And this was just Opening Night of Breeders Crown Weekend

The first dead heat in Breeders Crown history wasn't the only incredible thing about Opening Night at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

Let's breakdown an incredible Opening Night for the Breeders Crown at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

There were two Crown championships on the pace Friday, but three track records were recorded. The four championships produced margins



of three quarters of a length (the biggest of the four races), a half-length, a head – and a dead heat (thus setting two track records). It was the first dead heat to win in the history of the Breeders Crown.

Both of the pacing colts, Perfect Sting and Summa Cum Laude, get credit for the 1:50.2 final time, and so their names join Freaky Feet Pete and Always Bet De Grey on the Hoosier record books.


Perfect Sting looked like he had fought off arch-rival Southwind Gendry and was going to win and give David Miller his second Crown of the night and cement his spot in second place in Crown earnings. And he did, only Summa Cum Laude was flying late and earned the tie in the last step for Brian Sears, the second-winningest driver in Crown history. Joe Holloway and Ron Burke, the respective trainers, and all the owners are veterans of the Breeders Crown. (And further consolation for the Burke Brigade: Southwind Gendry got beat only a head for it all. Not that they need it after having a 21-1 victory.)

The colts made the head win of Fire Start Hanover seem like a romp for Dexter Dunn and Nifty Norman, but JK

Alwaysbalady, daughter of Horses of the Year, did her parentage and connections proud, too. Fire Start Hanover's 1:50.4 win put her next to Glorious Virgin on that line in the Hoosier record books.

On the trotting side:

David Miller won four Breeders Crown eliminations last weekend, and he continued to be in sparkling form at Harrah's Philly midweek, with three wins on each of Wednesday's and Thursday's cards – on the latter day rallying one maiden trotter from 22 lengths behind at the half, unheard-of at the speed-favoring southeast Pennsylvania oval.

Perhaps his best recent drive of all came behind Lady Chaos in winning the Crown baby filly trot. Having raced up to the lead and having Presto moving strongly to them, Miller calmly told Lady Chaos to let the other filly go without a fight into the far turn while keeping her up on the bit. The pair then found room up the inside in mid-stretch and out-trotted their opposition to the wire. The victory was the seventh Crown for Hall of Fame trainer Linda Toscano, putting her within the Top Ten (including ties) all-time in Crown training victories.

Bob McClure also had the best seat in the house behind



On A Streak in the pocket in the companion colt event, watching Captain Corey and favored Venerate slug it out, then ducking to the passing lane and having the most late in setting a record for this divisional Crown championship in 1:52.4, a tick better than Walner (trained, ironically, by Toscano), even though the temperature was under 40 degrees at post time. McClure won his first Crown; owners Determination and trainer Luc Blais had been there before, most notably with two-time Crown winner Emoticon Hanover.

One of the greatest rivalries for almost the length of the Breeders Crown series has been the battle between Hanover Shoe Farms and Brittany Farms for the most Breeders Crown

championship breeding victories. Hanover bred Fire Start Hanover, so they doubled their lead over the "friendly rivals" to 27-25...for about 50 minutes.

Then the DEAD HEAT light went on, and Brittany Farms were partners in the breeding (and the owning, thank you very much) of Perfect Sting, so we're back to a separation of one again, 27-26.

May these heavyweight breeders continue to battle for many more Crowns to come.

Oh ... did we mention that Pennsylvania sires produced the 1-2 finishers in all four Crowns? A Cantab Hall beat a Cantab Hall; a Cantab Hall beat a Bar Hopping; a Somebeachsomewhere beat an Always B Miki; and then an Always B Miki tied with a Somebeachsomewhere.

Post two, so hot last weekend with eight winners in 29 races? Before Perfect Sting, the second slot had gone empty on the night. Post four and five, which are 1-2 over the Hoosier season but only produced three and one success(es),

And how much did the weather and wind changes affect the racing? Last week, on the miserable Friday, the average last quarter with tailwind for pacers was :26.1, for trotters :27.2. This week, with a milder wind, the average last quarters in pacing races was :27.3, for trotters :28.2.

* * *

Early leader in the clubhouse for "Wish He/She Was In The Breeders Crown" would be Shishito, the 3-year-old trotting filly. The night last week before the rainy eliminations, the Father Patrick filly went wire-to-wire to win a Circuit City stake division in 1:52.2, which equaled the divisional track record (which was set in 2019 and equaled two weeks previous to her race). On Friday, she was entered in the Pegasus stake, and all she did is come out of the pocket to win again – and again in 1:52.2, equaling her own track record! And the stake record belongs to Shake It Cerry – in 1:52.2.

Shishito won \$240,512 at 2, and made the Breeders Crown final, although a bad post really hurt her chances. She was eligible this year, but after racing creditably in Pennsylvania she had to go to the sidelines for 42 days after an Aug. 30 race. Shishito picked a bad time, the "Should we go to the Crown?" time, to hit a dip – but she certainly is rebounding quite well right now.

* * *

The racing fans really responded to the quality racing offered at Hoosier, and even raised their levels on 2-year-old trotters – because they were Breeders Crown races. The Breeders Crown pacers, helped by a Pick 4, lured even more. A rough and unofficial tally done under pressure yielded an approximate figure nearing \$1.7 million. It might have gone a mite higher, but deadline is looming.

My old friend Yankee Bounty, now 8, was in to go Friday in a Hoosier overnight, but was scratched. I remember this horse winning his first eight starts as a baby in 2014, including the PA Sire Stakes Championship – but his last two PA Sires wins were by a neck and a nose, so when he came to Philly and was 1-20* in a stakes race, I tried to beat him with a horse named In The Arsenal, who did pull off the upset that day at 9-2 (maybe the last time I actually beat a favorite with a decent-priced horse on my Philly tip sheet). In The Arsenal would go on to be 3-2 in his Breeders Crown and win over a million dollars lifetime.





And of course, now center stage are tonight's plots:

- Kissin In The Sand, riding the momentum to lead her division, or Shartin N, the dominant force most of three years, taking back the ascendancy?
- Gimpanzee vs. Atlanta and has Ramona Hill built up too big a lead in Trotter of the Year consideration? (Not according to the Top Ten polls).
- Party Girl Hill vs. Tall Dark Stranger, in different races, for Pacer of the Year and perhaps Horse of the Year. (And will they race again this year? And does that depend on what Bettor's Delight does tomorrow night? And who will race against whom or the 3-year-olds against olders, if the TVG entries allow?)

That's eight out of this week's Top Ten horses, in three acts tomorrow. You don't have to be a fan of Shakespeare to appreciate the drama to be played out on the Hoosier Park stage tonight.

Lady Chaos leads orderly outcome for Cantab Hall daughters

The winners of this year's Breeders Crown Two-Year-Old Filly Trot eliminations highlighted a somewhat-surprising fact: Cantab Hall has never sired the winner of the freshman filly final. The 19-year-old stallion was inducted to the Goshen Hall of Fame in 2018 for his accomplishments at stud, and notably was named 2003 Dan Patch Trotter of the Year on the basis of his undefeated campaign at age 2. Cantab Hall's dam, Canland Hall, is even full sister to the 2001 Breeders Crown Two-Year-Old Filly Trot elim and final winner Cameron Hall. When Cantab daughters Mazzarati and Lady Chaos captured their respective eliminations last Friday at Harrah's Hoosier Park, it boosted their sire's prospects of adding this laurel to his already-significant legacy. Muscle Hill fillies have won five of the last six Crowns for this division, and there would be none in the 2020 final, race 8 on Oct. 30.

October 23 eliminations took place over a sloppy surface very unlike the fast track that greeted the field for the final. Flawless Country (2, 1:53m; \$323,121), co-fastest freshman filly trotter of 2020, was scratched from the first elimination due to illness, while divisional earnings leader Donna Soprano (2, 1:53.3s; \$433,570) jumped it off irreparably before the start of the second. The complexion of the final changed even further when #9 Gotta Believe, the Julie



Lady Chaos (David Miller) won the \$600,000 Breeders Crown for rookie trotting fillies in 1:54.4.

Miller-trained longshot who closed for place behind Mazzarati last week, was scratched sick after the draw.

A field of nine lined up behind the gate in the first of Friday night's four Breeders Crown finals, with #5 Lady Chaos (David Miller) the even-money post time favourite and #10 Presto (Yannick Gingras) starting from the second tier. #2 Iteration (Brian Sears) got the first call, but #4 Mazzarati (Tim Tetrick) grabbed the lead before the first turn, in control to the :27.1 opening quarter. That's when Lady Chaos came calling first-over from fourth, trotting smoothly around the leader as Iteration stayed inside in third. The next challenge came from #10 Presto, advancing from fifth, with a three-wide #7 Big City Pearl (Verlin Yoder) to her outside and backing off. At the :57.1 half, Presto was matching strides with Lady Chaos, then soaring past with Iteration in hot pursuit outside. The clocking at the three-quarters was 1:26, and it momentarily appeared that Presto and Iteration would be the two fillies battling down the stretch for the Crown. But the Cantab Halls had something to say about that, as the locked-in Lady Chaos shook loose from her spot behind Presto, charging inside, and an earplugs-out Mazzarati took the innermost path for a final lunge.

Under the wire, Lady Chaos prevailed by a half-length over Mazzarati, with next-closest rival #3 Splash Blue Chip (Ake Svanstedt) three-and-a-half lengths back for show. The 1:54.2 elimination winner had outdueled the 1:54.3 elimination winner in the 1:54.4 Breeders Crown final, in an all-Cantab Hall exactor paying \$20.90 for the \$2 ticket. It was her sixth win in 10 seasonal starts.

Bringing Lady Chaos to the winner's circle, Dave Miller said

the filly had responded perfectly to the varying demands within the mile: "You know what? Everybody wants to try to get into position to take shots so it's expected. The trip actually worked out good. I got parked around the first turn, but she got to the lead and relaxed. Yannick [driving Presto] came at her pretty hard and that filly was coming at her pretty hard last week, so I followed her around the turn and into the stretch and my mare had a lot of trot finishing."

Linda Toscano had praise for the event itself, and how Lady Chaos has handled the chaotic year that was 2020: "Well, it's the Breeders Crown. It all comes down to the Breeders Crown. It's really exciting. I've loved her from the minute we bought her and she's done everything right. We had a couple of glitches along the way, but she really rose to the occasion tonight. I'm tickled."

Lady Chaos, who sold at the 2019 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale under original name Tiger Mom Lindy, is out of the Muscles Yankee mare Strong Legacy (3, 1:58.3f; \$6,130), a full sister to multiple Dan Patch Award winner Mr Muscleman (1:51.1m; \$3,582,823). The mare's firstborn foal, bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut and Av and Son LLC, New York, brought a top bid of \$125,000. Strong Legacy's 2020 yearling, a Walner colt named Strongerwithlindy, brought just \$10,000 at Lexington, a trend which will likely reverse for the dam when next year's sale arrives.

Lady Chaos is owned by Richard Gutnick (PA), Tom Pontone (NJ), Joseph Lozito Jr. (NJ), and Enviro Stables (FL). Gutnick has co-owned previous Breeders Crown champions Chapter Seven (2011 Three-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Trot; 2012 Open Trot), and Market Share (2013 Open Trot), who were also trained by Toscano. Last year, she became the first woman to be inducted into the Goshen Hall of Fame for her career achievements as trainer.

On A Streak sets 1:52.4 stakes record to give McClure first Crown victory

The trifecta of owner Determination Stable, trainer Luc Blais and driver Bob McClure had another crowning moment together, this time at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Friday night.

While winning the 2019 Hambletonian with Forbidden Trade earned rave reviews as a blockbuster performance, what the trio did with On A Streak in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old male trotters can be considered a worthy sequel.

It was an effort that undoubtedly deserved an emphatic two-thumbs up.

Although the tote board suggested it was a two-horse race between Venerate and Captain Corey, On A Streak and driver Bob McClure had plans of their own in the fall showcase for rookie trotters.

And in the end, the Determination charge, bred by Fredericka V Caldwell, was a study in just that.

Sent on his way at 9-1, the son of Cantab Hall reeled in leader and second choice Captain Corey in deep stretch, and fended off In Range by three-quarters of a length to record the biggest win of his career to date. Venerate, the 4-5 favorite, was third.

It was the bay's first victory since a 15-1 upset in the \$535,000 William Wellwood final at Mohawk on Sept. 12.

After finishing third to Venerate in the inaugural Mohawk Million, the \$155,000 purchase at the 2019 Lexington Select Yearling Sale qualified at Mohawk on Oct. 13 in 1:59.2. Last Saturday, On A Streak finished fourth in his Breeders Crown elimination, trotting the mile in 1:54.2.

On Friday, he was at the top of his game, crossing the wire in a career best and stakes record 1:52.4. The previous stakes record of 1:53 was set by Walner in 2016.

A sizzling opening quarter-mile in :26.4 and a half timed in :55.3 courtesy of Captain Corey provided McClure the opportunity to keep a patient hand in the early stages of the race.

"I knew we were moving along and my colt is so handy



getting him off the gate, I wanted to leave and hopefully follow either Ake [Svanstedt, piloting Captain Corey] or Andy [Miller, driving Venerate] or even both. When I saw Ake look

over and try to take off on Andy, I thought 'This is looking really good."

McClure, in the midst of another strong season in the race bike, was bang-on in his assessment.

As the field turned for home, he felt even more optimistic about his chances.

"Andy's horse still seemed like he was coming, so I just tried to get into the passing lane and get him re-motivated. You know, it's not easy for 2-year-old trotters to dive into the passing lane and try to advance, that's not really taught to them, but he's such a professional. As soon as he saw open air he took off."

McClure, who recorded his first Breeders Crown triumph, was thrilled to deliver the trophy to his teammates.

"It's really nice. We've had some bad luck between me and Luc. He's had plenty of luck without me, so I was starting to think it was me, so obviously we had a really nice trotting filly [Donna Soprano] and I thought we had the best chance to get [a Crown] with her and I couldn't get her in, so it was really nice for the connections – owner Determination Stable and Luc Blais – that I worked out a trip with this guy and Luc had him awesome.

"I've had nothing but bad luck in the Breeders Crown finals, so it's nice to turn the table on that because that race, it required a whole lot of luck and I got it so it worked out."

Blais, whose brother Coco is the groom of On A Streak, knew the odds might have been against a win against a pair of accomplished trotting talents, but he wasn't about to throw in the towel.

"I think he raced good last week, come back :26.3 and today he was a closer in the stretch. I think he felt better. He needed a race before that race and he was stronger tonight. Winning a Breeders Crown is always special."

As for what's next for the Crown champion, it appears that

decision will be made, in some part, by On A Streak.

Said Blais, "We'll see tomorrow how he feels."

For the moment, the trio of owner, trainer and driver, will soak up a picture-perfect evening. Well, almost.

Despite not having Determination frontman Serge Godin there to see the race live (due to COVID-19 restrictions), Blais and McClure were happy to hoist the hardware on his behalf.

"Winning the Breeders Crown with a 2-year-old is very special," said Blais. "The season is long, it's almost November and it's far from home. It's tough to race at that time for 2-year-olds. We love the game and we're really happy, but I would like to see him in the picture."

"It's special for Determination and Luc Blais," said McClure. "I couldn't pick a better group to win it for. They've done so much for me."

And on Friday night in the Hoosier State, On A Streak did just as much for the trio.

The betting public considered the Oct. 30 Breeders Crown Two-Year-Old Filly Pace Final at Hoosier Park a wide open race, making three fillies a trio of choices and not settling on either of last week's two elimination winners as the favorite.

The public was almost correct, though, because early in the betting, Fire Start Hanover was the favorite. However, the bulk of the win pool money made Scarlett Hanover — who finished second to JK Alwaysblady in her elim win — the favorite. Meanwhile, Fire Start Hanover's odds rose and she took the second-choice spot, winning in a tight photo for the 1:50.4 mile.



"We looked at the race on paper and there were five I thought could leave pretty hard," he said. "It was one of those races where you had to see what was happening out of the gate. There were only a couple coming out hard, so we pushed her and got into a pretty good hole on the first turn."

Dunn had to brush his filly three wide this week to get the lead, passing the other two favorites, JK Alwaysblady and an on-coming Somethingbeautiful. He was aware of the chase. "I could feel Yannick [Gingras on JK Alwaysblady] coming so I was looking for the wire... She was getting a little tired at the end."

When Somethingbeautiful began to gallop, Matt Kakaley charged by with Scarlett Hanover and met Fire Start Hanover almost dead-on at the finish. Still, Dexter said, "[Fire Start Hanover] was much sharper this week than last week."

Trainer "Nifty" Norman won his fifth Breeders Crown race with the victory.

"It's a race you want to win all year," he said. "It's the one you circle on the calendar. It's a fantastic evening."

Norman agreed the race was wide open. "It's a strong division. The draw [post 7] was a little bit of a worry because she had to do a lot of work." Still, he said he was very confident because "she's a great and beautiful filly... She's been beautiful from day one. She got better and better. She's

a big, strong thing and I think she'll keep getting better."

Dunn added, "About five or six starts ago she really hit her form, two wins [at Hoosier], two wins at The Red Mile and she really hit her stride. She's so strong."

Bred by Hanover Farms, Fire Start Hanover (Somebeachsomewhere—Fit To Frame, by Art Major) won her seventh race in 11 starts in the abbreviated 2020 season.

Pinske Stables, David K Hoese and Lawrence M. Means own the filly.

Co-owner Marlys Pinske was aglow after the photo came up for her filly. "We won our first Breeders Crown last year so this is absolutely wonderful." She said she felt the filly could win all along.

Fire Start Hanover paid \$8.20 to win over Scarlett Hanover, second in the photo, and JK Alwaysblady took the show spot. That one's mare, JK She'salady, holds the Breeders Crown record of 1:50.2 at The Meadowlands in 2014 for the event.

Pinske said that Fire Start Hanover is headed to Florida to train for the winter.

Dead-heat: Perfect Sting and Summa Cum Laude can't be separated in juvenile pace

Brittany Farms and Val Dor Farms' Perfect Sting book-ended a perfect season for Hall of Fame trainer Joe Holloway with dead-heat scores by sharing honors with longshot Summa Cum Laude in Friday's \$600,000 Breeders Crown juvenile pace at Harrah's Hoosier Park (Perfect Sting also dead-heated in his July 28 pari-mutuel debut at the Meadowlands).

The Breeders Crown final brought the unstoppable force that is Perfect Sting to meet the immovable object in the shape of the Ron Burke-trained Southwind Gendry on a clear and chilly evening.

Neither pacer had lost a race in the last two months but something had to give on this night as the two phenoms squared off for the first time with year-end honors hanging in the balance.

Although eight other colts lined up to solve the intriguing paradox, only the 1-2 Perfect Sting and 2-1 Southwind Gendry were less than double digits on the tote board with the remainder of the field seemingly resigned to roles as extras in a showcase of two protagonists, who had dominated their division throughout the season.

The regally-bred Perfect Sting was the result of a pairing of two former Holloway trainees in Hall of Famer Always B Miki and champion Shebestingin. He entered last week's facile elimination victory over the Burke-trained Summa Cum Laude from scores in the Kentucky Sire Stakes championship ahead of wins in divisions of the Bluegrass and International Stallion Stakes.

Southwind Gendry, also by Always B Miki, brought a record of nine wins from 11 starts to the Breeders Crown final, including the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship as well as divisions of the Bluegrass and International Stallion Stakes.

The stage was set for a heavyweight fight of epic proportions with Southwind Gendry, from post 3 in rein to Yannick Gingras, commanding the early lead through a quick quarter in :25.3 as Perfect Sting, from post 2 for David Miller,

made sure his rival earned the point.

Miller and Perfect Sting pulled the pocket down the backstretch to take control through a half-mile in :54.1 and led the field into the turn with Abuckabett Hanover.

Perfect Sting held sway down the lane under persistent pressure from a stubborn Southwind Gendry as Abuckabett Hanover broke stride from a threatening position. Perfect Sting, dead game and flat out through three-quarters in 1:22.4, put away his co-headliner late in the lane but from out of the clouds came the Brian Sears-piloted Summa Cum Laude — the other Burke charge — with the duo hitting the

wire together in a final time of 1:50.2.

In a photo review, that took longer than the race itself, the judges could not separate Perfect Sting and 21-1 Summa Cum Laude, providing the first dead heat in Breeders Crown history. Southwind Gendry made the photo but had to settle for third.

Holloway, who had to share the spoils on this night, regardless declared his horse a champion following the race.

"It means a lot. I had the mother, the father. We talked the talk early and said he was going to be the best and he backed it up. He raced really huge tonight," said Holloway, who also conditioned three-time Breeders Crown-winner and two-time Pacer of the Year Jenna's Beach Boy. "Early on I said (Perfect Sting) could be the best one I've ever had, and I think he's proven it. None of my others ever went undefeated at 2."

In last week's elimination, Miller guided Perfect Sting through more moderate splits of :26.3, :55.1 and 1:24.3 en route to a four-length victory over the chasing Summa Cum Laude in 1:50.4. There were no easy fractions for Perfect Sting in the final and Miller tipped his cap to the young horse for battling to the wire.

"Well, his dad and Wiggle It Jiggleit, they used to go at it like that all the time. Neither one of us, Yannick or me, wanted to give our horses any breathers," said Miller. "I kind of figured it was going to be a battle, but (Perfect Sting) held strong. He battled a long ways and he held on. He showed his guts there."

The veteran reinsman said he only realized Summa Cum Laude was in the mix for a result of the highest distinction at the final moment.

"Right at the wire I looked over and saw him," said Miller. "I was still kind of judging Gendry and I looked over at the last second and saw Brian right there and it looked like he had momentum."

While Miller was looking for the wire, Sears was searching for just a little more racetrack with the on-tilt Summa Cum Laude.

"Getting away fourth, I didn't take the worst spot," said Sears. "Yannick was pushing the pace a little bit going to the half and I thought the way this horse could follow along pretty good, I sat in fourth and figured I could shake loose. I was following the right horses and it worked out.

"I was just counting them as I was going by. I knew I was closing in. The stretch is really long here, so I thought I was never quite out of it until it's over."

For Burke, it was a tale of two stretch drives with Southwind Gendry perfectly placed to go by if good enough, only for the longer-priced stablemate to provide late drama.

"The other horse got stung 25-and-a-piece, so I'm not embarrassed at all by him and then this colt, like, it was great. He angled him out late and was airborne," said Burke. "F - - - ing Perfect Sting is hard to get around! You just can't get around him. I thought we had him with the other colt and this colt, I don't know, to be honest, to be fair to Perfect Sting, if he ever saw us coming."

Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Phillip Collura, J and T Silva - Purnel and Libby and Weaver Bruscemi, Summa Cum Laude had to settle for completing the exacta behind Perfect Sting in the Bluegrass and International Stallion Stakes.

"He's a young horse and he's getting better and better," said Burke. "He's going to be a good colt next year. He's a good colt now, but the big track has helped him a lot. He just had to get off those small tracks."

By Somebeachsomewhere, Summa Cum Laude returned \$11.30 for a \$2 win ticket, while Perfect Sting's backers were rewarded with a \$2.20 payoff.

The only Crown race with fewer than 10 starters:

- **#1 Weslynn Quest's** sire won the Crown (2YOCT) in 2010 (Manofmanymissions). Has raced at five straight different tracks. Tough spot.
- #2 Conway Kellyanne is the rare Breeders Crown starter by a 1990s award winner 2YOCT of the Year Conway Hall (1997). In Deep.
- **#3 Pat Matters** is no doubt entering the Crown at the right time. Peaking. Nifty got money with all five Crowns starters in 2019.
- **#4 When Dovescry** is in a matchup of the last two years' Oaks winners. Pelling was the 2003 leading money-winning Crown trainer and goes back to 1996 with Mystical Maddy for his first score in the Breeders Crown series.
- **#5 Plunge Blue Chip** was on the board a year ago in this. She's won at two different tracks in sub-1:50 and is the first 3-year-old to do so at the Meadowlands, male or female.
- **#6 Felicity Shagwell S** tries to get Ake's barn started in the Crown but 1-for-20 covering two seasons will not help.
- **#7 Manchego** won here at 2 to complete a 12-for-12 season as the freshman leader. History's fastest female trotter is the single in here for those looking to jump-start their Pick-8 tickets.
- #8 Grand Swan— is one of five Swan For Alls in the Crown (None closer than post 8) at the track where he won twice in 2017 in the inaugural Crown locally with daughter Hannelore Hanover and son Fifty Dallarbill. Grand Swan: 50% over the last two seasons: 13-for-26.

Race 9 - 3YOFT

#1 Next Level Stuff— is 12-for-22 lifetime from the first crop of the late Sebastian K. Excellent betting affair.

- **#2 Crucial** squeaked into the final. One of 20 for Burke this weekend. Father Patrick was at his best come Crown time. (2013-2014 winner)
- #3 May Baby was short in this final last year and tries to carry the locals banner as far as she can.



- **#4 Sorella** is a homebred who has been right at the top of the division all year and carried herself well.
- **#5 Spoiled Princess** shows two big last quarters in October and that should translate into major contention.
- **#6 A Bs Attitudeexpress** is another shot for Lucas Wallin, who is trying to be the 165th trainer to win at least one Breeders Crown.
- **#7 Hypnotic Am** Brian Sears has six wins in this division and 12 sophomore Breeders Crown trotting trophies overall. No doubt the one to beat.

- **#2 Party Girl Hill** 14-for-14. A filly for the ages. Chris Ryder's specialty. Dexter Dunn looks to make a loud statement tonight with HOY honors still up in the air.
- **#3 Lyons Sentinel** The best three-win season ever? She showed them her heels in the elims big time. Runner-up last year as the strong favorite. Best chance at an upset (PIck-8 players pay attention here).
- **#4 Peaky Sneaky** is super sharp as these top three have spread-eagled themselves from the others.
- **#5 Pettycoat Business** is like Party Girl Hill in one way. Neither raced at 2. Remember the 2017 winner of this Crown, Blazin Britches, had just a lone start and no money at 2.
- **#6 Rocknificent** is a daughter of Captaintreacherous who was 1-2-3 in the 2YOFP a year back and Rockclamation, who banked well over \$2 million career.

- **#7 J K First Lady** is by a HOY sire-Western Ideal (Rocknroll Hanover) and out of the undefeated 2014 HOY JK Shesalady. A very consistent sort needs some help from others.
- **#8 Lady Lou** is a daughter of Sweet Lou who has won three Breeders Crown in 2018-2019. But 2-for-27 is what it is.
- **#9 Hen Party**—has banked well over \$500,000 and is by Crown-winning sire Roll With Joe (Racing Hill-2016).
- **#10 New Year** is Party Girl Hill's stablemate and Chris Ryders' pacing girls legacy includes Cathedra Dot Com, I Luv The Nitelife and Put On A Show.

Race 11 - 3YOCT final

- **#1 Capricornus** lit up the board in the elims. Marcus Melander is the defending Trainer of the Year and we just saw why a week ago.
- **#2** Amigo Volo is the standout on the card tonight. If your max play is \$20, double it. He's that good. Reminds me of 2007, when a gelding by the name of Arch Madness erupted onto the scene and handed Donato Hanover (the HOY), his only two defeats of the year.
- #3 Ready For Moni Hambletonian winners are just 6-for-37 through the years in the Breeders Crown in the same year. (Ramona Hill scratched from the Crown this year). Hambletonian runner-ups are 6-for-36. Tough to maintain your form that long.
- **#4 Play Trix On Me** No, your eyes are not deceiving you, \$4,500 is the yearling price. But, hey, Mr Muscleman sold for \$2,000 as a yearling and won two Crowns (3 and 5).
- **#5 Hillexotic** Trond Smedshammer has won nine Breeders Crowns all with Sears driving. He's 0-for-10 driving himself, but remember he did win the filly counterpart to this last year with Winndevie.
- **#6 Maesteraemon** is likely filling out the field, but didn't we say the same thing last week with Capricornus? Same barn, too.
- **#7 Back Of The Neck** hit the board in the Hambletonian. Must mind his manners and show he can trot both ends. The talent is there.
- **#8 Beads** quietly had one of the best elims of all. Remember Brian Sears has six wins in this division. Per Engblom worked for years under the Master, Jimmy Takter, who has 34 Crown wins lifetime.
- **#9 Chestnut Hill** paid \$122.90 in the Canadian Trotting Classic. By the way, that was the second time this year Richard Norman lit up the board to a triple figure payoff in a big stake. He won the Dorothy Haughton also \$108.20 over HOY Shartin N.

#10 Gangster Hanover— closed with abandon last out. Andy McCarthy posted a four-bagger last year in the Crown, the only driver ever to win his first four Crowns all in the same season.

Race 12 - Open Mare Pace final

- **#1 Sweet Lucy Lou** will try and post a monstrous upset. But, remember, Blazin Britches qualified seventh in 2017 here and won the final.
- **#2 Rockin Nola** has been the Horse of the Meet at Hoosier Park and father-son Putnams gave her the much deserved chance.
- **#3 Kissin In The Sand** has been great at 2-3-5, tough to do something like that, kinda like a Pure Country. She loves her work of late and is no doubt the fave.
- **#4 Caviart Ally** is the defending champ, but her prep was not what you'd want. Still, she's been remarkable and can get off the wings with any mare who has ever lived.
- **#5 Warrawee Ubeaut** goes for the three-peat. Only Jennas Beach Boy has done it three straight (1994-1995-1996) on the pacing side. Incredible mare goes to 50 per cent lifetime with a win (22-for-44).
- **#6 Shartin N** the 2019 HOY. Never has a pacer been named HOY and then won a Crown the following year. She can be the first. Wonderful race.
- **#7 Philly Hanover** more than pays her way but this division is deep very deep.
- **#8 Treacherous Reign** remember Tony Alagna won three Crowns in 2019. From Captain's first crop.
- **#9 Trillions Hanover** qualified back in good order, but needs to pull a rabbit or two-out of her hat.
- **#10 Stonebridge Soul** hasn't won at three after a strong showing in 2019. Brett Miller won Pure Country's first Crown as she went undefeated in 2015.

Race 13 - 3YOCP final

- #1 Tall Dark Stranger has the inside draw with HOY implications in the air. He has the same career slate after 21 starts that Niatross did 19-for-21. From the 15th crop of Bettors Delight. Yannick Gingras, somehow, has not won this division, but his 22-for-89 record in the Crown (last decade) speaks for itself. Congrats to Nancy, Katie and the entire team for a job very well done here.
- **#2 Manticore** for the man who won this race 10 years ago, Bruce Saunders, with Rock N Roll Heaven. This colt is deceptively sharp and can be used in exotics. Can Bill Matz do it again? In Indiana? (Beckhams Z Tam 2017).

Harness Racing Update

- **#3 Cattlewash** —Is there anyone hotter than this horse coming into the Crown? Sire SBSW leads all stallions with 14 Crown finalists. The pick to click.
- **#4 Warrawee Vital** fell a buck shy in his prep and clearly is better on the bigger track. He benefits the most from the long Hoosier stretch and Tim knows that. Quietly, Robert Fellows is in both sophomore Crowns.
- **#5 Save Me A Dance** is sired by Heston Blue Chip, who won this race in 2012. He's making money in the classics.
- **#6 No Lou Zing** has a world of talent and has not missed the board. Reminds me of Lather Up at the same point of their careers.
- **#7 Captain Barbossa** got his first win in the Jug with a stirring performance. Still very sharp, but the division is top heavy.
- **#8 Sandbetweenmytoes** is sired by the 2013 and 2018 winner of this race SBSW, who himself called it a career in 2008 after capturing the 3YOCP.
- **#9** The Greek Freak pays his way and can pick up others. Matt Kakaley had three 100-1 shots a year ago in the Crown and unbelievably got money with all three.
- **#10 Elver Hanover** is history's fastest freshman and has been solid throughout. It's just that the water is deeper in this end.

Race 14 - Open Trot final

- **#1 Mission Accepted** is a son of a Breeders Crown winner and a stablemate to the great Atlanta. Along for a share.
- **#2 Majestic Player A** is 65 per cent on the year, but not a winner the last four, but still has been never better. Figure it out.
- **#3 Gimpanzee** looks to equal the great Mack Lobell's 1986-1987-1988 record of winning the Crown at 2-3-4. His prep was perfect.
- **#4 Reign Of Honor** a full brother to Amigo Volo, was sired by Father Patrick while he was still racing. Has gate speed that likely will be called on tonight.
- **#5 Atlanta** is looking for that elusive Crown. Past \$2.5 million, the great mare is already in the category of Peaceful Way, Bee A Magician and Peace Corps. The one to beat.
- **#6 Lindy The Great** yielded late and is still winless for Team Miller. But remember they won the 2009 edition of this one with Lucky Jim.
- #7 Soul Strong needs to pick up his game a lot to get

- money. He did get fourth in the Hambletonian a year back.
- **#8 Katkin America** looks to complete the third father-son driving Crown double. The Yoders would join Ron/Randy Waples and Carl/Rod Allen.
- **#9 Crystal Fashion** was quietly the #1 trotting earner in the sport in 2018 and the Hambletonian fave. He is still plugging along and can be used in exotics.
- **#10 Fiftydallarbill** —won this at 2 in 2017, but is facing a big uphill battle tonight.

Race 15 - Open Pace final

- **#1 Sectionline Bigry** showed that :24.4 close while weaving late. Sharp. Young and capable Tyler Smith has a good one here. Steve Bauder looks to get on the training board in Crown history.
- **#2 Filibuster Hanover** has 15 wins and \$1.8 million showing how tough he is and how often he is a factor. Tonight too.
- **#3 Western Joe** hasn't won in a while but has stepped up when least expected before.
- **#4 Dorsudoro Hanover** won the Crown in 2018, and surges past \$2 million career first or second tonight.
- **#5 Sintra** to me is the most interesting horse in the field. He benefits when they go tooth and nail. That figures to be the case tonight. Watch him pick up horses late and include on your ticket.
- **#6 Backstreet Shadow** is 17-for-40 covering 2019-2020 and against many of the best, including these. Cannot dismiss.
- **#7 Century Farroh** is a 50 per cent winner at 3/4 and has to be used.
- **#8 Dancin Lou** tries the very tough 3-4 Crown Daily Double. The fastest ever to 20 Crown wins, Mr. Sears will have him in position.
- #9 Bettors Wish— figures to be the last to the top in what may be his final start. Just nipped by Dancin Lou a year ago. One to beat.
- **#10** This Is The Plan— is going to be a bomber. One of four Burke starters in the curtain closer.

It's all systems go for Chris Ryder in Breeders Crown

Chris Ryder says having a horse like Bettor's Wish is probably the highlight of his career as a trainer. Having another like Party Girl Hill is not far behind.

"That's exactly right," Ryder said. "It's great to have two horses like this."

Bettor's Wish, a 4-year-old stallion, is the 8-5 morning-line favorite in tonight's (Oct. 31) \$500,000 Breeders Crown Open Pace at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Five races earlier, Party Girl Hill, unbeaten in 14 lifetime starts, is the 2-5 choice in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown final for 3-year-old female pacers.

Party Girl Hill is the No. 2-ranked horse in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll, behind 3-year-old male pacer Tall Dark Stranger. Bettor's Wish is No. 8.

Bettor's Wish, co-owned by Ryder, has won five of 10 races this year and \$384,732. His triumphs include the Sam McKee Memorial, Dayton Pacing Derby, and Allerage Farms Open Pace. He was second in the Dan Patch Stakes.

For his career, the son of Bettor's Delight-Lifetime Star has won 23 of 41 starts and \$2.30 million. He led the sport in earnings in 2019 with \$1.64 million and was the Dan Patch Award winner for best 3-year-old male pacer.

At the end of the season, Bettor's Wish will retire to

stallion duties at Diamond Creek Farm of Pennsylvania.

"Bettor's Wish is probably the highlight of my training career," Ryder said. "He's like part of the family. He's got such a great personality, I really appreciate him around the barn, and he just keeps coming out and producing



time after time. Right now, he's just got a couple starts left. Then you realize it's going to be done. It's going to be bittersweet. But we're pleased it's working out the way it is.

"He's going to retire sound and at the top of his game. He's got a great gait, a great attitude, a big heart, he knows how to win, and he's from a great family; I don't know what more people could want in a horse. He's going to be a popular stallion. It's going to be fun to see his babies."

Bettor's Wish was purchased for \$20,000 at the 2017 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. Ryder owns the horse with Bella Racing, Fair Island Farm, and Bettors Wish Partners.

Last year in the Breeders Crown, Bettor's Wish finished second by a head to Dancin Lou. This year, he starts from post nine, the outermost spot on the gate. He brings a three-race win streak to the final.

"No matter how it goes, he's the horse to beat," said Ryder, who has won four Breeders Crown trophies in his career. "He had the seven (post) in the Allerage and eight in the Sam McKee, and he got the job done. He's real good at the moment. If he stays healthy, I think people are going to see something pretty good."

Something pretty good could be in store with Party Girl Hill, as well. Unraced at age 2 because of an injury, she has dominated at 3. Her victories this season include the Fan Hanover, Jugette, Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship, and Tattersalls Pace division, where she became only the second pacing filly to beat male rivals in a race worth at least \$100,000 in the last 30 years. She won her Jugette elimination in 1:49.3, the first sub-1:50 mile on a half-mile track by a female pacer in history.

"It's all systems go," Ryder said. "It's not like she's done a lot of easy races, they've all been top of the line.

"She's a phenomenal filly. I feel confident going into (the final), although there are some tremendous horses here. She has many qualities. She's got class. She's got speed and she can relax. She's got it all. She is versatile and takes everything that comes at her. She's undefeated, you can't beat that."

Party Girl Hill, a daughter of Captaintreacherous—Look Cheap, is owned by breeder Tom Hill.

Lyons Sentinel, the 2019 Dan Patch Award winner for best 2-year-old filly pacer, is the 9-2 second choice in the Crown

final. Peaky Sneaky is 5-1.

Takter hopes 'Kissin' ends Crown curse

Two years ago, trainer Nancy Takter accepted a bye for Kissin In

The Sand and advanced directly to the Breeders Crown final for 3-year-old female pacers. By skipping the eliminations, though, Kissin In The Sand missed the chance to earn an inside starting position with a win.

Kissin In The Sand ended up drawing post nine for the final at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, got parked out the entire mile, and finished second by three-quarters of a length.

So, this year when Takter was once again offered a Breeders Crown bye for Kissin In The Sand, she declined.

And Kissin In The Sand drew post nine for her elimination at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

"I was like, what the heck," Takter said with a laugh. This time, however, Kissin In The Sand prevailed from post nine, winning the single elimination by three-quarters of a length and securing post-position safety for the final.

Kissin In The Sand starts from post three in tonight's \$300,000 Breeders Crown Mare Pace at Hoosier Park. Dexter Dunn will drive the 5-year-old, who brings a five-race win

streak to the event and is the 7-5 morning-line favorite.

"She's just been really good," Takter said. "She's a little cursed when it comes to the Breeders Crown, so I hope we can get this done. She's my girl."

Kissin The Sand is making her fourth appearance in the Breeders Crown, and her third in a final. Last year, she drew post seven in a seven-horse Mare Pace final at Woodbine Mohawk Park and finished third. In 2017, at Hoosier, she drew post eight in an eight-horse elimination and failed to advance.

For her career, the daughter of Somebeachsomewhere—Kiss Me Kate has won 25 of 56 races and \$1.51 million for owners Marvin Katz and Hatfield Stables. She was a Dan Patch Award winner at age 3.

Saturday's Mare Pace field includes three previous Breeders Crown champions: 2019 Mare Pace winner Caviart Ally, 2018 Mare Pace winner Shartin N, and 2- and 3-year-old filly winner Warrawee Ubeaut. Shartin N, the 2019 Horse of the Year, is the 2-1 second choice.

Caviart Ally will attempt to become the first repeat Mare Pace winner since Shelliscape in 2013-14. Warrawee Ubeaut will try to become the first female pacer to win three consecutive Breeders Crown finals and the first 3-year-old filly champ to win the Mare Pace as a 4-year-old.

Kissin In The Sand is one of four morning-line favorites Takter will send out in Saturday's eight Breeders Crown finals. The others are 3-year-old colt pacer Tall Dark Stranger, 3-year-old filly trotter Spoiled Princess, and 5-year-old mare

trotter Manchego.

Manchego is a two-time Breeders Crown champion, with titles at ages 2 and 4. Only three trotters in history have won three or more Breeders Crown trophies. Female trotter Peace Corps holds the record with four. Grades Singing, another female, won three as did male trotter Mack Lobell.

Manchego, a daughter of Muscle Hill—Secret Magic, has won 31 of 54 career races and \$2.41 million. She was a Dan Patch Award winner at age 2 and is owned by Black Horse Racing. She will start the \$300,000 Breeders Crown Mare Trot from post seven with Dunn in the sulky and is the 8-5 morning-line favorite.

She is the fastest female trotter in history, with a 1:49 mile in 2019, and the only female trotter ever with sub-1:50 wins in multiple years.

Last Saturday, Manchego finished second to Gimpanzee, a

stallion with two Breeders Crown titles to his credit, in an invitational at Hoosier. She was sixth for most of the mile before closing with a :25.1 last quarter. As a point of reference, the fastest last quarter by a trotter in Breeders Crown history is :26, shared by Greenshoe and Chin Chin Hall in 2019.

"I was really happy with her," said Takter, a four-time Breeders Crown winner. "I made some changes on her just to keep her a little quieter. I changed her bit and put an ear hood on her, just so she could maybe be taken off the gate a little bit more and not go so hard the first three-eighths of a mile. She trotted really good. I changed her shoes up a little bit too. I think she'll be in good form this week. She needed that mile."

Elitloppet winner Cokstile moves to trainer Holger Ehlert

Norwegian bred and Italian owned Cokstile was awarded the victory in Elitloppet on Thursday due to the disqualification of Propulsion in the big race that was held at Solvalla at the ends of May this year.

Cokstile's owner Renato Santese makes some interesting statements on the Italian web site Galoppo e Trotto (http://gaet.it) where he speaks about the horse's future. According to Santese, Cokstile will shortly be trained by Holger Ehlert, who recently has experienced some really successful weeks in Italy. Ehlert won the \$995,00 Italian Derby two weeks ago with Bleff Dipa and last week, his Zacon Gio claimed the \$780,000 Gran Premio della Lotteria in Naples by defeating Europe's champion Face Time Bourbon.

Cokstile was scratched out of the Lotteria race in Naples due to a problem in a leg and next entry on the track will probably be in \$125,000 Gran Premio Duomo in Florence, Italy.

"Regarding the schedule for next year, it will be set after we've seen how many mares Cokstile will get in breeding business. Since the horse's bank account increased this week. Cokstile is already qualified for Prix d'Amérique. We'll see how we make the schedule for him and it might be that we aim for the Lotteria (in spring 2021) and then try to defend the title at Solvalla, in Elitloppet," said Renato Santese.

Gennaro Casillo has trained Cokstile the past months while Rocco Spagnulo was the man behind the 7-year-old Quite Easy son when Elitloppet was held in May.

French winter meeting is off and trotting

Vincennes racetrack opened its gates for the winter meeting 2020/2021 on Wednesday afternoon (Oct. 28) and the harness racing eyes will be aimed at Paris' racetrack until the end of February next year, when the meeting closes.

Jean-Michel Bazire is usually the king of Paris and he got a great start of the meeting when he drove his Dorgos du Guez to safe victory in \$87,800 Prix de Cevennes on Wednesday's race card.

Dorgos du Guez sprinted to victory in mile rate 1:57.1 over 1.7 miles and Bazire's horse defeated several well merited trotters such as Bahia Quesnot, Carat Williams and Anzi des Liards.

Conway Hall retired from stud duty

Conway Hall, one of the most influential trotting sires of the modern era, has been retired from the stud. Soon to be 26 years old, the infirmities of his age have rendered Conway Hall unable to continue as an active breeding stallion. The announcement of his retirement was made by Alan J. Leavitt, manager of the Conway Hall Syndicate. Leavitt also stated that Conway Hall is now back at Walnut Hall Ltd., in Lexington, KY where he will live out the rest of his days in the comfort and love he so richly deserves.

Trained by Bob Stewart, Conway Hall won \$818,884 at 2 and 3. At 2, he was unanimously voted the Champion Trotting Colt, winning USHWA's Dan Patch Award, HTA's Nova Award, and Standardbred Canada's O'Brien Award.

At 3, he got off to a late start due to an injury, but he continued to compete at the highest level. After finishing 2-1-2 in the Kentucky Futurity, he flew to Italy and won the classic Orsi Mangelli in straight heats, both times whipping the Italian champion Varenne.

Retired to the stud at 4, Conway Hall from his first crop had both the Champion Two-Year-Old Colt, the undefeated Broadway Hall, and the Champion Two-Year-Old Filly, the sensational Pizza Dolce.

From his second crop, Conway Hall got the Triple Crown Champion Windsong's Legacy, who, although ill-fated to die after his fourth year in the stud, sired Chapter Seven, a top stakes winner and now a leading sire. Chapter Seven's credits include the undefeated Walner, whose first crop are bringing record prices at the 2020 yearling sales.

Conway Hall sired a total of 1,658 foals registered with the USTA, and they have won more than \$89.5 million to date, and counting. In addition to the aforementioned Broadway Hall, Pizza Dolce, and Triple Crown Champion Windsong's Legacy, Conway Hall's other outstanding progeny include the Kentucky Futurity winner Wishing Stone, with earnings of \$2,359,150; Win Missy B., winner of the Peaceful Way Stakes, Goldsmith Maid, and Kentucky Filly Futurity; Wellwood winner Habitat; and Creamy Mimi, winner of the Hambletonian Oaks.
