## **Breeders Crown finals define my** appreciation of uncertainty

"So many races, so little time" ~ any anonymous bettor

On Oct. 10, 1986, I was where I usually spent Friday nights - at Los Alamitos Raceway in Cerritos, CA. What was different from the usual Friday night harness racing visit to Los Al was that evening's feature race — the \$301,350 Breeders Crown Open Pace.

I was a writer living and working in Hollywood. My

penchant for harness racing came west with me when I moved from Brooklyn, NY to Los Angeles in 1978. Even before I had an L.A. address. I found the itinerant West Coast harness community and became a regular at Hollywood Park, Los Al, and later

at Fairplex Park.

That October night at Los Al, though, was my first as a harness racing journalist. Though I had written articles on horse racing for various North American thoroughbred and harness magazines, that night I was on my first assignment covering a race, no less a Breeders Crown race, no less for "Harness Horse" magazine. That fact is important to the crux of this column because I was 99 per cent punter and one per cent standardbred race reporter — and I was still learning how to deal with the 99 per cent of it all. I found help.

The betting company I kept in California reshaped and universally popularized how to "play the horses" forever, adding concepts and lingo to the modern horse-player's lexicon.

Looking back at the 1986 Breeders Crown final at Los Al as I prepare to report on 2020 Breeders Crown finals from Hoosier, I realize the vast difference in the chores of reporting and handicapping. Innovative and astute sources blended with my experiences over the decades to make me passive, not aggressive — and that has become my strongest quality. For this game should humble anyone who plays it (though most refuse to face the chagrin it generates), so as

to decry the failure to appreciate uncertainty.

Though I became a decent harness journalist, I thrive as a bettor more than as a reporter. Reporting races, after all, requires delivering facts, truth and certainty; without editorial. A bettor delivers opinion only, which is an enormous difference. It requires one have a deep respect for accepting uncertainty.

"So, who do you like?" ~ any anonymous bettor.

There are few better races than the Breeders Crown elims and finals for those bettors accepting and respecting uncertainty, because to do so provokes wise decisions — like passing races when the public appears to be dead-on correct and playing when it might be very wrong — might be, not will be — because the public statistically fails winning races at least 67 per cent of the time (winning about 33 per cent). That 67 per cent is a product of a public flaw — its failure to appreciate uncertainty. However, uncertainty can prove profitable, obviously, because it supports a minority.

I am certain my uncertainty shall continue to guide me to making some smart wagers in the Breeders Crown finals because I will make my decisions to wager or not to wager based upon my opinion of an "overlay," that is, a horse (that in my opinion) going off at odds higher than its chances.

I rate the chances.

Rating is the product of my opinions. My opinions are based upon some fundamental elements that all handicappers know, except I take into consideration facets of probability, a.k.a, luck, likelihood, risk and propensity, which covers all we do not know, such as the generic chaos of any race, late-season improvers, lightly raced types with questionable class. These are out-of-our-control elements that the majority considers negative. For me, they are positive possibilities; they prove to work for or against any horse we bet and all of the horses in the races with the horses we bet. There is no way to know the affects these quirks will hold at any time or when they will occur and at what capacity they will perform, but they must be appreciated and incorporated into my opinions, because they will matter in my success.

This is, for example, why I know from watching the eliminations, that although I may agree with the public that Lady Chaos has the best chance of winning the frosh-filly trot, the betting public will bet her so strongly that another horse with not so good a chance will get longer odds than

its chances. There is, then, only one choice for my win bet — the other horse. In this case, Splash Blue Chip could get my win bet and he is my second choice. By that simple rule, I choose to wager or not at the time of the betting. Here are my possible targets in the order of their program number (races missing are those I know I will pass):

Splash Blue Chip; On A Streak; Paulas Bet Hanover; JK Going West; When Dovescry; Caviart Eva; Play Trix On Me; Dorsoduro Hanover.

I am sure few to none agree with me.

In fact, I am counting on it.

#### Atlanta at her best to take on the boys in the Breeders Crown Open Trot

The winner of more than \$2.5 million has rarely been better said her trainer, Ron Burke.

Atlanta has done plenty to impress trainer Ron Burke in the two seasons she has been in his stable, including win eight Grand Circuit finals, set speed records in the U.S. and Canada, and receive a Dan Patch Award.

Yet, as she prepares to take on nine male rivals in Saturday's \$500,000 Breeders Crown Open Trot at Harrah's Hoosier Park, Burke has never felt better about the 5-year-old mare.

Atlanta heads to the race off a 1:50 win over a "good" surface in the Allerage Farms Open Trot on Oct. 11 at Lexington's Red Mile. Only a half-length loss to Gimpanzee in the Caesars Trotting Classic at Hoosier in September keeps her from a four-race win streak.

"I could not be happier with her, she's the best she's ever been for us," said Burke, who took over the training of Atlanta at the beginning of 2019. "I like getting the week off because she loves to race off multiple weeks off, so she's going to come in sharp for the final. I'm thrilled."

What has made Atlanta even better?

"I think she's matured a little bit more," Burke said. "I've always worried about her weight, and it's really not an issue

now. She looks great. And maybe the year, the way her schedule has been, it's really helped. She hasn't raced that much, and I don't think she really wants to race a lot, because when she races she gives everything every step every time."

Atlanta has won five of 10 races this season. In addition to the Allerage, her victories include the Maple Leaf Trot, Dayton Trotting Derby, and Arthur J. Cutler Memorial.

She will attempt to become the fourth mare to win the Breeders Crown Open Trot, joining Hannelore Hanover (2017), Moni Maker (1998) and CR Kay Suzie (1996). Atlanta, the Trotter of the Year in 2018 and Dan Patch Award winner for best older female trotter in 2019, is seeking her first Crown.

Last year, Atlanta finished third in the Open Trot behind Bold Eagle and Six Pack.

Burke leads all active trainers in Breeders Crown hardware with 17 trophies. Jimmy Takter holds the record with 34.

Atlanta, who has won 25 of 49 career races and \$2.52 million, will start Saturday (Oct. 31) from post five with driver Yannick Gingras, a 23-time Breeders Crown winner. The mare is owned by Crawford Farms Racing, Brad Grant, and Howard Taylor.

With the way Atlanta is racing, Burke cannot help but think ahead a bit to 2021.

"I think it points to next year being her best year," Burke said. "I'm excited. Right now, it's all go to race next year again. I think we can do special things next year."

Atlanta is not alone in looking to add her name to the Breeders Crown record book Saturday. Four-year-old stallion Gimpanzee is aiming for his third win in a Crown final. Only three trotters have captured three or more Breeders Crown trophies in history. Female trotter Peace Corps holds the record with four. Grades Singing, another female, won three as did male trotter Mack Lobell.

Gimpanzee, a Dan Patch Award winner at age 2, has won seven of 10 races this year, including the John Cashman Memorial, and 24 of 33 lifetime. He has earned \$2.45 million for owners Courant Inc. and S R F Stable.

He enters the Crown final off a 1:52 win last Saturday in an invitational at Hoosier. He starts from post three with Brian Sears in the sulky. Sears has won 32 Crown finals, second most in history behind John Campbell's 48.

Prior to winning the invitational, Gimpanzee was sixth in the Allerage, his only off-the-board finish of the campaign.

"The result in Lexington was a little disappointing, even if I wasn't disappointed in the horse, but the result," trainer Marcus Melander said. "I could feel in the warmups

(Saturday) that he was in form. I told Brian that too.

"We were both very excited that he bounced back the way he did. It was a perfect prep race for him. Brian drove him perfectly and he didn't have to chase him hard down the lane, he did it very easily. I couldn't have been happier."

The Open Trot field also includes Fiftydallarbill, who won a Breeders Crown at age 2 in 2017 at Hoosier, as well as Lindy The Great and Majestic Player A, who are among three horses sharing the Hoosier track record of 1:51.1 for a trotter, and millionaire Crystal Fashion.

Harrah's Hoosier Park plays host to the four \$600,000 Breeders Crown finals for 2-year-olds on Friday (Oct. 30). The remaining eight finals, for 3-year-olds and older horses, are Saturday. Racing begins at 6 p.m. (EDT) both nights.

The 2020 Breeders Crown, presented by the Libfeld-Katz Breeding Partnership, is the 37th edition of the \$6 million event. Harrah's Hoosier Park will provide a free live high-definition streaming of the races on YouTube.

## Venerate gets respect in Crown final

After watching Venerate become the fastest 2-year-old trotter ever at Harrah's Hoosier Park by winning his Breeders

Crown elimination in 1:52.2 last week, trainer Julie Miller offered a succinct summary of the colt's effort.

"If he minds his manners and stays focused, that's the kind of performance we thought he could put in," Miller said.

Venerate heads to Friday's (Oct. 30) \$600,000 Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old male trotters with four wins in his last six starts. He went off stride in the two losses.

In addition to capturing his Crown elimination, Venerate's victories include the inaugural Mohawk Million and the Kentucky Sire Stakes championship. Overall, the son of Love You—Peaceful Kemp has won five of nine races and earned \$703,114. He is owned by Pinske Stables and Andy Miller

Stable Inc.

"He can be his own worst enemy," Julie said prior to the elimination. "He's kind of immature mentally and is still trying to figure out what we're asking of him. He wants to do the right thing, he's trying to figure it out."

On Friday, Venerate will start from post five with Andy Miller, Julie's husband, in the sulky. Julie and Andy have won one Crown together, with Lucky Jim in the 2009 Open Trot. Andy has a total of five trophies as a driver.

"(Venerate) is the horse to beat in my opinion," said trainer Marcus Melander, who conditions In Range, the winner of the event's other elimination. "That's a great horse."

In Range won his Crown elimination by a neck over Brookview Bolt in 1:54.1. The colt, by Bar Hopping out of Ilia, has won five of nine races and earned \$276,003 for owners AMG Stable, Kenneth Kjellgren, Tomas Hans Asell, and Rick Wahlstedt. He has finished worse than second only once, a sixth-place finish in a division of the Bluegrass Stakes.

Tim Tetrick will drive In Range, starting from post three.

"He's only had one bad race this year, and that was the first week of Lexington, and we didn't really know what was going on with him that week," said Melander, who has won two

Breeders Crown trophies, both with trotter Gimpanzee.

"Otherwise, he's been great. You can never count him out because he's always right there. He'll be right there with them."

Friday's final also includes William Wellwood Memorial winner On A Streak and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion Captain Corey, who was undefeated in five races before finishing second to Venerate in their Crown elimination.

"He raced good," trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt said about Captain Corey, "but Venerate was better.

"We're not giving up. We're going to fight (in the final)."

Captain Corey is one of two Svanstedt-trained colts in the race. Yannick Gingras will drive Delayed Hanover, who was third in the elimination won by In Range.

"He raced okay, but I expected more of him," Svanstedt said. "He didn't come home so good. Maybe it was a long trip (to Hoosier) too close to the race. Now, he is there for a week and can take it easy, so maybe he can be better."

Jim Campbell also has two finalists, Cricket Fashion and Take All Comers, who punched his ticket to the Breeders Crown by winning a Bluegrass Stakes division on Oct. 2 at Red Mile. The gelding finished third in his Crown elimination, which was won by Venerate.

"I'm very happy with him," Campbell said. "He was a very confident third. We've kind of taken it week to week with him. When we brought him to Lexington, we were going to

race him the first week and see how he raced. He went out and raced super and that's when we decided to go to the Breeders Crown with him. We chose not to race him the second week (in Lexington) intentionally."

Harrah's Hoosier Park plays host to the four \$600,000 Breeders Crown finals for 2-year-olds on Friday. The remaining eight finals, for 3-year-olds and older horses, are Saturday (Oct. 31). Racing begins at 6 p.m. (EDT) both nights.

#### Spoiled Princess part of Takter trio in Breeders Crown 3-year-old filly trot

When it comes to online purchases, Spoiled Princess looks like a royal buy. The 3-year-old filly trotter is a nose from being undefeated in three races for trainer Nancy Takter since her father Jimmy acquired the horse for \$90,400 last month in an onGait.com auction.

On Saturday (Oct. 31), she races in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown final for 3-year-old filly trotters at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Spoiled Princess heads to the race off a 1:53 win in her elimination this past Friday (Oct. 23), when she defeated favorite Hypnotic AM by a neck.

"It's 2020, the year of COVID-19, and everybody learned to

shop online," Nancy said, adding with a laugh, "Even Jimmy Takter learned how to buy horses online."

Jimmy Takter, the Hall of Famer who retired from training following the 2018 season, and happens to be the winningest trainer in Breeders Crown history with 34 trophies, was interested in Spoiled Princess as a broodmare prospect. Five days before she sold online, Spoiled Princess won a division of the Buckette Stakes at the Delaware County Fairgrounds in Ohio. Nancy Takter was at the track that day, watching her stable's Caviart Eva win the other division.

"He called me and asked about her," Nancy said. "He was really looking for a mare that he could breed to Ready For Moni later, that would cross well with Ready For Moni. She looked good, a nice-gaited filly, a nice big strong-looking filly. I knew she was sound. I didn't see where you could go wrong with buying her."

Jimmy Takter made the buy, with Black Horse Racing's Barry Guariglia. The filly now races for Black Horse Racing and Christina Takter. Since joining her new group, Spoiled

Spoiled Princess (Dexter Dunn, winning their Crown elimination last week) has been a terrific online find for the Takter family, so far.

Princess finished second by a nose to stablemate Sorella in a division of the Bluegrass Stakes, won a 3-year-old filly open, and captured her Breeders Crown elimination.

For her career, Spoiled Princess has won eight of 21 races and \$171,136. The daughter of Trixton—Fashion Spooner was trained previously by Nifty Norman.

Spoiled Princess will start the Breeders Crown final from post five with driver Dexter Dunn.

"She was in really good shape when she got to me; she was sound and a well-mannered filly," Nancy said. "She's beautifully gaited. We just made some bridle changes and stuff like that, and I put her on Lasix. She's maybe a little fresher than some of the other ones now. That plays to her advantage as well."

Spoiled Princess is one of three finalists for Nancy. Her others are Sorella, the Hambletonian Oaks winner, and Caviart Eva. Sorella finished third, beaten a half-length, in Spoiled Princess' elim. Caviart Eva was fourth in the other elimination, which was won by Next Level Stuff in 1:53.4.

"I was happy with both of them," Nancy said. "Eva is a game, honest filly. She's really an overachiever. She tries really hard. You can't help but like her. I was happy with Sorella too. She's not really as much of a sprinter as maybe Princess is. I think she raced good. She raced with shoes and she's better without shoes. She'll race without shoes in the final. She's been good all year. It's tough to maintain your form from May to November."

Next Level Stuff rallied to win her elimination by a neck over tempo-setting Ab'sattitudexpress. She has won three of her last four races for trainer Jim Campbell and owner Runthetable Stables. Her only loss during that span was a fourth-place finish in the Kentucky Filly Futurity.

She will start the final from post one with driver Tim Tetrick. For the year, the daughter of Sebastian K S—Nantab has won six of 12 races and \$231,361.

"I couldn't be happier with her, the way she's been going," Campbell said. "She's been very consistent all year long. She had a real good race the other night and hopefully we can keep her going for the final.

"She was really good in the Kentucky (Filly) Futurity final, she just had some bad racing luck. She was pinned in and didn't get out until late. But she raced really good there and

she took advantage of a good trip Friday at Hoosier."

Ab'sattitudexpress, trained by Lucas Wallin, and Hypnotic AM, trained by Marcus Melander, will start the Breeders Crown final next to each other, in posts six and seven, respectively.

"I was very happy with how Ab's raced and she never gave up," Wallin said. "With an eighth of a mile left it looked like she would get beat by two lengths or so, but she tried her best. She hasn't disappointed me yet this year."

Said Melander about Hypnotic AM, the Oaks and Filly Futurity runner-up, "I was very happy with her in the elimination. She got to the lead and just got beat by a neck. She's always right there in these races, she always shows up. She's never missed the board in her entire life. You can always count on her. She's a great horse and definitely one of the fillies that can win the race."

Kentucky Filly Futurity winner Love A Good Story finished third in her elimination, beaten a length by Next Level Stuff. She will start Saturday from post 10, in the second tier.

"I think she was really coming on for a good-closing third," trainer Julie Miller said. "I wasn't tickled with the 10-hole, but that's better than the eight or nine. We'll see what happens with her. I think she's really peaking right now."

## Declan Donoway: a harness racing life in black and white

When it comes to his look and approach in standardbred racing, everything is black and white for Declan Donoway.

The colors he eventually chose to wear on the racetrack were the result of homework and simple logic, a decision that in many ways aligns with his view of his life in the sulky.

"I think the biggest reason was that I had never really seen anyone with colors like that," said Donoway. "I couldn't really think of any other colors that no one else had. Looking out at the track, you'd stand there and say, 'Alright, he's got those colors and that guy has those colors.' There are so many colors out there, but I hadn't seen anyone that just had black and white. So, that's what I decided to go with."

While Donoway isn't a household name yet, there's no doubt the young reinsman from Salisbury, MD is on the fast track to success.

His talents in the race bike were evident from an early age, well before the day of Feb. 25, 2018.

That was the date of his first pari-mutuel win, one that came at Rosecroft Raceway in Fort Washington, MD.

Sitting behind 11-year-old pacer Hrubys N Luck, a savvy veteran trained by his step-father, Brian Malone, Donoway delivered in his milestone race.

And he delivered big-time.

Or, as Donoway sees it, Hrubys N Luck did.

Sent off at 1-5, the son of Sir Luck (ON), bred by C and I Siegel Racing Stable (NY), rhymed off an opening-quarter mile in a brisk :26.3.

Sensing the veteran pacer was travelling at an unsustainable clip, Donoway guided his charge through a half timed in :56.2 and three-quarters in 1:25.2.

Ahead by three lengths at the stretch call, the pair widened

their advantage with ease down the lane, crossing the wire 6 ¼ lengths ahead of their nearest rival.

The final time over a fast track was 1:54.3.

Not a bad way to get your career off the gate.

"I was just so happy that it happened," said Donoway. "I was lucky that I had such a good horse to be with for my first race. It's pretty easy to win when the horse does most of the work. I still remember it clearly, more than any other race I've driven in. I guess what stands out about the race itself was when I asked him to go and he just took off. And then we came back to the winner's circle and my whole family was there. They had big smiles on their faces and I think they were just as excited as I was. So to experience that moment with them was something I won't ever forget."

An easy first win didn't cause Donoway's ego to swell.

Well before that drive, he realized there would be plenty of ups and downs to contend with.

"I think you appreciate that you need to be patient to be successful in racing. You can't overdrive horses – you just have to be smart about what you do on the racetrack. You can't get too high or too low. You could be behind a horse that should win and it doesn't happen, or it could be the other way around. You want to have success, but you also need to listen and to learn. So, that's where being patient is a huge factor in your career. If you keep working hard, getting better at what you do, and listen to good advice, it makes all the difference in the world. And every race is different. You need to forget the last one and focus on the next one."

When he's not at the racetrack or in the barn, Donoway, time permitting, enjoys the opportunity to cast a line at local fishing spots.

Not that he gets much chance to indulge in one of his favorite pastimes or another top hobby, duck hunting.

Although he didn't have as much time to fish this summer as he usually does, Donoway did manage to land an impressive catch.

"Normally when I'm not racing, I'm in the barn working," he said with a laugh. "But I did get some fishing in. I did catch a decently-sized big one this summer."

Understandably, netting wins and with that, more opportunities, is his main focal point these days.

In 2018, Donoway won 32 races, upping his win total to 48 the next year. This season, a campaign that has been heavily affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, he's recorded 18 wins and 80 top-three finishes.

He has found, in every way, his true calling.

"I'm very fortunate to be doing this for my career. I think I knew I wanted to do this after I jogged my first horse. I was about 12. Then – I think I was 14 at the time – I had my first drive at the fairs. If I didn't know already it's what I wanted to do, I definitely knew after that first race. It's the greatest feeling in the world. I remember after that first fair race I just wanted to keep driving. It was tough when I had to wait for

the fair to come around the next year. I had to wait a while, and almost every day I wished I was out there driving."

Donoway hasn't looked back since those days.

He's hoping to add some more memorable drives before this year comes to a close, and to up his game even more in 2021.

"Just winning is the biggest thrill for me. I'm always happy when I win. It never gets old. I like it when I pick up more drives. My biggest goal is to make a career out of a driving. That's what I'm focused on. In the long term, I want to compete at other tracks outside of Maryland, some of the big tracks in the northeast. When I look at a program and see I'm in for a lot of races on a card that brings a big smile to my face. I just look at the program and see the opportunity to win races."

It's the ideal reminder – right there in black and white – of what Donoway strives for every day he's in the race bike.

### Zacon Gio defeated Face Time Bourbon, again, this time in the Lotteria

Champion trotter Face Time Bourbon (Ready Cash) won his elimination for \$780,000 Gran Premio della Lotteria in Naples paired with Björn Goop on Sunday afternoon (Oct. 25) and the duo went into the final as heavy favorites.

But Face Time Bourbon's elimination wasn't a spectacular race since the French champion made a break shortly after start, which actually didn't cost too much since Goop found a position in second over before the attack was set in at the

back stretch of the 5/8 mile track in Naples.

Face Time Bourbon disarmed leader Vitruvio and seemed to have much power left for the final when he crossed the wire in a 1:55.3 mile.

Alessandro Gocciado's Vernissage Grif (Varenne) hit the lead at an early stage in the second elimination and Gocciadoro left the opponents with several lengths over the home stretch. Vernissage Grif landed on a 1:55.2 mile.

Holger Ehlert-trained Zacon Gio (Ruty Grif) could take the lead after a quarter of a mile in the last elimination and driver Roberto Vecchione had everything under control even if pocket trip trotter Billie de Montfort got close at the end. Zacon Gio, who defeated Face Time Bourbon in \$200,000 Prix Unione Europea in Modena, Italy, in May 2019, trotted the fastest mile of the elimination winners: 1:55.3.

Zacon Gio started from post 1 behind the gate in the final and Roberto Vecchione was eager to keep the lead with Holger Ehlert's star trotter. With Vernissage Grif first over and Face Time Bourbon in fourth over, many factors told that Zacon Gio would claim the big trophy and even if the first choice Face Time Bourbon's effort was strong, he couldn't reach the leader who won in 1:55.2. Vivid Wise As grabbed the bronze medal.

Zacon Gio is a true champion and the victory in Lotteria

was his fourth Group 1-win in his career. His biggest trophy so far is the International Trot win at Yonkers from 2019.

#### Mascate Match in favorite position, before sale

Finnish 4-year-old mare Mascate Match (Muscle Mass) is undoubtedly one of the best trotters ever bred in Finland and after Sunday's Breeders Crown semi-finals at Solvalla in Sweden, the Pekka Korpi trained horse will be the horse to beat in the final in Eskilstuna on November 8.

Mascate Match was one of the more impressive winners at Solvalla's race card on Sunday afternoon, a card that contained 12 races, all semi-finals for Breeders Crown.

Alongside Mascate Match, Mahma Lane (Maharajah) and Grande Diva Sisu (Ready Cash) won their semi-finals, respectively.

Robert Bergh's Googoo Gaagaa duo Power and Hail Mary both impressed a lot in the eliminations for 4-year-old colts and geldings and in the same category, Johan Untersteiner's Guzz Mearas (Muscle Mass) won his heat in Sunday's best mile rate, 1:54.4 over 1.3 miles.

Winners in eliminations for 3-year-old fillies: Global Brilliance (SJ.'s Caviar), Eagle Eye Sherry (Bold Eagle) and Bank Wise As (Muscle Hill).

Winners in eliminations for 3-year-old colts and geldings: San Moteur (Panne de Moteur), Selected News (Maharajah), and Bandido Gar (Maharajah).

But back to Mascate Match. The story of this talented trotter is interesting. She was sold as a yearling in Finland and is owned by 1,000 fractional partners where every share cost 100 euro. The Muscle Mass daughter is one out of 12 contenders in something called "Raviliiga", "The Trot League", in Finland and it's a collaboration between harness racing and the Ice Hockey league in the nordic European country.

Several hockey players are involved with the 12 trotters that compete in the Raviliiga and this was from the beginning a project aimed towards finding new horse owners in Finland. The success of Mascate Match is of course a fairytale, but it's also well known that every fairytale must come to an end. In the contract it's said that the project of Raviliiga ends after this season and all horses will be for sale in December. Most likely an online sale will take place and rumors say that big owners from America have shown interest in the great Mascate Match.

It should not be a wild guess to say that Mascate Match will be an attractive object in December.

Mascate Match's record so far, ahead of the Breeders Crown final on Nov. 8 is 28 wins in 32 starts and \$830,904 in lifetime earnings.

#### Zeron wins four Massachusetts Sire Stake finals

Scott Zeron was all business at Plainridge Park on Monday afternoon (Oct. 26) as he won four of the eight Massachusetts Sire Stake (MASS) finals, including three straight to start the day. Trainer George Ducharme and owner/breeder Ray Campbell Jr. also combined for three stake wins and five in-the-money placings during the afternoon. There were eight \$90,000 divisions combined for a total value of \$720,000.

Zeron struck first with the 2-year-old trotting gelding Incommunicado (Chapter Seven—Gran Cavalla) who took an early lead and marched on the point by 1-1/2 lengths all the way to the three-quarters. At that station, Incommunicado kicked-away from the group and opened up six lengths around the last turn and stretched that advantage to 17-1/4 at the wire where he stopped the timer in 1:56.2, which was a new lifetime mark for the winner.

It was the third straight MASS win for Incommunicado (\$2.60) who is owned by Knutsson Trotting, Little E, Arthur Geiger and David Stolz. Ake Svanstedt is the trainer.

The Moni Maker Stable bred Incommunicado who was an \$80,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Selected Sale in 2019.

Next in the 3-year-old male pacing division, Zeron sat behind the heavily favored **Wyatt J** (American Ideal—Think Pink) and similarly called the shots on the front. When the race got to the half, Spatterdash (Mike Stevenson) moved alongside and presented a real threat as the pair matched

strides to the three-quarters and halfway around the last turn. There, Wyatt J pulled away by a length but still had to quell a late charge from R Maddy Blue Chip (Kevin Switzer) and Han Solo (Shawn Gray) to win by 1/2 length in 1:52.1.

Now undefeated in four starts in Massachusetts, Wyatt J (\$2.20) has also won eight straight starts this year for owner Ken Jacobs. Linda Toscano is the winning trainer.

Wyatt J was bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut and was a \$245,000 yearling purchase at the 2018 Lexington Selected Sale.

Zeron's natural Hat Trick was completed in the 2-year-old male pacing division with **Mullinax** (American Ideal—Up Front Kellie Jo) who took an early lead to the quarter in :26.4 before Maui (Shawn Gray) tipped and took control. At the five-eighths pole Call Me Maverick (Mike Stevenson) and Bumpah Stickah (Jim Hardy) drew even with Maui and Mullinax and the foursome paced away from the field. At the top of the stretch Bumpah Stickah tipped three deep and Mullinax went four wide and got the best of the insiders by only a neck at the light in 1:53.4.

The time was a new stake record and tied the existing track record that Mullinax set himself earlier this month.

It was the sixth win of the year and second straight for Mullinax (\$5.00) who is owned by William Varney and trained by Mark Ford.

Mullinax was bred by his namesake, Ed Mullinax.

Zeron completed the Grand Slam in the 3-year-old trotting filly division behind **Without A Warning** (RC Royalty—Concentration) who took the lead off the gate and was never headed after that. The filly trotted through quarters of :28, :58 and 1:26.2 when Zeron let Without A Warning out a notch and she swelled up down the stretch with a 6-1/4 length lead at the beam, timed in 1:55.

Without A Warning (\$2.10) swept the MASS for the second straight year and is now a two-time champion for owner/breeder Ray Campbell Jr. George Ducharme trains the winner. Without A Warning has also never lost a race in the state of Massachusetts and is a perfect nine-for-nine lifetime.

The 2-year-old filly pace went to **Purameri** (American Ideal—J K Pure Pearl) who got away sixth behind the

front-running So Amazing (Bruce Ranger). At the half, Suzie Blue Chip (Shawn Gray) was out and rolling and driver Nick Graffam followed that cover with Purameri all the way to the top of the stretch where they swung wide and paced up a storm passing So Amazing. Once in front, Purameri opened up a 2-1/2 length lead and won in 1:54.1 in a 7-1 upset.

Purameri (\$17.00) scored her second and biggest win in Massachusetts for owner the Purple Haze Stable and trainer Jessica Okusko.

Next was the 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings and **Double Dealing** (RC Royalty—Heather Spur) dug deep to get the win. After getting away third behind Life Is A Feast (Scott Zeron), Shawn Gray pulled Double Dealing at the half and motored up the rim towards the leader and engaged him on the backstretch. The two trotters tangled to the three-quarters, around the last turn and into the stretch where Double Dealing opened up a two length lead and cruised to the wire under a line drive in 1:57.1.

It was the third MASS win and seventh overall of the year for Double Dealing (\$4.60) and owner/breeder Ray Campbell Jr. George Ducharme trains the winner.

**Royal Envy** (RC Royalty—Temper Of Will) won her fourth straight MASS race after capturing the 2-year-old trotting

filly division. Me Too Baby (Matty Athearn) opened up a quick three-length lead on the field while Royal Envy sat fifth. But that was short lived as Shawn Gray came early behind Moni For Lindy (Scott Zeron) who was on the move in front of the stands. Moni For Lindy cleared at the half before Royal Envy crossed over for the lead past the five-eighths. With no serious challenge from behind, Gray line-drove Royal Envy from that point all the way to the wire where she won in 1:57.4, which was a new lifetime mark.

Royal Envy (\$4.00) now has four wins out of six lifetime starts for owners/breeders Al Ross and Ray Campbell Jr. The filly is also trained by George Ducharme.

Finally in the 3-year-old pacing filly group, **Ry's Red Rocket** (Sunshine Beach—Mo Molly Blue Chip) took no prisoners as Matty Athearn sent her to the front and she never looked back. Ry's Red Rocket tripped the timer in :26.4, :56.1 and 1:24.4 with Rojas Blue Chip (Drew Monti) right on her back, but her back was all the competition would see as Ry's Red Rocket turned for home and paced smartly to the wire on top by 1-1/4 lengths in 1:54.

Ry's Red Rocket (\$3.60) got her second stake win and sixth of the year for owner/breeder Linwood Higgins. Gretchen Athearn trains the winner.

#### **Mohawk Million to return in 2021**

After a successful inaugural edition, Woodbine Entertainment confirmed Tuesday (Oct. 27) that the Mohawk Million for 2-year-old trotters will return in 2021.

"We were very pleased with the support and execution of the inaugural Mohawk Million," said Jim Lawson, CEO of Woodbine Entertainment. "It is important for us to continue evolving and based on the results of the first Mohawk Million we're confident that we can start to build a legacy for this race that can have an immediate impact on many aspects of our industry."

The 2021 Mohawk Million will continue to follow a "buy-in" formula with a few minor changes made to the conditions.

A total of nine slots will be available for purchase, with the cost of each slot reduced from \$110,000 USD to \$100,000 CAD. The 10th and final slot will again be awarded to the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial.

The purse for the 2021 Mohawk Million will be \$1 million CAD.

Team Determination, who raced Donna Soprano and On A Streak in the inaugural Mohawk Million, has confirmed their intent to purchase a slot for the 2021 race.

"We are very pleased to support this initiative as it contributes to elevate our industry standards," said Team Determination in a statement to Woodbine Entertainment. "It encourages all of us, as industry stakeholders, to lead the way in Canadian horse breeding to achieve world class level."

The deadline to purchase a slot is Feb. 15, 2021 and \$50,000 (CAD) will be required with the submission of a slot contract. The remaining \$50,000 (CAD) is due June 1, 2021.

The inaugural Mohawk Million was recently contested on Sept. 26. Venerate, a son of French stallion Love You, won the inaugural edition for owners Pinkse Stables and Andy Miller Stable. The connections of the Julie Miller trained trotter negotiated a private deal to race Venerate in the slot of owner Brad Grant.

The date for the 2021 Mohawk Million will be confirmed and announced later this year.


