Friday night at the 2021 Breeders Crown championships

Weather, again, was as dominant a story as the horses on the track.

Once again, dank conditions had about as much to do with Breeders Crown racing as did the horses. We're about due for a turn of luck there.

The strong backstretch headwind was the major factor (don't believe us: Yannick Gingras said it on a pre-races interview). After the third race, before the Crowns, the judges put a "+1" on a fast track because of the wind factor (they did the same thing at Philly early in the card this afternoon). Wind is, as always important, and you can tell by the fractions just which way the wind was blowing, and who had bad luck to be on the move against the elements.

Yannick said that before the races; when the rain came, it came hard, and seemed to be almost as much a factor. It started to rain before the fifth, and was a downpour for the sixth, the first Crown, for which the surface was retro-rated to "sloppy +2"; all four Crown races carried that designation. (Gabe Prewitt looked like a clothes mannequin upon whom somebody through a new piece of protection for a few races there).

Clearly, the front horses were at a disadvantage – last week nine of the 19 elim winners were on the lead at the half, but seven of them were not there just off the first turn. This week, moving into the wind, over a tiring surface, moving to the lead later on the backstretch wasn't so great, even if as a favorite a horse had to be in a winning spot. The two that lasted on the lead made the moves earlier on the backstretch.

The equine star of the show was Niki Hill. If you thought after last year you might not see another filly like Party Girl Hill, it's a Hilluva thing that you only had to wait one year before possibly seeing the next one.

Moving early on a night that didn't help that tactic, then drawing away effortlessly and coming within three-fifths of a second of the stakes record over the "sloppy +2" surface – it was a most impressive performance, especially with Dexter Dunn not moving a muscle in the lane.

Chris Ryder (who was instrumental in bringing Dunn over here, and got a special mention) wasn't sure whether Niki Hill would go on to the Kindergarten Final and the Final Four – he said he'd have to talk to owner Tom Hill, who was up and watching the race at 2:45 a.m. in England. Whatever (and whenever) the decision, it will be made by a knowledgeable owner and trainer about a terrific juvenile.



The move towards owners' silks got a boost in the filly trot when the horse driven by the guy in red and gold (Brian Sears, Courant) photoed out the horse driven by the guy in blue and black (Yannick Gingras, Lindy).

Brian Sears now has 35 Breeders Crown championships, second behind only John Campbell. Sears still looks young at age 53.

And then there was almost a dead-heat for win in the 2-year-old colt pace, as there was last year, but Monte Miki got the nod over Gulf Shores in a 1:53.2 mile with a last quarter of :27.1. (Technically there was a dead-heat, but for sixth this year).

What a life-changing horse for trainer Mark Evers, whom I used to watch racing at Lebanon when I was working in Ohio in



the 1980s. Before this year, his best seasonal earnings were \$331,586 in 2005; Monte Miki, with wins in the Metro and now the Crown, himself has earned \$685,276 in seven lifetime starts.

(Longshot personal observation: Early Action will win in the month of November if Joe Holloway goes on with him. Follow this horse through a replay in the last half.)

Lindy Farms' Domenico Cecere was interviewed before a race, and when his interview was finished, he said, "Thank you, and good luck to everybody tonight." That was a refreshing, thoughtful way to end an interview.

Tim Tetrick also rates a mention in the quote category. Gabe Prewitt interviewed him after Rebuff came from third-over to win the colt trot, and said, "For those not as lucky as we are to be in this winner's circle right now, what would you say about the weather?", to which Tetrick said, without missing a beat, "It's always a bright and sunny day when you win a Breeders Crown." He's won 22 of them now, and he's not 40 until next month; he also went over \$10 million for the year with this win.

(And for those who say that all holes should be closed when possible, watch Tetrick's drive with winner Rebuff here.)

Yannick Gingras, who won five of the 19 eliminations last week, didn't get a Crown Friday night, but he had two seconds and a third. The four Crowns went to four different drivers; Dexter Dunn had 1-2-4-5 finishes for the most cash among drivers, \$459,600 (again, all these figures are not official as calculated quickly under the pressure of deadline). No trainer won more than one Crown on Friday, either.

Those who say that people don't bet more on good horses, check this: the first five races, in better weather, averaged a handle of \$214,000. Then there were the four Crown races for 2-year-olds, in adverse conditions, and they averaged \$349,000 – up 63 per cent. Granted, the Crown races all had full fields, but still.

And then, of course, is today's eight-course smörgåsbord:

3PF: Will Test Of Faith deliver another big victory and get into serious consideration for Horse of the Year? Does the gallant Fire Start Hanover have a chance to repeat as divisional champion with a 10-9 post draw in the Crown races? Will Grace Hill, right there all the time but kind of quietly, come up with a roaring performance to put her squarely in the spotlight?

OTM: Can Atlanta finally get the only major win she hasn't accumulated, a Breeders Crown – and would a win there put her in the Trotter of the Year talk? Can When Dovescry get a big win here – and how would that win impact November 20?

3PC: Here's the BIG Perfect Sting – Charlie May showdown. How will the weather, and the trips, work out? Seems like a win by either would go a long way towards the championship (but don't forget Nov. 20). Or can Southwind Gendry, who can be his own worst enemy, finally put it all together?

3TF: Would Bella Bellini, without question the seasonal leader, cement a title with a Crown victory? But how scary was Altar's win last week in 1:51.2 – 3/5 of a second faster than the fastest-ever final for this group?


3TC: Jujubee came up a little shy in his elimination – can he improve on that race and take the Crown, and likely the division, in this race? (A mention of Captain Corey here.) Too many other, realistic possibilities to name – depends on what you feel their maximum is, and what Jujubee can show today.

OPM: Lyons Sentinel is #1 in the polls entering this race. Does a victory here make her a tough one to topple for Pacer and Horse of the Year? Ironic that Rocknificent of 2021 vs. Lyons Sentinel is the Lyons Sentinel of 2020 vs. Party Girl Hill – a repeat of her Crown elim win would knock down that image.

OTH: What will we see from Ecurie D DK? Is a big win here and in the TVG (he could be invited) enough to make him a divisional winner in a year where the ladies often outshone the boys?

OPH: Will another impressive win FINALLY get Allywag Hanover into the Horse of the Year conversation that he should have been in for the last two months? Plenty of fast opposition here – maybe no one horse can beat the chalk straight up, but a number of wearing challenges could put somebody in prime position to take advantage. I don't think so – the Aug. 21 race at Pocono is the race of the year for any horse for me (THREE sub-27 quarters?).







Rebuff overcomes the weather and favorite Branded By Lindy to give Wallin first Crown

Rebuff didn't always strut his best stuff, but there was doubting his maturity and mettle after a polished performance in the Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old male trotters.

On a rainy, blustery Friday night (Oct. 29) at The Meadowlands, Rebuff put on a world-class show for those in attendance, those tuning into watch, and for an ownership group that spans the globe.

Trainer Lucas Wallin, who calls New Jersey home, shares owner-ship of the Muscle Hill—Meucci Madness colt with Kjell Magne Andersen (Switzerland) and Pieter Delis (Netherlands).

No doubt all three were on top of the world after Rebuff's stellar showing against nine rivals.

In rein to Tim Tetrick, the bay colt was overshadowed – both on the stat sheet and the tote board – by Branded By Lindy, the son of Chapter Seven who was chasing his eighth straight victory.

And while he wasn't prominent early in the \$600,000 rookie final, a revved-up Rebuff was at the top of his game when it counted the most.

Sitting seventh after a :27-flat quarter set by Branded By Lindy, Rebuff had moved into fifth position after a half-mile reached in

:56.1. Second at Roger Huston's stretch call in 1:25.2, he still had plenty left to do as Branded By Lindy held a two-length advantage.

Tetrick and Rebuff were able to get past Branded By Lindy, but then needed to rebuff an inside charge from a determined Fast As The Wind.

At the wire, Rebuff wouldn't be denied, stopping clock in 1:55.

Wallin, who celebrated his first Breeders Crown title, was elated at the effort from his stable star.

"We've been very, very high on him since we bought him, actually, but he was very immature and it took us a couple of starts to get him here and he really came up big here," said Wallin.

The performance was even more impressive considering it was contested under less-than-ideal racing conditions.

Before the field was sent on its way, Wallin wondered how his young charge would handle the steady rain and high winds.

"For sure, especially for 2-year-olds, it's tough on them already and then with this wind and this rain. Like I said, it's the same for everyone, but I was... maybe not worried more than anyone else."

In the end, he didn't need to be concerned at all.

Early on Rebuff's career, however, Wallin did have some reason for trepidation, a sentiment that was shared by Steve Stewart, who co-bred the horse with Michael Andrew.

After debuting with an eighth-place finish this July at The Meadowlands, Rebuff was scratched out of his next start on July 16. His first win, on July 30 at The Meadowlands, came with Wallin in the race bike.

"He could always trot," said Stewart. "I thought he was always somewhat of an immature yearling and I was very happy to see Lucas... he did an unbelievable job with him. Watching him race this summer, he was very patient with him and that's what the horse needed. He needed... not to hurt him. And they raced him from behind, like he said, and it's a wonderful thing."

Although there were mixed results ahead of a 1:52.2 career-best win in the International Stallion Stakes on Oct. 8 at The Red Mile, the \$200,000 purchase at the 2020 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale finally hit his best stride.

Rebuff (Tim Tetrick) overcame the elements, favorite Branded By Lindy and then held off Fast As The Wind (10, Dexter Dunn) to win the \$600,000 Breeders Crown final for rookie trotting colts on Friday at The Meadowlands.

Rebuff's win last week in his Breeders Crown elimination drew high praise from Wallin.

"Tetrick put him in the perfect spot again [tonight]. He's very, very fast and he warmed up really good, maybe a little too grabby, but in the race he looked very good so I was confident."

On a blustery, damp Friday night in New Jersey, Rebuff was the one looking confident, storming down the lane to notch the biggest victory of his career to date.

Aside from a few extra carrots and plenty of pats, the horse who now sports a 4-2-1 mark from 10 career starts, will get a well-deserved break from lining up behind the starting gate.

"He's very high on himself," said Wallin. "This is the horse's last race for the year and he'll get a nice vacation."

As for the conditioner, just like his diverse ownership group, he's simply thrilled to be on top of the world.

"I can't describe it, actually. This is what you work for and I don't know. This is what you're working for, so to win a Breeders Crown like this, it's incredible."

Sent off as the 5-2 second choice, Rebuff returned \$7.80. \$3.40 and \$3.

Joviality S grinds out decisive win

Joviality S, with Brian Sears in the bike, rode a classic second-over trip to win the \$600,000 Breeders Crown 2-year-old filly trot on Friday (Oct. 29) at The Meadowlands on a track rated "sloppy." The winning time for the mile was 1:54.4.

Through the evening's program, the weather deteriorated and it was pouring rain by post time for the freshman filly division's Crown final. Leaving from post 10, Joviality S was mildly supported at 8-1. Sears said, "I was not happy with the draw."

Still, Joviality S may have gone off even higher were it not for the fact that the outer most 10 post was a lively launching post all evening. There had already been an 18-1 winner early in the program and in the two Crown races before Joviality's win, fillies leaving from post 10 completed the exactas at odds of 80-1 and 11-1, respectively.

Joviality left the gate with all intentions of finding a good spot early but was forced to sit fifth when Jiggy Jog S and favorite Lilbitalexis secured quick starts. As well, Sears had to keep Joviality S clear of breakers. As Jiggy Jog S cut the first quarter in :26.3, Ebbies Lady took a few steps bad enough to eliminate her chances, even though she returned to stride. And as Lilbitalexis came out and rushed to get the lead with co-favored Raised By

RAISED BY LINDY JIGGY JOG S Lindy pulling to chase her, Selfie Queen and Jaya Bae galloped out of the contest.

Out of trouble and with live cover, Joviality S sat second over as Raised By Lindy cut three-quarters in 1:26.1 and Sears guided the Chapter Seven filly to a photo-finish win over Raised By Lindy in 1:54.4, the first Crown win of 2021 for trainer Marcus Melander. Jiggy Jog S held on for third over Brickhouse Babe.

Joviality S defeated Raised By Lindy at Hoosier Park on Oct. 9 in a Kentuckiana Sales Stakes division and after winning an International Stallion Stakes race she finished second to Raised By Lindy in the Crown elim at The Meadowlands.

As it turned out from post 10, Sears said, "I couldn't ask for a better trip," and as for catching Raised By Lindy, he said, "She loves chasing them down, though [chasing in] the slop was difficult."

She paid \$18.40 to win. She has now earned \$669,998 for her first racing campaign.

It was the eighth win of the season from 11 starts for Joviality, a Chapter Seven filly out of Muscle Hill mare Pasithea Face, bred by Am Bloodstock.

Courant, Inc. owns the filly, who became a New York Sires Stakes champion in the 2021 freshman filly-trotter division, winning the \$200,000 final at Yonkers.

Trainer Marcus Melander was concerned with the 10 hole draw for the Crown final, too, as well as the horrible weather did not help his worry. Still, he praised Raised By Lindy, calling her "an amazing horse" and he went on to revel in his filly's personality.

"She very angry, honestly," he said, recalling some brazen behavior and how tough she was on the New York half-miles on the path to her sires-stakes championship.

"Before one of her New York Sires Stakes races at Yonkers," he said, "I was going to lift up one of her legs and check her shoes and she kicked me on my leg. She just wants to be around herself. She doesn't want to be bothered. But she really is a sweetheart and [the Crown win] says a lot about her, about how she's so easy to handle and easy to be around and easy to train," he said.

Melander attributes her ability to a naturally "great technique," emphasizing again how she successfully handled the half-mile racing against the top fillies of her division.

"Going around the [four-turn] tracks in New York, she had no problem," he said. "She's so universal. She can come fast in the deep stretch and she can go [quickly] to the half."

Melander won two Crown events last season with his resolute older trotter Gimpanzee and his barn began this season with expectations for a strong Hambletonian contender, Dancinginthedark M. Unfortunately that colt battled gait problems through a tough stakes campaign and the matter did not help him compete favorably, no less during the rise of eventual Hambletonian favorite and winner Captain Corey.

Joviality S is most likely done racing at two, Melander said. "She has been traveling a lot and it has been a long season."

Brian Sears' victory with Joviality S was his 35th win in a Crown event. He is listed as third in all-time earnings for Crown drivers with over \$14 million.







Monte Miki prevails in Breeders Crown 2-year-old colt pace

Velocity Standardbreds' homebred Monte Miki dug in gamely down the lane to overcome Gulf Shores by a nose in Friday's (Oct. 29) \$600,000 Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old pacers presented by the Central Ontario Standardbred Association at The Meadowlands.

Sent to post at odds of 7-2 in rein to Scott Zeron, Monte Miki overcame the odds in a wide-open final contested over a sloppy surface on a rainy evening that favored horses racing from off-the-pace at the East Rutherford, NJ oval.

Gulf Shores left in a hurry for driver Yannick Gingras but Monte Miki, away well from post 2, pulled pocket and surged to the front with Beach Glass forced to retreat to third through an opening quarter-mile in 27.4.

Monte Miki maintained his advantage down the backstretch under pressure from Gulf Shores through a half-mile in 56.4 as Beach Glass launched a first-over move with Pebble Beach following his cover through three-quarters in 1:26.1.

Monte Miki held a precarious lead at the top of the lane with Gulf Shores angling inside as a host of challengers lined up their bids in the center of the track. Gulf Shores appeared to put a nose in front late in the lane, but a game Monte Miki was resurgent to notch a narrow win in a final time of 1:53.2.

The victory marked a fourth Breeders Crown score for Zeron, who won this event in 2018 with Captain Crunch.

"When I got away that close, I eventually wanted to make my way to the front. I protected my spot in that first turn," Zeron said. "He rates himself a little bit because he's eager for competition — he did all that himself."

Zeron, who guided Monte Miki to a half-length victory over Hammering Hank in last week's elimination, said that despite appearances his horse was never headed by Gulf Shores.

"It might have looked like that on TV, but he never really got his nose past us. This horse fights like crazy," Zeron said. "I never worry about him up there. All I worry about is keeping the pace honest. Once he sees another horse, he's really game."

The Ohio-based Velocity Standardbreds is headed by Sylvia Norris with her husband Mark Evers as the outfit's trainer.

The 64-year-old conditioner said he was breathless as he stood trackside through an exhilarating stretch drive.

"His races are an emotional rollercoaster, you know," Evers said. "It feels great. It feels good for my wife. She really loves the horses and she's been with us for the whole deal. She helps take care of them and does all the business."

Evers said he was cautiously optimistic following last week's elimination score.

"We had no idea that we were going to win tonight. I was just hoping that he would perform well and race something like he did last week," Evers said. "Last week, I thought he really showed well, especially when a horse came to him and fought him off. That was a good mile last week."

By Always B Miki, who sired last year's Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Colt Pace dead-heat winner Perfect Sting, Monte Miki is the first foal out of the Camluck mare Montenegro.

Evers said he was a fan of Montenegro, a 40-race winner with purse earnings of more than \$700,000, who he purchased for \$57,000 at the 2016 Harrisburg Sale.

"We raced against her all the time at Hoosier Park. I set the track record with Sugar Nips and she broke it the next year," Evers said. "Eventually, they retired her and sent her through Harrisburg and we made the trip up there and picked her up."

The talented Monte Miki is no stranger to adversity, overcoming

post 11 in a 12-horse field and racing from the second tier at 15-1 odds to capture the Metro Pace final in September at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"Going down the backside I didn't think he was going to get anything and then Scott went to the inside and a horse made a break and the waves parted and he got through," Evers recalled of the unlikely Metro Pace score.

Evers was returning to the Breeders Crown for the first time since finishing third in the 2003 2-Year-Old Colt Pace with Arts Chip which was won by No Pan Intended at The Meadowlands.

"He came back in the final and drew the nine hole and salvaged a third out of it. That was pretty nice, too, but not quite like tonight," Evers said, with a laugh.

Monte Miki, who won his first three starts at Scioto Downs, now boasts a record of six wins from seven starts. He incurred his only defeat when third in the International Stallion Stakes on Oct. 9 at The Red Mile.

The well-prepared Monte Miki, brought over by 2017 O'Brien Award-winning caretaker Teesha Symes, returned \$9.40 for a \$2 win bet.







Niki Hill back on track

Torrential rain and a sloppy track didn't stop Niki Hill from shining in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown 2-year-old filly pace Friday night (Oct. 30) at The Meadowlands.

Once driver Dexter Dunn guided Niki Hill to the top, it was lights out as she scored a 4 ¾-length victory in 1:51.

Dunn wasn't surprised she went that fast on the off track.

"I knew the conditions would suit her more than other fillies because she's so strong," said Dunn. "She's a big powerful girl and I was full of confidence with her. I was nearly halfway down the back straight trying to stop her [after the race]. She's got a massive set of lungs on her."

Chris Ryder trains the daughter of Always B Miki—Road Bet for owner Tom Hill, who resides in the coastal town of Morecambe in Lancashire, England.

Even though Niki Hill's race went off at 2:15 a.m. in England, according to Ryder, Hill was watching and cheering.

Niki Hill went into last week's Crown elims a perfect six-for-six but ended up finishing second to Queen Of Success, beaten half a length.

"She actually tied up on me last week," said Ryder. "Well, I was pleased to know there was something. We didn't come here last week to get beat, you know. We came here last week to make sure we had a good post and it didn't work."

Ryder's son Patrick has spent a lot of time with Niki Hill both at the farm and on the road as the person who drives her to the track for the detention barn.

"The last couple of days we've had her on the walker just to make sure she was getting plenty of movement [because it was too rainy to have her out in a paddock]," said Patrick Ryder. "I've even been out on the walker with her for 20 or 30 minutes a couple of mornings just to be sure she's safe on it. The walker's on and I'm holding a lead shank and I'm just walking with her.

"Melissa Erzena is her groom and she takes fantastic care of her. She also took amazing care of our wonderful filly, Party Girl Hill, last year."

Just as with Party Girl Hill, Niki Hill is owned solely by Hill.

"A lot of owners in the States are in it for 20 per cent or 25 percent, but every horse that races with my name on it with the exception of one, which I own most of, is owned by Tom Hill, not owned by five different people in a syndicate," Hill said. "It gives you the flexibility if you want to change a trainer or you want to go to a certain race, it's your horse, you say what happens to it. When you paddle your own canoe, you're the captain of your own ship. You make the decisions."

One decision that Hill regrets making was in 2018 when he took a horse away from trainer Chris Ryder to give it to another trainer.

Hill remembers running into Ryder that winter and how Ryder was just as nice and friendly as he was when he was training for him.

"If somebody takes a horse off you and gives it to somebody

else, they sort of get a sour taste, but Chris was exactly the same man as he was before and that's what I really liked, and it made me feel like a heel," said Hill.


Hill said he spoke with Ryder and took total responsibility. He also said Ryder had done nothing wrong and that he'd make it up to him. Enter Party Girl Hill.


7,000 career wins for Örjan Kihlström

Top Swedish driver Örjan Kihlström reached a big milestone on Friday (Oct. 29) afternoon as he competed at his home track Solvalla. In the first race on the card, Kihlström claimed win number 7,000 in his career His first victory also came at Solvalla in 1980.

Kihlström, 59, is known for his cool behavior in the bike and during the past 10-15 years, he has dominated several big races throughout Europe and he can look back on wins in the Elitloppet (four times), Prix d'Amérique, Swedish Derby (four times), Kriteriet (seven times), Oaks (eight times), Stochampionatet (eight times), Sprintermästaren (six times), Prix de France (two times) and Prix de Paris (two times).

The 2015 Hall Of Fame inductee has, again, had a tremendous year as a driver. He has collected some of the biggest races in

Europe and the two biggest at Solvalla during 2021.

In May, he won Elitloppet with Don Fanucci Zet and in late September he claimed Svenskt Travkriterium for 3-year-olds with Francesco Zet.

Trying to describe Örjan Kihlström's way of driving trotters depends on who is asked in the industry. Driving a horse completely tired in a race is something that he dislikes a lot and it's not unusual that he sometimes shows up in the serious stride a bit too late, but that's a tactic that often pays back to him in later races with the same horse. When he's behind the best horse in a race, a first over trip doesn't scare him and it's just that simple that Örjan Kihlström has what it takes to become one of the best drivers in the world. It's in his blood.

And speaking of Kihlström. When Solvalla held the Breeders Crown eliminations last Sunday (Oct. 24), he had 11 shots on the card. He won five of them and qualified nine out of 11 horses that he drove for the four finals at Eskilstuna on Nov. 7. What an achievement!

Swedish drivers Jorma Kontio (born in Finland) and Björn Goop are ahead of Örjan Kihlström when it comes to sulky victories in the northern European countries.







Atlanta seeks elusive Crown; comeback kids aim for Open Trot title

Name just about any major Grand Circuit trotting race, and it is likely Atlanta has won it. The Hambletonian? Check. Kentucky Filly Futurity? Check. Maple Leaf Trot? Check. Armbro Flight, Cutler Memorial, Steele Memorial, Hill Memorial, Dayton Derby, Joie De Vie, Allerage Open? Check'em all.

One race missing from her list of accomplishments is the Breeders Crown. This afternoon (Oct. 30), the multiple Dan Patch Award-winning female trotter will try to change that.

Atlanta is the 8-5 morning-line favorite in the \$300,000 Breeders Crown Mare Trot at The Meadowlands. She won last week's single elimination by three-quarters of a length over When Dovescry in 1:52.1 and will start the final from post two with Yannick Gingras driving for trainer Ron Burke.

With a win, Atlanta would not only capture her elusive Crown, but she would also move within \$4,000 of recently retired Manchego for fourth place on the career money list for female trotters with more than \$3.14 million.

"She wasn't a hundred percent healthy last week, so I think she's going to be better this week," Gingras said. "She will be a hundred percent health wise, so it will just be my job to get her the best trip. I think obviously she's the horse to beat in there.

"If I can spot her second over it would be ideal. She is definitely better chasing, everyone knows that. But great horses do great things, and she can win any which way. She doesn't need a trip, she just needs a target. She can be first up and that's not a problem."

Racing begins at noon today at the Big M and features eight Breeders Crown finals for horses ages 3 and up.

Atlanta, a 6-year-old daughter of Chapter Seven out of Hemi Blue Chip, has won 31 of 61 career races. In Breeders Crown finals, she was fourth at age 2 and second at 3. The past two years, she faced the boys in the Open Trot, finishing third each time

"It would be great to have a Breeders Crown trophy with her, that's for sure," said Gingras, who drives Atlanta for owners Crawford Farms Racing, Brad Grant, and Howard Taylor. "I think she is going to give a good account of herself."

When Dovescry will start today from post seven and is 4-1 on the morning line. David Miller will be in the sulky for trainer Brett Pelling. When Dovescry, owned by John Lengacher, has won six of 15 races this year and missed the board only once. For her career, the daughter of Muscle Hill-Cedar Dove has won 18 of 44 races and \$1.49 million.

"She is absolutely one of the most perfect lovely horses you could ever have in your stable," Pelling said about the 5-year-old mare, who won the Armbro Flight Stakes and Miss Versatility Series final this year. "She is a pleasure to be around. We love her, she loves us."

Hypnotic AM, who received a bye into the final, is the 5-1 third choice in the final, starting from post eight with Brian Sears driving for trainer Marcus Melander. The 4-year-old is a daughter of Chapter Seven-Daydream AM S and has earned \$1.44 million lifetime.

"She's had a great year," Melander said. "She's made just under \$300,000 and raced against the best 4-year-olds and the best mares. I can't complain. She's not a big horse. She went (1):50 flat in Lexington and she always tries her best. She's showed she can be right there with them, but we need a little bit of luck."

The field also includes two previous Breeders Crown champs, Next Level Stuff and Ramona Hill. Next Level Stuff, by Sebastian K S out of Nantab, will start from post 10 as she attempts to become the first female trotter to win a Crown at ages 3 and 4 since Bee A Magician in 2013-14.

Four-year-old Ramona Hill, who won her Crown at age 2 and captured the Hambletonian last year, starts from post five today as she hopes to put health woes behind her.

"She has a lot of issues with her back, and everything has to be good at the same time," trainer Tony Alagna said after watching the daughter of Muscle Hill—Lock Down Lindy finish a dead-heat fifth with Sorella in the elimination.

"I was thrilled with her. That was probably the best race she's put in this year. Jammed-up trip, sitting fifth-over, no flow, and when (driver Andy McCarthy) tipped her, she looked like her old self. I think with a start like that under her belt and a good draw, she will be that much better going to the final. Fingers crossed."

Felicityshagwell S, who was beaten by 1-1/4 lengths in finishing fourth in the elimination, is 15-1 on the morning line from post six, but trainer-driver Ake Svanstedt is happy with the 6-year-old

daughter of Maharajah-Diaz Boko.

"If I had racing room (in the elimination) I think I win easy," Svanstedt said. "She is in top form."

The Breeders Crown Mare Trot is race five today, the second of the eight Breeders Crown finals.

COMEBACK KIDS LOOK FOR CROWN

It was a slow road back to the races for male trotter Warrawee Roo, but the Luc Blais trainee is quickly making up for lost time. Warrawee Roo suffered a fractured foot at the end of 2018 and did not race in 2019 or 2020. This year, the 8-year-old stallion has won five of 16 races and is the 9-2 morning-line third choice in today's \$650,000 Breeders Crown Open Trot.

Eliminations were unnecessary for the Open Trot, with a field of 11 going directly to the final. Warrawee Roo, a son of Majestic Son—Karoon, prepped for the event by winning last week at The Meadowlands in 1:51.2, a career-best time. He will start today from post one with Dan Dube driving for trainer Blais.

Warrawee Roo has appeared in one previous Breeders Crown, finishing third in the 2018 Open Trot. He has won 15 of 66 lifetime starts.

"He's an amazing horse," said Blais, a four-time Breeders Crown winner. "It took long, but he has such a great attitude, I didn't give up, and he showed up. He likes to race. That's the kind of horse you want. He's a very nice horse.

"One thing I know, when he's on the track and he's feeling good, he's a competitor. That's for sure. He's going to try hard."

Another comeback kid for Blais is Forbidden Trade, the 2019 Hambletonian winner and Canadian Horse of the Year. A leg injury limited Forbidden Trade to five starts in 2020, but he has won four of 12 this season including the Caesars Trotting Classic and Crawford Farms Open. He is the 7-2 second choice in today's final, starting from post two with Bob McClure in the sulky.

Forbidden Trade, by Kadabra out of Pure Ivory, qualified last week in 1:53 to get ready for the Breeders Crown. He has won 20 of 42 career races.

"I'm very pleased with him," Blais said. "He's always there and races good, feeling good. He came back very strong this year. We're very pleased about that. When we started, we didn't know how far we were going to go, but he stepped up and he stayed sound. That's the main thing. I think he will always be a nice horse."

Two other horses coming back from health woes are two-time Breeders Crown champion Amigo Volo and Chin Chin Hall, both for trainer Richard "Nifty" Norman. Amigo Volo will start today from post nine, with Dexter Dunn driving, as he tries to join Gimpanzee and Mack Lobell as male trotters to win the Breeders Crown three times. Gimpanzee and Mack Lobell were champs at 2, 3, and 4.

Amigo Volo went off stride at the start of his prep race last week, but had two wins, a second, and a third since a more than two-month midseason hiatus.

"The horse was a little bit eager and hit the gate and made a break," Norman said about last week. "We gave him quite a bit of time off because his health wasn't good, but now he seems like he's right back on point. I think he will go good. He drew nine in the final. He's going to have to smoke it out of there."

Chin Chin Hall was limited to five races last year because of injury. He finished second to Warrawee Roo last week. He has hit the board in six straight starts, winning three. Todd McCarthy will drive Chin Chin Hall, starting from the post 11 trailing spot behind the gate.

"He was a good second," Norman said. "He's come on. I'm not sure if he's gotten better or if the pack has come back to him a little bit. But he's racing good and solid. Really good."

Ecurie D is the 3-1 morning-line favorite in the Open Trot off his one start in North America, a 1:50.4 win in the Allerage Open earlier this month. Born in Denmark, Ecurie D was a sensation in Europe his first two seasons of racing. He won his first 11 races in a row, including all seven starts at age 3.

In May, Ecurie D finished sixth in the Elitlopp. His 1:50.4 debut win in the U.S. puts him in a tie for the eighth-fastest mile of the season by an older trotter in North America.

Overall, Ecurie D has won 16 of 22 races and \$458,368. He was supplemented to the Breeders Crown for \$62,500 and starts from post three with trainer-driver Ake Svanstedt.

"We started up easy with him and then training more and more and he is doing good the whole time," Svanstedt said. "He is a good horse. He has good conformation, he is a smart horse, and he is good gaited. He is fast, he is strong, nice to drive. He is everything."

The Breeders Crown Open Trot is race 10 today, the seventh of the eight Breeders Crown finals.

No. 1 Lyons Sentinel, No. 3 Allywag Hanover favored in Crown paces

Lyons Sentinel is the No. 1 ranked horse in harness racing, but she is still looking to solve the Breeders Crown.

In fact, she enters this afternoon's \$330,000 Mare Pace at The Meadowlands attempting to capture her first Breeders Crown final.

The 4-year-old finished the finals second by a neck at age 2; second by a quarter-length at age 3; and was also third in last week's elimination after winning seven straight.

Nonetheless, trainer Jim King Jr. is looking forward to this afternoon and hopes to put the Breeders Crown past behind him.

"I'm not happy about losing, but I thought she went a tremendous mile," King said after Lyons Sentinel was third in the Mare Pace's single elimination, beaten a length by Rocknificent in 1:48.4. "She was out a long ways, got flushed early. They went big around the turn and by the time they got down to the wire, she was coming again.

"So, I'm not displeased at all. I don't feel at all discouraged about how things will go (this) week. I'm just glad we didn't draw the 10 hole. Our being here (for the elimination) was all about the draw. Sometimes things work, and sometimes they don't."

Breeders Crown elimination winners got to draw for a starting spot in posts one through five as the reward for their victory. Lyons Sentinel will race out of post three today and is the 5-2 morning-line favorite despite her elim setback. Rocknificent got post one and is the 3-1 second choice.

Racing begins at noon today at the Big M and features eight Breeders Crown finals for horses ages 3 and up.

Lyons Sentinel, a daughter of Captaintreacherous out of Tutu Hanover, has won 21 of 44 races and \$1.84 million in her career. This year she has hit the board in 13 of 16 races, with nine firsts, a second and three thirds good for \$604,183 in earnings.

Driven by Tim Tetrick, Lyons Sentinel had a qualifier leading up to the elimination. She won in 1:53.1 with a :26 final quarter.

"That's not the same (as racing)," said King, who won a Crown with Shartin N in 2018. "But this (elimination) is a good mile under her and I'm coming to win this week. I hope it happens. Trips make all the difference.

"It was a tough go, but that's okay; one of her best miles was the last time she got beat. It was out of the 10 hole right here (in the Dorothy Haughton Memorial), and she raced a tremendous mile and ended up fourth. I don't know if she was ever better than that."

Rocknificent, who finished second to Lyons Sentinel five times this year before beating her in the elimination, is trained by Linda Toscano and driven by Scott Zeron. She has four wins, eight seconds and \$365,088 in earnings this year.

"(Her elimination) was exactly the race you would love to see her get," said Toscano, who has won seven Breeders Crown trophies. "She didn't have to be used too hard, she just did her normal leave, and she got a great trip behind a horse that carried her.

"It worked out really well for us for a change because (Lyons Sentinel) is so monstrously good. She was just a little too far back and we were able to take advantage of the situation."

And while winning was nice, it was the performance that had the trainer really smiling.

"Obviously, you're always happy when you win a Breeders Crown elimination," Toscano said. "But I was more thrilled for that mare because she just comes back every week and gives us her best effort. I was tickled she could win. Scott has done an amazing job with her. He loves her and she goes so well for him."

Despite the horse finally beating her nemesis, Toscano is not predicting victory today.

"It would be fun, but I don't for one minute discount how great Lyons Sentinel is," she said. "I know how good she is."

Peaky Sneaky will take aim on a second straight Breeders Crown trophy after winning last year's race for 3-year-old female pacers. She has yet to win this year, taking three seconds and five thirds while earning \$93,479 in 14 starts. For her career she has won \$714,478 in 39 starts, winning eight.

The horse finished second for trainer Nancy Takter and driver Dexter Dunn in the elimination and is 5-1 out of post two. She will have to overcome not only her rivals today, but history as well. No female pacer has ever won the Breeders Crown at both ages 3 and 4.

"I'm happy with how she raced," Takter said. "She finished really

good. She was good with pace. She likes to race in the fall. She likes the Breeders Crown. Hopefully, she likes the Breeders Crown (this) week. I'm super happy with her."

Two horses received byes into the final, Racine Bell, who was supplemented to the race for \$32,500, and Drama Act.

Racine Bell has 11 wins, six seconds and four thirds in 23 starts for trainer David Dewhurst and has banked \$253,910 this season. Ron Burke's Drama Act has 12 wins, a second and third in 18 starts and has earned \$155,280.

The Breeders Crown Mare Pace is race nine today, the sixth of the eight Breeders Crown finals. "This horse has speed, obviously. He's got high, high speed. That's his best quality in my opinion. Maybe he could be a little stronger, then he would be like a super horse, but I think speed is his best quality, and he's a horse that's consistent. That helps a lot too."

This Is The Plan will start the final from post four and is 5-1 on the morning line. Cattlewash will leave from post five with David Miller driving for Burke and is 4-1.

The Breeders Crown Open Pace is race 11 today, the last of the eight Breeders Crown finals.

ALLYWAG HANOVER AIMS TO ROLL ON

In the Open Pace, Allywag Hanover is the 2-1 morning-line favorite out of post eight. Harness racing's No. 3-ranked horse is on a roll, having won five straight and six of seven. He received a bye into the final. In his most recent start, he paced 1:46.4 in the Allerage Open at Lexington's Red Mile to equal the world record for a gelding pacer.

"He's unreal, he's just grown up," trainer Brett Pelling said. "I can't one hundred percent put a finger on it, other than he's gotten a bit older and stronger. He's just become a better horse. He's always been a high-speed horse, but he's always liked to do things his way. Now, his way is the right way. So, he's doing great."

Allywag Hanover, by Captaintreacherous out of Anderosa Hanover, will have Todd McCarthy in the sulky. For the season, the 4-year-old gelding has won nine of 16 races and \$685,950.

"We do very little with him, he likes it that way," said Pelling, an 11-time Breeders Crown winner. "It's just working for him. As he's gotten older, he's not as hard on himself as he was before.

"He missed two weeks before he raced in Lexington, and to be honest with you, he never trained while I was down there until he came down. He just stepped out there and went (1):46.4, so he's on his game."

This Is The Plan was on his game last week, winning the Open Pace elimination by a nose over stablemate Cattlewash in 1:49.3.

"He raced really good last week," driver Yannick Gingras said. "It's been a long season, so I wanted to be able to trip him out. It looks like there is a lot of speed (in the final) so maybe we can trip him out the same way this week. He was really sharp last week, and I think he should be even better this week."

Trained by Ron Burke, the horse has six wins, eight seconds and four thirds in 22 starts, and has earned \$796,769 this year, which leads all Open Pace finalists. One of his trademarks has been his consistency.

"I think it's because of the Burke program," Gingras said. "The way they do it, they don't overdo it. They don't go speed in between races. They get some miles into them, a lot of jogging, but they also get a lot of turn out. His system works that way.
