Tremendous Harrisburg sale grosses \$70 million, just shy of the all-time record

Broodmare prospects brought big bucks in mixed sale finale.

Triscari Video Web Marketing The five-day **Standardbred Horse Sales** Company yearling and mixed sale grossed just over \$70 million, just \$650,000 off the 2007 record when **641** more horses were

sold.





Friday's (Nov. 11) session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Mixed Sale presented rich opportunities for breeders, who in turn shelled cash to secure the promising prospects.

Steve and Cindy Stewart of Hunterton Farm topped the day with two half-million-dollar purchases that they see as a reinvestment into the industry.

"We've been very blessed in being able to sell very high-priced yearlings every year and a lot of people ask us why we sell our fillies. This is why we sell our fillies, because we take our filly money and go buy mares," said Steve Stewart. "So, we're selling one-year product and go buy factories. It's kind of logical for us, you know. It makes sense to me. That's our plan and it's working out very well so far."

Cindy Stewart first signed the ticket for **Fire Start Hanover**, consigned by Preferred Equine and selling as **Hip 1414**. The 3-year-old filly by Somebeachsomewhere, who earned \$1.2 million through her career along with a Dan Patch Award at 2, left the ring for \$550,000.

"We play at the top end and she's the top end," Steve said. "We have a lot of guys behind us that want to play at the top end. We've been very successful buying at the top end, so we more

No Sunday issue of HRU



or less take our yearling money and put it right back in. And more or less, the guys that owned her will take that money and go buy our yearlings, right? It's a very simple game and I think it's working for everybody."

Steve confirmed Fire Start Hanover will go to the breeding shed following her final start, which will come in the TVG Finals on Nov. 26 at The Meadowlands.

Just under a half-hour later, the Stewarts landed another large ticket on **Selfie Queen**, consigned by Preferred Equine and selling as **Hip 1429**. The enigmatic sophomore filly by Muscle Hill, who took a mark of 1:51.2 as a 2-year-old at the Red Mile, sold to the Stewarts for \$500,000.

"She was what we wanted also on the trotting side, so they are good bookends, aren't they?" Stewart said. "What really intrigues us is the :51 mark at 2. We own Mission Brief and Jolene Jolene and they've done very well for us with those fast marks at 2. We're just going to carry on and hopefully she will pick up where they are. I don't know if you'd call her a 'great mare,' but she was a very fast and talented mare, so she, again, like Fire Start, fits the program."

Following Selfie Queen's ninth-place finish in the Breeders Crown, a radiograph ordered by trainer Nancy Takter uncovered a medial wing fracture in the filly's right hind. With the injury, which only requires stall rest, Steve Stewart nonetheless confirmed Selfie Queen will retire to the breeding shed.

The Winning Key team also returned with more firing power to strengthen its broodmare band. Eric Crocker, from Winning Key, acquired two top-class mares for the operation in **Bare My Soul**, a Preferred Equine consignee selling as **Hip 1405**; and Breeders Crown winner **Next Level Stuff**, also consigned by Preferred Equine and selling as **Hip 1422**. Crocker scored on a \$500,000 bid for Bare My Soul while he secured Next Level Stuff for \$350,000.

"We actually had a higher number on [Bare My Soul]," Crocker said. "We are glad that we got her where we did. [Next Level Stuff] was the first choice out of the book until we saw Bare My Soul and then we knew we had one and two and we got the two that we wanted, so we're thrilled."

Crocker and his wife have worked with Winning Key Farm for the last 20 years and said that they've been waiting for the operation to move into the direction of a premier breeding facility.

"It's exciting and I'm glad that Patty is as excited as we are," Eric said. "Bob was amazing to us for all those years, but the business... it's a lot more fun this way than just churning out racehorses. She's so passionate in wanting to do things the right way and breed the best. It just makes it a whole lot of fun for us and everyone at the farm."

The farm's continual broodmare investment coincides with its recent acquisition of many breeding rights to the sport's top

stallions, including the share of Walner Patty Key purchased for \$750,000 on Thursday. Crocker said the team is likely to use its Walner breeding with Next Level Stuff, a 4-year-old daughter of Sebastian K S out of the Cantab Hall mare Nantab.

Another big-ticket bid went a few minutes later in **Peyton Hanover**, consigned by Preferred Equine and selling as **Hip 1425**. Robert Lindstrom acquired the mare for \$410,000 and said she will go straight to breeding, potentially with Walner or Chapter Seven.

Hanover Shoe Farms purchased a notable mare in **Hip 1348**, a 2-year-old Father Patrick filly consigned by Preferred Equine named **Our W**ish. The filly left the ring for \$235,000. Her dam, the Donato Hanover mare Honor Thy Daughter, sold on Thursday for \$205,000 to Kentuckiana Farms.

BIG BOYS ALSO BRING BIG BUCKS

On Thursday night (Nov. 10), Double Deceiver pulled pocket on Breeders Crown winner King Of The North to win in 1:52.4 in the Matron at Bally's Dover. On Friday, he sold in Harrisburg for \$500,000 to Brixton Medical AB and will brace for a campaign overseas with trainer Daniel Redén.

"Yeah, that was much... a lot of money," said Johan Arneng, who signed the ticket for Brixton Medical. "But Daniel looked at all the races and he thinks it's a horse that would suit the Swedish

conditions and hopefully we can improve him. We think that he has a good future in Europe."

A good future which potentially includes starts in races such as the Elitlopp.

"That's what we're aiming for," Arneng said, "so we'll see where

we reach, but that's what we're aiming for."

Robert Lindstrom's signature inked onto another ticket late in the day, this one for \$410,000 on **Hip 1500** – the inaugural Mohawk Million winner **Venerate**. The now 4-year-old stallion by French sire Love You will head to trainer Marcus Melander with intentions to race.

"We'll evaluate him there and train him a little bit on [Marcus Melander's] sand track," Lindstrom said. "In one or two months, we're going to decide what we'll do with him – if he can continue racing next year or take him to breeding. You have options with that horse – he's got a fantastic pedigree and good racing results as a 2-year-old and it's gone on as he got older. The Amour Angus maternal line, it's all so strong. We're very happy to get him.

"We'll see where the market is best, whether it's Europe or United States. We haven't decided anything and it depends if we can race one more season. You never know what happens then."



"GANGBUSTERS" FINALE

"Today was gangbusters," said Dale Welk, president/director of operations for the Standardbred Horse Sales Company. "It was just unbelievable for the day. So, we're starting to tear down and clean up now."

The second session of the mixed sale grossed \$15,540,000 from 219 horses sold to bring the two-day gross to \$25,694,000. With the yearling sale, the overall gross of the five-day session in Harrisburg rang to \$70,050,000, falling just short of the all-time record of \$70,700,000 set in 2007 when 2,037 sales went through the ring versus 1,396 in 2022.

"I didn't think it would get this close [to the record], no," Welk said. "I thought we had a chance for \$65-68 million, but I didn't think we had a chance for \$70 million. It was just amazing. Great horses sold great. We didn't have a lot of Outs, which we already talked about. We had Outs, but nothing like other years."

Hip 1405 Bare My Soul was purchased by Winning Key's Eric Crocker for \$500,000 from the Preferred consignment.

David Reid echoed the sentiment. His consignment, Preferred Equine, handled \$13,785,000 in sales with more than half coming on Friday's session.

On Friday, Preferred sold the top five horses offered and 11 of the top 13.

"I don't think I remember selling four or five horses there for \$500,000 or more," Reid said. "You could really feel the strength of the filly department yesterday. We were showing all day long, our Fabulous Fillies section, and they lived up to the billing today. I was happy to see that Mrs. Key came back today and she bought a mare or two and I'm assuming one of those will go to Walner, which is a nice story for the week – to have her come back into the business in a strong way.

"It shows a lot of strength in the marketplace for the fillies. It gives buyers confidence when they go to a yearling sale and they buy a well-bred filly, a well-conformed filly, for big money that they are getting a return on their investment – whether they've returned enough on the racetrack or not. To see the residual value hold up was very gratifying for the industry overall, not only for us today. I think it's important for the industry."

Reid went on to say, regarding the strength of the marketplace, "On a personal note, to come here and have a live sale and

represents so many high-quality people in the industry, it makes Preferred so proud. It shows there's a need for a live marketplace. We have Preferred Equine Online and some of the keyboard warriors who don't have a big investment into the business last week were on social media saying, 'Why would the number one consignor have a sale the week before?' Well, it's been that way all year. Every two weeks we've had it the whole year, we've been consistent.

"It just goes to show you that there's multiple levels to the marketplace. To understand all levels, I think that's important for the industry. Not everyone operates under the same structure and we're in 2022 now and things can be a little different and still succeed."

And so through the Friday session, consignment staffs worked on tearing down their exhibits they rushed to raise in time for Monday.

Reid's staff maneuvered behind him to roll the rubber matting and ready the many tables in the Northeast Hall for shipping and storage.

"We have a lot of seasoned veterans back here," Reid said. "We've been doing it a long time. They come here on a part-time basis to help us. They are part of the Preferred family and there's definitely something to be said about that – loyal employees, loyal people have been coming to us to help pull this off for the week. They come from near and far. It's a little bit of a family reunion for some of them, but I couldn't do it without them.

"The workforce is getting more challenging, there's no doubt about that," Reid also said. "You can ask any farm or racing stable. It's the same with the horse sales business. It's hard to find sales help and we're competing against Keeneland right now and they are selling thousands of horses down there at the same time as we are. I'm very fortunate to have the staff that we do. They represent our brand well and they take great care of the clients' horses. It's a smooth, poetry-in-motion back here. They know what they are doing and that's another big key to our success, for sure."

"Tomorrow afternoon it'll pretty much be a ghost town," Welk said. We'll be tearing down this temporary office and all that stuff tomorrow. There's a lot of moving parts, but I've got a great crew and I guess I'm okay at coordinating it," he also said, with a laugh.

Then come January, when the world gathers back at the Complex for the annual Farm Show in Harrisburg, those in attendance will have no evidence that just a few months prior, the heart of the harness racing business pulsed through the halls.

TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

A conversation with hardworking, imminently likeable SHSC present Dale Welk

How many people do you know who were literally born in one place and never left it? This scribe knows only one such person. His name is Dale Welk. Most people would know Welk as the congenial president/operations manager at the recently concluded Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction in Harrisburg.

Welk's link lo Harrisburg emanates from his lifetime of employment at Hanover Shoe Farms where he still is a most valued employee.

Welk's father Dave, known as "Pappy," also spent a lifetime in the employ of the colossus of harness racing's breeding ranks.

"I remember going to work with my dad almost from the day that I knew what the term going to work meant. We lived right on the farm. When the time to get a job arrived, there was never any question that I was destined to begin as a groom prepping 'six by the head' for the yearling sale," Welk said. "I think that I was a pretty darn good groom. My string of yearlings always looked as good as anyone's and better than most. I also could show a yearling very well. I did have one disadvantage compared to most when it came to showing yearlings. I was always a pretty big guy. When I showed one, most yearlings would look smaller than they actually were. Despite that, through the years, the folks in charge of the Hanover yearling consignment, Monty Moncrief, Peter Boyce and very rarely even now Dr. Jablonsky would occasionally call upon me to help out on the days when the attendance at the Fairgrounds was so much that they needed an extra hand to help out."

In addition to being a very good horseman Welk was also excellent when it came to working in areas where mechanical and farming skills were required. Perhaps his greatest skill relates to his exceptional ability to get along with people, whether with doing so from a management perspective or

working directly with them. Dale Welk has never been loath to get down in the trenches himself and doing what he might ask anybody else to do.

As vacancies in the hierarchy at both Hanover and Standardbred became available, Welk was always there to step in and help out.

As time went on, Dale became more involved in the physical operations of Hanover than he did in the equine areas.

"Clyde Sterner had been the head of operations at the Farms for what seemed to be forever, I went to work under him."

At Standardbred, after Paul Keim passed and his successor John Moody left, Sterner was named head of operations there to go along with his similar position at Hanover.

"I guess I pretty much tagged along and followed Clyde," Welk said.

In 1988, Sterner said that he was retiring. It was only natural that his assistant at both companies would follow in his previous positions. Beginning with the 1989 sale, Welk was installed as Standardbred's head of operations. He is still here doing that. He responsibilities as Standardbred's president when its ownership began under Russell Williams. He still also oversees the physical day to operations of Hanover Shoe Farms.

Dale, most people would say that you have more than enough on your plate. How are you able to handle the many responsibilities that you have?

"My response would be that although it isn't easy, it isn't all that difficult either. First and foremost is that I've been blessed to work with great people with both Standardbred and Hanover. With Standardbred, we have a crew of 60 people which is comprised of a base crew of folks from near Buffalo, New York and a group of students from Delaware Valley College. The Western New York people have been coming to Harrisburg to set up, work the sale itself and take down since the inception of the sale in 1938. The makeup of that crew consists of some folks who trace back to fourth and even fifth generations of the original group initially put together by Paul Keim.

"Historically, these folks, many of whom worked year round in a mental health facility, would take their vacation time during the three weeks of the duration of the sale. They would come here to work during the set up, then work the week of the sale itself and stay the week after for the takedown. We've also had the Delaware Valley College kids in recent years during the sale itself. Its great experience for the kids working with the horses and with the people prominent in the industry in which some of them hope to make their life's work. As much as the experience is helpful to the kids, it is at the very least invaluable to us in having them here to help. We haven't been immune to the lack of help throughout America in order to make the sale a reality each year. It seems like each year I wonder whether we will have enough help to get things done. We always manage."

This scribe was the GM of the sales company for 37 years. Looking back, it seems that in each of those years, I would come to Harrisburg to visit the week before the sale. I would be greeted by a colossal mess. I'd say to myself, "There is no way that in a week's time this place will be fit to conduct the world's most prominent Standardbred horse sale." Yet in a week's time arriving on the Friday before the sale I found it ready for action. How do you do it?

"It's really not that difficult. Everybody here knows what is needed. They each have their jobs. They know what is needed of them and they do it. In almost all areas they do it well. If something goes wrong, we need to correct it. It always does get properly attended to. If doing that requires that we work extra time, then that is what we do. We all work well, most importantly we work well together. Together is the most important word."

I think this is a phrase that I initiated when speaking of you. If by some chance it wasn't me, I apologize to the person who first said it. Speaking of Dale Welk, "If it's difficult, it just very well might be easy. If it's impossible, it just may be difficult."

"I'm not sure if it came from you. It might have. I think to this time it has probably been true. I love challenges. Our team has always been up to them. There might be a time when we will fail. I don't believe that it has happened yet. But who knows what the future might bring?"

What is the most single difficult thing that the team undergoes?

"The single hardest thing might be changeover — the period of time when we change from the yearling portion of the sale to that of the mixed. It's not so much that there is so much work involved. Make no mistake of it, there is. But more important than the work is the limited amount of time that we have in which to do it. From the time that the last yearling is sold on Wednesday, we have to do an almost complete makeover of the entire facility. The word complete might not be entirely accurate. The process actually begins after the first yearlings are sold on Monday. Horses are moved out. The facility's looks have to be maintained. Other horses begin coming in for the mixed sale, although we try to discourage that from happening until Wednesday evening. Some of the yearlings are always tardy in leaving. We require space in which to place the members of both categories. The biggest difficulty might involve sleep! Most importantly, the lack of it among crew members and consignors. No sooner are all the mixed horses in, than consignors need to set up and make themselves ready. It's almost as though another sale is about to take place, in reality, it probably is."

Let's speak of your auctioneer team. It's almost as though you've undergone a near complete metamorphosis.

"It really has. For what I believe is the very first time, we aren't playing second fiddle to the Kentucky Thoroughbred Sales which almost always take place on the same conflicting dates. Even though some of the auctioneering dates are in conflict, we now have our team contractually set so that we have first rights to them. Speaking of the teams, I believe we have the best young team of auctioneers in the business Joseph Mast, Andy and Drew are second to none. We also have 15 bid spotters and three pedigree readers, all at or near the top of the game. We may have the only female bid spotter in the horse business. I shouldn't use the word female to describe our Mary. She is a great bid spotter and in no way because she just happens to be of the female persuasion."

When will you begin working on next year's sale?

"We already have begun. The sales dates have already been firmed up and contracted. Hotel rooms are already in place.

What happens next?

"In January, our preference letters will go out to our previous consignors. Then the process begins again. It won't be exactly the same as always. Nothing remains the same. There will undoubtedly be some changes hopefully they will all be for the better."

Allywag Hanover sets world record in winning \$125,000 Potomac Pace

Allywag Hanover made history Thursday evening (Nov. 10) when he paced the fastest mile ever on a 5/8th mile track while winning the \$125,000 Potomac Pace at Rosecroft in 1:46.4.

Owned by Allywag Stable, trained by Brett Pelling and driven by Todd McCarthy, Allywag Hanover followed favored Tattoo Artist past fractions of :25.4, :53.1 and 1:20. The two separated themselves from the rest of the field before Allywag Hanover cruised by Tattoo Artist midway down the stretch on his way to the world-record performance.

This Is The Plan was third and 2020 winner Leonidas A was fourth.

Allywag Hanover, the beaten favorite in last year's Potomac Pace, has now won six of 13 starts this year and has not finished worse than third. He eclipsed the previous track record at Rosecroft of 1:47.3 set by Keystone Velocity in 2017. Allywag Hanover came into the Potomac off a third-place finish in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown behind likely Horse of the Year Bulldog Hanover and runner-up Tattoo Artist.

"I thought Tattoo was going to be pretty hard to beat tonight. Last year we got beat so it was pretty nice to get a victory here tonight," McCarthy said.

Allywag Hanover's trip was similar to his trip when beating Bulldog Hanover in the Allerage Farms open on Oct. 9 at The Red Mile in a record 1:46.

"He loves that kind of trip," McCarthy said. "[Tattoo] was the perfect horse to follow there. I just had to hope the speed was going to be solid enough early that we were going to have a little short at the end, so it worked out tonight.

"It's pretty cool... he's had such a phenomenal season for what he got to race in. It's probably worked out perfect for him. Brett has done a good job managing him. He's a fun horse to drive and hopefully next year we got him in some main events."

Tattoo Artist's stakes victories earlier this year included two legs of the MGM Borgata pacing Series at Yonkers, the Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial at Saratoga, and the #SendItIn Invitational at Scioto. He had also finished second to likely Horse of the Year Bulldog Hanover in the Canadian Pacing Derby.

This Is The Plan was pacing in his third Potomac Pace. The 7-year-old gelding was seventh last year, fifth in 2020 and was a late scratch in 2019.

NOTES: **Wild Wild Western**, with Yannick Gingras in the bike, won the \$25,000 Maryland Preferred Invitational. The 6-year-old returned \$3.20...The evening began with driver Frank Milby winning the first three races of the 14-race program. Milby won Race 1 with Dancing on a Star (\$12), Race 2 with Always B Magic (\$2.40) and Race 3 with Jericho Hanover (\$3).

Southwind Admiral 'a pleasure' heading to Kindergarten final

From the beginning, Southwind Admiral was in command.

The colt, trained and co-owned by Ron Coyne Jr., has handled every task presented to him and brings a six-race win streak to tonight's (Nov. 12) \$268,180 Kindergarten Classic Series final for 2-year-old male trotters at The Meadowlands.

For the season, Southwind Admiral has won seven of nine starts and earned \$122,025.

"He didn't mind doing his work from day one," Coyne said. "He was a happy colt. He's got an even temperament. There were never any issues; whatever we wanted to do was all right with him. We were happy with him and hopeful, but you never really know what you've got until you get (to the races).

"It's worked out great. He's been doing everything we've asked him to do. He's made some money and he's been a pleasure." Southwind Admiral, a son of Tactical Landing—Amber Ella, was purchased for \$20,000 at last fall's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. Amber Ella, by Chapter Seven, was a multiple winner on the New York Sire Stakes circuit and half-sister to stakes-winner Newcastle. His family also includes Dan Patch Award-winner Armbro Blush, the dam of two-time O'Brien Award-winner Armbro Leader.

The colt is owned by Ron Coyne Stables, Blair Corbeil, Richard Carney, and Farrell Carney.

"He had everything we were looking for," Coyne said. "We liked his breeding, being a Chapter Seven on the mare's side. It was the first year for Tactical Landing, so we didn't know anything about that, but he was a good-looking colt and he moved well.

"There seemed to be enough pedigree on the page, so we took a shot. We just were lucky enough to get him."

Southwind Admiral's current winning streak includes the New Jersey Classic Series 'B' final, New Jersey Sire Stakes Standardbred Development Fund final, and a division of last week's final preliminary round of the Kindergarten.

"His temperament is the best thing about him so far," Coyne said. "Just the way he handles everything. Even when he faces a little adversity, when he gets parked out or things don't go exactly how they should, it doesn't seem to faze him."

Southwind Admiral was eligible to last month's Breeders Crown, but his connections decided to stay home rather than ship to Canada. If all goes well, the colt will finish his campaign in the Valley Victory Stakes later this month at The Big M.



"It just seemed like (the Breeders Crown) was going to be too much, so we passed on it and concentrated on these last couple races," Coyne said.

Tonight, Southwind Admiral starts from post 10 with Todd McCarthy in the sulky. He is the 4-1 third choice on the morning line behind 2-1 favorite Volume Eight and 3-1 International Man. Volume Eight, who starts from post seven with Andy McCarthy driving for Noel Daley, is this year's fastest 2-year-old male trotter with a mark of 1:52.1.

"It's a good race," Coyne said. "There are some really nice horses inside of him. Noel's horse is a very nice colt. He's got a real high turn of speed. We got a bad draw, so we just have to hope we can get our way into it somehow. Todd is going to have to figure that out. We'll hope for the best."

Racing begins at 6:20 p.m. (EST) tonight. The card also features Kindergarten finals for 2-year-old male and female pacers as well as 2-year-old female trotters.

Jim Doherty Memorial winner Instagram Model is the 5-2 favorite in the race for filly trotters. She had a four-race win streak snapped with a fifth-place finish in the Breeders Crown on Oct. 28 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. She starts from post two with Scott Zeron driving for Annie Stoebe.

Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion Bond, who is on a four-race win streak, is the 3-1 second choice from post 10 for trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt.

In the event for male pacers, Champlain Stakes winner and Metro Pace runner-up Save America is the 3-1 favorite. He will leave from post five with Yannick Gingras in the sulky for Nancy Takter.

The 6-5 choice in the race for filly pacers is Charleston, who won eliminations of both the She's A Great Lady and Breeders Crown and finished second in both finals.


