Canadian buyers came with loaded check books to the second session of the 2024 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling sale in Harrisburg on Tuesday (Nov. 5) as Ontario-bred yearlings took prominence in the over 300 sold.

The day's topper, tied later in the afternoon, sold around three hours into the marathon session. Hip #313, an Ontario-sired filly named Upgrade consigned by Concord Stud Farm, entered the ring and soared into six figures within moments. John Bax, seated between his son Matt and owner Brad Grant, nodded persistently to the center spotter and pushed the filly incrementally higher. Action cooled and the hammer hit to Bax's bid at \$300,000. Matt, who took over training for the Bax operation around three years ago, signed the ticket.

"He checked all the boxes," Matt said. "He was powerful, correct... Al Libfeld and Brad Grant were very interested in the horse, which you can tell from the price. I didn't think they'd have to go that far, but here we are. A lot of good

people looked at the horse and we did lots of homework and hopefully it pays off racing."

Upgrade is sired by Green Manalishi S, the 2019 Canadian Trotting Classic champ who quickly emerged as one of Ontario's top trotting stallions. In his first crop, Green Manalishi S sired Peaceful Way winner Monalishi – trained by Blake MacIntosh – and he is currently second in earnings of all trotting stallions in the 2024 Ontario Sires Stakes season. With 61 starters from 90 foals in North America, his progeny have banked over \$1.5 million, placing him sixth on the leaderboard of money-winning sires just above the late Bar Hopping and sensational Muscle Hill.

"There were a lot of nice Green Manalishis out there this year," Matt said. "They are a flashy, nice-looking horse and they do well in the Ontario program, so they are selling well. He's already proven now, so that allows you to maybe pay a little more than you normally would. He's doing well and competing on the Grand Circuit, so I think it's [Hip #313 Upgrade] a nice horse to get."

Bax's bid stood as the day's leader until Ake Svanstedt paid \$300,000 for Hip #439, a filly named Ellie Hanover from the first crop of Svanstedt graduate and 2021 Hambletonian champion Captain Corey. The filly is out of the Glidemaster mare Expect A Lot, who is a half-sister to 2011 Kentucky Futurity winner My MVP as well as the stakes-winning mare Top Expectations.

Luc Blais, bidding on behalf of Québecois magnate Serge Godin's Determination, also emerged as one of the top buyers

from the second session and, through two days, leads all buyers with \$1,905,000 spent, total, to acquire 13 yearlings. Blais made his first big purchase of Tuesday with Hip #277, a colt consigned by Preferred Equine named Studio Boss. The colt is sired by Ontario-based Bettors Delight, who perennially leads all pacing stallions in earnings, and is out of the Art Major mare Studio One – a three-quarter sister to double millionaire and world champion Glowing Report.

"The horse is a Bettors Delight," Blais said. "We're from Ontario. Well-bred and nice individual, too. That was the plan. We're looking for an Ontario-bred."

Blais later scored the winning bid on another of the day's session leaders with Hip #458, a Concord Stud Farmconsigned colt named Tavern Onthe Green. The colt comes from a maternal family extending to \$1.8-million earner Cameron Hall, dam of stakes-winning mare Ultimate Cameron. From the second crop of Green Manalishi S, Blais signed the ticket from a \$225,000 winning bid.

"For me, it's always too expensive," Blais said with a laugh. "But we need to follow the market. If you want a decent horse, I think you have to pay for it."

Early in the session, Ontario native Blake MacIntosh posted the first \$200,000 purchase of the day. He struck the winning bid on Hip #202, a Chapter Seven filly consigned by Anvil And Lace Farm named Kountry Sill. The filly is the second foal from near-millionaire Phaetosive, who finished second in the 2018 Hambletonian Oaks to world champion Manchego.

"She's just a really attractive filly," MacIntosh said. "We've been trying to get another Chapter Seven filly and she was the one that we liked and we ended up getting there. I would have liked to have got her for \$50,000 if I could, but we swung on a couple yesterday for \$300,000 and didn't get them, so we have to be happy with what we paid for her.

"She just had all the looks and attributes we wanted for her. Chapter Sevens can be a little small, so we thought she had a good size for a Chapter Seven. She had good conformation and we liked the breeding on her."

MacIntosh signed for the filly as agent for owners Daniel Plouffe and Clancy Farms.

SESSION TWO NUMBERS

Tuesday's session continued the bounce back following last year's dip from 2022's record-breaking sale. The second-session gross increased 2 per cent to \$14,973,000 from 379 sold, though the average of \$39,507 decreased year over year by 7.5 per cent with 39 more horses sold this year. Cumulatively, the 2024 sale has grossed \$31,531,000 - a 5.4 per cent increase from 2023's two-day gross of \$29,913,000. Though, with 32 more horses sold over two days this year, the average of \$59,605 is down 1 per cent from last year's average of \$60,187.

The two-day gross from 2022's record sale was \$35,750,000 - 11.8 per cent higher than this year's cumulative gross - and the average was \$70,652,15.6 per cent higher than this year's cumulative average.

"It evens it all out," said Dale Welk, president and director of operations for the Standardbred Horse Sales Company."I think

it stayed fairly strong. The auctioneers said that and they get a better perspective than what we do of how people were bidding and they said it was easy to get the bids, people weren't trying to give them \$1,000 bids or \$2,000 bids. They stayed right with it and they were very happy

with that. You never know... you used to be able to predict within a few thousand what a horse was going to bring. You just can't do that anymore. I mean, some guys may think they can — and maybe they can — but you've got \$50,000 horses bringing \$200,000 and \$200,000 horses bringing \$50,000. It's very hard to predict."

Though the increases off 2023's dip are only steady, Welk remains confident as the yearling sale enters its final session today (Nov. 6).

"Sometimes when things sell crazy for a year, it's got to correct itself," Welk said. "I think that's what it did last year, it was a lot of correction. There was some odd stuff going on, but I think it's corrected itself and, maybe not on a big rebound but we're evening out and getting a little better.

"There're a lot of good horses [Wednesday], and we'll see. That's all we can do. We try to do the best job we can, but we can't raise the hands. If we could, they'd all sell for a million. I'm looking forward to the rest of the week. We've got great consignors and buyers and bidders. It's exciting."

Today's session begins at 10 a.m. (E.T.).





After an accident, Carson Abbott literally got back up on the horse and it's made all the difference

Carson Abbott wasn't about to let it end that way.

The fifth race at Fraser Downs – the five-eighths mile oval in Surrey, BC – on April 4, 2024, had barely begun before the mayhem ensued.

A domino effect amongst multiple horses resulted in Abbott, in rein to a 4-year-old bay mare by the name of Sea Treasure, being unseated and then thrown to the track.

"It was bad," he said of the accident that saw him and Sea Treasure escape unscathed except for some minor bumps and scratches. "But compared to what could have happened... it could have been a lot worse."

Abbott's first thought was to dust himself off and get right back in the race bike.

In the days following, he wasn't quite so certain.

"The night it happened, I was still very motivated to drive and get back out there again," Abbott said. "But throughout the week, I did a lot of thinking. I thought, 'Should I be doing this?' and 'Can I still do this?' Mentally, it was hard for me to come to a decision.

"I felt that there were better days to come, and I wanted to keep going. The following weeks made me very happy that I made that choice."

It's understandable why Abbott would feel that way.

One week after the accident, he and Sea Treasure were into race at Fraser Downs.

There was no storybook ending on that evening – they finished fifth – but that would come less than a month later.

After they teamed to finish second, only a head behind the winner, on April 18, the pair was back behind the starter car seven days later.

Leaving from the same post 8 they did on the night of the spill, Abbott and Sea Treasure found themselves in sixth after an opening quarter in :28.3. On the march, they were second through a half in 1:00.3 and then $1\frac{1}{2}$ -lengths clear through three-quarters in 1:30.1.

A myriad of thoughts rumbled through Abbot's mind as they reached the finish line a length clear of their closest rival in 2:01.2.

"It made me very happy to not give up just because of that," he said. "It was a very special win. That is my favorite race so far because of the story behind it."

There had been other happy chapters prior to that evening.

On Sept. 22, 2022, Abbott finished third with the brown pacing mare Sea Breeze in his first race as the listed trainer.

One week later, the daughter of Shadow Play crossed the wire on top in a lifetime-best mark of 1:59.4.

The victory was even more special considering Abbott's brother John (his other brother Mark was a driver and trainer) was in the sulky.

"My dad had the horse in his name as the trainer, but he let me put my name down as her trainer," Carson said. "It was very exciting when I got my first training win with her – it was very special. Coming back to the winner's circle, there were friends and family waiting there. It was a great moment.

"When she won that day, she won comfortably. Everything was just right with her that day. She also won by 12 lengths in 1:57 that October with John driving again. We never really got those types of efforts out of her again. I spent as much time with her as I could, keeping her happy and taking her for walks. But I enjoyed my time with her and really liked her."

The young horseman is looking to experience more of those memorable moments on the racetrack.

Currently, he is working full-time for a local concrete pre-cast company, a job he has held for the past year and a half.

"They are two different worlds," he said with a laugh.

His hope is to one day return to racing in a full-time capacity.

"With my driving career, I would like to get as much experience as I can and gain more confidence," Carson said. "This is not an easy sport, but there is so much to love about it. I don't want to get ahead of myself, I just want to drive consistently and take advantage of any opportunities that come my way.

"I'm also hoping one day to get back to training on more of a full-time basis. If I do come back full time, I'm hoping to really dive in head-first."

He also has some plans in place for 2025.

"I would like to purchase my own horse in the near future for myself to drive and have my girlfriend, Alexa Bidell, who is also involved in racing, be the trainer," Carson said.

Carson, admittedly, didn't always have the so-called racing bug.

But he's grateful to have caught it.

"I have always been around it since I was a kid," he said. "I

didn't get seriously into it until about five years ago when I started working full-time for my dad. I started jogging horses and training them, but I also worked for some other people as well, catch-jogging and paddocking. I wanted to get my trainer's license, so I did that.

"I have always looked up to my dad and my brothers, so to be part of this world is very meaningful to me. I love it."

When he isn't part of the racing action, Carson is never far removed from it.

Nights off are typically spent in front of the television, tuning in to catch races from across North America.

"A lot of my life revolves around racing," he said. "In my free time, I enjoy watching racing. I like watching a lot of the Ontario tracks, like Mohawk and Western Fair. I like The Meadowlands too."

Those moments, along with his time in the race bike, are reminders, pleasant ones, of the choice Carson made not so long ago.

His focus these days is on the road ahead.

"I decided that I didn't want to give up on that note after the spill," Carson said. "It took a little bit of time to reach that decision, but it was the right one. I feel there are a lot of good days yet to come."



Coaches Corner fastest in MGM Grand Prix Pacing Series opener

Coaches Corner, the runner-up in the MGM Borgata Pacing Series final earlier this year, led the way with a 1:51 mile in the first leg of the MGM Grand Prix Pacing Series on Monday (Nov. 4) at MGM Yonkers Raceway. **El Rey** and **Nandolo N** won the other \$50,000 divisions that took place on the program.

Driven by Jason Bartlett and racing in the second split, Coaches Corner led through fractions of :27.2, :56 and 1:23.3 on his way to a 2¾-length victory over a first-up Seven Colors (Jordan Stratton). Pocket-sitter Chase H Hanover (Joe Bongiorno) finished in the third position.

A 4-year-old gelding by Always A Virgin, Coaches Corner is trained by Per Engblom for owners Jeff Fought Racing and Brian Carsey. Bred by Black Creek Farm and Hickory Hollow Stables, Coaches Corner is a 26-time winner, has earned \$688,944 and paid \$3.40 to win as a 3-5 favorite. He keyed a \$7 exacta and a \$21.80 trifecta.

Back in the opening tilt, El Rey (Bartlett) blasted to the front from post 7 and then gave way to sit in the 2-hole behind Desperate Man (Matt Kakaley), who had also shown speed from the 8-hole, past the :26.4 quarter. Once he had control, Desperate Man went on to reach the half in :55.4, but then he ended up locked in a side-by-side battle with Whats Stanley Got A (Brent Holland), who tipped first-over from fourth on the third turn, at the 1:24.2 three-quarters.

Desperate Man and Whats Stanley Got A continued their duel around the final bend and into the lane, as El Rey had room to tip out into a three-wide position coming off the turn. It was a cavalry charge to the wire, but El Rey was able to get up at the wire, defeating a dead-game Whats Stanley Got A by a nose in 1:51.3. Desperate Man was third, just a neck behind the top two finishers.

Andrew Harris trains El Rey, a 4-year-old son of Captaintreacherous bred by Riverview Breeding LLC., and he also co-owns him with William Pollock and Bruce Areman. El Rey, who was coming off a third-place result in the Breeders Crown Open Pace final, made his 11th appearance in the winner's circle, has pocketed \$791,451 and returned \$7.80 to win as the 5-2 second choice. He was atop a \$59 exacta and a \$343 trifecta.

In the night's final flight, Verdun (Pat Lachance) was going for his seventh straight victory, and he would get to the engine around Typhoon Banner N (Bongiorno) prior to the :27.2 quarter. Verdun then backed down the half to 57 seconds, and Nandolo N (Stratton) would get going first-up from third just after that station, tracked in the outer tier by Adam Twelve (Bartlett). Verdun and Nandolo N were nose-to-nose at the 1:24.1 three-quarters and remained in a tussle on the last turn as Adam Twelve angled into a three-wide position.

Nandolo N was able to finally wear down a stubborn Verdun about halfway through the stretch drive, and then he determinedly held off Adam Twelve to the wire, tallying by a nose in 1:52.1. Verdun had to settle for third from Typhoon Banner N.

Sent out by trainer Shane Tritton, Nandolo N is a 10-year-old Betterthancheddar gelding bred in New Zealand by Smith and Smith. The Stephen Klunowski-owned Nandolo N has a summary of 38-27-21 from 154 outings, has banked \$904,571 and paid \$65 to win as a 31-1 offering. He led a \$264 exacta and a \$1,094 trifecta.

Leg 2 of the MGM Grand Prix Pacing Series is scheduled for Nov. 11, and then the event takes a break until round 3 on Dec. 9. The \$250,000 final is on Dec. 16, and leg 3 and the final will be at the distance of a mile and a sixteenth.

On Friday night (Nov. 8), Yonkers will host the final preliminary leg of the MGM Grand Prix Trotting Series with two \$75,000 sections (races 4 and 6) drawn. It's Academic, who drew post 1 for David Miller and Ron Burke, will try to improve to three-for-three in the event in the first of those races, while Chapercraz and Take All Comers, who have one victory apiece in the series thus far, depart from posts 2 and 5, respectively, in the other dash. Chapercraz has Yannick Gingras listed to drive for Burke, while Jordan Stratton is on Take All Comers for Jim Campbell.

The \$250,000 MGM Grand Prix Trotting Series final is set for Nov. 15, and both Friday night's third round and the final will be conducted at the distance of a mile and a sixteenth.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is operating on a Monday through Friday live racing schedule with post time each night at 7 p.m. (EDT).

Three-year-old Matron Stakes at Bally's Dover

The 3-year-old Matron Stakes travel to Bally's Dover on Thursday (Nov. 7).

The fields are as follows:

The \$146,050 Matron Stake trot for 3-year-old fillies takes place in the sixth race (estimated post time 6:20 p.m.).

Breeders Crown champ Allegiant tangles with R Melina, who finished second to Allegiant in the Breeders Crown final. The two fillies renew their rivalry.

The \$152,800 Matron Stake for 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters compete in the eighth race (estimated post time 7 p.m.).

Highland Kismet, the altered son of Father Patrick, finished a fast closing fourth in the Breeders Crown final last start.

Sir Pinocchio could prove to be his main competition.

Sir Pinocchio has won five of his last six pari-mutuel races and is the leading money earner in the race with over \$600,000 lifetime. The 10th race on the betting card is the \$116,500 Matron Stake for 3-year-old fillies on the pace (estimated post time is 8 p.m.).

My Girl EJ, who was parked to the half, won the Breeders Crown final, in 1:49.3 as the betting favorite.

The Sweet Lou product has bankrolled over \$1.4 million and is the leading money earner in the race.

The \$178,100 Hap Hansen Memorial for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers, is scheduled for the 12th race with an estimated off time of 8:20 p.m.

The race is named in honor of the late Hap Hansen, who held the post of chairman of the board at Brandywine Raceway.

Highlighting the division is Mirage Hanover, a winner in the Breeders Crown final, winning in 1:48.

Other contenders include Little Brown Jug and Adios victor Captain Albano, who earned over \$1.3 million lifetime.

There are 15 races on the betting card.
