Twinbrook breaks through in Harrisburg second session

The Ontario-based family farm sold the second highest priced yearling on Tuesday as the two-day gross of \$35.7 million set a sale record.

colt Twin B Predator returned from the ring. The family posed for photographers alongside their pride, who topped the pacing ranks of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's second session on Tuesday (Nov. 8).

Twin B Predator, selling as **Hip 391**, fell center to a bidding war that propelled the colt's price through the six-figure sphere. Farm manager Tammy McNiven paced from wall to wall on the auctioneer's overlook while containing her excitement from

the climbing bids. At hammer's slam, the colt from the Western Ideal mare Paisley Hanover sold for \$310,000.

"I knew he had the potential because of the pedigree," McNiven said. "We paid a lot of money for the mare and the family is there. This is what we're striving for, to get that top individual. I think today has been a hard day out there and there's been some good, some bad and there's been some ugly. So, you really don't know where you're going to fall. You know you're probably going to be good, but you don't know if you're going to be great. So, when those numbers get going up and up and up... and there were several people involved, it just makes you smile and you think, 'Okay, we've done what we're supposed to do.' It's validating, very validating."

With his sale, Twin B Predator became the highest-selling yearling for Twinbrook Farm after they beat their record last year with Twin B Nation, an American Ideal colt who sold at Harrisburg for \$300,000.

"The Captaintreacherous colts averaged \$125,000 last year because we keep records of what they brought. So, we knew he was a little above average, but we didn't know he was THAT above the average," McNiven said with a laugh. "So, yeah, it was a little shocking, let me tell you. Now we've outdone ourselves from last year. Now, we've got to go outdo ourselves for next year. There's going to be pressure."

McNiven's words then started to choke and her eyes began to turn red. She was sharing the momentous achievement of her family with her family. "Uncle Jack" McNiven, the father of Tammy's husband Rob and a Canadian Hall of Fame breeder from his years operating Killeen Acres, came down from Ontario. And Tammy's two daughters, who help in the operation of Twinbrook, surrounded her. As well as her grandson Kingston, who Tammy strapped in a Twinbrook jacket she bought for one of her daughters at the Harrisburg Sale 20 years ago.

"This doesn't only build my confidence, it makes me so proud of my family because our daughters help us," McNiven said. "Uncle Jack is here and he's 88. He's a one generation and my husband is a second generation. Our daughters are a third generation and we've got a little grandson here that's fourth generation. So, when everybody is here, it's very validating."

"We do all the work and there's one girl that works for us part-time," McNiven also said. "The rest of us do everything, so there's a lot of blood, sweat and tears, 24/7 and 365. There's no days off because I feel that all the horses are priority before anyone else in the house, so it doesn't matter what day of the year it is – they get fed, they get looked after, and then it's our turn. This year, there might be a little change and we might have to have a little party or something to validate all of that."

The session-making moment for the McNivens came from Noel Daley, who purchased the colt – a first foal of a sister to several

six-figure earners as well as a three-quarter sister to the dam of Papi Rob Hanover – for Kenneth Jacobs.

“I think there were only two of us in for the last \$100,000, but [Jacobs] only bought one pacing colt and that's the one he wanted and he picked him out,” Daley said. “[Jacobs] said he's got way too much time on his hands and he just spends hundreds of hours going over all the videos. Then called me and told me he wanted to buy him, so I went and saw him. I said, 'Did anyone look at him for you?' He said, 'No,

I've been doing this for a long time.' I said, 'Okay, well, he is beautiful.'” Daley said laughing.

Daley, who will train the colt, also said “He actually reminds me a lot of Pebble Beach. All I did was bid for him and get him, but he's going home with me, which is good. I don't deal in these \$300,000 horses usually, so it's good for me.”

CONSIGNORS CONTINUE TO CASH

Tuesday's session saw three consigners enter seven-digit territory. Hanover Shoe Farms led all consigners with a gross of \$5,016,000 from 91 sold, with Preferred Equine next from a gross of \$2,955,000 after 56 sold. Blue Chip Farms sold 23 on the day for a total of \$1,396,000.

From consignments with more than 10 yearlings sold, Blue Chip Farms had the leading average of the second session with their yearlings' mean price at \$60,696. Hanover Shoe Farms averaged \$55,121 and Preferred Equine averaged \$52,768.

Through the two sessions, Hanover Shoe Farms sits atop the consignments with \$12,544,000 grossed from 139 yearlings. A strong opening session from Concord Stud Farm keeps them as the second-highest grossing consigner of the sale with \$5,917,000 and Preferred Equine just behind with \$5,259,000 grossed.

BLOOD RUNS THICK WITH TUESDAY TOPPERS

Ake Svanstedt topped the second session and stayed in the family with **Volcanic Blue Chip**, selling as **Hip 294**. The Walner filly, who left the auction ring for \$325,000, is the second foal from a mare whose sisters include the granddam of a pair of Svanstedt's previous pupils in world champion Plunge Blue Chip and stakes-placed Splash Blue Chip.

"The mother's family... I like that family," Svanstedt said. "I also like her conformation – maybe a little bit too big, but she was born in February. I liked the horse."

Trond Smedshammer also stuck with the family on \$260,000 acquisition Seven Again, selling as Hip 366. The Chapter Seven filly is the 11th foal from the Donerail mare Armbro Deja Vu, who also foaled world champion and former Smedshammer stable star Dejarmbro.

"She's obviously a great individual and she's a Chapter Seven," Smedshammer said. "The mare has produced all kinds with other stallions and she's got great broodmare value after she's done on the track. It's not a huge risk to take. I didn't buy Dejarmbro as a yearling, myself. I ended up with him after his 2-year-old year, but they have some similarities."

Lynn Curry fell in love long ago. Curry visited Hanover Shoe Farms with his trainer Annie Stoebe after catching a glimpse of the striking chestnut filly Elista Hanover, a daughter of International Moni, when at the Lexington Sale this year.

"The minute we turned her out, she was number one," Curry said. "She was the one we wanted the most, if we were lucky enough to get her. Emotion sets in...you go as hard as you can and still be what you think is reasonable. She checked all the boxes. It had nothing to do with color, but she is a beautiful horse."

Previously, Curry had only owned three horses. His third horse glided to the winner's circle of the Jim Doherty Memorial, a

Chapter Seven filly named Instagram Model. Since then, she won four more starts and finished fifth in the Breeders Crown final to earn \$261,025 through seven starts. This filly he purchased is a half-sister to stakes-placed May Karp and from a family which includes a granddam who foaled O'Brien Award winner Up And Ready and a great granddam who foaled world champion and double millionaire Maven.

But Curry said that success did not influence if he would widen his coffers for another high-tag horse. "When I started in the business, after all these years, I said that I wanted to race good horses," he said. "But still, I really don't know what level they are at, but, at the same time, there's a little emotional thing when you're out at the farm and your trainer loves them, you love them, your vet loves them – sometimes it's just a gut feeling, like, she belongs with us.

"I lucked out last year and got a great horse," Curry also said. "That's luck. This whole business is luck. When the gavel comes down, you're not guaranteed anything, so I'm just very happy that we got her. She will fit my stable perfectly and hopefully we're going to have a lot of fun."

Curry and Stoebe then walked through the Main Hall back to Elista Hanover's stall at the Hanover consignment. Stoebe petted the chestnut and Curry looked happily at the horse returning to his stable. Stoebe then handed the writer of this piece her phone to have a picture taken of the three of them.

While people started to leave the complex with just a few yearlings left to sell, Luc Blais struck a strong bid of \$235,000 on Abra Abra Kadabra, a Kadabra filly selling as Hip 512. The filly, going to Serge Godin's Determination, is from a dam who is a full sister to O'Brien Award winner Windsong Espoir, and is another addition to the restock of Blais stable.

"It's a good family and nice-looking filly, too," Blais said. "She's sporty and, like I say, maybe pay too much, but we like her. The Kadabras treat me good."

Blais left the second session with nine yearlings total bought at Harrisburg to add to his six bought at Lexington. And his eyes remain open into the final day of Harrisburg for more horses to fit his local operation in Ontario.

HIGH NUMBERS KEEP CLIMBING

Tuesday's session grossed \$16,014,000, up 2 per cent from 2021's single-session gross. Cumulatively, the 2022 Standardbred Horse Sale has grossed \$35,750,000, a 7 per cent increase from 2021.

More yearlings left the ring in 2022 than did in 2021, with 421 selling last year and 506 selling this year. As a result, the average sale price has dropped. The single-session average on Tuesday dropped 16.2 per cent while the cumulative average is down 11 per cent. Nonetheless, the \$35.7-million gross through Tuesday is a record for the Standardbred Horse Sale.

"I think the day was really good," said Dale Welk, president/director of operations for the Standardbred Horse Sales

Company. "You know, we had some ups and downs, like we did yesterday, but as I said last night, I think it showed today that we had horses that could've sold yesterday."

Sales started on Tuesday with a similar build to the opening session as many soft-priced yearlings circled the ring until the behemoth bids began lifting in the arena. But once the momentum swung, the auction action persisted to the last gavel slam around 6:30 p.m.

"Usually we say that everybody worries about the first 10, but it seemed like it was the first 30 or so in both sessions," Welk said. "Maybe it was even a few more, but once it got started there was no stopping it right up to the end with one at \$140,000 and \$75,000 for the last horse today."

"Overall, I think it was great. The trotters were incredible. The trotting fillies were just through the roof. Of course, the Captains are always going to be there. I'm very happy and I think we're going to be fairly strong tomorrow."

Despite one more day in the yearling sale today (Nov. 9), preparations have already started on suiting the Complex for the Mixed Sale, which begins Thursday (Nov. 10). As most of the yearlings vacate the premises, stable hands and other staff from the Standardbred Sales Company will be shifting consignments and readying the layout for the shipment of the Mixed Sales horses on Thursday.

"We're in the process already and getting things ready to go for tomorrow night," Welk said. "I've got a great staff, because I can't quite help as much as I usually do, but I count on them and they step up and take care of everything."

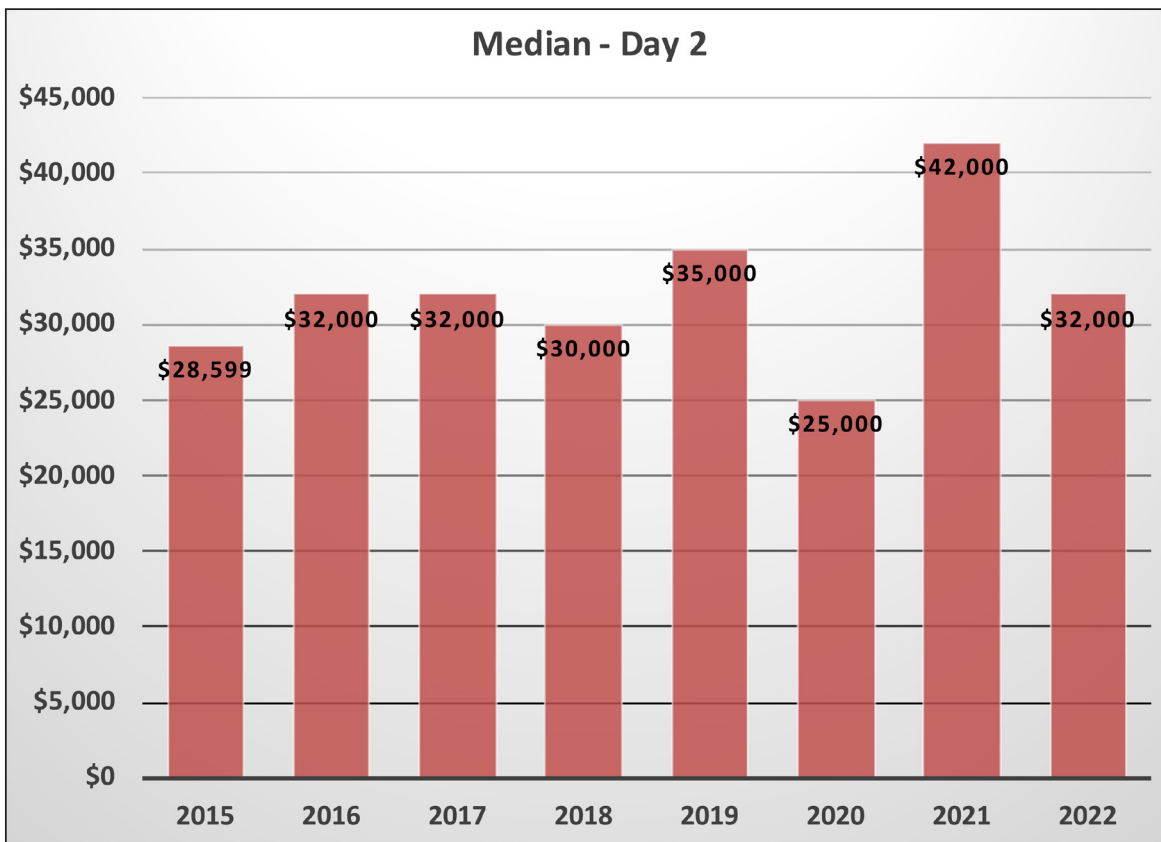
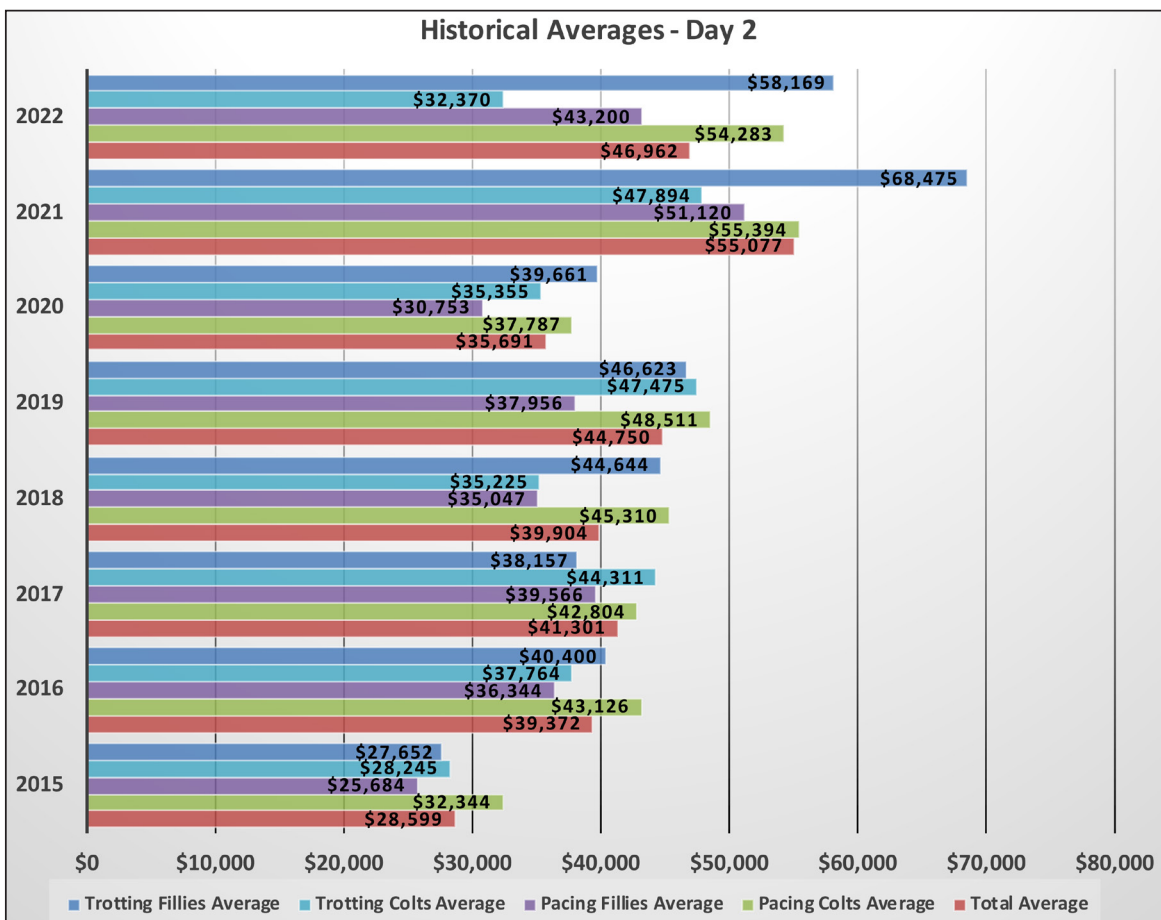

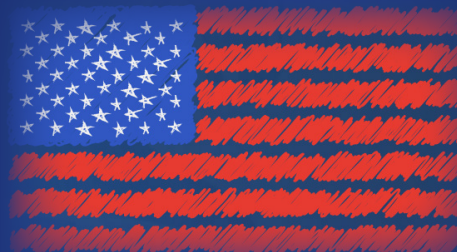

Bulldog Hanover: Ambassador without obligation

The presumptive Horse of the Year in Canada and the United States will have one final career start in the TVG open pace at The Meadowlands on Nov. 26.

Jack Darling bought one yearling Monday (Nov. 7) at the opening session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling auction in Harrisburg, PA. **Hip #17 Brady Hanover** (Always B Miki– Bittersweet Terror) is a half-brother to his former trainee Beaumont Hanover (p, 3,1:49.1m; \$430,427), who swept the 2019 Harvest Series at Woodbine Racetrack and won three 2020 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold legs at Woodbine and Rideau Carleton.

The Cambridge, ON horseman said he was pleasantly surprised by numerous well-wishers at the sale – not about the new \$100,000 purchase, but about Bulldog Hanover (p, 4,1:45.4m; \$2,247,325), the horse he bought at the 2019 Harrisburg sale for \$28,000. Darling developed and trains the fastest-ever standardbred, whom he co-owns with Brad Grant of Milton, ON.

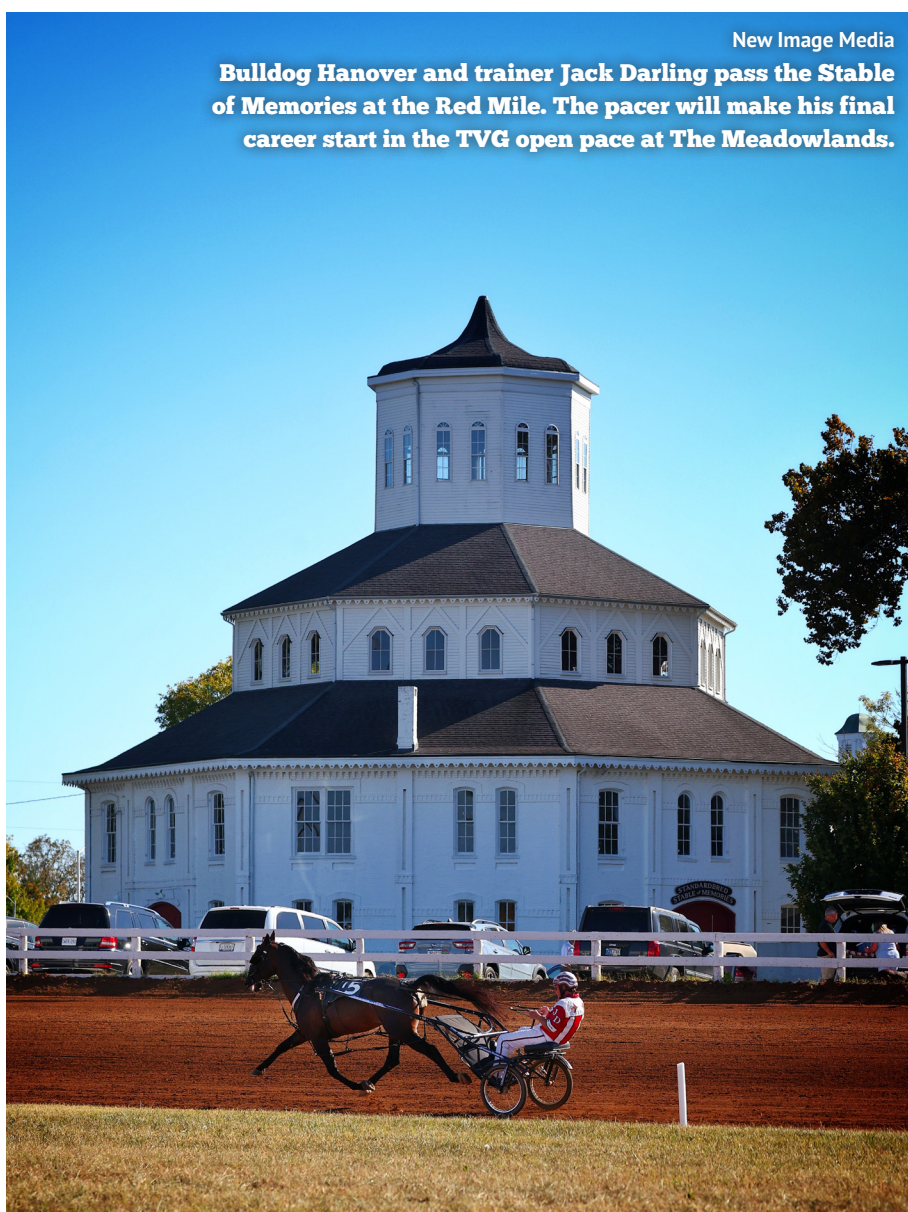
“Virtually everybody that I knew, and even people that I didn’t know, came up and congratulated me about Bulldog and said how much they admire the horse,” Darling said. “What really stands out is people were just so sincere. The look on their face and in

their eyes. I mean, they just have a tremendous reverence for that horse—they see the greatness in him. It’s really something.”

There were naturally questions about the decision to bypass Rosecroft Raceway’s Potomac Pace Invitational, taking place this Thursday (Nov. 10), and the decision to make the stallion’s final career start the TVG open pace on Nov. 26 at The Meadowlands. But the overall theme was simply appreciation for Bulldog Hanover.

Before his most recent start, the Oct. 29 Breeders Crown open pace, Bulldog Hanover encountered a steady stream of admirers in the Woodbine Mohawk Park paddock. Caretaker Johnny Mallia stood vigilantly alongside the stallion, who displayed a gentle, even friendly, attitude towards his visitors.

“I’ve never seen anything like it,” said Darling. “The last few times he’s raced, wherever he goes, people – I don’t know how they get in the paddock – but they’re getting in there to see him. They just can’t seem to get enough of him. They’ll stand



there for a long time. They just love to look at him and watch. He just stands there and pricks his ears up. He's just a very classy horse. Most of the really good horses I've had, they've had that class, you know—things just don't bother them. They take it all in stride."

The world champion's temperament is a clear factor in his success, but also his popularity. Not every top horse can calmly meet fans face-to-face, let alone a top horse who stood stud in early 2022.

"He was in training and bred 80 mares, so there's going to be little Bulldogs coming up this spring," said Darling.

He confirmed that Bulldog Hanover will be returning to stand at Seelster Farms in Lucan, ON, full-time in 2023.

The strength of the Ontario Sires Stakes program makes Seelster Farms an ideal location for Bulldog Hanover's second season at stud. Darling noted that dual-eligibility in other racing jurisdictions will create even greater opportunity for little Bulldogs.

"When they're raised in Kentucky, [foals] are Kentucky-eligible for all their stakes, and then Ontario-eligible as well, plus all the Grand Circuit races, so there will be lots of stakes races for his offspring."

Darling's Somebeachsomewhere—Armbro Wallflower mare Beach of a Time (p, 3, 1:52.2s; \$67,597) is currently in foal to Bulldog Hanover, as is Canada's fastest-ever filly on a 5/8-mile

track, Powerful Chris (p, 3, 1:50.2f; \$333,876). He co-owns the Betterthancheddar—Cell Power daughter with John Pentland of Dorchester, ON.

Unusually for a double-duty stallion, Bulldog Hanover has had plenty of close contact with fans this year. Did his owner/trainer expect the impromptu meet-and-greets?

"Not necessarily," said Darling. "He's just been there and people have come back, and we've let them. Sometimes I get a little concerned when there's people in the paddock, that it might be a little too much, but they just want to see him, get their picture taken with him, and they just want to touch him."

Bulldog Hanover's record this year (13 wins in 15 seasonal starts, seven in 1:47 or quicker) would indicate that he wasn't bothered by the spotlight. Before the Breeders Crown open pace at Woodbine Mohawk Park, he patiently posed for selfies, then went out to win going away in 1:46.4s, equalling Canada's fastest-ever mile (set by Dr J Hanover in 2017, then equalled in Bulldog Hanover's own Canadian Pacing Derby victory Sept. 3 at the stallion's home track.)

Standardbreds of this caliber have traditionally attracted popular attention, but audiences have increasingly splintered into areas of specific interest: Today's dedicated sports fan is unlikely to accidentally stumble upon harness racing content. Urbanization has simultaneously eroded the number of North Americans who have regular contact with horses, making

equine sports a hard sell. Expecting Bulldog Hanover to reverse harness racing's trend toward mainstream invisibility is unfair.

But Darling told HRU that he nonetheless witnessed a low-key, small-scale renaissance in public interest during his horse's year of escalating excellence.

"Well, I've got to say that he has attracted fans and [new] people," he said. "I've heard from people that aren't regular fans and they're not horsemen, but they've heard about him and they're interested in him. I think that he's created some interest in our [sport]."

"And we've been getting interest from the mainstream media around home. He's been getting quite a bit of that, and at the tracks that he races at: At Lexington, the local [television] station covered him, and Indiana, they had a couple of stations cover him. Even the Toronto newspapers are covering him, which is kind of unusual."

That media interest hasn't been evident since the great Somebeachsomewhere's 2008 campaign. "They're always trying to compare: 'Who's the greatest horse?'" said Darling. "Somebeachsomewhere and Bulldog, they're always mentioned in the same sentence. It's kind of neat."

He said Bulldog Hanover did his part to promote harness racing, one start at a time.

"He definitely has attracted his admirers. Over the summer, with each race, he got more and more fans. There's just something about him, the way he races, the way he does it. He's so overpowering, and that just attracts attention and admiration. People really admire and respect that horse."

Throw in an unexpected touch of easygoing charisma (à la Foiled Again) for a harness racing ambassador with more than pure speed and toughness. "It's such a bonus when a horse has that kind of mentality, when they can relax and take it all in," said Darling, adding that composure was always part of the 4-year-old's personality: "Yeah, I would say so. Even as a 2-year old, he was pretty good to work around. First time going to the paddock, to race and to qualify, he took it in stride. Every time he went to a new track, no problem."

Unfortunately, the 2022 Potomac Pace presented logistical problems for Bulldog Hanover.

"I was actually planning on [entering] it," said Darling. "He had 30 days between races, and that race kind of popped up and we thought it would be a good tightener for him. But mainly because of the Harrisburg sale, I couldn't get my regular trucker, and I was going to be at Harrisburg... It was just going to be a little too much, so I changed my mind. The shipping around is a little bit of a concern."

The TVG open pace will be Bulldog Hanover's final career start, but viewers can catch him in action one more time before the pari-mutuel farewell.

"He'll probably get a qualifier in at Mohawk, about a week before that," said his trainer. A 5-year-old campaign is definitely not happening, despite the stallion's all-but-guaranteed Horse of the Year season at age 4.

"In his case, I'm like everybody else: I'd love to watch him race for another year, too," said Darling, who will be inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame next year. "There's not really much there for him to prove, and he's going to be a very popular stallion."

He said he was already fielding Bulldog Hanover breeding queries from "virtually every standardbred breeder" at Harrisburg.

As with recently-retired Breeders' Cup winner Flightline on the thoroughbred side, there are risks associated with keeping the world's top racehorse in training. It is logical, yet emotional, to conclude on a high point.

"He likes to get behind the gate and race horses. He enjoys racing," said Darling. "But as much as I'd love to watch him race [next year], I'm just really happy that he can go into retirement never having been hurt, no surgeries, and he's going to live a great life, which he deserves."

While awaiting his final qualifier on Canadian soil, Bulldog Hanover is taking it easy at the Puslinch, ON training centre where Darling's stable is based.

"He's at Classy Lane. Out in the paddock every day for an hour. He loves life," said his trainer. "It's almost like he knows what's going on, he knows how great he is, and he just seems to enjoy it."

Kodack Black, Perfect Twenty dominate in DSBF splits

Kodack Black and **Perfect Twenty** stamped themselves as the likely favorites in the month-long Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings at Bally's Dover with matching 1:56.4 wins — both by double-digit margins — in their respective \$20,000 first-round preliminary divisions on Tuesday (Nov. 8). **Lilmisswontbewrong** and **Miss Daburg** captured their opening-round divisions for 2-year-old trotting fillies.

Kodack Black, who was disqualified from victory in the Oct. 12 Harrington series final due to a late break in stride, had no such issues in his first Dover preliminary. After driver Montrell Teague rated him in fourth behind a contested :28.3 first quarter, the Kodak Lindy—Love On Broadway gelding brushed aggressively with a lap to go and cleared early leader Carls Legacy (driven by Jason Thompson) before reaching the half in :58.2. As Kodack Black drew clear at will up the backstretch, Reddy Fox (Jared Moyer) angled from fourth and pushed into second over the badly fading Carls Legacy with three-eighths to go. Despite Reddy Fox's uncovered gains, he proved no match for Kodack Black, who coasted to three-quarters in 1:27.4 and drew 14 lengths clear at the end of his lifetime best score. Reddy Fox was an isolated second, 30 lengths better than third-place finisher Carls Legacy.

Perfect Twenty and driver Tim Tetrick were similarly dominant in the second split, clearing Clifton Green stablemate Hespookshescores (Russell Foster) easily through a :29 first quarter and traveling uncontested through splits of :58.4 and 1:28.1. The Yankee Royalty-Jetta Spring gelding accelerated for home while in hand, using a :28.3 last quarter to put 13-1/4 lengths of clearance on Hespookshescores. I Got It Made (Michael Cole) finished third, another 1-3/4 lengths in arrears.

Robert Allison Jr. owns the Jason Leid-bred Perfect Twenty, who paid \$2.60 in his fourth career win.

In first-round DSBF action for rookie trotting fillies, Lilmisswontbewrong took top honors with a 2:01 score in the first division. Corey Callahan floated the Anders Bluestone-Lil Miss Tagliabue filly for a pocket trip behind Royal Flirt (Kim Vincent) through a 1:01.3 first half. With seven-sixteenths to go, Lilmisswontbewrong moved forward, dueled to the lead through a :29.2 third split, and drew clear steadily to win by 5-1/2 lengths. Last Nights Hit (Art Stafford Jr.) improved mildly into second over a toiling Royal Flirt.

Bobby Glassmeyer owns and trains the Susan Durham and Linda MacDonald-bred Lilmisswontbewrong, who broke her maiden in what was her fourth career start.

In the second filly division, the previously undefeated She Is Strong (Stafford) controlled the terms as the 1-5 favorite, but stopped on the far turn after setting soft fractions of :29, 1:00.2 and 1:31.2 and being engaged by Lady Brass (Russell Foster), who pushed first-over from fifth up the backstretch and took the lead with just over an eighth of a mile to go. As Lady Brass engulfed She Is Strong, Pat Berry angled Miss Daburg out of the pocket to give chase in the stretch. The Anders Bluestone-Comical Dream filly lifted to collar Lady Brass in the final strides, springing a 16-1 upset and breaking her maiden in 2:01.3. Fairlee (Justin Vincent) improved belatedly for third; She Is Strong faded steadily to finish last in the five-filly field.

Traci Berry trains Miss Daburg for J. Craparotta and P. Berry Racing LLC, who also bred the filly with Taylor Gower. She paid \$35.40 to win.

Two-year-old trotters will contest the second preliminary round of their DSBF series next Tuesday (Nov. 15), with the eight highest point earners of each sex slated to square off in a pair of \$100,000 finals on Nov. 22.
