## Send it in, because you're going to get paid


When those inside the industry hear the Breeders Crown is at Pocono Downs, a couple of things might come to mind — fast times and a possible speed and post bias, for example. For bettors it can be a little different. They, almost without fail, mention the track's usurious takeout rates.

This year, that's something they cannot do, thanks to Pennsylvania racing, Pocono, and the Hambletonian Society. As I'm sure you've heard by now, the big night (and were the elimination cards) are both being wagered at 15 per cent across-the-board takeouts.

Now, in terms of handle or fan interest, we probably shouldn't expect the world from this reduction. Pocono sells their signal so cheaply that rebated players who are price sensitive already receive lower juice, and Pocono certainly doesn't have the branding of a Meadowlands or Woodbine with the event. But I will say one thing without equivocation: If you didn't partake in the pools before because of the poor payouts, you should seriously look at double fisting the cards. Because this year you are going to get paid.

At the last Breeders Crown event at Pocono, the bombs-away trifecta you hit that paid \$700 now pays \$850.

That tidy chalk super that paid \$100, now pays over \$120. The list goes on.

In fact, if you hit three trifectas and one super on the card that paid you \$1,300 last time at Pocono, this year you'll get back almost \$1,600. You made \$300 more, with the exact same handicapping and racing luck.

How many times have you hit a few nice tickets and said "how did I lose money this weekend?" I'd wager more than once. People lose money all the time with good handicapping because they don't get paid enough when they win.

A prevailing view in the industry is that when players win more, purses receive less. There's certainly some truth to that in the short term. However, in this case I'm not sure that fits very well.

If Pocono's signal fee is 3 per cent, the track and horsepeople make 3 per cent if the takeout is 30 per cent or 10 per cent. Their share will be similar even if handle stagnates. Much of the takeout goes to the bet takers, like ADW's, and really, why should we worry much if their margin goes down? If a business is selling something on the Home Shopping Channel it's worth something to be on there – the Home Shopping brand and its promotion of our item will mean a ton of sales for us. Is TVG or Twinspires working their

butts off to sell the Breeders Crown every year to their customers? Is their participation worth the bulk of the takeout?

I think a strong case is made that this reduction does make sense with little risk. That's the left-brained argument. But for the right brainers out there, I believe it makes sense from a branding perspective, too. This takeout reduction tells a story – namely, when the Crown moves to Pocono, bettors need to pay attention, because the track and the event wants your business. This is something the industry, and the Breeders Crown can build on.

Next weekend, the jam-packed Crown card is sure to be exciting. We get to see the best racehorses, best drivers and best trainers compete for big money, and possible end of year honors. Most of us would watch the event if betting was illegal. For many, though, the combination of short prices and high takeout were completely unpalatable. Those folks now have a reason to look at the card. And for other regular bettors, Gabe Prewitt's "Send it In" tee shirts have never been more apt. When you send it in this year, you're going to get paid.

## Emoticon Hanover, NF Happenstance take Breeders Crown elims for trotting mares

The field for Saturday's \$250,000 Breeders Crown mare trot is set after Emoticon Hanover and NF Happenstance won their respective eliminations earlier tonight. The next three finishers —Ariana G, Ice Attraction and Celebrity Ruth from the first split and Barn Bella, Pink Pistol and Caprice Hill from the second elimination — will join the winners, in the final, along with Broadway Donna from the second division, the fifth-place finisher with the highest earnings.

Second choice Emoticon Hanover, trained by Luc Blais, sat in the pocket behind Ariana G to win the first \$25,000 elimination in 1:52.4, going by the favorite in deep stretch to win by 3/4 of a length in 1:52.4. Ariana G posted fractions of :27.4, :57 and 1:24.4 to set up the Emoticon Hanover win. Both are previous Breeders Crown champs.

Emoticon Hanover, a 5-year-old bay mare by Kadabra from the Ken Warkentin mare Emmylou Who, posted her 20th career win and pushed her earnings past \$1.24 million dollars for owners Determination of Montreal, QC. Bred by L.

Wellwood, T. Aspden, A. Shunock and D Ingham, Emoticon Hanover was a \$165,000 yearling purchase at the Standardbred Horse Sale in Harrisburg, PA.

The second \$25,000 division went to 9-1 NF Happenstance, who cleared to the front just before the 27-second first quarter pole and then took the field past fractions of :56.3 and 1:25.4 over the sloppy racing surface before facing a modest challenge from favored Dream Together, who eventually made a break in stride, wiping out the second choice, Broadway Donna and opening up the easy win for the Jack Parker Jr- driven NF Happenstance. Her winning margin was three and one quarter lengths. Broadway Bella survived an inquiry to finish second and 95-1 Pink Pistol finished third. Broadway Donna finished sixth in the race, but was placed fifth due to interference from Dream Together, and that placing means the millionaire daughter of Donato Hanover will also race next week in the final.

NF Happenstance is an 8-year-old bay daughter of SJ's Caviar, from the Conway Hall mare Moira Hall. She is trained by Carole Jamieson-Parker for owner James D Moore III of North Carolina. The win was her 11th this year and 31st in 110 career starts as she pushed her lifetime earnings over \$600,000. NF Happenstance was bred in Pennsylvania by John Huntgen.

The \$250,000 Breeders Crown Mare Trot is one of 12 Breeders Crown finals to be featured Saturday, Oct. 28 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. First race post time is set at an early 5:30 p.m. (Eastern)

#### Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale on par with 2017, grosses more than \$6.8 million

Swan For All filly tops the sale with a bid of \$125,000.

After a solid first session, the 2018 edition of the Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale concluded Saturday (Oct. 20) with more strong numbers. Over the course of the day, 170 babies were auctioned off at the Indiana State Fairgrounds, grossing \$3.15 million and averaging \$18,529. Bolstered by a pair of six-digit yearlings, the session produced the slightest of average increases over the second day from one year ago.

While sale averages have been trending down this season, the Hoosier Classic sale posted numbers very close to 2017 business levels. All told over the two days, 354 babies were hammered down, grossing \$6,885,000 and leading to an average of \$19,449. By comparison, Hoosier Classic Sale Company LLC sold 355 yearlings for sales of \$6,932,000 and an average of \$19,527 in 2017. The decrease resulted in a difference of less than one percent.

"After setting the bar last year and having a record-breaking year, I'm pleased that we were able to match that again," said Steve Cross, Hoosier Classic's sale manager.

"With the trend that we've seen, status quo is a win. I was very pleased. I think we had a lot of new interest, many new buyers, and a lot of new faces. That certainly was encouraging."

Of the 374 yearlings cataloged for this year's sale, 93 trotters and pacers were first foals. Another 63 babies were second foals. Breeders have worked hard to improve the quality of mares in Indiana, and Cross noted the industry trend of buyers gravitating toward younger mares from good families.

Swan For All progeny were once again in demand, so it

came as no surprise that a filly from the sire topped the second session, and the sale overall with a bid of \$125,000. Cataloged as Hip 302, Bluebird Keepsake is the first foal from Yankee Glide mare Changed It All, a \$150,000 winner as a racehorse. Consigned by Bluebird Meadows, the filly's third dam is Breeders Crown champion and two-time O'Brien Award winner Armbro Keepsake 2, 1:57.4, 3, 1:54.3 (\$1,152,269). Dan Shetler signed the ticket, acting as agent.

Yearlings sired by Swan For All led the sale by average. In the second session, 21 of his babies brought \$622,000 and averaged \$29,619. Over the two-day sale, 46 trotters from the sire passed through the ring, bringing gross sales of \$1.37 million and averaging \$29,848.

Immediately following the excitement of Bluebird Keepsake's sale, Meadowbrook Chip entered the ring and became the second six-figure yearling of the day. From the first crop of Whom Shall I Fear, the colt is out of the Pine Chip mare Chips Goddess, who has already produced Swan For All filly and Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final winner Meadow Brook Grace 2, 1:54s, 3, 1:52.3s-'18 (\$306,983). Part of the Meadowbrook Farm consignment, Al Kowalewski purchased the colt for \$100,000 on behalf of his Kales Company LLC.

A total of 21 yearlings from the first crop of Whom Shall I Fear sold Friday and Saturday. The sire's progeny averaged \$23,452.

The highest-priced pacer of the day came from the In Law Stable consignment. Mr Courage, an Always A Virgin colt, brought a \$75,000 final bid from trainer Joe Holloway. The colt is the first foal from Real Artist mare Fashion Mystery, a winner of \$450,000 on the track with a 1:50 speed badge. Holloway purchased a trio of Always A Virgin colts Saturday, spending \$167,000. He also signed slips on Bluebird Demarini, Hip 318, a half-sister to Indiana Sires Stakes final winner Rockin Serena p,1:54.1s, 3, 1:52.1s, 4, 1:51.2-18 (\$248,215), and Sunset Secret, Hip 215, first foal from Cole Muffler mare Things Left Unsaid.

Always A Virgin topped all pacing sires by average. Represented by 53 yearlings and total sales of \$1,277,000, the stallion carried an average of \$24,094.

Rockin Image colt My House was next on the list of top-selling pacers. Part of the Legacy Lane Farm consignment, the colt is the first foal from Cambest mare Best Boss p,2, 1:52.3, 3, 1:51, 1:49.2 (\$707,440). Tom Pollack purchased the yearling for \$67,000, one of three pacers he acquired for a total of \$117,000.

Plunge Blue Chip and driver/trainer/co-owner Ake Svanstedt once again dominated a field of 3-year-old trotting fillies, this time in the Breeders Crown's first of two \$25,000 eliminations for her division on Oct. 20 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, winning easily in 1:53.3 on a track rated "sloppy."

The daughter of Muscle Mass—Dunk The Donato sat fourth off the gate as Top Expectations grabbed the lead with Looking For Zelda in the catbird seat and Courtney Hanover behind her in single file. The first quarter was clocked in :27.

Leading the field to a half in :56.2, Svanstedt pulled Plunge Blue Chip into the first-over position to challenge the leader. She tagged along side of Top Expectations until the 1:25 three-quarters near the final turn when she eased to the front the entering the stretch.

Plunge Blue Chip drew away to win in 1:53.3 with a lot of trot left.

Passing tired foes, Impinktoo slid into second, while Looking For Zelda locked into third and Courtney Hanover

## Atlanta wires foes in second Crown 3yoft elim

From start to finish, Atlanta and driver Scott Zeron led the six-horse field and won the second \$25,000 Breeders Crown elim for 3-year-old trotting fillies, skilfully holding off a late-closing Lily Stride to win in 1:53.

The field lined up behind Atlanta, with Lily Stride next, followed by Manchego, then Ciao Dolce, Supergirl Riley and Phaetosive. Atlanta cut the fractions in :28, :57.4 and 1:26.

At three-quarters the only movement behind Atlanta came from Phaetosive. She came to the outside after lagging behind the five others and picked off enough of them to finish fourth and make the final.

Manchego rolled in the stretch to get third as Lily Stride was pushed futilely to try to catch Atlanta and finished second.

Atlanta is by Chapter Seven—Hemi Blue Chip. She was bred by Order By Stable.

"I wanted to command the lead early," Scott Zeron said in the winner's circle, "and (Atlanta) stole the first fraction. It took her a bit to get back after the two heats in the Hambletonian and she was coming off two heats at the Red Mile, so tonight was good."

Rick Zeron trains Atlanta, the 2018 Hambletonian winner, and he co-owns her with Crawford Farms, Howard Taylor, Brad Grant and Holland Racing Stable. She paid \$4.20 to win.

Met's Hall finished second, with Jula Downtown third and Evaluate fourth. Those four all advance to the \$500,000 Breeders Crown final next Saturday.

Lawmaker battled Met's Hall for the early lead, taking the field to the quarter in :26.4, but Met's Hall and Andy Miller were immediately on the move, taking control as the field headed to the half-mile mark, which was reached in 55 seconds flat. Met's Hall continued to lead the field past three-quarters, but he was feeling pressure from Tactical Landing, who easily took his measure late. Tactical Landing paid \$3.60 to win.

Tactical Landing, an \$800,000 yearling purchase, is a son of Muscle Hill from the Varenne mare Southwind Serena, a Breeders Crown champion of 2007. He is trained by Jimmy Takter for the Tactical Landing Stable of Perrysburg, OH. The win is his seventh seasonal starts and pushes his 2018 bankroll to \$392,800. Earlier this season, he won the Bluegrass Stakes and eliminations of the Hambletonian and Kentucky Futurity.

Brushing to the lead before the half, the Ron Burke-trained Somebeachsomewhere gelding Dorsoduro Hanover held off the passing-lane bid from pocket-sitter Thinkbig Dreambig to take the first of three \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers on Saturday (Oct. 20) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Driver Matt Kakaley positioned Dorsoduro Hanover fourth to the quarter as Hitman Hill swooped to the top from post seven. Thinkbig Dreambig, away second, pulled from the pocket approaching the quarter and cleared past the :27.1 opening marker while Dorsoduro Hanover made his move first over in progress to a :55.2 half.

Dorsoduro Hanover controlled the pace heading to three-quarters with Ideal Feeling, tracking the favorite's stand-side brush, advancing into second through the 1:22.4 clip. Thinkbig Dreambig, off the pocket trip, thrust into the passing lane after Dorsoduro Hanover through the stretch but settled for second in the 1:50.1 mile. Springsteen, trailing the field throughout, fanned widest of all into the stretch and stormed home for third.

"I just didn't want to be first up tonight," Kakaley said after the race. "I had him first up in his last couple of starts, so I just controlled things my own way (and) he was really good. When they get to his bridle, he usually digs in and fights—when Yannick (Gingras on Thinkbig Dreambig) shot into the passing lane he just hit another gear; he was super."

Owned by Burke Racing Stable LLc, Silva Purnel And Libby, Weaver Bruscemi LLC and Wingfield Five LLC, Dorsoduro Hanover won his ninth race from 17 starts this season and his 11th from 31 overall, earning \$991,856. The Hanover Shoe Farms-bred gelding from the Artsplace mare Deer Valley Miss returned \$4.60 to win.

The Ron Burke trainee slid to the top from post seven with I'm A Big Deal securing the pocket to a :26.4 quarter. Courtly Choice, sent the 4-5 favorite and positioned fourth to the quarter, angled first over and ranged into second heading to a :55.4 half.

Courtly Choice continued to pressure This Is The Plan heading past three-quarters in 1:23.1 before giving way into the final turn. This Is The Plan spun into the stretch and sprinted to the wire under pursuit from I'm A Big Deal chasing to finish second ahead of American History, circling past Courtly Choice from second over, closed for third.

"Don't own a television, haven't for 20 years."

"Of course you don't." I sighed theatrically.

This egged me on to my big finale, "Unless, and until, my races can be purchased a la carte, I will need to say hasta la vista and use my money and time to watch the Discovery en Español Channel, which always arrives in High Definition with the illusion of being free."

He laughed, "Racetracks not streaming in High Definition is another whine for another time."

#### More math on draw probability

This is in response to Phil Sporn's reply as to the odds of three horses drawing into the same race (full story here ). He is correct that there are only four possibilities, but the fallacy in his argument is that each probability has an equal chance of happening. Also, the amount of horses in each division does play a role as to the eventual outcome that can be seen from the calculations below. The odds of three horses ending up in the same division in two eight-horse fields are 20 per cent or 1 in 5 which is 4 to 1 odds. The calculation: the first horse draws into either div. 1 or 2. There are 7 slots left in that division and 8 in the other so that is 7 out of 15. Then there are 6 left out of 14. The odds of both occurring are 7/15 x 6/14 which is 42/210=1/5. I know this is not earth shattering, but interesting nonetheless.

#### **Even more math**

Not to beat this topic to death, but I would like to respond to Phil Sporn's response to Pete Goulazian's letter concerning the odds of Manchego, Atlanta, and Plunge Blue Chip all drawing into the same division of the two splits of the filly Kentucky Futurity.

I believe that the odds are 25 per cent (1:4), not the 50 per cent (1:1) indicated in Sporn's letter nor the 700:1 odds against indicated in Goulazian's letter.

Sporn's analysis is close to being correct but does not include the fact that, a priori, there are actually six combinations of ways that you can have one filly in one division and the other two fillies in another division as indicated in the generic analysis below for three different horses (A, B and C).

They can be distributed into the two divisions as follows:

DIVISION 1	DIVISION 2
None	ABC
A	ВС
В	AC
C	AB
BC	Α
AC	В
AB	C
ABC	None

Thus, since two of the eight combinations have all three horses in the same division, the odds would be two out of eight (1:4) or 25 per cent. Note that it does not matter in these calculations as to the order in which the horses are drawn.

I also agree with Sporn that the analysis would not change if there were eight or even 88 entries in the race. If the number of horses in each division were unequal (i.e., 8 vs 7), the odds that a given filly might appear in one division or the other would be slightly different, but the overall odds that all three fillies might appear in the same division should not change.

As an aside, the odds would drop to 11.1 per cent (1:9) if there are three divisions of a race (three out of the 27 possible combinations would contain all three horses).

Finally, I should disclose that I used to know Phil Sporn from when I was a minor stakeholder in a number of horse partnerships that he helped broker many years ago. Hello Phil.

#### More changes needed

Reading HRU Oct 14 Feedback column William Waters spoke about changes he would like to see from the Red Mile and I would have to agree with what his concerns were and yes it does appear as an insiders' game. I wrote in this same column about how years ago I approached a WEG executive with years of statistics on the importance of timing and printing in the program the opening 1/8th and results. This, I was told, was something that needed to be brought to Standardbred Canada as they are the people that handle the charts and past performances. When I approached them, I was told it would be too much trouble to accommodate the changes, yet on WEG's broadcasts they do time and show on screen the opening 1/8, well done WEG. Another improvement was to indicate on each program page the horses that were either rising or dropping in class, this was for new customers to help them decipher the program pages, again nothing happened. How can the industry even talk about being self-sustaining when they need to have new customers yet do nothing about it? Doing nothing has been for years the norm and maybe the Ontario government should put conditions to their handouts for the industry and that is if they can't provide customers with total transparency then no funding. We can put a man on the moon and we can give birth through the use of computers and yet the keeper of statistical information for the industry in Canada says it's too much of a bother to make changes or it can't be done, amazing.
