Dexter Dunn on his drives for Saturday's spectacular Meadowlands card

The front-runner to win the Driver of the Year award (again), breaks down some of his stakes drives for the TVG / Final Four card.

It's hard to believe that after a harness racing stakes season that didn't truly get underway until June, that this Saturday's card at the Meadowlands features the last of the major stake's races in the calendar year. The stakes races have been fast and furious in that time, and they culminate at the Meadowlands with four TVG finals and four rich finals for the 2-year-olds.

In that same span, driver Dexter Dunn has put on a clinic in the shortened season. With only a little more than 1,500 starts, he's amassed more than \$10 million in earnings. No other driver is yet to reach \$9 million, and Dunn is all but a cinch to win his second consecutive Driver of the Year award. He's poised with a number of live contenders to pad to his seasonal totals, and he shares thoughts on some of his drives throughout the big card.

In race order, the TVG final for open trotters goes as the first major stakes event of the night. With this being the career send-off race for Manchego, it will be the last time that her and Atlanta square off in a rivalry for the ages that began to pick up steam during their 3-year-old campaigns. As usual, the result could go either way depending on the night. Atlanta comes off a third-place finish in the open

Breeders Crown, while Manchego dominated in the Breeders Crown against open mares.

Dunn has driven Manchego since July of last year and been responsible for a lot of her success over the past two years. She enters the TVG in fine form.

“She’s an amazing trotter. She’s had some ups and downs throughout this season, but when she’s run as many hard miles as she had, it’s hard to be 100 per cent all year long,” said Dunn. “But her last two starts at Hoosier were outstanding. Her first start there she finished off her mile great, and then she was excellent in the Breeders Crown final and really ran off with that race and was extremely comfortable doing so. So, she’s going into this race on top of her game and with the way that Nancy (Takter) has gotten her to relax lately, it really gives us options with the speed she has. If she relaxes nice, the small field might even help me if I can get her to relax off a helmet and not be too far off them. These can be tricky races but I have full confidence.”

Next up is the Goldsmith Maid for 2-year-old filly trotters, where in part because of the post advantage, Anoka Hanover will likely get the nod of favorite over Breeders Crown winner Lady Chaos. Dunn’s drive is Takter’s Insta Glam. In the Kindergarten final two back, Insta Glam rolled through a brisk pace on the front but tired in the waning stages. In that

same race, Anoka Hanover was second over but behind cover that couldn't get within a couple lengths of the leader. Despite that, you got the impression that Anoka Hanover always had Insta Glam's measure despite needing to close the gap a few lengths in reeling in that rival. Also in the race starting from the second tier is Mazzarati. She was my pick in the Breeders Crown when she closed late to narrowly miss, and closed well again last out when following Anoka Hanover.

In regards to Insta Glam, Dunn said, "She can be a bit of a tricky filly to drive and sometimes hard to rate. I think Nancy's going to change a little bit of gear on her this week and maybe she can get her to relax just a touch more. She got tired late in that last mile there, but obviously off those fractions it was understandable. And to get run down by a great trotter like Anoka Hanover is no disgrace. If she can behave and relax she might not be far away at all."

For the 2-year-old filly pacers in the Three Diamonds, a Breeders Crown rematch is coming between Fire Start Hanover and JK Alwaysbalady. This division seemed like it belonged to Test of Faith not too long ago, but I noted here after the Breeders Crown that Fire Start Hanover wasn't that far off, and since that time she came back to win her Kindergarten final. I think she's now in control of the division, and Dunn agreed.

"I think she should be given 2-year-old pacing filly of the year regardless (of how she does in the Three Diamonds)," said Dunn. "She bounced back a week after the Breeders Crown win and won again very nicely. She's got a good draw to work with in this race, and she's got great gait speed if I want to use it to try and get into a position that we like. But it's a big field and there will be some challenges, but hopefully she can finish off the season on a high note, too."

It's almost fitting that in the TVG final for open pacing mares that Kissin In The Sand drew post 9. This will be the final race of her career, and she'll be often remembered for overcoming post 9 in the James Lynch at Pocono Downs two years ago when parked the entire mile. Dunn is new to

driving Kissin In The Sand, but the duo are a perfect four-for-four together since October and the 5-year-old mare may have never been better than she is now.

"She's been extremely strong throughout the year, and in her latest miles she's been sort of running off with it and winning pretty comfortably. She's got a bad post so it might be tough for her this week, but she's been strong."

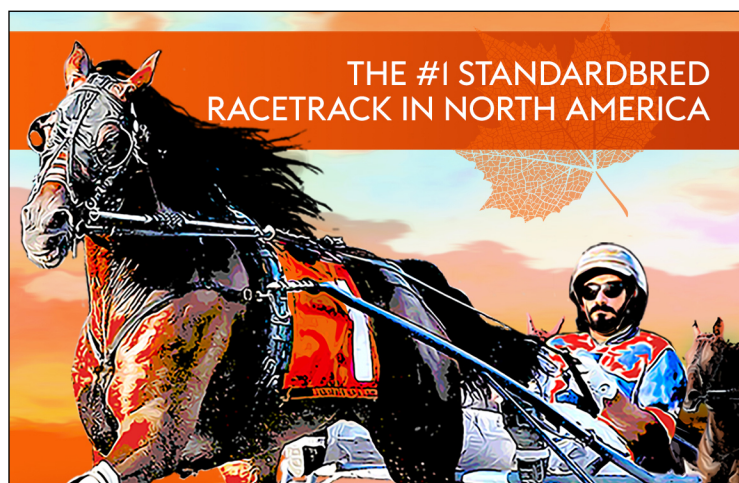
Kissin In The Sand has defeated Shartin N in three straight races now, but Shartin now lands the post edge and comes off a big qualifier. Also in the race is the lone 3-year-old Peaky Sneaky, who won the Breeders Crown two races back and pinned the lone career loss to Party Girl Hill in the process.

For Dunn, last but far from least comes Bettor's Wish in the TVG open pace. Bettor's Wish and Dunn teamed together to win last year's 3-year-old pacer of the year, and I'd say that the 4-year-old Bettor's Delight horse rates a fairly strong shot at once again taking an ultra-competitive division of older pacers. This division and this race could come down to him, and Century Farroh.

Looking to go out a winner before standing at Diamond Creek Farms, Dunn said Bettor's Wish is, "an amazing horse. I'll miss him but at the same time I've been lucky to be a part of him really."

"He's given me a lot of highs since I've been here. He's got so much character as a horse and he's talented and gutsy and gives you 110 per cent all the time. You can't help but love a horse like him and it's been a pleasure to race him the last two years. He certainly deserves to go out on a winning note with the miles he's put in last year and this year, but there's some good open pacers that he'll need to beat to try to make first. It'll be bittersweet to be the last time to race him, but at the same time I've been lucky to be involved with him."

Perusing Saturday's killer TVG / Final Four card

Saturday's tremendous card at The Meadowlands will mark the first time three female standardbreds with \$2.5 million or more on their cards will appear on the same race card.

Pacer Shartin N (\$2,513,349) and trotters Atlanta (\$2,579,653) and Manchego (\$2,563,181) are all scheduled to race.

Shartin N is the fastest female ever to race, Manchego is a three-time Breeders Crown winner and Atlanta is the 2018 Trotter of the Year.

Combined, the trio has a 60 per cent lifetime winning percentage thanks to 103 victories in 171 starts.

Cantab Hall's presence

Cantab Hall is the only trotting stallion to have progeny win two 2020 Breeders Crowns and go 1-2 in a final. He is the last trotter to be named Trotter of the Year as a freshman (2003). Take a look at his offspring for Saturday's Big M card:

Crystal Fashion is about \$5,000 from \$2 million lifetime. He is the co-fastest male Hambletonian elim or final winner ever at 1:50.1 and was second in the Breeders Crown.

Both Manchego and Atlanta are out of Cantab Hall mares.

Hemi Blue Chip is the dam of Atlanta and Secret Magic is Manchego's dam.

Felicity Shagwell S is in the TVG mare trot and is from a Cantab Hall mare, too — Diaz Boko.

In Comunicado is from a Cantab Hall dam (Gran Cavallaalso), as is Jack Fine with \$183,000 on the year. Both are in the \$398,650 Valley Victory.

Siring dominance

On the entire Saturday night card, 34 are either by Somebeachsomewhere (23) or his son Captaintreacherous (11).

Will big payoffs continue?

Can the wild mutuel prices from the Breeders Crown weekend carry over to the last big stakes night of the year?

Remember not only was the \$409.80 price for Sandbetweenmytoes a record, but the \$186 the week before in the elims was the high water mark going into final weekend.

Sophomore fillies take on their elders

How will the sophomore fillies Sorella and Peak Sneaky do versus the older set? Sunday marks the 46th anniversary of the most famous 3YO filly beatdown of the older boys — Handle With Care in California setting the world record of 1:54.4 beating not only the boys, but older males and the defending HOY Sir Dalrae, too!

Handle With Care was handled by 20-year-old Peter Haughton and was a sophomore pacing filly who would later beat the boys again (11/22/74 Hollywood Park).

Sorella and Peak Sneaky

What The Hill turned this trick in 2017 and nailed down divisional honors.

From Crown to TVG/Final Four

All six female Breeders Crown winners are in on Final Four / TVG Night.

WHAT pressure?

Bee A Magician was the undefeated 2013 Horse of the Year. Muscle Hill was the undefeated 2009 HOY. They are the only two trotters to do this. What happens when they pair up? Voila... BEE FOREVER is in the \$398,650 Valley Victory and has post 7. The Nifty Norman-trained homebred was third in the \$207,570 Kindergarten final.

Anoka Hanover and Todd McCarthy

Anoka Hanover, the likely favorite in the \$451,800 Goldsmith Maid, will be handled by 27-year-old Todd McCarthy, who is three years younger than this stake itself (it started in 1990 at Garden State Park).

Crown Pick 3

Betting a Pick 3 in races 9-10-11 — a combo of 9 with 3 & 7 with 3 would be a Breeders Crown-winning Pick 3.

Summa Cum Laude with Century Farroh and Dorsudoro Hanover with American History.

HOY parents

J K She's A Lady, the undefeated 2014 HOY-is represented by J K AlwaysBalady in post 11 in the \$323,600 Three Diamonds. She is the second 2-year-old on the card with both parents HOY winners. Her sire is 2016 HOY Always B Miki.

Interesting developments in the indictments, thoughts on the Propulsion case and my major personality defect

Tidbits: There are some interesting developments in the indictment story. The defense attorneys' responses to the many indictments handed down by the Southern District of New York involving horse racing have disclosed that they will fight the legality of the wire taps in some of the cases as their basis of defense.

To me, if this turns out to be a successful defense, it is a crushing blow to the prosecution. The most damning evidence in the cases are the phone conversations that give insight into the true intent of the perpetrators.

In other news on the subject, the New York State Gaming Commission medical director Dr. Scott Palmer DVM ordered the testing of all the New York-based horses involved with the individuals named in the indictments. He found 77 per cent of those tested were all positive for the drug Clenbuterol although it never appeared in their individual veterinary reports. Dr. Palmer states that this is proof that the drug is widely used as a performance enhancer and not simply as a relief from chest congestion. It has always been believed that Clenbuterol has the same long-term effect as anabolic steroids and will bulk up the muscles of an equine athlete.

In the first major hearing in the Southern District, government prosecutor Andrew Adams claimed that there well could be further charges brought against the already charged defendants as well as the possibility of a new wave of fresh indictments.

In the hearing, that only involved about half the indictees, all charged plead not guilty.

They included: Jason Servis, Jorge Navarro, and Chris Oakes the most formidable of the defendants.



I will not bore you with the courtroom details but most of the discussions involved defense lawyers complaining about the vast amount of discovery presented by the state. Obviously, this is a good thing.

Basically it all comes down to a tremendous amount of time allotted for trial preparation that will push the finality of the situation well into next summer. I will stay on it as it will be an interesting ride to say the least.

R.I.P. Scottie Harris, a good friend and one of the truly great characters in Kentucky harness history. Scottie, aside from being a top horseman, was to me like the Mayor of the Red Mile for decades. His smile, quick wit and genuine kindness will always be remembered.

The first reports on Lasix ban are all POSITIVE. To all of you that have predicted gloom and doom and refused to lend your support of the Integrity Act because of the fear that the sport would crumble with the banning of Lasix, the first major test is over.

The Breeders' Cup 2-year-olds all ran without the use of the drug and there were no major incidents of severe bleeding. On top of that fact is the assessment by many of the trainers that found their horses racing without the drug came out of the races with a lot more energy.

The true test will come in 2021 when all the stakes races are competed without the use of Lasix. Stay tuned.

Mvh Gosta Paterson (Sweden) asks: re: Propulsion Gate... After Propulsion was low-nerved trainer Tony Alagna was supposed to report it to the race office. Can you check if it has been done? Can it be confirmed by any documents? Was it possible to obtain this information before the auction? These answers may weigh on the degree of guilt of Daniel Redén.

I have spoken with Tony Alagna and everything was done and reported in a timely and proper fashion. The problems that have arisen were not with the trainers but were purely

procedural.

Immediately following the surgical procedure, Tony informed the racing office at the Meadowlands that the horse had been nerved. Subsequently the race office posted it on their bulletin board so the information was public knowledge. Unfortunately, the USTA does not receive that sort of disclosure until the conclusion of the meeting. That is where the cluster f—k begins.

Without the information coming from the Meadowlands in real time it is impossible for the association to enter the procedure on a horse's papers. It is the timing that is the culprit in a case as this not any one individual.

Very few logical things could have happened to avoid the horrible situation. One would not expect that Daniel Redén would be looking at the records in the race office nor would he be asking about nerving. As far as Tony Alagna is concerned I am sure he had no idea whatsoever that a nerved horse could not race in Sweden.

There is a paper trail if you wish to pursue it. You could contact the Meadowlands and ask if they keep the bulletins and request a copy. That would prove the story in its entirety is correct.

To this writer, Daniel Redén is 100 per cent innocent of any malicious intent in the matter. When he selected the colt for purchase I am certain that finding out whether he had been nerved was nowhere in his mind. The over-bearing decision by the Swedish Trotting Assn. should be referred to a proper court and reversed.

Dean Adams asks: I was looking into past records and I was surprised to find you really never trained a big stable. Was that by design or were there other factors?

I would have to answer that both were in some way relevant.

For the most part, big stables lost much of their popularity with the demise of the big training facilities. The loss of Pompano's training side and Ben White Raceway may not have been a determining factor but they didn't help the big outfits.

Barns such as Haughton, Dancer, Popfinger, Silverman, Sholty, etc. with their sets of eight on the half hour were gone until recently with the rise of Burke, Alagna, Miller and Takter.

In my era of Grand Circuit training, the big guns such as Sylvester, Erickson, Takter, Toscano, Smedshammer, and Holloway, the only giant stable that existed was Erv Miller and that was mainly due to the fact that he was training 50 Illinois-bred colts and the others stuck mainly to open stakes

prospects.

I would say a large barn in those days was 50 head. I stayed mostly in the 25 range.

Not just by choice, but I had a major personality defect that wasn't evident in most of my fellow trainers.

That defect was, I was a bit too caustic. I was a horse trainer, not a baby sitter, not a psychiatrist, and truly not a friend unless I wanted to be. I am a very social person but I want to spend my time with people I enjoy, not be forced into social situations because of business.

My other problem was I felt that if a horse was in my care and I deemed it a losing proposition for the owner I should be able to freely say, sell the animal without severe recriminations.

I blew off possibly one of the biggest owners in the sport in George Steinbrenner. John Cashman, visited my office every day at 6:30 a.m. One day he told me George wanted to send me some horses. The next day the truck comes with five head, one worse than the other. About a week later after exhausting all possibilities I called and said to George, 'Four of the colts are awful, either bad gaited or just no talent. One was very nice but needed green grass for at least three months.' He asked me to try them for a couple of months, to which I replied, 'I promise you they will be no better in 60 days than they are now.' The next day the truck comes to send them to another trainer. We all know the rest of the story, but the bad news is I never trained another horse for George Steinbrenner again.

To me there are two kinds of owners. The ones that if you say your horse is no good, they immediately put it in a sale. I like that. Then there are the ones that say thank you and send it to another trainer. I hate that.

Believe me I had no fear that someone was going to improve on my training it was just an ego thing that someone would think I was wrong.

Every year I went west with my entire barn after the Hambletonian and if I had a horse than was non-competitive on the Grand Circuit I would tell the owner to move the horse to another trainer, that was a normal yearly ritual, but I like it when the choice is mine.

Point of interest. There was one horse that I thought was better when he left my barn and I thought I missed something. I was right. The trainer of said horse is one of the indicted individuals that will soon be doing hard time or singing for his supper.

Alan Kelley asks: it's been forever since you have given us a book. Please give us some new reading suggestions.

Sorry I just can't. It's been two years since I proposed *Where The Crawdads Sing* and justly received lots of positive feedback as it remained near the top of the NY Times Best Seller list for all that time. I usually read a book a week, but have been on a bad streak and down to half that. It seems all my favorite authors Grisham, Silva, Connelly etc. are all suffering from brain lapse. They are all writing but not much worthy of praise is resulting. This too will change stay tuned.

On the other hand, there are some television series that I have found profoundly intriguing.

The *Queens Gambit* offered by Netflix is the story of an orphaned Lexington, KY girl who learns to play chess from the janitor of her orphanage as a pre-teen. Subsequently, she rises to the best in the world while fighting a drug and alcohol addiction. It takes place in the 1950s and '60s. The story is based on a novel by Walter Teis, famous for *The Hustler*, the story of "Fast Eddie Felson" played by Paul Newman in the movie with the same name. Well worth watching.

The *Undoing*, from HBO has an all-star cast led by Nicole Kidman, Hugh Grant and Donald Sutherland. It is another fabulous offering. It is a murder mystery and into the fourth episode this writer can make a case for everyone in the cast being the murderer. A must see.

Trio of Dan Patch Award winners to race for the final time in TVGs

Bettors Wish, Kissin In the Sand and Manchego will all be retired after racing Saturday during the Meadowlands' rich stakes card.

Harness racing will say goodbye to three Dan Patch Award winners following Saturday's (Nov. 21) TVG Series championships at The Meadowlands. Bettor's Wish, Kissin In The Sand, and Manchego will be retired to breeding duties after their careers conclude this weekend and each will be honored in ceremonies following their respective races at The Big M.

Bettor's Wish, a 4-year-old stallion, received the Dan Patch Award for best 3-year-old male pacer in 2019 and was second to mare Shartin N in voting for both Pacer of the Year and Horse of the Year. He led the sport with \$1.64 million in purses last year and has earned \$2.43 million lifetime.

The son of Bettor's Delight—Lifetime Star heads to Saturday's \$340,000 TVG Series Open Pace championship the winner of 23 of 43 lifetime starts. He has failed to finish among the top three only three times in his career.

"I'm going to miss him," said trainer Chris Ryder, who owns Bettor's Wish with Bella Racing, Fair Island Farm, and Bettors Wish Partners. "He's going to be near impossible to replace. It's hard to find a horse that can do what he's done, and he just takes it all in stride. When you look back, it's been a terrific run. You really appreciate having a horse that can do all he did."

Victories this year for Bettor's Wish include the Sam McKee Memorial, Dayton Pacing Derby, and Allera Farms Open Pace.

"Winning the McKee was very special to me," said Ryder, who noted at the time, "It's hard to describe. It's an honor to win it for Sam. I hope he's looking down on us today."

Bettor's Wish bred 58 mares in New Jersey this year before beginning his 4-year-old campaign. He will stand at Diamond Creek Farm of Pennsylvania in 2021.

Ryder gave credit to caretaker Alonso Martinez, second trainer Peter Trebotica, and his son Patrick Ryder, for playing

key roles in the horse's success. He also thanked his ownership partners and regular driver Dexter Dunn as well as trainer Chantal Mitchell and driver Paul MacDonell, who campaigned the horse for him in Canada at 2.

"Most of all, thank you Bettor's Wish," Ryder said. "He was such an exciting and tough racehorse for all of us to enjoy, consistently giving 100 percent on the track. We will all miss this amazing horse."

Kissin In The Sand was a Dan Patch Award winner at age 3. The now 5-year-old mare enters Saturday's \$150,000 TVG Series championship for female pacers with 26 career wins in 57 starts and \$1.66 million in purses.

A daughter of Somebeachsomewhere—Kiss Me Kate, she has been trained throughout her career by Nancy Takter and owned by Marvin Katz and Bud Hatfield. Katz said Kissin In The Sand will be bred to Tall Dark Stranger.

"It's been exciting," Hatfield said. "We all have had so much

fun with this horse, it's unbelievable. But it's time to start another chapter in her life. It's time for the breeding shed, and I think she'll be a good mom."

Kissin In The Sand brings a six-race win streak to her career finale. Among those victories was her first Breeders Crown as well as the Dayton Distaff Derby, Milton Stakes, and Allerage Farms Mare Pace.

Hatfield said Kissin In The Sand's determination was what he most admired about the horse. That grit was perhaps most famously on display in the 2018 James M. Lynch Memorial at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, where she won by a neck over Youaremycandygirl after being parked out from post nine for most of the mile.

"Even if she had a bad post, she would come out of there rolling, get parked, and keep digging in," Hatfield said. "She showed so much heart and grit.

"Nancy has done a heck of a job with her. They have a special bond, they really do. She loves that horse. She's a special horse and I think she will be a special broodmare."

Manchego, a 5-year-old female trotter, competes in Saturday's \$320,000 TVG Series Open Trot, facing a field that includes fellow mare Atlanta as well as male rivals Crystal Fashion, Lindy The Great, and Mission Accepted.

A daughter of Muscle Hill—Secret Magic, Manchego has won 32 of 55 lifetime races and earned \$2.56 million. Her victories include the 2018 Hambletonian Oaks and Breeders Crown titles at ages 2, 4, and 5.

She is the fastest female trotter ever thanks to her 1:49 victory in the 2019 Allerage Farms Mare Trot at Red Mile and also the fastest female trotter in history on a five-eighths-mile track, with a mark of 1:49.3 in this year's Spirit of Massachusetts at Plainridge Park. She is the only female trotter to win with a sub-1:50 mile in multiple years and has been the sport's fastest trotter in 2019 and 2020.

Manchego went undefeated in 12 races at age 2 and received divisional Dan Patch honors. She was trained by Jimmy Takter at ages 2 and 3 and by Nancy Takter at 4 and 5.

"For me, that (TVG) will be a rough one because it's been so wonderful, and I do like to race," owner Barry Guariglia of Black Horse Racing said. "It'll be a rough one, but the start of a new chapter for her.

"She seems to be in good form, so hopefully we've got one more (win) in us."

The Meadowlands hosts four TVG Series championships Saturday as well as the Fall Four for 2-year-olds.

Four Breeders Crown winners will be in action in the Fall Four: Lady Chaos in the \$451,800 Goldsmith Maid for 2-year-old filly trotters, On A Streak in the \$398,650 Valley Victory for 2-year-old male trotters, Summa Cum Laude in the \$371,900 Governor's Cup for 2-year-old male pacers, and Fire Start Hanover in the \$323,600 Three Diamonds for 2-year-old filly pacers.

Racing begins at 7:15 p.m. (EST).

Takter duo to tackle older foes in TVGs Saturday at the Big M

Trainer Nancy Takter will watch trotting mare Manchego and pacing mare Kissin In The Sand compete for the final time Saturday (Nov. 21) at The Meadowlands, but also will get another look at two 3-year-olds that will attempt to follow in their award-winning stablemates' hoof prints next season.

Hambletonian Oaks winner Sorella will face five older foes in the \$140,000 TVG Series championship for female trotters while 3-year-old filly Breeders Crown winner Peaky Sneaky will meet eight older rivals in the \$150,000 TVG Series championship for female pacers.

"They're both coming back next year, and they're both really sharp at the moment," Takter said. "I think they both deserve a chance."

It is the second time 3-year-old fillies will take on mares in the TVG Series championships, which debuted in 2013. Last year, Warrawee Ubeaut finished fourth in the Mare Pace final and Beautiful Sin was fourth in the Mare Trot.

Sorella's foes in the Mare Trot include 5-year-old Plunge Blue Chip, a world-record-holder and multiple Grand Circuit winner, and 4-year-old When Dovescry, who captured the 2019 Hambletonian Oaks and Dan Patch Award for best 3-year-old filly trotter. She will not face Manchego or Atlanta, who will both race in Saturday's \$320,000 TVG Open Trot final.

Peaky Sneaky's rivals in the Mare Pace include 5-year-old Kissin In The Sand as well as 7-year-old Shartin N, who was the 2019 Horse of the Year; 6-year-old Caviart Ally, who is the event's defending champion, and 4-year-old Warrawee Ubeaut.

The four TVG Series championships are among eight Grand Circuit stakes on Saturday's Big M card, along with the Fall Four for 2-year-old pacers and trotters. Racing begins at 7:15 p.m. (EST).

Sorella heads to the TVG Mare Trot off a win in last week's Matron Stakes for 3-year-old filly trotters. She has won eight of 14 races this season, hit the board a total of 12 times, and earned \$713,049. In addition to winning the Oaks, she won a division of the Casual Breeze Stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park in a Canadian-record 1:51.3 and the Reynolds Memorial in 1:50.2, which is tied for the season's second-fastest mile by a 3-year-old trotter.

"The only way I was putting Sorella in was if Manchego ended up in the (TVG) Open," Takter said. "I knew it was going to be a little bit of a short field, and I think she belongs in there. I don't think she gets enough credit for what she's done this year. She's raced from the first weekend of June all the way through November. She broke a Canadian record, she won the Oaks; she's had a tremendous year."

Peaky Sneaky won the Breeders Crown last month at Harrah's Hoosier Park, where she handed Party Girl Hill her only loss of the season. For the year, Peaky Sneaky has won six of 15 races, hit the board 12 times, and earned \$482,622. Her 1:48 win in a division of the Glen Garnsey makes her the third-fastest female pacer of the season, behind only Party Girl Hill and Kissin In The Sand.

"She's tough and gritty," Takter said. "I don't think she knows any different if they're aged mares or 3-year-olds."

Kissin In The Sand heads to the TVG final with a six-race win streak. Her victories include the Breeders Crown, Dayton Distaff Derby, Milton Stakes, and Allera Farms Mare Pace. For her career, she has won 26 of 57 races and \$1.66 million. She was a Dan Patch Award winner at 3.

Manchego, coming off the third Breeders Crown title of her career, and 5-year-old mare Atlanta both take on the males in the TVG Open Trot. Manchego has won 32 of 55 lifetime races and \$2.56 million. She was a Dan Patch Award winner at 2.

In the TVG Open Pace championship, Bettor's Wish will make his final career start against a field that includes Breeders Crown winner Century Farroh.

Four Breeders Crown winners also will be in action in the Fall Four: Lady Chaos in the \$451,800 Goldsmith Maid for 2-year-old filly trotters, On A Streak in the \$398,650 Valley Victory for 2-year-old male trotters, Summa Cum Laude in the \$371,900 Governor's Cup for 2-year-old male pacers, and Fire Start Hanover in the \$323,600 Three Diamonds for 2-year-old filly pacers.

Trainer Mariah Wright already has two fairytale highlights

Two memorable wins, two perfectly named horses. Mariah Wright couldn't have scripted the fairytale endings any better.

If the young, up-and-coming trainer currently calling Indiana home could come up with a movie title to describe her career, she might very well opt for Chasing Stars, or perhaps, Make Three Wishes.

And what a story it would be for daughter of Michigan Hall of Fame horseman Darrell Wright.

Although it's early on in her standardbred life, the 27-year-old, who was awarded the 2010 Harness Horsemen International Jerome L. Hauck Scholarship (worth \$4,000), already has pair of impressive highlights.

One of them came courtesy of the aptly named Star Chaser, a pacing son of Dontgetinmyway that Wright had claimed for \$4,000 on March 1, 2015, at Balmoral Park.

Wright's father had been training and driving the gelding bred by Tobias Troyer, while she handled the role of caretaker, but she took over the reins of driver ahead of the 2018 Ohio Ladies Pace at the Paulding County Fair.

In this instance, it was daughter knows best, as she piloted 33-1 Star Chaser to a 2:03.4 victory in the final.

"To this day, that is my biggest accomplishment as a driver. Winning the final in the series during Little Brown Jug week... the feeling of winning during the Jug was amazing. I just jumped into [driving]. My horse – he's a pet – I needed to qualify him for the Ladies Pace because they were short on horses to fill the first race that year. Bill Peters [regional coordinator for the Ohio Fair Racing Association], who does a phenomenal job with that race in keeping it going, he actually called me and asked if I had a horse that he could use for the race. I wasn't comfortable with anyone else driving him, so I told him that I would do it. Surprisingly, in

what was my first drive, he won."

Wright, a 2010 graduate of Stockbridge's Leslie High School, who carried a GPA of 3.75 and was a Congressional Medal of Merit winner during her senior year, netted another notable achievement a few months after her Star Chaser moment.

This one came on the hooves of the veteran pacing mare Make Three Wishes in the Ohio Ladies Pace Series Championship on Sept. 18, 2018 at Delaware County Fair.

"Winning at Delaware was obviously the most emotional and a big highlight. That was special too because my mom [Gina] used to work for [trainer] Joe Putnam. And Joe trains Make Three Wishes, so it kind of makes the world come full circle. That was one of my mom's first jobs, working for Joe. He had Make Three Wishes, who really needed to get her confidence going, so he trusted me to race her at a few fairs and it worked out that we didn't just race, we won a few races together. It made for a very special summer."

Yet Wright is certainly no one-season wonder.

Star Chaser and Make Three Wishes aside, the star-on-the-rise conditioner has worked hard to make a name for herself on and off the racetrack.

A standout in the classroom and on the court, Wright received the Coaches and MVP Awards in Varsity Volleyball during her junior and senior seasons. She also volunteered at the Ingham County Animal Control Shelter and at Leslie Outreach.

She continued her scholastic studies at Adrian College with a double major in biology and business, and a minor in chemistry.

But her favorite subject is, without a doubt, horse racing.

"I've grown up in racing. My dad has been involved for a long time, my grandpa [Richard] used to race horses in Michigan, as did my uncle, Jim. I started paddocking and doing everything probably before I was allowed to, at least according to the racetracks. I played volleyball in high school and went to play volleyball in college. From there, I got a job to come to Indiana between my junior year and senior year of college. I was a double major in biology and business, with a minor in chemistry. I realized – I wasn't wasting my time because I love college and learned a lot – but I was never going to use the degree because I've grown up in this world and I always wanted to do it.

"I don't have my degrees yet. I took two years off and then started again, and then took another year off. I start classes again in January, so I'm slowly working my way to achieving that goal. I want to have my degree before I'm 30. Not that I ever plan on using it for anything, but I feel with the time I've invested that I should finish it out. I went to a small private college. I actually wanted to be a vet, but I just realized in school that I wanted to be a vet because I wanted to stay with the horses. But my heart was in being a horse trainer and groom, so I stuck with that."

The business world's loss has been harness racing's gain.

Wright has been able to use some of the life lessons learned in the classroom and on the gym floor, and add certain skills she acquired into her horse racing repertoire.

"The one thing is, especially with volleyball and school – I was just talking with someone about this – is that in high school I wanted everything to be perfect. I wanted to be the person with straights A's, and then you get to college and you have a professor give you a C. As a freshman, you're just baffled by that because you think to yourself, 'No, you're supposed to do better.' You always strive to be the best. While volleyball is the same in that you want to be your best all the time, you sometimes have to find that happy medium of knowing when it's okay to step back and say, 'Okay, good enough is good enough.'

"That's the same thing with how you train your horses. If you push them too hard, then they'll burn out. It's the same when it comes to school. If you study too much, it just becomes a big blur. Horses, you want to make them the best they can be. You don't want to over-train them. I look at that as being the same for volleyball. If you over-train, your muscles will get tired, and then you'll get mentally drained. Being an athlete and being in school, you have to

balance everything you do to make sure you get the ideal results. Too much is too much."

Fortunately for Wright, she's put those words into practice. And while she might not always get the desired result on the racetrack, there is a measure of pride she rightfully takes in crafting her own blueprint for success, complemented by sound advice she's received along the way.

Two in particular immediately come to mind.

"The horses always come first. My dad instilled that in me. One, they are our livelihoods, but most importantly, if they are not on the top of their game, we're not on top of ours. They always have to come first. If that means you don't get to go to your friend's house on Friday night, then so be it. That was hard in high school, but now it's something I don't blink at. It's habit.

"The other thing is that there is no right or wrong way to do something. I've worked for a lot of different people and I've paddocked for a lot of different people. I worked for [top trainers] Ron Burke and Nancy Takter, and numerous people who have brought people to Indiana for the Grand Circuit races. They all do things differently, but they are all successful. You can never stop learning those different ways. If you are convinced that your way is the only way, you're letting the game pass you by."

For Wright, who is concentrating fully on training, it's just getting started.

She doesn't need to be a star chaser or make three wishes, although she's certainly happy to have her name associated with those words.

Sharing training duties with her father (he's currently in Minnesota and she's in Indiana), Wright will soon be on the move to Ohio, where she'll take a string of five to six of the 11 horses they train.

If past performance is indeed the barometer of future success, there's no doubt she's on the right track.

"I love this sport and looking back, I knew it's what I always wanted to do. I'm happy with how things have gone, but I'm going to continue to work hard every day."

Sunday (Nov. 22) is the day when the first of four "B-races" ahead of the Prix d'Amérique in Paris is scheduled and 18 trotters are scheduled to contest the \$112,700 Prix de Bretagne over 2,700 meters.

A place among the top three is the goal for every horse that wants to participate in Prix d'Amérique in late January of 2021 and there is a big chance that some upset horses will secure their spots, respectively.

The Prix de Bretagne has the same conditions as the Prix d'Amérique – 18 horses will contest it over 2,700 meters.

For the richest horses in the race, the Prix de Bretagne usually develops as a preparation race before the trainers try to peak their horses closer to the big race.

Updated protocols for owners attending races at Mohawk Park

With Halton Region currently in the red "control" zone, Woodbine Entertainment has released updated protocols for owners attending the races at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Starting Thursday (Nov.19), Woodbine permits just one owner, plus one guest, access to the Woodbine Mohawk Park apron for only the race their horse is competing in. The owner and guest will not be allowed entry to the grandstand until 10 minutes prior to the race and must exit five minutes after the race. If an owner has another horse racing that evening, the owner and guest must return to their vehicles until 10 minutes prior to their next race.

Access to the apron will be gained through the employee entrance (located on the West End beside the Paddock). At the point of entry, each owner shall present their AGCO Licence and undergo screening and a temperature check. Physical distancing must be practiced at all times. When exiting, owners shall exit through the front doors of the grandstand. Access to the grandstand is only for the purpose of traveling to the apron and exiting.

Owners must sign-up online prior to attending their race.

Big M looks to raise handle bar again

One week after setting new fall meet handle marks for a single card and a weekend, The Meadowlands is in position to better both bests again as the upcoming pair of race cards (Nov. 20-21) feature plenty of competitive racing, with Saturday night's Fall Final Four/TVG Finals Night standing dead center in the spotlight.

The stakes-race eight pack – the third biggest "event" program of the Big M calendar year after Hambletonian Day and Meadowlands Pace Night – has purses that total \$2,495,950, and figures to create a big night at the windows.

Last week (Nov. 13-14) saw Fall Meet highs of \$5,299,941 bet over the course of the two race cards with a single-night best of \$2,823,647 wagered on Saturday. In the end, the track had its first \$5 million weekend since Sept. 18-19.

The 20-cent Pick-6 continues to be a wager that creates big interest and big pools. A two-day carryover of just \$28,142 led to a total pool of \$104,695 on Saturday night, and those sharp enough to have all six winners walked away with \$5,642.

"All of us at The Meadowlands are pleased with the way things have gone with the Pick-6," said track chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemyre. "There is an

awful lot of excitement when there are carryovers in the wager, and a lot of value for the player. For instance, last week, only the \$76,553 in “new money” was subject to the low 15 percent takeout. All of the \$28,142 carryover was subject to no takeout at all.”

Other eyebrow-raising Saturday night payoffs included the 20-cent Pick-5 (\$1,599), 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 (\$2,527 for six-of-seven) and the 10-cent Pentafecta (\$1,166).

Friday night was for 50-cent Pick-4 players as over \$140,000 in action was taken on the wagers. The Early Pick returned \$4,186 while the Late Pick paid \$2,362.

As for hot horsemen, Dexter Dunn (five winners) led the driver's colony while Kelvin Harrison (three) topped the trainer's list.

SBOANJ annual meeting recap

On Monday (Nov. 16) executive administrator Al Ochsner played host to the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey's (SBOANJ) annual meeting along with president Mark Ford and the board of directors. For the first time ever, the meeting was held virtually online, and streamed live on Facebook.

The meeting opened with messages from Ford and Ochsner. Ford mentioned that the SBOANJ is now a member of the newly-formed North American Harness Horse Alliance. They both thanked the SBOANJ staff, all those involved with the Rutgers Risk Management Plan to enable racing to resume, the tracks and training centers that hosted dozens of qualifiers, and those who have reached out to help others during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Ochsner addressed the cancellation of the golf outing

which is the main source of revenue for TrotPAC the SBOANJ's Political Action Committee. He thanked all those members that helped continue fundraising capabilities to support legislators. That support along with the completion of the 2019 NJ Horse Racing Impact Study that was sent to all state legislators really made a difference in the state approving the appropriation funding for 2021. He also applauded Sam Landy's son Harry for making a great and informative video of the standardbred business, in an effort to bring attention to the need for the appropriation funding.

The SBOANJ has been working since 2016 to reduce the driver workmen's compensation insurance premium at both races tracks. Finally, NJRC established the standardbred premium to be based on the number of claims and the money associated with them. For many years the standardbreds had low claims or none at all but had to share a much higher premium with the thoroughbreds. In 2020, because of the adjustment and cash reserve available no money was needed to pay the cost of insurance. Plus there is a cash reserve to carry forward.

Plans have been made with Freehold Raceway to have two memorial races for the Fusco family and Harold Kelly in December and January.

The SBOANJ and BCAP presented four scholarships to SBOANJ member's children totaling \$9,000.

The 2021 racing dates were announced, the Meadowlands will race 90 dates and Freehold Raceway will race 82 dates.

The breeding committee reported that the breeding industry in New Jersey has shown gains for the third year in a row. There were 279 mares bred in 2017 and 780 bred in 2020.

The insurance committee reported another year without an increase to the insurance premiums for the 14th year in a row.

The finance and pension committee is very pleased with the investment policies at this time and continues to review UBS performances. They reported the investments to be good relative to benchmarks, especially during these uncertain times.
