Final Breeders Crown thoughts as Grand Circuit turns to Hoosier

The Carl Erskine, Monument Circle, Crossroads of America and USS Indianapolis are all on tap tonight in Indiana.

For all the ups and downs horses can go through over the course of a year – or even two years – the Breeders Crown was the coming full circle for several of the winners.

Starting with the 3-year-old male trotting colts, what a couple of years it's been for King Of The North. He was one of the first higher profile 2-year-olds to burst onto the scene in the

early-season stages when he won the NJSS and Peter Haughton, but he tailed off as that season concluded. Still, it was enough to (rightly) win his Dan Patch divisional honors. This season it's been the complete opposite. Though racing well throughout much of the year, he entered the Breeders Crown without a win in 11 starts. Now, after back-to-back elimination and final wins in back-to-back new career marks, he's suddenly a candidate for the division once again. He races at Hoosier tonight (Nov. 4), and more on that in a bit.

The 3-year-old pacing fillies division started off this season figuring to be largely between Niki Hill and Treacherous Dragon. It came down to just that, but no one would have figured all that would have happened in between. After beginning the year a perfect 5-for-5, Treacherous Dragon was one of a couple horses that moved barns from Pelling to Takter under less than publicized circumstances. From there, after winning her initial start with Takter, Treacherous Dragon lost five races in

a row and there was a ton of questioning about the barn change throughout the social media landscape. But from there, Takter and Treacherous Dragon righted the ship and have now won the Jugette and Breeders Crown in consecutive races. I'd imagine the win was a validation of sorts for Takter, and Treacherous Dragon now seems the most likely to take home her division.

The same pattern holds true for others, too. Last year's Breeders Crown winner, Ecurie D began this season with an amazing 1:49.1 win in the Cutler, but then was soon upstaged by new barn mate Alrajah One and was only able to race sparingly the rest of the season. But in what was just his sixth start of the year, Dexter Dunn was given a chance aboard Ecurie D and they jogged in the open trot. Though maybe not how Svanstedt first planned, Ecurie D is likely to get this year's Dan Patch award for Older Male Trotter based on how he started and finished the year.

Pebble Beach is another that comes to mind. He started the year off as the divisional favorite, won the Pepsi North America Cup and then went through a string of five straight second-place finishes. But he too has closed the year with a flourish, and by following up his Tattersalls Pace win with a Breeders Crown, he's solidified his position atop the division. In fact, aside from the Grace Hill win against Test Of Faith, it may turn out that every winner from Saturday's Breeders Crown races will end up winning their division (Bella Bellini, Jiggy Jog, Treacherous Dragon, King Of The North, Pebble Beach, Ecurie D and last but certainly not least, Bulldog Hanover).

ONTO THIS WEEK

As one of the two co-features on tonight's card at Harrah's Hoosier Park, Breeders Crown champion King Of The North is right back in action six days later in the \$200,000 Carl Erskine. Fresh off his resounding Crown win in 1:50.3, he'll warrant heavy favoritism but will have a couple of locals waiting for him. Ponda Adventure has won 12 of 15 on the year and hasn't been worse than second, and we'll see how the Swan For All-gelding stacks up. He was second to Cool Papa Bell here in September. Dover In Motion is just 2-for-13 this year after going 8-for-9 last year at 2. I'll note that he was storming down the outside last week from well out of it in the Circle City and probably would have gone past Ponda Adventure if not for the miscue in deep stretch. He continues to have problems with that, but seems a threat if he can keep it all together. Branded By Lindy couldn't get close to King Of The North in the Breeders Crown final but did find his best stride late in his elimination; rallies. Golden Wall As loomed in his elimination two back; capable with a trip from the second tier.

On the 3-year-old male pacing side in the \$200,000 Monument Circle, Bythemissal is another that races less than a week after his Breeders Crown had looked unstoppable prior to last week. I'm sure the drivers know better than I do, but I wouldn't think that Bythemissal being eighth early in the race was the ideal strategy from post 2, and there were a few other drives like that too. He now lands the outside post 9 but it shouldn't matter much if he's ready to go; simply faster than these. Ponda Warrior had a ton of late pace in his Crown elimination and credit to Zeron for giving him every chance in the Final by securing a good early position. He backed away a bit late, but this is a spot he can do some damage in as the main threat to the favorite. Birthday goes first-time Lasix for Burke; has thrown in some good miles under the radar this year. Yourwishisgranted surprised last week en route to a wire-to-wire score in 1:49.4.

In the \$110,000 Crossroads Of America, M-M's Dream goes from regular-standing driver Widger to Dave Miller and it'll be interesting to see what comes of that going forward. Her lone loss on the year in 12 starts came at the hands of Fashion Schooner and even that was a solid effort in the Moni Maker. Last out in the Pegasus, M-M's Dream just got up in the final stride in a race where it looked like Cash Infusion was going to win after wresting away command first-over and holding a steady lead late in the stretch. She has since come back to crush in the Circle City. Bluebird Dove has worked out some nice trips in her last pair and will find this group tougher but does have another nice inside post to work with.

Sea Silk was better in the Breeders Crown final than she was the week prior and her best would obviously be good enough in the \$100,000 USS Indianapolis. It wasn't too long ago that she nearly won the Jugette and has been a staple as one of the best younger fillies in the sport the past two seasons. Galleria Hanover is the stable mate to Sea Silk and she's another that's been battling it out against the best sophomore fillies all year; could be a race where the Burke entrants run 1-2. Patsville has prepped for this by running through the Pegasus and Circle City; gets into the race early for DeLong.

Everything you need to know as live racing returns to The Meadowlands.

Following a six-week break, here's everything you need to know about what's going on this month as live harness racing returns to The Meadowlands.

BRITS, BEANS AND BREEDERS' CUP

Opening weekend kicks off tonight (Nov. 4) with a tribute to the late Queen Elizabeth II.

The Queen loved horses and horse racing was her favorite sport.

On the track, the GSY Driving Club plays host to five British amateur drivers – Grant Cullen, Jaimie Davies, Richard Haythornthwaite, Marc Jones and Lee Morris – who will take on their American counterparts in two one-mile dashes – while in the Pink and Trotters buffet, British favorites, Shepherd's Pie and Fish and Chips, have been added to the traditional American fare.

The weekend wraps up on Saturday (Nov. 5) with the fourth leg of the Kindergarten Series and The Meadowlands' Chili Cook-Off: Fall Edition.

There will be official judging in three categories, Homestyle, Chili Verde and Salsa. The two top chili champs will get a \$1,000 grand prize plus a spot in the ICS's World Championship Homestyle Chili Cook-off.

The Salsa category winner will get a \$500 grand prize as well as a spot in the ICS World Championship Salsa Cook-off.

The Paris winter meet is here

Vincennes opened the 2022-23 winter meeting on Thursday (Nov. 3) afternoon and during following months, big purses will be offered in races 4-5 days a week in France's capital.

Jean-Michel Bazire claimed the \$90,000 Prix des Cevennes with his 8-year-old gelding **Elie de Beaufour** (Royal Dream) after an offensive tactic. Elie de Beaufour followed with cover three wide the first half-mile before Bazire stepped on the gas pedal and hit the lead a mile into the race.

Elie de Beaufour got company from Ampia Mede SM up the backstretch and the fight for the victory was about the two front horses as the field turned for home, even if bronze medalist Decoloration finished quickly after a late attack at the stretch.

Leader Elie de Beaufour held Ampia Mede SM on the outside all the way and Jean-Michel Bazire's trotter, who claimed his 31st lifetime win, came home in a mile rate of 1:57.4 over 1.7 miles.

The Vincennes' winter meeting finishes in style on the last Sunday in January, when the \$1,000,000 Prix d'Amérique is scheduled.

CALGARY GAMES IMPRESSIVE

And speaking of Prix d'Amérique... place your bets! Wednesday's (Nov. 2) race card at Solvalla was in fact just an ordinary race day in Stockholm, but two factors made the night at Solvalla very special. The first thing was the fact that 5-year-old **Calgary Games** (Readly Express) entered the track for the first time since his victorious fall 2021 campaign, when he won the \$800,000 Derby in Sweden and the \$400,000 European Derby and left the scene undefeated after nine lifetime starts.

Trainer Timo Nurmos contacted Björn Goop, who has been Nurmos' driver in France the prior seasons, for the qualification race at Solvalla and it's pretty clear that Nurmos has prepared his phenomenal horse for a battle in Paris this winter. Calgary

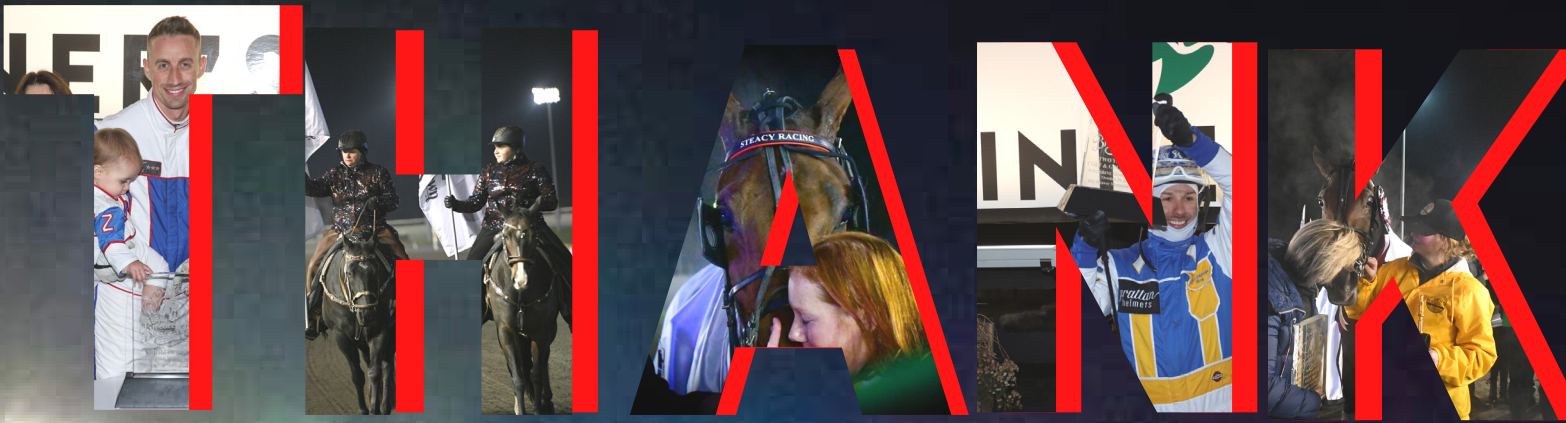

"This was an impressive experience. Timo (Nurmos) told me that he wanted to let Calgary Games run today, but the horse wasn't tired at all when we crossed the wire, he just felt enormously strong and good," said driver Goop after his first connection with Calgary Games.

Reijo Liljendahl trained **Admiral As** (Ready Cash) impressed in the \$20,000 Triton Sund's race over 2,640 meters. A first-over trip didn't bother Admiral As, who easily disarmed leader Esprit Sisu at the top of the stretch and the 6-year-old gelding came home in mile rate 1:55.1, one fifth from Milligan's School world record over the distance.

Next in the process of writing our re-imagined screenplay using the novel “Frankenstein,” we return to Mary Shelley’s story for essentials. In a previous part we explained how best to name nouns, i.e., people, places and things, and so named our main

character, Dion Percy. Now we check Shelley’s cast of supporting characters and the naming process continues for our other characters.

Ralph Percy, Dion’s father Theresa Percy, Dion’s mother Joseph Percy, Dion’s younger brother Frieda, Dion’s girlfriend Karl Clive, standardbred trainer / breeder.

Always, our naming process leaves room for the author’s whim as well as references to the source; in fact, the more personal the choices, the stronger the author takes possession of reimagining a source version. In my cast, above, I chose: Ralph, Dion’s dad; an Old Norse title for a rugged counsellor (also, the surname of my dad). Theresa, Dion’s mother (also, my mother’s surname). Joseph, Dion’s younger brother; meaning “god will give,” a tie into how Dion gets his demigod complex (also my birth-given middle name). Frieda, meaning “peace” which is a state of being Dion does not find (also the name of my teenage girlfriend and the name of a child girl the monster kills in “Bride of Frankenstein”). Karl Clive, harness horseman whose name combines an actor and a character in the original two “Frankenstein” movies.

Have fun with that on both levels.

Wait. Where’s the creature? Can we reimagine the classic story without the creature? Stay with me, here, because this is a crucial step.

At this point, the author should be aware the shape of a fresh tale has emerged. Thanks to following the source there are already solid story elements formed for a beginning, middle and end and the drama is looming without needing the “creature.” The fresh story tells me I can spin the Prometheus angle with a different kind of creature. More about that later.

But let’s face it, I could not have gotten this far as without the source. I am deeply involved in this screenplay without having written useless drafts or laboring over an outline. Confidence insured, this is a place where the scriptwriter can freely stray from the source and concentrate on the importance of the harness-racing atmosphere.

In essence, the “role” of standardbreds in our example play must have the same depth as we applied to names. An audience must immediately accept its presence as a “perfect entity,” that is, a setting with importance, a setting devoted to assist in satisfying the premise. This is essential in any piece of structured literature.

Take, as a perfect example, the setting of Arthur Miller’s 1957 short-story “The Misfits,” which he reimagined into a film script with the same title in 1961.

“The Misfits” takes place in 1950s’ Nevada, where throughout the state’s barren dessert, the story’s top characters are weathered cowboys who hunt for wild horses in order to capture and sell them to slaughter to companies making pet-food. It is a faultless setting and once the audience meets the characters it understands the “nature” of the setting. It’s a desolate place. It’s a world with inherent strength over human and animal misfits and it offers no mercy. Indeed, the metaphors resound.

I must use the “harness racing” setting my reimagined script so it resonates as strongly. Thankfully, the play already has a sound foundation so that an audience does not have to know a thing about, no less like or understand, harness racing. It will accept harness racing as a perfect entity. By the way, to accomplish this alone legitimizes the standardbred sport in ways no other film script has been able to in the history of movies. Here’s how we insure the setting.

A key for that initiative is not a trotter or a pacer, it’s a character – the Karl Clive character. Karl is presented as a moderately

successful veteran standardbred trainer/breeder who is in the of the setting. His farm (complete with training track) borders the spacious acreage of the rich Percy family. Neighbor Karl mentors Dion (just as Shelley’s Doctor Waldman inspires Victor Frankenstein in the source). Karl becomes a surrogate father to the youthful Dion, sharing years of advice, warnings and wisdom unavailable to Dion from father Ralph.

Due to the nature of Karl’s character, the standardbred atmosphere he masters automatically represents a positive force, one that assures the audience it is holy ground, at least compared to the Percys’ home where there is deep emotional conflict. Karl’s modest school for harness horses makes Dion humble, whereas the Percy family’s stodgy status promotes entitlement to Dion and his brother, which creates false and cruel expectations. The conflict of the settings is strong with fabrics that eat at Dion’s soul and, we realize from the premise, will have Dion haunted by Karl’s wisdom as he cultivates hubris as his weapon for success.

In Part 8 we sit on the precipice of writing our masterpiece. Stay with us.

Now 18, Always A Virgin will spend the rest of his days in leisure at Bluestone Farm in Hopewell, NJ.

Always A Virgin's son Always B Miki reigned as the sport's fastest horse with his record-setting 1:46 mile in 2016 at the Red Mile. Always B Miki is now the leading active pacing sire of Breeders Crown wins.

Always A Virgin sired three Breeders Crown winners – Always B Miki, Color's A Virgin p,4,1:49.2f (\$1,188,220) and Beckhams Z Tam p,4,1:49s (\$854,048) – in addition to numerous Indiana Sires Stakes champions.

Following a successful racing career in which he narrowly missed sweeping pacing's Triple Crown for owners Bluewood Stable, Val D'Or Farms, and breeder Joe Hurley's Roll The Dice Stable, Always A Virgin was retired to Victory Hill Farm, which is owned and operated by the husband and wife team of Dr. Jeff King and Dr. Maria King. As a son of Western Ideal out of the Big Towner mare Neverhadneverwill, he offered Hoosier State breeders one of the most successful male sire lines in standardbred breeding.

With the 2022 Breeders Crown results now in, the focus of the connections of those with horses in contention for year-end honors is drawn to the \$1 million TVG Championships at The Meadowlands on Nov. 26.

The last of the major stakes for the Grand Circuit season is unique in that its format encourages the top 3-year-olds of each division to test the sport's veteran stars, possibly enhancing their chances to collect that sought after hardware for their handlers.

As the **TVG conditions** state, those stakes which offer the option for the winner to be invited to race in the TVG Championship are listed below, in order of preference:

"The Meadowlands reserves the right to invite the winner(s) of the races in the order listed below to race in the Championships to reach the maximum number of starters. All invited horses from the races listed below are required to pay the declaration fee to enter the race."

NEW to the TVG Conditions in 2022 is the "Mare Buy Up" clause; *"If, after all of the above conditions are exhausted there remain unfilled positions, mares that are eligible to the TVG Mare divisions may buy into and race in the TVG Open. To gain eligibility, the difference in payments between the Mare and Open divisions must be paid along with the Open declaration fee."*
