That said will someone please explain to me why Woodbine's thoroughbred track is closed (Note: Woodbine Mohawk Park and other Canadian harness tracks remain open)?

That move is a senseless over-reaction to the pandemic. Eliminating patrons is a given due to the rise in positives in the area, but to discontinue the sport is over the top.

True, I am almost 2,000 miles away but nothing I have read has said anything about a rise in positives in the Canadian racing colony. Nor have I heard of any racetracks having outbreaks of the virus. If I am missing something I am sorry for this piece if I am not shame on the powers that be for curtailing the livelihood of my fellow horseman.

I must give Jim Lawson, CEO of Woodbine Entertainment credit for his comments about the shutdown. He was oh so politically correct in pointing out that the sport had the cleanest of records in respect to the virus and, as he stated for future reference, the decision will have a terrible effect on the income of the horseman. He was not at all harsh with the government's policy decision to put the city of Toronto into lockdown (Woodbine Mohawk Park is located outside of Toronto city limits in Milton) due to the majority of Ontario's COVID-19 cases coming from that region, but in no way was going to capitulate to their thinking.

If you read between the lines it seems like he was giving the government an out to reverse the decision if it is at all possible.



Manchego was in an awful funk in August and September. That said, Princess Takter immediately righted the ship and she finished the year in grand style. Last Saturday she followed Atlanta off very pedestrian fractions (half in :57) and crushed her in the lane.

Two of the greatest trotting mares in the history of the sport both with amazing careers, to this writer there should be no loser in the older trotting mare division. I suggest the USHWA votes unanimously to give this year's addition a draw.

I think Debbie's mistake is that she is relying too much on statistics. With two horses that close you must step back from the numbers and review the entire season. Atlanta was magnificent in the Maple Leaf Trot, Manchego's last two — the Breeders Crown and the TVG Final — were perfection.

winner I think Manchego's year-end flurry is worthy of the honor. However, there is a downside to this decision. The tables may have possibly been reversed had Atlanta's connections decided to race in the Crown for trotting mares instead of trying to tackle the boys. Unfortunately I cannot make suggestions as to whom you should approach for fear of recriminations. That said, you have a myriad of choices.


As far as barn help is concerned it gets tougher every year. The best outfits with all their perks even struggle to get good help so that leaves a newbie like yourself in a bad place. If I were in your shoes I would simply over pay someone to help you out for a few years till you had the self-confidence to tackle the problems by yourself.

I don't know exactly where you train but it would be far easier to get good advice stabling at the racetrack than on a farm. At The Meadows there must be a dozen good trainers that would be willing to go a fast trip for you. Plus, you have qualifying days where you can get a top driver to train a mile for you before the races or school after the races. Starting out as a veterinarian you are much further ahead of the curve than you realize.

Ideas that harness racing can consider lifting from the thoroughbred sport

My esteemed HRU colleague, The Guru, led off his column a couple of weeks ago by discussing the disparities of big money at sales between our sport and in the thoroughbred game (full story here). I wouldn't say that The Guru's comparison of future thoroughbred Hall of Famer Monomoy Girl to harness racing's Sister Sledge to illustrate was exactly an apples to apples comparison, but I understood his point.

There are certainly clear differences between the sports, though at the same time there are things that harness racing can take from its thoroughbred counterpart to potentially better itself. Here are some that came to mind.

From a purse structure standpoint, there is a high premium on winning in the thoroughbreds. The drop-off in purse monies from winning a race to finishing second is a far greater disparity than the difference in harness racing. Whereas harness racing purses allocate 50 per cent to the winner and 25 per cent to second, purses in thoroughbred racing typically allocate 60 per cent towards the winner and 20 per cent or even less for second. On the other hand, purses in harness racing only pay out through fifth, but in the thoroughbreds all starters in a race at least will earn something, usually a few hundred dollars. From an owner's perspective I could see a case for both sides, but there's also a case to be made that the top-heavy purse structure would benefit the actual racing in harness racing.

By putting an even greater emphasis on finishing first, wouldn't that make the actual racing in harness racing livelier? There's always discussion as to what harness racing can do to improve the flow of races, the competitiveness and overall make for a better product. We talk about if we should have passing lanes or not and how the flow of races should have to go, but wouldn't all of that take care of itself if horses had to win in order to get the lion's share of these purses? Instead of conservative tries where drivers go into the race content with a third or fourth, would it spawn a more aggressive style of racing knowing how much more in value a win is proportional to any other placing? Intuitively, it seems like something that would help.

Another key difference that comes to mind is the availability of information. Admittedly, this is something that can be improved in both sports, but even with that said, the thoroughbred industry is far ahead of the harness industry in terms of readily available data that is offered at no cost. And I say this knowing that the United States Trotting Association has made strides in recent years as to what statistical information is made publicly available at no cost, but the reality is as follows: I can go to the Equibase website at this moment and search for data on any thoroughbred horse in history. And I can see full detail for a horse that just raced a few moments ago, or I can see full detail for Seabiscuit. The data on Equibase includes lifetime career results, including lifetime race charts complete with footnotes, as well as comprehensive sales history. And it's all entirely free.

In harness racing, much of this same information can be obtained through the USTA's Pathway or through Standardbred Canada's TrackIt, but it comes at a price. Even to look up the most basic of information on a horse costs something. Maybe it's just me, but if I were interested as a potential owner and was trying to gather information on a horse I was looking to claim or acquire, it seems like repeated paywalls would be a deterrent to entering the sport. It just makes things more difficult than it needs to be, and common sense should tell you that the easier it is to obtain information, the more consumer engagement it will bring.

Interestingly, on the sales front, the two sports actually had some similarities in this fall's largest respective yearling sales. With 773 yearlings sold at Standardbred Horse Sales Company's pandemic-effected sale being the lowest in at least the last 20 years, the 2,346 yearling thoroughbreds sold at Keeneland in September were also the lowest in at least the last 20 years. The two industries navigated the COVID-era sales as well as possible and tracked similarly, relatively speaking. And in 2019, harness racing reached a milestone with having not one, but two yearlings go over the \$1 million sale price; something that traditionally is far more common at the thoroughbred yearling sales (Keeneland had 15 seven-figure horses this year alone).

Lastly, with yesterday being Thanksgiving, I think that harness racing missed an opportunity with the absence of racing at all U.S. tracks (Canada which celebrates its Thanksgiving in October, had four tracks going, including Woodbine Mohawk Park). Even if it was only one U.S. track in a sport that traditionally doesn't race on the U.S. holiday, I remember being young and watching Monticello race – how's that for a fond childhood memory? But in recent years, even Monticello has ceased to race on the holiday. Meanwhile, thoroughbred tracks including Churchill Downs, Del Mar, the Fair Grounds and Laurel Park all raced and generated decent handle. Maybe handle in harness racing isn't of paramount concern, but even if it were seeing trotters come home in 2:02, there's something unique about racing on Thanksgiving.











To say it's been a challenging year is an understatement, but, as with every challenge, our industry steps up and we get through it together.

Incredible timing helped Todd McCarthy have instant success at the Meadowlands

Going into this weekend's racing, driver Todd McCarthy sits atop the Meadowlands' Fall Meet standings with 30 wins.

Not bad for the expat whose first drive at the mile oval was on Sept. 11.

McCarthy is not the first driver to come to the Meadowlands and make their presence felt, but to do it so fast may be a first.

Both Brian Sears and Tim Tetrick rose to the top at the Big M quickly, but unlike McCarthy, they had been established elsewhere in the U.S. before going there.

McCarthy had been thinking about trying things in the U.S. for a while when he visited North America in 2019 to see his brother Andy race in the Breeders Crown at Woodbine at Mohawk Park.

"I think seeing the success that [Andy] had there was obviously a big push for me to make the move," Todd said. "For me it was pretty awesome to be there on that night. It was definitely motivating for me to get over."

Todd arrived Stateside at the end of August, somewhat delayed by COVID-19.

"I sort of started the process with my visa before corona hit and I kind of had my heart set on being able to come over

this year," Todd said. "I would have liked to have been over a little earlier in the year, but obviously things got slowed down. Really, I was probably pretty lucky in hindsight that I only got pushed back a few months."

Todd, 27, arrived with a resume that included winning the 2018 Inter Dominion and being the top driver at Menangle Racetrack in Sydney for five years, but now he was going to be taking on the big boys at the mecca of harness racing.

"As a kid growing up, you think of the Meadowlands, that for me has always been the pinnacle of harness racing, so to be able to get there and actually have a few drives, it was pretty surreal," Todd said. "And not long after, I had a few winners come with it, so it was an amazing start for me in North America."

He was shutout on his first night at the Meadowlands, but the next night he made some noise winning four of the 13 races.

"I got to drive qualifiers [on Sept. 5 and 12] first so that was good to get a feel for the track," he said. "I've got to say, since being here in America, it's been my favorite track to race at, The Meadowlands. I love going there every Friday and Saturday night.

"It might sound a little corny but I love getting there especially at night time and you can see New York City in the background," he added. "To me, it's a pretty special place to be racing horses."

Trainer Noel Daley has known Todd since he was a kid and thought the driver was something special the first time he saw him in the sulky.

"I said to a friend of mine, a very smart judge in the game, real early in the piece, 'You watch, this guy's going to be a top five or six driver within 12 months.' And he said 'No.' And I said, 'You watch.' "I'm happily surprised for him that it's happened this quick," Daley said. "That it happened, that didn't shock me at all."

Todd's win with the Daley-trained Anoka Hanover in the \$451,800 Goldsmith Maid for 2-year-old trotting fillies last Saturday night put the driver at the top of the Big M standings, one in front of Dexter Dunn, who won four stakes races on that same night.

"The most amazing part of it is [Todd] really hasn't driven young trotters before," Daley said. "He wouldn't have driven more than a handful tops of young trotters before he came here. And that's a pretty tough ask, trotting fillies."

Todd knows his U.S. experience so far has been exceptionally good, and he can't thank all the trainers — both expat and American — enough who have taken a chance on him.

"I do my best to make the most of every race and I hope it works out," Todd said. "I honestly thought when I came over here that I'd be picking up a drive here or there and I'd be doing it pretty tough there for a while. But I think just the timing, the way that things worked out, was that Andy was away and he was able to recommend me and at the same time there was also a handful of

great drivers that were away for stakes races and I probably just arrived at the best possible time that I could have."

Todd said the most important thing he's learned about racing at the Meadowlands is patience.

"Learning to just feel like you've got a little more time, sometimes," he said. "You see great drivers and they seem like they've got all day to make decisions on the racetrack. In my eyes, I think that's a pretty great asset to have on your side."

Todd was fortunate enough to secure a visa that will allow him to stay in the U.S. for a few years and would be extendable if necessary.

"It was a good head start for me where I didn't have to worry about going home any time soon," Todd said. "My plan is to stay. I'm really enjoying it at the moment and there's nowhere else I'd rather be."

He has never celebrated Thanksgiving before, but the timing couldn't be better since he truly has so much to be thankful for.













Rising star Austin Sorrie approaches every race in Ontario trying to put horses in the best position to win

Austin Sorrie had several thoughts racing through his mind as the finish line drew ever closer.

It was just over a year ago on a cold early December night at Woodbine Mohawk Park when the young driver from Montague, PEI and a bay son of Bettors Delight began to draw away from their rivals as the field turned for home.

Holding a 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ -length lead at the stretch call, Sorrie, in rein to Bugsy Maguire, had watched this scene unfold countless times.

Only this time, he wasn't watching the races.

"I would see the races from Mohawk, and I always remember how many times I'd watch a horse on a fairly comfortable lead get collared late and end up finishing second," said the 21-year-old. "I saw that happen a lot."

When Bugsy Maguire started to widen his advantage that evening at Mohawk, Sorrie started having a conversation of sorts as they got close to the infield tote board.

A pep talk would be a more accurate take.

"All I was thinking about was watching all those races at Mohawk, and you'd see a horse get away on the field, but then someone would pick them off late. In my head, I was saying, 'We've got to get there, we've got to get there.' That was running through my head. I was thinking, 'Where's this line at?'"

The answer was 1:52.2 from when the duo started and where they ended, three lengths clear of their closest rival.

Owned by Walter Simmons of Summerside, PEI, Bugsy Maguire had already delivered Sorrie with a memorable score earlier in 2019 when they partnered to win the Birthplace of Confederation final in August at Red Shores Charlottetown.

Four months later, it was picture time again.

"When you looked at the program at Mohawk, the stats said he was likely third best in the race. I was hoping to finish second or third in my first start there. That's all I

wanted to do. I got away in the two-hole, and at the top of the stretch, I popped him out. He was wanting to go, so I just let him go. And he just flew home.

"I always dreamed about winning Mohawk. I was nervous the first night there, driving against the guys you always hoped you'd have the chance to race against. The guys congratulated me for getting my first win in my first start there. And I got a bunch of text calls from back home too. It was just a great night all around."

That was one of 80 wins on the campaign for Sorrie, up from the 32 victories he had posted in 2018.

Despite the COVID-19-related challenges in 2020, the reinsman has soared past the numbers he put up last year.

Starts, wins, purse earnings – Sorrie has continued to show the promise he displayed in his rookie season.

That said, the soft-spoken horseman isn't touting his solid year.

He pauses momentarily, trying to find a particular highlight from 2020.

"It's been a quiet year. But I still try and push for the goals I set. That's what I always do. I'll set goals and keep pushing until I get there. And if I don't, then it just makes me that much more hungry the next year."

A finalist for the 2019 Rising Star Award – the honor went to Dave Kelly – Sorrie headed west from the vibrant PEI racing scene to the bright lights of the Ontario circuit nearly two years ago.

At the age of 14, he piloted Onehotvett to a 1:57.2 score in The Kilted Race, Pinette Raceway's signature event. His win came at Red Shores (Charlottetown) with his own Thebestofme (2:02:1) in May 2018.

These days, competing mainly at Western Fair and Flamboro, Sorrie, whose driver colours are blue, yellow and white (his father, Wade, wore blue and yellow during his years in the sulky), is eager to add more experience and more wins before the end of the year and well beyond.

He has plenty of support, from trainers to Ontario, to his own personal cheering section back home.

"I'm grateful for both," said Sorrie, who has over 50 victories as a trainer. "The people back in PEI, having them in my corner means a lot. That's where I started out. To have people still follow you... that's pretty cool. You look back to those days and everyone that was rooting for you and that they are still doing it."

Sorrie certainly hasn't forgotten his roots, and he definitely hasn't forgotten the words of the highly-respected PEI horseman Walter Cheverie.

"He told me, 'Time only matters in jail.' You can look over a program 15 different ways and your horse only shows it can go two minutes, but in Walter's words, 'That doesn't mean

anything.' And that's the way I approach every race. You try and put yourself in the best situation to win every time. It doesn't matter if you're 100-1 or 1-1, if you are in that spot, and you put your horse in the best position, the horse will give you everything."

That's very much how Sorrie views his role.

With over 1,000 starts to his name this year, he's not looking for any down time or a few days off.

If he had his way, he'd be driving nearly every day, with the odd summer day spent in the great outdoors.

"In the summer, we do some boating and Sea-Doing. I love the water. But in the winter, it's more or less about just staying warm. When you go seven days a week, it's hard to get time off in the winter, but that's just fine with me."

As for what he'd like to achieve on the racetrack for the rest of 2020, Sorrie would simply like to have the opportunity to line horses up behind the gate and chase more trips to the winner's circle.

After all, sitting behind pacers and trotters is exactly where he's always wanted to be.

"I just hope we keep racing, to tell you the truth. That would be the biggest thing. It's not a job if you love doing it. And in that sense, I don't have a job. When you dream of playing in the NHL and you get there, you don't see it as a job. That's how I view being a driver. I was really young when I knew what I wanted to be, maybe 10. That's all I thought of. I always looked forward to the day it would come true."

And Sorrie's never looked back since.











Diable de Vauvert wins \$112,700 Prix de Bretagne by a nose

The road towards the 2021 Prix d'Amérique took its first serious start at Vincennes racetrack on Sunday afternoon (Nov 21) when the \$112,700 Prix de Bretagne was held. It was the first out of four B-races ahead of the Prix d'Amérique in January.

As usual, many of the more merited trotters are participating, making the four B-races spectacular to watch. Trainers and drivers are aiming to have their horses peak for Sunday, Jan. 31 when the biggest trophy in European trotting is at stake.

Sunday's Prix de Bretagne was a spectacular show in many respects, not the least of which because of the thrilling finish when, it seemed, half the field fought for a top three place which would have guaranteed them a spot in the 2021 Prix d'Amérique.

Jean-Michel Bazire sat behind the first choice Valzer di Poggio and the duo aimed for the front position at an quite early stage since driver Pierre Vercruysse was happy to give his Drole de Jet a pocket trip over the 1.6 miles long distance.

Valzer di Poggio still had control of the race when the field turned for home, but the leader's gait became worse at the stretch, so when attacking opponents challenged seriously closer to the wire, the leader went off stride and was disqualified.

Tough mare Bahia Quesnot had a very strong race three wide during the event's last kilometer and she was close to the winner, beaten by less than a head as third. The horse that followed her three wide during the last turn, **Diable de Vauvert** (Prince d'Espace), paired with Gabriele Gelormini, was given full attack command at the top of the home stretch and the Bertrand Le Beller-trained 7-year-old colt came home in a mile rate of 1:57.1.

Philippe Allaire's Feliciano finished quickly between horses and was a nose behind the winner when the wire was crossed.

The 2020 divisional equine awards will be announced virtually, as will an abbreviated roster of human awards. In addition, USHWA will hold their directors and general membership meeting exclusively online.

The determination was made through a unanimous vote of USHWA's executive board and president's advisory committee.

"This has been an extremely challenging year for everyone and health was our priority in making the decision to cancel the 2021 Dan Patch Awards Banquet," said Kimberly Rinker, USHWA president. "USHWA's executive and presidential advisory teams have worked diligently to ensure that the Dan Patch Awards will continue in 2022 and beyond."

As well, there will be no Dan Patch Awards Journal in 2021 and USHWA will not be soliciting advertising or sponsorships.

"We are eternally grateful for the years of advertising and sponsorship support by so many in the harness racing industry," Rinker said. "USHWA relies on these monies to put on a first-class event in the Dan Patch Awards Banquet. I think people are tired and frustrated by the events of the past year and they need a break. When things return to normal, I'm confident that those folks who have supported USHWA in the past will continue their support."

Tetrick and George awarded top accolades at close of Harrah's Hoosier Park's 2020 meet

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino closed the curtain on its 27th season of live harness racing on Saturday (Nov. 21). In conjunction with a dynamic 14-race card, the leading driver and leading trainer honors were awarded. Driver Trace Tetrick took home his ninth leading driver title and trainer Tyler George broke through a competitive group to take home his first title.

Tetrick seemed to have his sights set on the leading driver honors as soon as the 2020 meet kicked off, spending the rest of the season bolstering his lead on his competitors to earn 273 seasonal wins in his 1,311 starts. As it has been in seasons past, the top 3 drivers consisted of Tetrick, Sam Widger and John DeLong. Widger held the silver title with 165 wins from 1202 starts while DeLong took third with 145 wins from 1096 starts.

Taking home his seventh consecutive leading driver title, Tetrick currently resides in fifth place for top drivers nationwide with his 386 this season. Since 2008, the Illinois native has continually earned over \$2 million a season, contributing to those lifetime earnings of \$61,086,842. Tetrick has driven three Breeders Crown victors, sitting behind Freaky Feet Pete in 2015, as well as Blazin Britches and Fiftydallarbill in 2017.


"Getting to come in and drive great horses for great trainers and owners makes my job fun," Tetrick said in the winner's circle. "I just remember that every night's a new night and it's important to come back fresh the next day. It's a privilege to get to race here in such a great environment."

When asked what goals he has set for himself? "I am already looking toward that 10th title," he said.

In years past, Jamie Macomber and Jeff Cullipher owned the battle for the leading trainer title but after a hallmark season, Tyler George bested the two with his 70 wins from 233 starts. Macomber and Cullipher tied for second with 60 wins each.

While George has been training since 2004, he began consistently bringing in over \$1 million in yearly earnings in 2016. The Ohio native is no stranger to the Indiana Sires Stakes circuit, training horses like Golden Paradise and Always A Prince. While 2020's earnings sat just under 1 million at \$932,957, George has had a standout year earning a 30% win clip as well as recording his 1000th training win at Hoosier Park in September.

"I feel like this is such an accomplishment," George said.



"This is a very competitive track to race, so I'm grateful to have such a great team who puts all their time and effort into the game. I'm very proud to have earned this title."

Ohio Breeder's Awards deadline fast approaching

The registration for mares bred in 2020 to be eligible for Ohio Breeder's Awards must be postmarked by Nov. 30. Registrations received with post marks after Nov. 30 will be charged a late fee.

To be eligible for Breeder's Awards, mares must be bred to an Ohio standardbred stallion, must foal in Ohio and remain in Ohio for 187 consecutive days in the year of foaling, all owners of the mare must be Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association members and new forms must be completed each year that the mare is bred.
