# Does it all come down to the Breeders Crown for Twin B Joe Fresh?

Twin B Joe Fresh has been ranked No. 1 in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll for 15 consecutive weeks and is currently viewed as the favorite for Horse of the Year, which will be announced at the Dan Patch Awards banquet in Orlando, FL, in February of 2025.

Following a second-place finish from the 10-hole in the lone Breeders Crown Open Mare Pace elimination on Saturday (Oct. 19) at The Meadowlands, the question of whether Twin B Joe Fresh needs to win in the Crown final to lock up HOY was discussed on social media.

Twin B Joe Fresh had a nine-race win streak going into her Crown elim. Her only previous loss being her first of the year in an overnight against a field of 4-year-old male competitors, where she finished second.

HRU spoke with co-owner/trainer Chris Ryder about the Crown elim and why he didn't take a bye.

"It happens," Ryder said about finishing second. "It's alright. We just got to keep doing our thing and I believe we'll be fine. We had a qualifier, and she's been alright before off a qualifier. Obviously, we had to race and here we go again, so she'll be all right.



Had the daughter of Roll With Joe out of the Captaintreacherous mare Fresh Breeze won her elimination she would have earned draw protection between posts 1 through 6 in the final. So, going into Tuesday's (Oct. 22) draw, Ryder was hoping to have more luck than he had had so far with some of his other Crown entrants.


"They've drawn two fields of my horses and one got a 9 and one got a 10, so I'm not doing too well," Ryder said.

Ryder's Miki And Minnie drew post 9 in the Breeders Crown 2YOFP, and post 10 with Tarrific in the 3YOFP prior to the Tuesday draw when Gem Quality got post 8 in the 3YOCP, and lastly, Twin B Joe Fresh, post 5, in the Mare Pace.

Even though his other three horses drew towards the outside of the gate, Ryder was happy with post 5 for the Twin B Joe Fresh whom he co-owns with her driver, Dexter Dunn, Peter Trebotica and Barry Spak, especially since it's one of the winningest posts at The Big M. In terms of win percentage, the top post at the East Rutherford mile oval bounces between posts 5 and 6, with post 6 currently having a slight edge.

If the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll, which came out on Tuesday before the draw, is any indication, going into tonight's (Oct. 26) Crown finals, Twin B Joe Fresh's HOY hopes are still looking good.

To be fair, even though she maintained 27 first-place votes, her overall point total dropped from 336 to 332, but she also widened the gap on her opponents. Jiggy Jog S — who was retired prior to the Crown elims due to an injury — although still second in the poll with seven first-place votes, saw her total points drop from 315 to 300. Off his Crown elim victory,

Captain Albano jumped up from fifth to third, going from 193 to 233 points, and Crown ineligible Chantilly, who is reportedly done racing for the year, dropped from third to fourth but gained 16 points to go from 210 to 226. Rounding out the top five is Nijinsky, who moved up in the poll from sixth to fifth after a close second-place finish in his Crown elim, although his total points dropped from 149 to 142.

This year for Twin B Joe Fresh has been nothing short of sensational with her nine seasonal victories coming in the Betsy Ross, Perfect Sting, Dorothy Haughton Memorial, Lady Liberty, Cleopatra, Milton, Dayton Distaff Derby and elim and final of the Roses Are Red. She has banked \$627,062 for this season heading into tonight's finals; a good amount for a pacing mare that, unlike trotting females, doesn't race against males for much better purses.

But, if indeed Twin B Joe Fresh loses in the Open Mare Breeders Crown final, would she lose her top spot in the poll and for HOY consideration?

In recent years, both Tall Dark Stranger (2020) and Shartin N (2019) finished second in their respective Crown finals but still garnered Horse of the Year honors.

Whether Twin B Joe Fresh will race again this year, after tonight, remains to be seen.

"That depends on the final of the Crown," Ryder said. "I'm going to leave that on the table, so to speak."

Having a top horse like Twin B Joe Fresh is nothing new for Ryder, who will be inducted into the Hall of Fame in Goshen in July. But to be on top at the end of the year when the voting happens would be particularly meaningful as he has never had a Horse of the Year and is the only trainer to have a HOY runner-up three straight years: Bettor's Wish (2019), Party Girl Hill (2020) and Niki Hill (2021).

"Well, it'd be nice [for Twin B Joe Fresh to be Horse of the Year], but I don't want to get ahead of myself," Ryder said. "We'll just race, and we'll go from there. You know, [the voting is] out of my hands. All I can do is take care of my horse and here we go."

# What could go down at tonight's Breeders Crown

Breeders the sound of the sound

Continuing on from my thoughts on **Friday's 2-year-old races**, here is my take on the eight 3-year-old and open Breeders Crown races for tonight (Oct. 26) at The Meadowlands.

# **RACE 4: OPEN MARES TROT**

While still acclimating to North American racing, Nelsonbriteagle NO came up a little short against a few of these over the summer, but it looks like a different ballgame right now. As one of two opportunistic late supplements in this division following the


injury to Jiggy Jog S, she had won two in a row prior to the Allerage in Lexington, and her recovery in that race was nothing short of spectacular. After being down probably over 20 lengths following an early break, she only lost by a neck to barn mate, rival, and co-supplement, Call Me Goo. Any semblance of her last couple seems like it would be plenty good enough to beat these. M-M's Dream hasn't had quite as strong a year this time

around as she did last year but is still to be respected and comes off a confidence building win at Hoosier. Refined has a knack for stepping up in spots like this, invades from Ohio for Morgan. Tactical Mounds won in 1:49.4 over this track earlier in the year but has been dusted the last two times by the top choice.

# **RACE 5: 3-YEAR-OLD FILLY TROT**

In one of the more wide-open contests, Willys Home Run is a live price play from the rail. After showing early trot last week as a 22-1 longshot, she was quickly shuffled out of it but came on really well with a late charge to out close everyone. She was second to Drawn Impression from a bad spot in the Simcoe and seems overdue for some better racing luck. Drawn Impression will be the deserving favorite after besting Date Night Hanover last week. Both fillies took some time to clear to



the lead in that elimination, but Blais' filly was even better en route to taking a 1:51.1 lifetime mark. You could say that maybe R Melina "bounced" a little last week in losing at odds of 2-5 following that unbelievable front-end win in the Kentucky Filly Futurity but still only lost by a neck, will be interesting to see how she responds. Allegiant went the mile of her career in her elimination win over R Melina coming on the barn change from Beachy to Toscano. Warrawee Michelle seems almost forgotten from post 10 but always takes action.

Picks: Allegiant, Willy's Home Run, Drawn Impression

# **RACE 6: 3-YEAR-OLD FILLY PACE**

Is it just me or did the elimination race times for this division go comparatively slow to all the other races that night? My Girl EJ was coming off a lifetime best 1:48.1 win two back but really had to fight hard for that win last week to prevail by a neck over a game Collusion Hanover in 1:51. No slip-ups allowed in this competitive group if she wants to repeat as a Breeders Crown champion. Its A Love Thing was blocked for her life last week before finally getting through too late, will be my tepid pick. Direction was second to My Girl EJ two back in the Glen Garnsey and may have been beaten to the punch for an opening last week by longshot Asweetbeachhere. Caviart Belle was also knifing her way through late in that same race and looked better than she did throughout September. Rocket Deo is another that couldn't replicate her Red Mile feats from the start prior and at least will offer a higher price this time around for those that want to try her back. Disney will track from off the pace and look for similar late heroics.

# **RACE 7: 3-YEAR-OLD COLT TROT**

Highland Kismet is lucky to draw well – let alone draw at all – into the race following the retirement announcement of Karl, and he will be a major player going second-time Tetrick. He was already passed by those couple of big longshots last week even prior to the break but he had a tough trip in his defense; better positioned now. TCI encountered no issues whatsoever in his elimination and looked like himself of old while coasting on the front-end off soft fractions; would have to think he'll be forwardly placed once again by Miller. Security Protected gapped along the inside last week but gathered some late momentum; Secret Agent Man chased T C I around from the 2-hole in that same elimination. As has been a theme, Sig Sauer was another that raced tremendously last out at The Red Mile but the Futurity winner couldn't reproduce the same try last out. Amazing Catch took a ton of action last week but couldn't get close to T C I. Tony Adams S is a wild card from post 10. He's another that had a ton of road trouble last week and if you toss aside the ridiculous :52.4 half-mile race from two back he's been very good.

# **RACE 8: OPEN PACE**

Bythemissal has gotten sharper every start since he returned last month and made fairly easy work of it in his elimination after having to wait for clearance earlier to make it to the front. He has the post edge on his main rival in post 8 and could be set up to pounce should Ruthless Hanover be allowed to set the pace. Ruthless Hanover was able to hang on last week in a race where Miller did a good job to get separation from the field around three-quarters and Abuckabett Hanover did well to close but just had too much ground to make up in the lane. Indiana-bred Coach Stefanos came from a wide third-over to emerge out of the pack and close nicely when being second in his elimination to Bythemissal. It's My Show made a brief bid in his elimination against Bythemissal but was quickly repelled; Seven Colors goes second start off the month layoff and will get a new driver.

Picks: Bythemissal, Coach Stefanos, Abuckabett Hanover

# **RACE 9: OPEN TROT**

Logan Park really has impressed in his last few; first winning the Dayton Derby three back and then kicking home twice in a row to pass Periculum, who had become one of the best open trotters since his return to the U.S. Logan Park swept everyone to win his Allerage coming from last, and last week as a tune-up, he trotted a final quarter of :25.4. For what it's worth he has the age advantage on some of the 4-year-olds in here and will leave



it to McNair who picks up the livest of drives to overcome the outside post. The resume of Winner's Bet this year speaks for itself and his mark of 1:49.3 came over this track earlier in the year in a Graduate split, Dunn's pick over Logan Park. Periculum continues to fire honest efforts every race for Melander and is entirely playable too; could come down to the trip. Oh Well won that prep race last week but things look trickier here from the second tier. Ari Ferrari J has earned a try here off recent Yonkers form; It's Academic was better last year but will offer a price for Burke.

Picks: Logan Park, Periculum, Winner's Bet

# **RACE 10: 3-YEAR-OLD COLT PACE**

That was some show put on last week between Mirage Hanover and Nijinsky. Those two locked up at about three-quarters and had it to themselves, nearly inseparable the rest of the way with Mirage Hanover ultimately getting the better of the Meadowlands Pace runner-up by a head. Those two will line up from the two inside post draws and it'll be interesting to see if they push each other early. Captain Albano won his elimination last week in the faster time of 1:48.1 and a lot of credit should be given to him for versatility. Probably known more as a five-eighths mile horse due to his success in PA, he since won the Jug on a half-mile track and then put up a career best 1:48.1 at The Meadowlands. Captain Luke actually took a pretty good shot at Captain Albano in his elimination and wasn't disgraced whatsoever in finishing second; larger problem now is the outside post. Gem Quality upset in this race last year and would benefit from a lively pace.

Picks: Mirage Hanover, Captain Albano, Nijinsky

# **RACE 11: OPEN MARES PACE**

A win here by Twin B Joe Fresh would likely clinch Horse of the Year honors. She was beaten in her elimination by a former familiar rival in Grace Hill which snapped a nine-race win streak. You could say that maybe post 10 and a :26 and change quarter contributed to the loss, but maybe it was just her time to lose. I'd be surprised if she doesn't return back to winning ways. Grace Hill stepped up huge last week and gathered steam late to go past Twin B Joe Fresh from the pocket; seems like she'll be well-positioned enough once again to take her chance. Silver Label was only a length down to Twin B Joe Fresh a few back in the Milton and invades off a confidence building win at Woodbine Mohawk Park; had some successful moments here last year. Sylvia Hanover has her work cut out for her.

Picks: Twin B Joe Fresh, Silver Label, Grace Hill

# Sophomore filly pacers look for key Crown win

When it comes to tonight's (Oct. 26) \$600,000 Breeders Crown final for 3-year-old female pacers, the adage that "It all comes down to the Breeders Crown" seems particularly relevant to trainer Brett Pelling.

Pelling will send out four fillies in the field of 10 at The Meadowlands. Ron Burke-trained My Girl EJ is the 2-1 morning-line favorite, followed by five horses listed at no more than 8-1, including three from Pelling's stable: Rocket Deo, Direction, and Disney.

My Girl EJ, an elimination winner last week, is the season's fastest sophomore filly pacer, with a mark of 1:48.1. Its A Love Thing (the 7-2 third choice) and Rocket Deo (3-1 second choice) are not far behind, at 1:48.2 and 1:48.3, respectively. Fan Hanover Stakes winner Its A Love Thing is the division's richest horse, with \$572,408. My Girl EJ and Rocket Deo have both surpassed \$400,000 and Direction has nearly reached that level.

"When they say that it all comes down to the Breeders Crown, I think it definitely does for the 3-year-old fillies," Pelling said. "Its A Love Thing, Rocket Deo, My Girl EJ, and, if Direction wins, she will have won the two highest purse money stakes for the 3-year-old fillies. So, her hat is in the ring. Any one of those four fillies, to me, could be filly of the year. I don't know if anyone else thinks that way.

"It's an interesting race. My Girl EJ will be the favorite; she deserves to be. It will be a good race. I see at least four horses pushing out of there hard."

All Breeders Crown finals for 2-year-olds were held Friday at The Meadowlands. The remaining eight finals will be tonight at The Big M. First-race post time is 6:20 p.m. (EDT). Fox Sports will air coverage tonight from 7:30-11 p.m. on FS2.

Rocket Deo finished fifth in her elimination last week, which was won by stablemate Disney at odds of 66-1. Rocket Deo, a daughter of Captaintreacherous—Rocklamation, was a nose from unbeaten in her previous seven races. Her wins included divisions of the Glen Garnsey Memorial and Bluegrass Stakes at Lexington's Red Mile.

"She was sick coming back from Kentucky and I missed a week with her, which is really out of character for her. That's just not what she does," said Pelling, whose 13 lifetime Breeders Crown triumphs are tied for fourth in history. "She was good a couple of days prior to the race, but I think the week in the interim, it just wasn't a good week for her."

Direction also was fifth, missing by less than two lengths, in her elimination, which was won by My Girl EJ. She was no worse than second in 10 of her remaining 11 races this season, with her seven victories including the \$400,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes championship. She was second to My Girl EJ in a Garnsey division in her start prior to the Breeders Crown elim.

"She's never put in a bad race," Pelling said about the daughter of Always B Miki—Blood Red. "I do believe that if she got through the other night, she wins. She was the one with all kinds of pace. She was just shaking her head trying to find a spot."

Disney, a daughter of Always B Miki and two-time Breeders Crown champ Pure Country, rallied from the back of the pack to win her Crown elimination by a head. She raced in the Kentucky Sire Stakes Golden Rod Series, the third of the KYSS levels, before moving up to take on Grand Circuit horses in a division of the Bluegrass, which she won, in September.


"She's just a big, strong, easygoing filly," Pelling said about Disney, who has six wins, four seconds and a third in 11 starts. "She's still learning how to race. She's just really working it out. I kind of expect that she learned a bit the other night as well. I think she liked doing it that way, and she's drawn for it to be the same way again. I know there will be a better group of better horses in front of her, but if they go crazy, who knows."

**Lady Landia**, with James MacDonald at the lines, soared late to catch Miss Belmar and win the \$700,000 Breeders Crown 2-year-old filly trot final, on Friday (Oct. 25) at The Meadowlands, in a career-best 1:53.3.

Miss Belmar (driven by Andy McCarthy) took the early lead into the first turn, with Aperfect Annie (Todd McCarthy) early lick settling for second spot and Lady Landia trotting easily in third. In the contest for early positions, Luna Lovegood (Dexter Dunn), the overwhelming favorite, galloped while showing an aggressive move off the gate but was eliminated from competition thereafter.

"[Luna Lovegood] just got a little pacey in the first turn and went off stride," Dunn said. "She's usually really goodgaited but these are 2-year-olds and it's just a shame for it to happen tonight. She was very good afterwards, though [finishing sixth]"

Miss Belmar dug in to maintain the lead to the half in :57.1 while the only movement from behind was from Delaney Hanover (Tim Tetrick), followed by Sound Judgement (David Miler). But the leader put some distance between herself and the rest to cut three-quarters in 1:25.4.

Down the stretch, Lady Landia was full of trot, and MacDonald moved her to the outside and chased with gusto.

"Our chances felt good at the five-eighths," MacDonald said. "I told myself to hold on and don't fall off. I was surprised she was loaded heading for home."

Miss Belmar held on for second; Sound Judgement closed late to take the show spot.

MacDonald, who scored his first Breeders Crown win, was picked to drive Lady Landia late by trainer Åke Svanstedt and was happy because "[Svanstedt] always has his horses ready.

Asked when he found out he was down to drive, MacDonald said, "When the sheet came out. [Svanstedt] never asked me before. I'd driven a few for him so it's just that you see your name down and do your thing."



Forced into a first-over push midway up the backstretch, **Miki And Minnie** never ceased in her grind for the front and forged forward to a decisive 1:50.2 knockout in the \$700,000 Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Filly Pace on Friday (Oct. 25) at The Meadowlands.

Driver Dexter Dunn sent Miki And Minnie from post 9 and found a position in fifth behind a :27.2 first-quarter skirmish wrapped with 1-2 favorite Looksgoodinloulou landing on the lead.


"You can't do much about [the draw]," Dunn said. "You've just got to go out there and race the horse. She earned it tonight. She had the toughest [trip] in the race and really deserved to win that."

With Rodeo Drive Deo swiftly angling from the pylons in seventh and marching forward, Dunn vacated his spot at the cones and began an advance towards Looksgoodinloulou into a :55.4 half.

Looksgoodinloulou braced for pressure from Miki And Minnie through the final turn and maintained control by three-quarters in 1:24. Miki And Minnie persisted spinning for home and stuck a head in front of Looksgoodinloulou, who soon folded from the battle, to then edge away to a 1¾ length victory. The Last Martini burst from a pocket trip to take second with Rodeo Drive Deo finishing third and Looksgoodinloulou holding fourth.

"I definitely felt confidence in her," Dunn said. "She just got better and better as the year went on. I thought her elimination last week was really good; we had to use her extremely hard the first quarter and half. The draw was a little bit of a worry, but I was out at [trainer] Chris [Ryder]'s farm this week, and [he] usually doesn't say much, but I've never seen him so confident in a horse. So that filled me with confidence."

Miki And Minnie, a homebred daughter of Always B Miki out of the Roll With Joe mare That's The Ticket, collected her fifth win from 10 starts and has now banked \$671,750

Maryland and Dunn left from post 2 and were out-sprinted in the early stages as Maximus Mearas S and driver Scott Zeron vaulted to the early lead and seated Emoticon Legacy in the pocket. David Miller had Super Chapter parked and pressing, and that pair took charge through the :27.3 first quarter.

Louis-Philippe Roy, driving Emoticon Legacy, was anxious and moved on the backstretch to gain control three-eighths of a mile into the race, followed closely by Dunn with the favored Maryland. The pace was moderate, and Dunn strolled to the lead past the :56 half.

Dunn and Maryland were quickly joined by Go Dog Go and Todd McCarthy, who applied severe pressure to get level with the leader through three-quarters in 1:24.3.

Dunn called on Maryland in the homestretch, and the Melander trainee dug in gamely — at times throwing his head in response to urging. That was good enough to stall Go Dog Go's bid to his outer flank, but Maryland soon found company along the pylons as early leader Maximus Mearas S came charging boldly in the final yards. The wire arrived in time for Maryland, who used :27.1 closing speed to preserve his lead and leave Maximus Mearas S a neck short of the upset. Go Dog Go finished a well-earned third with Blank fourth across the wire.

For Maryland, bred by Hanover Shoe Farms and owned by the partnership of Courant Inc., PCW Racing, Holly Lane Stud East, and Steve Stewart and Robin Thorn Stables, the victory sewed up his championship season but will not be his last race of the year.

"We're going to bring him back for the Kindergarten final here (at the Meadowlands) in a couple of weeks, and that will be his last start," said Melander.

It was the second Breeders Crown victory of the night for Dunn.

"He fought hard to the wire," said Dunn. "Marcus and Mattias have done a great job with him."



# Louprint upsets in freshman male pace to give Wrenn, Jr. first Crown triumph

**Louprint** wore down pacesetter Fallout in deep stretch and held off fast-closing stablemate Sippinonsearoc at the line to capture Friday's (Oct. 25) \$700,000 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old male pacers in 1:49.1 at The Meadowlands. The margin was a head over Sippinonsearoc and q neck over Fallout in the three-horse photo.

Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. picked up his first Breeders Crown trophy by driving Louprint to victory for trainer Ron Burke.

The triumph was the 21st for Burke in the Breeders Crown. He leads all active trainers in victories, trailing only Jimmy Takter's 34 triumphs.

Louprint's time was one-fifth of a second off the stakes record, which was set in 2011 by the colt's sire, Sweet Lou.


In last week's elimination, Louprint was second by a nose to D A Love Boat

"Then, he draws the nine. I said, 'I told you, that's why you've got to win those things!"

"[But] I have all the faith in the world in Ronnie. He knows what it takes to win. I'm very impressed, and I'm very happy for him also."

Despite being one of the top drivers in the Midwest, last week was Wrenn, Jr.'s first time driving at The Meadowlands. He scored his first Big M win earlier in Friday's card.

"Last week was my first-time ever racing here, which is crazy after about 30,000 races," Wrenn, Jr. said, laughing. "I'm just a midwestern kid, I guess. A horse like this, I told them when I qualified him that I'd travel anywhere he'd go because I thought he was special. It's a dream come true."

Fallout and Louprint started from posts 8 and 9, respectively, and both left the gate quickly to get favorable early positions.

Louprint got the lead midway on the first turn and brought the field to the opening quarter in :27.1. Fallout and driver Tim Tetrick, though, were already closing in and took over the top spot on their way to a :55.2 half. Fallout remained in front at three-quarters, reached in 1:22.3, but faced pressure from Louprint as they came out of the final turn.

The two colts battled down the stretch, with Louprint overtaking Fallout nearing the wire. Sippinonsearoc and driver Scott Zeron, who were sixth at three-quarters, closed on the inside with a :25.3 last quarter to get up for second in the final strides.


Louprint, out of the mare Rockin Racer, is owned by breeders Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, and Phil Collura. He has won seven of 10 races and earned \$737,939.

"This colt was trained at the farm, he didn't even go to Florida," Burke said. "All winter I kept telling the guys down in Florida, listen, we've got one up there that can beat all of yours. They said I was crazy. I told them, the best colt we've got is up there. We've battled all year between our group trying to see who's the best. Tonight, he gets to be the best."

Burke sent out four colts in the Breeders Crown. In addition to Louprint and Sippinonsearoc, he had Swingtown and Railroad Station.

"They're incredible; they're all good," Burke said. "They try hard. We even have some other ones that aren't in here that are really nice colts, but these guys are special. Sippinonsearoc, I have to give him credit. He just kept getting better and better all the way to the end here."

Sent off at 8-1, Louprint paid \$18 to win.

# Massachusetts Breeders Stake finals had a recordbreaking day

The \$1.28 million finals of the Massachusetts Breeders Stake were held on Thursday (Oct. 24) afternoon at Plainridge Park and records of all sorts were rewritten throughout the program. Four stakes and two track records as well as four lifetime marks were either tied or broken during the stakes divisions that were contested for \$160,000 each.

Quick notes from the afternoon show that Yannick Gingras was the leading driver with three stakes wins, seven different trainers each won one stake apiece and Lindy Farms of Connecticut bred five of the seven 2024 Massachusetts Breeders Stake champions.

In the non-betting 3-year-old filly pace, **Every Mans Dream** (Always B Miki-Lindy's Nightmare) became a two-time Massachusetts champion after she destroyed the field in a record mile.

Gingras eased Every Mans Dream to the front and cut quarters of :27, :55.2 and 1:23.2 while Beantown Ace (Nick Graffam) followed in the pocket. As they entered the last turn, Every Mans Dream and Beantown Ace had separated themselves from the rest of the field. But then Every Mans Dream pulled away

from Beantown Ace and flew home in a swift :27 flat final panel to win by 11¾ lengths in 1:50.2.

The time tied the lifetime mark of Every Mans Dream, tied the track record and set a new stakes record for 3-year-old pacing fillies, breaking what she just set earlier this month.

Every Mans Dream is owned by Thomas and Scott Dillon and trained by Ron Burke.

Lindy Farms of Connecticut bred Every Mans Dream.

The 2-year-old colt and gelding trot went to current track record holder **Belmondo** (Walner—Love Lockdown) who brushed late to a convincing victory.

Moni Man (Brett Beckwith) took the lead and was followed by Castel Lindy (Gingras), Belmondo (Marcus Miller) and the remainder of the field through consistent quarters of :27.1,:56.2 and 1:26.4, with nobody pulling the right line. But as Moni Man headed into the turn, Gingras engaged Castel Lindy and Miller tipped Belmondo three-deep, and that top trio entered the stretch in a line across track. But it became quickly evident that Belmondo was full of trot and pulled away from the field before holding off a late closing My Degenerate (Andy Miller) to win by three-quarters-of-a-length in 1:55.3.

It was the third straight MBS win for Belmondo (\$2.60) and owners Andy Miller Stable, One Legend Stable and Jean Goehlen. Julie Miller trained the winner, Belmondo and the place finisher My Degenerate.

Belmondo was bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut.

There was a major upset in the 3-year-old trot for colts and geldings when **Pepper Wow** (Crazy Wow—Tori Hall) tripped-out to victory at 22-1.

the stretch, where Beckwith tipped O'er The Ramparts and took dead aim on the leader. These two pacers were all out in the lane, but O'er The Ramparts had a little more in the tank and got up at the last moment to win by a neck in a lifetime best, 1:52.

It was the sixth win of the year, but

first in the MBS for O'er The Ramparts (\$36.20) who is owned by Glenn Goller and Stephen Demeter and trained by Mark Beckwith.

O'er The Ramparts was bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut.

The 3-year-old trotting filly final went to the current MBS record holder **Treatyofversaille** (International Moni – Birthright) who captured her third consecutive stakes victory on Thursday.

Treatyofversaille (Bruce Ranger) got away third as Sassy Zaza (Beckwith) cut the quarter in :28.2. But Ranger was out and rolling early and put Treatyofversaille on the point before the :58.1 half. From there, Treatyofversaille fought off Dawn Of Lindy (Gingras) at three-quarters, turned for home and then held the tripping Sassy Zaza at bay late to win by 1¼ lengths in 1:55.4.

It was the sixth win of the year for Treatyofversaille (\$3.60) who is owned and bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut and trained by Domenico Cecere.

Another stakes record fell in the 2-year-old colt and gelding pace where **Jon I Love Dat** (Downbytheseaside—Franney Love Dat) was never headed as he claimed the crown.

Gingras took control easily from post 1 with Jon I Love Dat and had Digging For Gold (Graffam) shadow him from the garden spot. Jon I Love Dat paced smartly on the lead through quarters of :26.4, :55.4 and 1:24.3 with Digging For Gold breathing down his back. When they turned for home, Digging For Gold pulled to advance, but Jon I Love Dat just paced away from him and to a 2½-length victory in 1:52.3, setting a new stake record for 2-year-old pacing colts.

Jon I Love Dat (\$6.20) is owned and bred by Robert Lovett and trained by Chuck Connor, Jr.

The 2-year-old pacing filly final was declared a "no contest" after It's Crunch Time made a misstep and fell in the first turn, causing interference to the trailing horses. All wagers on the race were refunded.

The horses and drivers involved were checked out and okay after the race and the purse money will be distributed according to USTA Rule 13.05 (e) 1, concerning no contest races.

# Virginia Breeders' \$720,625 Championship Day card set for Sunday at Shenandoah Downs

Fields for the 27th annual Virginia Breeder's Championships are set for this Sunday (Oct. 27) at Shenandoah Downs and will help usher out the fall racing season in Woodstock. Eight divisional championships featuring 2- and 3-year-old pacers and trotters of both sexes will be carded on the front end of the 14-race card and run consecutively as races 1 through 8 beginning at 1:05 p.m. Combined purse money for the eight is \$720,625. An additional six races will follow — including five Virginia Breeders Older races worth \$20,000 each — bringing the afternoon's purse distribution to a record \$830,625.

Kelsey Wagner's Brooksforreal set a new track record for 2-year-old gelding pacers in his October 13th Breeder's elimination win, then shaved nearly two seconds off that mark in last Sunday's elimination with a 1:54.1 effort. The Rusty's For Real gelding leads a field of eight in Sunday's \$90,975 final for freshmen colt and gelding pacers. Corey Braden will drive for trainer John Wagner. Overshadowed a bit in this division is W. Hartt, H. Taylor, B. Dillon and J. Dumberger's Paxamillion, who snagged a first leg score in 1:56.3 then, when facing Brooksforreal last week in the second leg, had a solid runner-up finish crossing just 1¾-lengths behind. Luke Hanners will drive for trainer Britney Dillon.

Kelsey Wagner's Swervingmervin authored a track record last week as well in the 2-year-old colt/gelding trot category and leads a field of eight in the \$92,175 final. The John Wagner trainee wired the field in 1:58.4 and crossed 1¾ lengths the best over Scott Woogen's Mane Man Charlie who scored a first leg elimination in 2:03.4, over Swervingmervin. The record holder will be piloted by Corey Braden while the latter will get the services of leading driver Fern Paquet, Jr. for trainer Gary Messenger.

Caviart Farms' Caviart Glory thumped the field in the 2-year-old filly trot's first leg, wiring the field by 20 lengths while setting a new track record in that division. The Greenshoe filly crossed in 1:59.4 and after cementing her spot in the final, took a pass on

the second elimination a week ago. Trainer Philip Scott Sonsteby will be in the sulky in Sunday's \$94,500 final from outside post 8. Other divisional winners include Jane Dunavant's Kat's Fancy and Song Master and Scott Woogen's KJ Breeze.

Four different freshman filly pacers won elimination races the past two weekends including Elwood Tignor's Mygirlmia, whose 1:57.1 clocking was fastest of the four. William Carter's Alexandria's Dream and Elwood Tignor and Deborah Mulligan's Toys Little Tinker — who each have seven combined first and second place finishes this year — recorded winning elimination miles of 1:57.4 and 1:58.4, respectively. The latter has bankrolled \$60,500, highest figure of any entrant in the field. Dr. Edward Ward's Caviart Acadia collected the other elimination victory in 1:58.1.

All four divisional champions from the 2023 class return as 3-year-olds with hopes of defending their titles, though none reached the winner's circle in their respective eliminations.

Kelsey Wagner and Scott Woogen's K J Dash brings a field best bankroll of \$221,011 into the \$86,000 3-Year-Old Colt/Gelding Trot final. The Lockkeeper gelding is fresh off a pair of runner-up finishes in the eliminations. Debbie Warnick's Royal Beep Beep authored the fastest elimination win in 2:00.4. Other winners were Kelsey Wagner's Geralds A Keeper, who is eight-for-10 in 2024, Jane Dunavant's Pretty Two and Dein Spriggs and Barbara Murphy's Caviart Grady.

Anne McDonald's Sweet Pirategirl has fared similarly. Last year's 2-year-old filly pacing champ has a second and third in 3-year-old Breeder's elimination races but is fresh off a dominant conditioned race win Oct. 13. Caviart Farm's Caviart Sophie has a pair of series wins including one in 1:54.1. Those two and five other entrants will battle in the \$87,600 final on Sunday.

Kelsey Wagner's 2023 2-year-old colt/gelding champ Pete's For Real has a second and third in 2024 eliminations and his \$101,682 bankroll tops the field. With only seven in this division, the first two weeks served as prep races, which were won by Tracy Bradshaw's Bgoing Away (1:56.4) and Lawrence Cooper's Caviart Simon (1:55.2). The \$84,400 final has been carded as the sixth race.

Last year's 2-Year-Old Filly Trotting champ Rip Away enters the sophomore title bout with a pair of runner-up finishes from her eliminations. The Dusty Winner filly is one of two in the \$90,000 final that sport a six figure bankroll. The other, Nanticoke Racing and Delbert Cain's Platinum Proposal, won both of her eliminations with Jim Morand in the bike. The Les Givens trainee has career earnings of \$185,931. Other preliminary leg winners were Marna Shehan's Speedy Town and Howard and Linda Dege's Royal Robin.

Sunday's Breeders' Championship card will close out Shenandoah Downs' final weekend of the fall race meet. A 14-race card is scheduled for today as well beginning at 1:05 p.m.

## Harrah's Hoosier Park 2025 racing dates approved

The Indiana Horse Racing Commission approved Harrah's Hoosier Park's 2025 live racing dates during their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday (Oct. 24). Offering 160-days of live harness racing, the 2025 racing season will begin on Friday (March 14) and extend through Saturday (Nov. 29). Harrah's Hoosier Park will retain its standard post times of 6:15 p.m. on weeknights, and 7 p.m. for Saturdays during the 2025 racing season.

The 2025 season will closely mirror that of the 2024 race schedule, with a few minor changes agreed upon between both Harrah's Hoosier Park and the Indiana Standardbred Association. The March 14 start date is a week prior to that of the opening of the 2024 season. Racing will begin with a two-day (Friday and Saturday) schedule for the first two weeks of the 2025 season, a three-day (Thursday through Saturday) schedule the following two weeks, before beginning a four-day (Wednesday through Saturday) schedule on Wednesday (April 9). From there, the 2025 season will look much like 2024, with a five-day (Tuesday through Saturday) racing schedule from Tuesday (June 24) through Saturday (Oct. 25).

An additional change for the 2025 season is that there will be no racing on Wednesday (Aug. 6) to avoid overlapping with the Grand Circuit racing at the Indiana State Fair Grounds highlighted by the Fox Stake.

Included with the approval of the 2025 race dates was approval for special post times from many of Harrah's Hoosier Park's signature race dates. The cards for both the 32nd Dan Patch Stakes (Friday, Aug. 8) and eighth Caesars Trotting Classic (Friday, Sept. 19) will both begin at 6 p.m. as they did in 2024. Additionally, Harrah's Hoosier Park will once again offer a 4 p.m. post time on the first Saturday in May (May 3), splitting the card around the Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs in efforts to introduce more of the Derby Day crowd to racing at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Post Time for the two remaining Triple Crown dates (Saturday, May 17 and Saturday, June 7) will be 7:20 p.m.

Stall applications for the 2025 racing season will be made available at a later date and additionally posted on the Harrah's Hoosier Park website.
