High priced claimers make a return

Clearly, there is a need for these races in the condition books at Yonkers and The Meadowlands.

Since September, Yonkers and the Meadowlands have routinely carded higher level claiming races, including races with six-figure claiming prices offered weekly at the former. There is clearly a need in the condition books that these races are solving.

Until recently, options were limited for horses of value over the \$25,000 or so, which seems to be the highest claiming price found consistently across most other tracks. Horses valued above this amount often must race in conditioned or optional-claim races driven by recent earnings, at which point they are often at odds with superior horses arriving on sharp drops for reasons other than necessarily just form.

As has been the case in recent weeks, this past Monday at Yonkers held claiming races for prices of \$30,000, \$40,000, \$50,000, a pair of \$75,000's, and a \$100,000 claiming event. The Meadowlands ran \$100,000 claiming races every week in September. Whether or not some of the horses have a fair market value of their \$100,000 claiming price (though the same which could be said for any



claiming level), these races often bring together evenly matched fields that's produced some compelling racing.

Monday's (Nov. 1) \$100,000 event at Yonkers was won by Walkinshaw N at odds of 11-1. It was his second start for the claiming price and had been racing in recent weeks in

mid-to-upper-level conditioned races. Two weeks ago, the race was won by a 20-cents-on-the-dollar barn change to Gareth Dowse from the rail, but three races ago, the \$100,000 claiming race produced first and second finishers of odds at 14-1 and 12-1, good for a \$368 exacta. In addition to all standard handicapping considerations, it's now also a matter of why and intent with horses being offered for a six-figure tag.

Back when \$100,000 to \$200,000 claiming prices were a common occurrence at the Meadowlands 20 years ago, a lot of horses for those prices were claimed, unlike today in which claiming at the high-end prices are rare. Could these horses in for \$100,000 beat the likes of expensive claimers such as Nianimble, Bad Bert, Motor City Smitty and so forth from the turn

of the century? The point isn't how these claimers stack up to those, but rather the purpose these claimers today are serving.

Let's go back to Sept. 25, the most recent \$100,000 - \$150,000 claiming handicap at the Meadowlands. The winner of this race – which was his third in a row while in for the \$110,000 tag – was Vettel N. Prior to his race against (albeit high level) claimers, he was third at the Meadowlands on Sept. 4 in a race won by Ruthless Hanover. For those not familiar, Ruthless Hanover raced last Saturday (Oct. 30) in the Breeders Crown, won in 1:47.2 this year and has battled it out much of the year with the sport's best free-for-all pacers. It's tough running into him in a non-winners of \$17,500 conditioned race. It's not a coincidence either that Vettel N won three in a row in that condition, he was one of the only horses in those races that probably is worth at least \$100,000. On the other hand, horses that did seem to be worth \$100,000 such as stakes horses from last year, lost. It's all part of the puzzle.

At Yonkers, many horses have used the \$100,000 claiming race to take refuge from having to race in the preferred, open, or non-winners and winner-over \$30,000 races. It's been fascinating to handicap these races.

In Monday's (Nov. 1) race, the favorite was Whitecookie, who came into Yonkers a week ago after racing prior in the opens at Northfield.


With mixed results in those opens that went for \$20,500, he was able to win for a \$50,000 tag at Yonkers which carried a purpose of \$36,000. Not only did he go from conditioned to claimers, but he won for nearly twice the purse. Also in the race was Franco Totem N who was making his third start for \$100,000 and four back was in a \$42,000 preferred. The \$1.8 million dollar career earner Western Fame was a contender in the race, and he made his first start for DiDomenico off the \$100,000 claim from Daniel Renaud; the only six-figure claim since these races began. In the end, the race was won by an outsider, Walkinshaw N, who hadn't won since at least June for any condition higher than non-winners \$10,000.

Walkinshaw N could be an example of a horse where I'm not sure if the connections even thought he was worth \$100,000 but figured it might be worth racing against other horses in for a claim – whether worth \$100,000 or not – rather than continuing to race in the conditioned races. Sure, you still must deal with quality animals, but you're guaranteed to not run into a killer dropping out of a free-for-all race somewhere.

In entering a horse for \$100,000, it's not likely for the horse to be claimed if for no other reason than the purse structure. The race goes for a purse of \$36,000, which is a relatively small winner's share of the purse when compared to the claiming price. Conversely, a \$30,000 claimer goes for \$28,000, almost 100 per cent of the claiming price. The higher the claiming price, the higher the disparity between claiming price to purse. With that, trainers can enter their horses freely for \$100,000 and face a full field of horses entered for like-minded reasons.

Overall, the high-end claiming races are a welcome change of pace. It brings together horses that wouldn't normally be in the same type of race and makes things more difficult to figure out, as well as producing competitive racing. These conditions should continue at tracks that currently offer them, and variations of them should expand to ones that don't.

See you in September, again

If the New Jersey Racing Commission approves their dates for 2022, The Meadowlands will once again be racing in September.

"Ninety race days is what we have applied for," said Meadowlands' chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "After the Hambletonian, we'll take [the rest of] August off and come back in the beginning of September and then take October off for the Thoroughbreds. And harness will come back at the beginning of November. But this is pending regulatory approval."

The September dates are expected to accommodate legs of the Kindergarten Classic Series, as they did this year, as well as the recently announced "New Jersey Classics" for Garden State sired 2- and 3-year-old males and females of both gaits.

In a September press release, Meadowlands' president and chief executive officer Jeff Gural shared thoughts about the new races.

"We believe that with the New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS) racing for purses increased by 20 per cent next year, including these new races will allow trainers to race for large purses over fewer



races in a shorter span of time in New Jersey and not have to endure the time and expense of traveling," said Gural. "The truth is there are so many races for good money now starting in July that the toll is becoming too great on the 2-year-olds for them to last until October and November for Red Mile Grand Circuit, Breeders Crown and the Fall Final Four."

Mark Ford, president of the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ), works closely with The Meadowlands throughout the year and appreciates the efforts put forth by everyone associated with the track to make the racing good for the horsemen.

"It's not us and them, it's we," said Ford. "We're all trying to work together to make it better for everybody. I'll take my hat off to Nick Salvi and Jason [Settlemoir] and the bunch that get it all put together. They're trying to lengthen the calendar here in New Jersey to make it different and hopefully, better. If you have a New Jersey bred, you could stay in New Jersey the whole season and not have to move, per se. There's more of an opportunity, there's more money."

Increased purses and new races can certainly be enticing to owners who are looking to cash in with their sales purchases.

"It is something where, as a group, we would be more likely to



consider New Jersey breds than if they weren't adding those races," said owner Mark Weaver. "It sounds like it would probably clash with Lexington, which I think was probably their goal to go heads up with Lexington with their increased purses. It's certainly something that would make New Jersey a great option, as is Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky. I definitely agree it's something New Jersey kind of needed to do and I would think it would help with their yearling prices for sure."

Nifty Norman, who trains NJSS 2-year-old trotting filly champ Venerable, thinks more money and new stakes races are already having an effect.

"For example, a lot of people are going out of their way to buy a Lazarus just to be involved in the New Jersey thing, so I think that's a good sign," said Norman.

Venerable's part-owner David McDuffee thinks these changes have New Jersey heading in the right direction.

"I think it's interesting because there's a lot of good sire stakes programs around the country," said McDuffee. "Kentucky, obviously, has jumped to the head of the class, I think. And New York has always had a fairly good program, not always, but for the last 10 years or more. And New Jersey's program was pretty weak and it was really very difficult sometimes to justify spending a lot of extra money for a Jersey bred one. But I think now that they're catching up and they're doing a pretty good job things are more equal in that regard. I definitely think it's a great thing."

The fifth leg of the Kindergarten Classic Series at The Meadowlands is Saturday (Nov. 6) with the Finals next weekend on Saturday, Nov. 13.

My picks for the best in dining in Harrisburg

I was asked to put together a list of recommended dining spots for people to visit while they were attending the sale in Harrisburg, PA this coming week.

I'm guessing that I've lived in various hotels in Harrisburg for a minimum of a year when all the days are added up, probably closer to two years in my 52 plus years at Hanover Shoe Farms and my 37 years as general manager of Standardbred Horse Sale Company and for a few years prior to those gigs.

Alas, my very favorite restaurant — which is also a favorite of many people privileged to have eaten there in its heyday — is no more. In fact, it's been gone 40 years now.

The Maverick, which was less than a three minute drive from the historic Pennsylvania State Farm Show Complex, opened in 1961 and was consumed by a fire in 1981. It was THE gathering place for horsemen from all over the world to eat, drink and otherwise spend time while in Harrisburg. Not only was it a great gathering place, it was also a great restaurant.

The food, drink and service were exceptional. It was the only place in Harrisburg where you could get Bananas Foster or a Caesar salad prepped tableside — by the owner, no less.

The bar was always hopping and for a relatively unsophisticated, mid-sized city like Harrisburg, it had a superb wine list.

On the Friday prior to the sale it became a tradition for myself,

Randy Manges, Ralph Lemmon, sometimes Jim Simpson, Dale Welk and whomever we could round up to have lunch there. Randy and I would invariably order chicken livers, a dish they prepared better than any place I've been to before or since. Oh the joy we exhibited when everyone else at the table asked us how we could order such a disgusting dish.

Since the last time I was in Harrisburg, another of my favorite places has also gone to restaurant Valhalla. Char's Tracy Mansion, a beautiful building set right on the Susquehanna river has closed because of the retirement of the owner Char Masgaro. It was a gorgeous place with food that came very close to the beauty of its space. Char also had another superb restaurant in Harrisburg that preceded the mansion. It was a tiny place overlooking the south side of the Susquehanna called Char's Bella Mundo.

Other good restaurants that have come and gone since the Maverick were the Gazebo Room, Scott's, Harry's Tavern, Lombardo's and my late friend Skip Lewis' all-time favorite Santanna's. Skip would spend a whole year looking forward to being able eat at Santanna's a few times while he was in Harrisburg for the sale.

However, it's not the departed restaurants I was asked to write about, rather the ones that are still there that I would recommend.

Harrisburg is neither a wasteland of good food, nor is it comparable to a city like Lexington, which has a great number of good restaurants and many cuisines from which to choose.

In addition to those individually owned and run places that I've listed, it would be unusual not to find a major chain ranging from the omnipresent McDonalds to the somewhat upper scale Bonefish Grill or Texas Roadhouse, within the city or its close environs.

There are several good diners for breakfast, as well as the chains Cracker Barrel and my favorite Waffle House. The latter are somewhat rare to find in a Northeastern City.

Instead of listing just a group of restaurants, I will list in order of my preference those that I've enjoyed and which, from personal experience, I can recommend. I may also mention a dish or two that I've enjoyed and am able to recommend.

It's important to note that many restaurants in Harrisburg and the area are not open for Sunday dinner. Of those listed below, only Gabriella, The Glass Lounge and the Altland House

welcome quests for dining on Sunday evening.

Mangia Qui — It's a very small restaurant on North St, less than a five minute walk from the State Capital and about a 10-minute walk from the downtown Hilton Hotel, where many of the sale's attendees stay. It is owned by its chef, the charming Qui Qui Musarra. The restaurant is described as an Italian Bistro. Qui Qui is a firm believer in freshness and quality ingredients. Everything on the menu is good, most of it outstanding. I have eaten at steakhouses throughout the world. You may find one or two that present a steak close to as well as Manqi Qui's prime "Il Toscano". There is not a single one in my experience that is better. Not only is it great, it's also huge. Bravo to the person who can finish one. There is not an item on the often changing menu with which I could possibly find fault. You will probably see some familiar faces here. Horsepeople are there throughout the week. Lella and Bryan Montgomery like this place so much that you are likely to encounter them here several times. Bryan has told me that during the course of the year, he has been known to make the occasional detour just to be able to dine here.

Tavern On The Hill — It's technically not in Harrisburg itself. It is located just across the Susquehanna river in the small town of Enola Pa. Once again, everything that you order here will be at the very least good and when it comes to a few dishes, I would say great. They probably have the finest wine list of any restaurant in the area. It contains a huge assortment of great wines from all over the world. The prices of the wines, although not those of the food, can border on the exorbitant. The food isn't cheap, but for its quality, it is reasonably priced. As for the wine, I suppose that it costs a lot to maintain such a quality inventory. The food is excellent. Once again, I've never had anything here that was not of the highest quality. Their lamb chops, rack of lamb, steaks, crab cakes and the crabmeat cocktail are especially good, as is the rice pudding, if you are going to indulge in dessert. The complimentary bread they serve is good, but do yourself a favor and order some of their garlic bread for a few bucks more. It is difficult to find better. If you are going here for the first time, it can be somewhat difficult to find, so make sure that your GPS is working properly.

Progress Grill — If there is one restaurant that perhaps has taken the place of the departed Maverick as being the most beloved horseman's hangout, it would have to be the Progress Grill. There is nothing fancy about the place. The food is excellent. The menu is huge. It is usually crowded, but generally not hard to get a table. Among the dishes I can recommend are the crab cakes, the prime rib, the steaks are good as are whatever fish dishes on offer, the rice pudding for dessert is to die for. Every time I think of the Progress Grill, I visualize my late dear friend Mr. Ed, Ed Mullinax diving into his favorite dish, liver and onions with a big scoop of mashed potatoes on the side.

1700 Degrees Steakhouse — It's located in the downtown Hilton Hotel where a good many horsepeople stay. In a previous incarnation, the restaurant had another name that escapes my fading memory. When Bill Perretti was alive and in business he'd take over the restaurant every evening during the week and hold court there. If you were tough enough to stand up to his abuse, you were guaranteed a good evening of great wine, good food and some craziness. It has been some years since I've been there. I cannot imagine the food being as anything but good to excellent.

Rubicon — A sister restaurant to Mangia Qui and located virtually next door. The focus of the food here is more related to

French than the Italian, but the offerings are quite similar to that of its sibling, including that incredible "Il Toscano" steak. If you can't get into Mangia Qui, then eat here. You won't be losing anything in terms of quality.

The Glass Lounge — A place that has been in Harrisburg for as long as I can remember and that's a long, long time. Unless my memory is failing me it was a favorite of Ronnie Waples. It's an old school tavern type of place that specializes in steaks and seafood and more specifically crab cakes. There's nothing fancy about the place. The food and the service are very good.

Gabriella — An old school, red sauce Italian place that serves all the favorites. I especially enjoy the lasagna. Everything here is good.

If you have the time, there are two restaurants of note which I would highly recommend that are less than an hour's drive from the state Capital.

The Circular Restaurant is in the historic Hotel Hershey in Chocolate town, Hershey, PA. It's a beautiful place in a great and beautiful historical setting.

Another place of note is the historic **Altland House** (founded in 1763 and run continuously since then, the original deed was signed by William Penn) in the tiny borough of Abbottstown, PA (just north of Hanover, PA). It is now owned and run by the fourth generation of the Hough family. If you've ever wondered where those famous crab cakes are from that are served to visitors to the Hanover Fairgrounds inspecting the Hanover yearlings for the last 60 consecutive years — this is the place.

Bazire has claimed wins in the Elitloppet (twice), Prix d'Amérique (four times), Prix de France (four times), Prix de Paris (seven times) and has many other big wins.

The opening day of the meeting featured the \$105,000 Prix des Cevennes for older trotters and Alain Laurent's mare **Chica de Joudes** (Jag de Bellouet) upset from the lead and came home in a mile rate of 2:00.4 over 1.7 miles.

Breeders Crown finals close the stakes season in Sweden

This Sunday (Nov. 7), Eskilstuna racetrack in Sweden plays host to the four finals of Breeders Crown in Sweden and the purse in each division is \$373,000 (horses bred outside of Sweden races for half that purse).

The Breeders Crown counts as the last of the really big races in Sweden this year and the four fields are truly spectacular. Even with dominant 4-year-old Calgary Games absent, the races are shaping up to be thrilling.

The 3-year-old colts and geldings are first out and Kriteriet winner Francesco Zet solved his elimination at Solvalla on Oct. 24 quite safely, even if he got some tough resistance from Jörgen Westholm's Global Concept, who was more than brave after a first over trip in high pace. An interesting race with several horses that can go all the way, which is the fact for all four finals.

Venerable, the winner of the Mohawk Million, now sits on the cusp of \$1 million in career earnings (exactly \$997,145) for owners David McDuffee, Mel Hartman, Paul Bordogna and Steven Arnold.

Norman also won the final Matron test of the night when **Joyride** Hanover (Tim Tetrick) stayed out of trouble and powered to a wire-to-wire 1:52 victory in the \$145,100 division for 2-yearold pacing fillies.

The daughter of American Ideal—JK Higher Power defeated Shipnstrol Hanover by three lengths. Frantasy Hanover was third. Joyride Hanover paid \$1.60.

At the top of the stretch, interference impacted all but Joyride Hanover, with Galleria Hanover being placed from fourth to last in the eight-horse field. Horses that crossed the wire between fifth and eighth were all bumped up one spot by the judges.

Joyride Hanover, owned by Eric Good, improved to 3-3-3 in 10 starts and improved her bankroll to \$181,364

Walner to stand for \$30,000 in 2022

The Walner Syndicate has announced that the 2022 stud fee for its record-setting trotting stallion has been set at \$30,000. Walner, whose stud career is managed by Preferred Equine Marketing, stands at Southwind Farms in Pennington, NJ.

Never before has the industry seen a trotting stallion's first-crop achieve such success. Walner is the overall leading sire of 2-year-old trotters, with \$3.8 million, and ranks more than \$1.2 -million ahead of his closest rival — his own sire, Chapter Seven.

Meadowlands to enforce driver policy

Drivers participating at The Meadowlands for the upcoming Fall/Winter meet are reminded that the track policy regarding "courtesy" tucks will be enforced beginning this weekend.

"The drivers asked that I waive enforcing this for the two weeks of Breeders Crown races. I agreed with the understanding that when the Breeders Crown was finished they would give my request that they close up the holes and make the racing more competitive an honest try," said Meadowlands president Jeff Gural. "I took them at their word. If I don't see an effort to make the races more competitive and less predictable, I will address it by asking them to take a weekend off from driving at The Meadowlands.

"We'll take a hard look at the end of the year and evaluate how this is received by our customers, whose complaints are actually the biggest reason I'm enforcing this policy. Then we'll make a decision on the future."

This policy will not apply to races restricted to 2-year-olds, considering some are still green.

The Meadowlands will be racing live every Friday and Saturday at 6:20 p.m. through the month of November. **The complete 2021 calendar may be found here**.

Big M betting a Crowning achievement

The return of the Breeders Crown to The Meadowlands was a rousing success as the total wager of \$7,372,478 for the weekend of Oct. 29-30 established a new Meadowlands record for the series (in the two-day format) that originated in 1984, and

exceeded the previous mark by nearly \$1 million, which was set the last time the series stopped at The Big M in 2016.

No track in history has played host to more Breeders Crown finals than The Meadowlands, which has now carded 103.

The betting bonanza began when wagering topped the \$3 million mark at the mile oval for the first time since Hambletonian Day after \$3,251,099 was pushed through the windows on the Friday night 13-race card. Play on the Breeders Crown events was especially vigorous, as a total of \$1,396,843 was put in play on the four races, an average of \$349,210 per dash.

Wagering on the eight Saturday finals was spirited throughout the day, as at least \$316,162 was bet on each of the Crown races. The largest single-race total was the \$457,657 pushed through the windows on the dramatic showdown between Perfect Sting and Charlie May in the 3-year-old colts and geldings pace.

Total wagering on the eight Crown races was \$2,972,101, good for an average of \$371,512 per dash.

Including the five overnight events, total betting on the 13-race program was \$4,121,379, an all-time high for a single card in the history of the Crown when at The Big M.

"What more can you say about the loyal fans that support Standardbred racing?" said Big M chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "On short notice, with the post moved up six hours, the players wagered over \$4.1 million. The final Saturday afternoon handle was almost 20 per cent higher than the Saturday evening Breeders Crown handle at The Meadowlands in 2016. That's a seismic increase and a wonderful culmination to a sensational weekend of exciting Breeders Crown races. Business was robust, with every one of the 12 Breeders Crown events handling more than \$300,000."

The year-end championship series was televised on two separate networks for a total of six hours. There was 3½ hours of coverage on Fox Sports 2's (FS2) national feed, plus, there was a 2½-hour telecast on the regional network SportsNet New York (SNY), which is the home of the New York Mets.

The Breeders Crown races, which brought a combination of winning favorites and surprises, only served to muddy the waters in the race for Horse of the Year. Lyons Sentinel and Allywag Hanover, the two horses who arguably had the inside track on the trophy heading into last weekend, both tasted defeat while Test Of Faith and Niki Hill were super-impressive when scoring as popular post-time choices.

In addition, the winners of the four events for 3-year-olds will get invitations to the TVG Finals and get a chance to take on older foes and bolster their resumes for a possible shot at Horse of the Year honors. The four winners were Perfect Sting (male pace), Jujubee (male trot), Test Of Faith (female pace) and Bella Bellini (female trot).

Fall Final Four/TVG Finals Night, which is the last major stakes card of the year and takes place on Nov. 20 at The Big M, will go a long way toward determining who will take home Horse of the Year honors.

"Breeders Crown Weekend at The Meadowlands was a tremendous success," said Hambletonian Society president and chief executive officer John Campbell. "The response from the horseman and the competitiveness of the racing made for some of the most exciting races of the year. The betting handle was exceptionally strong, producing \$7.3 million over the two nights. This all reflects the strength and popularity of the Breeders Crown brand."
