37th Breeders Crown draws 161

The \$6 million event at Harrah's Hoosier Park has eliminations this Friday and Saturday.

Entries for the \$6 million Breeders Crown events at Harrah's Hoosier Park saw 161 elite trotters and pacers fill the entry box to qualify for the rich finals on Friday (Oct. 30) and Saturday (Oct. 31).

The Open Pace (10), Open Trot (10) and Mare Trot (8) will go directly to the finals on Sat. Oct. 31.

The 2018 Hambletonian winner, Atlanta, has entered the Open Trot, vying to become just the fourth mare to beat male counterparts in this event. The Indiana-bred Hannelore Hanover won the 2017 Breeders Crown Trot at Hoosier Park, while Moni Maker (1998) and CR Kay Suzie (1996) are the other two "Crowned" mares.

Teenager Cheyenne Christman using YouTube to bring harness racing to her generation

Cheyenne Christman is helping to heighten the popularity of harness racing one view at a time.

The videos the high school senior creates on YouTube (available here) are a combination of information, education, and entertainment, all presented in a clever, creative and professional package.

Although she never gave much thought to how many people would click 'play' or the amount of positive feedback

"I started it for my own pure enjoyment," said Christman, whose parents Mark and Joelene have combined for nearly 700 career training wins. "I also like it because it gives me the chance to update people on my life, to show my association with the horses, and what I love to do. It's really surprising on some of the videos. Never in a million years would I have thought that people – I think one of the videos has over 3,000 views – would watch something like that. It's just crazy. I still can't believe it."

she'd receive, Christman, a third generation horseperson, has come to know, in the best way possible, just how impactful

her horse racing videos are.

In fact, her original plan called for creating one video.

As it turned out, more supply was needed to meet the demand.

"I was sitting here for so long not showing a part of my life that is so huge. I really wasn't sure if people would find it interesting at all, whatsoever. I thought I'd make one video and see how it turned out. It got a decent amount of response, so I figured I'd keep going with it. It was so strange... I was talking to my one friend about horses and she started asking questions, wondering what certain things meant. It's so interesting just how many people don't know about harness racing, or understand the behind-the-scenes of it, what trainers, grooms and drivers go through on a daily

basis.

"When I did my 'Day at The Meadows' video, that's how I was inspired to make that one. My mom and I were paddocking a horse and I was texting my friend back and forth. She wanted to know what paddocking was and I started explaining the process and all the steps involved – what each horse needs, what some trainers or owners might want from you as the groom. So, that's why I decided to make that video."

The professionally shot videos cover a range of topics, from how to put on a race harness to what a typical race day looks like, with Christman serving as the host.

Having the platform to showcase her passion for racing, along with her love of acting, has been a true thrill ride for the teenager, the one who developed a bond with horses and horse racing at an early age.

"I get my love of harness racing through my parents. I was kind of just born into it. My mom got me my first pony, Patch,

and I used to go barrel racing with him. So, from trail riding and barrel racing, I eventually gravitated towards standardbreds. These days, mainly, I'm a groom. My parents, I respect them and I love them – they are incredible people. So, for me, it's all about me being lucky enough to learn from them. I do stalls, water buckets, and groom. I really love being at the racetrack or working with the horses."

Christman, at least momentarily, can't pinpoint the precise moment she fell in love with the sport.

Seconds later, she does.

"The exact moment was when I went to a standardbred horse show with my mom, and we took one of our standardbreds, Royal Revenue [a bay trotting son of Revenue S], with us. I was in sixth grade, and we ended up winning reserve champion with the horse. Basically, we trained the horse how to barrel race, how to ride English, and of course, working the cart, which was natural for him. I think that was the moment I fell in love with standardbred racing because it showed how versatile these horses are... how you can take them from their every day life, which is harness racing, and they can learn something else. It also shows they can have a good and happy life after racing."

Just like Hoopie has.



Bred by Randy and Michael Ringer, the trotting son of San Pellegrino is owned by Christman's father.

In 235 career starts, the Pennsylvania-bred won 32 races and bankrolled \$487,816.

"Hoopie is just wonderful. I still barrel race him and trail ride him. He's a keeper, for sure. He's done so much for the farm, and for my parents and I. He's just a true blessing."

It's the exact term Christman uses to describe her association with standardbred racing, a mantra she repeats to herself during the challenging moments.

Advice from one of the sport's top drivers, words she hears from him often, remind her to keep a positive outlook.

"Honestly, the rollercoaster of good times and bad is one of those things that you just come to accept. Aaron Merriman says it all the time... life's a marathon not a sprint. He talks about focusing on what comes next and not dwelling on the past. Maybe the past race was tough, but you have to shake it off. My parents say that you have to stay at it, stay consistent. One quote my dad says all the time is, 'It's not what you do some of the time, it's what you do all the time.' You just have to keep believing something good will show up. Then at some point, you're going to get the results, and it starts rolling from there."

When she's not lending a helping hand to her parents, Christman is hard at work on her YouTube videos [not all of them are horse racing themed] with an eye on something even bigger.

"I saw the trailer for the movie "Amazing Racer." It's a movie based on harness racing, but from what I gathered, not a lot of people were big fans of it. I saw the trailer, but I haven't watched it all yet. What I thought looked really cool was the idea of making a movie and writing your own screenplay. You could hear what people's opinions are about that first one, and build on that for the one that I would write. That's something I've thought about. I love to sing and act, that's my number one thing. So being able to combine harness racing and my love for acting would be incredible. I'm also running my own photography business. Really, I just love being creative in any way, shape or form."

It's something that continues to be noticed and noted, even when Christman least expects it.

"There's a trainer, his name is Brandon Presto. I was just sitting in the paddock at The Meadows one day, doing my own thing. He comes up to me and tells me one of my videos popped up when he was watching races online. He said, 'You're actually really good at it.' That was so cool that it connected with someone I knew from the racetrack, but had never really talked to that often."

One of Christman's biggest hopes, in relation to harness racing, is to see more people her age become involved in the sport.


She thinks about it often.

"I feel bad. I wish there could be marketing done to reach people my age. I know when I tell people my age what I do, they'll say, 'That's so cool! I love horses.' When I show them what I do, it opens a door for them, showing them that there are jobs in this sport if you are passionate about it."

They have an ideal role model to look up to in Christman.

"I love putting my creativity into things and seeing where it takes me."







Legendary cold blooded trotter Järvsöfaks is dead

Järvsöfaks, considered, by many fans, to be the best cold blooded trotter in the world, died Monday (Oct. 19) in his hometown of Hudiksvall, Sweden at the age of 26.

The Swedish bred horse had an amazing career at the tracks in northern Europe.

Järvsöfaks became an icon in Swedish harness racing, which is quite an achievement for a cold blooded trotter.

Three times he was named Horse Of The Year in Sweden and 12 occasions (1998-2009) he claimed the title of Cold-Blooded Trotter of the Year.

Jan-Olov Persson was the trainer and driver behind the charismatic trotter throughout all the years Järvsöfaks competed and together they experienced a magical harness racing moment in Gävle in July 2005 when Järvsöfaks became the first cold-blooded trotter to race below a 1.18,0 mark. His 1.17,9 over the approximate mile is equal as a mile rate of 2:05.2, which still is a record for the sport. There are many drivers from all over the world that has been given the opportunity to drive a cold-blooded trotter, including during World Drivers Championship tournaments in the northern European countries, so a few American drivers can understand the contribution Järvsöfaks has made to his breed.

A champion trotter who collected almost \$2,415,000 in earnings is now the new king in heaven.

Järvsöfaks, born 1994

234 starts, 201 victories and \$2,413,414 in earnings.

50 offspring that earned more than \$113,366 (approximately 1,000,000 SEK) and his best offspring, Hallsta Lotus, won 75 races in 195 starts and earned \$1,135,500 in his career.

Raceways will thrive with renewed local presence appreciated

When I was active in radio broadcasting there was an industry policy restricting the territory every radio station covers. It read: "All radio is local."

Radio station coverage was sliced and spread across North America to compete with one another only in a particular area, known as a market. That market's commercial businesses were the lifeblood of a station's income, keeping stations afloat through local advertising targeted at residents within the broadcast market. The rule was important to the survival of local radio stations.

Then came the digital revolution.

Commanded by a new technology, the borders of any broadcast facility's market were obliterated. Digital tools allowed instant reception almost anywhere on Earth. Physical borders have become irrelevant. With what is now household hardware, along with digital software, a person in Hobart, Tasmania can turn on his or her digital device and pick up a radio station in Ashtabula, OH, making the definition of "local" coalesce with the meaning of "global."

Today, a large menu of pari-mutuel raceways provide simulcasts of their product at dedicated wagering websites and off- and on-track wagering areas. A fingertip's touch can receive a visual race signal and bet on it. Suddenly there is no distance between, say, Northfield Park, U.S.A., and Albion Park, Australia. Times of day may alter in a virtual distance, but a live broadcast is real time, so for the horseplayer, hundreds of races are in the mix 24 hours a day for betting in every time zone.

Though raceways pick up business worldwide, they also contend with enormous additional competition, nationally and internationally. Only one source of income is exclusively available — a raceway's local area's local goods and services.

How, then, might a raceway benefit from embracing its local presence to the tune of income?

"Wherever there is a void," said a veteran Madison Avenue ad man, "there is a new market for something waiting to emerge."

The general problem identified, including collateral damage (live attendance) caused by the pandemic, means creating the think tank and jumping into it with open minds should be a top priority for a raceway's public-relations department.

Alternative Actions (AA) offers some ideas to build upon.

A raceway's profile locally demands concentrated efforts promoting and serving commerce and charity in its community. If you read into that correctly, it means doing stuff for free (which will have financial benefits in the long run). Every business in your track's immediate area faces the same problems as a raceway, that is, they have a need for more customers. Developing strong relations with local businesses unites elements of community commerce and nothing says "let's work together for our community" better than free advertising.

Imagine everything a raceway can propose that could benefit neighboring businesses and charities. Do not restrict your imagination; let the ideas flow.

Present (commercial) Community Flea Markets – Your raceway parking lot has more space than you may ever need again. Still, it's valuable real estate, so why not offer it free to house a flea market or two? Or more — always under the [your track name here] banner. Tell the local shops they can sell anything, as long as they give some stuff away through a raffle or some other gimmick. Try to make it a regular thing for local residents on a Saturday, maybe? Your raceway will have a kiosk at the flea market, too. Give away \$2 bets if people join the [your track name here] e-mail list.

How about using the parking lot for charity purposes on Sundays? Have religious outposts unite to create Food Banks. During your racing programs, do a lot of public service announcements urging area residents to contribute non-perishable foods to their places of worship so those items can be handed out to the needy on Sundays at the [your track name here] Food Bank.

Meanwhile, back at the track — research area history and begin naming overnight races with regional historic names of people, places and things. Name a race after a founding father of the township; name a race after whomsoever

started the public library or the family that pioneered agriculture or manufacturing.

Kadabra, who stands at Tara Hills Stud in Ontario, has surpassed \$100 million in progeny earnings by Standardbred Canada accounting.

The progeny of top Ontario sire Kadabra have exceeded \$100 million in total earnings, as computed by Standardbred Canada (which records money earned in the U.S. and Canada at par).

Kadabra, who stands at Tara Hills Stud in Port Perry, ON hit the milestone on Saturday (Oct. 17) when Up And Ready finished second to Dashing Muscle in the \$250000 2-year-old filly trot Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Super Final.

By USTA accounting (which converts Canadian dollars to U.S. dollars), Kadabra's progeny have earned over \$91 million.

Muscle Diamond to stand in Ohio at Cool Winds

Royally-bred, multiple stakes winner MUSCLE DIAMOND 2,1:53.4; 3,1:53.2f; 1:50.1 (\$834,424) has been retired from racing and will begin stallion service at Cool Winds Farm,

Lima, OH, for the 2021 breeding season.

The fastest male trotter ever sired by the incomparable Muscle Hill, he is from the world champion mare WINDYLANE HANOVER 3,1:53 (\$1,155,231), and will stand for a stud fee of \$4,000.

A fast and ultra-consistent performer, Muscle Diamond was 55 times 1-2-3 in 70 lifetime starts with 20 wins. At age 6, when he took his 1:50.1 record at The Meadowlands, he won 7 of his 13 seasonal starts, which also included the prestigious Vincennes Trot on Hambletonian Day, defeating some of the top trotters of the day like Pinkman and Obrigado.

Throughout the first four years of his career, he was handled by the leading money-winning driver of all time, John Campbell.

"Muscle diamond was a perfect horse to drive. He had a pure gait with a very high turn of speed," said the Hall of Famer, now president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society. "He raced at the highest level throughout his career and was very versatile with exceptional speed out of the gate."

Earning an average of \$119,203 per season in seven years on the track, he raced against the best stakes trotters in North America during his 2- and 3-year-old seasons.

At 2, he won the International Stallion Stake at Lexington, and was second in both his elimination and the \$500,000 Breeders Crown Final (by a head to Hambletonian winner Pinkman) at The Meadowlands. At 3, he went back to the Red Mile and captured the Bluegrass Stake, won numerous other stakes events around the Grand Circuit, and then capped off his sophomore season with a close third in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown Final at Woodbine.

When the 2021 breeding season begins, Muscle Diamond will be the fastest trotter to stand in the state of Ohio. In fact, only two horses sired by Muscle Hill have ever trotted faster than Muscle Diamond, and they are both female.

Yankeeland Partners (Charles E. Keller III, Charles E. Keller IV, Brett Bittle and Dan Bittle) selected Muscle Diamond as a yearling, and have owned, trained and campaigned him ever since. Trainer Brett Bittle said, "We are excited to team up with Randy and Kim Haines and their Cool Winds Farm of Ohio to stand Muscle Diamond. We believe his exceptional breeding and talent on the track will be passed on to the next generation. He possessed unbelievable speed, stamina and athleticism ranking as one of the top 2-year-olds of his year."

Yankeeland breeding manager Dan Bittle agreed, "Muscle Diamond has the breeding, ability, attitude and conformation

to be an impact sire in the lucrative Ohio program. We are looking forward to breeding, purchasing and racing his sons and daughters in the Buckeye State."

Coming full circle and impeccably bred, his dam Windylane Hanover won the 2002 \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks, was a World Champion, won \$1.15 million and went on to be named the 2003 Dan Patch Older Trotting Mare of the Year. She was campaigned by none other than Brett Bittle and owned by the Kellers and Dan Bittle.

Rookie fillies splash around in Harvest opener

The Harvest Series for Ontario sired 2-year-old fillies kicked off Monday (Oct. 19) on a rainy night at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

A total of four \$17,000 divisions were contested with trotting fillies starting the evening before the pacing fillies took their turn later in the card.

Justice Hall filly **Hawaii** took care of business in the first division for trotting fillies by moving from fourth to first before the half and never looking back for a 1:58 score (**replay here**) The Rick Zeron trainee was driven to the maiden-breaking score by Trevor Henry.

Hawaii, who was coming in off a runner-up finish in an Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold division, posted fractions of :59.2 and 1:29.2 before a :28.3 final-quarter secured a victory

of a length and a half. Tealicious finished second, while A Blue Blood was third.

Sporting multiple top-three finishes in Gold starts, Hawaii was made the heavy favorite and returned \$2.30 to win. She now has \$45,125 earned in seven starts for Rick Zeron Stables.

Val Taurus filly **Out On A Mission** took advantage of an early break by the favorite to break her maiden at odds of 5-1 in 2:00.4 (**replay here**)

The Gord Dancetovic-trained Out On A Mission was making just her third career start and was leaping up from the Autumn Series at Western Fair. Mike Saftic sent the rookie to the front and never looked backed, posting fractions of :28.2, 1:00 and 1:31 before a :29.4 final-quarter secured a victory of just over two lengths.

Somewhat Sacy finished second, while Waikiki Wave was third.

Out On A Mission's maiden-breaking win pushes her earnings to \$9,520 for owners Bob Dancetovic and Kenneth Albrecht. She paid \$12 to win.

Over on the pacing side, **Dabarndawgswatchin** powered to the lead in the second-quarter and kept on rolling for a 9-1 upset over four other rivals. Jody Jamieson guided the Ron MacDonald trained daughter of Hes Watching to victory.

Moving to the top from third going to the half, Dabarndawgswatchin had to deal with race-favorite Platine Alpha on her outside throughout the middle-half. The MacDonald trainee was not fazed by the pressure and scooted home in :29.3 over the "Good" track to win by five-lengths in 1:56.3 (replay here).

Platine Alpha finished second, while Control The Thong was third.

Owned by Julie Ferguson and Lloyd Stone, Dabarndawgswatchin now has two wins, eight on the board finishes and \$19,386 earned in 10 starts. She paid \$20 to win.

Sunshine Beach filly **Shes A Sassy Beach** powered to the lead in the second-quarter and kept on rolling to a 1:56.4 victory in the final division of the evening (replay here).

The Ken Middleton trained Shes A Sassy Beach flashed early speed for driver Sylvain Filion to land in an early pocket spot. Always Watching cleared to the lead entering the backstretch, but the lead was brief as Shes A Sassy Beach powered to the lead from third, posting a :58.1 half.

After securing a :30.2 third-quarter, Shes A Sassy Beach scooted home in :28.1 to win by two and three-quarter

lengths in 1:56.4. Carnival Heart rallied for second, while Siri Blue Chip was third.

Shes A Sassy Beach is now has two wins and \$34,183 earned in 11 starts for Middleton and the late Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame member Bill Galvin. A \$2 win ticket on the rookie pacing filly returned \$10.30.

The Harvest Series is for Ontario sired 2- and 3-year-olds that were non-winners of \$30,000 in 2020 as of Sept. 30. Rookie colts will have the opportunity for their first leg of the Harvest Series on Thursday (Oct. 22).

Mullinax rewrites track and stake records at Plainridge Park

The third leg of the Massachusetts Sire Stakes (MASS) for 2-year-olds of both gaits and genders was held at Plainridge Park on Sunday afternoon (Oct. 18) with \$113,750 in purses up for grabs.

In the first of two divisions of 2-year-old male pacers, **Mullinax** (American Ideal—Up Front Kellie Jo) made his presence known while winning in a big way.

Mullinax (Scott Zeron) got away third as the undefeated Call Me Maverick (Mike Stevenson) set fractions of :27.3, :57.3 and 1:26.1 with the field in single file behind. Entering the far turn, Maui (Shawn Gray) pulled from second and took his best shot at the leader as they headed into the stretch, but it was Mullinax who tipped three-high around both and paced furiously to the wire to win by 1-3/4 lengths in 1:53.4.

The winning time was a new track and stake record for a 2-year-old pacing gelding.

It was the fifth win of the year for Mullinax (\$4.00) who is owned by William Varney and trained by Mark Ford. Ed Mullinax and Mark Ford bred the winner.

The second set of first-year side-wheelers saw **Beantown Bruschi** (Dragon Again—Wondrous Grace) overcome a late miscue to take the win.

Beantown Bruschi (Mitchell Cushing) also sat third while Edelman (Ron Cushing) played hardball with post time favorite Dancing Lew (Bruce Ranger) to the quarter in :27.1. Dancing Lew took that trip to the half where he pulled and brought Beantown Bruschi (Mitchell Cushing) and Bumpah Stickah (Jim Hardy) with him. Rounding the far turn they fanned three across when Beantown Bruschi made a break, appearing to leave Dancing Lew and Bumpah Stickah to

decide the winner. But Cushing gathered Beantown Bruschi together and steadied him down the stretch where he caught the leaders at the line in 1:54.3, which was a new lifetime mark.

It was two wins in a row for Beantown Bruschi (\$10.60), owner/breeder Michael Goldberg Racing and trainer Jeff Lieberman.

The 2-year-old colt and gelding trot was basically a walk-over by **Incommunicado** (Chapter Seven—Gran Cavalla) after three horses broke by the quarter.

Incommunicado (Scott Zeron) trotted on the point with a loose lead to the half in :58.2 and three-quarters in 1:28.1 while Tbtwelve (Steve Smith) and In The Cards (Nick Graffam) tried to stay close. But when they turned for home Incommunicado had opened up a three length lead and bolted to an eventual 8-1/4 length victory in 1:57.3.

The win was the second straight in the MASS for Incommunicado (\$2.80) and owners Knutsson Trotting, Little E, Arthur Geiger and David Stolz. The Moni Maker Stable bred Incommunicado who was an \$80,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Selected Sale in 2019.

The first-year pacing fillies were up next and **So Amazing** (So Surreal—Teddy Ballgirl) was in complete control while putting on a dominating show.

After taking the lead immediately off the gate, So amazing (Bruce Ranger) maintained a quick pace while working through challenges from Ideally Sweet (Steve Smith) to the half, Purameri (Nick Graffam) at the three-quarters and then holding off deep stretch challenges from trippers Rightfully Mine (Scott Zeron) and Suzie Blue Chip (Shawn Gray) to win by a 3/4 of a length in 1:53.1.

So Amazing (\$20.80) scored her first MASS win along with a new lifetime mark for owners/breeders Nancy and Domenic Longobardi and trainer George Ducharme.

Lastly, the freshman filly trotters took the track and **Royal Envy** (RC Royalty—Temper Of Will) scored off a late closing kick.

Me Too Baby (Matty Athearn) went to the front while Moni For Lindy (Scott Zeron) followed in second as they rounded the first turn. At the three-eighths pole, Royal Envy (Shawn Gray) pulled and advanced only to third, where he hung for most of the next half mile. As the trotters approached the three-quarters, Moni For Lindy tipped out and took the lead from Me Too Baby while Royal Envy was still floating on the rim about four lengths behind. When they hit the stretch Moni For Lindy looked like she was home, but Royal Envy finally found his footing and trotted up a storm to the wire,

beating Moni for Lindy by 1/2 length in 1:58.

Royal Envy (\$4.80) scored his third straight MASS win for owners/breeders Al Ross and Ray Campbell Jr. George Ducharme also trains this filly.

Live racing at Plainridge Park featuring the third leg of the 3-year-old Massachusetts Sire Stakes will convene on Monday (Oct. 19) at 2 p.m. The \$720,000 (est.) MASS finals will be held on Monday (Oct. 26) at The Ridge with post time for the first race also at 2 p.m.

Wyatt J, Without A Warning undefeated in MASS

The third session of the Massachusetts Sire Stakes (MASS) for 3-year-old contenders met at Plainridge Park on Monday (Oct. 19) to compete for the \$112,500 in available purses with two early favorites ending the day three-for-three in the stake.

The 3-year-old male pacers saw **Wyatt J** (American Ideal—Think Pink) successful for a third straight week after hanging on for the win.

Wyatt J (Scott Zeron) took early command and led a single file field through five-eighths of a mile without movement. The first one to flinch was R Maddy Blue Chip (Kevin Switzer) who moved towards the leader up the backside and got within a length at the 7/8th's pole. There, Han Solo (Shawn Gray) pulled from fourth and swung three-deep into the lane and looked like he would take the prize. But Wyatt J was tougher and hung on to a neck victory in 1:52.3.

Owned by Ken Jacobs and trained by Linda Toscano, Wyatt J (\$2.20) should head into the final as the prohibitive favorite. Bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut, Wyatt J was a \$245,000 yearling purchase at the 2018 Lexington Selected sale and drew the highest sale price of any American Ideal yearling that year.

The other undefeated participant was **Without A Warning** (RC Royalty—Concentration) who bested the 3-year-old trotting fillies for the third straight week in a non-betting event.

Without A Warning (Scott Zeron) followed RFL's M London (Jim Hardy) for a quarter mile before Zeron tipped, took the lead and ran off with the money. The filly stayed close to the field until the top of the lane where she kicked away to a 2-1/2 length win in 1:57.

After tangling with the likes of Love A Good Story and Hypnotic Am in the New York Sire Stakes all year, Without A Warning has shown her class in this series with three easy wins for trainer George Ducharme. Without A Warning was bred by her owner, Ray Campbell Jr.

In the 3-year-old male trotting division, **Dazzling Lindy** (Crazed—Lindy On The Rocks) got his first MASS win and did it with a career best effort.

Dazzling Lindy (Drew Monti) took no prisoners and went right down the road with hectic fractions as the favored Life Is A Feast (Scott Zeron) following closely. Dazzling Lindy cut quarters of :27, :55.2 and 1:24.1. At that last station, Life Is A Feast pulled the pocket and tried to advance, but Monti popped the plugs and Dazzling Lindy trotted on. He opened up two lengths at the top of the stretch and held off a late lunge from Double Dealing (Shawn Gray) to win by 1/2 length in 1:54.4, which was a new lifetime mark.

Dazzling Lindy (\$10.20) scored his fourth overall win of the year for his owner the Lindy Farms of Connecticut, who also bred the gelding. Domenico Cecere is the trainer.

Finally the sophomore pacing fillies were tamed by **She's A Fireball** (Western Maverick—Fire Can Fly) on the strength of a big three-quarter move.

Rojas Blue Chip (Drew Monti) stepped to the half in a swift :55.3 with Ry's Red Rocket (Matty Athearn) and Shes A Fireball (Ron Cushing) right behind her. As they hit the 5/8th's, Cushing pulled Shes A Fireball and went right around Rojas Blue Chip and opened up two lengths on a fast approaching Ry's Red Rocket. Those two fillies broke away from the field heading into the stretch but Shes A Fireball was wrapped up and not to be caught, winning by 2-1/2 lengths in 1:54.1, tying her lifetime mark.

Shes A Fireball (\$5.80) has now won two of the three MASS legs for owners Ron Cushing and Adams Racing. Lucia Les and Kenneth Clairmont bred the winner.

The \$720,000 (est.) Massachusetts Sire Stake finals will be held on Monday (Oct. 26) at Plainridge Park with post time for the first race at 2 p.m. All eight finals will be held on that day.

Live racing at Plainridge Park will resume on Thursday (Oct. 22) at 2 p.m.
