Michiana Classic average up 23 per cent; Midwest Mixed Sale grosses over \$1.1 million

The yearling sale and mixed sale were held back-to-back on Tuesday at the Michiana Event Center in Indiana. The two sales grossed some \$2 million combined.

The Michiana Event Center in Shipshewana, IN served as the venue for the Michiana Classic Yearling Sale and Midwest Mixed Sale. Traditionally, the events are held on back-to-back days, but this year a condensed calendar saw the two auctions take place on Tuesday (Nov. 23). A group of 98 yearlings were sold at the Michiana Classic, generating gross sales of \$891,200 and producing an average of \$9,094, a 23 per cent increase over 2020.

"The Michiana Classic is the last opportunity this year for horsemen to purchase Indiana-sired yearlings. For those that still have stalls to fill and were unsuccessful in buying at the Hoosier Classic or Harrisburg, they still have one more chance," said sale manager Steve Cross. "Each year we see that the yearlings selling at the Michiana Classic bring good prices because of that need. Our catalog this year was smaller, but our average and median set new records."

The 2021 catalog included 113 yearlings, considerably fewer than the 180 cataloged a year earlier. Gross sales were down due to the smaller catalog, but the average climbed \$1,711 per yearling, and the \$7,500 median rose \$1,300 compared against 2020 figures.

Tabasco Cat, a Tellitlikeitis colt consigned by Fred and Carolyn Shiery, topped the Michiana Classic sale with a \$30,000 bid. Cataloged as Hip 82, the Indiana and Michigan eligible bay is out of Southwind Mocha. The Artsplace mare is a 100 per cent producer, dam of six winners led by 34-time winner Southern Winds p, 2, 1:58.1h; 3, 1:56h; 1:52h-19 (\$265,760) and multiple Indiana Sired Fair Circuit winner Smooth Mocha (\$99,544). Kim Roth signed the ticket as agent for Rock and Roll Stable.

Progeny from the first crop of trotter You Know You Do followed on the sales sheets. Filly Five Star Photo, part of the In Law Stable consignment, sold for \$27,000. A half-sister to Indiana Sires Stakes leg winner King Felix 2, Q1:56.4s; 3, 1:55s-'21 (\$116,425), the yearling was purchased by Freeman Mast, acting as agent. Trotting Marky, a gelded son of You Know You Do, brought \$26,000. Selling near the end of the sale as Hip 104, the bay is a brother to four winners including Indiana Sired Fair Circuit winner and Governor's Cup runner-up Whom Shall I Love 2, 2:01s; 4, 1:56.4f -'21 (\$71,868). Cassie George signed the sales slip.

More than 75 different buyers signed tickets at the Michiana Classic. Owner/trainer Alvin Miller spent the most of any buyer, picking up a pair of Rockin Image colts for \$47,000. Acting as agent, he bid \$24,000 for Lupa, Hip 50, out of the Integrity



Stables consignment. Miller spent \$23,000 on Rockin Corona, Hip 73, from the Premier Acres consignment.

Shortly after the conclusion of the Michiana Classic, the Midwest Mixed Sale kicked off Tuesday afternoon. As the name implies, yearlings, weanlings, stallion shares, broodmares and racehorses were auctioned, with gross sales totaling a little over \$1.1 million. Southwind Ritz, a 3-year-old Muscle Hill filly with a mark of 1:56.2f, topped the session with an \$87,000 bid. Cataloged as Hip 288 as part of the Winterwood Farm consignment, the filly sold as a racing or broodmare prospect, purchased by Jonas Slabach of Applecreek, OH.

"The broodmare market, especially in this region, is especially strong for a live sale, and I think it proved that today," said sale manager Jeff Fought. "I felt like trotting mares were especially strong. The trotting market was very strong and I think that carried through the broodmares. We are seeing individuals buy broodmares and broodmare prospects specifically to sell here due to the strength of the market."

Six horses brought bids of \$40,000 or more, with three consigned by Winterwood Farm. Shes Light Out, a Somebeachsomewhere broodmare, brought the second highest bid of the session, hammered down for \$52,000. In foal to JK Endofanera, her first foal, the mare was purchased by Swiss Boarding Farms. A Ray Of Sunshine, a Cantab Hall mare consigned by the Bellville, Ohio farm, brought \$40,000. Another purchase by fellow Buckeye Slabach, the mare is in foal to Marseille. Flow And Go, a Yankee Glide mare carrying a Swan For All foal, also her first, sold for \$50,000. Consigned as agent by In-Law Stables, John Lengacher signed the ticket.

"Winterwood has developed a reputation of being a consignor of the very high end at this sale," said Fought. "Same thing with In-Law Stables. They are a very popular agent consignment."

Fought said that while the breeding stock portion of the sale proved strong, racehorse entries were down. The 2021 Midwest Mixed catalog included 21 racehorses whereas last year's event offered more than double the number.

"I think that market has changed, where people want to instantly sell if they have a racehorse that they want to move or need to move. They don't wait for physical sales as much as they have in the past," said Fought. "Racehorses are just tougher to buy right now because there's a lot of opportunities to race. People are more apt to hang onto a racehorse where maybe in the past they might have sold."

After sale topper Southwind Ritz, Heavens Dancer fetched the next highest price for a racehorse. The Somebeachsomewhere—Fancy Creek Funny mare, a six-figure earner with a mark of 1:52.4, was purchased by Joseph Nissley for \$24,000.

Rockyroad Hanover wins Progress Pace

Alagna-trained, Hanover-bred pacers finish 1-2 at Dover Downs.

Taking advantage of a garden trip behind a pressured pace, **Rockyroad Hanover** (\$11.00) surged up the open stretch to capture Wednesday's (Nov. 24) \$310,000 Progress Pace for 3-year-old colts and geldings at Dover Downs.

Dexter Dunn pushed forward with the son of Captaintreacherous — Romantic Moment, working three-wide through the entire first

turn to clear Chase H Hanover and Abuckabett Hanover at the end of a :26.1 first guarter.

Rockyroad Hanover strung 3-2 favorite Charlie May out through the third furlong before yielding for the pocket to draft behind middle splits of :54.1 and 1:21.3.

While Charlie May was busy fending off sustained pressure from the first-over Abuckabett Hanover through the far turn, Rockyroad Hanover was poised to pounce up the inside turning for home.

As expected, Rockyroad Hanover struck in the final sixteenth, winning in 1:49.3 and edging his Tony Alagna stablemate Abuckabett Hanover by a half-length. Charlie May, after being engulfed in deep stretch, narrowly held third over Lou's Pearlman.

Riverview Racing, Brad Grant, Kenneth Jacobs, and the Plouffe Head and VJ Stable share ownership of Rockyroad Hanover, whose sixth career win lifted his lifetime earnings to \$595,134.

Hanover Shoe Farms bred both Rockyroad Hanover and runner-up Abuckabett Hanover.

Rockyroad Hanover sold for \$65,000 and Abuckabett Hanover sold for \$160,000 at the 2019 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA.

Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund finals recaps

An early break in stride by odds-on favorite Shabby Chic paved the way for **Odds On Surfer Gal** (\$43.60) — making just her third career start — to upset at 20-1 in Wednesday night's (Nov. 24) \$100,000 Ramona Hubbard, the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund final for 2-year-old pacing fillies, at Dover Downs.

With Shabby Chic off stride at the start, Corey Callahan worked Odds On Surfer Gal around Bank The Win and Gaitway Gal to assume the lead at the end of a :27.4 first quarter, only to yield for a pocket ride behind Bank The Win — the 5-2 second choice — with a lap to go. Odds On Surfer Gal stayed tight to the pacesetter through middle splits of :57.1 and 1:25.4, and found herself poised to attack after Bank The Win shrugged off a first-over challenge from Gaitway Gal into the far turn. Off the home turn, Victor Kirby called on Bank The Win for every last bit of energy she could muster, but Odds On Surfer Gal surged to the fore up the open stretch, reaching the lead in the final 70 yards of her 1:54.3 score. Gaitway Gal re-rallied in mid-stretch for second, a neck behind; Bank The Win was a beaten third.

Tony Alagna trains Odds On Surfer Gal — now a two-time winner with \$62,400 in earnings — for Odds On Racing. Odds On Nourrir bred the Badlands Hanover-Odds On Moinet filly.

In the \$15,000 Michael T. Scuse DSBF consolation for rookie pacing fillies, **Tahoe** (\$10.00) vaulted from the pocket to win for the first time since her career debut, taking a mark of 1:57.4 in the act.

Following fourth-place finishes in both of her preliminary divisions, Tahoe and driver Art Stafford Jr. left from post three to secure the pocket behind 6-5 pacesetter Donna's The Best and draft through early splits of :28 and :58.4. With five-sixteenths to go, Stafford angled the daughter of Badlands Hanover and Veronica Lake off the pegs, worked to within a half-length of Donna's The Best past three-quarters in 1:28.1, and sprinted clear with ease through the far turn. Tahoe finished the mile 4-1/4 lengths better than 22-1 long shot Clean Up Hitter (Rich Borowsky), who circled three-wide through the final turn to edge Toodle's Power (Allan Davis) for runner-up honors.

Michael Hall trains the Doc's Farm-bred Tahoe for Eric Cherry's Let It Ride Stables, who has moved He's Watching to the First State for the 2022 breeding season.

Rivers, Shes All Woman take DSBF rookie trot finals

Rivers (\$3.00) completed a sweep of the fall Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 2-year-old male trotters at Dover Downs in Tuesday night's (Nov. 23) \$100,000 final, narrowly staving off a late charge from Navy Blue in a stakes record-tying 1:56.4.

The gelded son of Anders Bluestone and Stargazer Lily yielded to Navy Blue and Canoe Trip through a :28.2 first quarter before brushing to the lead in front of the grandstand. After clearing with nine-sixteenths to go, Rivers sprinted 2-1/2 lengths clear to a :57.2 half. Navy Blue tightened down in the pocket nearing three-quarters in 1:27.1 and edged to the outside at the eighth pole, but Rivers rose to the challenge, prevailing by a diminishing nose. Navy Blue (Art Stafford Jr.), who won in the second preliminary round, was 5-1/4 lengths better than LG's Reed O Wen (Jim Morand), who finished third.

Nick Callahan trains the Nancy Miller-bred Rivers, now a three-time winner with \$77,550 in career earnings, for Stuart Chambers Racing, BCJM Inc., Divine Horse Racing and Cinbrew Enterprises.

Cotton (\$4.40) won the \$15,000 DSBF consolation for rookie male trotters, turning aside sustained pressure from JAS Bluestone before edging clear to a two-length win over Brief Legacy in 2:01.4. Tim Tetrick drove the Jane Dunavant homebred son of Dusty Winner and Cashmere for trainer Carlo Poliseno.

On the strength of a 4-1/4-length win in the second preliminary round last week, **Shes All Woman** (\$5.60) dug deep late to repel 3-2 favorite Our Last Penny in the \$100,000 Marv Bachrad Memorial, the DSBF final for 2-year-old trotting fillies.

Jared Moyer pushed Shes All Woman forward from post seven, and the pair landed in the pocket behind early pacesetter Just Pump It, who tore through a :28.3 first quarter before yielding to Franky Doyle with a lap to go. Now relegated to third, Shes All Woman remained in the clear through a :58.1 half and angled off the pegs to advance around a struggling Just Pump It. Shes All Woman steamrolled to the front nearing three-quarters in 1:28.3, and Our Last Penny — who was eight lengths behind at the bell — chased live flow out of fifth to work to within striking range on the far turn. Our Last Penny and trainer/driver Rod Allen angled back to the outside after a brief tuck turning for home, but despite her strongest rally, Shes All Woman held her ground to win by a head in 1:59.4. Miss Timber Wolf (Kim Vincent) finished third, beaten 6-1/4 lengths.

John Wagner trains Shes All Woman, an Anders Bluestone—Wark Woman filly who also won the \$85,125 Virginia Breeders' Fund final at Shenandoah Downs on Oct. 1. Thus far, the Pamela Wagner homebred has won four of her seven career outings and banked \$111,200.

Rod Allen retires from racing

Rod Allen, who trained and drove his homebred Our Last Penny throughout the DSBF series, came up a head short of ending his storied harness racing career on a winning note, as he has announced his retirement from active participation in the sport.

"Rod has been a major participant in the Breeders' Fund since his dad, Carl, committed to standing CR Commando in Delaware at the inception of the program," said Judy Davis-Wilson, executive director of the DSBF. "He has always carried himself with grace and class, even in defeat. We want to thank Rod for all his years spent in the industry, and especially in our program."

Allen enjoyed success on harness racing's grandest stage, having won five Breeders Crowns as an owner and three as a driver — including two with the legendary CR Kay Suzie. But it is his

class and work ethic off the track that stands out to many of his colleagues, including Hall of Fame driver John Campbell:

"I have known Rod and his family for many years going back to my racing days in Michigan," Campbell, the current president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society, said. "I've always respected the Allen family for their hard work, determination, and the resulting successes they have achieved. Rod always exhibited class, no matter the wins or the losses. It is somewhat sad for me to think of Rod retiring, as the Allen name has been so prominent in racing for many years. I wish Rod and his family all the best moving forward."

The 65-year-old Michigan native and current Florida resident won 519 races and \$11.9 million in purses as a driver, and trained the winners of 110 races since the United States Trotting Association began maintaining training statistics in 1991.

Heinikin Bythebay completes Dover DSBF sweep

Following front-end wins in both of his preliminary divisions, **Heinikin Bythebay** (\$2.20) completed a sweep of the fall Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings at Dover Downs with a decisive 1:53.1 score in Monday night's (Nov. 22) \$100,000 final.

Having drawn the outside post in a scratch-reduced field of five, Heinikin Bythebay and Tim Tetrick used the entire first turn to advance alongside early pacesetter DS Heartland (Art Stafford Jr.), prompting a sharp :27.1 first quarter before working clear with just over a circuit to go. Heinikin Bythebay led DS Heartland through a sizzling :55 half, and they left the other trio behind amid a stout backstretch headwind.

After passing three-quarters in 1:24.1, Heinikin Bythebay dismissed of his pocket rival through the far turn, amassing 4-3/4 lengths of clearance at the winning post while under mild tap urging through the final sixteenth. DS Heartland finished second; It'spronounced Jif (Montrell Teague) rallied mildly for third, another 3-3/4 lengths behind, passing both Bad And Boujee and Schrute, the latter of whom tailed off badly through the final three-eighths after prompting the early pace.

Heinikin Bythebay, a gelded son of Southwind Lynx and Sally Pansen with \$109,925 in earnings, earned his seventh win in 10 starts this year for trainer Kevin Switzer and owner-breeder KDK Standardbreds, of Harrington, Del.

In the \$15,000 DSBF consolation for rookie pacing colts and geldings, **Cntnobdytelmenothn** (\$7.40) rode a clear pocket behind even-money favorite Casinobags Vincent through splits of :27.4, :56.3 and 1:25.3 before angling off the pegs in upper stretch and surging to a 1:55 win, recording his second career win by 2-1/2 lengths. Big N Bad Brad finished third.

Tony Morgan drove Cntnobdytelmenothn, a George Teague Jr. homebred son of Southwind Lynx and Cahill's Fancy, for trainer Clyde Francis.



The journey of fourthgeneration horseman Bryson Dunning: from tiny wheelbarrow to first training victory

Bryson Dunning's horse racing career began long before he earned his driver and trainer licenses.

Ask the 18-year-old from New Jersey when he first fell in love with standardbred racing and his first response is a hearty laugh.

"Since I can remember," said Dunning. "I was probably around six or seven when my parents bought me a wheelbarrow, a tiny one, so that could I clean the stalls. You could only get about two scoops in that thing, but that wasn't the point. I had a little pitchfork and a little wheelbarrow. I think I really fell in love with racing when I was around 10, that's when I got serious about it."


His affinity for horses and horses racing is in his DNA and family tree. His father, Jody, is a longtime successful trainer, having racked up more than 400 career wins. His mother, Christine Stafford, can trace her racing roots for decades.

"I've learned a lot from my dad over the years and on my mom's side, I'm fourth generation," said Dunning. "It's been in the family for a while, so I decided to keep it going. My dad, the way he taught me was that I never had to come to the barn, but I always did choose to go to the barn, and now I'm sticking to do it."

Dunning's first driving win, four years ago, is a story in itself, an interesting yarn that took place on the Maryland fair circuit.

Then just 14, the aspiring reinsman partnered with Crocodile Rock, a veteran pacing son of American Ideal, at Pocomoke Fair, for his milestone drive.

"It was my first-ever drive," said Dunning. "My dad and I, we never train in race bikes, so I had never sat in a race bike until two days before that. We took this older horse with us, which was basically our family pet. I don't think he had won a race in the past two years or something like that, but we took him to



Pocomoke. I sent him to the front and we won by seven lengths." What did that moment feel like?

"I thought, 'Damn, is it this easy?' But you realize that isn't the case." Even so, Dunning's love for racing didn't diminish.

Thankfully, there have been other successes since that milestone score.

On Nov. 18 at Harrah's Philadelphia, he celebrated another career first.

Dunning notched his first training victory when Real McCoy, with Simon Allard in the sulky, took a new mark of 1:57.3 for owner Dante Scattolini.

"I got my first horse when I was 16, but this is the first one in my name."

The win was decidedly different than his first driving triumph. Getting away third, Real McCoy held a half-length advantage at the stretch call going on to win by the same margin.

"There were two horses, including him, who came off the last turn and were ahead by about 10 lengths. It was kind of a cool race. They were both right there until the very end when my horse was able to dig in and get the win. It was a good race for a first training win."

Dunning will look to keep that momentum rolling.

"Right now, I have a barn of my own. I have four racehorses and one yearling. It's a nice little start, but I'd like to grow. I'd rather have more quality than quantity. I found that out when I was growing up with it. If you have a lot of horses and some of them aren't that good, you'll end up paying it for at the end. I'd like to have a stable of maybe 10-15 horses, decent moneymakers, and keep growing. That's my goal."

Down the road, Dunning is hopeful of broadening the scope of his stable.

Seeing his name at or near the top of the standings is a future goal.

"Long term, I would like to become well known, just like everyone else in this business wants. That's something I'll continue to work hard at, to improve both as a driver and a trainer, to grow my stable and to get some good horses to work with. For being 18, I'm on my own, have my own barn and my own truck and trailer, so I'm happy with how things have gone. But I know that there is still a lot of work to be done."

And not just at the racetrack.

Dunning's day is far from over after the horses cross the wire in the final race of the night.

"You still have plenty to do, to make sure the horses are properly taken care of. Whether that's their bandages or medicine, you need to take care of them. You have to stay on that program and sometimes it can be hard, especially when you come home around two or three in the morning. But that's been my biggest thing... even if I come home and I'm dead tired, I still go to the barn and make sure everything is done so that they are okay. If I didn't do that, I wouldn't be able to go to sleep."

Dunning has plenty of reason to wake up happy each day, including the backing he's been getting from those who put the horses in his barn.

A winning attitude and an unwavering commitment to his job and to the horses has caught the eye of a few owners.

"I've been very lucky to have some owners who believe in me and want to help me grow. Dante, who I had my first training win for, he's trying to help me grow. He's very supportive and it's nice to have someone like that on your side."

While the days of filling up a tiny wheelbarrow at his father's barn are long gone, Dunning's connection to the racing world is as strong as it has ever been, his dreams for long-term success front of mind.

And as for those moments cleaning out stalls as wide-eyed youngster, it's almost as though he never left.

"Ever since those times when I was a kid pushing that wheel-barrow and holding that pitchfork, I've been at the barn almost every day. It's where I've always wanted to be."







Blackflash Bar disarmed Gocciadoro's duo

Alessandro Gocciadoro had two top trotters behind the gate when the \$370,000 Gran Premio Unione Europea was held in Modena, Italy on Sunday (Nov. 21) afternoon, but neither leader Bepi Bi nor first over trotter Bengurion Jet could defend themselves when **Blackflash Bar** (Oropuro Jet) attacked from second over paired with driver Santo Mollo.

Blackflash Bar finished strongly over Modena's home stretch and the Fausto Barelli trained mare claimed the victory in a mile rate of 1:58 over 1.3 miles.

Bepi Bi held to second place ahead of stable mate Bengurion Jet.

The Italian "B-crop", the 4-year-olds, is strong, which horses like Bepi Bi and Bengurion Jet proved earlier during the season and Blackflash Bar belongs in the top of the crop as well. She was runner up in last year's Italian Derby, beaten by Bleff Dipa, and she has claimed three Group 1 wins in her career.

Easy for Face Time Bourbon

The 2021 edition of the \$125,000 Prix de Bretagne, the first out of four "B-races" ahead of Prix d'Amérique in January, suggested that the two-time winner Face Time Bourbon (Ready Cash) has a huge chance to claim his third consecutive win in one of the world's greatest races for trotters.

Sébastien Guarato's 6-year-old was just outstanding in Sunday's (Nov. 21) race at Vincennes and driver Eric Raffin acted like he had the best horse in the field.

A safe start was followed by a three-wide attack as Vincennes' track goes downhill after the wire post, with a little less than two kilometers to go in the 2,700 meters long race.

Face Time Bourbon hit the lead shortly after and at that point, the Prix de Bretagne was over, at least regarding who would win. But there were three spots in Prix d'Amérique at stake in the B-races and early leader and runner-up Etonnant, along with Jean-Michel Bazire's 5-year-old Ganay de Banville, who finished third, secured their spots in the Prix d'Amerique.


Face Time Bourbon more or less jogged his 1:54.4 (mile rate) win over 1.6 miles and it's hard to see that there are any horses in Europe that can threaten him in his chase for the third consecutive victory in Prix d'Amérique.

Remembering Phil Pinkney

A celebration of the life of the legendary horseman was held Saturday.

The black-trimmed green and gold driving colours. The impeccably-turned out horses — often colts and fillies on their way to big-time success. The friendly smile. The unparalleled skill, described last weekend by another top developer of young horses, Clare MacDonald: "You would never know Phil was in the race, until he went past you and was going to the winner's circle."

There was only one Philip Richard Pinkney.

A celebration of his life was held in Truro, NS, one week after the 84-year-old horseman's Nov. 13 passing. Phil Pinkney was born on May 24, 1937 in South Ohio, NS, into a family with an affinity for horses: father Kirk was a trainer/driver who initially worked with draft horses; his older brother Dave was inducted to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame as a trainer/driver in 2001.



Phil began his racing career as a young teen at Truro Raceway, helping in the Belbo Gould and Harley Harrison stables, then setting out on his own at age 17.

In Paul Murphy's 2014 book Horse Power: Behind the Gate Returns, Pinkney remembered his first drive, winning with mare Jenny Belfast: "It was around 2:18 at the Truro Raceway."

He said he studied future Canadian Hall of Famer Johnny Conroy: "As a horseman, he had it all."

Pinkney would end his driving days at the Bible Hill, NS track on Sept. 10, 2015, in the sulky behind Arizona Bucks. Woodmere Nora was the last horse officially trained by Phil, but his influence continued beyond 2019 and continues today, with protégés such as Paul Langille, Darren Crowe, and Ben Hollingsworth, as well as Brent MacGrath, who spoke at Pinkney's memorial gathering Saturday (Nov. 20).

Local sports columnist Lyle Carter addressed the gathering first, sharing family stories and memories from the local racing

colony. He read a letter from horseman Barry Whidden, describing what Phil Pinkney was like to work with: "At 80 years of age, Phil would still shoe the odd horse. When he finished, he would beat on his chest and say, 'I'm some tough, as hard as a rock!' Anyone who knew Phil couldn't argue with that. When Phil was getting a young horse ready to go out to train or jog, I saw times when he was 30 or 40 minutes getting the horse out of the barn. I would say, 'Come on Phil, you're tying up the floor.' Phil would reply, 'Stay cool, Barry!'"

MacGrath spoke next, sharing details about his 50-year history with Phil Pinkney. At age 14, he was mucking stalls at Truro when he noticed an impressive-looking horse trailer outside, ventured over and met Pinkney, who became a lifelong friend, in addition to occasional employer, employee, and partner on horses. "It didn't take long after that day for me to realize Phil's set-up was a little bit different than most," said MacGrath. "He did things differently."

Phil was known for his quiet, gentle way with young horses.

"Fall was a very exciting time of year in the Pinkney Stable, for buying yearlings and getting them going, trying to win races next summer, and dreaming about next year's champions," recalled MacGrath. "For the next 40 years [after Pinkney began working with yearlings], there would be very few horses trained and driven by Phil that were not competing at the highest level in the Atlantic Sires Stakes program... How lucky was I to learn from a guy like Phil?

"Over the years, I've watched Phil take a high-strung, nervous horse and turn him into a confident, happy, good-feeling colt. As Dale [Phil's son] will attest, he did some of his best work in the stalls, alone with the colts, picking their stalls out and straightening them up, getting to know them, building the trust with the young horses that had just come out of the field."

Phil and son Dale developed and campaigned Rumpus Hanover

(p,2, T1:52.3m; \$721,993), a former world champion who in 1986 set a new standard for 2-year-old pacing colts at The Red Mile. But there were many standouts in his lengthy career, such as 1986 Gold Cup and Saucer winner Rev Your Engine (p, 3, 1:56.2f; \$123,468), three-time Atlantic Canadian Horse of the Year Dunachton Gale (p, 6, 1:53.1h; \$177,016), and Deep Finesse (p, 6, 1:49.3f; \$236,016), North America's winningest 2-year-old of 2008, all leading up to Phil Pinkney's 2008 O'Brien Award of Horsemanship.

"Whether you leaned on him or not, you probably watched him very closely on the track," said MacGrath. "He would change equipment on horses between trips, but if he didn't see a noticeable improvement, he would change it back and start again. There were very few horses that he did not get figured out. It did make for some long training days, especially if there was shoeing involved in the changes."

Remembering Pinkney's kind and generous spirit, it was easy to let his statistical accomplishments remain in the background. MacGrath ensured they did not: "Phil had about 5,500 races in his lifetime [as a driver]. He won 1,700 of them. That's 30 per cent, 30.2 to be exact, in his lifetime. As an average, it's unbelievable. More unbelievable than that is his UDRS... Phil's average for his lifetime is .440. In 2004-2010, that seven-year stretch, Phil's UDRS or batting average, whatever you want to call it, was an unbelievable .533."

Near the end of Saturday's gathering, MacGrath passed along some of Pinkney's familiar advice: "Stay cool. Don't get too up on a good day, and don't get too down on a bad one. Always let your horse do the talking. Pay attention to your horse: When they're having an off day, recognize it. Make it always about the horse."

Words to live by, from a horseman who did.





A few pushes off the fence

He gazed through the passenger window, watching leaves skitter across the berm of the blacktop. Without turning his head, he asked, "Did you ever see a therapist?"

"Once, as in a single, one-hour session."

"And?"

"My health insurance deductible clock got reset. Paying out of pocket was a stretch. Besides, I found my therapist quite nosy."

He looked my way and smiled. "I did a year. It was interesting. Dr. Marie Lucas, my therapist, constantly pushed me to find an activity where I could lose myself. She tried to get me involved in the world outside of work. She advocated that passions and hobbies are great outlets for escape, personal expression, and distraction. You found harness racing. I never found anything serious."

"Phew, that was a little wordy, but I know what you mean. A lot of people sit on the couch, doing the same old, same old."

He ran his hand through his salt and pepper chin stubble, "Some of us are passive by nature. Others are active. Humans are complicated."

I took a few seconds and said, "I know at least six people who sort of enjoy harness racing, folks who have disposable income they will take to the grave. They seem to walk up to the line of getting involved and then find reasons not to cross that line."

He said, "I'm one of those people. I enjoy listening to your horse rantings. Several times I have considered buying a few yearlings or gambling on races, but for some unknown reason, I never do it, I never commit."

"Dude, I wish everyone knew the joy of finding a passion. It doesn't have to be my passion. Any *activity*, hobby, outlet, or creative endeavor can do the trick and can be magic."

My therapist agrees with you. She said the right passion could change how a person views themself and can be good for physical and mental health. But Trey, for some of us, it's difficult psychologically to allow ourselves to dive into new territory."

"And you never did?"

"Not really. I bought a few rare books, scratched the surface. But all along, it felt like I was pretending, you know, forcing it."

I nodded. "My thinking is that some individuals are afraid to make fools of themselves. They overthink things. To get into the zone, you have got to stick your neck out and get into unknown waters, sort of abandon common sense, whatever common sense means."

"During our sessions, Dr. Lucas gave me specific tips for finding a new passion or at least reconnecting to an old passion. I don't

remember all of her suggestions, but I remember a few."

"Like what?"

"One suggestion was that whatever I chose to try, I should do it daily, regularly, make it a habit. I was supposed to block out an hour each day to think about a subject and allow my unconscious to kick in. Even without a detailed plan, creativity will kick in. She told me to close my eyes or stare at an image on the computer but stay in the lane of my potential passion until something pops up. Then follow that something and don't let regular life get in the way."

I said, "Nah. To me, when your therapist suggested that you make yourself do something, it seems like forcing the issue, like having a job to finish. The mindset should be you don't want to stop."

His voice grew louder. "That IS the mindset of people who are easily engaged. She was talking about ways to REACH that point. She also suggested it is easier to get over the hump by engaging in the chosen activity with people who either love the activity or are at your level of learning the activity. Having a partner can reinforce motivation."

I shook my head. "Meh, make time, make friends. Those sound lame."

"You might like this one, and it might work in your sport. Dr. Lucas said that some people are motivated by competition. For horse racing, it could be setting specific targets. Buy a yearling and turn a profit. Bankroll a monthly amount to wager on races and try to turn a profit. Buy a broodmare and try to sell a yearling for a profit. These sorts of goals are specific prompts that give people focus, particularly introverted people."

I flashed him a thumbs up, "Now, that one I like."

"She had other suggestions, like take a class."

"Another, meh."

"Here's a weird one I remember. One suggestion was to choose a project that incorporates positive childhood memories. As a kid, I enjoyed reading, especially history. That's the reason I gave a half-hearted attempt at book collecting."

I nodded, "Memoires, interesting. One of my favorite childhood memories was going to the racetrack with my grandparents, running around collecting tossed tickets from the dirty apron of the racetrack. It sounds gross now, but I loved filling popcorn boxes with those tickets. Maybe that factors into my harness racing affliction."

"Possibly, the mind is a strange thing, especially yours."

"Hey, you're the subject on the table. I found my thing. We are looking for yours."

"Yeah, you're right. I need to find something – anything – and make it mine. I need to find the magic, to live it, breathe it, and go to sleep thinking about it."

"Heck yeah. Step into the waters of the obsessed. Step today, step fast, and don't overthink things. You will find that making a fool of yourself is great therapy."

Hollywood Dayton to enhance purses in a unique way during December

Hollywood Dayton Raceway has announced a unique method of boosting purses for the month of December, the final month of the track's annual fall-winter meet.

Every normal class that was offered in November will get a one-time opportunity to race for more money in the closing weeks. On the day designated for each individual class, the purse will be enhanced by 20 per cent if enough enter to fill the race. Those races that attract 16 or more entries will be split into divisions with the top finishers returning for a mini-series final for double the normal purse the following week. In the event that more than 10 and fewer than 16 enter a class the normal Ohio preference rules will be enforced.

A total of 55 potential mini-series will be offered, including races for 'green' horses, condition races from N/W \$1000 last 4 starts to Opens and the full range of claiming classes. Claimers who have raced in the same class (or 1 class lower) in their last two starts will not carry claiming tags in a mini-series that splits into divisions. Horses dropping down in claiming class will have to carry a tag.

A complete list of the specific December dates that each potential mini-series are offered is posted in the paddock, available in the race office, and will be available soon on both the OHHA

and Hollywood Dayton websites.

"There were a number of days this year that we were not able to meet our business model, which calls for 14 races with full fields on a daily basis," said race secretary Gregg Keidel. "That left us with a surplus in the purse account. After consultation with the OHHA and its track director, we arrived at this plan to distribute the excess funds to as many owners as possible."
