Loaded with intrigue, stage is set for Breeders Crown finals

A long year is starting to have an impact on the sport's stars.




Last weekend's elimination races weren't kind to most of the sport's top-rated horses, many of which were highlighted here in last week's column (full column here) as divisional locks or spoken to in favorable terms. One amusing message I received in response to the column was that the 2-year-old locks are a kiss of death and that the owners should sue me for jinxing. I must admit, it was rather uncanny.

For most of these horses, even the 2-year-olds, it's been a long season. A lot of things can and do change throughout the year, both physically and environmentally. Horses that were lesser-known commodities throughout much of the year are now top Breeders Crown contenders, and horses who carried the headlines for much of the year are now more suspect.

A solid case in point is that of Ambassador Hanover in the 3-year-old colt trotting division. He's clearly a nice enough horse and who was third in the Hambletonian as a big longshot, but for much of the year I don't think anyone would have considered him to be one of the leading contenders heading into his Breeders Crown final.

Following his sharp elimination win last week, even his trainer and driver Ake Svanstedt was left searching for words to describe the performance. In that post-race interview, Svanstedt said that



he was a little surprised by how sharp his colt was, and that he thought that's the best Ambassador Hanover has been. Conversely, in the same division, Jujubee entered his elimination on the heels of a record 1:49.3 win in the Kentucky Futurity, and lost.

That's just one example of not necessarily a division but also a Breeders Crown final that seemed like a sure thing a week that's now up for grabs as complexions have changed. Horses that seemed invincible no longer are. It's all the result of more

compelling elimination races than usual and sets the stage for what sets up to be 12 high quality Breeders Crown finals.

Trying not to jinx anyone, here are my thoughts for the races across tonight and Saturday.

FRIDAY, OCT. 29

Race 6, 2-year-old Colt Trot

BRANDED BY LINDY blew the doors off them last week in his Meadowlands pari-mutuel debut, and that was a continuation of the show that he put on in two races at the Red Mile. He's emerged as a star and will warrant heavy support. DOUBLE DECEIVER was making late gains though well after the matter had been decided, he's never raced worse than second when staying flat. REBUFF sat loose second over cover in his elimination but then ended up winning going away. TESTING TESTING faces tougher and loses Miller. DULY RESOLVED has thrown in a couple of good ones but also some surprising losses.

Race 7, 2-year-old Filly Pace

NIKI HILL went down in defeat for the first time in her elimination, but I think that can be forgiven. She went into a first-over grind for the second straight race, and this time it got her as she was able to eventually wear down the race pace setter but lost to the tripped-out pocket sitter. No real reason she can't make amends. QUEEN OF SUCCESS rallied from third-over a couple back against Niki and then pulled off the upset last week off the perfect trip engineered by McCarthy; was a longshot both times. DON'T FENCE ME IN accepted a bye into the final and should be fresh for Alagna. SEA SILK also saw her unbeaten streak come to an end last week and now has post 10, doesn't seem easy from out here for Page. GOTTHEGREENLIGHT got the second-over trip but didn't have enough in her elimination, does have Sears and the rail though.

Race 8, 2-year-old Filly Trot

Perhaps the biggest surprise of last week is Venerable breaking stride and not making this final. At the time she broke she was a length or so off LILBITALEXIS who took a lot of support that night and went onto win that elimination in good order. She's another 2-year-old trotter that carried her Lexington form through to her Crown elimination and looms a top contender. SELFIE QUEEN fought on through the lane even though passed and has appeal at a square price. DELILAH HANOVER was trotting a streak on the backside in her elimination, was pushed three-wide and still held well; upset possibility. RAISED BY LINDY beat LILBITALEXIS two back at Lexington and held off all comers last week. Sears goes with JOVIALITY S over Melander barn mate JAYA BAE.

Race 9, 2-year-old Colt Pace

What a race this shapes up to be. MONTE MIKI proved that his Metro win two back was no fluke when he was put on the front in his crown elimination and took them all the way to a career-best 1:50.4 score. I was surprised that HAMMERING HANK was bet so heavily in that same race, that being his first start in a month while stepping up. He looked like he was going past MONTE MIKI easily at three-quarters but was turned away through the lane. BEACH GLASS lost as the big favorite in his elimination, but it was a high quality try. He set fast fractions and it looked like he had shaken off SIX FEET APART towards the top of the lane, but that rival kept coming. In a further vote of confidence, Dave Miller goes to SIX FEET APART over GULF SHORES, who was excellent in his elimination splitting horses late and just missing to PEBBLE BEACH who got the jump on the second-over trip. EARLY ACTION fought off first-over pressure in

SATURDAY, OCT. 30

Race 4, 3-year-old Filly Pace

TEST OF FAITH returns off convincing wins in the Courageous Lady as well as two races in Lexington in which she beat most of these consecutively. Anything can happen but she's proven herself to be the one to beat. SCARLETT HANOVER tracked down TEST OF FAITH in the Jugette and now will try to do it again, this time on the big track; is re-united too with Tetrick. GRACE HILL held on in her elimination and won the Shady Daisy here in August. FIRE START HANOVER went a big trip last week from post 10 and fires almost every race, defending Breeders Crown champion. BLUE DIAMOND EYES was gradually getting into it from that same elimination.

Picks: Test of Faith, Grace Hill, Fire Start Hanover

Race 5, Mare Trot

ATLANTA got the job done last week in her elimination and seems well-positioned to secure her first Breeders Crown win in her illustrious career. She got the better trip in that race over WHEN DOVESCRY, though the latter stayed on well considering the parked-out trip. These two continue to seem a step above the others in this division. REFINED impressed upon arrival from Dayton and was moving fastest of all approaching the wire. HYPNOTIC AM qualified well in a race won by Forbidden Trade.

Picks: Atlanta, When Dovescry, Refined

Race 6, 3-year-old Colt Pace

Here comes the showdown between CHARLIE MAY and PERFECT STING! PERFECT STING never let the others get close in his elimination when he won convincingly in 1:49.2. Three races later CHARLIE MAY made a decisive move to the front and was kept to task winning in 1:49.1. The division could come down to this race! Not to be forgotten, ROCKYROAD HANOVER was closing last out with a :26.1 final quarter rally and owns a solid recent history here. SOUTHWIND GENDRY never threw in the towel last week. ABUCKABETT HANOVER surprised against these two back, capable when at his best.

Race 7, 3-year-old Filly Trot

Another top-notch matchup coming in this Breeders Crown too. BELLA BELLINI was far back with no cover flow whatsoever in her elimination and she still won despite it from what seemed like an improbable spot. Awaiting her is ALTAR, who's turned into an absolute killer for Takter. Of course, she broke when I selected in that race against Atlanta two back, but she couldn't have been any better last week in that 1:51.2 win. SHIRLEY GOODNESS deserves respect as the Indiana Sire Stakes champ. ITERATION may show speed to try to get into it early. HERCULISA made a good account for herself last week but lands post 10 for the second straight time.

Race 8, 3-year-old Colt Trot

JUJUBEE was one of the bigger surprises last week, losing at 20 cents on the dollar coming off that scorching 1:49.3 win in the Futurity. I hate to put too much stock into just one race, but there's no doubt he wasn't as strong as he had been in week's prior, especially considering the perfect trip. That said, he remains the one to beat. AMBASSADOR HANOVER was as sharp as ever on the front-end last week and he won his elimination a full second quicker than the other elimination; Svanstedt nearly quaranteed to have him on the front. CUATRO DE JULIO got a well-earned win last week when he was able to surge late from third over; one of many possibilities in here. FLY LIGHT offered late trot in his elimination from an impossible spot. DELAYED HANOVER appreciated the return to the Meadowlands and nearly pulled off the 30/1 shocker last week; last time Gingras drove him was in the Hambletonian final. DANCINGINTHEDARK M is suddenly a longshot; his very best would be good enough.

Race 9, Mare Pace

LYONS SENTINEL was another odds-on favorite that lost last week, though that effort seems forgivable. It didn't look like she was advancing much first over but eventually found a better gear late. It was only an elimination and one would think she'll be ready with the big money on the line. ROCKNIFICENT has now won two in a row and finally beat LYONS SENTINEL, will have to do it again when it counts more. That might have been the best race this year from PEAKY SNEAKY last out, almost tracking down ROCKNIFICENT who had the trip from the pocket. RACINE BELL was a supplement; I feel like she may have had more a chance against these earlier in the year. ROCKIN NOLA paced a fast third quarter last week before tiring. KEEP ROCKIN A may step back up one of these days; goes second start off the qualifier.

Race 10, Open Trot

ECURIE D DK couldn't have looked any better in his first impression at Lexington three weeks ago. He took all the money that

day and jogged upon arrival, anxious to see his follow-up act. BACK OF THE NECK was parked in the Allerage so toss that; prior to that he was a solid winner at Dayton and had been rounding back into top form. FORBIDDEN TRADE is always a presence. BEADS set a quick clip last out and is better than that.

Race 11, Open Pace

ALLYWAG HANOVER has been unbelievable the past few months and is suddenly a contender for Horse of the Year. He's beaten this deep group of FFA pacers repeatedly and any semblance of himself from prior races would keep the streak going. THIS IS THE PLAN was able to pick it up from fourth to track down stablemate CATTLEWASH in the nick of time last week. In that same race, ENAVANT was loaded with late pace in his first start over the track for connections that do very well here; could be dangerous. OCEAN ROCK looks like someone that might be overlooked but shouldn't be. He was on a tear heading into the Allerage before that race in which he brushed to the half in :51.3.

Breeders Crown triple treat

Roger Huston, Anthony Stabile and COSA-TV will provide some early Halloween treats for Breeders Crown fans this weekend.

The Hall of Fame "Voice" of harness racing, Huston, will make a special appearance at The Big M and call the first two Breeders Crown races both tonight (Oct. 29) and Saturday afternoon (Oct. 30).

"I was asked if I would do it and I said yes," said Huston. "I know how much these races mean to the owners, trainers, drivers and caretakers that have worked so hard all year and it's a big thrill for me to be part of their big day."

Huston's Crown connection goes back to the event's inaugural season and even though he has called over a dozen finals over the years, including all the 2- and 3-year-old races at Colonial Downs in 1998, his favorite will always be his first.

Even though it was a memorable competition, It's the behindthe-scenes things that made that race special to Huston.

"That year [1984] I was, more or less, the publicity director for Dragon's Lair," said Huston. "We kept touting him wherever he went as the horse from The Meadows and I made the statement numerous times that Dragon's Lair was the best 2-year-old pacer that year and that was going directly against Nihilator, of course.

"And when we got to Delaware (OH), Billy Haughton asked me 'Do you really think Dragon's Lair is better than Nihilator?' and I said 'Yes, Dragon's Lair will win the Breeders Crown.' And Billy said 'Well, we'll just have to wait and see.' And the rest is history."

Although this stat has never officially been kept, Huston, at 79, appears to be the oldest announcer to call a Crown race. In addition, he's called the Crown at multiple tracks, more than anyone else.





Announcing Breeders Crown races in the booth at The Meadowlands will also be special to Huston because it's where his protégé, the late Hall of Famer Sam McKee, called from.

"I know for a period of two years after he died, there would be times just in the middle of a horse race, I would all of a sudden think of Sam and for a while those were the toughest races to call," said Huston. "There was something special about Sam and I realized that from the get-go."

Anthony Stabile, co-host of the New York Racing Association (NYRA) pre-race show "Talking Horses," will join The Meadowlands' own Jessica Otten and provide handicapping and analysis for live coverage of the Saturday Crown races on Fox Sports 2 (FS2) and SportsNet New York (SNY).

Stabile, part of the Hambletonian broadcast on "America's Day at the Races" at Saratoga, may work for the thoroughbreds, but his first love was harness racing.

"Some of my first memories of the racetrack were at Roosevelt Raceway," said Stabile.

You had to be at least 6-years-old to get into Roosevelt, and even though Stabile was only 3, his parents managed to smuggle him in.

As an adult, Stabile still knows his way around a harness track, having participated in more than half a dozen exhibition races at Goshen Historic Track, Monticello Raceway and Yonkers Raceway.

"When you consider the Breeders Crown is this weekend followed by thoroughbred racing's biggest weekend, the Breeders' Cup, it's a great time of year for racing and I look forward to being part of all the Saturday action for the Breeders Crown," said Stabile.

The Breeders Crown broadcast on FS2 is from 12:30-4 p.m. while SNY's coverage goes from 3-5:30 p.m.

The Central Ontario Standardbred Association (COSA) will have its COSA-TV at The Meadowlands for the Breeders Crown doing their first live shows outside of Ontario.

COSA-TV was launched in 2019 as a way to help Ontario racing increase its fanbase and provide valuable content to their followers.

"To get people interested they've got to be fans before they're bettors," said COSA president Bill O'Donnell. "And that's what I thought with this COSA-TV thing. We have some marketing money, let's put it to use rather than buying a bunch of hats and t-shirts, let's get it out there to people on those platforms and it's kind of a brand now."

Curtis MacDonald will produce the live broadcast with host Greg Blanchard. Otten will co-host tonight with Michael Carter in the paddock, while on Saturday, Carter will move into the co-host chair with Otten occasionally adding some paddock content.

"Our goal isn't to duplicate what [The Meadowlands' in-house show] is already doing," said MacDonald. "We're not focused on handicapping and giving people tickets to bet. We're focused on

people in the paddock and giving some exposure to the people that don't typically get it in the paddock with the horses. It's something completely different and more of an entertainment thing than anything."

Sweden's ATG will be taking wagering on the entire Saturday card and The Meadowlands' Facebook page and YouTube channel will show all the action live tonight and Saturday afternoon.





Trainer Brian Brown to send out three in the Crown freshman colt pace

Ohio conditioner looks for third Breeders Crown title from trio with Buckeye State connections.

We are not sure if trainer Brian Brown is an avid poker player, but he hopes to be holding three aces tonight (Oct. 29) at the Meadowlands in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown Final for 2-year-old colt pacers.

Brown will send out Gentle Giant (Post 1; 15-1 morning line), elimination winner Six Feet Apart (Post 4; 9-2) and Gulf Shores (Post 6; 8-1) – all three colts have a majority of Ohio-based owners.

Six Feet Apart used a gutsy stretch drive with David Miller in the bike to catch the heavily-favored Beach Glass in the second of three eliminations last Friday (Oct. 22). The Sweet Lou—Ideal Love colt tripped the timer in a lifetime best 1:50.2 in the half-length upset score.

"He came into the elimination in really good shape," said Brown. "He raced good both weeks in Lexington. He had to come from behind the first week, off slow fractions, flew home and still couldn't catch them. He had a better trip the second week. The fractions were better. The horse raced great. He was really good last week."

Six Feet Apart, who was purchased during day #2 of the 2020 Lexington Select Sale for just \$21,000, has made just eight starts



this season for his owners: Michael Dean Robinson (Lewis Center, OH), Robert Mondillo (Delaware, OH), David Meola (Powell, OH) and Rich Lombardo Racing (Solon, OH).

The colt started his career with five straight starts in the second level Kentucky Commonwealth Series.

"He got a late start, but the plan was to just to stay in the Kentucky (Commonwealth) Series. David (Miller) was actually the one who talked us into staying in that series," said Brown. "He suggested that we bring him along slower and to teach him how to race without over doing it every week. It's worked out perfect."

The Crown elimination win was his fifth of the season and increased his 2021 earnings to \$93,225.

In last Friday's first elimination, Miller guided Gentle Giant to a solid third place finish using a final quarter in :26.4.

"I was very happy with his race last week. He can finish well, but he's not a great sprinter," said Brown. "I think that if the race sets up different for him, better fractions, he'll race even better this weekend."

Country Club Acres (Findlay, OH), Acadia Farms (Canfield, OH), Joe Sbrocco (Brecksville, OH) and In The Gym & Lombardo Racing (Solon, OH) own the JK Endofanera–Miss Liz colt, who was a \$50,000 purchase from the Hoosier Select Sale.

Gentle Giant raced exclusively in the Hoosier State – the Indiana Sire Stakes and Fox Stakes — until his elimination effort.

"We made a shoeing change a little over a month ago. He just kept getting better and better every week from there. It made him a much better horse," said the trainer. "He went to four aluminum shoes and I take it that he got a hold of the track better. He's really come around."

In the final elimination, Gulf Shores used a patient drive from David Miller, needing to split rivals in the stretch to advance to the \$600,000 final with a scant nose loss to Pebble Beach in 1:51.3.

The Downbytheseaside–Western Drag colt started the season a perfect six-for-six and won the \$300,000 Ohio Sire Stake Championship before taking on Grand Circuit company at

Lexington and the Meadowlands.

"He was really good last week, but David told me to open his bridle up – an eye hood with holes on. He said that when he started through he thought for sure he was going right through (that hole)."

Gulf Shores was hammered down for \$100,000 on the fifth and final day of the 2020 Lexington Select Sale.

He has earned \$358,967 for Country Club Acres (Findlay, OH), Diamond Creek Racing (Wellsville, PA) and Wingfield Brothers (Kenton, OH).

Long-time Brown patrons, Country Club Acres will have a total of four entries in the freshman colt pace final – Gulf Shores, Gentle Giant, Pebble Beach (Post 3; 3-1) and I Did It Myway (Post 5; 15-1).

With Miller piloting all three of the advancing Brown trainees, the Hall of Fame reinsman needed to make a decision on which to drive in the final. Miller elected to stay with Six Feet Apart, opening opportunities for Yannick Gingras with Gulf Shores and

Leading Mohawk owner Brad Grant sends out six Breeders Crown finalists

But the man from Milton, ON said he might be cheering hardest for super trotting mare Atlanta to earn her first Crown.

Brad Grant, one of Woodbine Mohawk Park's perennial leading owners, will send out six horses this weekend in Breeders Crown finals at The Meadowlands racetrack in New Jersey, but he will be rooting especially hard for his star six-year-old trotting mare Atlanta to earn her first Crown.

In fact, it's the reason Grant, from Milton, ON, and his U.S. ownership partners — Crawford Farms and Howard Taylor — along with trainer Ron Burke, opted to put Atlanta in Saturday's (Oct. 30) \$300,000 Crown final for trotting mares (race 5, post 2). In both 2020 and 2019, Atlanta finished third racing against the boys in the more lucrative open trot.

"This is a mare that is one of the greatest and she deserves to have a Breeders Crown on her resume and she does not have one. So, we all believe the right spot for her was in with her own. Hopefully, she will get it done," Grant said of the 2018 Hambletonian winner who has earned just shy of \$3 million (U.S.) in her career. "This is the last big race that I can think of that she hasn't won. It's not going to change her status if she doesn't, but, again, if there's anybody that deserves to have a Breeders Crown on her resume, it's her."

In that same mare trot, Grant, and partners will also send out his other Hambletonian-winning filly Ramona Hill, who was a Breeders Crown winner at age two. Now four, the mare has spent most of the year injured, but trainer Tony Alagna has her in good form lately.

"Tony has done a great job nursing Ramona (Hill) along... I thought she raced outstanding the other night coming three and four-wide off the turn and come from back in the field to finish fifth (in her Crown elimination)," Grant said. "I was really, really pleased with her. She's drawn a decent position (post 5). Hopefully, she can get spotted and we'll see what happens from there."



The Breeders Crown is being split between an evening card on Friday (Oct. 29) for the four freshman finals that starts at 6:20 p.m. (Eastern) and an afternoon card on Saturday for the remaining eight sophomore and older events that begins at noon.

Grant, who entered seven horses in Crown eliminations and qualified all but one for the finals, is the lone owner of 2-year-old trotting colt Gigondas, who races tonight (race 6, post 5).

"I bought him probably two starts in. Tony (Alagna) was pretty high on him. We didn't have a great start with him. I think we had three or four fifths in a row and then we won a race. Tony kept saying, 'Be patient, Brad,' and I used to say, 'I'm not a doctor. Doctors have patients.' We would laugh about it and he would say, 'He's getting better, he's getting better.' He continues to race better and better. He raced really well in his elimination. Again, he's in tough, but he finished second in his elimination, so I guess that gives him the opportunity," Grant said.

Grant's other five Crown finalists race Saturday. Apart from Atlanta and Ramona Hill, he is partners on sophomore pacing filly Notorious Pink and 3-year-old pacing colt Rockyroad Hanover and owns open trot finalist It's Academic solo.

"It's Academic is probably in over his head," Grant said. "I bought him at the Lexington Mixed Sale a year ago and I bought him just to bring up (to Woodbine Mohawk Park) as a racehorse to race in the preferreds. If there's something good that came out of the pandemic, when Woodbine Mohawk Park shut down, I shipped him back to Ronnie (Burke) and the rest of the year has been history. He's just raced outstanding. He's probably raced over his head. Ron and his team have done a tremendous job in getting the most out of him this year, so Ron thought he deserved a shot, so we put him in."

Lifetime, Grant has three Breeders Crown victories. He won his first when Stay Hungry triumphed in 2017 at Harrah's Hoosier Park and took two more on his home turf at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 2019 when Ramona Hill and Reflect With Me both won.

Grant said he can't be in New Jersey for tonight's races, but he is planning to be there for the Saturday card.

"Winning a couple of times (this year) would be nice," he said.

Woodbine Mohawk Park regulars are well represented in the 12 Crown finals. Among drivers, four will be driven by leading reinsman James MacDonald, three by Bob McClure, two by Paul MacDonell and one by Trevor Henry. Ten horses are trained by Woodbine regulars, including four by Luc Blais for the Determination Stable and two by Robert Fellows. Multiple horses, beyond Grant, feature ownership by Canadians that race regularly at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Apart from Determination's four horses, Canadian native Robert LeBlanc has four finalists, John Fielding has two and Threelyonsracing has two.

Numerous Crown contenders among 2-year-old pacers

Noel Daley thinks he has one of the horses capable of winning tonight's (Oct. 29) \$600,000 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old male pacers at The Meadowlands. He also thinks he is not alone.

Daley-trained Pebble Beach was one of three elimination winners last week, along with Monte Miki and Six Feet Apart. They lead a group of 10 Breeders Crown finalists that have combined to win 51 races and hit the board in 73 of 81 starts.

"I think it's a very competitive race," Daley said. "To me, it looks like there are six or seven real legit horses in there. That's going to be a good race.

"That might help (Pebble Beach) because he's not going to be the target for anybody. I think he can outsprint all of them, it's just a matter of the trip."

Pebble Beach, by Downbytheseaside out of Santa Rosa, has won seven of 10 races and finished no worse than third. He has two second-place finishes, by a neck to Caviart Camden in a world-record 1:48.3 mile, and by a head to Early Action in a division of the Bluegrass Stakes. His victories include the Kentucky Sire Stakes championship and a division of the International Stallion Stakes.

He will start the Breeders Crown from post three with driver Todd McCarthy. He won his elimination by a nose over Gulf Shores in 1:51.3.

"I was happy with him," said Daley, who trains Pebble Beach for Patricia Stable, Joe Sbrocco, Country Club Acres, and LA Express & JAF Racing. "He goes to them really quickly, but he seems to pull up once he gets to the front and can't see anybody. Todd said once he got the horses fighting back, he kicked on again.

"We only have one pacing colt, and it's him, so he's done a good

job for us. He's got a real good attitude. He's good to be around, a good-feeling horse. And he's got the will to do it."

Monte Miki, trained by Mark Evers, has won five of six races and finished third in his defeat. His victories include the Metro Pace. The son of Always B Miki—Montenegro will start Friday from post two with Scott Zeron driving for owner Velocity Standardbreds. He won his elimination by a half-length over Hammering Hank in 1:50.4.

"When you stand beside him, he's a gorgeous horse, beautiful stature," Zeron said. "If anything, he's a little immature. Mark did a great job changing up his bridle to a can't-see-back from a closed. When I was on the front with the can't-see-back, the second he saw someone he fought back. He's on top of his game. To come and do this (in his elimination) really showed me he is a good horse."

Six Feet Apart is one of three finalists for trainer Brian Brown, who saw Gulf Shores and Gentle Giant also advance. Six Feet Apart, a son of Sweet Lou—Ideal Love, won his elimination by a half-length over Beach Glass in 1:50.2 with David Miller in the sulky. He will start the final from post four.

The colt has won five of eight races, with one second and one third. His wins include the Kentucky Commonwealth Series final. He is owned by Michael Dean Robinson, Bob Mondillo, David Meola, and Rich Lombardo Racing.

"David started that horse out in Lexington, and he talked us into staying in the (Kentucky Commonwealth Series)," Brown said. "He taught him how to race, never over-raced him. He's not a big sprinter, but he's a good-trying horse. The horse never gives up. He's always finished good every time. I think he's a nice horse. He's just coming into his own. He's come on at the right time."

Gulf Shores, the Ohio Sire Stakes champion, and Gentle Giant will start the final from posts six and one, respectively. Brown

plans to make a bridle change on Gulf Shores, opening it up, following his narrow loss to Pebble Beach.

"I'm happy going in," Brown said. "We got a good post with all of them. You want to avoid the things that can go wrong; post is the first thing we avoided. We still need trips even though we have posts, but when you have good drivers, they usually take care of that."

DEEP GROUP OF 2-YEAR-OLD FEMALE PACERS VIE FOR CROWN

The field in tonight's \$600,000 Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old female pacers also is a deep group, with the 10 fillies combining for 51 wins and 74 top-three finishes in 87 races. Queen Of Success won last week's single elimination by three-quarters of a length in 1:50.3, handing runner-up Niki Hill and third-place Sea Silk their first losses of the season.

Queen Of Success, a daughter of Captaintreacherous out of Cashaway, has won five of eight starts. She was 10th in the She's A Great Lady Stakes, won by Niki Hill, at Woodbine Mohawk Park but bounced back with a second-place finish to Niki Hill in a division of the International Stallion Stakes in her race prior to the Breeders Crown elimination.

"She hit a few bumps in the road but her last start in Lexington when she was second to Niki Hill showed us that she was coming back to what we thought she was early," trainer Tony Alagna said. "The only time this filly showed a little chink in her armor was when we took her to Mohawk. She just didn't get over the track well, just wore herself out and was scrambling. I was a little concerned about the limestone here (in the elimination), but she was super."

Queen Of Success is owned by Alagna Racing, Caviart Farms, and Robert LeBlanc. She will start the Breeders Crown final from post five with driver Andy McCarthy. She is one of three finalists for Alagna, with bye recipient Dont Fence Me In and Boudoir Hanover.

Dont Fence Me In, who won the Kentucky Championship Series final, has four firsts, four seconds and a third in nine starts. The daughter of Captaintreacherous-Mystery Game will leave from post six on Friday.

"She's been very good, solid," Alagna said. "She had a great run in Kentucky, and she was very good qualifying (in 1:52.1 last week). She's matured a lot over the year, so I think she will have a nice year next year too hopefully. She's a nice filly."

Boudoir Hanover, by Captaintreacherous out of Bedroomconfessions, will start from post nine. She has won two of 10 races, including a division of the Bluegrass Stakes, where she beat Lyons Serenity.

"I'm very happy with my group," Alagna said.

Lyons Serenity, who has won seven of 10 races and finished second twice, also received a bye to the final. She will start from post eight for trainer Jim King Jr., who also sends out Captain Cowgirl in the final. Lyons Serenity counts the Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stakes among her triumphs. Captain Cowgirl was the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champ.

"I thought the bye would suit (Lyons Serenity) fine," King said. "She's a really good trainer; I can train her in racehorse time if I feel the need. I think she will be just as ready by not showing up as she would be if she did show up. And she couldn't get eliminated this way.

"(Captain Cowgirl) might be playing ball in the wrong park, or just a step above where I would like her to be, but she's a pretty nice filly. I'm certainly not ashamed of her. Both of mine in there, I don't feel like they're winners — I hope they do — but hopefully we can get paid. You can't win 'em if you're not in 'em. What better place to be than right here?"

Niki Hill, a five-time winner on the Grand Circuit in seven starts, will look to bounce back from post seven in the Breeders Crown final.

"First of all, they're all beatable," the filly's trainer, Chris Ryder, said. "She's very good, but they're all beatable. She got beat. Obviously, we didn't want to. That wasn't the idea at all. But she's a winner. That's the end of the story. She's a winner. It's not over yet.

"I knew she could go fast, and she is nice and solid. I told (owner Tom Hill), I don't know how fast she's going to go, but she's going to go pretty fast. She's been problem free."

This time, Alexis has landed the leading role.

Lilbitalexis, whose name is a reference to the song performed by character Alexis Rose during her failed *Cabaret* audition on the acclaimed Canadian sitcom *Schitt's Creek*, is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in tonight's \$600,000 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old female trotters. Lilbitalexis was one of two elimination winners last week, with the other, Raised By Lindy, the 3-1 second choice in the final.

A daughter of Walner out of Jolie De Vie, Lilbitalexis was bred by Keith Clark, Jeffery Ruch, and Daniel Phillips. It was Phillips' wife, Jacquie, who came up with the *Schitt's Creek*-inspired name. In the episode, Alexis Rose bills her Britney Spears-styled dance song as "the title track off of my critically reviewed, limited reality series, A Little Bit Alexis."

Feel free to sing along if you know the words.

"I wasn't a big follower of the show, but my wife is a big fan," said Daniel Phillips, who was among the owners of Berto Primo, the fourth-place finisher in the 2006 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old male trotters. "I've had pieces of a couple nice horses along the way, but this is the first really kind of special horse that we bred. So, we're excited. We'll be keeping our fingers crossed and pulling for the big filly. I'm nervous, but it's a lot of fun."

Lilbitalexis, trained by Richard "Nifty" Norman, has seven wins and a second in nine starts. She has five wins on the Grand Circuit, including a division of the Bluegrass Stakes earlier this month. She won her Breeders Crown elimination by 1-3/4 lengths over Selfie Queen in 1:53.3. She was the 9-5 second choice in the race behind previously unbeaten stablemate Venerable, who went off stride on the last turn.

"She got a good trip," Norman said. "It worked out nice and she was pretty strong. That's the best trip she's had, a nice two-hole trip, so that was good.

"She's fast. She's just flat-out fast. And she's good gaited. She's a nice filly."

As for Venerable's miscue, Norman said, "I don't really know. It's just unfortunate. I think she was a little keen and (driver David Miller) was just trying to calm her down and she was wanting to get going too much on the turn there and made a mistake."

Lilbitalexis, owned by Pinske Stables and David Hoese, will start tonight from post three with driver Dexter Dunn. Norman also will send out Delilah Hanover, who was fourth in the elimination won by Raised By Lindy. She is 12-1 on the morning line and leaves from post four with Todd McCarthy.



Raised By Lindy, a daughter of Walner out of Birthright trained by Domenico Cecere, will start from post five with Yannick Gingras. She brings a three-race win streak to the final and has won five of nine races overall for owner Lindy Farms of Connecticut. She won her elimination by 1-1/4 lengths over Joviality S in 1:54.4.

"I'm very happy with how she raced," Cecere said. "This, I think, is the second time she raced on the lead, and she's been learning a lot. It looks like she has developed into a very nice filly. I think we are in good shape. She has a lot of speed. You can see it. And her mind now, she is in a very good place. In the beginning when we started, she was anxious to do everything quick. But we did a good job to get her to settle down. When you have the head, the brain, in the right place, we see the speed is there, that's the best thing."

Joviality S, the New York Sire Stakes champion and Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stakes winner, saw a five-race win streak halted with the loss in her elimination. One of two Marcus Melander-trained entries in the final, with Jaya Bae, she is the 9-2 third choice.

A son of Chapter Seven out of The Lindy Label, Branded By Lindy has won eight of 10 starts for owner Lindy Farms of Connecticut. His triumphs included divisions of the Bluegrass and International Stallion stakes and the Kentucky Commonwealth Series final.

He won his Breeders Crown elimination by 2-3/4 lengths over Kentucky Championship Series winner Double Deceiver in 1:53.

"We always thought he was a nice horse," Cecere said. "We had a little bit of early issues. It wasn't much. He just really wasn't strong yet. When we moved to Lexington, he started to get stronger and stronger. He showed me in Lexington that he was the real deal.

"He's a nice horse, a great horse. He is making our job much easier. I don't think we saw the end of the tank. Now, we dream for (the final)."

Lucas Wallin-trained Rebuff, who won his elimination by 2-1/4 lengths over Gigondas in 1:53.4, is the 4-1 second choice followed by Testing Testing, who captured his elim by 1-1/4 lengths over Majestic J in 1:53.4, at 5-1. George Ducharme, who trains Testing Testing, entered Wednesday with 999 career victories.

Testing Testing, a son of Walner—Sound Check, will start from post two with Andy McCarthy. He has won four of seven races for owners Bill Donovan, Purnel & Libby, Joe Sbrocco, and Jim Winske.



Perfect Sting and Charlie May both won a Breeders Crown elimination for 3-year-old male pacers, and their connections will be looking for another victory in Saturday afternoon's (Oct. 30) \$600,000 final at The Meadowlands with the hopes of taking control of the division.

Racing begins at noon Saturday at the Big M and features eight Breeders Crown finals for horses ages 3 and up.

Charlie May is ranked No. 10 in this week's Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll with 71 points. Perfect Sting sits right behind with 64 points. No other 3-year-old male pacer received more than one point.

Perfect Sting, who won his elimination last week by three lengths over Chase H Hanover in 1:49.2 is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the final. Charlie May, who took his elim by three-quarters of a length over Southwind Gendry in 1:49.1, is the 3-1 second choice.

"We're really looking forward to the Perfect Sting showdown," said Don Tiger, who bred and owns Charlie May.

Said Joe Holloway, who trains Perfect Sting, "I've had some success (in the Breeders Crown), but this would be extra special."

Perfect Sting won last year's Breeders Crown for 2-year-old male pacers in a dead heat with Summa Cum Laude. It was the first dead heat for win in Breeders Crown history. He finished the season 10-for-10 and received the Dan Patch Award for 2-year-old male pacers.

This year, the son of Always B Miki—Shebestingin has won six of 15 races, finished second on eight occasions, and third once for Holloway and regular driver David Miller. His earnings of

\$973,847 top all horses in North America.

His second-place finishes this season include six in races worth more than \$275,000: the North America Cup, Meadowlands Pace, Tattersalls Pace, Little Brown Jug, Max C. Hempt Memorial, and Cane Pace. Two of those losses have been by a nose, one by a neck. He has never been beaten by more than three-quarters of a length.

"Like I tell David, he's six feet from greatness," Holloway said. "There could be another million dollars on his card if you just give us six feet."

Perfect Sting, who is owned by breeders Brittany Farms and Val D'Or Farms, will start Saturday from post five. He will attempt to become the first male pacer to win Breeders Crown trophies at ages 2 and 3 since Artiscape in 1997-98.

"That would cap it off," said Holloway, who has won eight Breeders Crown trophies in his Hall of Fame career. "I'll explain to him that if he wins this, he doesn't have to see a harness again."

Holloway, who recently made a bridle change with Perfect Sting, was pleased with the colt's performance in his elimination.

"That's the best he's been since his first qualifier this year," Holloway said. "It was the only time I've breathed easy since he's raced all year.

"He got home well. He paced through the wire strong, so I was happy to see that."

Charlie May, a son of McArdle-Stipple Hanover trained by Steve Carter and driven by Brett Miller, has won nine of 18 races this season and finished second five times. He has earned \$622,025, which is good for second among all 3-year-old male pacers.

He did not race in last year's Breeders Crown, when he won seven of nine races, finished second twice, and was named Ohio's best 2-year-old male pacer.

"I expect him to finish up the year with a bang," said Carter, who is appearing in his first Breeders Crown. "I was really confident

when I came out because he's in really good form. He's a great horse. He shows up every time he's behind the gate."

Charlie May's wins this year include the Carl Milstein Memorial at Northfield Park, where his 1:48.4 mile was the fastest ever by a 3-year-old on a half-mile track. He also won a division of the Bluegrass Stakes, with Perfect Sting finishing second. He was first across the wire in the Meadowlands Pace but placed ninth for interference.

The gelding added Lasix after losing the Ohio Sire Stakes championship in early September.

"It was unexpected to lose that, and unexpected that he bled," Carter said. "That was really a disappointing loss for me. But he's bounced back and raced good."

In his start prior to the Breeders Crown elimination, Charlie May finished fourth in the Tattersalls Pace. He was seventh, five lengths off the lead, at three-quarters but came home in :25.4 to end up only a length behind winner Abuckabett Hanover.

"He was in an impossible spot," Tiger said. "This is going to sound crazy, but that was the best he ever raced. Brett and I spoke after the race, and he said he was phenomenal.

"He's a beast."

Southwind Gendry and Abuckabett Hanover join Perfect Sting as the only returning Breeders Crown finalists from last year. Southwind Gendry will start Saturday from post one and is the 5-1 third choice. Abuckabett Hanover, leaving from post four, is 6-1. He was third in Perfect Sting's elimination.

Cane Pace winner Rockyroad Hanover is the only other horse with single-digit odds. He is 8-1 and will start from post seven after finishing third in the elimination won by Charlie May.

The Breeders Crown for 3-year-old male pacers is race six Saturday, and the third of the eight Breeders Crown finals.

TEST OF FAITH AIMS TO MAINTAIN TOP STATUS

Brett Pelling-trained Test Of Faith, the No. 2-ranked horse in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll, will head to Saturday's \$600,000 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old female pacers at The Meadowlands as the 2-1 morning-line favorite.

A daughter of Art Major—Cannae Cammie, Test Of Faith has won 12 of 14 races this year and 20 of 23 lifetime, earning \$1.20 million. She has never finished worse than second.

Test Of Faith received a bye to the Breeders Crown final. Her most recent start was a track-record-equaling 1:50.2 triumph in the Courageous Lady Stakes at half-mile MGM Northfield Park on Oct. 16. It was her third consecutive win.

"She's very, very special," Pelling said prior to the race. "I think she's a bit of a freak. She's push-button, and she's bottomless. She's unreal."

Pelling has won 11 Breeders Crown trophies in his career, which is fifth most in the event's history despite a decade-long hiatus from training that ended in 2017.

Test Of Faith will start the Breeders Crown from post eight with driver David Miller. She did not race in last year's Breeders Crown for 2-year-old female pacers, which was won by Fire Start Hanover. Last week, the Richard "Nifty" Norman-trained Fire Start Hanover finished second by a head to stablemate Grace Hill in the Breeders Crown elimination.

Grace Hill, leaving from post five with Todd McCarthy, is the 7-2 second choice. Fire Start Hanover, starting from post nine with Dexter Dunn, is 4-1. The two fillies have combined to win 11 races in 2021 and nearly \$1 million.

"I thought Grace Hill was very good," said Norman, a six-time Breeders Crown winner. "She raced real tough and held off her stablemate and (third-place Blue Diamond Eyes) coming at her. She's been rock solid all year.

"Fire Start was very good too. She came first-over a long way. She drew nine, but Test Of Faith drew eight, so maybe she can get a trip behind her. She just has to get lucky. Her year has been pretty good. She hasn't done much wrong. Test Of Faith is just sort of better than her, but otherwise she's been solid."

Blue Diamond Eyes, who was beaten a neck in the elimination, will start from post seven with Yannick Gingras driving for trainer Ron Burke. She is 5-1.

"I raced her from the back, and she had good pace finishing, but I still don't think she's giving me a hundred percent," Gingras said. "I talked to Ronnie and we're going to do some equipment changes on her this week, and I really think it's going to help her.

"I think she is in a good spot. Post seven might not be ideal, but all the speed drew outside of her. Obviously, we're going to go forward to try to get position somewhere and then get a trip after that. It's a great group of fillies. Test Of Faith might be a little notch above the rest of them right now, but it's a horserace, and we're going to race."

The Breeders Crown for 3-year-old female pacers is race four Saturday, the first of the eight Breeders Crown finals.

Ecurie D aiming to complete multiple triples in Breeders Crown Open Trot

The horse is bred by a Frenchman, sired by an Italian stallion, originally registered in Denmark, developed in Norway, owned by Swedes and finally sent to the U.S. to take the world by storm. The only horse to be supplemented to the Breeders Crown open division for trotters this year, Ecurie D, has a truly international background.

With that kind of background, the horse naturally has an international pedigree with multiple Franco-American crosses. His pedigree is a mix of some of the best bloodlines in both Europe and North America. His sire, the recently deceased Infinitif, is an Italian-born son of Pine Chip out of the French-born half-millionaire Island Dream. His dam, To Soon, is by Muscles Yankee. Even though the second and third dams are unstarted, one should not be fooled into underestimating the genetic quality. Ecurie D hails, without doubt, from one of the best French maternal families. Five Euro millionaires trace their maternal line back to Ecurie D's fifth dam, the incomparable Dourga II. Best of these is probably Oyonnax, winner of the 2010 Prix d'Amerique. Another millionaire, Daguet Rapide, completely dominated the Italian 2000-crop at 3 and 4. A third, the speedy gelding Giesolo de Lou, is one of the only horses to ever beat Varenne fair and square. Another maternal family member, Indy de Vive, has also secured eternal fame – not as one of those five millionaires, but as sire of a certain Ready Cash.

In the trotting world, few things are as entertaining than intercontinental competition. After a one-year absence, another European-bred and born trotter has entered the open division of the Breeders Crown. Ecurie D has some impressive shoes to fill, but if he can notch up another win at the Meadowlands, he

will make it five out of ten for European-bred and born trotters, for a rather incredible 0.500 record against North American opposition.

Can Ecurie D make it three in a row?

Should Ecurie D indeed win, it will make it the third start and win in a row for a European trotter in the open division.

The last time was two years ago. Veteran superstar Bold Eagle made the journey across the Atlantic and had no problems asserting his superiority on a wet Canadian night of racing. The North American public surely didn't know what to think when Bold Eagle was high-strung and behaved in a rather unorthodox

In the race itself, though, the French legend behaved perfectly for Brian Sears. Despite Six Pack and Atlanta doing their best, Bold Eagle easily held off the North American challengers.

The French son of Ready Cash was the first European challenger in five years in the open division. Seven years ago, an 11-year-old-superstar wrapped up his fantastic career by winning this race. Commander Crowe, making his 106th start, went to the front at the half, and with some urging from Örjan Kihlström in the final stretch of the Meadowlands, held off Maven and Creatine to make it the 61st — and last — win of his illustrious career.

For the well-travelled Commander Crowe, it was a matter of third time lucky.

In 2012, Le Grand Blonde had a stellar season in Europe. At the half of that year's Breeders Crown, he looked to be on the way to more glory, sitting pretty in the lead with Chapter Seven parked outside. It was not to be, however, as Chapter Seven put on monster performance and Commander Crowe faded to third in the six-horse field at Woodbine Racetrack.

In 2011 at Woodbine, Commander Crowe and Rapide Lebel honorably defended the European colors in the Breeders Crown. Still, it was not quite good enough to beat San Pail, who narrowly defeated the European challengers. Randy Waples read the race correctly and sent San Pail forward early. That ensured Rapide Lebel, with Commander Crowe on his tail, had to travel on the outside of the Canadian star the whole race. San Pail got two lengths early in the final stretch, and even though the two French-trained horses inched closer and closer to San Pail at the end, it was too little, too late for Rapide Lebel and Commander Crowe.

Can Ecurie D make it three for Dubois?

There is of course a link between these last two European winners. Bold Eagle was bred by Jean-Etinne Dubois, son of the legendary Frenchman Jean-Pierre Dubois. Commander Crowe is a son, and physically quite a clone, of French stallion Juliano Star – the latter bred by Dubois senior. Ecurie D can give Jean-Pierre Dubois another Breeders Crown win as a breeder, as the 81-year-old Frenchman is the breeder of Ake Svanstedt's latest star.


Of course, Dubois is no stranger to breeding superstars – nor to breeding Breeders Crown winners. In the '90s, Dubois also bred trotters in partnership with Sandro Viani, through the latter's Italian stud farm Allevamento di Zenzalino. One of these Italian-bred horses would give Jean-Pierre Dubois a Breeders Crown-winning experience – though only as a breeder. Unsure of the horse's ability after a disqualification in his first career start, Dubois had sold the horse at 3. The horse should actually have been sold the previous year, as a deal to sell the then-2-year-old had been reached. However, when the x-ray in the subsequent veterinary checkup revealed a tiny chip in the right

rear fetlock, the buyer reneged on the deal.

A few years later, the trotter had blossomed into one of the all-time greats. When Varenne came to the Meadowlands in 2001, he provided Europe with its first victory in the Breeders Crown – and in irresistible fashion. Not only did he toy with the opposition, he won spectacularly in a new world record of 1:51.1. It was one of many highlights of a stellar career, and made the 2001 season a particular highlight. That year, Il Capitano won the Breeders Crown in addition to the Prix d'Amerique, the Elitlopp, the Lotteria, the biggest races in France, Sweden and Italy, respectively.

The only winner to be kidnapped

Varenne's victory would be the first of two Italian wins. Six years later, in 2007, Jan Nordin brought Equinox Bi to North America. The well-bred son of Valley Boss Bi and 1996 Breeders Crown winner Personal Banner was very talented but equally injury-prone, and only managed 27 starts in a career that spanned

four years.

The three starts he made in North America in the summer and fall of 2007 turned out to be his swansong. After a surprise second-place finish in the Nat Ray, he was placed first to win the Breeders Crown at Mohawk. Admittedly, there was an element of luck to that win since Corleone Kosmos was first across the wire, but was off stride in the process. Two weeks later, however, he won the Maple Leaf Classic to underline his credentials. That would, however, be Equinox Bi's final career start.

The following year, he would stand stud at Blue Chip Farms, but not without drama in-between: in early November 2007, Equinox Bi was kidnapped from the owners' farm in Italy. Despite no ransom being paid, the horse was returned unharmed one month later.

Dubois for six generations

Twenty years after Varenne, and 14 years after Equinox Bi, Ecurie D can give Dubois yet another Breeders Crown win. It would only be fitting, because Ecurie D is Dubois through and through.

Jean-Pierre Dubois acquired Ecurie D's fifth dam, the above-mentioned legendary Dourga II in 1981. In 1982, she was bred to High Echelon, who three years prior had given Dubois his first Prix d'Amerique win as a driver. The resulting foal, the mare Rangone, was one of the best fillies in her crop and crowned her career at four by winning the Grand Prix de l'UET, also known as the European Derby, naturally with Dubois as breeder, owner, trainer and driver. Through matings with Defi d'Aunou and Love You, two stallions both bred by Dubois, we arrive at See You Soon, Ecurie D's maternal grandmother. She was taken out of France and bred to Muscles Yankee at 3 to produce To Soon, the dam of Ecurie D. On the paternal side, Dubois bred Infinitif, the sire of Ecurie D. He also bred Infinitif's dam, Island Dream, and the Dubois family also bred her sire Coktail Jet, who is bred by his son Jean-Etienne.

In fact, Dubois, including his family, bred both parents, two of the four grandparents and three of the eight great-grandparents. Looking closely at Ecurie D's pedigree, we see that Dubois even bred two of the horses found in the sixth generation in Ecurie D's pedigree.

And finally some revenge...

Amid all the excellence and all the glory, Ecurie D can also provide some revenge. Despite the Dubois family's two wins as a breeder, they also have one loss. After all, before Varenne, European trotters had underperformed in the Breeders Crown.

In 2002, Stig-H Johansson brought Victory Tilly to the Breeders Crown, and the Swedish gelding was second favorite behind Fool's Goal. These two put in a lightning fast :26.4 opening. In the end, Fool's Gold was full of steam, while Victory Tilly faded to fourth. Two weeks later, the Swedish visitor got his revenge

in the Nat Ray in a world record 1:50.4.

The very first European horse in the Breeders Crown, however, was Coktail Jet in 1996. The French legend had already won the Prix d'Amerique and the Elitlopp that year, and travelled to the U.S. full of confidence after having won the Prix d'Europe two weeks prior. Nobody knew it at the time, but Coktail Jet would never win a race again. In the race, Jean-Etienne Dubois drove passively. He sat second last at the half and only attacked at the three-quarter pole. That proved very costly. Instead, it was CR Kay Suzie who triumphed with ease, while Coktail Jet was unable to make up much ground in the final stretch.

The one time the Dubois family could have won the Breeders Crown, both as a breeder and owner, they ended up finishing sixth. Now Ecurie D can provide another little bit of revenge. Not only that, with Ecurie D being 3x4 bred on Coktail Jet, it would be a win with a particular sweet aftertaste.

Carmichael, Gaskin inducted into Indiana Horse Racing Association Hall of Fame

The Indiana Horse Racing Association (IHRA) held its annual banquet to honor and induct two new members to the Hall of Fame on Sunday (Oct. 24) at Indiana Grand Racing & Casino. Dr. James Carmichael, inducted posthumously, and Ernie Gaskin were the 18th and 19th individuals added to the prestigious list of leaders who have worked tirelessly to promote and support horse racing in the state of Indiana. Rachel McLaughlin served as emcee for the ceremony.

Dr. James Carmichael, a long-time resident of Sullivan County, was a career advocate for Quarter Horse racing. The graduate of Purdue University School of Veterinary Medicine owned a veterinary practice in Sullivan, Ind. prior to his death in 2009. He was one of the initial members appointed to the Quarter Horse Breed Development Committee. Carmichael was instrumental

in developing the program for owners and breeders that has flourished over the past 25 years. He was later appointed to the Thoroughbred Breed Development Committee and was elected chairman.

Randy Beard, long-time friend of Carmichael, provided a look at Carmichael's career in racing and talked about how he joined his father, Eugene, at an early age to run Carmichael Stock Farm. The official resolution was read by Brian Elmore, also a native of Sullivan County and family friend, prior to the unveiling of the portrait of Carmichael.

Jan Carmichael, Jim's wife, accepted the award on behalf of Jim, and was joined by family members during the induction. Jan noted Jim's love of horses and his dedication to racing during his life.

"I want to thank the IHRA for this wonderful honor," said Jan. "Jim would have been so proud to see how racing has evolved in Indiana, and he would be so happy to be recognized for his involvement. He loved racing and horses so much. My family and I thank you for honoring him with this award."

Following the induction of Carmichael, Rick Moore, vice president and general manager of racing at Harrah's Hoosier Park, provided a look at Ernie Gaskin's life in racing. He arrived in Indiana in the early 1990s and it didn't take long for industry leaders to recognize his expertise and leadership in the sport. Gaskin was an initial member of the Standardbred Breed Development committee and brought a wealth of knowledge on racing from his days working as an assistant trainer for Billy Haughton, Hall of Fame driver and trainer.

Moore pointed out Gaskin's endless hours working to establish a breeding and racing program in the state as well as his work on related projects such as lobbying for casino gaming at racetracks, enhancing the breed development funding, and providing positive solutions to better the sport. Moore also noted Gaskin's success as a trainer in the state. He has two leading trainer titles to his credit at Harrah's Hoosier Park and conditioned four Indiana Sires Stakes champions in addition to hundreds of other horses that have prospered over the past 25 years.

Following the reading of the resolution by Moore, Gaskin was welcomed to the stage by a standing ovation before delivering an emotional heartfelt speech to the room.

"I have to thank my partner, my wife, Darla," said Gaskin. "She should be in this photo with me. She has worked so hard right along with me to make racing a success in Indiana. One thing I learned from Bill Haughton is 'surround yourself with good people' and wow, what a great group of people we have here in Indiana. We have come a long way in the program and there are so many people who helped along the way. I'm so very proud of where we are now and what we have all accomplished."

Both portraits of Carmichael and Gaskin were painted by artist Melinda Spear-Huff of Sheridan, Ind. They will join the other 17 portraits on IHRA Hall of Fame display on the Mezzanine at Indiana Grand Racing & Casino.
