Dunn smashes Breeders Crown dash and earnings records with six victories, \$2 million weekend

Meanwhile, Ron Burke passes Jimmy Takter as the leading money-winning trainer in Crown history.

Dexter Dunn won the final three Breeders Crown races on Saturday's (Oct. 26) card at The Meadowlands to become the first driver to be victorious in six Crowns in a single year in the 41-year history of the series.

Dunn surpassed the previous record of five Crown wins set by David Miller on a single night at Woodbine Racetrack in 2015 and Dunn also became the first driver to exceed \$2 million in purse earnings in a single Breeders Crown year.

"It's been a great weekend, but I came into the weekend with a lot of good drives and had some good draws to work with, too," Dunn said. "The trainers had them ready to go and they performed on the night."

"It's 'pinch yourself' stuff, really. The horses I've been driving, they are great horses and it makes my job easy. The Breeders Crown is never easy to win. They are tough races. We got lucky and got good trips with a couple. I don't know what to say, really, the horses just did all the hard work."


Dunn also became the fastest driver to record 20 Crown victories. He ended the night by driving his own **Twin B Joe Fresh** to a dominant win in the Mare Pace to record his 21st lifetime Crown win in just over six years since coming the United States from New Zealand.

"I was hoping to win one stakes race when I came over," Dunn said, laughing. "That was my aim, to win one stakes race. You

never think this will happen, but I've been lucky to have great support from [Chris Ryder], Nifty Norman, Tony Alagna put me on early and gave me a shot... when they probably could have got more experienced drivers, but they believed in me and that got me rolling. I've been really lucky that way."

Dunn won Crowns with **Miki And Minnie** (2YOFP) and **Maryland** (2YOCT) on Friday and **My Girl EJ** (3YOFP), **Winner's Bet** (Open Pace), **Mirage Hanover** (3YOCP) and likely sealed the Horse of the Year title for his own Twin B Joe Fresh, whom he shares with her trainer Ryder, Peter Trebotica and Barry Spak.

"It's probably the most excited I've ever been winning a race tonight, with her," Dunn said. "It's been a dream ride with her. That was just a massive thrill tonight when I won with her.

"I just have faith in the horse and you've just got to go in with confidence. Tonight, she felt great... Going to the gait, she was up on her tippy-toes and that was a good sign. I was pretty happy when she was ready to roll."

Prior to this year, 31 Breeders Crown winners have been voted Horse of the Year in 40 years (an impressive 77.5 per cent).

Meanwhile, when T C I finished second in the sophomore trotting colt final, trainer Ron Burke surpassed Jimmy Takter to be the leading trainer, by earnings, in Breeders Crown history. On Friday, Burke cashed six checks for a total of \$696,500. He cashed five more checks worth \$639,520, total, on Saturday for a \$1,336,020 weekend.

Burke now has \$14,381,400 in all-time Crown earnings, just ahead of Takter's \$14,245,211.

Takter still leads with 34 trophies from 28 champions, but Burke is second with 22 trophies from 17 champions.

"Backing into it [by finishing second by a nose with T C I] wasn't really the way I wanted to do it, but obviously it's nice," Burke said.

Burke Racing also extended its lead as the leading owners by earnings in Crown history.

"My mom and dad are the leading owners of all time and that's incredible when you think about all the owners. Now, to be the leading trainer... that's a neat thing. I never even knew that I was close with that. I knew that I was second to Jimmy in wins, but I didn't know I was anywhere near in money, so that's nice."

As for how many Crown winners will end up with divisional titles, that's too difficult to assess just yet. But, prior to this year, 267 Crown winners have been voted divisional champion out of 466 horses (57 per cent), including the last three – Test Of Faith (2021), Bulldog Hanover (2022) and Confederate (2023).

WINNING BREEDERS

Over 12 Breeders Crown races, 10 different breeders were victorious this weekend, including four homebreds. Only Hanover Shoe Farms (Maryland and Mirage Hanover) and the team of Burke Racing Stable and Weaver Brusceci et al (Louprint and My Girl EJ) doubled up.

Hanover Shoe Farms extended its lead in the breeder standings. The famed farm now has 29 Crown champions that have won 33 trophies. Hanover also extended its lead in the all-time Crown money list for breeders, with nearly \$22 million. Brittany, which bred Twin B Joe Fresh, is second in Crown champions (23), total Crown trophies (31) and money (nearly \$13 million).

Also scoring his first career Breeders Crown triumph was Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. who won the 2-Year-Old Colt Pace with Louprint on Friday.

TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

with MURRAY BROWN

How did May Dodge do at Harrisburg in 2021?

On Nov. 7, 2021, [this column](#) dealt with the female descendants of the mare May Dodge which were selling at that year's Harrisburg sale. I thought it might be of interest to go back to that column and see in retrospect how one might have fared if my advice had been taken and someone had bought all of them. Of course, the amounts paid do not represent a true number, since it would have required at least another bid to secure each of those fillies. But we are speaking in imaginary terms anyhow, so we will go with the actual prices that each of those fillies brought.

One would be tempted to ask how one might have fared? In just a couple of words, I would say extremely well.

There were 20 fillies listed. One had died, so that left us with 19. There was another that for some unknown reason was on the list that didn't belong. She was of all things a trotting filly. So, our venture began with 18 fillies.

The total expenditure for the purchase of those fillies was \$914,000.

To date they have earned, now get this, \$4,177,641.

I understand that it costs money to train horses today, so let us for the sake of expediency put a number of \$100,000 per filly over the almost three years to cover training costs. Obviously, the expenses for some will be well over that amount. Others were lightly trained and probably didn't come close to racking up that amount in bills. There are actually three of them who had yearlings in this year's select sales. One might assume that they either were not trained at all or were only trained for a short period of time.

Using these numbers, as imprecise as they may be, leaves us with a profit of over two and a quarter million and we still own all the fillies. We are also well on our way to having the makings of a wondrous band of broodmares, cost free.

Of course, a naysayer might say that the numbers are inordinately weighted down because of the presence of two of the greatest pacing fillies of the modern era in Twin B Joe Fresh and Sylvia Hanover. My response would be that those two fillies are a major reason why we are involved with the entire herd. By concentrating on the descendants of May Dodge, we are seeking

excellence. The fact that it was achieved is far from accidental. I'll go to what one of the foremost students of pedigrees and racing, Myron Bell has more than once said to me: "When I buy a filly, I look at the venture as being entirely one of buying a broodmare that will further the breed. If she races fine. If she does well, even better. That's a great bonus. But my bottom line is that I am buying a future broodmare."

Brian Paquet's memory kept alive through his beloved, eponymous trotter

They may be polar opposites in personality, but the late Brian Paquet and the tenacious trotter named in his honor share a penchant for leaving a lasting impression.

Jody Jamieson, one of standardbred racing's most successful stars in the sulky, laughs when asked about the rookie colt's spirited, somewhat untamed disposition.

"I'll tell you what, I liked him better in his first couple starts as a pro," said the veteran reinsman, who has been in the race bike for each of Paquet's seven lifetime starts.

"He's getting a little racy. We've been trying to temper that, at least earlier in the race anyway. That's been a big part of his development."

Paquet, the horseman, a highly-respected and admired figure in horse racing circles, never got the chance to see his equine namesake compete.

But he'd no doubt be thrilled with the rambunctious 3-year-old's top-shelf talents.

"He is just so effortless in his gait," said Jamieson.

"That goes a long way in making him as good as he is. And being a Muscle Mass, he has the pedigree to go along with it."

Brian Paquet, who died in August 2023, saw something special in the bay who was purchased for \$70,000 at the 2022 London Classic Yearling Sale.

"We got a truck to go to the sale a couple years ago – myself, my buddy [trainer] Paul Cameron, my dad [trainer, Carl Jamieson], and Brian Paquet," Jody said. "We met Brian at the carpool in Guelph and headed up there, and they bought that horse. On the way back, we stopped for something to eat, and Brian said, 'I want a piece of that horse. I really like him.'"

At that time, the son of Muscle Mass—Darjeeling entered the sales ring as Hip #60, Dion Seelster.

However, in the wake of Brian's death, it was evident that a name change was in order.

"Brian was just such a great guy," Jody said. "He's had a horse or at least a piece of a horse with my dad for about 20 years. He was such a gentleman. Anybody that you talked to from Quebec, it always seemed like Brian Paquet had a hand in their career."

Although their time together was short, the Quebec-born horseman knew that his team had something special with the spirited Paquet.

Prior to suffering a tendon injury in February of his 2-year-old year, the young Paquet had shown significant promise across his several workouts.

That was not lost on Brian, who according to Jody, preached patience during trying times.

When Paquet finally made his professional debut this past March as a 3-year-old, the long-time owner and breeder's prudent perspective proved invaluable for the Jamiesons and Co., who were saddled with another seemingly insurmountable obstacle when their neophyte racehorse endured another significant injury after his first ever start – a 10¼-length triumph on March 21 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Fortunately, with the help of trainer Rod Hughes, the rehab process went off without a hitch and Paquet was ready to return to the oval.

"I think the rehab that we put him through was second to none," Jody said. "We're really happy with Rod Hughes and the work he did at R&R Farms. He was integral in bringing him back."

"The process developed relatively quickly. We knew we had something special and wanted to give him a chance to race for some good money in big races."

Despite being “as bad as he's ever been” that night, Jody was effusive in his praise for Paquet, the horse, and the person who foresaw this day before anyone else.

“Brian was willing to wait with the rest of the partners and now the rest is history,” Jody said. “It does mean a lot to me, and a lot to everybody that knew Brian, that this horse is having success carrying the Paquet name around.

“I don't know if Brian's ever won a Super Final – I think he must have years ago – but I know how much he would have loved being there because that was the only reason he bought Ontario-breds, to win Super Finals.

“We love the horse, don't get me wrong. But Brian himself, he was a true gentleman, class act all the way through, and now his daughters, Jennifer and Jessica, and his wife, France, are still in on this horse and they're enjoying the success as we go.”

Across seven starts this season, Paquet owns an impressive 4-1-1 line and has banked \$315,265 (as of Oct. 25).

As for what lies ahead in the short-term, Jody said the plan is to enter Paquet in next Friday's Carl Erskine at Hoosier Park in Anderson, IN.

Until then, the Jamiesons remain intent on uncovering the source of Paquet's angst, which they believe is rooted in his mouth and teeth.

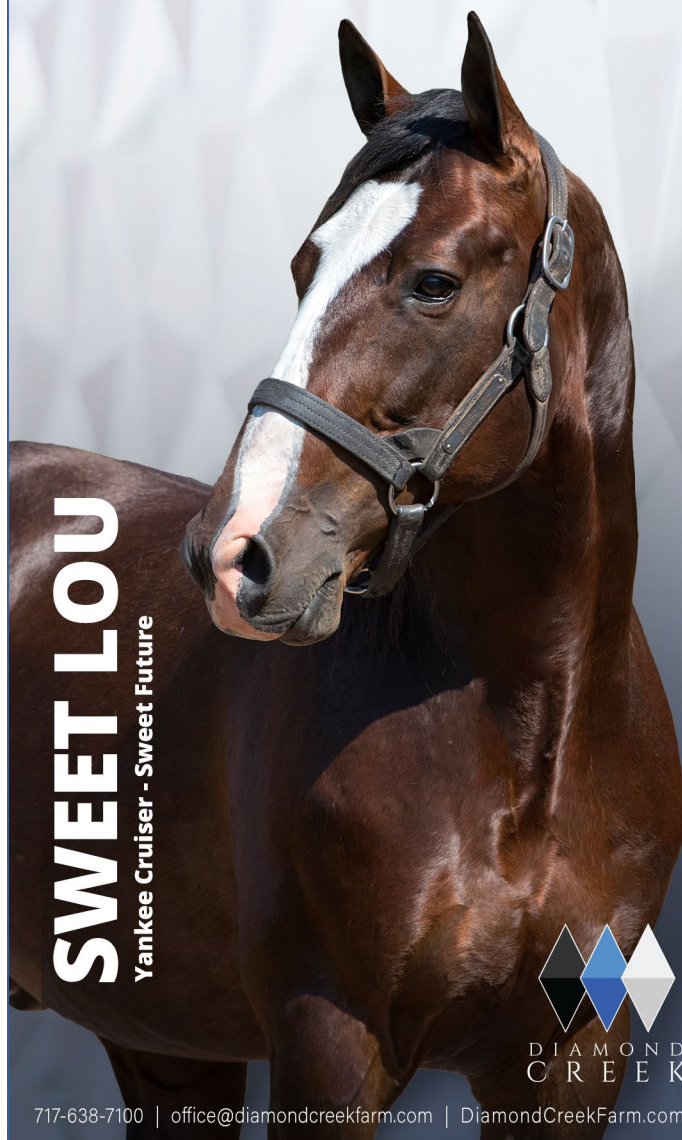

"My dad's been really working with his mouth and trying to figure out what's going on there," Jody said. "Every time he goes on the track, even jogging, he was starting to get that way, where he was acting up, rooting, and something in his mouth was bothering him.

"We're going to school him. Hopefully, he's going to be a little bit better and not as mad when you put the bit in his mouth."

Clearly not lacking in ability, Paquet, like any young athlete recovering from a string of injuries, had to fast-track his learning curve to compete with more experienced contemporaries.

While that undoubtedly led to more bumps along the way, Jody, who's won more than 8,700 races over his storied career, knows Paquet possesses the potential to accomplish extraordinary things - one of which happens to be a lifelong dream of Jody's.

"I'd love to be able to take this horse to Europe," he said of Paquet, who trotted 1:52.2 in his third career start.

"I've always dreamt of a European campaign with a top trotter. He still needs to learn a lot. He's got a lot of experience that he needs to go through, maybe that's a couple years away. But I think it'd be really cool. I think the ceiling would be some sort of European tour with him."

Jody pointed to the example of Jess Tubbs and Greg Sugars, the Australian wife and husband, trainer/driver duo who found incredible success with Just Believe and earned their way to the Elitloppet in Sweden.

"I think it would be an amazing experience," said Jody, who has raced in Europe a few times, including in an Elitloppet elimination event.

But not only for himself.

Jody would relish the chance to represent a horseman and friend he still holds in the highest esteem.

"If I'm talking about the European tour being the ceiling, that's obviously a heck of a career because you have to get invited over there," Jody said.

Should that become a reality, Jody will have plenty of stories to bring along, including those of the man who believed in his beloved trotter from day one.

"He'd be pretty well thought of if someone were to invite us there," Jody said.

Whether he was speaking of the horse, horseman, or perhaps both, Jody could not have said it any better.

Liza Josselyn a winner again

Jean-Michel Bazire sat behind his – or to be correct – his son Nicolas’ **Liza Josselyn** (Ready Cash) in the \$125,000 Prix Uranie for 3-year-old fillies at Vincennes on Friday (Oct. 25) night. And the well-bred trotter showed that she is near the top of the French L-crop.

Jean-Michel had a cool start with Liza Josselyn and from a position far back in the field, the three-wide attack was set in with a half-mile to go. Liza Josselyn disarmed the leader 300 meters later and when Jean-Michel asked for a little bit more, she flew away from her opponents and hit the wire in a strong mile rate of 1:53.4 over 1.3 miles, which was totally outstanding.

In the \$125,000 Prix Victor Regis for 3-year-old colts, **Lombok Jiel** (Enino du Pommereux) continued to prove that he is one of the best 3-year-old horses. Lombok Jiel finished second to Lovino Bello in the Criterium des 3 ans earlier this fall, but he has collected some prestigious trophies in Paris already before Friday’s race. Lombok Jiel won in 1:58.3 over 1.3 miles.

Vincennes is getting prepared for another winter meeting. The Paris track opens the gates on Oct. 31 and the meeting ends on March 1 2025. In between, there will be some 715 races, distributed on 72 cards with approximately \$45,000,000 in total purses offered.

November 17 is the first date for a qualification race ahead of Prix d’Amérique and news about the four “B-races” is that the top four horses in each event will get a ticket to the Prix d’Amérique. Previous years have offered the three best horses in the B-races a spot in the big Grand Prix.

Horsy Dream, winner of Elitloppet and the Åby World Grand Prix this season, risks to miss the meeting in Paris due to problems with a hind leg.

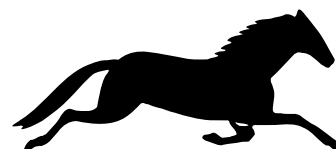

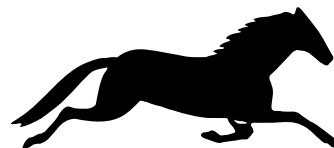

Jessica Roegner's enjoying her win in the Jugette with Soft Shot

Jessica Roegner is the trainer of Soft Shot, the winner of the 2024 Jugette.

Horsepeople dream of one day winning one of the top major races in the sport of harness racing with their standardbred, such as the Adios, Breeders Crown, Hambletonian, or Little Brown Jug.

The Little Brown Jug is part of the Triple Crown of harness racing; the premier pacing classic for 3-year-old pacers that provides a fascinating chapter in the more than a century-old history.

In 1956, the Jug provided the anchor for the Triple Crown of pacing to go along with the Cane Pace at Yonkers Raceway in New York and the Messenger Stake held at that time at Roosevelt Raceway in Westbury, NY.

The first LBJ was contested in 1946 – the purse was \$35,358 – drawing fans from Canada, Florida, New Jersey, California and

from everywhere in between. That was the first of decades to continue, drawing the best of the best four-legged athletes. The grandstand was packed with fans coming from all walks of live.

The winner of the first Jug was Ensign Hanover with Delaware's Wayne "Curly" Smart in the sulky. But it took four grueling heats to determine the first Jug winner, with two colts and one filly competing in the final showdown.

From its humble beginnings, the Jug grew to become one of the most prestigious stakes on the pacing gait.

And what was good for the goose became good for the gander, when in 1971 the very first Jugette – for 3-year-old pacing fillies – was raced over the half-mile track in Delaware, OH, with Jefferson Time driven by Ben Webster crossing the finish line first in 2:00.1.

Throughout the years the finest drivers such as Bill O’Donnell, Stanley Dancer, William Herman, Billy Haughton, Glen Garnsey, John Campbell, Ron Waples, David Miller, and others graced the track at the Delaware County Fairgrounds to participate in one of harness racing’s greatest races.

This year, in 2024, the Little Brown Jug was won by Captain Albano and Jugette was won by Jessica Roegner’s filly Soft Shot.

“I was born and raised in Michigan but now reside in Ohio,” Roegner said. “My introduction in the business was from my mother Judy Roegner who was very good friends with the niece of one of the best – if not the best – horsewomen ever, Bea Farber.

“After my mother graduated from high school Bea gave mom her first standardbred to train. At that time, my mother worked for a couple of different trainers.”

Jessica always loved horses and showed them until she turned 13, deciding then to sell her show horses and try to earn money at what she loved to do the best.

“I bought a racehorse called Priority Mike – who was my priority – and have owned standardbreds since,” she said. “Today, I, along with my husband, train 18 horses that are stabled at Sahbra Farms in Streetsboro, OH. I mainly buy or claim horses but do own one broodmare named Crazy About NY.”

Jessica’s owner bought Soft Shot from OnGait for \$30,000 with the intention of having a nice racehorse. “After qualifying, she won eight-in-a-row, starting in the NW 2 working her way through to the open,” Jessica said. “She is not very big, but she doesn’t know it.

“I’d say my favorite horse in the barn is my homebred Forky who I have bred and raised. He is a nice horse and quite a character.

Unfortunately, he got hurt and is rehabilitating.”

Then there’s JC Onthebeach who retired from Jessica last year.

“When it came time that he would have to race in a claimer to be competitive I retired him where he now lives his days as a trail riding horse,” she said. “I try to do the right thing when one of my horses reach the point that he needs to retire from racing. I try to find them good homes and, yes, I’d have more money if I sold them, but I believe it brings good karma when I do the best thing for the horse, and it’s not always about money.”

Jessica said winning the Jugette was a dream come true.

“There are no words to say how it feels; it’s a magical feeling where lots of happy tears were shed,” she said. “We went into the race hoping to make the final and to win it was surreal, incredible and unbelievable.

“It was all such a shock. After winning the elimination came the worry on how to take the proper care in between heats. Do I walk her? Do I let her rest? But it all worked out for she won.

“I am very grateful that Soft Shot’s owners Paul and Patti O’Neal decided to take a chance with our little, but mighty filly.”

Jessica said the female that she admires most in the sport is definitely her mother.

“She’s self-made and has fought tooth and nail to be the horsewoman she is,” Jessica said. “Sadly, she doesn’t get enough credit. She does it all on her own - train, jog, ship and at times even shod herself. My mother is a great role model besides being a great mother.

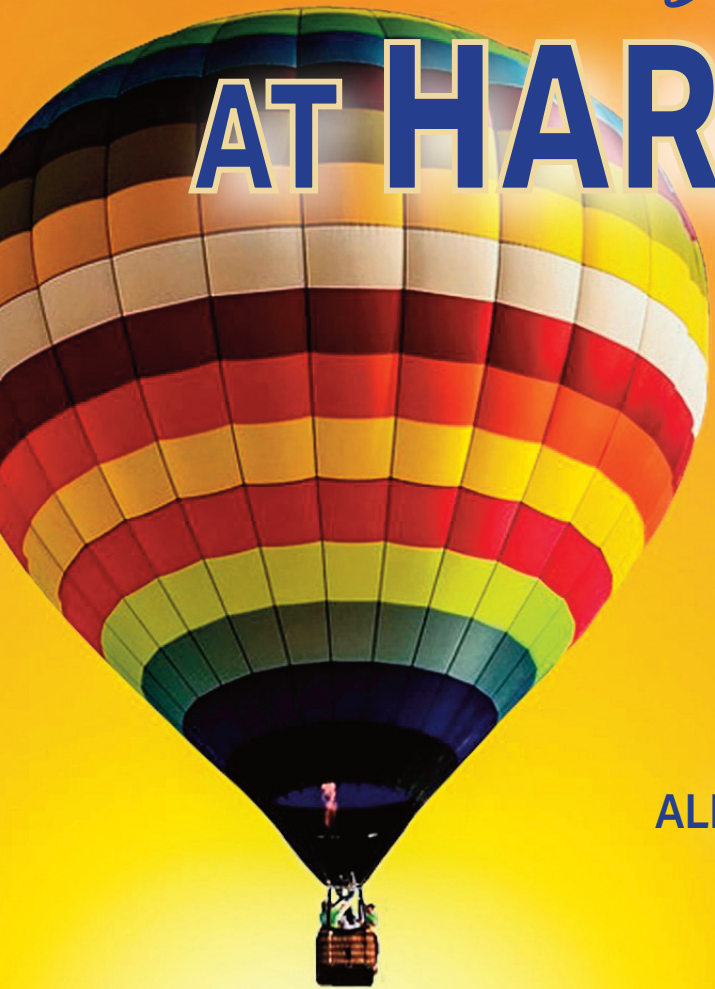

Mother Country

The current political unrest has many of us nervous about the looming elections. Emotions blind everyone, and positions are entrenched. Quiet, thoughtful reasoning and discussion are in the caboose, while emotional clickbait drives the unsuspecting passengers. For those who bothered to read the previous two sentences, you are probably wondering - is this writer a friend or a foe? Is he in my tribe? Is he a REAL American?

This column is not a place for politics. Instead, I would like to reflect on two conversations and offer a song that might calm our troubled waters for a few moments.

Earlier this summer, by accident and fate, I was introduced to a fellow who is a relatively big player in harness horse racing. This man is active in many facets of the sport and has owned countless horses. To my astonishment, despite using pseudonyms for much of my scribbling, he knew my real identity. More astonishing, he began our chat by nodding towards me and saying, "John Stewart."

John Stewart was a singer/songwriter with a small yet passionate following. I have most of his five hundred songs on cassettes, CDs, and digital files. I attended his shows each time he played within a few hundred miles of my home. Through the years, in my writing, I would look for opportunities to insert a nugget with his name or his music into various columns and stories. At some point, my new harness racing acquaintance followed the trail of crumbs and picked up the Stewart bug.

The odds of finding a kindred musical spirit on a racetrack apron must equal my owning the Hambletonian winner.

Although we were at the racetrack, with trotters racing, music was our chosen conversation subject. I specifically recall my new friend mentioning a song titled Mother Country.

His mention of this song title reminded me of another conversation about 15 years ago in a small club where John Stewart performed. Between sets, Stewart put down his guitar and sat across from me. As often happens with strangers, he asked about my interests. I replied. "Harness horse racing."

His squinty eyes widened, and he became energized. Then he said, "My father was a harness horse trainer! We lived in California and made the circuit of racetracks. I grew up on the backstretch. My father was hard on me, and the boys on the backstretch cared for me. I wrote some of my early songs using the rhythmic clapping of hooves on the racetrack for the beat. I'll never forget those days, those horses, those people, those sounds and smells."

Although this column is a politics-free zone, let me offer a tidbit known to Stewart fans. As a young musical man on the move, one of his early and formative gigs was as the opening musician for Robert F. Kennedy. Stewart and Buffy Ford would warm up the crowds by performing on the campaign trail across America, often at train stops. Many of his songs describe the hope and joy of those days, dreamy days that ended with an assassin's bullet on the floor in a hotel.

Returning to our little sport, the "Lonesome Picker" died in 2008. [Here is a link](#) from the year before - he sings solo in a small club. The song in the video clip is Mother County. The people in the song are harness horsemen from his youth. His love of America is evident. Many of you will relate to the old campaigner circling the racetrack.

Call Me Goo supplements and scores stakes record in

Breeders Crown Mare Trot

Trainer Ake Svanstedt has been making a habit of capturing the Breeders Crown Mare Trot. And on Saturday (Oct. 26), his good fortune continued as his two supplemental entries **Call Me Goo** and Nelsonbriteagle NO finished one-two in the \$496,000 event at The Meadowlands, with Svanstedt guiding Call Me Goo to a stakes-record 1:50.4 mile.

"Well, I kind of said to Ake, 'We have two great fillies and they can't race' so we talked to the owner about the situation and they were like 'Let's gamble a little bit,'" said Sarah Svanstedt, Ake's wife and stable partner. "It's an expensive excitement, but obviously it's two great horses so they have a chance to win. So, that's why we took a chance."

Action was hot and heavy at the start with Pioneer As and Tim Tetrick sweeping around trotters from post 9 to gain control before the quarter. Ake left with Call Me Goo and remained parked through the opening bend, making M-M's Dream and David Miller race three wide for much of the opening bend. Past the :27.4 opening quarter, Call Me Goo took control of the

race and never looked back with Ake not letting M-M's Dream pass at any point.

Call Me Goo was safely on top through a :55 first half, with a wind-aided :27.1 second quarter, and through three quarters in 1:22.3 with M-M's Dream tiring and Nelsonbriteagle NO and Dexter Dunn marching three deep with hope of closing the margin on her stablemate. That wouldn't be the case on this night as Call Me Goo, a daughter of Googoo Gaagaa from the Great George Two-sired dam Callmemza, had plenty in reserve and trotted her final quarter in :28.1 to maintain a 3¼-length margin to the finish. Nelsonbriteagle NO finished with solid trot to be a clear second after racing the entire mile on the rim. M-M's Dream had an even tougher trip and was quite game holding down the show spot. Warrawee Xenia and Tactical Mounds finished fourth and fifth, respectively.

Owned by Graham Grace Stables and Ake Svanstedt Stables Inc., Call Me Goo was a winner for the 23rd time during her three-year racing career with her Breeders Crown clocking a career mark as well. Bred in Maryland by William B. Roberts, Call Me Goo pushed her career bankroll to \$936,518 with the victory.

"It's special," Sarah said. "Everyone wants to be in those races and Breeders Crown has its glory and everyone is working so hard to try to do right for the horse and end up in the Breeders Crown, but, again we never know. Every day is like stress to see how they get out of the races and to prepare for the next races. It's not always glory, this life."

The Svanstedts' decision to supplement both mares had nothing to do with the retirement of Jiggy Jog S. "She was going to go with the boys," Ake said in the post-race interview. "The owner has been talking about supplementing for the last few weeks, so we decided to go."

Call Me Goo's 1:50.4 mile lowers the stakes record of 1:51 set by Manchego in 2019. Trainer Svanstedt won his third trophy in the Mare Trot after winning his first Breeders Crown in 2021 with Felicityshagwell S and taking last year's edition with Jiggy Jog S.

As a 5-1 choice, Call Me Goo returned \$12 to win.

Breeders Crown elimination winner **Allegiant**, with Scott Zeron in the bike, won the \$600,000 Breeders Crown 3-Year-Old Filly Trot at The Meadowlands on Saturday (Oct. 26), crossing the finish in a personal-best and stakes-record-equaling 1:51.1.

Zeron fired his filly off the gate and took the lead easily enough, but R Melina was looking to avenge losing her elimination and overtook Allegiant for the lead in a soft :27.4 first panel. Willys Home Run took safe cover behind the first two with Elista Hanover behind them in fourth.

Nothing changed as R Melina guided the field to a :55.4 half, but Elista Hanover took to the outside to chase, giving cover to elim-winner Drawn Impression while the top two rolled towards three-quarters in 1:23.2. Zeron's filly had tons of trot saved from the catbird-seat journey when he sent her mid-track to use that saved energy for a convincing challenge to win and defeat R

Melina by 2¼-lengths. Elista Hanover took the third spot with Drawn Impression in fourth and Warrawee Michelle closing from last for fifth.

Even though it was a smooth trip, Zeron said "It shows how tough she really is." The win by the daughter of Tactical Landing, from the Yankee Glide mare Too Good For You, puts her on the edge of being a millionaire with \$933,197 in her wallet lifetime. Bred by Atlantic Trot Inc. and Steve H. Stewart and owned by Ryan W. Smith, Allegiant scored her 10th win in 25 starts over two seasons.

Zeron scored his eighth Breeders Crown trophy with his second-straight win driving Allegiant. "I was happy to sit in the second spot," he said after the race. "She shows me no emotion [when we race]." He also praised trainer Linda Toscano, who won her ninth Breeders Crown trophy and first in this division, for how the filly has been handled.

Toscano received Allegiant from trainer Vernon Beachy to race in the Breeders Crown.

"[Allegiant] is an absolute pleasure," Toscano said. "I got a call from Vernon, a little less than a month ago, and he said he wanted to send her for the Breeders Crown. I said, 'Are you sure?' and he said, 'Absolutely, I just feel like she doesn't like to travel and maybe she could be a hair better than what she is.' So, he said, 'Take a shot with her and see what you can do.'"

"Kudos to Vernon, he did an incredible job with her, prepping her and getting her to the races and to where she is right now. I really did very little except just to keep her on his program. So, I give all the credit to him."

Allegiant matched the stakes record set in 2022 by Jiggy Jog S with the win and paid \$6.00 to win.

Sophomore pacing filly My Girl EJ gallantly takes back-to-back Breeders Crowns

My Girl EJ and Dexter Dunn made it back-to-back Breeders Crown victories on Saturday night (Oct. 26) when they captured the \$600,000 event for sophomore pacing fillies at The Meadowlands in 1:49.3, holding off a longshot bid by Tarrific in the final strides.

Dunn kept his position from the start as My Girl EJ, a homebred daughter of Sweet Lou, stayed parked while allowing Direction and Todd McCarthy to move quickly towards the lead. Tarrific, with Jason Bartlett, overcame post 10 with a sharp opening bid and gained control midway on the opening bend. Following a :27.2 first quarter, Todd McCarthy moved Direction to the front, and that prompted Dunn to get on the move with 6-5 favorite My Girl EJ.

Direction and My Girl EJ hooked up briefly with McCarthy parking the favorite well past the :55.1 half before yielding control of the race. My Girl EJ kept a lively clip through three-quarters in 1:22.2 as Its A Love Thing with James MacDonald applied some pressure first over followed by Rocket Deo in the outer tier.

Once into the homestretch, My Girl EJ asserted herself by pulling away from the pocket-sitting Direction, but found late company along the pylons with Tarrific closing ground rapidly for Jason Bartlett with a shot at a huge upset. My Girl EJ, trained by Ron Burke, would not be denied as she bravely held off Tarrific by a neck on the finish with Direction not far back in third. Its A Love Thing held onto fourth with Rocket Deo fifth across the line.

"I had full faith in her having driven her for the last two years," said Dunn of his confidence with the strong middle-half move. "She's quick, she's tough and she's game."

Bartlett gave Tarrific a terrific steer from post 10 and almost scored his first Crown victory.

"It was really close," Bartlett said. "If [Tarrific] had the 2-hole, I'd think we'd get it, but out of the 10-hole and getting away third, it's a pretty good spot to be.

"It is a good group of fillies and no one really stuck out. I knew that mine was under the radar, because she's been in New York and sometimes New York horses don't get the respect that they should get on the Grand Circuit.

"She's just a really, really good horse. I've never left with her before. It shows once, but I never fired her up like I did tonight. She's just such a professional that she came right back to me. That's kind of her characteristics anyway. I thought that if I could fire her up and get her into position that she'd have a good shot."

My Girl EJ – the sixth filly in Breeders Crown history to repeat as a 2- and 3-year-old – is owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Brussemi LLC, Ron Burke and Elizabeth Novak. From the top producing broodmare Lucy's Pearl, a daughter of Well Said, My Girl EJ was a winner for the ninth time this year and the 14th time during her career. Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Brussemi and Elizabeth Novak bred the filly who upped her career bank account to \$1,444,060.

Ron Burke collected his fourth trophy in the 3-Year-Old Filly Pace, making him the winningest trainer in the event after being tied at three wins with the late Bob McIntosh. Burke last won in this division in 2019 with Warrawee Ubeaut. Dexter Dunn won for the first time in the 3-Year-Old Filly Pace.

As the public choice, My Girl EJ paid \$4.40 to win.

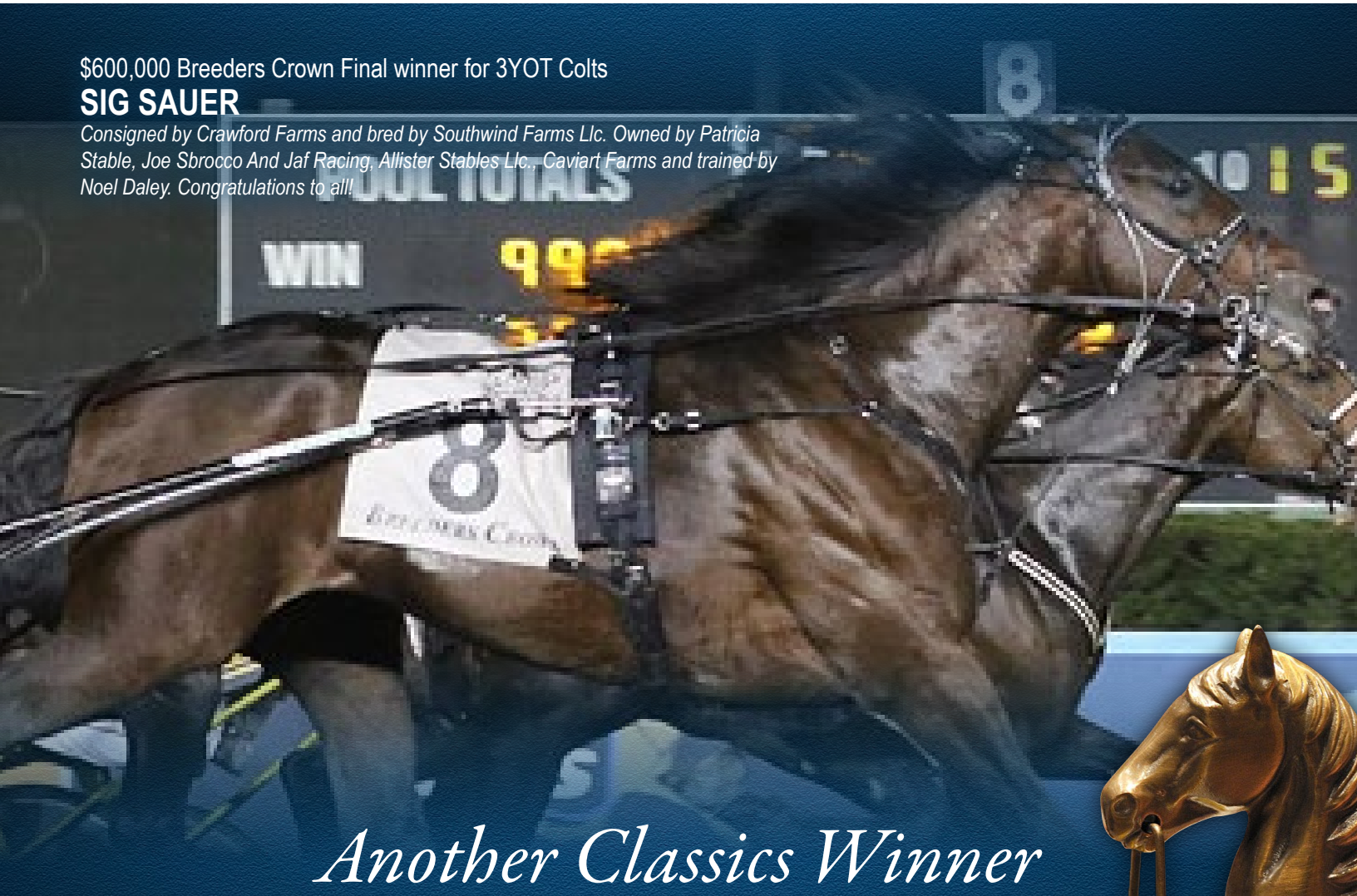

Sophomore trotting colt Sig Sauer caps career with Breeders Crown trophy

A season that started with a 68-1 surprise over eventual Hambletonian winner Karl came to a close on Saturday (Oct. 26) at The Meadowlands with **Sig Sauer** surging to the lead right as the curtain fell in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown 3-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Trot to retire a champion with a 1:50.4 win.

Driver Andy McCarthy asked Sig Sauer for speed out of post 8 but was out hustled to the first turn and settled into sixth. Tony Adams S forged forward out of post 10 and landed on the point after a :27.1 first quarter before relinquishing control to 4-5 favorite T C I marching up the backstretch.

T C I strode to a :55 half readying for pressure to the far turn. McCarthy pulled Sig Sauer off the cones and fished a live tow from Amazing Catch out of fifth, as he then powered forward but stalled as T C I accelerated to three-quarters in 1:22.4. Sig Sauer launched three wide rounding the bottom corner, and McCarthy implored the Muscle Hill colt to reach forward. T C I held his ground in the stretch, but the chalk could not stave Sig Sauer's

closing sweep over the top. Sig Sauer crossed the beam a scant nose better than T C I while Amazing Catch finished between horses in third, Highland Kismet took fourth off a third-over trip and Private Access finished fifth.

"It's been a front-end night, you had to be up close – even second-over, I haven't been noticing them win," trainer Noel Daley said after the race. "But Andy [McCarthy] pulled him a little early to get him up there, and he does dig in so that's one good thing."

T C I's trainer, Ron Burke, became the leading money-winning trainer in Breeders Crown history with the second-place finish.

"[T C I is] great and he raced awesome," Burke said. "He's supposed to go to stud, I think, but there's one part of me that wants to race him next year. I think I could re-do this year maybe next year and make it a lot better, but I'll talk to the partners and see."

"I think he's going to be a great stud when he gets the chance, it's just whether we want to do it next year or if I could talk them into going one more."

Sig Sauer, a Southwind Farms-bred colt out of the Donato Hanover mare Sigilwig, collected his fifth win from 10 starts this season and his ninth victory from 15 starts in his career. The Kentucky Futurity champion has crossed the millionaire threshold with \$1,151,312 in the bank for owners Patricia Stable, Joe Sbrocco & JAF Racing, Allister Stables LLC and Caviart Farms.

"To me, there hasn't been a better 3-year-old all year, I don't think," Daley said. "A sound Sig Sauer – he's right there with them. They're a good bunch there, tonight; Karl wasn't there, [but] it's a good group. And he showed it: he doesn't have to be lucky. He just needs to be there."

Daley, who last won in the 3-Year-Old Colt Trot in 2003 with Mr Musclemann, confirmed after Sig Sauer's crowning moment that

the colt will head to stallion duty at Hanover Shoe Farms in Pennsylvania. Off the 7-2 second choice, he paid \$9.20 to win.

Coach Stefanos sizzles late to win Breeders Crown Open Pace

Coach Stefanos and driver James MacDonald swarmed a pair of longshots capitalizing from a melting pace to win the \$600,000 Breeders Crown Open Pace final at The Meadowlands on Saturday (Oct. 26) in a 1:48.3 mile.

From the moment the field left the gate, the open pacers were raring to compete with defending champion Bythemissal. It's My Show, Ruthless Hanover and Abuckabett Hanover muscled towards the top ahead of race-favorite Bythemissal to a first-panel battle in :26. Abuckabett Hanover chanced pacing hard from that point on, speeding to the lead and upping the tempo through a :53.2 half. Bythemissal took to the outer tier from fourth and revved his engines, giving cover to Seven Colors. The field was in two rows in the final turn and to three-quarters in 1:21.1.

Getting only calls for trailing, MacDonald moved Coach Stefanos around the field and paved a path to unleash a blistering drive down the middle of the track five wide and swoop the field to hit the finish first by a half-length.

"I was sitting last at the three-quarters," MacDonald said, "and I said to myself, 'Don't panic, this guy can close like a freight train.' And tonight he had a big finishing kick."

Second at the finish was Seven Colors, a rank outsider in the betting, as was third-place finisher El Rey, who defied late traffic to take advantage of a decent trip he got at the pylons.

Three double-digit payoffs hit the tote board. Coach Stefanos paid \$29.60 to win over a \$61.40 place payoff for Seven Colors and a \$69.40 show-priced El Rey.

"I knew where my horse was the whole time and it wasn't in a good spot," said trainer Erv Miller, laughing. "I was last all the way around the last turn on the outside... It helped they were :26 flat and :53-and-something to the half, so they were down there in time and that helped a lot.

"He raced great last week and he's good and healthy. I was smiling at the half while he was still racing last because he's closed in :25.1 many times.

"Coach has been knocking on the door all year and he just can't seem to get the right trip and tonight they went fast enough fractions and it worked out great."

Miller won for the second time in the Open Pace after taking the 2006 edition with Lis Mara.

Coach Stefanos is a 4-year-old gelding by Tellitlikeitis out of the Rocknroll Hanover mare Watch N Be Watched. It was his third win in 19 races this season and his share of the purse earned him millionaire status as he has now earned \$1,265,206 for owners Kenneth Duffy, D&M Trading II LLC and Mr. John Stefanos. He was bred by Victory Hill Farm.

Winner's Bet scores in Crown Open Trot

Winner's Bet got the lead at the half, appeared to be drawing clear from the field off the final turn and down the stretch, but still had to rebuff fast-closing Periculum to capture Saturday's (Oct. 26) \$600,000 Breeders Crown Open Trot by a nose in a stakes-record-equaling 1:51 at The Meadowlands. Hillexotic finished third.

It's Academic was first to the quarter in :26.4 after a four-horse battle for the early lead. Ari Ferrari J moved to the front on the backstretch, but Winner's Bet had his nose in front at the half in :54.4.

Winner's Bet remained in control around the final turn and hit three-quarters in 1:23 while turning away a first-over bid by Oh Well. He separated himself from the field heading down the stretch, but Periculum and driver Scott Zeron came flying late to force Winner's Bet to work to the end.

The victory gave trainer Nancy Takter the 11th Breeders Crown of her career, moving her into sole possession of sixth place

among conditioners in the history of the series. The triumph was the fourth of the Breeders Crown weekend for Dunn.

"I knew there would be some action early," Dunn said. "But Winner's Bet has developed into such a nice horse and so versatile. He makes my job easy because I can move him whenever I want. We had to move when we did, and we got a pretty good third quarter after that. It was a long way down the stretch toward the end and Scotty was coming hard, but he stuck his neck out.

"I thought I was home halfway down (the stretch), but I saw Scotty coming pretty quick and my fella started to get a little bit tired. But he hadn't raced in a while, and he really did a great job. He was really good tonight."

Winner's Bet is owned by Lindy Farms of Connecticut and Robert Rudolph. He has won eight of 11 races this season and 14 of 31 lifetime, good for \$1.3 million in purses. The son of Walner—Side Bet Hanover was bred by S R F Stable.

Sent off as the 1-2 favorite, Winner's Bet paid \$3 to win.

Mirage Hanover pounces, prevails in sophomore colt pace as trainer Jake Leamon wins first Crown

Driver Dexter Dunn worked a snug pocket ride for 5-2 second choice **Mirage Hanover** and powered to the wire to equal the 1:48 stakes record in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown 3-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Pace on Saturday night (Oct. 26) at The Meadowlands.

Leaving from the pylon post, Dunn pushed Mirage Hanover to secure a seat behind 3-5 favorite Captain Albano, who bore a furious challenge from Timeisonmyside through a :26.4 first quarter. Timeisonmyside remained a pestering thorn to Captain Albano, who nonetheless coasted to a :54.1 half.

Captain Albano continued to cruise as Timeisonmyside retreated through the turn and congested the outer tier on the move to three-quarters in 1:21.2. Mirage Hanover all the while followed with intent and amply responded once Dunn launched him for home. Mirage Hanover drew alongside Captain Albano and zipped away in the final eighth to post a 2½-length win with

Nijinsky emerging off a ground-saving trip for second. Captain Albano faded to third with Calicojack Hanover finishing fourth and McCrunch taking fifth.

“He absolutely loves it; just loves to do it,” said trainer Jake Leamon, who won his first Breeders Crown trophy in just his second finals appearance. “He’s laid back, easy to jog – two fingers – never gets excited and just goes when you ask him. [Captain Albano] is a really tough horse. It was going to come right down to it.

As for winning his first Breeders Crown, the trainer said, “It’s awesome. Just beyond words to put in a lot of work and have it finally pay off.

“I thought we had a good shot at it, the way it was working out with the horse being parked and he was going to pick somebody off that was coming from behind. If we got out I knew we’d have a chance at it. Albano is a really nice horse so it wasn’t a guarantee that we could get by him, but my horse loves to close and pass horses. So, it was licking the chops, but waiting until they crossed the wire.”

Leamon said Mirage Hanover is the best horse he’s ever trained.

“His brother Max is a very good horse, but he never had the quickness that this horse has. He never got tired and this one doesn’t get tired, but he also has quick speed so he can just turn it on like now.”

Marvin Rounick owns Mirage Hanover, a Hanover Shoe Farms-bred colt by Bettor’s Delight out of the Mach Three mare Mayhem Seelster. The colt collected his sixth win from 17 starts this season and his 10th victory from 26 starts in his career, good for \$882,593 in earnings. His 1:48 win matched the record set in 2016 by Racing Hill at The Meadowlands. Dunn collected his first trophy in the 3-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Pace.

Mirage Hanover paid \$7.40 to win.

Twin B Joe Fresh rolls to Breeders Crown victory

Twin B Joe Fresh and driver Dexter Dunn capped off the Breeders Crown weekend in style at The Meadowlands.

Dunn picked up his record-setting sixth driving victory of the weekend when he guided Twin B Joe Fresh to a 1:49 win in Saturday's (Oct. 26) \$400,000 Mare Pace, the last of 12 Breeders Crown events hosted by The Big M over the weekend.

Twin B Joe Fresh, harness racing's No. 1-ranked horse, defeated Kobe's Gigi by 1¾ lengths, missing the stakes record by one-fifth of a second. Sylvia Hanover was third.

The triumph was the fourth of the night for Dunn and followed his two-victory performance Friday. His six wins set the Breeders Crown record for the most driving wins in a year, breaking the previous record of five set by David Miller in 2015 at Woodbine Racetrack.

Dunn, a New Zealand native who moved to the U.S. in 2018, has won 21 Breeders Crowns since his debut in the series in 2019. His total is the eighth most in the 41-year history of the event.

"It's a thrill," Dunn said. "Not in my wildest dreams did I think that this weekend would happen when I moved over here. I've had so much support, so many good horses to drive. It's just been a great ride."

Dunn won Friday with 2-year-old female pacer Miki And Minnie and 2-year-old male trotter Maryland, then added Saturday wins

with 3-year-old female pacer My Girl EJ, 3-year-old male pacer Mirage Hanover, 4-year-old male trotter Winner's Bet, and Twin B Joe Fresh.

"I had a lot of great horses to drive this weekend, but it's Breeders Crown, it's not easy," Dunn said. "It's tough racing. You saw it tonight, there were a lot of tough miles. But the trainers had them ready and they performed."

Twin B Joe Fresh, owned by a group that includes Dunn, trainer Chris Ryder, longtime Ryder assistant Peter Trebotica and Barry Spak, performed much like she has all season. The 4-year-old daughter of Roll With Joe—Fresh Breeze notched her 10th win of the season in 12 starts and upped her seasonal earnings to \$827,062.

She came into the Breeders Crown final off a second-place finish from post 10 in her elimination last week but left no doubt about Saturday's outcome after taking the lead at the half and opening a 3½ length lead in the stretch.

"She felt so good tonight," Dunn said. "Going to the gate, she was up on her tippy toes and that's a sign she was ready to rock and roll. Coming around the last turn, she just felt so good. I called on her and she changed gears and sprinted off well."

Twin B Joe Fresh opened this season with a second-place finish against male foes before reeling off nine consecutive victories heading into her Breeders Crown elim. With her triumph in the Breeders Crown, she has won seven of the eight richest races of the season for pacing mares, including the Roses Are Red, Dayton Distaff Derby, and Milton Stakes.

"I've been trying to take it one race at a time," Ryder said. "Dexter has been looking after her, we really haven't bottomed her out. Basically, we wanted to keep her good for this week. We had a hiccup last week, but we got over that. I was pretty sure she was 100 per cent tonight."

"It means a lot. It's been very exciting all year. We started out the year and we were pretty confident with her. Then she started winning and kept winning and it's just been fantastic. She's got a lot of support. I just didn't want to disappoint tonight. It's a big relief for me."

Bred by Brittany Farms, Twin B Joe Fresh has won 29 of 39 races and hit the board a total of 37 times. She has banked \$2.26 million lifetime.

Sent off as the 1-9 favorite in the Mare Pace, she paid \$2.10 to win.
