn and knew it was game time and really fought good up the straight. The further we got into the mile, the better he felt. He stuck his head out and fought up strong."

Nancy Takter trains Captain Optimistic, a colt by Captaintreacherous out of the Art Official mare Cinamony. The colt has now won six races from eight starts and earned \$210,885 for owners 3 Brothers Stables, Marvin Katz and Caviart Farms. The 1:49 mile by the Fair Winds Farm Incbred colt eclipses the previous Meadowlands track record for 2-year-old pacing colts of 1:49.1 set by Huntsville in 2016 and is the fastest mile ever by a pacing 2-year-old over the track.

Dunn perched Swingtown into a second-over tow behind 1-5 favorite Fallout and bolted forward in the stretch to a 1:50.1 win drawing away in the second Breeders Crown eliminations for freshman pacing colts and geldings.

Swingtown floated off the wings to race fifth right behind Fallout as he abandoned his leave attempt to tuck to the pylons before a :26.4 first quarter uncorked by Papi's Rocket. Fallout bided his time to a :55 half until Swingtown forced



his hand outside to begin a rush into the final turn. Papi's Rocket folded on the lead through three-quarters in 1:23.4 as Fallout marched forward with Swingtown fanning wide for the stretch drive. Swingtown drew alongside Fallout in the last eighth and slid by the odds-on chalk with ease in progress to a 2¾-length victory. Makes Sense saved ground to take third with Prince Hal Hanover settling for fourth off a pocket ride and Banderas earning the last berth into the final.

"I've obviously seen him race; he's a little bit hot, little bit excited, but he was good out of there once he got on the helmet," Dunn said. "There was a bit of action early, so we bailed out [and] Timmy [and Fallout] bailed out and landed in the spot in front of me. He was the perfect helmet to follow. Once I moved him off the helmet up the straight, he really sprinted good."

A colt by Downbytheseaside out of the Art Major mare Swinging Beauty, Swingtown earned his sixth victory from nine starts and has now banked \$352,182 for owners Burke Racing Stable, Hatfield Stables, Knox Services Inc. and R A S Racing LLC. Ron Burke trains the Steiner Stock Farm-bred colt who paid \$7.60 to win.

Elimination winners Captain Optimistic and Swingtown earned draw protection between posts 1 through 6 for the Breeders Crown final next Friday (Oct. 25).

Looksgoodinloulou sets Big M track record in Crown elim



Heading into Friday's (Oct. 18) Breeders Crown eliminations at The Meadowlands, **Looksgoodinloulou** owned the distinction of being the fastest 2-year-old pacing filly of the season by way of her world record-equaling 1:48.3 win in the International Stallion Stakes. She nearly matched that mark in the first of two \$25,000 Crown eliminations for rookie pacing fillies, prevailing in a Big M divisional track record 1:48.4.

Looksgoodinloulou and driver Yannick Gingras protected pylon position on the first turn, yielding to third and stalking 55-1 pacesetter My Sweet Lily through a :53.1 first half. As Dexter Dunn pulled Miki And Minnie out of the pocket to wear down My Sweet Lily on the far turn, Looksgoodinloulou angled second-over to ensure clear sailing turning for home, and the Sweet Lou—Looksgoodinaromper filly struck the front with a sixteenth to go on her way to a half-length win. Rodeo Drive Deo (driven by David Miller) rallied three-wide to complete an exacta for trainer Ron Burke, Miki And Minnie finished third, and long shots Gigglingonthebeach and Millie May Hanover completed the top five finishers.

"I didn't want to get away third off slow fractions, so I did push on the first turn," said Gingras. "But after that, I figured when the field was coming, I would pull. The trip worked out."

Now a winner in four of seven career starts, Looksgoodinloulou has earned \$252,675 for breeders Burke Racing Stable and

Weaver Bruscemi, who share ownership with Larry Karr and Phil Collura. As the 3-5 favorite, she returned \$3.20 to win.

"She can do anything; she's a complete pro," Gingras said. "The fractions were hot, but she got a good trip out of it. She's one of the best 2-year-old pacing fillies I've ever driven; she's really, really nice."

The second \$25,000 Crown elimination for rookie pacing fillies saw New York Sire Stakes champion, **The Last Martini** chase cover on the far turn and roll down the center of the track for a 1:51 win.

The Last Martini settled in sixth while 1-5 favorite Rose clicked off early splits of :27.1 and :55.1. Doug McNair angled the Huntsville—Martinique filly off the pegs at the half-mile pole, and the pair advanced steadily before flushing Duration out from third midway on the far turn. As Duration and driver Todd McCarthy ground forward to collar Rose in deep stretch, The Last Martini switched three-wide and lunged to likewise nab Duration by a half-length. Unreasonable lifted down the grandstand side to nab Rose for third; Cant See Me completed the top five.

"She's been getting better and better as the year went on," said McNair. "She finished second to Chantilly [in the She's A Great Lady]; I was really impressed with that. I figured if I got her in the right spot that she could keep up with them."

Jared Bako trains The Last Martini, a four-time winner from nine starts with \$353,847 in the bank, for Glenview Livestock Ltd. The Crawford Farms-bred filly paid \$11.20 to win.

The top five finishers from each elimination will reconvene for the \$700,000 final on Oct. 25. By virtue of their elimination wins, Looksgoodinloulou and The Last Martini will draw for posts 1 through 6.





Sound Judgement and driver David Miller easily overcame the outside draw and were strongest in the stretch, capturing the first of three \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations for juvenile trotting fillies at The Meadowlands on Friday (Oct. 18). The Muscle Hill-sired filly from the Cantab Hall-sired Pin Kronos IT scored for the third time in her career with a 1:54.4 mile.

Miller worked out an ideal trip, cutting the opening quarter in :27.4 before letting Delaney Hanover and Todd McCarthy pass nearing the half in just :56.4. Though the pace slowed, Miller let Sound Judgement stalk before letting the Jim Oscarsson-trained filly out in mid-stretch to pounce on the pacemaker. With a sub-:28 final quarter, Sound Judgement went by Delaney Hanover by three-quarters-of-a-length and easily held off a strong-closing Miss Belmar in deep stretch.

Bred in Sweden by AM Bloodstock, Sound Judgement is owned by Blomberg Stable Inc., of Delray Beach, FL. As a 5-1 offering, Sound Judgement returned \$12 to win.

"She trained good coming into the season, but I had to have her calm down," said Oscarsson of Sound Judgement's development. "She's more relaxed without the shoes."

Sound Judgement raced at The Red Mile, in Lexington, KY, without shoes and went without front shoes in her Crown elimination.

The pocket trip again proved to be the way to the final as **Lady Landia** and trainer/driver Åke Svanstedt worked 2-hole magic to perfection and soared past Aperfect Annie in the closing strides of a 1:55.2 mile to capture the second \$25,000 elimination.

Svanstedt's early aggression with Lady Landia not only got him to the front but kept him out of trouble as favorite Deja Blu broke stride early, seriously impacting R Dutchess and driver Jody Jamieson.

Todd McCarthy re-moved with Aperfect Annie following a :27.4 opening quarter and then crawled the middle half, setting up a stretch showdown. Lady Landia was more than up to the challenge with Svanstedt urging her lightly to the wire to win by a neck. Aperfect Annie held for second with Kadena rounding out the finalists from this division.

Bred and owned by Svanstedt in partnership with Santandrea Inc. and Jeff Gural's Little E LLC, the daughter of Tactical Landing from the Chapter Seven-sired Seventimesalady won for the third time in seven career starts and returned \$15.80 to win.

"I hope she can get a good post for the final," said Svanstedt, with the filly guaranteed a draw in the first six positions by rule.

Luna Lovegood proved the fastest — and perhaps the best — of the elimination winners when she captured the third \$25,000 elimination for driver Dexter Dunn in a snappy 1:52.2 mile. The filly from the first crop of multiple-Crown champion Gimpanzee is from the Muscle Hill-sired mare Southwind Venus.

Though bearing out some in the stretch, the Marcus Melander-trained filly had plenty in reserve to march home 51/4 lengths the best off the strength of a :28 final quarter.

What A Bid Hanover and driver Svanstedt found room to the inside in mid-stretch and rallied for second with Spicy Nice just edging Lasting Dream on the wire for the third and final qualifying spot.

Owned by Holly Lane Stud East Ltd., Luna Lovegood was bred by Blue Chip Farms and Stefan Melander.

"She's been doing everything right from the start," said Marcus following the victory.

A winner in four of her seven starts to date, Luna Lovegood returned \$7.40 to win.

The top three finishers from each division join Champagne Problems in the Breeders Crown final.



My Girl EJ lasts, Disney stuns in Breeders Crown sophomore filly pace eliminations

A tale of two tote board outcomes unfolded in the pair of \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations for 3-year-old pacing fillies on Saturday night (Oct. 19) at The Meadowlands – **My Girl EJ** fulfilled a 3-5 promise winning her elimination and **Disney** later spoiled at odds of 66-1 in the second elimination.

My Girl EJ persevered from a laggard start and a first-over grind to clinch a 1:51 victory in the first elimination for pacing fillies.

Outfooted by Asweetbeachhere from post 9, Dexter Dunn raised the whip on My Girl EJ to gather speed, but, managed to only

land in sixth while Asweetbeachhere took the lead to a :27 first quarter. Dunn stayed put up the backside with no bites to pull outside after a shuffle on the lead, so he angled My Girl EJ off the pylons and marched forward uncovered into a :55.2 half.

My Girl EJ loomed forward towards Collusion Hanover, who cleared the lead from pocket-pulling Direction before the half and engaged in battle to three-quarters in 1:24.3. Collusion Hanover kept fighting to the inside, but My Girl EJ nonetheless forged forward while weary from the overland trip to hold a neck in front at the finish. Asweetbeachhere, at 79-1, burst through traffic to claim second from Collusion Hanover while Sweet Gal and Direction finished fourth and fifth, respectively, to take the last slots into the final.

"She usually gets out of the gate really good," Dunn said after the race. "She just left a little flatfooted when the gate sped off tonight, so I had to work her a little bit to not get too far back. She's so versatile; if we got a helmet and a cart up into the race, it would've been great. But she's done a first-over grind before, and it was a great effort; we were sprinting pretty hard in the straight tonight."

A filly by Sweet Lou out of the Well Said mare Lucy's Pearl, My Girl EJ collected her 13th win from 28 starts. The homebred for Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi and Elizabeth Novak — co-owned with Ron Burke — has now earned \$1,144,060 and paid \$3.20 to win.

Disney found a tow from last and landed on the line first in a 1:50.4 mile to upset in the second elimination for pacing fillies.

Driver Todd McCarthy took Disney back from post 9 and raced ninth to a :26.4 first quarter carved by Its A Love Thing pushing for control. Its A Love Thing then dialed the heat to a dawdle approaching a :56.2 half, prompting Rocket Deo to dart out of fifth and shoot forward to the lead. Once Rocket Deo assumed command, the outside tier led by Tarrific continued to plunge forward in the charge to three-quarters in 1:23.3, at which



point McCarthy began fanning Disney from third over to the center of the track.

Rocket Deo withstood amplifying pressure on both flanks in the stretch and entered the final eighth on fumes. Tarrific pushed forward to the outside and Its A Love Thing surged through a seam at the inside, but McCarthy gathered ample momentum with Disney and slid over the top of all to notch a head win in the final strides. Tarrific took second from Its A Love Thing in third with Caviart Belle taking fourth and Rocket Deo holding fifth.

"The trip actually worked out okay," McCarthy said. "From where I got away in the first turn, there was an outer flow from the get-go and I tacked onto that. There were a few moves, and I ended up third over. It was a long way for her to come in a big mile like that. She had a good kick coming home. It was one of them spots where I knew there probably wasn't going to be many looking to drop me in – it was a bit of a step up in class for her, so I had to take her back; my hand was forced. I was really confident that she'd be competitive with the right trip, and fortunately enough she was."

A homebred for Diamond Creek Farm, Disney has now won six races from 11 starts and earned \$118,980. The daughter of Always B Miki out of Breeders Crown champion Pure Country paid \$135.60 to win.

My Girl EJ and Disney earned draw protection between posts 1 through 6 by winning their respective Breeders Crown eliminations.

Captain Albano grabbed the lead before the half and remained on the pedal to the end of a 1:48.1 mile in the first elimination for pacing colts.


Driver Todd McCarthy floated Captain Albano into third out of post 3 and circled for the lead after a :27 first quarter. Captain Albano was planted on the point heading to a :54.2 half and cruised through the final turn. Captain Luke rushed first over out of fourth to challenge Captain Albano by three-quarters in 1:22.2 and kept the 1-5 chalk honest through a stretch sprint. Captain Albano staved the persistent push from Captain Luke by a half-length with pocket-chaser Timeisonmyside another three lengths behind in third. Howlenthehills finished fourth and McCrunch claimed the last berth into the final.

"He's been good all along," McCarthy said after the race. "We were a little unlucky early in the season with him. I think that bad luck just turned for us. It's good to see him finally show himself. He's

I felt confident in the horse all the way down the stretch."

Noel Daley trains Captain Albano, a Captaintreacherous colt out of the American Ideal mare Angelou bred by Fred Hertrich III. He is owned by Patricia Stable, L A Express Stable, Sjoblom Racing Inc. and Michael Dolan and won his 16th race from 23 starts, good for \$1,255,223 in earnings. He paid \$2.60 to win.


Mirage Hanover overpowered stubborn pacesetter Nijinsky in the final strides of a 1:48.4 mile to score as the 1-5 choice in the second elimination.

Driver Dexter Dunn placed Mirage Hanover on the lead to a :27.2 first quarter but yielded control to Nijinsky midway up the backstretch. Nijinsky took over and clicked a :54.4 half, though Mirage Hanover swelled from the pocket and started creeping off the cones circling the far turn. Marvin Rounick owns Mirage Hanover, a colt by Bettors Delight out of Mayhem Seelster bred by Hanover Shoe Farms Inc. He paid \$2.60 to win.

Also making the final were Elista Hanover in third, Willys Home Run in fourth, and Sugar Instead in fifth.

The mile is a lifetime best for Drawn Impression, a daughter of Muscle Hill out of the Kadabra mare Emoticon Hanover. She made her first start on Lasix, but Roy said after the race he saw no difference in how she performed.

"She was racing good lately, but tonight she raced really good," Roy said. "When I tipped her to beat the other one, she really put in the extra effort."

Going into the final, Drawn Impression has earned \$475,297 lifetime. The elim was the fourth win in nine sophomore starts for the Determination homebred and the eighth win from 15 starts in her career.

The second elim was dominated the first three-quarters of the trip by prohibitive favorite R Melina until Scott Zeron fired his charge Allegiant in the stretch to edge the public choice by a neck in 1:51.3.

At 8-1, Allegiant got a call fifth leaving the gate as the rest of the fillies lined up and R Melina sliced panels of :27.4, :56.1 and 1:24.2. Zeron made a move with Allegiant after R Melina in the final turn and kept digging to the beam. She downed the favorite late for the victory.

Crossing the wire in 1:51.3 was a new mark for the Linda Toscanotrained daughter of Tactical Landing, out of the Yankee Glide mare Too Good For You. She increased her bankroll heading into the final to \$633,197 with her ninth win in a pair of racing seasons. The prize for win backers was \$18.40.

Bred by Atlantic Trot Inc. and Steve H. Stewart, Allegiant is owned by Ryan Smith.

"Her last effort [at The Red Mile] was not her best," Zeron said after the race, "but here she did exactly what she is capable of doing."

He also voiced his admiration for the filly.

"She's ready made, happy and healthy," Zeron said, while adding that it was "a little surprising getting past R Melina," considering the trip.

Also capturing spots in next week's final were R Melina in second, Sadbirdstillsing in third, Warrawee Michelle in fourth and Soiree Hanover in fifth.

By winning their Breeders Crown eliminations, Drawn Impression and Allegiant earned draw protection between posts 1 through 6 in the final next Saturday (Oct. 26).



T C I, Daiquiri Hanover take Crown sophomore trotting colt elims

TCI marched to the front into the first turn and never looked back for driver David Miller, capturing the first of two \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations for sophomore male trotters at The Meadowlands on Saturday night (Oct. 19).

T C I, a son of Cantab Hall out of the Dream Vacation-sired mare Nicole's Promise, raced on Lasix for the first time in his career and wasted no effort in gaining control as over three rivals engaged in battle for early lead through a :27.3 opening quarter. Secret Agent Man followed in second through the trip, and there was no movement to the outside prior to the :56.2 first half. The pace of the race picked up on the far turn as Sig Sauer pulled to gain cover and Amazing Catch moved in front to go on the offensive shortly before three-quarters. The jockeying for outside position allowed Miller the freedom to back the pace down with T C I to 1:24.2.

Once into the homestretch, T C I, a colt trained by Ron Burke, accelerated away from his rivals and won by 2¼ lengths in 1:51.1. Secret Agent Man trailed him in second with Security Protected third. Sig Sauer raced off cover and held his ground in the stretch for fourth, ahead of Amazing Catch, the last qualifier for the final from the first elimination.

"I let him trot finishing and he went right through the wire," said Miller of T C I's closing kick.

Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Hatfield Stables, Knox Services and Weaver Bruscemi, T C I was bred by Concord Stud Farm. T C I returned \$6.80 to win.

In the second \$25,000 elimination race, **Daiquiri Hanover**, making his first competitive start since July, rallied from last to capture the contest for trainer/driver Åke Svanstedt, zooming past dueling leaders Karl and Highland Kismet to score by a neck at odds of 79-1 in a 1:51.3 clocking. The son of Bar Hopping from the Donato Hanover-sired dam Dab Hanover won for just the third time in his 10-race career.

The action was heated from the start in this trial as Tony Adams S secured the lead before the :27 first quarter and then stung favored Karl three-eighths of a mile before yielding command. Yannick Gingras had 2-5 favorite Karl at the half in :55.2 but saw pressure through the third quarter as Highland Kismet and driver Tim Tetrick applied serious pressure. Following a three-quarter clocking in 1:23.2, the dueling leaders found company

coming from all locations. While Daiquiri Hanover and Svanstedt had a clear path, as did runner-up Greenspan, Tony Adams S was not as lucky, with Dexter Dunn weaving for space late to gain the show spot. Private Access and Louis-Philippe Roy cleared late along the pylons for fourth. Both Highland Kismet and Karl were locked in a duel for the final spot, but Karl, who finished sixth, inherited it when fifth-place finisher Highland Kismet broke late and was disqualified and placed sixth for lapped on break at wire.

Hanover Shoe Farms bred Daiquiri Hanover, a \$170,000 yearling purchase in Kentucky by owners Åke Svanstedt Inc, Stable Why Not and Tomas Andersson.

Daiquiri Hanover's followers were rewarded with a \$160.40 pari-mutuel payoff for win.

"We found out he had a chip in his front ankle after the Hambletonian," said Sarah Svanstedt of Daiquiri Hanover's absence. "He had the surgery, and he really didn't lose much conditioning."

As for winning from post 9 in a field of this caliber, Sarah said, "I wasn't sure he'd be ready for this."

Daiquiri Hanover and T C I will both draw for posts within the first six spots for next week's Breeders Crown final.



Bythemissal converts, Ruthless Hanover

holds sway, Grace Hill defeats Twin B Joe Fresh in Crown older pace elims

Bythemissal and driver Yannick Gingras won with authority in the first of two \$25,000 Breeders Crown Open Pace eliminations on Saturday night (Oct. 19) at The Meadowlands. The 5-year-old Downbytheseaside-sired gelding was a handy 1:48.4 winner.

The field of eight saw multiple horses leaving the gate, and Gingras was smart to keep Bythemissal in reserve through a series of lead changes before assuming command on the backstretch following a :27.1 opening quarter.

Once settled in command, Bythemissal, trained by Ron Burke, cut a leisurely pace, hitting the half in:55.1 and awaiting company. Scott Zeron took the challenge with It's My Show attacking without cover on the turn and towing Seven Colors and Coach Stefanos along in the outer tier.

It's My Show couldn't reach the leader through three-quarters in 1:22.4, at which point Gingras let Bythemissal out and got

an instant response. From the top of the stretch home, the battle was for minor spoils with Coach Stefanos and driver James MacDonald offering the most speed to be well clear for second, a length in arrears. In the battle for show, Seven Colors edged out Voukefalas and It's My Show with all three gaining entry into next Saturday's (Oct. 26) final.

It was the second win in just six starts this year for defending Breeders Crown champion Bythemissal. From the Western Hanover-sired broodmare Dismissal, Bythemissal was bred by Stephen Dey III.

"The horse is super sharp. I kicked out the earplugs just to be safe," said Gingras of the late challenge in the homestretch.

The second \$25,000 elimination saw **Ruthless Hanover** and driver Andy Miller get the front three-eighths-of-a-mile into the race and lead the rest of the way, scoring in 1:48.1 over a determined Abuckabett Hanover.

South Beach Star and driver David Miller left alertly, looping Ruthless Hanover on the first turn and driving to the top before

the :26.2 first quarter. Ruthless Hanover and Andy Miller gained control as the field lined up through a :54.2 first-half clocking. As has been the custom for Ruthless Hanover, Miller let him sprint hard through the far turn, making it near impossible for Abuckabett Hanover and Dexter Dunn to make any sort of progress through a :26.4 third-quarter split.

With a long lead entering the stretch, Andy Miller worked to keep Ruthless Hanover engaged, and he did hold Abuckabett Hanover a neck at bay, though that rival closed a big gap in the late stages. South Beach Star held his ground well for third with Why Not Now fourth and El Rey finding a seam along the pylons in deep stretch to secure the final berth.

Ruthless Hanover is a son of Somebeachsomewhere from the Rocknroll Hanover-sired Rockaroundthetrack. He was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms and is trained by Tom Cancelliere for owner John Cancelliere. As the 2-1 second choice, Ruthless Hanover paid \$6 to win.

"I didn't want to use him too much on the first turn," said Andy Miller of his strategy to keep Ruthless Hanover in check until the early dust had settled.

In an upset, **Grace Hill** ended the nine-race winning streak of favored Twin B Joe Fresh to capture the single \$25,000 elimination for the Breeders Crown Mare Pace. Todd McCarthy executed the upset, putting the former Crown champion in perfect position behind the heavily-favored Twin B Joe Fresh and then out-sprinting her rival in a spirited 1:48.4 clocking.

Grace Hill, bred by White Birch Farm, is owned by Tom Hill and trained by Virgil Morgan, Jr. The daughter of Always B Miki from the Western Terror-sired dam Western Silk won for the sixth time this year and quickly elevated her status to major contender for next week's final. She paid \$22.60 to win.

Eight of the 10 mares in the elimination qualified with Beach Cowgirl, Always B Naughty, Sylvia Hanover, Valar Dohaeris, Kobe's Gigi and Zanatta joining the top pair. Silver Label and Strong Poison both received byes into the final.



Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame 2024 Immortals announced

In July 2024, the Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame announced that the trustees of the Museum had unanimously endorsed the election of Lester Hollenback, Bob Key, Harmon Showers, American Winner, Grades Singing, Magician, Romalie Hanover and Town Pro as harness racing Immortals. On Sunday (July 6, 2025), these individuals will be inducted into the Hall of Immortals during ceremonies held under the tent on the Museum lawn.

Lester Hollenback (1922-2020) had a great influence over the careers of many star horses as a master horseshoer. Some of these included Dudley Hanover, winner of the 1950 Little Brown Jug; 1951 Harness Horse of the Year and Hall of Fame Immortal Pronto Don; 1970 Hambletonian winner Timothy T; Waymaker, winner of the 1974 Kentucky Futurity; 1979 Kentucky Futurity winner and Hall of Fame Immortal Classical Way; and 1986 Kentucky Futurity and 1988 March of Dimes Trot winner Sugarcane Hanover. In 1965 Hollenback established the Midwest Farrier School in Macomb, IL, then moved on to shoe horses at the Ben White Raceway in Orlando. There, he shod for some of the best standardbred trainers in the world. In 2002 Hollenback was inducted into the International Horseshoeing Hall of Fame in Lexington, KY.

Robert "Bob" Key (1933-2021) was introduced to harness racing through his work as an attorney. Soon after getting into the sport, he was among the owners of 2-year-old filly pacer Amneris, who won a Breeders Crown in 1984, the inaugural year of the event. Four years later, Key expanded his involvement to breeding, and in 1993, American Winner, a Key-bred horse and the product of his Hall of Fame broodmare BJ's Pleasure, won the Hambletonian. American Winner later achieved recognition as a sire, particularly of broodmares. American Winner's daughter Yankee Blondie produced Hall of Fame trotter Muscle Hill and other daughters produced Dan Patch Award winners, Sand Vic and Maven, O'Brien Award winners Define The World and Classic Photo, and millionaires including Key-campaigned Breeders Crown champion Break The Bank K and Grand Circuit star Win Missy B. Key's stable ranked in the top 20 in earnings every year from 2010 through 2019. It exceeded \$3 million in purses three times during that span and topped \$2 million in each of the remaining seven years.

Only a few men are recorded as having a direct significant impact on the origins and career of the standardbred foundation sire Hambletonian 10. These men include breeder Jonas Seely, owner William Rysdyk, and caretaker Harmon Showers (c1828-98). Showers, a man of mixed Iroquois and African lineage, was born in Orange County, NY. Like his father, Showers began his work life as a farm laborer. But in a region in which trotting horses were an almost universal passion, this meant also learning the ways of horses. When Hambletonian was foaled in 1849, Showers was living near the Jonas Seely farm and may have even worked alongside Rysdyk there. Showers became a skilled horseman and remained Hambletonian 10's dedicated caretaker under the employ of Rysdyk and later his widow Elvira for 20 years (1856-76), maintaining the stallion's conditioning, driving and riding him under saddle and handling him in the stud. Showers developed a rapport so perfect and trusting with the stallion that Rysdyk relied on it to keep the stallion under control when presented to the 1,609 mares booked to Hambletonian during this period.

American Winner (1990-2018) was a stellar performer on the racetrack who then went on to make a huge mark on the trotting breed through his daughter Yankee Blondie, who produced Hall of Famer Muscle Hill, and also through his sons, Viking Kronos and Hall of Famer Credit Winner and their offspring. As a 3-year-old in 1993, American Winner won the first leg of trotting's Triple Crown, the Yonkers Trot (in world-record time), and took an eight-race winning streak to The Meadowlands for the Beacon Course and Hambletonian. He finished second to Pine Chip in the Beacon Course and then turned in an easy win over Pine Chip in the Hambletonian, giving him victories in two of the three legs of the Triple Crown. He finished his racing career with 16 wins in 27 starts and \$1,302,451 in earnings. American Winner's sire (Super Bowl) and dam (BJ's Pleasure) are both members of the Harness Racing Hall of Fame, as is his son, Credit Winner.

Grades Singing (1982-2007), a three-time Breeders Crown champion, had a remarkable seven-year career with 148 starts across nine countries, securing 87 wins and earning over \$2.5 million. She made a splash as a 2-year-old, sweeping the Quebec stake races and was named Canadian 2-Year-Old Filly Trotter of the Year. Her winning streak continued with significant victories in Sire Stakes races, garnering her the title of Canada's 3-Year-Old Trotter of the Year. In her 4-year-old season, Grades Singing triumphed in prestigious events like the Maple Leaf Trot and was named USTA Older Trotting Mare of the Year. Her success extended to Europe, where she clinched titles on the Grand

Circuit while adding two more Breeders Crown championships to her name. Retiring in 1990, Grades Singing was honored with a place in the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame.

Foaled in Lexington, KY, Magician (1995-2008), had a lifetime race record of 111 49-14-14 with earnings of \$3,579,103. In his freshman and sophomore seasons, Magician made a name for himself in New York Sire Stakes competition, winning the final in both 1997 and 1998. In 2000, 5-year-old Magician's wins included the Breeders Crown (defeating Moni Maker), Maple Leaf Trot, Art Cutler Memorial and American-National. With earnings of \$1,200,190 he was unanimously voted 2000 Dan Patch Older Trotter of the Year. In 2001, after overcoming an injury, Magician returned to racing with victories in the Classic Series, Arthur Cutler Memorial, American-National and Su Mac Lad. He finished second to Varenne in the \$500,000 Trot Mondial in Quebec. With earnings of \$979,375, Magician was voted 2001 O'Brien Older Trotting Horse of the Year. He ended his career at the age of 8 in 2003.

Bred and raised by Hanover Shoe Farms, **Romalie Hanover** (1969-c1996) sold for \$101,000 at the 1970 Standardbred Horse Sale, then the highest price ever paid for any yearling pacing filly. She won 29 races and \$394,385 at 2 and 3 and was honored as both the Dan Patch 2-Year-Old and 3-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year, with multiple world record-setting performances on all size tracks. Heralded as one of the greatest pacing fillies ever when she retired, her numerous stakes wins included the Jugette, Lady Maud, Adioo Volo, Battle of Saratoga, Hanover-Hempt, Flora Temple Stake, Hoosier Futurity, Walnut Hall Stake, Almahurst Farm Stake and multiple Pennsylvania Sire Stakes events.

Town Pro (1987-2014), distinguished herself as both racehorse and broodmare. In 1989 she was crowned 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year based on a season which produced 12 wins in 13 starts and culminated with a Breeders Crown triumph. At age 3, Town Pro won 14 of 17 starts, lowered her record to 1:51.4 and captured another Breeders Crown. She was voted 3-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year, becoming one of the very few pacing fillies to win back-to-back divisional honors at ages 2 and 3. As a broodmare, Town Pro was a prolific producer, with 13 starters collectively earning \$4,048,775. Her most accomplished offspring is daughter Darlin's Delight, a winner of \$2.9 million. In 2004 Town Pro was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame.

The Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame is located at 240 Main Street in Goshen, NY and is open Tuesday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 for children ages 4-12.
