


Tidbits: The amazing program put on by the Meadowlands last Saturday night certainly didn't disappoint. The problem with the timing of my column and Saturday night racing is that by the time you read Ask The Guru, last Saturday is old news. So, reviewing the winners is a waste of time, but I will throw in some comments. On the positive side, Bret Pelling has returned to our shores with the same talent he left with. I don't think he has lost a step. Ake Svanstedt at age 61 is setting the world on fire, Yannick Gingras did his usual big night thing and the two Andy's, McCarthy and Miller, as they normal do, put themselves in the right place at the right time.

On the negative side, I think we are racing our horses too much. In the eight stakes races Saturday five big favorites went down to defeat, all arguably the best of their divisions a month ago. We are definitely going too fast too often. It was 43 degrees and the track was downgraded to good with a -1 variant and the pacing mares went in 1:48 — crazy.

of second the entire year and was 19 13-6-0 with \$1,650,000. He was second Saturday against older horses after a brutal trip.

I studied the top horses carefully and the only one that were in the mix were Shartin N who dominated a very mediocre group, and Papi Rob Hanover who could have gotten the vote if he wasn't DQ'd in the Breeders Crown.

Greg Gangle (Racing Manager, The Raceway at Western Fair District) asks: How do you think the Down Under mares will do in the American breeding shed, and at the sales?

I personally am a lover of distant outcrosses. We have seen, of late, American trotting mares bred to European stallions with great success. International Moni, a son of the great Moni Maker is by Love You a European stallion. International Moni was a top stakes horse in the U.S. and with better racing luck may well have won the Hambletonian. He stands stud at Hanover Shoe Farm. There are also some sons of Ready Cash, also a stallion from the continent ,doing good things on the Grand Circuit. Ready For Moni was a game second in the Valley Victory Saturday night at the Meadowlands pushing his 2-year-old earnings to nearly \$300,000.

Delicious, the good trotting filly I exported to Sweden, broke records all over Europe. She is by Cantab Hall out of Ipsara LB an Italian mare. Unfortunately, I paid little attention to Down Under broodmares, but I will tell you one thing for sure, I would love to be selling a Captaintreacherous colt out of Shartin N in the near future.

The sample as of this writing is too small to make a positive assessment but I would definitely take a chance if I liked the individual.

As for sales, the foreign pedigree will definitely hurt unless it's the first or second foal of a great race mare.

John Deters asks: Do you ever hear of any discussion of having the Breeders Crown at the Red Mile?

To Lexington addicts like myself and many others this would be a dream come true, but there are so many things to take into consideration, the biggest of which is money.

If we could solve that problem, the logistics are also tough. It means sending a horse with your caretakers and trainers to a place that is, for the most part, seven to 11 hours away for another three weeks — or if you are already there for the

Grand Circuit, it would mean staying an additional period. The expenses would be a problem, but the reward of having the races earlier in the year and on a great racing surface would make much of the headaches go away.

I have heard other problems with the plan that included the weather being a factor as there is limited sheltered seating for an event of that magnitude and the clubhouse itself is too small for the food service and seating they would need.

After surveying the situation to the fullest I find that all the stumbling blocks can be overcome if the money was there and some have even told me the money could be there under the proper circumstances. The expense for the event itself is \$900,000 to the racetrack. That does not include any money for the onsite changes that are needed in order to make the patrons comfortable.

Could it be done? YES. Will it be done in the foreseeable future? Probably not in a year or two. But after speaking with the people that are the most important in this endeavor, my feeling is that down the road it will happen. There have been discussions about building a hotel on the property and if the antiquated clubhouse area becomes the attachment point of the hotel and the property, a major new dining room would be in the works. Trackside tents in the first turn are also a possibility. I could bore you to death with scenarios. Instead, I will just keep my fingers crossed.

Bob Stewart asks: Is there any validity to the story that Balmoral could reopen?

I got the question and immediately went to the best source I know for Chicago information, Eliot "Doc" Narotsky, who was director of racing for most of Illinois for the past 30 years.

It is a possibility, but lots must change for it to become reality.

The company that owns the property is more than willing to sell. However, there are two major obstacles. One, Balmoral is not in a county named in the gambling bill for an approved casino. This can be overturned, not easily, but it is possible. The second and most difficult situation to overcome is that when the forced sale of the property occurred there was a caveat that there could be no gambling on the grounds for a period of 10 years after the sale. would bring the possibility of a casino to the year 2026 which is a long time to wait while others are trying to secure a license to open in other areas. According to Doc the possibility does exist but there would have to be an almost perfect storm for it to succeed.

No one loved Illinois Racing more than I did and I might think of putting my colors back on if Illinois stakes returned.

Bob Marks asks: Did you look at hip #88 Take This Society (Muscle Hill—Thatsnotmyname) at Harrisburg? How did he compare to the siblings that recently sold?

Yes, I looked at him as well as his sister the previous year. He brought \$475,000 and she brought \$500,000 last year.

I think they were very comparable, but not worth anywhere near their selling prices. Both got high marks from me, but not nearly the highest. Obviously, the pedigree is impeccable, but my marks were less than the half-million dollar range. Remember \$500,000 today is the \$250,000 yearling of a few years ago. We are in the midst of a great horse inflation. When you can sell a stallion for \$14 million, the value of yearlings increases.

Concord sells a lot of high-profile horses and David Meirs told me that Take This Society was his favorite and I respect his opinion. If a colt like that has a big 2-year-old campaign, people will be knocking down the door to be in the winner's circle come Hambletonian time next year. One thing is certain, that if he doesn't have a great year Adam Bowden will be back next year to try again.

I will add that I found more minor faults in the colt than the filly, but I also thought he was the better gaited of the two.

I wish both Adam and SRF, the buyer of the filly, the best of luck on the racetrack. When you risk that kind of cash it's always good to reap reward.

Puzzling over why more wasn't bet on the TVG card

One of the things that's hard to figure is why doesn't the Fall Final 4 and TVG Finals card at the Meadowlands handle more than it does? Last Saturday's blockbuster card handled a few dollars short of \$2.7 million, which is still great compared to any other industry standard, but it should be doing an additional \$1 million based on what's being offered.

Sure, two of the bigger races weren't the least bit desirable from a betting standpoint, where Atlanta and Papi Rob Hanover were 1-9 favorites in their respective races, but handle for the 13-race card was consistent with what's been bet into the same card over the past two years. In 2018, the same card handled a tick higher at \$2.7 million and in 2017 handle was \$2.4 million.

Handle is up on the big cards compared to other racing nights throughout November, which are typically in the low \$2 million range, but by contrast, Saturday nights throughout the winter routinely top \$3 million. Aside from the TVG Mares Pace and the Governor's Cup, as referenced above, last Saturday's card was widely bet-able with nearly every other race running deep and competitive. If a bunch of lower level

overnight horses in the dead of winter can draw \$3+ million, why can't the sports very best horses come close that?

If anything, I'd think that the TVG races would help handle. By the end of the year, handicapping the same horses against each other can become stale, but that gets changed up a bit in the TVG. There were multiple races that included top 3-year-olds taking on older horses, and a female taking on open trotters in the case of Manchego versus Six Pack. Adding some variety is something that fans and bettors should embrace from a handicapping standpoint, but for whatever the reason it's not being reflected, yet, in what's actually being bet.

Total purses offered for the Saturday night card were slightly higher than the total amount bet, which is something you don't often see at the Meadowlands. It's puzzling for a card of that quality that deserves to be seen and bet.

On the racing side, Six Pack won the TVG Open on a fairly crafty drive by Svanstedt to beat the hottest horse in training, Manchego. With the win, Six Pack ends his 4-year-old season and retires with earnings just shy of \$2 million. I don't get the impression he'll go down in history as one of the all-time bests, but for a horse that hasn't been hyped up as some others, he's put together an awfully impressive resume these past couple seasons. There's only been seven trotting miles at 1:49:2 or faster, and last year's 3-year-old champion has two of them (1:49:1 in last year's Futurity and 1:49:2 this year). We'll be left wondering what could have been in last year's Hambletonian, but, overall, he's been an incredibly fast and honest horse that showed up to race in nearly every start.

Shartin is almost certain to be Horse of the Year, but it's interesting to note that Caviart Ally has now beaten her three out of the last five times they've raced. Looks like a

rivalry to watch for next year.

In the category of bad disqualifications, race 12 from the same card was one that I thought was genuinely bad. Like previous things I've said on the topic, the subjective nature at which horses can be disqualified is really something that should be looked at. In the race, Griffon Hanover (Zeron) sat second into the stretch behind race leader Mcthriller. Once in the straightaway, Zeron was looking for room to the inside with Griffon Hanover but didn't have clearance at first. In the process, head-on replays show that he did go inside one pylon. However, he never actually advanced forward to pass until he did have clearance, and from that point onwards he never went inside any pylons. Losing by a neck, he was disqualified to fourth where it was determined that the advantage he gained equated to being moved behind the third place finishing horse. There's some races where a horse goes inside three pylons on a turn and judges say that an advantage was not gained, but then there's a race like this one where a horse goes inside a pylon on a straightaway, waits, and then it's said that an advantage was gained. Some consistency would be welcomed.

At Yonkers, it's presumed that an all-time speed mark was broken earlier this week. On Monday night's conditioned race for N/W-4 or \$50k lifetime, 47-1 longshot Odds On Columbus blasted from post 8 and rolled through the half mile marker in a time of :52.1. Trained by Scott DiDomenico, the 3-year-old gelding with a career mark of 1:52.4 from a

qualifying mile, was up by eight lengths through a :25.4 first quarter and then expanded the lead to 12 lengths when he went to the half in :52.1 (only two-fifths off a second of what Somebeachsomewhere went in the Meadowlands Pace final and four-fifths off a second from a pumped up Devonshire Hanover's half at the Meadowlands in 2006). Predictably, he stopped shortly thereafter, but nothing comes to mind as there ever being a faster half-mile paced on a half-mile track.

The races that have the potential to produce a half-mile time this fast, such as the Little Brown Jug or the Battle of Lake Erie – none of them ever had a horse go that fast to the half. Odds On Columbus isn't a world champion, but his race will go down as an oddity on an otherwise typical Monday night.

The other big number from the week was the \$305,556 that Northfield Park handled in the mandatory payout Wednesday for its jackpot pick 6 wager. The \$305,556 was new money bet on top of the \$154,311 carryover heading into the mandatory payout sequence. The amount bet on the wager at Northfield was unprecedented for the track, and it continues to show that while rare, when bettors see advantageous situations they won't hesitate to put a lot of money into the races.

Significant hurdles to clear before Balmoral will rise again as a racetrack

Is Balmoral Park destined to be a born again racetrack?

Bankruptcy forced Balmoral out of business following its

2015 harness meeting when the Illinois Racing Board didn't award it 2016 dates.

HITS, Inc., a New York-based company, purchased the track and has been conducting hunter/jumper competition there since 2017. The deed prohibits pari-mutuel horse racing, casino gaming or any other type of gambling on the property until 2026.

But now HITS is under contract to sell the property to Team Real Estate Development, LLC., a firm headed by Chicago south suburban developer Phil Goldberg, whose plans call for the resumption of racing and the introduction of gaming.

"Balmoral Park is one of the crown jewels of Chicagoland, and our plans include returning it to its former glory and creating a premier sports, event and entertainment destination," Goldberg told the *Chicago Tribune*.

He has the support of State Representative Thaddeus Jones and Michael Einhorn, the president of the village of Crete where Balmoral is located.

Although the massive gaming expansion bill passed by the Illinois legislature and signed by Gov. J.B. Pritzger earlier this year calls for a new harness track/casino it stipulates that the racino must be located in any of six south suburban Cook County townships and Balmoral is in Will County.

According to the *Tribune*, Jones plans to make passage of legislation that would allow Balmoral to operate as a racino one of his highest priorities when the legislature reconvenes in January. Chicago Mayor Lori Lightfoot wants lawmakers to

revamp city and state taxes for a Chicago casino authorized by the expansion legislation and the newspaper quoted Jones as saying: "This (Balmoral racino) should be included in the broader package to give Chicago what they want."

State Senator Michael Hastings is strongly opposed to changing the law. "The racino should stay in the townships the original bill allocated for," he said.

In September, it seemed as though a new harness track that would be located in the village of Tinley Park was a done deal. Real estate developer and video gambling magnate Rick Heidner was planning to buy the former Tinley Park Mental Health Center and build a state-of-the-art racino and the Illinois Racing Board approved his application for a 2020 harness meeting from Dec. 6-29.

However, in October, when it was revealed that Heidner had business ties to a banking family with alleged organized crime connections, Governor Pritzger called off plans to sell the Mental Health Center to Tinley Park, which was going to sell it to Heidner, and the dates were revoked (full story here).

Heidner had bid \$1.8 million for Balmoral in 2016, but instead, the bankruptcy court and the state's four highest-earning casinos accepted a \$1.6 million bid by HITS. The casinos had a \$77.8 million judgement against Balmoral and its sister track, Maywood Park, after winning a lawsuit involving a racetrack impact fee connected with the corruption scandal that sent former Governor Rod Blagojevich to prison.

The 2016 closing of Balmoral and Maywood left the Chicago metropolitan area with only one harness venue, Hawthorne Race Course, where the standardbreds share time with the thoroughbreds on a seasonal basis.

The metropolitan area's other track is Arlington International Racecourse, which conducts thoroughbred racing from May through September while Hawthorne conducts harness racing. In 2020, Hawthorne also will hold harness racing in February, March and April rather than its traditional spring thoroughbred meeting to put construction of its casino on the fast track.

In 2021, Hawthorne president Tim Carey's plans call for resumption of the spring thoroughbed meeting, which would limit Chicago area harness racing to May through September.

In contrast to Heidner, who was partnering with Carey in the proposed Tinley Park track and was working with the support Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association (IHHA), Goldberg hasn't reached out to the horsemen. "The horsemen are open and interested in any opportunity to get back to racing year around," said IHHA executive director Tony Somone. "With only one racetrack right now — with Hawthorne being the only game in town — that's not possible.

"The IHHA worked very hard to get language into the bill that allowed a standardbred racetrack to be built. If Balmoral is to race again there are some extreme hurdles to get over. The language would have to be changed. Again, we are willing to work with the (Team Real Estate Development) people to make that happen. But there is also the existing constraint on gambling on that property for the next seven years. How do you get past that? And it's within 35 miles of Hawthorne (the statutory boundary for another racetrack) so that would have to be changed. These are all things that concern us.

"We'd like to know more about who is promoting this and who are the key players behind bringing Balmoral back to life. We're certainly interested, but there are some unanswered questions and so many moving parts, and information is not forthcoming. We need more facts before we jump in head first."

Racing Board Commissioner Tom McCauley said he also is in the dark.

An Internet search revealed that among the other projects that Goldberg's company is working on is putting a boutique Vib Hotel on property adjacent to Arlington International Racecourse.

"I find it intriguing that someone who apparently has had no involvement with Illinois racing heretofore suddenly has projects announced not only for Balmoral but also for a property adjacent to Arlington International," McCauley said when asked about the two developments.

"If anybody were going to resuscitate Balmoral it's a very complicated path with a lot of hurdles. Never mind that it says in the Balmoral deed that gaming shall be prohibited (until 2026). Balmoral is in Will County and the bill passed by the legislature stipulates a bill exclusively for harness racing in Cook County in one of six townships.

"I'm going to assume he knows what he's doing but it all seems very mysterious."

Shake That House upsets in Progress Pace

After working to catch cover up the far side, Shake That House (\$20.20) vaulted three-wide off the final turn to collar Captain Crunch in the \$335,000 Hap Hansen Progress Pace final for 3-year-old colts and geldings on Wednesday night (Nov. 27) at Dover Downs.

The sophomore son of American Ideal—Shake That Junk landed in sixth early while 3-5 favorite Captain Crunch (Yannick Gingras) worked to clear American Mercury (Tyler Buter) through a :26 first quarter. As Captain Crunch, who won last week's elimination heat, sped along through a :53.4 half, Tim Tetrick angled Shake That House third-over — but the pair lost their cover upon reaching the backstretch.

While the first-over Dancin Lou (Andy McCarthy) sustained gradual headway up the far side, the second-over Semi Tough (David Miller) angled back to the pegs upon straightening, forcing Shake That House to close a three-length gap in the outer tier into a 1:21 third split.

Despite the extra work he endured, Shake That House had ample energy to swing three-wide around a stalled Dancin Lou well above the eighth pole and tracked down Captain Crunch to prevail by a widening neck in 1:50.1. U S Captain (Dexter Dunn), who was locked in from mid-division, rallied up the open stretch to take third.

Shake That House, who also won the Max Hempt Memorial at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono in June, eclipsed the

\$500,000 mark in seasonal earnings with the 10th victory of his career. Chris Oakes trains Shake That House for Crawford Farms Racing, Alan Johnston and the Northfork Racing Stable.

Cinder Rock, Bebop On The Block take DSBF pacing finals

Fillies were swift out of the gate led by the favorite **Cinder Rock** (Rockabillie—Cinderella) from the start to the finish pulling away by 10 and ¾ lengths in 1:53.2 for driver Allan Davis, trainer Wayne Givens and owner Legacy Racing of DE, Inc. The breeder was Elam Esh of PA. Spin Sumthin was second followed by Emma in third.

The sixth race saw the freshmen colts and geldings led off from the gate by favorite American Nitro who was challenged at the three quarters by **Bebop On The Block** (Gambler's Dream—Seboomook Mao) who pulled away by 2 and ¾ lengths to win in 1:54.2. Down Under sensation Dexter Dunn was at the reins for trainer Josh Green and owners Debbie Cook and her son Brendan of Hartly, DE. The breeder was Garnet O'Marrow. American Nitro held for second followed by Undercovershamrock in the show position.

In the early non-wagering combined consolation it was the maiden colt **Bookin** (Tobago Cays—Page One) in 1:57.3 for driver Russell Foster and trainer Dennis Walls. He is owned

Davis was a founding member of the Meadows Standardbred Owners Association, writing its bylaws and serving as president and an officer for several years. His connections as a shareholder in a Pittsburgh cable television company paved the way for the Meadows Racing Network programming.

Arlene Siegel and her husband Jules started Fashion Farms in New Hope, PA in 1984 as breeders and owners. Over the years, the couple built their breeding and racing operation into one of the best in the business. Arlene was instrumental in the farm's success, involved in the selection and purchase of yearlings, foaling operations and regular attendance at races. Fashion Farm's Tagliabue won the 1995 Hambletonian, and Broadway Schooner the 2009 Hambletonian Oaks. Fashion Farm's stallion Broadway Hall sired 2011 Hambletonian winner Broad Bahn.

Freaky Feet Pete retired; to stand at Ivy Lane Farm

Ivy Lane Farm is proud to announce that world champion Freaky Feet Pete has been added to the stallion roster for the 2020 breeding season. The fastest and richest son of Indiana's leading pacing sire, Rockin Image 3,p 1:48:2 (\$901,756) will join the stallion ranks in Indiana, in which Freaky Feet Pete was twice (ages 2 and 3) a divisional champion in the state.

Bred in Indiana, few horses have garnered more attention throughout their career than Freaky Feet Pete. Only defeated once at two, Freaky Feet Pete won four Indiana Sire Stakes eliminations, and three \$75,000 Indiana Sire Stakes preliminary finals. He capped off his near perfect freshman campaign with an eye popping 1:50.4 victory in the \$200,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final over an off track. His 1:50.4 clocking was just one-fifth of a second off the 1:50.3 track record set earlier in the season by Freaky Feet Pete which still stands today at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Freaky Feet Pete won nine of 10 starts in his freshman campaign.

At age three, Freaky Feet Pete continued his domination of the Indiana Sire Stakes circuit, winning five ISS eliminations, and four preliminary finals, including yet another track record of 1:48.2s, breaking the previous mark set by himself and fellow world champion, Always B Miki of 1:48.4s. Freaky Feet Pete concluded his domination in the Hoosier State capturing the \$220,000 ISS Super Final over eventual 2015 Horse of the Year, Wiggle It Jiggleit, before heading north of the border to Woodbine Racetrack as a supplemental entry into the Breeders Crown. Freaky Feet Pete would take his elimination in 1:49:4s, before trudging through the slop and rain to capture the \$530,000 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings in 1:50s.

Freaky Feet Pete would conclude his sophomore season with dominant wins in the Monument Circle at Hoosier Park, and the American National at Balmoral Park in a stakes record equaling performance of 1:48:4m. In 17 starts, Freaky Feet Pete won 15 of them with his only two defeats to world

champions Wiggle it Jiggleit and Wakizashi Hanover. Freaky Feet Pete would finish third in Horse of the Year voting behind Wiggle It Jiggleit and Pinkman.

At age 4, Freaky Feet Pete would be the third member of "Harness Racing's Big Three," alongside champions Always B Miki and Wiggle It Jiggleit. The stallion would claim six victories in 15 starts, including a win in the leg of the Graduate series at Mohawk as well as four invitational paces at Harrah's Hoosier Park. The Breeders Crown Champion established his lifetime mark of 1:47:1f at Pocono Downs in an elimination for the Ben Franklin. With driver Trace Tetrick in the bike, Freaky Feet Pete established a world record for 4-year-old pacing stallions on a 5/8-mile racetrack, a record he still currently holds. Freaky Feet Pete would go on to finish second in the Ben Franklin Final, Graduate Series Final, Hoosier Park Pacing Derby and finish third in the Battle of Lake Erie and Dayton Pacing Derby.

After racking up major stakes wins all over the country, Freaky Feet Pete continued to race at the top level through six seasons. Freaky Feet Pete will retire with a record of 76 37-7-5, career earnings of \$1,617,056 and a lifetime mark of 1:47:1f.

Freaky Feet Pete is out of Pilgrim's Punch mare, Skyway Lori who was in her own right an Indiana Sire Stakes winner and talented racemare, earning \$56,663 on track with a lifetime mark of 1:54:1s. Noelle Duspiva to receive Excelsior Award

Just like many of her classmates, when Noelle Duspiva entered the Horse Husbandry curriculum at Morrisville State College in 2001 she enjoyed being around pleasure horses and thought, "I could just ride horses for the rest of my life and it will be profitable."

She added, "I realized very quickly that this would be a difficult career path."

As the neighs and whinnies of yearlings echoed through the vast halls of the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex, Duspiva noted that she had no idea that she would find herself managing a standardbred breeding farm in Orange County, NY less than a decade later.

While din of the auctioneers could be heard in the background of the Harrisburg yearling sale, Duspiva recounted her need for a summer job while on college break and one of the only positions available was in the breeding barn. Being late in the month of May, there was but one mare left to foal, so the then-eighteen-year-old agreed to take a shot at foal watch.

The mare foaled perfectly, "but I was freaking out," she said with a laugh.

Luckily for Duspiva she was working in the breeding shed beside one of the most knowledgeable and well-known breeding managers in the state of New York, Dave Hanson.

She credits Hanson and Dr. Larry Sautter as two of her mentors in the industry and recalls the early days of collection stallions, inseminating mares and ultimately prepping yearlings at the Morrisville College program.

"That summer I got a crash course in harness racing and

breeding operations, literally from the ground up."

She fell in love with the sport and was hooked. She picked breeding as her major concentration and stayed at Morrisville all four summers until she graduated.

But, before she could graduate, the program stipulated an internship at a breeding farm...which provided Duspiva the opportunity to enter the world of Winbak Farm. Following the internship and graduation in 2004 she was offered a job on the standardbred nursery in Walden, NY.

She has been there ever since, taking over as manager in 2010.

Over the course of her work at Winbak of NY there has been as many as 12 stallions standing stud at one time. Although she counts Muscles Yankee and Malabar Man as two of the most memorable, they each had their own distinct accomplishments and is very proud to have worked with all of them.

In addition to her duties farm manager, Duspiva is also the president of the Harness Horse Breeders of New York State. Her work with that organization has allowed her to interact with breeders from all over the state and to help implement improvements to the program in concert with the New York Sires Stakes and the Ag Fund.

When the Monticello-Goshen Chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association holds their 61st annual Awards Banquet, on Dec. 15, Noelle Duspiva will receive the chapter's Excelsior Award, for her dedication and contributions to harness racing in the State of New York.
