Ohio's growing influence evident as Timonium Mixed Sale opens

About 20 per cent of the broodmare and stallion share purchases were made by residents of the Buckeye State.

Preferred Equine's David Reid said Friday's (Nov. 6) opening mixed session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Auction was "okay" at best, but he did notice an interesting trend toward buyers from Ohio stepping up to purchase breeding stock.

"I would just say that the market was similar to the way it's been all week," said Reid, who led all consignors Friday with \$1,746,000 in gross sales. "But it seems that a large portion of the horses went to Ohio."

About 20 per cent of Friday's purchases — broodmares, mostly — are headed for Ohio which is experiencing a boom

period thanks to slot machines at its racetracks.

Ohio residents made up the second largest demographic of buyers in terms of numbers Friday (54) after only Pennsylvania (58). In all, people from Ohio made \$800,000 in purchases which ranked them third behind Pennsylvania (\$1,202,000) and New York (\$828,000).

In all, 275 horses/stallion shares were sold Friday for a


total gross of \$6,567,000, an average of \$23,880 and a median of \$15,000.

Though mixed sales are difficult to compare because their makeup can change remarkably from year to year, the 2019 numbers from the opening session of the mixed sale were: 329 sold for a gross of \$12,459,000, an average of \$37,869 and a median of \$19,000. Keep in mind, last year's mixed sale included the dispersal of White Birch Farms' breeding stock. There were no major farm dispersals this year.

Cumulatively, through three yearling sessions and one mixed session, the SHSC auction has grossed \$36,107,000 for 1,048 sold for an average of \$34,453 and a median of \$20,000. This year's gross through four sessions is down more than \$17 million compared to 2019 when the gross was \$53,265,000 and the average was \$45,721. The 2020 average is down 25 per cent from 2019 through the first four sessions.

On the day, 144 broodmares grossed \$3,824,000 in total to average \$26,556. Sixty-two stallion shares fetched \$1,870,000 in total for an average of \$30,161.

Crawford Farms of Syracuse, NY purchased the session topper, broodmare Somwherovrarainbow from Diamond

Swedish bloodstock agent Robert Lindstrom was the session's second leading buyer with \$388,000 spent on five mares bound for Sweden.

Creek Farm, for \$240,000 and also acquired Muscle Hill shares for \$117,000 and \$115,000, respectively. Crawford topped the session's buyers by spending \$492,000 on Somwherovrarainbow, two Muscle Hill shares and a What The Hill share (\$20,000).


Muscle Hill shares fetched four of the top seven prices achieved Friday.

Apart from selling the session-topper, Diamond Creek also sold the second most expensive mare that went through the ring Friday — mare Live Love Laugh sold for \$150,000 to Swedish bloodstock agent Robert Lindstrom, who was the session's second leading buyer with \$388,000 spent on five mares bound for Sweden.

Diamond Creek was Friday's second leading consignor by gross, behind Preferred. Diamond Creek collected \$1,392,000 in sales, followed by Northwood Bloodstock (\$1,305,000).

The final sale session starts today at 10 a.m. (EST) and features mostly racehorses.

Trixton is currently fourth in money earned among 3-year-old trotters behind only Muscle Hill, Chapter Seven, and Father Patrick. He is in the top 1- in money earned among all age trotters in 2020 with 116 starters and over \$3.144.612.

Trixton is by Muscle Hill who is considered to be the greatest trotting colt of the generation and in turn a son of Muscles Yankee who was responsible for consecutive Hambletonian winners Deweycheatumnhowe, (2008) Muscle Hill (2009) and Muscle Massive (2010). Trixton's dam Emilie Cas El was a 2-year-old trotting champion of the year and is a full sister to three leading contemporary trotting sires in Andover Hall, Angus Hall and Conway Hall. The next dam is Amour Angus arguably the leading trotting broodmare of this generation.




Standardbred owner, legendary track coach Dennis Fairall dead at 67

Legendary University of Windsor track and field and cross country coach Dennis Fairall has died at the age of 67.

Fairall, a long-time standardbred owner and harness racing fan that loved to frequent Windsor Raceway, coached the University of Windsor's men's and women's track and field and cross country teams to an unprecedented 25 Canadian national university championships and 46 Ontario championships between 1985 and 2016, when he stepped down as coach after being diagnosed with the rare brain disease progressive supranuclear palsy (PSP).

In his career, Fairall was named Coach of the Year an astounding 65 times (each of the four teams — men's track and field, women's

track and field, men's cross country and women's cross country gives a Coach of the Year award in both the province and nation annually).

Fairall, a native of Tillsonburg, ON, is a member of the Tillsonburg Wall of Fame and was inducted into the Windsor/Essex Sports Hall of Fame, Athletics Canada and Athletics Ontario Halls of Fame, and the university's Alumni Sports Hall of Fame. He was awarded the Athletics Canada coach of the year, a Petro Canada Coaching Excellence Award, and an honorary Doctor of Law degree from the university.

According to a Canadian Press report, Fairall coached more than 1,800 athletes at Windsor alone. His immense impact was felt in the number of weddings he and wife Janet attended - 13 in one summer alone.

University of Windsor director of athletics Mike Havey said in a statement that what made Fairall special wasn't his incredible success as a coach, but that he was, "a humble and incredibly effective team builder and collaborator... When you met with Dennis you always felt better afterwards. He made you feel good."

Fairall is survived by Janet, son Jeremy, daughter Erin and two granddaughters.

I was wrong (full story here) about going two-for-two in the 1992 Breeders Crown because I just remembered that surreal evening at Pompano Park where in fact I did record a two-for-two record winning both Crown 3-year-old trots. For an older fellow that has trouble remembering a lot these days that would have been a real stretch expecting me to remember those details. That was almost 30 years ago, and, in my own defense, the Mohawk race was Oct. 9 and the Pompano races were on Oct. 23.

SBOANJ additional whipping rule information

Earlier this week, the SBOANJ reached out to the NJRC regarding the implementation of the new whipping rule and a possible transition period with written warnings.

The SBOANJ was told that the NJRC staff considered a transition period with written warnings but decided against it. The new whipping rule became effective on Oct. 19, 2020, but the NJRC delayed the implementation of the rule until Nov. 6, 2020 to allow judges time to meet with drivers and explain the requirements of the new rule.

The NJRC stated that the new rule is intended to protect the horses and the staff cannot delay implementation any further. As of Nov. 6, 2020 penalties, which will be determined by the Board of Judges, will be imposed after the judges conduct their hearing.

USTA District 8 announces 2020 award winners ahead of NY Sire Stakes virtual banquet

United States Trotting Association District 8 has announced the winners of its 2020 year-end awards. For the second year in a row, George Ducharme has been named Trainer of the Year; Pari-Mutuel Driver of the Year goes to Jason Bartlett; and Leon Bailey is the County Fair Driver of the Year.

Ducharme earned a combined \$382,482 in the New York Sire Stakes and Excelsior Series this year with 77 starts. His stable was led by 3-year-old trotting filly Without A Warning, who took home \$231,162, and 3-year-old trotting colt Berkery J, who earned \$90,530. Ducharme was also the leading money earner at his home track, Vernon Downs, with \$132,121 in purses and a 36.2 winning percentage. Overall, Ducharme's horses have banked \$1,298,188 this season and he sports a .403 UTR average.

Bartlett has \$1.44 million in combined New York Sire Stakes and Excelsior earnings this—five County Fair Champions, three Excelsior Series Champions and two Sire Stakes Champions, including Hobbs (3-year-old trotting colt) and King James Express (2-year-old colt pacer). For the year, Bartlett has guided almost 300 winners to nearly \$4.7 million in earnings.

Bailey finished atop the New York County Fair earnings chart with \$66,456 in 91 starts. He drove 33 winners, including New York County Fair Champions Mr. Dunnigans (3-year-old pacing colt) and Miley Rose (2-year-old pacing filly), whom he also trained. In addition, Bailey also earned his first driving championship at his home track of Vernon Downs. This is his first USTA award.

Awards will be recognized during the joint NYSS and USTA District 8 virtual banquet taking place this Sunday (Nov. 8) on Facebook Live. The evening will honor champion horses, trainers,
