Consigners reflect as 2024 SHSC yearling sale sees increase in gross over 2023

2024 SHSC YEARLING SALE AT HARRISBURG

STANDARD BREED HORSE SALE COMPANY



Wednesday (Nov. 6) wrapped the yearling portion of the 2024 Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction in Harrisburg, PA – a year that saw minor gains from last year's drop off from the record 2022 sale.

The third day of the yearling sale grossed \$5,560,000 from 337 horses sold, down 6.7 per cent from last year's single-session gross of \$5,957,000 from 313 horses sold. The average also dropped 13.3 per cent, from \$19,032 to \$16,499, and the median dropped from \$15,000 to \$12,000.

However, 2024's complete yearling sale grossed 3.4 per cent more year over year with \$37,091,000 in sales from 866 horses sold. Though, the average year over year fell 3.3 per cent to \$42,830 from \$44,284.

"With the market right now, the middle market is straining badly and I don't know what we can do to bring that back," said Dale Welk, president and director of operations for the Standardbred Horse Sales Company. "The high end is great. Monday was a wonderful day and yesterday stayed fairly strong, but there were a lot of great horses that went through here that sold cheap today."

and nobody wanted him. There definitely was a dip that we didn't expect when we were breeding to him for this crop."

Hanover Shoe Farms also entered Day 3 of the yearling sale ahead of its 2023 numbers. The consignment, which made Black Book history selling \$1-million yearling Cambridge Hanover on Monday (Nov. 4), gained nearly 13 per cent from its 2023 gross with \$10,685,000 in sales this year from 13 more horses sold. They were the yearling sale's leading consignor by a margin of nearly \$5 million.

"We certainly left 2023 somewhat disappointed and we were hoping for a bounce-back year and thankfully we've had that," said Mark Loewe, who is in his first year as vice-president of customer relations for Hanover. "The fact that we can say that Hanover Shoe Farms sold the highest-priced yearling at both the Lexington and Harrisburg sales speaks volumes. The first million-dollar horse ever sold at Harrisburg this year, so I think the team made some corrections during the course of the year that were successful and we hope to grow from that."

Loewe also noted a softening in middle-market yearling prices.

"It feels like there's a lot of people who are all on the same horses," he said. "So, your high end is very strong. Your middle seems to be where there's a little bit of a letdown and the low end always manages to hold its own. It's just a matter of people making sure they bring the horses to the sale that the people want. That's watching the races, watching the stallions, watching the mares that are being successful

Julie Meirs of Concord Stud Farm shared this sentiment.

"The high end is solid and that's definitely going to stay solid," Meirs said. "The middle is disappearing and so that's been a challenge for breeders to try to figure out how we're going to get back in there, because there's only so many top mares."

With the slight bump in gross over 2023, Concord Stud Farm was among the consignors that saw year-over-year gains. In fact, the consignment entered the third day of the sale already ahead of its 2023 figures and closed the yearling portion up 6.3 per cent to a gross of \$5,616,000 with seven more horses sold.

"We were very solid our first two days," Meirs said. "Today, is a little different."

Meirs also talked of how some hits consignors are taking – as well as their home runs – are representative of market demand for established stallions as well as lukewarm reception of still developing stallions.

"We are trying to pull out our crystal balls because we have to breed them so far in advance," she said. "So, you have to try to guess what everyone is going to want for the future. So, some people have guessed right and some people haven't."

"Stallions, you never know who is going to hit and who's not. Chapter Seven has been very solid and, luckily for us, we had a significant number of them so that has helped considerably. But you take a stallion like Tall Dark Stranger and he has not

and trying to breed to the buyers so they are seeing what they want to see.

“You’re always looking for the highest price you can get for a horse, but if somebody gets a horse that they consider a value buy and the horse is successful, it just means that they’ll be back the next year. So, yes, regardless of what they pay, we want that horse to be successful so that the buyers will come back knowing that they are going to get a quality product every year from Hanover, regardless of the price.”

David Reid, president of Preferred Equine Marketing, echoed the strength of the high-end in the yearling market as well as the turbulence to the middle-priced sector.

“The top of the market was good and the middle of the market has been a little challenging throughout the year,” he said. “I think today was definitely a little challenging, but the marketplace is what it is. At the end of the day, the public is the best judge of the marketplace. They judged and now we move onto the mixed sale portion tomorrow.”

WEDNESDAY’S LEADERS

Hip #607, a Preferred Equine-consigned filly named Shes On The Money, topped the Wednesday session with a \$95,000 winning bid from George Ducharme, who famously trained 2013 Hambletonian champ Royalty For Life. Shes On The Money is an E L Titan filly that is the fifth foal from Chocolatier mare Queen Of More, whose granddam Caper Caillie is a half-sister to world champion and double-millionaire Wesgate Crown.

Noel Daley signed for the second-largest purchase of the session when getting the gavel slam on Hip #675, a Six Pack filly named A Case Of You, for \$80,000. The Walnridge Farm-consigned filly is the fifth foal from SJ’s Caviar mare Tactical Caviar, who is a

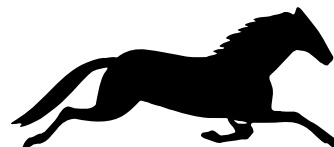

full sister to a pair of world champions in Triumphant Caviar and Centurion ATM.

Three horses exited the sales ring at \$75,000, including a pair of E L Titan colts. Howard Okusko, Jr. struck first with Hip #753, a Blue Chip Farms-consigned colt named Aquarius Blue Chip. This E L Titan colt is the first foal from Chapter Seven mare Double Red, whose granddam is Dan Patch Award winner Day For Night. Exceed Stables LLC took Hip #811 Avalon Blue Chip, the other E L Titan colt leaving the ring for \$75,000. The Blue Chip Farms-consigned colt is the fifth foal from Andover Hall mare Aurova Hanover, whose granddam American Wish is a half-sister to \$1.5-million earner Algiers Hall as well as Avalicious, the dam of 2024 Hambletonian winner Karl.

A rare roan standardbred earned the third \$75,000 winning bid in the session. Hip #859, a Tactical Landing colt named Steel Grey consigned by Blue Chip Farms, sold to William Jackson.

TO THE MIXED SALE

Signs swapped and horses shipped in all through the Wednesday session ahead of the Black Book Mixed Sale, which begins today (Nov. 7).

“It’s going to be, I’m hoping, a fun two days,” said Welk. “Us guys on Friday start looking like, ‘Oh, we’ve got to tear all this down,’ but if you have a good sale on Thursday and Friday... like, last year, the mixed sale brought our whole sale back. We were down 19 per cent after the yearling sale and we ended up down six per cent because of the mixed sale. We had a record mixed sale last year. I think we’re going to surpass that this year.”

The opening session of the Mixed Sale features weanlings, yearlings, stallion shares, broodmares and the first phase of All American Harnessbreds dispersal, which includes Hambletonian Oaks runner-up Buy A Round. Friday features racehorses of all ages as well as the fabulous fillies section of racing mares and breeding prospects.

“There’s always going to be breeders wanting to reinvest to upgrade their stock,” said Reid. “So, I think tomorrow is going to be good. I think the racehorse market is going to be solid [too].”

“We have a lot to offer and I’m very happy with our quality of the line-up for the next two days. Obviously, it’s an honor just to have Hot Mess Hanover in here – the dam of Jiggy Jog [S]. Whenever you can sell a mare of her quality... she’s a queen. She’s 10 years old and in foal to Walner and carrying a full sibling to Jiggy Jog [S]. That should be exciting [today] to get a feel for the marketplace. I look forward to selling her and others, and then Friday (Nov. 8) we’ll come back with horses like Mambacita and Amazing Catch, who was a terrific 3-year-old this year. He’s by Walner and Walner had a great week here, so we’re looking forward to selling him on Friday, as well as those others.”

Southwind Amazon, a 14-year-old pacer owned by Ameer Najor and trained by Paul Holzman, reached a remarkable milestone Tuesday night (Nov. 5) at Northfield Park where his 3¾-length victory in 1:54 made him the winningest horse in modern standardbred history. The score was the 138th of his career from a staggering 393 starts.

“The countdown is over,” said Holzman. “We can now enjoy his last two months of racing.”

Southwind Amazon, the son of Camluck out of the Artsplace mare, Artoonist, had been tied at 137 scores for the all-time winners' crown with Niffit, a pacer who campaigned in Canada's maritime provinces from 1977 to 1989.

Niffit had to work hard for little money. He banked only \$30,617 from 422 trips to the post. Southwind Amazon is no pauper. He has collected \$1,501,624 in purse checks. Among North America's winningest horses, only Foiled Again (\$7,635,588 and 109 wins) and Rambling Willie (\$2,038,219 and 128 wins) have earned more money.

The record-breaking 138th victory was recorded by Southwind Amazon and Justin Irvine on Tuesday (Nov. 5) at MGM Northfield Park.

And Southwind Amazon stepped on a lot of stopwatches in reaching the pace and trot summit. Among the top 25 winningest horses, only Foiled Again's lifetime mark of 1:48 is faster than Southwind Amazon's 1:48.3 mile that he sizzled as a 10-year-old at Scioto Downs in 2020.

"Every time I watch him race, it brings a tear to my eye," said Holzman. "He's gotten older and a little slower, but he doesn't want to retire. However, he's earned his retirement and will go to a farm up in Michigan."

Southwind Amazon has won at 20 different tracks for 29 drivers. Five other trainers conditioned the moderate brown win machine before Holzman purchased him for Najor of West Bloomfield, MI in February of 2016 at Pompano Park.

He has proven so sturdy for so long that four of the tracks where he won are out of the standardbred business – Northville Downs, Sudbury Downs, Woodbine (harness racing is now contested at its sister track Mohawk Park) and the aforementioned Pompano Park.

Southwind Amazon, in his 13 years of competing, never won fewer than two races. His top year was 2018 when he won 22 times. His lone two-win campaign came in 2013.

"I bought him for \$30,000 for Najor from a buddy of mine who was racing in Canada at

Rideau Carleton," said Holzman. "My friend said the horse didn't fit well up there and shipping seven hours to race at Woodbine was too much, so he felt selling him would be best."

At that point in his career, Southwind Amazon was a 6-year-old, racing mainly in Canada. He had won 18 of 71 starts and Holzman could see that his new purchase was quick and talented. What he didn't know was that the gelding could use a session or two on a psychologist's couch.

"He has anxiety issues and has always had them," said Holzman. "He's a bad teeth grinder, a very nervous funny duck who is afraid of his own shadow. At one of his county fair starts this year, he got so upset he tied up. The rides, the food stands, even the stage in the infield bothers him."

Despite being a head case, Southwind Amazon has overcome his nervousness with brushes of brilliance.

"What's made it hard on him to win is that he's racing against horses half his age," said Holzman. "It's like a 75-year-old man racing against a 25-year-old kid. Another thing about this horse is that I found out he cracked a hind pastern as a 2-year-old and has raced his whole life with two screws back there. Luckily, they have never been a problem."

After the win, Southwind Amazon's connections celebrated in the winner's circle and beyond.

Southwind Amazon is a medium-sized horse that Holzman says is very athletic, so light on his feet that's easy on his shoes (less wear and tear), which he believes has helped his star pupil remain sound for over a decade of racing.

Owner Najor doesn't get to watch all of Southwind Amazon's victories in person, but he drove the 2½ hours from his Michigan home to be at Northfield on Tuesday night.

"I just had a feeling this would be the race," said Najor who celebrated with Holzman after the race with a drink or two at the trackside bar at Northfield Park.

Northfield Park is expected to honor Southwind Amazon before he officially retires on New Year's Eve. And with good reason. He's a horse for the northern Ohio course with 91 of his victories coming at the home of the Flying Turns.

Southwind Amazon's other scores include seven at Pompano, six at The Meadows and Northville Downs, five at Mohawk, four at Scioto Downs, three at Rideau Carleton, two at Ohio's Stark County Fair in Canton as

well as two at Harrington and Yonkers, and one at Clinton, Dresden, Flamboro, Harrah's Philadelphia, Hiawatha Horse Park in Sarnia, Pocono Downs, Saratoga, Sunbury Downs, the Williams County Fair in Ohio at Montpelier, and Woodbine.

"As long as he's able, he'll continue to race until the end of the year," said Holzman. "He could get in another seven or eight starts."

When it's over, and Southwind Amazon gets a gold watch and heads for a patch of paddock grass, Holzman can reach for the remote control and return to watching reruns of his favorite horse's winning efforts.

"I started watching them last month when he was in a bit of a slump," said Holzman. "I watched about 60 of them. Do you know how long it would take it watch all 138 of them?"

Yes. That would require a minimum of four hours and six minutes. Perhaps Holzman, when he gets lonely looking at Southwind Amazon's empty stall, can take his laptop and head for his old friend's retirement paddock near Detroit. They can watch the replays over and over again. And never lose a race.

Jonas Schlabach's mixed sale purchase paying big dividends two decades later

Ohio-based breeder Jonas Schlabach had a hunch his filly, *Swinging Loyalty*, would sell well Monday (Nov. 4) during the opening session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction in Harrisburg, PA. The Walner-sired yearling, however, far exceeded his expectations. Cataloged as Hip #53, part of the Concord Stud consignment, *Swinging Loyalty* was hammered down for \$760,000, the top price for a filly and second most overall.

"Being the last one brought \$390,000, I thought this was a nicer filly, more of a powerhouse," Schlabach said. "She just caught your attention. I was hoping she would bring \$500,000, but you never know. You go into these sales and you don't have any guarantees."

Indeed, there are no guarantees, but leading into Monday's session, the breeder received some encouraging feedback that gave him reason to be optimistic.

"Richard Gutnick came up to me and said, 'Hey, I love that filly and I hope I can reach her. You can know that if I don't buy her, I'm back bidder,'" Schlabach said. "Then Dale Welk came along and told me, 'You might have the top filly of the sale.'"

After spirited bidding Monday afternoon at the Pennsylvania State Farm Show Complex, Gutnick emerged the winner, and Schlabach was left in amazement.

"I got my hopes up that she would bring nice money, but I never dreamed she would go to \$760,000," he said. "You don't have these but once in a lifetime. It's a dream for a small guy like me."

The origins of Monday's big score trace back four generations to Striking Sahbra mare *Swing Anna*

Miss. On the track, the filly banked \$133,729 over the course of 30 career starts. The trotter hit the board in 25 of those attempts, collecting 12 wins. *Swing Anna Miss* was a standout in the Buckeye State at 2, finishing first or second in each of her 13 starts, claiming nine wins and just over \$100,000 in earnings. The campaign earned her 2-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year honors in Ohio in 2001.

Swing Anna Miss was entered at Harrisburg following her sophomore season, and Schlabach purchased the filly to add to his broodmare band.

"She was just from a very ordinary Ohio pedigree, nothing fancy," he said. "But she was a very good filly by Striking Sahbra. She was the 2-year-old filly of the year. I bought her. I think I paid \$19,000 for her. I had her for probably 12 foals or more. She paid her way."

The story could have very well ended there if it weren't for an incident with one of *Swing Anna Miss*' foals, *Swing Anna Cash*. The *Cash Hall* filly, the fifth foal from the mare, was being prepared for the sales when fate intervened.

"She hurt herself when Spring Haven Farm was videoing her for the sale," the breeder said. "She ran through a fence and hurt herself. I had to pull her out of the sale."

Schlabach would lease the filly for two seasons. During that time, *Swing Anna Cash* won four times in 25 starts, accumulating earnings of \$42,774. As a sophomore, the trotter took a mark of 1:56.3 at Scioto Downs.

"I just leased her out for two years but I wanted her back for a broodmare," he said. "I liked the filly; she was a nice filly."

As a broodmare, *Swing Anna Cash* showed she could produce just like her mother. *Swing Anna Miss* produced 10 winners from 11 starters, and 14 foals overall. *Swing Anna Cash*'s first foal was the RC Royalty filly *Swinging Royalty*. The filly sold for \$40,000 at the 2013 Harrisburg sale before going on to earn \$255,880 and take a 1:54.1 sophomore mark. Schlabach reacquired the trotter at Harrisburg, paying \$55,000 during a mixed session.

“Today, you try to buy a mare back like that, it’s like \$300,000 or \$400,000,” he said.

Bringing Swinging Royalty back to his Apple Creek, OH, farm, Schlabach bred the mare to Chapter Seven.

“I felt she was the caliber mare that could handle that and should be bred to something like Chapter Seven,” Schlabach said. “Right at the time, Ohio wasn’t that great. It did work out for her, which is why she is where she is right now.”

Every breeder’s dream is to have a top-producing mare with sought after babies, and Schlabach has that in Swinging Royalty. Her first foal, colt Ahundreddollarbill, sold in the first session of Harrisburg’s 2019 sale. Bringing \$65,000 in that opening session, the trotter went on to win the Canadian Trotting Classic and is less than \$30,000 from \$1 million in earnings. Swinging Royalty’s second foal, Slay, another son from Chapter Seven, earned just shy of three-quarters of a million before being retired to stud duties in Ohio. He was also a first-day Harrisburg yearling, fetching \$130,000.

Chapter Seven filly Royal Filly, Swinging Royalty’s third foal, was sold privately, and has gone on to score five wins and bank \$246,209. Last fall, Jeff Snyder purchased Royal Mission

in Harrisburg’s opening session, going to \$390,000. The Chapter Seven freshman captured the New York Sires Stakes final and added nearly \$300,000 on her card in 10 seasonal starts.

“They just kept clicking,” Schlabach said of the quartet of Chapter Seven foals. “I’ve got a nice weanling by her side by Chapter Seven and a baby in her belly by Chapter Seven. If this Walner pans out, I might breed her back to Walner in a couple years.”

On Monday, Swinging Loyalty sold for more than her four siblings had brought... combined. Swinging Royalty has produced foals grossing a few thousand dollars south of \$1.5 million, a gaudy statistic for the dam.

“Being in this and trying for about 40 years, I realize you just get a mare like that once in a lifetime,” said the 70-year-old. “I’m trying to enjoy it while I can. I just feel lucky to have a mare like that.”
