Key continues enhancing late husband's operation

Patty Key topped the Thursday's opening session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's mixed sale by paying \$750,000 for a Walner stallion share.

"It's all about the legacy of Bob Key. I wanted to make sure that he lives forever in the harness racing business. It's very emotional for me. It's been a year and 11 months [since he died]. I know he'd be very happy with what I'm doing because we had differences many times throughout the years," Patty said laughing, "but this is my dream and that's what I'm focusing on right now."

Patty, whose husband's plethora of achievements include a victory in the 1993 Hambletonian with American Winner, received a round of applause at the gavel slam for Hip 1052, a share of the phenom stallion Walner which sold for a final bid of \$750,000.



Last year in Harrisburg, Shaun Laungani of Diamond Creek Farm helmed an over million-dollar revamping of Winning Key Farm, now under the operation of the late Bob Key's widow Patty Key. Patty came to Harrisburg for the start of the Standardbred Mixed Sale on Thursday (Nov. 10) looking to continue her mission of making Winning Key Farm a staple name in the harness racing sphere.

"It was fun. It was a nice high," Patty said, laughing. "I enjoyed it and I'm having a good time. [Bob] said to me, 'I want you to have a good time.' It took a long time for me to get to this point, but I'm enjoying every minute of it. I've always been in the background with him, but I've heard every conversation and I've been involved in everything and there isn't anything that I don't know about every deal he made or every conversation he had with everybody. I was quiet in the background, but I learned. A lot of people don't know who I am and that's because it was all about him taking the center stage and that's where he liked being. Now, like I said, I want to make sure that his legacy lives on and it will."



The share Key purchased represents a fractional ownership interest in the breakout stallion who has sired Breeders Crown winners King Of The North, Jiggy Jog S and Special Way as well as Hambletonian Oaks winner Fashion Schooner. It also reserves Key the right to breed one mare a season through the life of the stallion.

"That's what I intend to do. We've culled a lot of mares and lots to bring in new mares with better records to buy and breed to and Walner was a big part of that," Patty said. "I've been trying to get into him and this was the only way that I could, but I went for it. I wasn't leaving home without it."

"I knew it was going to go high. I was kind of surprised. I didn't know everybody was going to be bidding that fast and quick... but I had a number in my mind and I just committed to it."

David Reid, manager of Walner's syndicate and president of the share's consigner Preferred Equine, said of the astronomical sale, "You'd probably have to go back to the Valley Victory days or Speedy Crown days... you know, that far ago. [But Walner's] proven in the sales ring. He's proven on the racetrack. If a farm wants to breed champions, they are going to have to have shares in horses like that."

Reid was also happy to see the share sell to enthusiastic hands, saying, "Mr. Key was a great supporter of the sport and I'm happy to see the Winning Key farm team came here and did their work. Mrs. Key was here. Obviously, she's passionate about the business as well, which is great."

Patty now presses through the second year of the Winning Key recalibration with her eyes targeted on the many broodmare prospects entering the ring for the final day of the Mixed Sale on Friday (Nov. 11).

"I think our progress is going great," Patty said. "I'm looking to buy even better mares off the track and I'm going by times of the race mares and turning them into broodmares. Then, with the stallion shares we have and the other stallions that we are able to get, I intend to have a small, but fun boutique-type farm."

'FRANK' COMES HOME

The same year that Ron Burke's freak speedster Mission Brief tackled the boys to a second-place finish in the 2015 Hambletonian, Burke raced another promising youngster in the Peter Haughton Memorial named Southwind Frank. He took the Peter Haughton with ease and then launched a campaign that brought Team Burke back into the clutches of a Hambletonian trophy in 2016. And though Marion Marauder foiled Team Burke's next try at a Hambletonian, the colt completed a campaign worth \$1,946,693 and an O'Brien and Dan Patch Award for his 2-year-old season.

Southwind Frank retired to stud with Diamond Creek Farm following his 3-year-old season and has since sired five crops with the first landing on the ground in 2018. But the now nine-year-old stallion's future has widened after Ron Burke reacquired his boy on the first day of the Harrisburg Mixed Sale.

Burke brought a \$215,000 bid to buy back the stallion from a now-dissolved syndicate helmed by consigner Diamond Creek Farm. And while he envisions continuing Southwind Frank's stallion duties, Burke also is possibly eyeing suiting the stallion back with a bike.

"It's like he's coming home to us," Burke said. "We're thrilled. We're trying to decide... we're going to stand him at stud, but I think I'm going to train him, too. We're in a process – we were just trying to get the horse bought and then we'll come up with what we're going to do.

"Obviously, he was a champion to me," Burke also said. "He's only 10 next year, and he's capable of doing all of it and everything. I'm very thrilled to get him back."

His reacquisition of Southwind Frank also continues Burke's expansion of his racing enterprise, which has branched from a pure racing operation to an operation also breeding its own prospects.

"That's the thing, we have mares that we can breed to him," Burke said, "depending on what state we move him to or what country we move him to, so we'll see."

No matter the future, Burke said "For sure, he goes home today and starts jogging tomorrow. I'm certain about that."

THE DAY'S OTHER LEADERS

Five-year-old Andover Hall mare I D Diana NO, consigned by Preferred Equine, brought the overall second-highest bid of the Thursday session when exiting the ring for \$225,000 to Euro Stall SE of Berlin, OH. The mare is out of a dam who is a half sister to triple millionaire Mr Muscleman. She is also a three-quarter sister to Dunk The Donato, the dam of world champion and millionaire Plunge Blue Chip as well as stakes-placed Splash Blue Chip and Threepointbluechip.

Just two other sales topped \$200,000 on the day. The first came earlier in the session at Hip 1102, an 11-year-old trotting mare named Honor Thy Daughter. Consigned by Preferred Equine, the mare is a full sister to stakes-placed Honor And Serve and has foaled six horses including stakes-placed Beautiful Game as well as Special Hill, the dam of Breeders Crown winner Special Way. Honor Thy Daughter went at the hammer's bang to Kentuckiana Farms for \$205,000 and is in foal to Muscle Hill.

And while many left the building at sun's fall, a supplemental sale entry brightened the day's twilight with a winning bid of \$205,000. The bid came from Michelle Crawford for the Cantab Hall mare Unexpected Gift, who sold as Hip 1624 and was consigned by Preferred Equine. Selling as just the sixth horse left of the session, she is a four-year-old mare by Cantab Hall and a half sister to millionaire and world-champion gelding Spider Blue Chip. The mare sold in foal to Walner.

Preferred Equine led consigners with \$3,803,000 grossed from 89 sales with three other consigners breaking seven figures: Concord Stud Farm, Northwood Bloodstock and Diamond Creek Farm.

SESSION WRAP

"I thought it was good overall," said Reid of Thursday's session. "There were fewer numbers sold today, but I thought the day went well. We sold a broodmare in the supplement in foal to Walner, and obviously Walner had a big day with the share sale that was outstanding.

Five-year-old Andover Hall mare I D Diana NO, consigned by Preferred Equine, brought the overall second-highest bid of the Thursday session when exiting the ring for \$225,000 to Euro Stall SE of Berlin, OH.

"It's a credit to the people who desire the best and I think that's what you saw straight through the day," Reid also said. "It's no secret that quality always sells. You could say that for 100 years and today, I think, when you see the catalogue it was maybe a little bit of a mixed bag of offerings and that's maybe where you see the little peaks and valleys, but quality sold well. You saw the stallions sell well, the Captaintreacherous, the Walner share was tremendous."

Day one of the Harrisburg Mixed Sale grossed \$10,154,000 from 273 sales, which puts the cumulative gross from Harrisburg's four days at \$54,510,000. The average sale on the day was \$37,194 while the average over the four days sits at \$46,313.

"I was really pleased with today," said Dale Welk, president/director of operations for the Standardbred Sales Company. "Could've been more pleased, but the good horses sold really well today and I think that's a great indicator of how tomorrow is going to be. I don't think we're going to have a record year – I was hoping and it was looking close with the yearling sale, but as long as we can stay on par or close, I'm going to be very happy."

"There was a gentleman in today – I'm not going to name the farm – but he said he'd like to have bought four or five more today, but he doesn't have help to take care of them," Welk also said. "He said he has his help stretched to the max and he doesn't want to put any more on them. I think that's hurting... there's just a lot of things going on. I think the middle and the lower ends are going to suffer anywhere, as far as mixed sales go. I think tomorrow, on the higher end, things are going to be incredible."

Friday's session features primarily racehorses including many star mares in the traditional "Fabulous Fillies" block of the sale as well as other prominent young racehorses looking to switch hands.

"It's looking like a lot of the good horses are here already," Welk said. "We do have some racing in the Matron tonight that are in the sale tomorrow. I think we're going to have a good day tomorrow."

Welk turned 64 years young on Thursday.

Searching at Harrisburg for the next Bulldog Hanover

Purchased for just \$28,000 by Jack Darling at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA three years ago in 2019, Bulldog Hanover will go down as, among other things, one of the best yearling purchases ever. Sold as Hip 795 in that sale, Bulldog Hanover was the 12th living foal out of BJ's Squall, whose production record up that point could be considered average. Of course, it didn't hurt that BJ's Squall herself is a half-sister to the likes of Betterthancheddar and

Courtly Choice, but the point being you never know when a dam is about to throw an exceptional one. With that in mind and conformation notwithstanding, here is a sampling from the first 1,000 yearlings sold this week for prices within \$10,000 plus or minus of what Bulldog Hanover sold for. Could the next sub 1:46 pacer be in here?

HIP 85 SEVENNSEVEN ZETTE, CONSIGNED BY HUNTERTON SALES AGENCY, SOLD FOR \$37,000:

Bay colt by Chapter Seven is the first foal out of the dam Lady Zette. Though she was unsuspecting in her race career, Lady Zette is a half-sister to Alarm Detector, who himself is a Chapter Seven. Alarm Detector sold for \$110,000 as a yearling and was one of the sport's best 2-year-old trotters early in his career when he won the William Wellwood and had success in his 3-year-old season as well while still racing at the highest of levels. Third dam Jambo has produced 2004's Trotting Colt of the Year Ken Warkentin.

HIP 206 JAYPORT BEACH BOY, CONSIGNED BY TWINBROOK FARMS, SOLD FOR \$33,000:

Standing at Winbak Farm for a fee of \$6,500 (CDN) for one of the fastest horses in history, it'll be interesting to see how McWicked's success on the track correlates to his performance as a sire. Out of Beachy Girl who was a force as a 2-year-old back

at the Red Mile Grand Circuit meet in 2007 and has produced eight winners from nine previous foals as a broodmare, this bay colt is a half-brother to 2019 and 2020 O'Brien winner Century Farroh (Mach Three), known best for battling it out with the sport's best free-for-all horses over that time.

HIP 226 VILLAGE BLUE CHIP, CONSIGNED BY BLUE CHIP FARMS, SOLD FOR \$30,000

Second foal out of Carlo's Superstar, who at 2 won a late closer in 1:53.1 at the Red Mile, and was once a \$100,000 yearling. Second dam is L Dees Lioness who was a killer at 2 and whose mark of 1:50.2 taken at that same age would have been a record back in 2012 if not for I Luv The Nitelife besting that time on the same night. L Dees Lioness has produced Life's A Puzzle; one of the better 2-year-olds racing right now from the first crop of Lazarus.

HIP 236 GROOVY JANE ANN, CONSIGNED BY WINBAK FARM, SOLD FOR \$23,000

Bay filly is a full sibling to Groovy Joe (Roll With Joe). One of the more successful progeny of Roll with Joe, Groovy Joe was a top New York Sires Stakes performer at 2 and 3, and was a 1:48.4 career winner and earned almost \$500,000. Dam Chotat Milk was a fast and highly-accomplished filly in 2004 and 2005, and has produced six winners from seven foals as a broodmare. Second dam Tre Cress has produced Peenie; another hard hitting performer who earned over \$700,000 in his career.

HIP 389: DUSTY DUNGAREES, CONSIGNED BY PREFERRED MARKET EQUINE, SOLD FOR \$30,000

Led by Southwind Avenger and Splash Blue Chip, sire E L Titan produces this bay colt out of Pacific Edge. He's a half-brother to Adare Castle who has been one of the best trotting fillies in Canada the past two seasons having won countless Ontario Sire Stakes while earning close to three quarters of a million dollars, and don't forget that Adare Castle has wildly overachieved as she was once an underestimated \$10,000 yearling from this sale two years ago. Second dam Pacific Photo has produced a couple of decent ones in Margarita Way and Bold Fresh.

HIP 480: AIM UP, CONSIGNED BY PREFERRED MARKET EQUINE, SOLD FOR \$30,000

Sire Stay Hungry has burst onto the scene this year with his first crop that includes fast winners such as Annapolis Hanover, Hungry For Love, Hungry Man and a host of others. There's been a lot of his yearlings that have gone for reasonable amounts thus far at Harrisburg this week including this one, a bay filly. She's the first foal out of her dam, though second dam Must See was a fast 2-year-old and has since gone onto produce Pacer

of the Year and successful sire, Well Said. Also is closely related to So Surreal who has been proving himself as a sire after his racing career ended prematurely; hails as well from the family of another world champion, Glowing Report.

HIP 545: EXPEDITION PASS, CONSIGNED BY CONCORD STUD FARM, SOLD FOR \$25,000

This is the lone Alarm Detector yearling thus far that fits into the sold price range of this column, as part of that sire's third crop. Second dam Angel Eyes Hanover has produced Ambassador Hanover, a 1:51.2 winner at 3, the same year he was a fast closing third in the Hambletonian.

For those seeking to catch lightning using the same sire as Bulldog Hanover, Hip #'s 529 and 624 are by Shadow Play. Hip 529 Short Sweet Ride (\$25,000) is the first foal from Across Hanover, who is a half-sister to near half-million dollar earner Appleoosa Hanover. Hip 624 Play Dew (\$18,000) comes from the family of Arbitration; a bargain basement yearling that went onto win over \$700,000.

HIP 757: MARIE'S CHOICE; CONSIGNED BY WINBAK FARM, SOLD FOR \$25,000

From the first crop of Meadowlands Pace, Little Brown Jug and Canadian Pacing Derby winner Courtly Choice, this bay filly is out of Marietta Hall, a hard-trying and high-earning filly from about 15 years ago. Her production record hasn't matched her record on the track, but she's a full sister to near million-dollar earner Cammibest, as well as a half-sister to It's That Time and Tomy Terror.

HIP 932: EASY CHEESY, CONSIGNED BY WINBAK FARM, SOLD FOR \$30,000

This bay filly is a full sister to Wisdom Tree, a NYSS standout from a few years ago who earned close to \$700,000 while taking a career mark of 1:49.1. It's worth noting that Wisdom Tree was just a \$28,000 yearling, right in line with this one. There's loads of talent from this family going back to the production of second dam Can Du River, including world champion Allamerican Captor, Class Six, Amazon Art, and the list goes on.

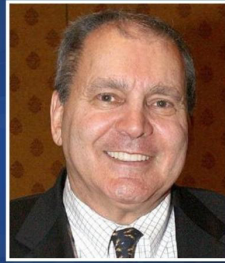

Small, but mighty

My favorite little horse, Double Deceiver, is again getting some public notice as he heads for the Matron Stakes at Dover. Double D is actually one of the few top trotting colts I know personally. That happened because he spent some time here at the Red Mile this summer, and his groom, a wonderful lady I've known for a long time, gave me free access to her small but mighty charge.

Double Deceiver is a nice little guy, and, for my part, it's a shame he's a gelding. Jim Harrison taught me light years ago that a little stud will sire progeny whose size almost always goes back to the norm, which is normal, medium size.

From personal experience, one of the first pacers I ever stood was Muncy Hanover. He was a son of Adios, owned by Norman Woolworth, trained and driven by Earle Avery, and he wouldn't have measured 15 hands. Nevertheless he gave Bullet Hanover the fight of his life in the 1960 Little Brown Jug, when he won the first heat.

Johnny Simpson had Bullet, who had been picked out by Tom Murphy, the "Wizard of the Turf." Murphy was one of the top standardbred trainers, who then switched to the runners and did well, who then went to Wall Street, but dabbled in standardbreds as the advisor to Leonard J. Buck, whose *nom de course* was Allwood Stables.

I was just getting in then, and my path crossed Murphy's a few times. I still have a vivid memory of Murphy's pale eyes of whatever color they were, looking right through my physical self to my soul.

Murphy did have a son, Tom, who was about a different in every respect as he could be from his Old Man, but he was in our biz for a few years. Billy Haughton was his trainer, and the first yearling Billy bought for him was Laverne Hanover.

Laverne was a top colt, who among other races won the Jug, and then was a big money winner in the free-for-alls. We had him at Lana Lobell as a stud, but he flopped, like all the other big name sons of Tar Heel.

The only exception was a horse named Steady Beau, and again I have a good reason to remember him.

At 2, Steady Beau, who was by Tar Hell, out of Steady Beat, by Adios, won the biggest 2-year-old purse stakes for pacers. He has bred by U. C. Steele, who named every horse he bred with a name that started with S, for his last name. Lyss (short for Ulysses) Steele bred only pacers, and he was quite successful. He was also very smart, and we were friends.

Steady Beau didn't come back at 3, and in 1963 he wound up in the mixed sale in Harrisburg. The morning he was to sell, Lyss Steele approached me with a proposition. He and three other breeders would join me in buying Steady Beau, and I'd stand him at Lana Lobell. He accurately guessed that the colt would sell for around 20-25,000, and he brought exactly \$25,000.

However, being attentive to detail, I looked over Steady Beau in the long lineup along the wall they had in those days at Harrisburg. What I saw looked more like a horse who had been abandoned in a storm than a promising sire prospect. The whole time I looked at him he stood with all four feet in the same spot, never raised an ear, and you could have run raft trips down his rough coat.

So, I was smart enough to walk, and a guy named John R. Colvin bought him. He took Steady Beau to his farm in Tennessee, and I was reliably told that the horse had to make a two foot jump to get over the front wall after the stall door was open.

Mr. Colvin did advertise his prize, with his ads always starting with "My sermon today..."

Despite all his handicaps, Steady Beau was a sire, and a good one. After he hit, his owner made a deal to syndicate him and stand him at Rodney Farm in New York. Before he actually made it to New York state, Steady Beau suddenly died mysteriously. No reason for his loss was ever given. With him went the only shot Tar Heel had at extending his sire line, and today only a few old fools like me even remember his name.

And now, back to Muncy Hanover and the 1960 Little Brown Jug. Muncy won the first heat, setting a new world record for 3-year-old pacers on a half-mile track. Bullet Hanover made a break in that heat, and was out of the money for Johnny Simpson.

Simpson was totally open about what he did next, which was to go back to his tack room and attach a "whip spur" to his whip. A whip spur is exactly what it sounds like; a spur that screwed on to the shaft of the whip.

For the next two heats, Simpson raked that spur over Bullet's hind end, and when they were over, he had the winner of the Little Brown Jug.

That was far from the only time Simpson used a whip spur. When he ran an ad in a campaign for USTA director, he added a picture of himself and Stanley Dancer in their colors, with their whips, in the Roosevelt paddock. There, clear as daylight, you could see the trusty spur on Johnny's whip.

There are no spurs on whips now, and little Double Deceiver won't need one as he goes on his merry way to winning a million dollars. And I think it's our loss that he won't get the chance to reproduce his speed and courage.

But then nobody asked me before they castrated him, maybe because they remembered how wrong I was about Steady Beau.



Whatever the pursuit, he was the best guy in the room, but he was always busy telling everyone else how good they were."
