This year it likely won't come down to the Breeders Crown

The presumptive trio in line for Horse of the Year honors all lost Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk Park, meaning it's the rare year where the Breeders Crown isn't a determining factor.

That “crunching” sound you are hearing at various hotbeds of harness racing is the sound of people taking any preconceptions they had about Horse of the Year voting, balling them up, and preparing to toss them into the nearest wastecan, getting set for a

re-evaluation.

Shartin N, Greenshoe, and Bettor's Wish all finished second in their Breeders Crown events at Woodbine at Mohawk Park on a Saturday night that started windy and moderately-tough, and gradually turned more and more messy.

Their conquerors – Caviart Ally, Gimpanzee, and Dancin

WEG sets Canadian standardbred handle record with \$6.6 million wagered on Crown cards

Breeders Crown weekend produced a Canadian and Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) standardbred handle record of \$6,678,779 million combining the Friday and Saturday cards at Woodbine Mohawk Park. On Friday, \$2,902,937 was bet on the card that included the four Crown finals for 2-year-olds. On Saturday, \$3,775,842 was wagered on the card that featured Crown finals for 3-year-olds and older horses.

The previous Canadian record was \$5,748,950 set when Woodbine Racetrack played host to all 12 Breeders Crown finals in a single night in 2015.

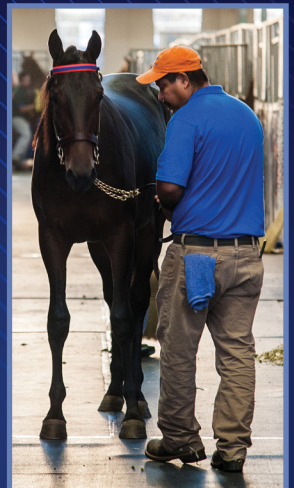

Lou, respectively – are all fine horses; we’ve known about the first two for a long time, and we’ve learned a lot about the third one in recent weeks (Saturday we learned that the law profession has probably lost trainer Tahnee Camilleri for good). And they all came uncovered on the far turn.

Greenshoe got interfered with by a breaker and still closed powerfully; Shartin N had recently been sick, and had had only one race in 55 days before her Crown. Bettor’s Wish lost by a small margin as usual when he doesn’t win – he’s now won over \$1.5 million (all these figures U.S.) this year, and his five losses have come by a combined *11 feet* – three heads, a neck, and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length – and have cost him a total of \$738,294, which is \$67,117 a foot and \$5,609 *an inch*.

If one or two of the Top Ten’s Big 3 had won, you might have had a case for thinking less of the horse(s) who suffered defeat Saturday. But all were upset, all in different ways, and you have to view these results, and their seasons, with a fresh eye.

(And don’t forget to extend some of your vision to Warrawee Ubeaut, who did win in the 3-year-old filly pacing Crown, was unlucky in midseason, and was ruthless early in the year and especially late, the “crunch time” of extra

weighting of results.)

Writing this on a deadline, I'm not offering any evaluations, other than the ones you have read above. The stakes are too high to not go back to try to put all this information in proper context. And remember that there are still other stakes to come yet this season – I love the Breeders Crown, and I'm afraid of Moira Fanning – but this year it doesn't seem like it will all come down...

Caviart Ally's owners said before her upset of Shartin N that they were beginning to wonder if she ever would get the job done in the Breeders Crown. But even if she had finished second again, which would have raised her Crown earnings to \$265,100 (U.S.) lifetime, she had a way to go to become the richest Breeders Crown earner never to win a Crown. That title goes to the Hambletonian-winning trotter Vivid Photo, who earned \$477,620 (U.S.) in the seasonal championship series without ever wearing a Crown.

Caviart Ally and Manchego winning the first two Saturday Crowns had a precedent of sorts: they both won their respective Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Championships in 2017, when Manchego was two and Caviart Ally was three.

Caviart Ally and Manchego also continued the success of Andrew McCarthy and Dexter Dunn, both Breeders Crown maidens coming to Toronto; now McCarthy has four, two both nights, and Dunn has two, one each night. (And remember, Dunn drove both Bettor's Wish and Dancin Lou to victory in the Crown elims, stuck with Bettor's Wish – and guess which Australian got the drive behind the victorious Dancin Lou).

Joe Bongiorno would "break his Crown driving maiden" with American History in Saturday's Open Pace – this is a horse who can do amazing things when he is on top of his game.

Manchego gets a separate mention for setting a Mare Trot record with a 1:51 victory, breaking the 2014 1:51.4 record of

Bee A Magician. Her race came in not-the-best weather, but before conditions really deteriorated.

The New York-based filly Winndevie didn't fool many people on Saturday – she would up as the 3-2 favorite after her blinding :26.1 last quarter in her elimination. She brought trainer Trond Smedhammer his fourth win in the 3-year-old filly trot Crowns, making him #1 there, and she also brought driver Brian Sears to his 31st overall Crown trophy, making him #2 behind John Campbell, and adding a record sixth Crown in the sophomore filly trot. The “Red Knight” (for the race, anyway, wearing the owners' colors) then added #32 with the legendary European trotter Bold Eagle, who made a simple brush to the lead down the backstretch and held off the likes of Six Pack and Atlanta quite handily.

Brittany Farms had a great Crown weekend, with two owning triumphs furthering their all-time lead in both wins and money in that category, and being the breeder of three winners moving them within one of Hanover at 26-25; Hanover bred Caviart Ally and kept their lead in wins, and they are far and away the biggest money-winning breeders in Crown history.

Pennsylvania won the title for most graduates of its program taking victories, with New York coming second.

Favorites won half of the eight Crown races on Saturday after going 0-for-4 Friday, bringing the weekend's total to 4 for 12, and the two Crown weeks of races produced eight chinks in 27 events. But there were quite a few second choices and other highly-regarded horses – \$13.10 was the highest Crown mutuel Saturday.

Given our discussion of post positions in yesterday's column, it seems appropriate to say that on Friday night, these were the posts of the entire card's winners: 6-5-6-6-9-10-8-4-7-9-6-9. And in the two overnights on Saturday before our deadline, the winners came from 10 and 9. But in the Saturday Crown races, the distribution was more normal – 3-4-6-5-3-6-4-1, with some winners having won elims and shaking for a 1-5 post draw.

The wind was a pretty pronounced stretch tailwind, which would account for the very fast first quarters – and much slower second quarters – that were seen throughout the night.

Answer to last night's trivia question: Canadian big-track record set at Woodbine and still standing? You probably got one of them – the 1:49 Sweet Lou went on October 29, 2011, the Canadian record for 2-year-old pacing colts and at that time the fastest mile ever by a 2-year-old, beaten only last

year by the filly Warrawee Beauty and then by the gelding Elver Hanover this year at Lexington (both 1:48.3).

The other is Mister Herbie, still the recordholder for 3-year-old geldings with a 1:52 mile at Woodbine on November 12, 2011. Mister Herbie would go on to set the Canadian 4YO+ trotting gelding record of 1:50.4 at Mohawk exactly eight months later – and that mark still stands, too.

You may have heard Woodbine Mohawk Park announcer Ken Middleton Jr. mention that Bill O'Donnell produced one of the most memorable sound bites in Breeders Crown history. In case you were wondering...

In 1987, Robust Hanover was in the Open Pace Crown event at Roosevelt, and went to a knee coming onto the racetrack. The judges ruled that by New York rules that constituted “falling to the track,” which necessitated a scratch. That decision was not well-received by some, including “The Magic Man,” and when an announcer said to him on camera that that was certainly bad luck, O'Donnell responded with some comment about the absence of fecal matter – never did quite catch the full context.

Horse of Year and divisional honors remain in flux following Breeders Crown

The 12 Breeders Crown races that took place over Friday and Saturday lived up to their billing as far as race quality goes, but in many ways only added to the complexity of trying to sort out where horses stand with year-end awards. That's because only a small number of the races were won by the respective divisional leaders going in, and how much is given to the notion that it all comes down to the Breeders Crown will go a long way in determining who ultimately ends up on top. Also, there's still more racing to take place in the Matron, Fall Final Four and TVG series, but here's how I see things as of this moment following the Breeders Crown.

Starting at the top with Horse of the Year, the two front running horses both lost in their Breeders Crown races. In the current Hambletonian/Breeders Crown top ten poll, the older pacing mare Shartin N led slightly over the 3-year-old colt trotter Greenshoe, with both splitting nearly all the first-place votes in the poll.

It's impossibly difficult to split these two with comparable records and similar relative dominance over their divisions, but let's presume that Horse of the Year was Shartin's to lose since she went into the weekend with the slight edge in the poll. Sent off at odds of 2-5 to win her Breeders Crown and close the deal, she was upended for the second consecutive time by Caviart Ally, who also bested her prior in the Allerage. It's still been a brilliant year for the 6-year-old Shartin and there's no question she'll be the older mare pacer of the year, but she hasn't won a race now since Sept. 1 having dealt with sickness and hasn't won a six-figure stakes race since the middle of August. With her loss, it opened the door for Greenshoe to step in and claim the top spot.

However, it wasn't meant to be for Greenshoe either. Sent off also as odds-on at the price of 50 cents on the dollar, in a race reminiscent of his loss in the Beal at Pocono, Greenshoe found himself with too much ground to make up following stalled over and could only rally to be second best. As with prior, the defeat was more a result of poor race circumstance much more so than the effort he put forth. With both horses losing, conventional wisdom would say that Shartin remains ahead, but I think her stock is a bit more tenuous than Greenshoe who overall remains sharper. For my money, Greenshoe may be slightly ahead in the eyes of voters and will have a chance to solidify his standing in at least one more major stake race this season.

Within the individual divisions, the 3-year-olds seem more settled than the 2-year-old ones. Starting with the glamour 3-year-old pacing colt division, Bettor's Wish went into the Breeders Crown ranked #3 in the top ten poll only behind Shartin and Greenshoe, and despite his loss to Dancin Lou he remains a cinch to claim that division's top honor. The top spot was held earlier in the season by Southwind Ozzi but was overtaken in recent weeks by Bettor's Wish and no matter what happens from here on in, he'll top the division despite a late season surge from Dancin Lou. For the 3-year-old pacing fillies, Warrawee Beaut already had the division locked up but put an exclamation point on it with her comfortable win Saturday over rival Tall Drink Hanover.

On the 3-year-old trotting side of things, Greenshoe is obviously a foregone conclusion on the colt's side. The fillies side, though, is far more debatable. If I had to guess, I'd say the right now the divisional honor would fall back to last year's divisional winner in this category, When Dovescry. She's tailed off somewhat in the latter part of the season and her record for the year stands at just four wins from 11 starts (though she's yet to miss the board including a runner-up spot in the Breeders Crown), but who else would the award go to? The next logical choice would be Millies Possession, but When Dovescry owned her in head-to-head meetings throughout the year. It's too bad that Millies Possession had to scratch from the Breeders Crown final because she would have been in a favorable position to win, but without being able to compete in the final I think it's hard to place her in front of the division.

For the rookies, the most clear-cut division are the colt pacers. This one will go to Tall Dark Stranger whose only loss of the year came in his Breeders Crown elimination, though

things could have gotten interesting if Papi Rob Hanvoer were kept up in Friday's Crown final. That would have meant a split for the duo between the Metro and the Breeders Crown, and a case could have been made for either.

In all other 2-year-old divisions, the divisional leaders lost as those Breeders Crown races were highlighted by big upsets. For the filly pacers, Lyon's Sentinel lost by a neck to Reflect With Me only after being raced over-aggressively where she brushed to the lead through a :53:3 half mile. She held well considering, with a record of eight wins and four seconds through her 12 starts, she's done more than enough to take home the top spot in the division. Credit though to Reflect With Me who won't win the division, but proved far better than her longshot odds indicated in winning the Breeders Crown and no one would be blamed for giving her outside consideration.

The two 2-year-old divisions for trotters get interesting. Up until last week, it seemed to be a no-brainer that the Doherty Memorial and NYSS winner Hypnotic Am would win up the divisional champion. But she was slightly less than her best in the Breeders Crown and out of nowhere Ramona Hill has come on to make a strong late season case for herself. She's now won the Bluegrass, the International Stallion Stake, and the Breeders Crown, along with a mark of 1:52:2 from Lexington. This division could still be determined, but at the very least Ramona Hill has put together a very credible resume to warrant the top spot for the division.

It's a similar situation on the colt side although perhaps to a lesser extent. Real Cool Sam entered the Breeders Crown with a perfect 9 for 9 record. He didn't get a good trip in the final and regardless I don't know if a single loss would suddenly take the division away from him, but Breeders Crown winner Amigo Volo is starting to build a case. With the same type of recent wins as Ramona Hill on the filly side, he's peaking at the right time. The division still should belong to Real Cool Sam, but it's subject to seeing how the rest of the year plays out.

Manchego is a lock as older trotting mare and that was emphasized by her resounding Breeders Crown win. McWicked didn't have as much luck in the Open Breeders Crown pace but he will win the division again, nonetheless.

France's Bold Eagle simply stunning in first start outside Europe

Coming into Saturday's Breeders Crown Open Trot at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Bold Eagle was one horse drawing a lot of headlines. The French-based son of Ready Cash, out of the Love You mare Reethi Rah Jet, would be

making his first start outside of Europe in search of his 46th career win in his 68th career start.

He did not disappoint.

Despite heavy rain, strong winds, the rail draw, and getting slightly worked up on the track during the warm up, Bold Eagle was all business when the race began. He settled in fourth behind the mare Atlanta heading into the first turn, but made a strong move for the lead in the backstretch. He was challenged by Six Pack on the far turn, and Atlanta also made a late run in the stretch, but Bold Eagle would not be denied as he crossed the wire first in 1:52-flat. Six Pack held on for second, while Atlanta was third.

Bold Eagle has won a number of major honors in Europe in

his career, including the 2016 Prix d'Amerique, and a French Trotting Triple Crown in 2017, and he can now add a Breeders Crown victory to his long list of achievements.

A trip to the Breeders Crown for trainer Sebastien Guarato, and owners Pierre Pilarski and Thomas Bernereau had been a few years in the making, but even they would not have been able to predict the success they would have when they purchased Bold Eagle from breeder Jean Etienne Dubois following the horse's 3-year-old campaign in 2014.

"We promised that we were going to come and now we are very satisfied," Guarato said through a translator.

Bold Eagle was driven by veteran driver Brian Sears, who now has 32 Breeders Crown victories after picking up a pair of wins on Saturday. Sears also drove Winndevie to victory in the 3-year-old Filly Trot final earlier in the night.

It was a joyous winner's circle for Bold Eagles connections.

Sears said he didn't have a specific racing tactic in mind for Bold Eagle heading into the race.


"I just know that he's a good horse and he fits the class and then I just play it by ear," he said. "The move I was making on the backside, it was pretty bold, but he held on and he showed his class."

Sears added that he also wasn't concerned with Bold Eagle's pre-race behavior.

"I warmed him up and he was really rank, but I've seen that before over there in France and then once they get behind the gate they are usually fine," he said.

Bjorn Goop had been Bold Eagle's driver for the majority of his starts this season, but Sears said he was honored to get the call to drive Bold Eagle in the Breeders Crown when Goop opted to stay in Sweden to compete in stakes races.

"It's definitely an honor to be chosen to drive a horse like that," Sears said. "There's some great horsemen over there, some great drivers. I got to go over there and witness it first hand in a couple of those races and it's pretty amazing, some of those races with the big fields and the distances they go.

Warrawee Ubeaut scores second Breeders Crown victory

Warrawee Ubeaut designed back-to-back Breeders Crown victories, this time as a sophomore at Woodbine Mohawk Park, winning the \$720,500 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old pacing fillies on Oct. 26 in 1:50.2.

Yannick Gingras guided the 1-5 favorite trained by Ron Burke.

The speedy daughter of Sweet Lou—Great Memories (Sweet Lou was also trained by Ron Burke), left smoothly behind the early foot from Stoneridge Soul (Tim Tetrick) from outside post 8, but quickly challenged by Treacherous Reign (Dexter Dunn) with a burst of speed of his own from the inside.

Dunn tried to keep Treacherous Reign on the lead after the brief duel and cut a :25.3 first quarter when settled, though not for long, because Gingras steered Warrawee Ubeaut first over to pursue the lead. Gingras took his filly to the top with a firm brush and cut a brisk :54.4 half as Stonebridge Soul took a few steps ahead of Treacherous Reign.

After that shuffle, Treacherous Reign returned into the second spot as Stonebridge Soul became trapped in third in front of the anxious threesome of Sunny Dee, Tall Drink Hanover and Beautyonthebeach, each preparing to use the best of what they had left in them to catch Warrawee Ubeaut.

Warrawee Ubeaut, however, was full of pace. She cut three-quarters in 1:23.1, tossing off the very idea of being challenged. Gingras sat back and his charge showed once again why she was the best in the division through the long stakes season.

Still in full stride, she crossed the wire in 1:50.2 for her second Breeders Crown championship.

Tall Drink Hanover was next best, paving her way from the

outside mid-stretch, while Stonebridge Soul got the show spot.

The win was Warrawee Ubeaut's 19th as a 2- and 3-year-old. With the 2019 Breeders Crown championship, her earnings were boosted to \$1.68 million.

Warrawee Ubeaut is a local filly. She was bred by Warrawee Farm, just a gallop or two away from Woodbine/Mohawk Park. Her caretaker is Jennifer Thomas.

Burke Racing Stable LLC, Phillip Collura and Weaver BrusceMI LLC own her in partnership.

"She was much the best and she is so sharp right now," said Gingras, adding he had to go to the lead but was concerned about the move at first. "Then she relaxed in the third quarter," he said, "and was fine [holding the lead]."

Burke said he thought the race was going to go exactly as it did.

"We didn't see Stonebridge Soul leaving that hard but Yannick did a good job getting in and [getting the filly] settled," Burke said. "He knew when they were going to take a break in the second quarter and move into it."

Burke, who led Warrawee Ubeaut to her championship freshman season in 2018, said she is "an incredibly strong and talented filly" and has always had "high speed" on her side.

He admitted that having consecutive winning seasons is tough, but said, "She's one of the better 2- and 3-year-olds

ever. She's the whole package. It's hard to repeat, for sure. I'm proud of her. That's back-to-back years on two terrible nights [of weather] that she overcame. I think she's doing everything we could ask of her right now."

Her future is being planned, as well. "I think you'll see she's going to race the aged mares hopefully at the end of the year," he said, "and I think she'll show that she can go with them, too."

Not only that, but Burke said he feels Warrawee Ubeaut will race "at least the next two years, God willing, as long as she stays sound all the way until five" and for one great reason, he said: "She can go faster. One of these days it will set up where somebody cuts huge numbers and she can sit in, just like last year when she went forty-eight, and she'll do something special then. She's just a very special horse."

Tony Alagna trains both Tall Drink Hanover and Treacherous Reign.

"Warrawee Ubeaut has been dominant," Tony said. "She was very good the second part of the season."

In the Breeder Crown final, Alagna said, "Treacherous Reign got stung pretty good getting to the front. I thought the other filly raced great first over. She came first over from fifth, which is very tough to do, especially into a headwind, so I thought it was a great effort for her."

The favorite throughout the wagering, Warrawee Ubeaut paid \$2.40 to win.

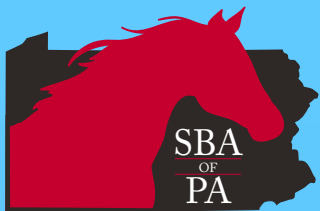

Gimpanzee leads one-two Melander punch

He may not be the most physically imposing horse, but on a windy, rainy night at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Gimpanzee weathered the storm and came up huge in the \$657,895 (CDN) 3-year-old Breeders Crown Colt Trot final.

Purchased for \$170,000 at the 2017 Harrisburg sale, Gimpanzee, a son of Chapter Seven—Steamy Windows, didn't stand head and shoulders above many of those that entered the ring.

But it didn't take long for the horse originally known as Army of Monkeys, bred by Order By Stable (Sweden), to show he packed plenty of punch where and when it counted the

most.

The most impressive 'tale of the tape' stat for Gimpanzee? Nine straight wins in as many starts in his 2-year-old campaign.

Not surprisingly, he was feted with Dan Patch honors in his division.

Trained by Marcus Melander, Gimpanzee was a force on the New York Sire Stakes circuit in 2018, taking six preliminary rounds and the \$225,000 championship, before ending his

campaign by winning his Breeders Crown elimination and the \$600,000 final.

His unblemished performance yielded \$591,358 in earnings for owners Anders Strom's Courant Inc. and Lennart Agren's SRF Stable.

Heading into his 3-year-old season, Melander heaped praise on his heavyweight pupil.

"He's filled out nicely. He's not the biggest horse but we've been very happy with him all winter. He doesn't make any noise here at home, he just looks like a regular horse. He's nice and calm," Melander said.

And on Saturday evening at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Gimpanzee, who came into the Breeders Crown sporting a 6-1-2 mark from 11 starts on the year, showed he could rise

up to the biggest challenge.

In order to win his Breeders Crown engagement, he'd need a Herculean effort to get by Greenshoe, a fellow Melander trainee, and winner of six straight races.

Mission accomplished.

It was 33-1 outsider Soul Strong who took the lead, crossing over from post nine to hit the front into the first turn, with Hambletonian champ Forbidden Trade settling into second spot. Gimpanzee, with David Miller in the bike, sat fourth, while 2-5 favorite Greenshoe settled into sixth.

Just before the half, reached in :56.2, Forbidden Trade took control, as Miller and Gimpanzee, still in fourth, soon took to the outside flow, setting their sights on the leaders.

Ahead by a diminishing half-length at the three-quarters mark, Forbidden Trade was then overtaken by Gimpanzee, who proceeded to open up a 2 ½-length advantage at Ken Middleton's stretch call, timed in 1:25.3.

At the wire, the bay colt bested a late-closing Greenshoe to win by 1 ¾-lengths in 1:52.3. Soul Strong finished third, with Chin Chin Hall grabbing fourth spot.

It wasn't the most ideal path to the winner's circle, admitted Miller.

"I was planning on leaving," said the veteran driver. "I gave him a rough trip but he's so tough."

Melander wasn't concerned about the less-than-ideal weather.

"I don't think it would matter if it was a snowstorm and minus 20," said Melander, whose third entrant, Green Manalishi, finished sixth. "He wouldn't have a problem with it."

Gimpanzee's biggest victory this year before Saturday's score was in the 65th Yonkers Trot in August.

Not only did he deliver his connections top prize in the \$500,000 race, but he also set the track record for 3-year-old colt trotters in the second jewel of the Trotting Triple Crown, stopping the teletimer in 1:53.3.

While he's had to live in the shadow of stablemate Greenshoe this season, Gimpanzee, whose caretaker is Natalie Norlander, had the spotlight all to himself in Milton, ON.

"I mean, Greenshoe has no problem with this weather either, but he just got very far behind and he raced great," said Melander. "He sprinted home fantastic, but it was just Gimpanzee was too far ahead."

"Gimpanzee is a really good horse. He showed that before. A lot of people said he wasn't fast enough or whatever, but he's been racing good all year. Win in the Yonkers Trot, third in the Hambo, third in the Futurity, won Empire Breeders, won the Sires Stakes Final and he's almost over a million dollars now. I'm very happy about him."

So, too, is Strom, who co-owns Greenshoe and owns Green Manalishi.

"To be fair, Gimpanzee has not had so much luck in his post positions all year. Had he had better in the Hambletonian, in

the eliminations (post seven), I think he could've had a shot at winning that day. Now, he showed what he is capable of and obviously I'm happy for Greenshoe. He also did really well."

It's been a genuine thrill ride for Strom to see his trio of trotters all enjoy success.

"That's never going to happen again, for sure, but I'll just enjoy it together again with everyone because Courant, the Melander family – been working with them for five years now – so it's nice to be a part of a big team like that. It's a good group."

And it's a group that's impossible, admitted Melander, to choose a favorite from.

One has the speed, one is easy to drive, and the other has plenty of potential as a 4-year-old.

"They are all great horses," said Melander. "Greenshoe, he's a really fast horse, the fastest of them all. Gimpanzee, he's really a complex horse. He can do whatever you want him to do. He's not grabby. He's perfect to drive. Green Manalishi, he's a big horse and I think he'll be... even after two great seasons over here, I think he will step up even more next year, because he's a big 3-year-old so I think he'll be a really good 4-year-old."

Gimpanzee's season may not be over yet. His connections are mulling their options.

"We haven't decided yet," said Strom. "We will see. Even before this race, he was in such good shape so we were actually looking into what races he has left. He has one or perhaps two races that he could start in, if he takes this race good. If he comes out right. Matron and TVG... those are on the card and then we'll think about it. If we were going to race next year, I would say with a high probability that he's going to continue with Marcus here in the U.S."

Offered Melander, "He will 99 per cent race next year."

Gimpanzee paid \$13.10 for the win.

Dancin Lou steps to victory with large surge to the delight of trainer Camilleri

David C. Kryway and 1362313 Ontario Ltd.'s Dancin Lou, expertly piloted by Andrew McCarthy for up-and-coming trainer Tahnee Camilleri, stormed down the grandstand side to upset Bettors Wish and capture a wet and wild edition of the US\$600,000 Breeders

Crown for sophomore pacing colts and geldings presented by Libfeld Katz at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Bred in Kentucky by Anvil and Lace Farm, Dancing Lou brought \$140,000 at the Lexington Select Sale and he brought racing fans from Down Under to their feet, pacing bravely through a driving rain with a strong wind pushing the field home on a track rated "good."

The Australian duo of McCarthy and Camilleri embraced in an ecstatic winner's circle celebration with the driver collecting his fourth Breeders Crown, while the trainer, who gave up a legal career to condition horses, earned her first.

It was not a glamorous night for the Glamour Boys division as the elements conspired to delay the start of the race on multiple occasions with safety pylons blown across the track. But a hearty field, including the 1-2 finishers of the Pepsi North America Cup in \$1.5 million earner Captain Crunch and \$1.7 million rich Bettors Wish, brought the heat on an otherwise stark night.

Longshot Semi Tough blasted off the gate to assume an early lead with a blinkered Captain Crunch, in rein to Yannick Gingras, settled in second before brushing to the lead through the quarter mile in :26.2.

Bettors Wish left the gate as the 3-5 mutuel favourite in rein to Dexter Dunn, who engineered an aggressive move at the three-eighths pole to challenge for the lead into a stiff headwind as the half-mile ticked by in :55.2

Dancin Lou, patiently handled by McCarthy, watched from fourth as the favorites battled themselves and the elements through the turn. Angled outside for the stretch run, Dancin

Lou quickly found the wheel of Captain Crunch and continued his momentum to a daring finish in the final stride to nip Bettors Wish in a solid time of 1:50.2.

Earlier this month, Dunn had the opportunity to drive both Bettors Wish and Dancin Lou to victories in separate division of the Tattersalls at the Red Mile. And while Dunn guided

both horses to victory in last week's Breeders Crown eliminations, he could only commit to one option on Saturday night, leaving McCarthy a late-blooming option in the year-end classic.

The margin was so tight at the wire, McCarthy couldn't be sure he'd stolen the show.

"I thought I did. I had the momentum on the outside. I was hoping I did," said McCarthy. "I had a little trouble in the last turn getting his momentum going, but then once I got him rolling there, yeah, what a tough horse, he just digs and digs and digs."

The 32-year-old Camilleri was understandably emotional in the winner's circle, having witnessed the successful culmination of hard work and a brave decision to restart her training career after practicing law for five years.

"It's a Cinderella story, I can tell you that," said Camilleri. "This is unbelievable. There were nights when I was laying in

bed wondering if I'd made the right decision, but nights like tonight I know that I have.

"You always wonder doing a big career change like that if it was the right decision and 12 months ago, I think on TVG night, I had a horse in one of the undercard races. I was just happy to get a winner on that night. Twelve months later to come here on one of the biggest nights of the year and to be a competitor was such an honor. And then to win the race, I'm the luckiest girl in the world."

By Sweet Lou, Dancin Lou is out of the modest Cambest dam Dancewiththebest. Following an uneven juvenile campaign in which he won just once, the owners transferred the colt to Camilleri for his sophomore season and were rewarded with outstanding results

"I sold a couple of horses to them last year, when I first came over, and luckily for me they decided to give me a shot," said the hands-on Camilleri, who also took care of caretaking duties on the evening. "It's turned out great. I couldn't believe that it's turned out as good as it did. I'm very lucky."

The owners had to wait for their investment to come good and they were patient on Breeders Crown night as the versatile Dancing Lou, who has won with all manner of trips, closed late to pick up the winner's share of the purse.

"He can come first over, he can peel off for home and he's got gate speed," said Camilleri. "There's no chinks in his armor. He's a fantastic little colt and I love him."

Dancin Lou, who is likely headed to the Progress Pace next at Dover Downs, returned \$12.80 for a \$2 win ticket.

Manchego dominant; wins by more than six lengths in 1:51

When Ron Burke, who trains Atlanta, opted to enter the Maple Leaf Trot runner-up and 2018 Hambletonian winner in the Breeders Crown Open Trot, he made a statement. He literally called double world champion Manchego the best horse currently racing, and opted to send his mare against

males instead in the Mare Trot. Atlanta just happens to be the fastest trotter in Canadian history, courtesy of her 1:50.2 tour of the Woodbine Mohawk Park track on June 15.

#4 Manchego (4, 1:49.0m; \$1,939,355) is the fastest female trotter in international history, on account of a blistering personal best, set in the Allerge Farms on Oct. 6 at Red Mile. The 4-year-old Muscle Hill—Secret Magic (by Cantab Hall) daughter tallied six wins over 14 races this year, building a four-race string of victories on her way to the Breeders Crown. Her front-end wins over four different tracks have come against males and females, highlighting an adventuresome campaign put together by owner Black Horse Racing of Lebanon, NJ, and trainer Nancy Johansson. For race 3 of #Crown19 Saturday, Dexter Dunn was back in the race bike behind the 2018 Hambletonian Oaks star and multiple world record holder.

The 10-mare field had necessitated eliminations on Oct. 19. Manchego had taken hers in 1:52.3 over the winner of the last two Mare Trot finals, Emoticon Hanover (4, 1:50.2f; \$1,828,196).

Returning 2016 divisional Breeders Crown Champion #6 Hannelore Hanover (5, 1:49.2m; \$3,258,261) was back for a swan song, as the Ron Burke-conditioned veteran readied for a future as a broodmare.

With any number of possibilities for how the event would unfold, Manchego and Dunn remained single-minded. Emoticon Hanover and Dube charged to the earliest of leads, with Manchego in hot pursuit and eager to cut the mile. By the opening quarter, Dunn's mare was doing just that--reaching that point in a track-record-matching 26.1,

with Emoticon Hanover settled behind her and Hannelore Hanover taking her chances first up. The remainder of the mile was a trying one for the parked-out Hannelore Hanover, as Manchego controlled the race to the 55.3 half, with the two-time defending Emoticon Hanover pocketed up to the inside in second. By the three-quarter pole, the leader was into what track announcer Ken Middleton termed "another gear", trotting the last fractions in 1:23.4 and a winning 1:51 flat stake record "masterpiece."

Post-race, a mud-spattered Dunn told interviewer Greg Blanchard, "She certainly makes my job easy... The last half of this season, she's just exploded... She won great on Hambo Day. (Then) they gave her a little break, just to freshen up, and now she's won five in a row."

The New Zealand native was understandably thrilled by his first win of the card: "I probably have to pinch myself a little, but really, it's hard to believe... It's been a great ride."

Katie Remmerswaal is caretaker for Manchego, who sold under the name "Whispering Hills" at the 2016 Lexington Select Yearling Sale for a \$120,000 price tag. The half-sister to In Secret (6, 1:52.3f; \$813,657) was bred by Brittany Farms

LLC of Versailles, Kentucky. Secret Magic (3, 1:54.4f; \$198,260) is a Hanover Shoe Farms broodmare out of Chorine Hanover; Manchego is her third, and most accomplished, foal. Secret Magic's 2019 Muscle Hill colt Stilton Hanover is a full brother to the newly-crowned Breeders Crown Mare Trot champ.

Even on the heels of a place finish, Emoticon Hanover's conditioner Luc Blais expressed his gratitude. "I'm happy, I think so, from the 10-hole," said Luc Blais. "Everything turned right, and gave (driver Dan Dube) a chance to be in the race, and turned out very well. The 10-hole, you have to leave a

little bit and see what's going on. That's the driver's plan. After that, he's got the controls."

Seven lengths behind the dominating Manchego at the Crown finish, Determination's mare was ready for the next battle, whatever the post position: "That's a very nice mare. We're going to the TVG, for sure," confirmed Blais.

Joe Bongiorno scores first Crown driving win by piloting American History to victory

When the connections of American History ponied up \$150,000 three years ago at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, they had high expectations for the son of American Ideal—Perfect Touch. Saturday night, the 4-year-old delivered in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown final for open

pacers, scoring the victory for trainer Tony Alagna and driver Joe Bongiorno in a time of 1:48.3. Dorsoduro Hanover raced second with a hard-charging Always A Prince finishing third. Favorite and defending champion McWicked, steered by Brian Sears, paced fourth.

Making only his fifth trip to the winner's circle in 18 seasonal starts, Alagna said the win at Woodbine Mohawk Park was the culmination of a maturation process that has transformed the Brittany Farms-bred product into a horse capable of beating the best.

"Early in the year, even though he wasn't getting the wins, he was third, fourth with the aged horses and he was putting in great miles and pacing huge last halves. Now he's a mature 4-year-old. He's later in the year and he's going with these guys," Alagna said. "He's showed that he's so versatile; he can do it on any size race track and he's just a special animal. He's finally showing everybody he's the horse we thought he was all along."

Bongiorno, one of the sport's young drivers on the rise, has proven a good match for the stallion. Before the gate folded Saturday night, the reinsman called an audible that turned out to be the move of the race. It set the duo up for a stretch drive where they overtook leader Dorsoduro Hanover, driven by Matt Kakaley, and collected a victory for the partnership of Brittney Farms, Marvin Katz, and American History Racing.

"I totally aborted my game plan behind the gate. I looked over to my left and saw that Scott (Zeron) wasn't leaving with Jimmy Freight. I said to myself, 'If I don't go out of there, I have a feeling these Burke horses are going to line up and they are going to walk around there and I'm not getting put in that situation,'" said Bongiorno. "I took a shot out of there and I was able to seat Yannick (Gingras and This Is The Plan),

and I thought I was going to end up being able to stay on the front."

Kakaley moved from third after a :25.4 opening panel to take control, setting fractions of :53.4 and 1:21.3. Bongiorno was happy to sit and take his shot late in the mile with the pacer, cared for by Fiona Reynolds.

"I watched his replay and he was phenomenal last week, so I said, 'He's going to get me to where I have to go and there's a long stretch here.' So, I took my chances," said Bongiorno.

It was a calculated risk, but the late change in strategy paid off handsomely for all connected to American History, as

he became the sport's newest millionaire in victory. The win pushed the four year old's career earnings to \$1,043,895.

"He's got a lot of confidence in the horse," the trainer said of Bongiorno. "A lot of guys wouldn't have done what Joey did. It was the winning move and it worked."

The victory also continued a big weekend for Alagna and Katz. The conditioner picked up two Breeders Crown victories Friday with freshman filly trotter Ramona Hill and 2-year-old pacing filly Reflect With Me. Katz was part of the partnership behind freshman pacing colt final winner Tall Dark Stranger. Victories on one of the sport's grandest stages are not new to Alagna and Katz, but a Breeders Crown triumph is a breakthrough moment for Bongiorno.

"What a thrill. To win a Breeders Crown at my age, you know, it's not even something that I dreamt of, to win a Breeders Crown in the aged pace," said the 26 year old. "It's a thrill and to do it for Tony, it's even that much more special. I'm just so thankful."

The race marked a disappointing finish for McWicked, 2018

American History (Bongiorno) stopped the clock in 1:48.3.

Horse of the Year and defending Open Pace champion. However, after the race trainer Casie Coleman said multiple factors led to the ageless wonder coming up short Saturday in a bid to add a third Breeders Crown trophy.

"He had to leave hard out of the outside post, 25 (seconds) and a piece, and ended up first over again and Brian said that headwind is pretty strong out there. He raced good, that's just a big mile in a big headwind first over into it," she said. "He also hit his tendon tonight, which he's never done before. I don't know why, but that's going to cause him to slow up a little bit too. That's new for him. He doesn't wear any boots and he usually doesn't hit, so I'm not sure why he did that tonight but he did. That's obviously going to falter him a little bit also. Obviously, I'm disappointed he didn't win but with an outside post and the headwind, the conditions, I thought he raced good enough. Now knowing that he hit that ankle, he'd be affected by that a little bit."

Spending her whole career on the New York Sires Stakes circuit, Winndevie had little problem acclimating to the Grand Circuit.

The once-common Breeders Crown pairing of Brian Sears and Trond Smedshammer teamed to land Winndevie in

the winner's circle for the C\$657,895 Breeders Crown Three-Year-Old Filly Trot at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday. The filly just recently exited state-bred competition and even skipped the Hambletonian Oaks.

"She was eligible to the Oaks, but it was right in New York season and I would've missed a couple of legs," Smedshammer said. "Right around that time, she was racing for \$90,000 a leg, so we would give up a lot of money for a check in the Oaks, but right now it's a different story because the other ones are worn out."

With the early-week scratch of Millies Possession due to her

breaking a coffin bone, Winndevie went to the gate the 3-2 favorite despite only finishing third in her elimination. Sears positioned the Joie De Vie Farms-bred Credit Winner filly seventh as Only Take Cash cleared control to a :26.2 first quarter. Hambletonian Oaks winner When Dovescry soon popped pocket to take command but soon yielded to elimination winner The Ice Dutchess before a :56.3 half.

Sears meanwhile floated Winndevie first over nearing the far turn and crept towards the front approaching three-quarters in 1:25.3. From there she dashed with the wind on her back to a three-quarter length score over When Dovescry slipping past The Ice Dutchess as she drifted through the stretch.

"I thought the way she raced last week... it's just usually not nice weather up here at this time of the year," Smedshammer said on having the wind on Winndevie's back. "There's a lot of tired fillies, it seems like. She's fresh and still brave."

When Dovescry meanwhile missed becoming the 10th filly to win the Hambletonian Oaks and the Breeders Crown the same year by less than a length.

"It set up similar to what I thought," said Simon Allard, who drove When Dovescry. "I wish it would have taken a little less out of my mare, the first turn. If I saved a little bit there maybe I could have won. I wasn't put in the spot I wanted to be, I wanted to cut it. She is so much better on the front end than in the two hole. It just didn't work the way I really wanted. Second is still good, I guess. I'm happy, but we always want to win."

Collecting her 12th win from 21 starts, Winndevie – cared for by groom Katie Graham – has now banked \$867,529 for Wanda Polissen's Purple Haze Stable LLC, for which

Smedshammer has trained for over a decade.

"I'm so sorry she wasn't here," Smedshammer said. "There's no better owner."

From here Winndevie will compete once more against Grand Circuit company when she ships to Dover Downs from the Matron Stakes. After that, Smedshammer said he'll either send her to the breeding shed or ready her for a 4-year-old campaign.

Caviart Ally takes down Shartin for Chaffees and Pelling

It was already setting up for an evening of randomness: As the rain began, race 1 saw a narrow photo finish decided in favor of #10 Classic Pro (Bob McClure), at odds of 67-1. A racing surface rated "fast" and a prohibitive favorite leaving from the inside post would put

the handicappers' world back on its axis of normalcy in race 2. Maybe. Maybe not.

A victory lap for the presumptive 2019 Horse of the Year, or a chance for others to set her Crown askew? These were the questions going into the \$393,000 Breeders Crown Open Mare Pace, as #1 Shartin N (p, 6, 1:56.4m; \$2,067,957) looked to build upon a 14-win season against her toughest divisional competition. The Tintin In America—Bagdarin (by Live Or Die) mare displayed rare hints of late-season vulnerability, such as being scratched sick from the Sept. 21 Milton Stake at Woodbine Mohawk Park, and giving way to Caviart Ally in the Oct. 7 Allerage Farms Filly and Mare Pace at Red Mile. Teamed up with regular reinsman Tim Tetrick, Richard Poillucci, Joann Looney King, and Tim Tetrick LLC's, the reigning Dan Patch Pacing Mare of the Year had a 2018 Breeders Crown title to defend. But capturing this year's edition would seemingly secure the Jim King Jr.-conditioned import's bid to become the first-ever older pacing mare to be voted Dan Patch Horse of the Year. She had, after all, become the sport's fastest distaff pacer and co-fourth-fastest pacer ever in the Lady Liberty on Hambletonian Day.

#3 Caviart Ally (p, 5, 1:48.0m; \$1,672,633) looked most likely to topple the queen in the final, which had required no eliminations. Owned by Caviart Farms of Vienna, VA, the Bettors Delight—Allamerican Cool (by No Nukes) daughter finished second in her previous matchup with Shartin N — an Oct. 18 qualifier at The Meadowlands, clocked in 1:51.2 — but she had handed the champion an unexpected defeat in the Allerage. Driver Andy McCarthy enjoyed two double-digit upsets in Friday night's 2-year-old Breeders Crown finals, handling 15-1 Ramona Hill (Two-Year-Old Filly Trot) and

27-1 Reflect With Me (Two-Year-Old Filly Pace) for back-to-back victories for trainer Tony Alagna. Caviart Ally, a Brett Pelling trainee, was the most logical choice to succeed Shartin N, if the latter was not at her best, or if randomness entered into the equation.

Despite the sparse field of seven, this final was no two-mare grudge match, nor an exhibition race for the mighty Shartin N. #4 Youaremycandygirl (p, 3, 1:48.2m; \$1,159,677) who was a Two-Year-Old Breeders Crown Filly Pace champion recorded three seasonal victories in 13 starts prior to the Oct. 26 divisional showdown, and prepped for Saturday with an unusual tightener Oct. 19. The 4-year-old American Ideal—Sweet Lady Jane (by Somebeachsomewhere) daughter was a competitive show finisher in the Woodbine Mohawk Park Preferred, timed in 1:50.2 and beaten only by Breeders Crown Open Pace combatants Jimmy Freight (second) and Dorsoduro Hanover (first). Racing for owner William Donovan of Delray Beach, Florida; trainer Richard Moreau, and driver Louis-Philippe Roy, Youaremycandygirl

loomed a dark horse threat in the Open Mare Pace.

Race 2 delivered on the stellar credentials of its top pair, but not as the win pool predicted. #7 Kissin In The Sand (Yannick Gingras) blasted from the outer post to clear Shartin N into the first turn, but Tetricks charge had little patience for the pocket and looped to make front by the 25.5 first quarter. The leaders were tracked single-file by #2 Kendall Seelster (Jody Jamieson) and a fourth-place Caviart Ally as a confident Shartin N led the way to the 55 flat half. McCarthy sent his mare first over to challenge, drawing alongside the #1 at the three-quarters, reached in 1:22.3. The battle of the incumbent Crown queen and the rising heir apparent developed through the stretch drive, in which Caviart Ally looked Shartin N in the eye and then established a two-length victory margin by the wire. The 1:49.3 win represented a 5-2 win at the windows, but something much more for breeder Hanover Shoe Farms and owners Buck and Judy Chaffee of Caviart Farms.

Buck Chaffee said that his distaff pacing star missed the

first Breeders Crown to which she was eligible, at age two. "Not the first year, and we kick ourselves for not (entering), because we didn't think she was quite ready that year. Then, the winner of the Breeders Crown beat us by a nose in the Kindergarten final the week after. That made us think, 'Why didn't we do it?'" In 2019, Caviart Ally's evolution has been undeniable, confirmed her elated owner: "She's been second twice, and (she's) been a different horse. Shartin last year, and Blazing Britches the year before are both really good mares, and she was really competitive, but this is the first time that she got the best of them (in the Breeders Crown final)."

Judy Chaffee added that both her own mare and Shartin N turned in extremely game performances. "They are both terrific, and you can't fault either of them. Last year, Ally had the 9- or 10-hole; she was on the outside and she only lost by, I think, half a length. It was so close."

Conditioner Pelling, who last won a Breeders Crown in 2005 before retiring, said he is already savoring 2020 as part of his return to the upper echelons of the sport. "I'll get to bring (Papi Rob Hanover) and Caviart Ally to the Breeders Crown next year, so I've already got two Breeders Crown horses for next year."

He said it has taken more than he would have liked to re-establish himself.

"I've said to some people, the business has shrunk a little bit. A lot of the owners I had before are in partnerships, plus there's only 'x' amount of really strong buying stables out there," Pelling said.

He wasn't sure whether his latest win as a trainer represented a personal comeback milestone, but there's no doubt that he's back.

Record set for Indiana-bred yearlings sold at auction

Two \$175,000 yearlings set the record for highest-priced Indiana-bred yearlings sold at auction, but the Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale was down 7.3 per cent from 2018.

The second session of the Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale saw another record-setting day for well-bred babies and siblings to top performers, but the overall business decreased by just over 10 per cent when measured against 2018 totals. A total of 172 young horses entered the ring, hammered down for a gross of \$2.86 million and average of \$16,634. By contrast, 170 babies grossed \$3.15 million in last year's Saturday session, producing an \$18,529 average.



Over the course of the two days, 358 yearlings were sold for a gross of \$6.45 million, signaling an average of \$18,028, an overall decline of 7.3 per cent. Last year the two-day event registered sales of \$6.88 million for a group of 354 trotters and pacers. The highlight of the session, and the sale, came when a pair of trotters fetched final bids of \$175,000.

Bluebird Spirit was the first of the pair to achieve the new high-water mark for an Indiana-sired yearling at auction. Cataloged as Hip 251 from the Bluebird Meadows consignment, the Swan For All colt is the first foal from \$250,000 winner Goosebump Hanover. The dam is a half-sister to Hambletonian winner and millionaire Perfect Spirit. Bidding was indeed spirited before the gavel fell, with Bo DeLong signing the ticket.

DeLong and his son, Pat, are traditionally very active at the Hoosier Classic sale, however, this year they purchased fewer yearlings and spent more on those they acquired. Combined with Friday's \$100,000 session co-topper, DeLong purchased five yearlings totaling \$371,000.

Freshman TJ's Top Pick capped a nearly perfect campaign

with an Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final victory for owners Tom Pollack and Jeff Cullipher just a few weeks ago. With the success of the trotter, it was expected that his full sister, Meadowbrook Jane, would command attention. The second foal from Broadway Hall mare J As Ayd matched the new record as Hip 278, purchased by Pollack. Meadowbrook Farm consigned the filly.

Over the course of the two days, Pollack reloaded on Indiana-sired yearlings with seven purchases. He paid \$449,000 for the trio of trotters and four pacers.

Swan For All was the strongest seller after Friday's session, and Saturday only bolstered his numbers. The top four yearlings sold Saturday were sired by the son of Andover Hall. The collection of 41 babies brought \$1.33 million in gross sales over both days and averaged \$32,439. Of the group, 22 fillies averaged \$31,023 and the colts averaged \$34,079.

The top-selling pacer Saturday was the Rockin Image colt Rockin Fire. An agent yearling consigned by Jeff Jones, the bay is out of Well Said mare Black Diamonds, a sister to

Diamond Stick Pin p, 2, 1:54.4f, 3, 1:53f, 1:49.3f -'13 (\$557,102), I Said Diamonds p, 2, 1:52.3f, 3, 1:50f -'16 (\$480,382) and Bet The Ranch p, 2, 1:57.1h, 3, 1:54s, 1:51.1s -'10 (\$352,877). Brian Brown signed the slip.

Rockin Image also had a pair of \$50,000 fillies in Luckiana Farm's offering Sparkling Dawn (Hip 297) and Sassy Q (Hip 326), consigned by In Law Stable. The sire finished the sale with 64 yearlings averaging \$22,930. Colts brought a higher average as 38 registered an average of \$25,526 while 26 fillies averaged \$19,135.

The first crop of double millionaire JK Endofanera also had a strong showing over both days. FR Lucky Striker, part of the Homestead Acres consignment, garnered a \$47,000 final bid Saturday to lead the pacer's progeny. The first foal from a Camluck mare that is a sister to three \$300,000-plus winners, the colt was one of Pollack's day-two purchases.

Dutch success in \$124,000 Breeders Course

The \$124,000 Breeders Course final for 2-year-olds was held at Jägersro racetrack in Sweden on Saturday afternoon and when the mile was finished, a Dutch owned and trained trotter collected the trophy.

Robin Bakker drove Kuyt F.Boko (Conway Hall) for trainer Paul Hagoort and he placed his horse in the pocket behind leader A Good Point, who was in pole position when the field turned into the last turn since first choice Pucks Bounce had ran the whole race without cover first over. Erik Adielsson and Pucks Bounce seemed to have control of the leader with the stretch to go.

At that time, Kuyt F.Boko had found his spot to make a quick last 200 meters and while Pucks Bounce got a grip of the race, Robin Bakker used Kuyt F.Boko's speed just enough to be first at the wire.

The time for both winner Kuyt F.Boko and runner up Pucks Bounce was 1:58.2.

"I was a little bit worried about post one behind the gate,

but we got a great trip behind a good horse. At the same time, we had the favorite on the outside and when we came out of the last turn, it felt like Erik Adielsson just waited to make his move. His horse got a couple of meters advance of us, but we finally could win. Both Erik and I agreed that this was two very good 2-year-olds", said Robin Bakker after the big victory.

On the same race card, the \$82,500 C.L.Müllers Memorial was held over 1.6 miles for the established elite and an interesting comeback was made by Jerry Riordan's champion Ringostarr Treb (Classic Photo). From post eight behind the gate, driver Wim Paal put in the turbo gear from start and Ringostarr Treb hit the lead, in heavy fight against Racing Mange, after a little less than a half mile and the first quarter went fast, 26.4. Two kilometers remained of the race at that moment and Wim Paal couldn't get involved in another fight for keeping the lead when Rajesh Face attacked three wide in hunt for the front position with less than a mile to go.

With Rajesh Face in front, big upset Velvet Gio (Nad Al Sheba) and driver Ulf Ohlsson had to try their best from a position outside the leader and with a quarter of a mile to the wire, none of the opponents seemed especially tough after the hard pace in the beginning of the race and Velvet Gio easily disarmed Rajesh Face and cruised to safe win in mile rate 1:56.2.

Here's a proposal to increase the competitiveness of elimination races. The idea is ONLY the race winner is guaranteed entry into the final. Please publish for feedback. Horses not drawn in their respective draw do not enter the final, nor do they become eligible for any other draw. Thus the incentive is to finish first as no finisher, other than first place, is guaranteed a start in the final.

Change the pylon rule

There is a rule, that in my opinion, should be changed. A horse that is on the lead that goes inside any number of pylons, as long as the horse and sulky are back on the track at the wire, should not be DQed. Since it is a straight away, there is no advantage gained! A

perfect example was the egregious decision to DQ Six Pack on an extremely windy night when he had an eight-length lead.

There is a rule that horses in the outer lane must go forward. Recently, more and more, especially at The Big M, I notice horses leaving and hoping to find holes, but when they don't find one, they just sit and wait for cover, while keeping the horse inside of them to be locked in (usually being backed up to last), giving that horse almost no chance in the race. Any driver that doesn't move forward should be fined with suspensions for repeated occurrences. Also, their horse should be DQed and placed last.
