Canadian Coronation on Crown opening night

Canadians figured prominently in the opening night of the Breeders Crown on Friday at Woodbine Mohawk Park that also renewed the battle between Hanover Shoe Farms and Brittany Farms. Even the weather was cooperative, for once.

For the first time in a long time, the Breeders Crown kicked off with a rain-free night and the Canadian locals made the most of the opportunity, figuring prominently in the first three of four freshman Crown finals on Friday (Oct. 28) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.



On a cool-yet-dry Ontario evening featuring \$3.24 million (Cdn) in Crown purses on the night - \$810,000 for each of the four Friday finals - the locals kicked off the night in the freshman trotting colt division a with maiden-breaking Crown victory for both driver Louis-Philippe Roy and nine-time defending O'Brien Award winning Trainer of the Year Richard Moreau.

Roy earned it, too, with a perfect steer of **Gaines Hanover** out of the less-than-advantageous one-hole, to edge favorite Celebrity Bambino at the wire in 1:53.2.

The driver told Mark McKelvie in the winner's circle that he felt he had put Gaines Hanover in position to win, but in midstretch his lingering thought was, "Please, win. We didn't do all that just for second."

That it was a victory by mostly Quebec connections was also particularly nice to see given La Belle Province's incredible harness racing history.

Not only did it spark a big night for local and Quebec connections, but it also fired up a big evening for breeder **Hanover Shoe Farms**, which scored back-to-back Crown wins and went over \$20 million in lifetime Breeders Crown earnings. Gaines Hanover's win, followed right after by **Sylvia Hanover's** triumph in the 2-year-old pacing filly final, gave Hanover its 25th and 26th Crown champions, which is the most all-time.

It was also back-to-back victories for Quebec ownership. Sylvia Hanover, trained by Mark Steacy, is owned by Tony Infilise's

Hudson Standardbred Stb. Inc. of Hudson, QC. It was Infilise's first Breeders Crown victory after more than 40 years of horse ownership.

The night also continued Hanover's epic battle with Brittany Farms for Crown supremacy. Gaines Hanover allowed Hanover Shoe Farms to tie Brittany in the total breeder trophy count with 28. Hanover went ahead thanks to Sylvia Hanover's win in the very next race and then Brittany tied it back up at 29 with a win by homebred **Special Way** in the 2-year-old filly trot final.

However, Special Way helped George Segal's Brittany further solidify its lead as the top owner in Crown history.

Special Way is a homebred owned by Brittany (based in Kentucky) and Toronto's Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld — that's where the third straight winning locals comes in. She was driven to victory by her trainer, Ake Svanstedt.

Trainer Shawn Steacy was part of a parade of Canadian Crown winners in the first three championship events. His trainee Sylvia Hanover won the 2-year-old pacing filly title. For Brittany, Special Way is their 19th champion as an owner. Those 19 champions have produced 22 Breeders Crown triumphs. Brittany is also the leading owner by earnings in Crown history.

It was the 14th champion and 15th trophy for Katz and the ninth champion and 10th trophy for Libfeld.

A Breeders Crown trophy seems like a terrific reward for the good work of Katz and Libfeld. Earlier in the evening, it was announced that the Breeders Crown Charity Challenge has raised a whopping \$1.4 million for local charities in Crown host cities since Katz and Libfeld started it in 2019, the last time the Crown was held at Mohawk.

If all that wasn't enough excitement for one night, the Crown events ended with a bang.

Ammo posted a 52-1 shocker from post nine in the 2-year-old pacing colts' final. The upset — which broke up the Canadians' hope for a sweep of the night — was orchestrated by Hall of Famer David Miller for Hall of Fame trainer Joe Holloway and U.S. owners Val D'Or Farms and Ted Gewertz.

It was the 30th Crown win for Miller, the 10th by Holloway (and fourth in this division alone), the ninth by Gewertz and the sixth by Val D'Or Farms.

As for Ammo's breeder, Sergent Stables of Pennsylvania, it was a Breeders Crown first.

Spotlight on the winning **Breeders** Crown **breeders**

When a breeder sends their yearling through the sale ring, many want to see a good price, but just as important is where they go. Get them in the right hands and they stand a chance of flourishing. Friday evening (Oct. 28), four new Breeders Crown winners were crowned at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The breeders behind each newly-minted champion had plenty of reasons to celebrate.

Perennial powerhouse breeder **Hanover Shoe Farms** entered the 2022 Breeders Crown leading in nearly all major categories. The Pennsylvania-based operation extended their record of champions bred when Gaines Hanover captured the \$810,000 final for freshman trotting colts, scoring for driver Louis-Philippe Roy in 1:53.1. The gelded son of Cantab Hall—Gatka Hanover is the farm's 25th Crown champion. The victory also delivered a 28th overall trophy, allowing Hanover to draw even with Brittany Farms in the category.

Last November, Gaines Hanover sold for a \$50,000 price tag at Harrisburg. Entering the final with \$88,851 on his card, the freshman delivered a handsome return and Breeders Crown championship for his connections. For Hanover, the win provided a major update in the pedigree of Good Faith Hanover, a Greenshoe filly that sells on the first day at Harrisburg this year. The fifth foal from the Muscle Massive mare is cataloged as Hip 63 in the consignment.

The night's seventh race, the \$810,000 final for 2-year-old pacing fillies, pushed Hanover over \$20 million in Crown earnings when Sylvia Hanover prevailed in a time of 1:51.1. The Always B Miki – Shyaway filly sold for \$135,000 last fall at Harrisburg, purchased by Hudson Standardbred Stb Inc. Under the tutelage of Shawn Steacy, the freshman has won eight of nine starts with earnings just shy of \$800,000. More importantly, she staked her claim to year-end divisional honors.

After matching Brittany Farms one race earlier, the victory temporarily moved Hanover into sole possession of the record for Crown trophies with 29 to their credit. Like Gaines Hanover, a sibling to Sylvia Hanover is set to sell next month. Sula Hanover, a Downbytheseaside sister, is consigned to Harrisburg as Hip 131. Shyaway had already produced a Breeders Crown elimination winner in Western Fame prior to Sylvia Hanover's championship win.

George Segal said Friday night that each year his **Brittany Farms** this time in partnership with Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld – selects a trotting filly or two at the farm to put in training.





His comments came in the winner's circle following homebred Special Way's triumph in the \$810,000 Breeders Crown final for freshman fillies. The Walner—Special Hill 2-year-old captured the championship event in a track and Canadian record 1:52 performance.

The victory added yet another piece of Crown hardware for the trio of owners/breeders, who have each tasted multiple victories in one of the sports marquee events. As a breeder, Special Way represents Brittany Farms' 21st champion and 29th Breeders Crown trophy, matching Hanover's mark established one race earlier. As an owner, Brittany Farms leads all in the category with 19 champions, 22 trophies and in excess of \$9 million in earnings.

Katz has bred four Breeders Crown champions, all trotting fillies, winning five trophies. As an owner, he has won 15 trophies with 14 champions. He ranks fifth among owners, surpassing \$6 million in earnings with the latest victory. Libfeld is now credited with breeding six Crown champions that have won seven trophies. As an owner, he has reached the winner's circle with nine different horses, winning 10 trophies in total.

While the first three championships produced winners bred by farms with lengthy Crown resumes, the \$810,000 final for freshman pacing colts saw new blood represented. When Ammo and driver David Miller shocked the field at 52-1, the victory secured a first trophy for breeder **Sergent Stables LLC**. The Blairsville, PA farm had one prior Breeders Crown finalist heading into Friday night. Always A Miki finished sixth in the 2-year-old colt pace final at Harrah's Hoosier Park in 2020. Ammo, a \$90,000 purchase last October at Lexington, is Always A Miki's Sweet Lou brother. His full-sister, Sweet Gal, brought \$125,000 in this year's second session.

Earlier in the program, McSeaside, also bred by Sergent Stables and Andray Farm, finished ninth in the Crown final for pacing fillies.



Popular local victory for Gaines Hanover in freshman trotting colt Crown final

Gaines Hanover kicked off the 2022 Breeders Crown on Friday night (Oct. 28) at Woodbine Mohawk Park and scored an impressive victory in the \$810,000 final for 2-year-old trotting colts. The victory gave his driver, Louis-Philippe Roy, and trainer, Richard Moreau their first Crown victories in their careers.

Oh Well, the winner of the Mohawk Million last month at the Campbellville track, made a break as the gate left for tonight's Crown opener. Dave Miller had Dire Straits up to the top from post 10 and hit the first quarter in :27.2. He was passed by Kilmister and Brian Sears just past that point and they trotted by the half in a tepid :57.

Down the backside, Yannick Gingras had the favorite Celebrity Bambino in full stride in the outer lane and was neck and neck with the leader at the 1:25.4 three-quarters. Celebrity Bambino

took over the lead mid-stretch but Roy and Gaines

Hanover, who had followed them in the outer

flow, tipped off cover and went on by to win in 1:53.2. Celebrity Bambino held for second with Kilmister third.

Roy and Moreau are both multiple O'Brien Award winners as the best driver and trainer in Canada respectively for several seasons, but they had yet to put a Breeders Crown trophy on their mantles until tonight and were thrilled with the

outcome.

"It was great, the trip felt pretty good. I just had in my mind I said, 'Please win. We didn't do all that just for a second.' It was just a great moment," said Roy who said he was thrilled with the trip he was able to work out for Gaines.

"I feel like Yannick was the same way as me, we didn't want anyone in front to have too easy fractions, but we didn't want to have to use our horses too early. He knew he had a pretty good horse on his backside and he didn't want to tow me in too early. I think he drove his perfectly but mine when he showed up was a little bit better."

Coming into the race Roy noted his only concern was the post Gaines had drawn.

It was the first career Breeders Crown victory for driver Louis-Philippe Roy.

"The rail is a tough spot here; I didn't know how it would turn out but it actually worked pretty well. I'm coming into the weekend with a few good drives and I never really had the chance to win a Breeders Crown before now so I'm just excited for the whole weekend."

A Cantab Hall gelding, Gaines Hanover is owned by Gestion Blais of Montreal. Bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, Gaines was purchased for \$50,000 at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's 2021 yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA. He is the fourth foal from Gatka Hanover, a winner of \$262,000 in her career.

Gaines Hanover, who won his Crown elimination by two lengths last weekend, now has four wins, a second and a third in eight starts so far in his young career. He came into the contest with just under \$90,000 on his card but now has an additional \$405,000 in his bank account.

"Actually, I fully intended to just come from off cover with her. I figured second over, third over, with the inside forward leave," said McClure. "I knew there would be a couple leavers from the outside, but I got up on the gate and then some of the outside horses were pushing out and I couldn't get away seventh or eighth and give them that advantage, so I decided to try my luck at that trip again and she got caught again. And luckily, we got really lucky. I wouldn't call it any skill, I just got extremely lucky to get out.

"From the three-quarter pole on, there's no driving her. She gives you everything she's got. She's great leaving the gate, it's just that middle half. You can sit there and knock her down for that trait and the odd trait – she is finicky, she is lazy – but man, she definitely knows how to get her nose to the wire first. And she's proving it. If it weren't for the 11-hole one week, she would've been undefeated this year. I'm just extremely lucky to be along for the ride with her."

Ammo fires off 52-1 Breeders Crown shocker in the freshman pacing colt division

Ammo, sent on his way at 52-1, pulled off the stunning upset in Friday's (Oct. 28) \$810,000 Breeders Crown 2-year-old pacing colt final at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The tote board suggested Ammo didn't have much of a shot at taking all the spoils, but one of the sport's all-time top drivers had other ideas.


It was outsider Ervin Hanover, from the outside post, who swept across and to the front, as David Miller, in rein to Ammo, followed suit from post nine, and took up residence in second going into the first turn.

Ervin Hanover held a short-lived nose lead after an opening panel in :27.1, as Ammo was then sent to the front, only to be passed by Combustion, who held a two-length advantage through a half in :56. Confederate, the popular 1-2 choice, sat eighth of 10.

Reaching three-quarters in 1:23.3, Combustion was three lengths clear of Stockade Seelster, now second, while Ammo, another quarter-length behind, dug in as the pace quickened down the lane. Miller had his charge rolling along the inside, while Confederate, to the far outside, was picking off rivals with every stride.

At the wire, Ammo staved off Confederate – both of them sons of Sweet Lou – to win by half-length in a time of 1:50.4. Combustion was third and Stockade Seelster finished fourth.

"I thought he raced well last week, and I thought racing him back in a week might suit him, and David just drove him great," said Holloway, who sent out history's first 1:50 2-year-old, in the 1998 Breeders Crown winning with Badlands Hanover. "And sometimes it works out. I tried to map it out for him [Miller] as best I could,

told him to do all that and then he just kind of handled it from the head of stretch home."

Not that Holloway needed to tell Miller what to do.

"Oh, I think he knows his way around there," quipped the Hall of Fame conditioner about the Hall of Fame driver.

It was just the fifth start for the bay colt owned by Val D Or Farms and Theodore Gewertz. Bred by Sergent Stables LLC, Ammo was a \$90,000 purchase (Hip No. 23) at the 2021 Lexington Select Sale.

Now 2-1-1 from five starts, Ammo, who came into the Crown final with just over \$38,000 in earnings, paid \$106 for the win.

Much at stake in tonight's Breeders Crown races

The eight Breeders Crown races to be contested tonight (Oct. 29) at Woodbine Mohawk Park are loaded with intrigue and have the potential to go a long way in determining divisional honors, as well as leaving horses with a lasting legacy. Here is my race-by-race rundown.

RACE 2 – BREEDERS CROWN MARE TROT

In what lines up to be the second to last race of her illustrious Hall of Fame career, Atlanta rates a live chance to capture what would be her first Breeders Crown win. She's rebounded nicely since the last time she raced here in September in the Maple Leaf Trot where she was over-raced, including a 1:50.3 win last out in the Allerage Farms in her final Red Mile appearance. She enjoyed the pocket ride in behind Next Level Stuff that day and was able to hold off familiar rival When Dovescry who tried to track her down from third that day. You'd think Atlanta will be looking to get the jump on Bella Bellini who hasn't fired her best in her last pair, but it's back to the big track now which will obviously suit her style much better.

RACE 3 – BREEDERS CROWN MARE PACE

It seems like Test Of Faith has been ripe for an upset in her couple of races, but it still hasn't mattered as she always has an answer and continues to always be the best in this group. Last week, longshot So Much More had room to rally up the inside and looked for a moment that she was going to sprint by but could never clear and missed by a nose. Mikala caught the eye late in that same race, coming on strong from last to close within a length and a half. Test Of Faith has had her number, but she continues to be close to that foe, just as she was in

the Milton elimination and final. Grace Hill came from last and weaved through traffic to somehow score in the other Breeders Crown elimination last week, doing it a in a pace-less race no less. A win or a second would take her over \$1 million for her career. Racine Bell probably should have lasted coming off that soft :56.4 half mile; goes second-time Sears and will be going forward early as usual.

RACE 4 – BREEDERS CROWN 3YOFT

In one of the premier matchups over the entire Breeders Crown event, Joviality and Jiggy Jog throw down in a race that could sway the division. Both were outstanding off the pace winners last week and for Joviality in particular, she came from further off the pace than she has maybe all year. Known mostly for her gate speed, she was reserved from well out of it and then exploded home to win going away over Misswalner Fashion who couldn't fend her off despite getting the two-hole ride. She still starts a couple slots to

the outside of Jiggy Jog, but won't be at as much of a disadvantage as she was two starts back when she had to start from the second tier. Like Joviality, Jiggy Jog closed in :26.2 last week and in doing so, stopped the clock in 1:51.2. She had open lengths to make up on Fashion Schooner who for a short while there, looked like she was in position to steal away but couldn't stop the late race onslaught of Jiggy Jog. Warrawee Xenia may have lost a bit of her luster in the last few weeks but she was loaded late last week after saving ground; McClure had to negotiate traffic and just missed second.

RACE 5 — BREEDERS CROWN 3YOFP

It's been quite a return for last year's divisional champ Niki Hill, as she's already notched wins in the Bluegrass and in the Glen Garnsey since returning from an injury sustained in May. That recent qualifier against Treacherous Dragon here at Woodbine Mohawk Park a week ago could have set up as a preview for the main event. In that morning race, Treacherous Dragon tracked from second, Zeron urged her on a bit to get on terms as Dunn gave some urging to Niki Hill before the matter had been settled late; post 10 may not make it easy. Treacherous Dragon was great as mentioned in that qualifier and makes her first start back since winning the Jugette; looks dangerous. Gallucci stablemates Silver Label and Prohibition Legal come off a 1-2 finish in their Ontario Sire Stakes Gold Super Final. Sea Silk gave way badly from the pocket after being used when last seen but can bounce back. Queen Of Success showed a new dimension last out and she was strong despite a shuffle; encouraging.

RACE 6 — BREEDERS CROWN 3YOCT

This division for 3-year-old male trotters has been one of the more wide open divisions all year, so it's no surprise that last week's Breeders Crown eliminations produced winners at odds of 7-1 and 28-1. The larger of the two upsetters, King Of The North, was last year's 2-year-old champion and last week's elimination win was his first victory of the year, coming in his 12th start. But he had been racing well in many races leading up to his elimination so it's not like that 1:51.1 lifetime best mile was a total shock. Donning headgear in victory last week with the "WW" emblem, champion thoroughbred trainer Wesley Ward is part of the ownership group for King Of The North, and he could be very much alive for a Breeders Crown-Breeders' Cup double in the week ahead. Cool Papa Bell was wildly overbet last week considering it was just an elimination race, and did well for himself to close from a hopeless spot which should serve him well for the final. He can a close a ton and it won't be easy from an outside post, but a win in this race just might be enough to give this year's Hambletonian winner divisional honors. Slay got the second-over trip in his elimination, but I think might have been caught a bit off guard by Double Deceiver deep to his inside who snuck up the rail from last. Slay was amazing here three back in winning the Canadian Trotting Classic; Double Deceiver could use another Miller Magic steer. Branded By Lindy gapped second-over cover early before finding his best stride late. Fast As The Wind seems to be in line for a good trip from the inside; could surprise in a wide open event.

RACE 7 – BREEDERS CROWN 3YOCP

In the glamour division, both odds-on favorites delivered as expected in their eliminations and sets the stage for what should be a thrilling race. Bythemissal continues to race on a tear, and I thought his win last week was scary. I don't think Page moved at all in the bike throughout the stretch; I guess he was that confident. Starting from post two, not only does he have the post advantage on his main adversary, but fellow stablemate Birthday lands the rail. It could make the strategic advantage that much more. Pebble Beach has now put together two straight wins after five straight runner-ups, and McCarthy had him on the front end last week earlier than usual. He's likely to be forwardly placed again as he looks to replicate his North America Cup success from this track earlier in the year. I Did It Myway tried hard to get to Bythemissal last week just as he tried hard when he rallied two back in Lexington against Pebble Beach; high quality horse may only need to be within striking distance turning for home. Ponda Warrior was extremely impressive last week in his elimination coming into Woodbine Mohawk by way of Hoosier Park. Indiana Sire-Stakes champion closed with a

ton of place in his elimination to just miss second; looks like him and Zeron got along well. Greatest Ending picks up a new driver in Gingras. Fourever Boy might have tailed off just a touch since early September.

RACE 8 – BREEDERS CROWN OPEN TROT

Fashion Frenzie has only lost a single time this year and it was in the Maple Leaf Trot, a race he was actively used in. Going for dangerous connections of Moreau and Roy, he was a two length winner a couple of weeks ago in the Open Handicap, and that was a race in which Forbidden Trade sat nicely right in behind him the entire way but couldn't make any real impression. A ton of credit should be given to Greg Wright Jr. on the work with Jujubee and the progression that last year's Breeders Crown winner has made since returning to races in September. His win last out in the Allerage was well deserved and is a major player once again. Back Of The Neck was powerful when last seen here at Woodbine Mohawk in the Maple Leaf Trot, a race he won surprisingly easy. He since followed that up with a similar off the pace score at Dayton and no disgrace whatsoever with his formidable try in the Yonkers International. Ecurie D went on a speed mission last out at Yonkers in a mile and a half race and folded. Of more importance now is the driver change to Dunn.

RACE 9 — BREEDERS CROWN OPEN PACE

The Breeders Crown main event is saved for Bulldog Hanover, and it's back to business with no longer having to toy with the idea of racing solely to break another speed mark. His and Dunn's focus now will be to win the Breeders Crown and lock up Horse of the Year, something that he'll be heavily favored to do as his season for the ages winds down. Give credit to Allywag Hanover for sticking right with Bulldog Hanover and moving past him; he always looked like a major threat every step of that race in the Allerage. His prior two races against Bulldog Hanover were horrific trips so it's not like his win was a total fluke; it's possible he could spring the upset again. Tattoo Artist has been thriving with James MacDonald driving; wasn't terribly outmatched against Bulldog Hanover in the Canadian Pacing Derby.

Twaddle hopes for a "Fourever" homecoming

The emotions are running high for trainer Tim Twaddle as he prepares his prized pupil Fourever Boy for tonight's \$600,000 Breeders Crown 3-year-old colt pace final at Woodbine Mohawk Park in Campbellville, ON.

"Anytime you get a chance to race in the big ones is exciting, but to do it with friends and family around, it makes it more special," said Twaddle. A former trainer and driver on Woodbine circuit (called the Ontario Jockey Club in those days), Twaddle is now based at The Meadows Racetrack in Washington, PA. Tonight, he will be joined by his older sister, Cindy, and his father, Robert, as well as his wife Sophie and his kids. His mom, Patricia, is in a nursing home and won't be able to attend.

It will be a bit bittersweet to Tim as he lost one of his biggest supporters, his sister, Robin, just over a year ago when she died suddenly after a brief illness. She worked in the hospitality industry, both at Woodbine and Mohawk Racetracks, and in the early days at Greenwood.



"She had a bird's-eye view of my career as it took off, and the downfalls, as well. She was a big fan,

and with all the limelight and the hoopla that goes with these big events, she'd be eating it up like ice cream. But she's with me all the time," he said emotionally.

Fourever Boy heads into the Breeders Crown final off a fourth-place finish in his elimination, which was disappointing to Tim, and he took every precaution to make sure his colt's health was good.

"I had trouble the last race at Lexington — he bled, I really didn't expect it. He's a Lasix horse, and we put him on it early in the year to help combat his allergy issues. It wasn't because he was a bad bleeder. In the Tattersalls Pace, he was flat," said Twaddle.

Fourever Boy had some time in the field before the elimination to heal, and trained pretty strong on Lasix at Mohawk last Tuesday.

"He was superb, and he scoped clean after that training."

On the Saturday after the elim, Tim felt the race was flat. He had his colt scoped again, and discovered heavy mucous.

"He had a real reason not to be great (in that race), and knowing what I know now, he did great to get to the final, so I'm happy about that."

With 20 starts this year, and a lot of traveling, Fourever Boy ships well and doesn't need to take his track with him.

"Even the best ones in the world, it takes a toll on them after a while, but he doesn't seem to show any signs of wear and tear. Even Dexter (Dunn) made the comment when we were going out of the paddock the other night how good he looks. To look at him, you'd never know he had 20 starts. He's alert, he's sharp. He feels good."

It has been more than two decades since Twaddle won a Breeders Crown trophy, and going into tonight's race card, he admits it's not the same.

"Totally different vibe this time around. Winning the Breeders Crown in '94 with Hardie Hanover was a monumental moment in my driving career and an extremely gratifying accomplishment. However, Hardie was a great filly, a world champion as it turned out. She was heavily favored and my job was to not mess up. I think as a much younger me, I was more focused on driving her well and getting our business taken care of."

The race took place at Garden State Park.

"Of course, it is now defunct. I had some owners in attendance (Ron and Lori Maruya of Martwest Stable), but no family. I basically was on my own to come in, drive and get out (under the radar as I wasn't a headline act)," Twaddle said.

With Fourever Boy, Twaddle is enjoying every race and every milestone with this special colt.

"This time around I know how special an event like this is, and although we'll be underdogs, we will eat up every moment. This colt is special to us on so many levels and seeing him compete with the world's greatest driver guiding him is surreal.

"I was training horses at The Meadows Tuesday morning, and my friend Dr. Rick Balmer was speaking to me about the colt. I mentioned we were thinking about making the drive to Milton, ON for the draw (Tuesday evening). Doc says, 'When was the last Breeders Crown dinner you attended?' I told him I've never been able to attend one. He stopped and asked, 'When will be the next one?' And I said that I wasn't sure there ever will be one. His reply? 'Exactly! Go enjoy every minute of this opportunity."

Twaddle is enjoying every opportunity, and believes in his colt.

"I want him to race well. I want him to be a big factor. Let's face it, he's up against two outstanding colts. For Ronnie Burke to say [Bythemissal] is the fastest horse he's ever had is a giant statement. If we were ever going to beat him, it probably would have been in the [Little Brown] Jug. We got to the front and the race was ours to win or lose, and he got out and got to us in the lane. Finishing second to him is no disgrace, that's for sure. But they all get beat. Even Bulldog Hanover. If it's the right day and the right situation, anything can happen. We didn't draw terrible, and of course, [driver] Dexter [Dunn] is a magician, so we will see what happens."



Atlanta looks to check final box of stellar career in Breeders Crown mare trot

When the mare trotters line up at Woodbine Mohawk Park tonight (Oct. 29) for the \$472,000 Breeders Crown final, one of the greatest trotters of all time will be looking to add the only line that is missing from her resume: a victory in this stake.

Triple millionaire Atlanta has competed in the Breeders Crown five times to date finishing second twice, third twice and fourth, and this will be her last opportunity to get the "W" in her final year of racing. And although it would be the connections wish to get that accomplished, her trainer Ron Burke and driver Yannick Gingras affirmed Atlanta's legacy is secured regardless of the outcome.

"It's big anytime you're trying to win a Breeders Crown. But Atlanta's career is complete to me no matter what she does. If you're going to try to hold that against her, you're really being picky. She is one of the greatest trotting mares ever," said Burke.

"She's one of the great ones, no doubt about it. But the Breeders Crown is one thing that's missing on her mantle. It would definitely mean a whole lot to win it for her," said Gingras.

Burke also said that having Atlanta draw outside of Bella Bellini makes it very tough for his mare because the big track "picks up" Bella Bellini, so Atlanta will also have to step up her game.

Bella Bellini is already a Breeders Crown champion, having won it as a 3-year-old. And there was no let down this year as she has come back at 4 just as good or better than she was in 2021. Bella Bellini has beaten both Atlanta and When Dovescry during this season and has also bested all male fields in the Hambletonian Maturity and Caesar's Trot.

Trainer Nifty Norman spoke glowingly of Bella Bellini and said she's in a good spot here for this final.

"She's been fantastic, she's exceeded my expectations. To me, she's the best mare in the country and you don't expect it from a 4-year-old. And I think she will appreciate getting back on a big track. Going to Yonkers (for the Miecuna Invitational) was probably a bad idea on my part, but it was a \$250,000 race and we learned something, anyway. She doesn't like a half," said Norman.

When Dovescry has something in common with Atlanta besides being a multi-millionaire. Although she has won more than \$300,000 in Breeders Crown events to date, she too has not won a championship in four tries after being twice second and third. And unlike Bella Bellini, she had no issues at all going around four turns at Yonkers Raceway as she won the Bob Miecuna Invitational by 1-1/4 lengths. When Dovescry comes in fresh off that victory right into this final and her trainer Brett Pelling said he is feeling confident about her chances.

"She is in the form of her life right now and I think she really appreciates the cooler weather. I don't think she likes to sweat too much and she's definitely done better as we've gone into the fall. Some horses come to their form early in the summer, and other horses seem to get it done in the fall. We're always thinking long term so hopefully this is the time of year where it really pays off." said Pelling.

For the next decade, besides the Crown crystal breeders trophy, the winning breeder of the Crown mare trot champion will receive the Charlie Keller Memorial Award, a \$10,000 bonus. The bonus will be presented after the race to the winning breeder of the Mare Trot champion in the Diamond Creek Winner's Lounge by Keller nephew Dan Bittle.

A passion for Fashion Frenzie

Louis-Philippe Roy would love to make a 'Fashion' statement tonight (Oct. 29) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

When the field of 11 top-rank standouts line up behind the starter car for the \$810,000 Breeders Crown open trot final just past 10 p.m., Roy will find himself in rein to a multiple stakes winner and Canadian champion, a horse that he knows inside and out.

Winning the heavyweight tilt with Richard Moreau trainee Fashion Frenzie, he admitted, would certainly be fitting.

"He is a very talented horse and has so many good qualities," said Roy, of the 5-1 fourth choice in the morning line. "I've driven him a lot and he's become smarter and better as he's gotten older. He's just one of the horses you just love to partner with."

A double Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final champion – he won his division's Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final in both years of eligibility at 2 and 3 – Fashion Frenzie has designed an outstanding career for Quebec-based Ecurie Francis Richard, Pierre Guillemette, and Sylvain Richard, who co-own with Mario Bourgea of Stanbridge East.

The son of Archangel – Striking Fashion is 18-for-27 lifetime and is less than \$55,000 away from joining the millionaire ranks. The 4-year-old is a two-time Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final champion, an O'Brien Award winner in 2021, and victor in the 2022 Earl Rowe Memorial Trot.

Not bad for a \$7,000 purchase at the 2019 London Selected Yearling Sale.

Now, the horse with the modest price tag will test his mettle against some of the sport's top trotters tonight, a group that includes 5-2 morning line choice Ecurie D, fellow millionaire Jujubee, Maple

Leaf Trot winner and \$1.5 million earner Back of the Neck, and multiple stakes winner Forbidden Treasure, who has over \$2.3 million in earnings.

Although the competition is steep, Roy has unwavering faith in the brown gelding bred by John Petrik of Moorefield, ON, who sports a 7-0-0 mark from eight starts this season.

"He definitely belongs, and I couldn't be happier for the ownership group," said the driver closing in on 2,100 lifetime wins. "This is the type of race you always dreamt about being in, and I can't wait to get out there."

While he hasn't seen it up close himself, Roy has heard the stories about Fashion Frenzie's tough-as-nails personality.

"When Francis and the group bought him, there was a sign outside of the stall at the sale that read something like, 'Be careful!' I don't know what he's like at the barn, but he's

definitely up for the challenge when he's on the racetrack. He's got that competitive edge you like to see in a horse."

A horse that doesn't need to be on the lead to be dangerous.

While he's no stranger to trotting on the front end, Fashion Frenzie can bring his A-game regardless of where he finds himself.

"That's another great thing about him," praised Roy. "He likes to pass horses, to battle with them, so you know that you are going to get all his best no matter what unfolds."

Fashion Frenzie arrives at his latest engagement in top condition.

"I would say he's at 100 per cent," said Roy. "He's definitely ready to go."

So too is the man who will sit in the race bike.

Life, on and off the racetrack, is indeed good these days for the native of Mont-Joli, a town of just over 6,600 people located about 350 kilometres northeast of Quebec City.

Roy, who won his first Breeders Crown on Friday night, recently became a first-time father, welcoming a son, Simon.

"It's a great feeling to be a dad," he said. "He's doing really well, and we couldn't be happier."

While Roy had to whisper on the call while his son slept nearby, he'd undoubtedly have a far different tone if he were to notch a Breeders Crown triumph with Fashion Frenzie.



"That would be amazing," said Roy. "The closer the race gets, the more excited you get. I can't wait to get out there with him."

A horse who is undeniably well-suited for success on the biggest stage.

British Invasion

Five lads from Great Britain are looking to take the U.S. by storm next weekend.

As part of a tribute to the late Queen Elizabeth II, amateur drivers Grant Cullen, Jaimie Davies, Richard Haythornthwaite, Marc Jones and Lee Morris will cross the pond to race against the GSY Driving Club on Friday, Nov. 4 at The Meadowlands.

"In addition to the friendly competition, we will be honoring the memory of the late Queen and her support of racing and the ethical treatment of horses," said event organizer and GSY club president, Dave Yarock.

This competition has been in the works for months and was originally envisioned as a way to recognize the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, commemorating her 70 years on the throne. But when the Queen passed on Sept. 8 at the age of 96, it turned into more of a celebration of the life of a world-renowned and beloved monarch who loved horses.

Yarock relied on Dein Spriggs, president of the Florida Amateur Driving Club, to coordinate with Morris to get drivers for the competition.

"In 2016, I hooked up with Lee and we put together a U.S.A. versus U.K. competition at Pompano," said Spriggs. "It was really



great and we went the following summer (2017) and raced in the U.K.

"So, I spoke to Dave [Yarock] and he wanted to do something for the Queen's jubilee, this was before she passed away, and I said sure, I know the guys, and actually one of the guys moved here to the States with his family in February and I'm in touch with him all the time. So, we got Lee Morris and he started working on putting guys together."

In addition to racing a small stable of horses, Morris is a blacksmith at Tioga Downs and currently resides in the Southern Tier District of New York.

"I said I think we can make it work," said Morris. "It would be great to have people celebrate the Queen, especially with what sort of person she was as far as horses go.

"Being obviously British, the monarchy is a big thing back home. Growing up, all I've ever known is the Queen. And I think, basically, that she was just such a fantastic woman, but not only that, she was such an avid supporter of horses in general."

Queen Elizabeth II, an avid horse fan, owner, breeder and ambassador, owned many horses over the years, some that were her personal riding horses and others that were racehorses which won top races, including Ascot's Gold Cup and the Epsom Derby. She was inducted into the British Championship Series Hall of Fame in 2021 in a new "special contributor" category.



Morris believes that the team he has assembled to honor the late ruler are all very capable drivers and are superb representatives for the British way of racing.

"Everyone that's coming, their families are involved [in racing]," said Morris. "They're all second or third generation. They've all been working with horses all their life."

Anyone who watched the funeral for the Queen knows that her favorite riding horse was part of it as well as her personal bagpiper that played to wake her nearly every morning.

As a nod to that tradition, champion piper John Bottomley, director of piping at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, will be on hand to play the British National Anthem, "God Save The Queen".

This event would not be possible without the support of Meadowlands' president/chief executive officer Jeff Gural, chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir, and the entire staff at The Big M.

In addition to the festivities on the track, there will be some traditional British favorites offered as part of the Pink buffet, including Fish & Chips and Shepherd's Pie, while Gin and Tonics will be the special cocktail of the evening.

Yarock could not thank Morris, Spriggs or the Big M's Rachel Ryan and Scott Warren enough for all their hard work and dedication in putting this complicated event together. And what started out as just races at The Meadowlands has grown to include stops at Monticello [Nov. 3] and Freehold [Nov. 5] Raceways.

"I hope everyone will come out and support the event at all the tracks," said Yarock. "Not just because it will be good, competitive racing, but also because it pays tribute to the late Queen."

Even though Davies, Haythornthwaite and Morris have all raced in the U.S. before, they never raced at The Meadowlands, and, in fact, none of the British competitors have ever raced on a mile track since they don't have any back home.


"There are three permanent tracks [dirt tracks], one in York [in the Northeast of England], one in North Wales, called Tir Prince and one in South Wales, called Amman Valley," said Morris. "Other than that, it's in a field where they lay out some white pegs and make a track, so you go around a grass field.

"I think the biggest difference is [in the U.S.] it's an industry, it's a job, it's a way of life. And I think people do it back home in England because it's a passion. It's a hobby and they don't rely on it for a job. They can't make enough money off it as a job to survive as a living."

By trade, Cullen is an electrician, Davies is a sheep farmer, Haythornthwaite is a carpenter and Jones is a farrier. All love harness racing and are extremely excited to compete in the U.S., especially at The Meadowlands.

"If you ask anybody in England where they'd like to drive, it's always The Meadowlands because it's the biggest name in racing," said Morris. "It's the place that everybody dreams to just drive around, whether or not you win is another thing. For us back home when you race around a grass field, it's something you can only dream about really."







The New Zealand Trotting Cup brings Christchurch to a standstill

They say the Melbourne Cup is the race that stops the nation in Australia.

Remarkably, it is a harness race, the New Zealand Trotting Cup, which goes closest to stopping the nation across the ditch in New Zealand.

We'll get to why it's called a "Trotting" Cup soon when it's actually for pacers, but it is truly remarkable to think a harness race – above anything in thoroughbred racing – is THE race most New Zealanders consider their once a year, must-watch race.

New Zealand's most prominent racing media man Michael Guerin grew-up with the NZ Cup ingrained in his DNA.

"It's always been a huge thing in my life, but it's the same for so many people over here," he said.

"The (NZ) is still clearly NZ's biggest race. There are three \$NZ1 million galloping races, but none of them get the media coverage, pull the crowds or just have the general buzz of NZ Cup Day.

"It's the only race in NZ which commands a public holiday where it's run (in Christchurch).

"It would also be one of only two harness races in the world which is the biggest horse race in that country, the Elitlopp in Sweden would be the other.

"But this race is bigger in Christchurch than the Elitlopp is in Stockholm, and I've been to both. There is nothing else that matters in Christchurch on Cup Day. It's like it's the only thing that exists."

Just as Australians know when the Melbourne Cup is on by the tag "the first Tuesday in November", NZ Cup's stamp is the "second Tuesday in November."

Now, why's it called the NZ "Trotting" Cup when it's actually a pacing race? That's tradition. In its formative years, the "trotting" was used to describe harness racing in general as a difference to thoroughbred or galloping racing. The Kiwis are big on tradition and don't like tinkering with it.

The passion and interest of the NZ Cup certainly extends to Australia, but winning it has proven elusive for Australian trainers.

Since the Victorian-based Jimmy O'Sullivan upstaged the Kiwis with (ironically) a former NZ pacer My Lightning Blue to win the 1987 NZ Cup, only one Aussie-trained pacer has been able to do it again.

And that was an historic moment.

Victoria's Kerryn Manning, a real trailblazer and one of the world's most successful female drivers, became the first female to train and drive an NZ Cup winner with Arden Rooney in 2015.

For all of her incredible achievements, Manning ranks it right up with her greatest moments.

"It may be my greatest achievement in the sport," Manning said. "It's such a special race and incredible day to be part of it. I'll treasure it for ever. Every year it's run, it brings back so many great memories."

This year's Cup is just around the corner on Nov. 8.

And there are two Aussie trainers trying to create memories of their own like Manning, and O'Sullivan before her.

Victorian Mick Stanley is already across in NZ with his young star Rock N Roll Doo, while the almost revolutionary young NSW trainer Jason Grimson heads across early next week with his stable star Majestic Cruiser.

Importantly, they are two best credentialled pacers in Australia to fly the flag at Addington Raceway on Tuesday week.

Rock N Roll Doo is a potential champion. He's furnished from a raw diamond into something special over the past few months.

His win in the Group 1 Victoria Cup at Melton was something to behold.

In an era where the gap between the very best and those chasing isn't great, Rock N Roll Doo did something very rare. He sat parked throughout the race and humbled a hot field. He won without Stanley having to fully extend him.

But crossing the Tasman Sea to get to NZ isn't the only hurdle Rock N Roll Doo has to overcome. There is also the standing-start factor.

You see, the NZ Cup is a 3200m (two mile) race, contested from a standing-start.

When Rock N Roll Doo left Australia, he had never raced from a stand. He had his first try at Ashburton, in NZ's South Island, last Monday and it didn't go to plan.

The 4-year-old seemed a tad overawed. He hopped and skipped and lost about 30-40m at the start before recovering, catching the field, moving around to sit parked and fading late for sixth.

It was a brave effort and showed, with a safe and even start, he is as good as any of the Kiwi pacers he will face on Nov. 8.

But, and it's a crucial but, he must learn from the experience and step away safely from the standing-start to be any winning hope.

It's something the more seasoned 8-year-old Majestic Cruiser has in common. He too is new to standing racing.

And Majestic Cruiser won't see the standing-start tapes under race conditions until he lines up at Addington.

But Grimson isn't fazed. "I wouldn't be taking him all that way if I thought he was a big risk of blowing the start. He's a relaxed old fella and he stepped away well when I stood him in a (Menangle) trial recently."

Grimson is also driven by the fact Majestic Cruiser has already been to NZ and beaten their best. He did so back in April in the Group 1 Messenger at Auckland's Alexandra Park.

"I've been itching to get back since. It was a great experience winning the Messenger and my horse is such a great stayer, my mind turned straight to the NZ Cup," Grimson said.

Both Stanley and Grimson know the significance of the race and the enormity of the challenge confronting them.

Remarkably, Stanley has sacrificed a shot at the Inter Dominion – arguably Down Under's biggest and most famous harness race – to focus on an NZ Cup and the major races early next year.

"I love the race, always have," Stanley said. "I've always wanted to have a runner in it and when this horse started to emerge, I spoke with Brendan (James, owner) and we decided we'd have a crack at it if he kept ticking the boxes along the way.

"Even before he won the Victoria Cup, we'd decided we were going. We think the whole trip will be a great experience for him and help make him, because he's still getting better and learning. But we also think it's a race he can win."

Grimson also admits the sheer "pull" of tackling a race as special as the NZ Cup is the reason he is taking Majestic Cruiser across.

"It's awkward timing and sorting travel – both over and back – hasn't been easy, but we think he's the right horse for the race and it's something we just really want to be part of," he said.
