Proven power prominent in recordbreaking opening Harrisburg session

Full sisters to star trotting mares Atlanta and Manchego fetched \$750,000 and \$700,000, respectively, as the first session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction set a record for average (\$130,368) and grossed \$17,730,000, the second most in history.


In the last 10 years of harness racing, the sport has seen debatably two of the greatest trotting mares to ever set foot on a racetrack. Spectators and participants then had the privilege to, in recent seasons, see Atlanta and Manchego spar on multiple occasions, putting forth several miles etched into the slates of racing records. Though their rivalry ended this year, their blood battled through the ring on Monday (Nov. 8) during the opening session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's (SHSC) yearling sale in its return to Harrisburg, PA.

First of the two was In Italian, selling as Hip 69 of the 136-yearling session. The Concord Stud Farm-consigned filly, bred by Stefan Balazsi, is sired by New York stallion star Chapter Seven and out of the Cantab Hall mare Hemi Blue Chip, whose first foal became the multi-millionaire world-record holder and 2018 Hambletonian winner Atlanta (6, 1:49M; \$3,058,601). And standing in the corridor from the sale's arena to the Main Hall of the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex, Brad Grant of Atlanta's ownership – among many other prominent standardbreds – scored the winning and session-topping bid of \$750,000 on his star mare's full sister.

"Well, I know a little about Atlanta," Grant said with a grin. "I think she's the best and that's what I came here to buy. Howard Taylor and I are partners on (In Italian), but we kind of put a number on her and luckily we didn't have to get here. Not a drop-dead number in our minds of \$800,000, but at \$800,000 you'd kind of get the feel for how it's going.

"She was the horse I specifically came down for."

Grant confirmed that he and Taylor plan to have the yearling trained by Ron Burke, who became Atlanta's regular trainer in 2019. Grant also said he and Taylor will discuss adding Michelle and Al Crawford of Crawford Farms to the ownership and bring the whole Atlanta band back together.

"Everything says that she should be as good as her sister," Grant said. "If we have half as much fun as we did with Atlanta, we're going to have a good time.

"Really, I thought I'd have to go at least \$800,000. I'm glad I


didn't, but I think she's the best in the sale and I think she'll end up being the best price in the sale, although Manchego's full sister is in here, too."

Manchego (4, 1:49M; \$3,144,627) and Atlanta came from the same crop; the foal class of 2016. As 3-year-olds, Manchego continued the Hambletonian Oaks domination of trainer Jimmy Takter and driver Yannick Gingras by winning the 2018 edition at The Meadowlands just one race before Atlanta became the first filly since Continentalvictory in 1993 to win the biggest race in the sport. That day, Manchego went the faster mile – a 1:50 coast-to-coast victory – while Atlanta, having finished second in the first heat of the Hambletonian, uncorked a 1:50.4 mile. Both fillies grew into mares who transcended the trotting speed barrier of the 21st century: the 1:50 mark.

Oddly enough, neither mare broke the glass ceiling for the speed threshold. It was their one-time rival Plunge Blue Chip who became the first trotting female to win in sub-1:50 when she beat Manchego in the 2018 Del Miller Memorial. Manchego, into her aged career, won three races where she beat the 1:50 mark while Atlanta just recently won her second sub-1:50

race when taking the \$81,000 Allerage Filly & Mare Trot at Lexington. Manchego and Atlanta have faced off on 12 occasions since becoming aged competitors in 2019. In eight of those events, Atlanta came out on top. And in this unusual matchup just outside downtown Harrisburg, nearly a month after the announcement of Manchego's retirement from racing, another point went to Atlanta, but the margin was fittingly tight.

Manchego's full-sister sold at the tail end of Monday's session as Hip 118 – a Hanover Shoe Farms-consigned filly named Swanky Hanover. She lured a \$700,000 bid from Jeff Snyder, registering as the second-highest sale of the session.

"My wife said she liked it. She likes the filly and my son did also," Snyder said before Paula Snyder added with a laugh, "I liked her... I didn't like the price."


"We hope we'll get lucky," Jeff said. "We're concentrating on trotters this year and we sold a few pacers, so we can fund it a little bit. There's some real good residual value there... that's one reason that we went that high. There's pedigree there. The only thing I was concerned about is that she's a June 11th foal, so we're going to have to take our time and wait on her. But, if all goes well, she'll be a broodmare somewhere down the line and we'll sell them here at the Harrisburg sale, like these crazy prices are going for."

Snyder also confirmed that Swanky Hanover will go into training with Marcus Melander.

Record-breaking session

The sale's opening session grossed \$17,730,000 and set records for average (\$130,368) and median price (\$100,000). Only the 2019 opening session grossed more (\$19,227,000) and it did so selling 32 more horses (136) than this year (168).

Compared to last year's sale held in Timonium, MD due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the gross was up 38 per cent over the first-day total of \$12,813,000 and the average was up 57 per cent from the 2020 opening average of \$83,201.


Monday's average was 14 per cent higher than the previous sale record for an opening session average set in 2019 (\$114,446).

These numbers come off a strong Lexington Selected Yearling Sale which smashed records in every category.

Big bucks from Blais and others

When first asked about the price of Craft Made, a Walner half-brother to Fashionwoodchopper (2, 1:53M; \$490,858), trainer Luc Blais only said, "Too much, too much." Purchasing the colt for his owner Serge Godin (Determination), Blais nonetheless liked a lot about the colt, except the price.

"For the [Walners] I saw selling, it was the nicest one I saw," Blais said. "Nice-looking horse, good page. He was perfect. I know

we paid lots of money, but it's tough to buy right now, this year.

"We connected with that horse, that's for sure. When I saw him, I always liked him. I saw him lots of times and all the time it was, 'Wow, wow.'

The final bid on Craft Made, consigned by Preferred Equine, was \$610,000, marking him as the session's third-highest sale. Two others in the first day broke the \$500,000 mark. The next highest price came for Hip 58, Lord Bridgerton – a Muscle Hill colt consigned by Concord Stud Farm. From the Cantab Hall mare Fine Tuned Lady (3, 1:52.2M; \$643,987), he left at the slam of the hammer to the tune of \$530,000. Robert Lindstrom purchased the colt as agent for "owners from Sweden."

"I don't know exactly how the group is going to be finalized," Lindstrom said, "so I don't want to say anything for the moment – someone could be left out.

"He was a big horse and he grew with every visit. Such nice conformation and he moved so easily. I was looking at him at the farm... they let him out and everything and he was super, a super nice horse. It's a top family, impressive in the bottom – Credit Winner family, but so good on so many branches of the family."

Lindstrom also confirmed that, although the ownership is from Sweden, that they plan to race the colt in North America. "We take them over when they agree to be a stallion," he said with a laugh. He also later confirmed that the colt will go into training with Marcus Melander.

Andy and Julie Miller had the last half-million-dollar acquisition, though it came in as the first. With the second horse of the day going into the ring, Team Orange Crush won the auction for \$500,000. The filly they purchased is named Defacement, also consigned by Concord Stud Farm and by Muscle Hill out of the Windsong's Legacy mare Thatsnotmyname (2, 1:55M; \$340,730). She is a full-sister to Fifty Cent Piece, who recently won in the Swedish Breeders Crown. Coincidentally, Fifty Cent Piece and Future Secured, a Thatsnotmyname foal by Cantab Hall, both drew \$500,000 when they went through the ring at Harrisburg. Breeder Order By Stable retained Future Secured's full-sister Basquiat while Take This Society sold for \$475,000 in 2019.

"Well, I'm pretty fortunate," said Julie Miller, whose husband Andy Miller made sure to deservingly point all the credit to her in picking out this filly. "Andy and I went out to Concord Farms because we liked the horse. We liked the turn out, the floor presentation. The page was amazing, so we were pretty fortunate that the ownership group of Katz, Brixton Medical and Hatfield decided to go together and buy her today and we're honored to get to train her.

Though they purchased the filly early in the afternoon, Andy and Julie stood to their usual perch against the fence in the West Hall and watched several of the higher-priced horses go through the ring.

"That was a bargain, I guess, in today's market. Now [Katz et al.] can pay their training bills and staking bills, I guess," Julie said with a laugh. "We loved the filly and we were tickled pink with

her. She check off all the boxes so we're happy to have her in our barn. Size, her proportion, her substance... just looked like the kind of animal that you can't wait to get your hands on to train."

Concord comes out on top

Robin and David Meirs III's Concord Stud Farm led all consignors of the opening session, selling 25 yearlings for the leading

average of \$197,120. And, of the five that broke the half-million mark, three came from Concord including the sale's topper. Blue Chip Farms checked in second with an average, from four horses, of \$189,250 followed by Hanover Shoe Farms selling 48 for an average of \$135,354 and Allamerican Harnessbreds with eight selling at an average of \$126,125.

"After watching Lexington and seeing those numbers we sort of expected that we would have some good numbers here," Robin Meirs said. "We didn't know what those numbers were going to be, but we were hoping they were going to be high. We're just so proud of everyone that is here. Most of the horses are born and raised on our farm and a lot of them are for our owners as well, so it's great to be able to do such a great job for them, for all of our clients.

Asked about whether the first foal from Fine Tuned Lady would attract such a high price when compared to the pedigree on their full sister to Atlanta, Robin said, "I was not anticipating \$530,000. We were hoping to hit a home run with him being a first foal. We purchased the mare and then bred her to Muscle Hill right away. We were really hoping that was going to be a home run for us and it was. That was a good home run for us."

Even though the first day for Concord was strong, Robin said she and her consignment are excited for several other yearlings set to go through the marathon sale of the next two days with just about 300 yearlings to sell today (Nov. 9).

"We've got some great horses (Tuesday). There's a ton of interest in the #165 (Known Agenda), the Resolve out of True Friends. At #178 (A Good Chardonnay), we've got a Walner filly. The Walners have been selling amazingly, so who knows where we're going to go there."

Concord yearlings were not the only ones bringing high bids. Through the whole session, a total of 69 yearlings brought a six-digit figure to the credit line – accounting for just over 50 per cent of all the horses sold on the day.

"People want to buy horses," Robin said. "That's very clear. I thought we had a good crowd today. People were here and they were getting their hands up. You weren't really getting away with... if there was something nice, you were going to pay for it."

"It was incredible," said Dale Welk, who is in his first year as president of the Standardbred Sales Company, of the opening session. "Far exceeded [expectations]... not far, but it exceeded more than what I thought it would. I'm very happy with what everything brought. We had a few that didn't bring what we thought, but we had others that just far exceeded. I've got to thank the buyers, the bidders, the consignors, the owners that sell horses with us... it was an incredible day for my first time in this seat.

"[It's a] very healthy market," Welk said. "I think some of it, too... last year people were kind of reined in and they couldn't be here. When you have the people here, it makes a big difference. Big difference.

"I think the border opening helped some. I did a couple hundred letters for our Canadian friends. Some of them had to use them and some of them didn't when they went across. There was a lot more online bidding last year and I think part of it was because of that, but I can't be happier with the way the day was and I think it's going to carry on. I really do."

Online bidding became a staple of the yearling auctions with the onset of the COVID-19 in 2020. But nearing the third year of the pandemic, many buyers made their way back to bid in person while the sale offered online bidding merely as an option.

"I listened to the auctioneers closely when someone was bidding online and I think it was okay, but it wasn't near what it was last year," Welk said. "It was, you know... I don't know yet how many bought online – there was some, but nothing like last year when we sold 130 online. Or 115. I'm not sure how many were bought online, but there was some bidding, and pretty aggressive bidding, on the big horses especially.

"It's good to be so-called 'home.' This would've been our 83rd sale here, but we missed last year, so it's 82 years here and it's just like being at home. You're under a roof. As you know, last year the tent went down. Jim (Ladwig) from Winbak came up and said, 'The roof is still standing.' We got through that, but there's nothing like being here and nothing like having a day like today."





Impressive winners in Swedish Breeders Crown

Four \$373,000 Breeders Crown finals were on the menu in Eskilstuna, Sweden on Sunday (Nov. 7) afternoon and the race card was indeed rich in content with most of the best 3- and 4-year-olds in Sweden gathered around the same track.

Unfortunately, the Swedish fall seriously entered the region on Sunday morning and rain and quite low temperatures subdued the atmosphere a bit around the oval. Nonetheless, the four Breeders Crown divisions were all exciting and one American-bred trotter hit the wire as winner. SRF Stable owned **Fifty Cent Piece** (Muscle Hill) has been fortunate in every stakes race she's been in this year. Victories in Drottningpokalen and Stosprintern preceded the triumph in Breeders Crown for 4-year-old mares which ended up being pretty safe. Robert Bergh came to the

lead after a quarter of a mile, after a hard battle against Hall Of Am, who made a break just before Fifty Cent Piece reached the front position. Heavy favorite Honey Mearas went off stride after 100 meters and when two of the worst opponents were out of the race, Fifty Cent Piece proved to be best, even if runner up Sayonara had advantage over the leader at the top of the stretch. The mile rate 1:57.2 was the moderate winning time for Fifty Cent Piece over 1.3 miles. Hall Of Am did a very strong race after her break in the first turn and came back as third at the wire.

Fifty Cent Piece's "purse" in the final was \$186,500 since, in this case, she was bred in a country other than Sweden.

Derby winner Calgary Games didn't try the Breeders Crown since he's working at Menhammar Stuteri as a stud and when elimination winner San Moteur was scratched from the final for 4-year-old colts and geldings, Per Nordström-trained Önas Prince (Chocolatier) had to bear the burden as first choice. Önas Prince left quickly for the lead and Nordström was allowed to pass the half mile (approximately) in 1:01.2.

Örjan Kihlström (Mister Hercules) understood that it would be more or less impossible to reach the leader when the pace was set so low, so he left second over for a first over trip when a kilometer remained. And then the great battle began. Önas Prince and Mister Hercules left the rest of the gang with 20-30 meters at the back stretch and the serious move by Kihlström costed a little bit too much for Mister Hercules, who couldn't challenge the brave leader over the home stretch.

Önas Prince won easily in mile rate 1:56.2, so the last kilometer was quick. Big upset Dollar Doc finished strongly as third for Jorma Kontio.

Önas Prince is definitely a factor when the best 4-year-old trotter will be named at the Horse Of The Year awards in February. Some fans consider Calgary Games to be the obvious choice in that category, but if we look back at this entire season, Önas Prince has dominated in a big way by winning Kungapokalen, Sprintermästaren and Breeders Crown, while he finished second to Calgary Games in the Derby. The mystique that surrounds Calgary Games since he's undefeated, probably weighs heavier when the journalists will decide who's the best 4-year-old trotter in Sweden 2021.

Both divisions for 3-year-olds were claimed by Daniel Redén and owner Brixton Medical AB (Stall Zet). Kriteriet winner **Francesco** Zet was the big favorite in the Breeders Crown for 3-year-old colts and geldings and Kihlström hit the lead after a quarter of a mile. Francesco Zet (Father Patrick) has developed a lot during the season and the colt seemed eager to run all the way this time. When he won \$882,000 Kriteriet at Solvalla earlier this season, Francesco Zet acted immature and in Sunday's race he seemed to be a grown up horse who knew what the job is about. Kihlström had everything under control and the Father Patrick son hit the wire an outstanding winner in a mile rate of 1:56.2.

Runner up Indy Rock finished very strongly ahead of Dozen Of Oysters.

It was more of a surprise when Redén trained **Glamorous Rain** (Muscle Hill) claimed the Breeders Crown for 3-year-old fillies. From position third over, driver Kihlström had to leave three wide with a lap to go when attacks were made from behind and Glamorous Rain did the tough job outside of horses in two turns while the pace was really high. First over trotter Lara Boko kept the pace high and leader Red Lady Express could never rest one second in front. Lara Boko got advantage of the race in the last

turn and Glamorous Rain should have been out of both moral and power with the tough three wide trip, but Kihlström managed to persuade his trotter over the home stretch. Glamorous Rain kept her nose first at the wire and a very brave Lara Boko had to find herself as runner up ahead of Imhatra Am. Glamorous Rain also became the fastest winner of Breeders Crown 2021. The mile rate for her was 1:56.1.

"It was an exciting day and we had our shots in advance. My horses all performed very well in the eliminations and I had great belief in both Francesco Zet and Honey Mearas," Redén said. "Unfortunately for Honey Mearas, she didn't like the track today after all this rain, but overall, the surface has been great, considering the weather and everything. Francesco Zet is a very good horse, which he proved already in Kriteriet and today he won with a lot of power to use in the end. We've had an unbelievable year, again and our horses have claimed several big races during the season. I'm just thrilled."

Redén claimed his eighth Breeders Crown trophy when Glamorous Rain won on Sunday. It is a great achievement for a trainer who opened his stable in 2017.

Case Bateson's first career win on a pari-mutuel track took time to sink in

His first pari-mutuel track win didn't require a photo, but that's not how Case Bateson saw it develop from the driver's seat.

The 19-year-old horseman from Ohio put the bay 5-year-old pacer Rock N Randy V, in a perfect spot just seconds after the starter car zoomed away from the field on the night of Nov. 1 at Hollywood Dayton Raceway.

Crossing over from post seven, Bateson and the gelding he co-owns with his father, Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association president Steve Bateson, was a half-length in front after an opening panel in :27.1.

Although the duo gave up the lead soon after, the pair was still in a prime spot and were 1 ½-lengths behind the pacesetter, 2-5 favorite Starthimup, after three-quarters. A length behind at the stretch call Rock N Randy V, at 14-1, was rolling under emphatic urging from Bateson.

At the wire, the son of Pet Rock, trained by Jason Brewer, and his pilot were 1 ¼-lengths the best.

There was no wave of the whip, fist pump or celebratory outburst of emotion from Bateson after the finish line.

The reason why?

"I've never been really good knowing if I got it or not," said Bateson. "And I really didn't know if I got it. I was 85 per cent sure that I held on. A few steps after the wire, [driver] Tyler Smith pulls up and asks me if I won. I told him, 'I thought I did, but since you're asking me, I don't really know.' I scored way far down the backstretch and waited for Tony Hall (driving the favorite) to pull up in the paddock. When he did, I finally thought, 'I think I got it.' I was so zoned-in on that approach of 'keep driving,' that it didn't really sink in."

That victory, aside from a treasured milestone score, was also meaningful in what it represented, goal-wise, for Bateson.

"Getting that first win at a pari-mutuel track was something I wanted to achieve before the end of the year. And it was so great to come back and see Jason and my dad waiting there. They were ecstatic. It was pretty special to bring the horse back and see them waiting for me."

The young reinsman, who works in the Brewer barn, couldn't have scripted it any better.

Well, with perhaps one exception.

"It would have been even better if we would have bet him," quipped Bateson.

Although he's just starting out, Bateson sounds very much like a seasoned pro whenever he talks about his career.

One of the big keys to his early success is keeping an open mind when it comes to his work in the sulky.

"I learn something new every single day. I could walk around the paddock and ask the same question to 100 people and potentially get 100 different answers. Advice is not tough to come by and that's something you really appreciate. I've been really, really blessed. God has dealt me a pretty fair hand. I have lot of great people behind me, and they've been the wind beneath my sail."

There's no doubt the up-and-coming star has charted a course towards a successful career.

A wealth of good advice has helped him navigate the ups-and-downs in his rookie campaign.

"I think the one thing that really stands out for me is that you need to turn the page in this sport and in this particular role. You can't let things bother you too much. Obviously, that's way easier said than done – you're going to lose more than you win – but I think about that approach often. Being able to shake off a bad result is so important. You just keep reminding yourself that you can go out and chase the outcome you want.

"Another bit of advice that I think is a big key is to be patient. Success will come when it comes – don't try to rush it along and get worried about when that will happen."

Win or lose, Bateson, post-race, makes sure to bring back a good

attitude when he speaks with the connections of the horse he just drove.

Keeping that bright outlook is a must-have, he said.

"Be positive. People like when a driver pulls up and is positive. If you come back and you don't have that positive approach – there's no need to be negative in this sport. There's too much of that already."

That mindset extends to his life outside of the racetrack, whether it's with family and friends, or when he's watching race replays.

A critical eye is tempered by an open mind when it comes to his craft.

Bateson is still very much a student, albeit in this instance, a pupil of the standardbred industry.

Although he enjoys spending his time hanging out with his friends away from the racetrack, there is always homework to be done, namely, preparations for the next day of racing.

And when he does sit down to study, Bateson isn't just looking at video replays of the horses he'll be driving.

In order to give himself the best odds of besting the competition, he likes to familiarize himself with the pacers or trotters who should provide the toughest test.

So, whenever class is in session, Bateson takes copious notes, both on paper and stored in his mind.

"I watch a ton of replays. I watch a lot of replays on the horse I'm going to drive and then I'll typically pick out three or four horses that I think are really tough factors in the race and I'll watch all their replays, just to see the different styles that they race and who's driving them, things like that."

Although his career is just taking off, the teenager is very much a numbers man, a humble horseman with big hopes for his career in the race bike.

"I am a big numbers guy. This summer, I said if I could get five wins by the end of the year, I thought that would be pretty special. So, I turn the page and then I set new goals."

And while he might look unflappable in the minutes leading up to a race, there is, he admitted, a nervous energy that overtakes him as the clock ticks down to post time.

"I'm always more nervous before I go to the gate. Once I'm on the gate, I'm fine. And when you're on your way, whatever you plan you might have going into the race, that can change in a second. You look left, you look right, and then you adapt to what you see. It's all about knowing where you're at and going from there."

Even in the moments when he might not always know what he's achieved.

Pelling proteges prove prolific in Big M's Kindergarten

Trainer Brett Pelling has a strong pair of 2-year-olds heading into next week's Kindergarten Classic Series Finals, as his Treacherous Dragon and Hammering Hank recorded easy victories Saturday night during the series fifth and final leg at The Meadowlands.

In a split for filly pacers, **Treacherous Dragon**, one week removed from a third-place finish in the Breeders Crown Final taken by division standout Niki Hill, was away from the gate in anything but a hurry, as driver Tim Tetrick opted to sit fourth while Find Happiness led at the quarter (:27.2) before 3-1 second choice Always Gonna B You took over at the half (:55.3).

Ever patient, Tetrick waited until just after the five-eighths-mile mark to move the daughter of Captaintreacherous-My Little Dragon off the rail. Treacherous Dragon then picked up cover from the pocket-popping Find Happiness on the far turn before tipping wide as they straightened up before cruising to a safe head win in 1:52. Find Happiness was second with Counterparty Risk third.

"I was pretty aggressive with her last week and wanted to come off a helmet this time," said Tetrick. "She finished up well. I thought that [Find Happiness] might pull in front of me."

What about the finish, when Find Happiness was closing in nearing the wire?

"My mare waits on them," said Tetrick. "She was just messing around." Treacherous Dragon returned \$2.40 to win as the heavy 1-5 public

choice in raising her record to four wins from eight lifetime starts.

Hammering Hank, fourth in the Crown a week ago to Monte Miki, was handled with care by Dexter Dunn, who had the gelded son of Captaintreacherous-History Repeats sitting fourth early in a dash for male pacers.

Dunn then had 'Hank' in a live flow third-over to the head of the stretch before sailing by his foes while pacing a final quarter in 27.1 to record a lifetime-best 1:51.2 mile. "He has extremely high speed," said Dunn. "His run in the Breeders Crown last week was awesome, and tonight, he was doing it pretty easy in the stretch."

Hammering Hank returned \$2.60 to his backers as the 1-5 favorite as his record remained unblemished in three Kindergarten starts.

Pelling is feeling good about his chances in next week's Kindergarten Finals, which will offer four dashes for freshmen of each sex and gait, which, depending on if the consolations fill, could go for purses totaling \$1 million.

"Treacherous Dragon has always been very, very good," said Pelling. "She knows what she's doing and is a very smart girl. Hammering Hank? We actually haven't seen his speed yet. He's pretty cool.

"I would never have raced either horse this week [since they raced a week ago in the Breeders Crown]. But the point leaders in the Kindergarten automatically draw well [posts 1 through 5] so I decided to race both so that next week, they come back with inside posts."

NYSS announces Breeders Awards earned for 2020 performances

The New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) has released annual Breeders Awards for the 2020 racing season. Payment packages will be mailed to the recipients this week. The full list of awards can be found at the New York Sire Stakes website.

The Breeders Awards program provides rewards for each level of New York Sire Stakes racing: Sire Stakes, Excelsior Series and County Fairs. The awards are residency based, rewarding breeders who keep their mares in New York State for at least 180 days during the year of conception, thereby contributing to the agricultural economy. The program is designed to stimulate New York State's agriculture sector and support New York farms.

A total of 308 New York-bred horses and 130 entities earned awards this year, totaling \$500,000. Of those awardees, 10 earned more than \$10,000. Two-year-olds returned nearly 13 per cent of their earnings to breeders and 3-year-olds returned 11 per cent.

The single largest earner was last year's New York Sire Stakes champion Hobbs, a homebred who earned \$234,090 in New York-bred purses and rewards breeder Runthetable Stables with a \$26,795.24 check.

Blue Chip Farms, earning awards as Blue Chip Bloodstock and Blue Chip Farms LLC, received the largest sum in awards totaling \$58,364.43 for 33 offspring. Winbak Farm, the perennial leading breeder across all tiers of the New York Sire Stakes program, received \$56,013.07 in awards from 31 offspring.

"Breeders are the foundation of the harness racing industry. We are proud to support the investment they make right here in the Empire State," said M. Kelly Young, executive director, Agriculture and New York State Horse Breeding Development Fund. "We are coming out of a difficult period in our history and we appreciate the breeders maintaining their commitment to New York as our revenues were impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. We fully anticipate the Breeders Awards will return to \$1 million in 2022 and that purses will return to pre-pandemic levels."

The New York Sire Stakes is the state's premier harness racing program for 2- and 3-year-old Standardbreds designed to stimulate the breeding, buying and racing of Standardbred horses in New York State. It is the nation's oldest harness racing program of its kind has served as a model for state-bred racing programs.
