All-time record smashed for Harrisburg yearling sale

Standardbred Horse Sales Company tops \$44 million in gross at its yearling sale for the first time.

2022 SHSC YEARLING SALE AT HARRISBURG

In the climb back from economic recession spurred by the pandemic shutdown, the Standardbred Horse Sales Company in Harrisburg saw a stabilization of growth in 2022 which propelled the yearling portion of the sale to an all-time high.

From 904 yearlings sold over the three days, the Harrisburg Sale has grossed \$44,366,000 to crush the previous record of \$42,784,000 set in 2007 when 1,048 horses sold. The 2022 gross also represents a 4.5 per cent increase over last year's gross of \$42,465,500 from 777 yearlings sold in the three days. And though the increase in yearlings sold brought down the average sales price, the growth of the gross as well as an increase in the potential number of racehorses stepping onto the track point to a strengthened course of opportunity for harness racing.

"I can't thank the consignors, buyers and breeders enough," said Dale Welk, president/director of operations for the SHSC. "When you have a good sale like that it helps the Mixed Sale because people will be looking for mares for their next crops. We're down in average, but I think at times there's a little too much emphasis put on the averages at every sale... If there are happy people – happy consignors and happy buyers – that's all that matters.

"I think between us and Lexington, we probably sold 200 more

yearlings between the two sales so that's pretty incredible. Like I keep saying, the depth and the quality is unbelievable. We've really refined our breed and the breeders have done a wonderful job."

Wednesday's (Nov. 9) single-session gross registered \$8,636,000 from 398 yearlings sold, which was more than sold in the third session last year when 356 went through the ring for a gross of \$9,038,500. The single-session gross plateau represented just a 4.5 per cent dip in year-to-year change. For the three days, the average yearling price in 2022 was \$49,077 compared to \$54,653 in 2021 – a 10.2 per cent decrease.

PAIR PRY SIX-DIGIT PRICES

The toppers of the Wednesday session both just broke through to six-figure territory. Bill Donovan was first to beat the plateau when he struck the winning bid of \$100,000 on **Vignette Blue Chip**, selling as **Hip 769**. The Blue Chip Farms-consigned filly from the first crop of Bettors Wish is out of the Rock N Roll Heaven mare Mo Molly Blue Chip, who has foaled one other progeny in \$100,000-plus earner Rys Red Rocket.

"I'm from Massachusetts, so that was a big plus that she was dual-eligible," Donovan said. "To be eligible in New Jersey, where, besides Lazarus and Keystone Velocity there's not a lot of competition there. In New England, it's limited so, if she proves herself, it'll prove to be a bargain when all is said and done in the next two years in the Sires Stakes program."

The yearling sale topper came just 38 horses into the sale. Date Night Hanover, a Chapter Seven filly out of Don't Wait Up, was purchased by Jeffrey Snyder for \$600,000 from the sale's leading consignor, Hanover Shoe Farms. Hanover grossed over \$14 million at the sale for only the second time in its history.

The second-highest priced yearling was Hip 60 Tandem Hanover, a Walner filly out of Think Twice purchased for \$510,000 by trainer Andrew Harris from the Hanover Shoe Farms consignment.

"That's primarily why we bought her. There's four of us in the group – myself, my long-time partner Joe Sbrocco, Craig Henderson and Libby Jones. The four of us, it's actually the same partnership, we own Just Divine together, who is racing in the Matron [Thursday]. We've had horses together and it's a good group, a fun group to share ownership with. This filly, I think there's some earnings potential there.

"There's still a question mark of what kind of a stud [Bettors Wish] is going to be," Donovan also said, "but looking at her she's very correct. She's not real big, but he wasn't really big. So, hopefully, he's a good stallion and she's his first-crop star. We'll all be happy."

Wednesday's other \$100,000 sale came from the nod of Linda Toscano, who landed the last bid on **Tenacious Hanover** – a Hanover Shoe Farms-consigned colt selling as **Hip 893**. The colt comes from a family with a great granddam who is a half-sister to millionaire Kenneth J, whom Toscano also trained, and O'Brien Award and Breeders Crown winner Percy Blue Chip.

"The mare looks like she's been a 100 per cent producer. The family has been good to me," Toscano said. "He's kind of sharp-looking colt with a really good video, too. He's very correct and he moves really well. He fit the bill for what we were looking for."

Regarding the colt's price on a day where figures occasionally pushed near \$100,000, Toscano said "Whenever you see one at the end of the sale that has it all, you know that people are going to reach because it's the end of the sale season and there really isn't another chance at this point, so we were prepared

to go a little bit more than we thought and we did. We went a little bit further than we thought we'd have to go, but that's what it took to buy him."

Toscano purchased the horse as agent for an ownership group which includes Joe Sbrocco, Andy Cohen and Radio Racing, Lorne Polger and John Fodera.

The third-highest sale of the day also came from the Bill Donovan checkbook in **Artonic Hanover**, a Hanover Shoe Farms-consigned filly selling as **Hip 534**. The daughter of Betting Line is a half sister to \$500,000-plus earners in JJ Flynn and Air Force Hanover and also comes from a family with a granddam who is a half-sister to millionaire Caviart Ally. Artonic Hanover sold to Donovan for \$95,000.

Elche Hanover brought the next largest sale of the day at \$82,000 when Glengate Farms won the auction. The daughter of Southwind Frank is a three-quarter sister to \$500,000 earner Hillexotic and has a bloodline which extends to the great, great granddam, who is a half sister to champion trotter Donerail.

Just below that price sold **Long Run Hanover**, another Hanover Shoe Farms-consigned filly. Selling as **Hip 725** to Nicholas Malcolm of Milton, Ont., the filly is a full sister to stakes-placed Luckycharm Hanover and Lilu Hanover. She also comes from a dam out of world champion Beat The Wheel. That dam is also a half-sister to world champion and millionaire Beatgoeson Hanover.

Of the top five yearlings sold on the day, four came from Hanover Shoe Farm.

HANOVER ON TOP

Once again, Hanover Shoe Farm reigned over the yearling sale. From 198 yearlings sold, Hanover grossed \$14,115,000 to beat their 2021 total of \$13,156,000 from 199 yearlings sold. The 2022 gross falls just short of Hanover's all-time record of \$14,371,000 set in 2019 when they sold 233 yearlings.

"To sell \$2 million more worth of yearlings with nine less means we're heading in the right direction ourselves," said Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky, executive vice president of Hanover Shoe Farms. "The quality of our broodmare band, our stallion roster has increased.

"I'm optimistic and I've been optimistic because I usually gauge it by interest and we were very busy in the fairgrounds and had a lot of phone calls. We were very busy here on Sunday, even Monday before the sale. We were taking people's numbers and asking them to come back because we didn't have enough people to show horses. That's really always a good indicator. You don't know what kind of limits they are putting on, but I felt like people were here to spend money.

"We're helped by the overall atmosphere of the business. There's a lot of places racing for a lot of money. People want to have horses and a lot of people have told me, 'Look, if I'm going to lose money in the stock market, I'd rather buy a horse and have



some fun.' So, I just think everything came together for it to be a good sale. I thank the people that bought yearlings from us and the people that buy yearlings from us every year and have faith in us. Of course, we wish them the best."

And for Hanover, the work continues into Thursday (Nov. 10) with the first day of the Mixed Sale, which features several broodmares on the selling block.

"We have 20 [broodmares] on the list so I'll look at them and we'll get our shortlist for who we're going to narrow in on," Dr. Jablonsky said, "but the Harrisburg Mixed Sale is certainly the place where we like to make the high-profile purchases, because, by then, we know how much money we have. It's really the best place to sell a broodmare and, I think, the best place to buy a broodmare. As a breeder, you know how much money you have to spend, so you gross your amount and you know what your expenses are and you know how much you have

to reinvest... but you have to reinvest. People are continuously looking for new blood, current blood, so you can't really rest on your laurels, for sure."

A MIXED SALE LOOKING TO BLOOM

The layout of the Farm Show Complex shifts in the course of 14 hours to accommodate the hundreds of horses shipping in for the start of the two-day mixed sale today (Nov. 10), which primarily features a variety of young horses, breeding prospects and established broodmares among other things. Friday (Nov. 11) will then feature primarily racehorses, with a plethora of stacked talent slated to enter the ring.

"The broodmares and in-foal broodmares and we've got a really strong selection of stallion shares, as well," said David Reid, president of Preferred Equine. "We're starting off tomorrow with a couple of really interesting weanlings that will be selling as well.

"Friday, we've got a good line up of Fabulous Fillies, there's four, five, six real crackerjacks in there. Then we've got Double Deceiver for the racehorses, a 3-year-old that just won his elimination of the Breeders Crown, second or third in the Final. We've got a good core group of racehorses. The numbers are down a little bit, but the quality is up. I think a lot of the horses are racing, and racing competitively, right now. The racehorse market is very strong and I look forward to having a good Friday."

Welk echoed the sentiment for the Mixed Sale, saying, "I'm really looking forward to the mixed sale. I think we can keep this record thing going, for the gross... and we might pick up a bit on average, too. We have 48 Fabulous Fillies. I think, right now, we have three Outs for them, but we have less Outs than we've ever had for a Thursday at this point. I'm sure we'll have a few tonight.

"We probably have five or six horses that are racing in the Matron [Thursday] night that are in the sale on Friday. So, you always wonder because they've got to get them here, but that's why we kind of give them an extra hour each day. Our numbers are down about 60 total for the two days, so that cuts about an hour out, so we're still going to be out of here at a decent hour tomorrow night and Friday night."

The record numbers for the Standardbred Horse Sale come as Welk wraps his second year at the helm of the operation.

"I guess I couldn't have taken over at a better time – last year and then this year," Welk said. "But I'm not going to take the credit, the credit belongs to the consignors and breeders and buyers and the whole staff, everybody here at the building."

Gary DiLeo: Man of the people

The Meadowlands' long-time marketing and event host Gary DiLeo was referred to on national TV as "the hardest working man in horse racing," and those who know him understand why.

That compliment was paid to DiLeo by New York Racing Association (NYRA) TV personality Anthony Stabile on the April 30 broadcast of "America's Day at the Races" when The Big M shared the nighttime spotlight with Churchill Downs on Fox Sports 2.

Stabile has known DiLeo for about a dozen years and used him as a sounding board to make sure he was up to date on the latest happenings in harness racing before show time.

"Harness racing has always been a passion of mine but with my duties now I don't get to pay as much attention, but I do still keep an eye on things," said Stabile. "But after a 10-minute conversation with Gary, you're all caught up. It's almost like watching a soap opera. You can miss 10 months of a show and in three episodes, you're all caught up. That's what talking to Gary is like.

"And you know how much he does over there and he's always nice enough and kind enough to take time out of his day. And

when he helps you, he kind of makes you feel like you're the only person he's helping and you know that's not the case."

DiLeo, a Linden, NJ native, started going to the old Meadowlands Racetrack as a teenager with his older brother, Joe.

But it wasn't until the late 1980s when the track would also become his workplace.

"There was a job seminar at The Meadowlands Racetrack, and I went to it and that's kind of how I got my foot in the door," said DiLeo. "I remember Dave Brower went to it as well, but I didn't know him then. He got hired on TV and I got hired to do handicapping seminars on Saturday nights."

DiLeo would go on to have a tip sheet, called "Harness Insider," that he sold at the track.

"I sold mine for \$10 when everybody was selling for \$2," said DiLeo. "I went to \$10 thinking people would think it was better."

"That didn't work out," he said with a laugh. "But then I went down to \$5 and I was doing okay."

Anyone who ever spent time in Paddock Park, a trackside hang by the paddock near the old building, should remember "Winners at the Wedge."

The highly popular Big M bash that took place at the Kahuna Wedge was DiLeo's idea and next to "Talk to the Stars," was one of the most crowd-pleasing promotions at the track.

"I hosted a party there every Friday night and we had group Pick-4s that hit for \$17,000," said DiLeo. "We had a lot of fun. I'd get drivers and trainers to come and talk. We'd give away prizes and always had live music."

Although DiLeo says he doesn't have a favorite driver, he does have a favorite trainer and best memory from his time in harness racing.

"I love Brett Pelling," said DiLeo. "I think Brett Pelling is the greatest trainer that ever sat behind a horse."

"In the late 90s, [owner] Sandy Goldfarb took me all around the country to watch Shady Character race. My biggest thrill in racing was going to the Little Brown Jug with Sandy and I was in the winner's circle and I was like a Beatle throwing roses at the people."

DiLeo has been on staff at The Meadowlands for over a decade now, and in addition to his winner's circle duties, he does paddock tours, seminars for parties in Pink, and can regularly be seen walking through the building interacting with the fans.

"Gary is a fantastic team player," said Rachel Ryan, Meadowlands' director of marketing and event operations. "We rely on him tremendously – he helps us with events, race presentations, customer service and more. He is available at any time and is willing to step in and help get the job done. He is not just a colleague; he is a friend."

The Big M has always made customer service its top priority and DiLeo is on the front lines making that happen.

On a nightly basis, no one on staff at The Big M interacts with the fans more than DiLeo, who could be considered to be the face of the building.

"I want to give a shout out to all the drivers," said DiLeo. "They help me out a lot. If I tell them that it's someone's birthday, they're terrific with the fans. They just won the race, so they're happy to begin with, so they just continue the happiness."

"I love my job. I love going to work. Rachel, Jason [Settlemoir] and Marianne [Rotella] let me go and do what I've got to do. I love talking to people. Everybody knows me, so it's a lot of fun. Most fans have never been in the winner's circle or had their picture taken with a horse. It's a big, big thing for the fans. So, I pick different fans during the races to get their picture taken and they love it. I'm there for the fans."

Double Deceiver seeks big score in Matron

When it comes to appearance, Double Deceiver is, well, deceiving. Small in stature, the 3-year-old male trotter is big in heart. Purchased for \$17,000 at the 2020 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, the Carter Pinske trainee has hit the board in 19 of 24 career races, winning 10, and earned nearly \$700,000.

Today (Nov. 10), Double Deceiver will compete in the \$143,950 Matron Stakes for 3-year-old male trotters at Bally's Dover. He heads to the event off a second-place finish in last month's Breeders Crown and is the 5-2 morning-line second choice behind Breeders Crown winner King Of The North at 2-1.

Double Deceiver and driver David Miller will start from post one in the eight-horse field.

"He's just a little horse," Pinske said. "People look at him and say, 'That's Double Deceiver?' He's kind of plain looking, but he's quick and he always tries as hard as he can. You can't discount him ever. Anytime he's had a bad run, it's either due to traffic or something out of his control. I can't say enough about him."

Double Deceiver was a bit of a project as a young horse but blossomed as he made his way through his 2-year-old campaign, which included a victory in the Kentucky Championship Series final. This season, he has picked up two wins on the Grand Circuit, including his Breeders Crown elimination, and finished second in the MGM Yonkers Trot.

"From the beginning, he always showed ability, always showed a bit of speed, when he paid attention," Pinske said. "David Miller has driven him every start and really took care of him. Every start he got better and he's a real professional now. You can do anything you want with him, and I give a lot of the credit to Dave for always doing right by him."

Earlier this year, Double Deceiver captured a leg of the Kentucky Championship Series in a career-best 1:50.2 at Lexington's Red Mile. He started from post eight and rallied from third, three-lengths back, with a :26 last quarter. The winning time is tied for the second fastest by a 3-year-old male trotter this season.

“That wasn’t the biggest race he was in, but it showed what type of horse he is, how gritty he is,” Pinske said. “He beat some good horses that were sharp at the time.

“That’s the cool thing about him; he’s a small horse but he can go around any size track. He’s kept his form from June until November and, hopefully, he gives us one more good start on Thursday.”

Double Deceiver, a son of Cantab Hall—Sarcy owned by Pinske’s wife Makenna and Pinske Stables, will make his final start for his current connections in the Matron. The gelding is in Friday’s mixed sale at the Standardbred Horse Sale.

“I never imagined I would buy a \$17,000 horse off the cuff and he’d make as much money as he has,” said the 27-year-old Pinske, who purchased 21 yearlings this fall in preparation for his third year with a training stable. “He’s been a really good horse to us.”

The Matron for 3-year-old male trotters, race No. 8 on today’s 15-race card, is one of four Matron Stakes for sophomore trotters and pacers at Dover.

Joviality S, who is approaching \$2 million in career purses, is the 2-1 favorite in the Matron for the female trotters, which is race six. She is coming off a third-place finish in the Breeders Crown and meets a field of seven rivals that includes Breeders Crown runner-up Raised By Lindy, who is the 3-1 second choice.

Niki Hill, who has two wins and two seconds (both by a neck) since returning in September from a three-month layoff, is the 2-1 favorite in the event for female pacers, race 10. She was second in the Breeders Crown and will see the Crown’s third- and fourth-place finishers, Boudoir Hanover and Silver Label, in the Matron.

Breeders Crown champion Pebble Beach is the 2-1 choice in the race for male pacers, which is race 12. Crown runner-up I Did It Myway is the 5-2 second choice.

Action for today’s 15-race card begins at 4:30 p.m. (EST). Complete entries for the card may be found at this [link](#).



Committee soliciting input on Ontario Sires Stakes program

Ontario Racing's Standardbred Improvement Program (SIP) committee is dedicated to ensuring the SIP and its flagship Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) remain industry leading programs. In the spirit of that endeavor the SIP committee is engaging in a consultation process with industry stakeholders to shape the program beginning with the 50th anniversary season of the OSS in 2024 and to lead the program into another 50 years of excellence.

The consultation process will take place from Nov. 3 to Nov. 24, with written submissions due on Nov. 24.

Written submissions must follow the template provided here by Ontario Racing and align with the SIP's core mission of promoting the breeding of Standardbred horses in Ontario and to provide economic incentives to breeders to improve the quality of the Ontario Sired and Bred horse.

"The SIP consultation process will allow all industry stakeholders a chance to share their thoughts and insights on how to grow and promote this already successful program well into the future," said Standardbred Breeders of Ontario Association (SBOA) president, and SIP committee member Walter Parkinson.

The SIP committee is hosting two sessions with leading trainers and owners from the OSS between Nov. 14 and Nov. 23. Details on these sessions will be shared with participants within the next week.

In addition, the SBOA is hosting a meeting of breeders during the consultation time frame.

"Horses produced through this program not only highlight the OSS and Grand Circuit racing each season, but they also graduate to become some of the best aged pacers and trotters across North America," said Parkinson. "I am excited about the future of this program, and I look forward to seeing it develop well beyond the 50th anniversary season."

After the conclusion of the consultation period, the SIP committee will discuss all submissions during its December meeting, and

Misty Coast tops in DSBF filly pace prelims

Misty Coast continues to prove herself as Delaware's top rookie pacing filly, cruising to a 1:56.1 win in her \$20,000 first-round Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund preliminary event on Wednesday (Nov. 9) at Bally's Dover.

Following wins in the \$100,000 final of the DSBF Harrington series on Oct. 11 and against older conditioned company in a lifetime best 1:54.1 on Nov. 2, Misty Coast recorded her seventh career victory in extremely easy fashion, taking the first of three splits.

No Gel Nikki (driven by Montrell Teague) sprinted two lengths clear at race's outset, only for Art Stafford Jr. to vacate the pocket with Misty Coast before the first turn. The Powerful Mist—Cruisinthecoast filly cleared to the lead before completing the :28.3 first quarter and faced nary a challenge from that point on. After rating a :59 half, she accelerated up the backstretch to three-quarters in 1:27.3 — and while No Gel Nikki kept pace, their other four rivals tired considerably. Misty Coast finally dismissed her pocket rival in the final eighth, drawing clear handily to win by 4-1/4 lengths over No Gel Nikki. I Dareutoticmeoff (Pat Berry) rallied belatedly for third over Hold My Wine (Michael Cole), who tired after mounting an uncovered bid on the backstretch.

Les Givens trains Misty Coast, who has amassed \$106,300 in career earnings, for owner/breeder Stephen Messick.

Stafford capped a DSBF driving double in the final division, teaming up with first-time starter **Killer Stripes** to post a 1:57.3 debut score. The daughter of Badlands Hanover—Tiger Style rode the pocket behind even-money choice Ezycure (Teague) through a :58 half, pulled the pocket with five-sixteenths to go, and struck the front at three-quarters in 1:28. After putting Ezycure away, Killer Stripes dug deep to stave off a sustained challenge from Clearlydreamy (Victor Kirby) by a half-length. Spoiled Rotn Girl (Allan Davis) overcame traffic on the far turn and dove to the open stretch to just miss the runner-up spot.

Trainer Andrew Stafford co-owns the Winbak Farm-bred Killer Stripes, who paid \$6.20 to win, with Thomas Ireland and Bonnie Benson.

Direct Mist completed the trio of first-round winners with a gritty 1:57.1 performance in the second division. The Powerful Mist—Yankee Vista filly was innermost of four early leavers, and driver Trae Porter used pole position to protect the lead with her through a :28.1 first quarter. With all six of her rivals behind her in single file, Direct Mist pulled the half back to :59, but was forced to accelerate when Kims Secret Search (Teague) mounted a first-over push to take second from a gapping Spicy Tuna (David Rearic) nearing three-quarters in 1:27.3. Despite the sustained challenge on her outside, Direct Mist prevailed, keeping Kims Secret Search a half-length at bay while driven out. Chatty Kathleen (Berry) remained a detached third, 8-1/4 lengths farther behind, after losing cover.

Wayne Givens trains two-time winner Direct Mist, a Legacy Racing of Delaware homebred who paid \$2.10 to win.

The second preliminary round in the current DSBF series for 2-year-old pacing fillies is slated for next Wednesday (Nov. 16), and the eight highest point earners from both preliminary legs will meet in a \$100,000 final on Nov. 23.
