Passion for the Game

Reigning NBA MVP Nikola Jokic was in his glory on Friday when he jogged horses at Gaitway Farm in New Jersey and attended the races at The Meadowlands.

Nikola Jokic is used to racking up points on the court for the Denver Nuggets, but on Friday night (Dec. 3) he was piling up pics in The Meadowlands' paddock instead.

The National Basketball Association's reigning Most Valuable Player was in town to play the New York Knicks Saturday (Dec.

4) afternoon, but since he got to town on Thursday, he spent his day off on Friday with his buddy, Hall of Famer Tim Tetrick.

"He knew me from following me on Facebook," said Tetrick. "And we started talking about two or three months ago about horse racing and he asked me if he could come to a farm and I said, 'Any time.' It worked out that he was in town for the weekend."

Jokic, 26, grew up on a farm in Sombor, a city in the northern part of Serbia, where as a teenager he fell in love with horses, specifically trotters, at the track in his hometown and even worked there for six years cleaning stalls. He now owns his own farm with a training track and about nine trotters.

Since Jokic plays on the West Coast, trips to the New Jersey area don't happen often but it appears he made the most of his time in town on this trip.

"He asked if he could come to the track [Friday night] and I said, "Sure. What do you want to do?" And he said, 'I want to hang out in the paddock with you and the other quys," Tetrick said.

"I was telling him about Nifty Norman having two trotters that made a million dollars, the first time in history. And Nifty was in the paddock and I said, 'Come here, I want to introduce you to Nifty.' His eyes lit up like he was meeting Michael Jordan. He said 'You're Nifty? Wow.' And he talked to him for 20 minutes."

During their conversation, Norman found Jokic to be humble and genuine.

"I couldn't be more impressed by what a good bloke he was," said Norman. "You know, you meet professional sportsmen and most of them are a - - holes. He's fascinated by the business. That's all he wanted to talk about. He was more fascinated by us than we were by him.

"I said to him 'Next time you come out, please get a hold of me and come down to the farm and see where I train.' And he said, 'We don't play here again for a long time.' Dude, any time you're in town, Timmy or Ashley can put you in touch with me and you can some see the farm, come jog some horses, come see some yearlings, whatever you want to do. Hopefully, we get to meet again."

Meadowlands' marketing coordinator/TV talent Jessica Otten was informed in advance that Jokic might be attending the races so she could prepare for an interview.

"First off, I was scared I was going to get his name wrong, so I had him tell me his name a couple of times," said Otten. "And he was like 'Don't worry if you don't get it right, not many people do."

"You come across some famous people and they're not always humble sometimes and he was just so happy to be there. He literally walked around to every race before they went out and watched outside right on the fence and rode in the starting car and waited for Timmy to get off the track. It was so cool to see people outside of our world love it as much as we do."

During his interview with Otten, Jokic talked about jogging that afternoon with Tetrick at Gaitway Farm.

"It was great, because in Serbia it's not a really big sport," said Jokic. "Here there is at least a lot of people into it and just to have 30, 40 horses around me, it was a really fun experience."

Thanks to his relationship with Tetrick, Jokic gets to watch much more harness racing.

"When we first started texting back and forth, he said 'How do I watch American racing?" said Tetrick. "I'm thinking, well, he travels all the time and I said TVG. But he said, 'Most hotels don't have it.' I said RTN is \$10 a month. He said, 'That's amazing.' And he texted back an hour later and now he follows everything. He watched all the Breeders Crowns and texted me after every race. I got a thousand texts from him in the last two months."

In the 2020-2021 NBA season, which was shortened by 10 games due to COVID-19, Jokic became the first MVP winner to play in every game of the season since Kobe Bryant in 2008. Jokic averaged 26.4 points and 10.8 rebounds per game.

He is viewed as one of the best passing big men in the game.

Only he and Wilt Chamberlain, at 6'10" or taller, have averaged at least 7 assists per game. Chamberlain did it twice, while Jokic now has a hat trick. He also recorded the fastest triple-double in NBA history of 14 minutes and 33 seconds in 2018.

Jokic put up 32 points with 11 rebounds Saturday as the Nuggets beat the Knicks, 113-99. A game attended by Tetrick and several other horsemen who were given tickets by Jokic.

The Nuggets return to New York to play the Brooklyn Nets on Sunday, December 19. It's impossible to tell if Jokic will have

time to spend at The Meadowlands on that trip, but one thing that is certain is that as soon as the NBA season is over, he's immediately on a plane going back home to his horses.

"Basketball is how he makes a living and the horses are his passion, that's basically what he said to me," said Norman.

Trainer of Year is up for grabs in hotly contested battle

Many trainers had outstanding seasons in 2021. The standings are filled with the usual large stable names who performed well relative to standard expectations, but also with up-and-coming conditioners who had breakout years.

There are a number of those trainers that deserve to be mentioned in support for the Trainer of the Year award.

Take for starters, Ron Burke. After a COVID-19-impacted 2020, Burke once again surpassed \$20 million in seasonal earnings leading the way as usual by massive margins in earnings and wins. Top stakes performers for him included a win in the Little Brown Jug with Lou's Pearlman, and other multiple stakes winners Blue Diamond Eyes, Atlanta, Cattlewash and the veteran This Is The Plan, to name a few.

Tony Alagna is another who had a strong year. He's going to finish second in earnings behind only Burke, with a number that will likely be just shy of \$8 million. He campaigned top 3-year-old pacers Abuckabett Hanover and Rockyroad Hanover, as well as the 2-year-old colt trotter Fast As The Wind who closed the season with a flourish.

Ake Svanstedt warrants a mention, too. He won two Breeders Crowns with Ecurie D Dk and Felicityshagwell S, and he may have been held in even higher regard if not for a mid-season injury to his Hambletonian hero, Captain Corey.

But for all intents and purposes, this year's Trainer of the Year is going to come down to two individuals who know each other well, Richard "Nifty" Norman and Brett Pelling. Nifty used to be Pelling's first trainer.

With Norman and Pelling sitting in fourth and seventh respectively in the trainers standing by earnings there's been other trainers that have won more, but these two have been in control of the stakes landscape through many of the divisions this year. Horses from these two barns appear five times in the Top 11 ranked horses in the final Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll.

Beginning with Norman, his two biggest guns were Bella Bellini and Venerable. Having two millionaire trotters in a single year is an amazing and rare feat, and they paved the way towards the stable's total earnings of almost \$5.9 million on the year. Much consideration should be given to Norman for that achievement alone. Those combined with 3-year-old pacing filly stars Grace Hill and Fire Start Hanover, and a host of additional 2-year-old talent such as Bluegrass winner and Breeders Crown elimination winner Lilbitalexis and Matron winner Joyride Hanover. All told, his stable won 135 times in 633 starts and currently stands with a UTRS of 0.345.

Onto Pelling, he only started 323 horses this year but has put up a ridiculous UTRS of 0.462. No other trainer except for Nick Gallucci with anything more than limited starts has come close to that UTRS sported by Pelling. Pelling only had 323 starts, he won over 100 of them and his horses finished in the money 204 times. Numbers are one thing, but Pelling also has the horses to go with it including the top-ranked horse in harness racing, the 3-year-old filly pacer Test Of Faith.

And while Norman had two millionaire trainees', Pelling wasn't far off. Test Of Faith was a \$1 million earner this year, and his 4-year-old pacer Allywag Hanover finished just below that seven-figure threshold at \$942,000.

It's one thing for trainers to win races with horses that are

supposed to, but both Norman and Pelling did exceptional things with horses that would have never been expected to achieve so much success this time a year ago.

Did anyone ever hear of Bella Bellini months into this year? She went winless through seven starts only hitting the board a single time as a 2-year-old while earning just over \$4,000 before being transformed into the best 3-year-old filly trotter this year. In addition to the Hambletonian Oaks, other signature wins include the Breeders Crown and Matron. Maybe not to the same turnaround extent in terms of numbers, Pelling was able to develop the always-fast Allywag Hanover from an erratic type into a free-for-all machine and carried that all the way through to the end of the year. His big wins include the McKee, Canadian Pacing Derby, Haughton, TVG Pace and a 1:46.4 record in the Allerage. Not to be overlooked, Pelling also trained When Dovescry to multiple stakes wins including getting the best of rival Atlanta to close out the year in the TVG Trot. A race by the way in which immense credit should be given to Norman for taking a shot with the 3-year-old Bella Bellini who raced huge from an outside post.

If the number of division winners plays into the equation, Norman would seem assured with two. Venerable in the 2-year-old filly trot division who should last over Joviality S, and Bella Bellini in the 3-year-old trot division. Pelling is also nearly guaranteed with two division winners as well: Test Of Faith in the 3-year-old filly pace division and Allywag Hanover in the older pacing division. There's also a chance he gets a third, depending on how much support When Dovescry gets in the older trotting mare division against Atlanta and Manchego.

Horse of the Year seems to be coming down to Test Of Faith, and the Chris-Ryder trained Niki Hill, but I think it's going to ultimately go to Test Of Faith. With a record of 14-2-0 in 16 starts against ultra-competitive competition, she's deserving. Provided it goes that way, that would leave Norman and Pelling with razor-thin differences in their resumes, but Pelling would have Horse of the Year in Test Of Faith.

I don't have a vote in the matter, but if I had to pick one or the other, I'd go ever so slightly to Pelling. Though a dead heat, as improbable as that is, would be more fitting.

DD's Big Joe has made a 180-degree turn for Doug Geesaman

The gelding has won nine starts in 2021 and now stands as the best horse Geesaman has had in 25 years.

Last fall, Doug Geesaman found himself frustrated and disappointed with homebred DD's Big Joe. The then-freshman, bred and owned by the Pennville, IN resident and his wife, Donna, had managed a lone second-place finish on the fair circuit in 10 starts. Looking to sell the Rockin Image—Crown Lady gelding, the owner was talked into keeping him, and this season the sophomore has made a 180-degree turn for his connections, collecting nine wins in 28 starts.

"I would have sold him. I was very disappointed in him," said Geesaman. "When I broke him I thought I had a really nice one."

The owner/breeder/trainer went as far as sending the pacer to Marvin and Larry Wickey after the 2020 campaign. They jogged DD's Big Joe and liked the horse, but instead of buying him, they encouraged the veteran horseman to keep the homebred.

"They told me, 'Doug, I really think you'd be making a mistake selling him," he recalled. "They did me a favor because I was ready to get rid of him."

DD's Big Joe is the third foal from Pro Bono Best mare Crown Lady. Geesaman purchased the winner of \$268,642 in an online auction. Campaigned by Ross Croghan, the mare took her mark of 1:51 at age 4. She suffered a suspensory injury, and while Geesaman tried to bring her back to the races, the previous injury hindered her success on the track.

"I brought her back here and I thought I would try to race her and see how she got along. She would get me some checks, but she wasn't anything like she was earlier," the conditioner said.

Crown Lady was bred to Sand Shooter in 2015, and her first foal, gelding Sand Sniper, is currently racing, a winner of \$101,703 in his career with a mark of 1:51.4. Filly Rock N Roll Lady came next, but her career was abbreviated.

"She had some structural problems in her hips. They weren't quite lined up correctly," the breeder said. "She had the speed, but she just couldn't carry a mile. I raced her the first year and ended up selling her."

Then along came Joe, a foal named after the Geesaman's grandson.

"When he was born, he was so tall and gangly he had trouble nursing the mare," Geesaman said. "My grandson is a baseball player and his coach calls him Big Joe. That's how he got his name."

As the breeder began to break and train his latest pupil, he believed the pacer had talent. However, he would have to entrust the young horse to Ben Schwartz due to personal health issues and challenges with the developing pacer.

"Joe was a really nice colt. I jogged him for a couple months and he started to develop a mouth issue. He got to where I'd take him out and jog him and I couldn't keep him on the track. That mouth was bothering him and I couldn't quite figure it out," Geesaman said of the colt. "Ben jogged him and finally



got the issue resolved. He got him trained down and my health improved. I raced him on the fair circuit."

In seven fair starts, DD's Big Joe managed to earn two checks, finishing second at Portland and fifth at Indianapolis. Moving him to the big track, Geesaman hoped he might improve. In three starts he finished 10th, and twice raced eighth.

"For whatever reason he just was not ready. He would go out and try. You could tell he was trying. Overall, he just was not a promising colt. I knew he had it in him, but it just wasn't showing," he offered.

After being convinced to keep DD's Big Joe, Geesaman sent the pacer to Justin White to race on the fair circuit this season, winning at Hoosier Park in April before the fairs began. The sophomore collected two victories, both at Portland, a trio of second-place efforts and a third-place performance, qualifying the gelding for the Governor's Cup at the Indiana State Fair.

"I wanted to try to win the Governor's Cup down at Indianapolis. We put him on the fair circuit and he won a couple times on the circuit. We went to the Governor's Cup and I felt real good going in there," Geesaman said. "They had a storm coming in so they postponed the races (Thursday evening). We came back Sunday and I don't know, Joe just didn't seem like he was ready to roll that day. I think we ended up getting fourth, which I was majorly disappointed in."

With his fair season complete, DD's Big Joe moved to Harrah's Hoosier Park. Geesaman sent his charge to Tyler George based on a friend's recommendation following two starts in the White barn. Since then, the sophomore's fortunes have changed dramatically. Under the guidance of Hoosier Park's defending leading trainer and driven by Trace Tetrick, the track's leading driver, DD's Big Joe has scored six wins in his last eight attempts, taking a mark of 1:50.2 in the process.

"He's done a 180 degree turnaround. Tyler has done a good job with him. I give him all the credit. Trace has done a super job driving. Those two guys are tops," Geesaman said.

In mid-November DD's Big Joe was entered in the Richard Taylor Memorial, winning the \$14,000 first leg by two and one-half lengths in 1:51.1. The favorite captured the second leg on November 26, this time the margin was a length and a half. Sent off as the favorite in the \$27,000 final, DD's Big Joe held the lead racing into the stretch before finishing third. The gelding was elevated to second by judges after the second-place horse was disqualified. DD's Big Joe has banked just over \$59,000 this year.

In late 2020, Geesaman looked to unload the homebred after a disappointing season. Now, he is anticipating the gelding's 4-year-old campaign in 2022.

"I'm thrilled. This is just a hobby for me, and it's taken me 25 years to come up with this colt. I started training horses in 1996. I've had some pretty decent horses, but nothing of this caliber. He's the fastest that I've ever owned," Geesaman said. "I'm excited to see what he can do as a 4-year-old. Hopefully he'll just keep improving."

Looking back 74 years to the first Horse of the Year award

Back in the day, Horse of the Year banquets were routinely held in December. The racing calendar essentially came to a halt in early winter and would resume in late February or March. Not today.

Let's look back at the Horse of the Year awards during the past 74 years as we gear up for #75 this February in Florida:

First year of voting in 1947

Fifty ballots were cast by sports editors and radio commentators.

There were 22 horses recommended for the award and 165 votes for the winner Victory Song, who set a record of 1:57.3.

Stablemate Hoot Mon was the runner-up with 160 votes. Hoot Mon set the new Hambletonian mark of 2:00.

Sep Palin trained and drove the top two, yet his total driving earnings for the year was just \$121,102, good for second in the nation behind Harry Fitzpatrick (\$133,675).

April Star was third in the voting with 108.

Algiers, who won the \$50,000 Golden West Trot, received 69 votes.

Rodney, who was named Horse of the Year in 1948 finished 10^{th} in the voting in the inaugural year.

Second year of voting in 1948

The winner, Rodney, won three times in 1:58 in 1948.

Demon Hanover was second and Knight Dream was third in the voting.

Proximity was fourth. She would be named HOY in 1950, becoming the oldest ever to do so at age 8.

Victory Song was 10th in the voting.

The ballot 50 years ago

In 1971, a \$7,000 yearling named Albatross was voted Horse of the Year and then would repeat in 1972 becoming the first ever standardbred to win over \$1 million over two consecutive seasons (his \$558,009 in 1971 was a new single-season record).

Steady Star was second with 34 votes to Albatross' 141. Steady Star uncorked his record 1:52 all-time fastest time trial that year.

Fresh Yankee, the defending HOY, was third with 8 votes.

Hambletonian winner Speedy Crown was fourth.

Super Bowl, a stablemate of Albatross, was 10th. The following year they would go 1-2 (1972: 136-48 over Triple Crown winner Super Bowl). Speedy Crown and Super Bowl entered the stallion ranks in 1973 and for many years they were 1-2 in stallion earnings.

HOY - it has happened only once before

A Breeders Crown and Triple Crown winner also being named Horse of the Year — No Pan Intended in 2003.

A 2-year-old pacing filly voted HOY –J K She'salady

Father/Daughter each with multiple HOYs? — Jimmy Takter (4) and Nancy Takter (2)

Down Under horse - Shartin N

Back-to-back HOY runner-ups — Deweycheatumnhowe (2007-2008)

Winner by fewest votes – 1975 Savoir 52-49 over Silk Stockings

First Triple Crown winner

Scott Frost was not only the first Triple Crown winner, he was also voted Horse of the Year in 1955.

Scott Frost was close to being the first three-peater in the annals of HOY balloting. In 1954, as a 2-year-old, he actually got more first place votes than winner Stenographer, but lost on points. Scott Frost had the exact same 1-2-3 record as Stenographer from 1954 with 23 wins two seconds and a single third.

Amazing parallel of Bret Hanover and Nevele Pride

Bret Hanover was HOY in 1964, 1965 and 1966.

Nevele Pride was HOY in 1967, 1968 and 1969.

No other horse has won HOY three times.

Both raced as much or more at 2 than at 3 or 4.

Bret Hanover was 24-for-24 at 2 and Nevele Pride was 26-for-29.

Both won 21 times at 3, in the same 24 starts.

Both had their fewest starts/wins at age 4: Bret Hanover was 17-for-20 and Nevele Pride was 10-for-14.

Both won the HOY every year they raced. Previously, the HOY duplicators had not done so.

Both set the earnings records for freshmen for single seasons and for Bret Hanover also set the record for lifetime earnings. Bret retired at \$922,616 and was passed two years later by Cardigan Bay who became the first million-dollar winner, though some of those earnings were from New Zealand. Nevele Pride finished at \$873,238, just \$12,000 behind Su Mac Lad at \$885G.

Both raced and won the Triple Crown.

Both retired to stud and had marquee horses — Bret Hanover upon his passing in 1993 was #5 all time with \$62 million and had son Even Odds win a \$1,422,000 race, the Woodrow Wilson. Nevele Pride's Bonefish won the 1975 Hambletonian.

Both went into the Hall Of Fame in 1994.

Both are buried alongside thoroughbred royalty. Nevele Pride at Stoner Creek next to both Meadow Skipper and the Triple Crown winner Count Fleet. Bret Hanover was buried at the Kentucky Horse Park. They died 84 days apart — Bret at 30 on 11/21/92 and Nevele Pride at 28 on 2/13/93.

Hard work, love of horses is the key to Albert Adams' longevity

He's close to 86 years old, yet he still begins every day at about 6 a.m. feeding two stables of horses, followed by cleaning anywhere from 15 to 20 stalls at Winterwood Farm, a farm he built and lives on,

but no longer owns. According to his dear friend Dean Hoffman, "Hard work is what keeps Albert Adams alive."

Albert, "Ab" to his multitude of friends, began his life's journey close to the Ontario town of Brantford where his parents had a farm.

His schooling began in a country schoolhouse where one teacher taught eight grades consisting of a total of 60 students.

"School didn't interest me that much anyway, so I never felt very deprived of a complete education. My dad put me in charge of the livestock at the farm at the age of 13. I always loved horses and enjoyed watching and reading about them, primarily thoroughbreds, because they were the only ones that I was exposed to.

"My first physical contact with standardbreds occurred when I was approached by a gentleman whose name was Vern Evans, who asked me to board and foal a mare for him at my father's place. I jumped all over the opportunity and all went well. Little did I know that was the first foal of perhaps thousands of them I would help to deliver."

While still a youngster, Adams went to work for Max Webster, a well-known automobile dealer in Hamilton, who had branched out to breeding, raising and sometimes racing trotters and pacers.

"Max was a wonderful man and a great person for who to work. He treated me as well as it was possible for a boss to treat someone working for him."

By then, Ab had met, married and had his first of four children

with the one love of his life, Sherry, to who he was married for over 58 years. He says that he hasn't yet and never will recover from her loss six years ago.

Adams enjoyed working for Max Webster, but received an offer to go to the Bluegrass of Kentucky and work for the world renowned Almahurst Farm.

He spoke with Mr. Webster and Max told him that if his dream was to go to "horse heaven" in the bluegrass of Kentucky then that he should follow it. Adams says, "to show you what a great man Mr. Webster was, even though I was leaving him, he gave me a check for \$300, which was a lot of money back in 1962, to help us with our moving expenses."

When he first arrived at Almahurst, then under the management of Paul Throckmorton and owned by Californian Jim Camp, all was not quite as he was promised. Instead of the house that he was told they would get, Ab, Sherry and baby Lorrie were moved into a bug and rodent infested attic in the city which required going up 26 steps to reach. When Sherry became pregnant with their second child it became impossible for her to navigate all those steps. They were in an impossible situation.

Ab went to management and submitted his resignation. Miraculously, they were quickly moved into more livable quarters on the farm.

Two years after the Adams family moved to Almahurst, it was sold to P.J. "Jack" Baugh. Noted Hall of Fame horseman Francis McKinzie, who helped to arrange the sale, became its president and farm manager.

With the new ownership came a series of layoffs of the then overstaffed farm. McKinzie quickly recognized the work ethic of the young Canadian transplant and kept him on as his assistant.

Francis McKinzie is well recognized as one of, if not the greatest of all farm managers. His ability earned him a place as an Immortal in the Harness Racing Museum. Tell us a little about him.

"He was a great man, but not the easiest person in the world to work for. He was exceedingly demanding. However he would be willing to do anything that he asked you to do. He almost defined the word perfectionist. He could prep a yearling better than just about everybody. He could be very kind, but could sometimes be the opposite. There were some instances where he actually brought me to tears. I was ready to quit once or twice, but resisted the temptation. You know the saying 'Whatever doesn't kill you, will make you better.' Francis McKinzie definitely made me a better horseman."

You worked at Almahurst for Jack Baugh for 30 years.

"All things considered, it was a great experience. When Francis

left, Mr. Baugh made me the farm manager. We complemented each other well. I worked hard and remained exceedingly loyal. I was offered jobs at other farms, one of them at Hanover for a lot more than I was making at Almahurst. He was very kind to me and my family. He built us a brand new state of the art, five bedroom home. I always had a new vehicle at my disposal. Interestingly, when I left, I was still earning the same salary as when I began. But there was a great added benefit, in that I was allowed to kept all of my own horses at the farm free of charge. This was a tremendous advantage to both of us. When I left, I owned 13 horses. At the height of my time there, we would foal somewhere around 300 mares a season. I tried to be present for every new arrival."

Tell us about Winterwood Farms.

"From the time I was a child I always wanted to own a farm of my own. While I was at Almahurst, I became aware of a 27-acre piece of land available in Central Ohio, which later grew to be 200+ acres. Sherry and I looked at it. We loved what we saw. We decided to go into debt to buy it. We had no real long range plans for it, other than when I stopped working for someone else, that would be the place where we would ultimately settle and if I was still working with horses, that would be where it would be. Anytime I could get away from Kentucky was spent on our farm. We constantly worked on it and made all the improvements that we could afford and maybe some that we couldn't. Eventually, the debt that I was carrying became too onerous and I had to sell. Thankfully, we were able to sell to a very generous family who love the farm and the horses as we do. I'm grateful for everything. My son Mark runs the farm and does a great job of it. He also does an incredible job in taking care of his aged father."

You are known for your affinity for grey horses, most specifically with the great Laag, a horse you bred and owned throughout his racing and breeding careers.

"Laag was a truly wonderful horse from the time he was foaled until he drew his last breath. He wasn't a kid's horse though. He definitely had a mind of his own. The trick with him was to make him believe you were doing what he wanted you to do, while doing what you wanted him to do. He was also very smart. There were people he responded to positively and others that he didn't like at all. I loved grey horses well before I acquired Laag's dam Tinsel and well before her, Blue Hurricane. My dad had a grey Percheron and I've loved greys ever since. Almahurst was the place where the greatest grey ever, Greyhound, was foaled. Maybe that in some undefinable way is what landed me there. Speaking of Laag, in going through his pedigree, there are five successive generations of tail end grey mares in it, maybe even more, but five is as far back as I could go with identifying their colors. My love for greys is still intact. I own a grey Somebeachsomewhere mare that is in foal to Fear The Dragon."

You were around many great horses while you were at Almahurst.

"One of my favorites was Shadow Wave, a bright chestnut with lots of white — a color combination that most standardbred people tend to dislike."

Did you get many of his yearlings that looked like him? Were they difficult to sell?

"Even though he was a chestnut, he didn't sire that many of that color, but he did get a lot of white on some of his foals. It rarely presented that much of a problem though, since he was such a good sire and so many of his horses became good on the racetrack. He was as wonderful a horse to be around as any that was ever foaled. He was both kind and smart. He never was a problem in any respect. He wasn't all that big, but was strong and stout. He probably resembled a quarter horse more than any other standardbred that I've ever been around. I was actually approached by more than one quarter horse

person to see if they could breed their mares to him. He was extremely game as well. He was foundered at 2 which became a life-long problem for him, to the point where near the end of his life he was close to missing one of them. That never stopped him from doing his job. His groom, Sam Brown, loved him and would have conversations with him. There were times where I believe that Shadow Wave actually understood what was being said."

You, along with Francis McKinzie, Bill Brown, Carter Duer and Jack McNiven are generally recognized as being among the best to prep and show a yearling. Do you notice any difference in doing so today than in your era?

"At the risk of sounding like a grumpy old man, I would say that the major difference is in finding enough good help to do the job. I think back then we had more people who loved what they did and loved and cared about the horse perhaps more than they do today. Of course saying that, back then there were only a few farms that presented their yearlings looking great. Today the ones that don't do so are the ones that stand out, rather than the ones that do. Most people do an excellent job. I worked the Hoosier Classic Sale for Steve Cross as an advisor for several years. Back then a lot of the yearlings might have looked like overgrown goats. Today all the consignors are in competition with each other and most of them present a well grown out, very presentable horse."

In all your years in the sport, what represent your greatest thrill and achievement?

"Actually both my greatest thrill and also my greatest disappointment could be summed up in one word — Nihilator! When we got him to stand at Almahurst, I was honored beyond my imagination. Here I was, believing the greatest horse to ever look through a bridle was coming to Almahurst Farm and would be under my direct supervision. My biggest disappointment was in his failure to live up to expectations in the stud and in his early death."

As great as Nihilator was on the racetrack, why do you believe that he failed in the stud?

"Looking back, I would say that it was likely that the chief reason was because he sired so many poor individuals. He wasn't the best individual himself. He had two front feet that looked as though they might have belonged to two different horses. He was able to overcome his physical deficiencies on the racetrack, most of his foals were not. He wasn't the first great horse who wasn't the greatest individual to enter the stud and become a disappointment. A notable other one might have been Prakas. On the other hand, Tar Heel was far from being a great individual and still became a great sire. When it comes to sires, there are more questions than there are answers."

In all your years in the business, were there particular people you enjoyed showing horses to and conversely were there any whose appearance you dreaded?

"Most of the people were a pleasure to show to. If I had to pick one all-time favorite it would probably be just about everybody's favorite, Billy Haughton. In addition to possibly being the greatest horsemen ever, he was one of the greatest human beings to ever walk this earth. He was remarkable in that he almost never had a negative word or thought about anybody, whether it be person or horse. There were others, many others. Those that immediately pop into mind are Jack Kopas, Gene Riegle, Dick Farrington and numerous others. There wasn't anybody in particular who I disliked dealing with, but in general terms I wasn't really that comfortable around people who jerked or prodded the yearlings. I feared not only for the safety of them and the horses that they were manhandling, but also for everybody around. I always felt that if someone were inclined to do that, they should ask that the horse be taken into a stall or if they could come after hours to inspect it. The rare person who would just go into a horse's stall without permission would also upset me for the same reasons."

Our mutual friend Dean Hoffman says that as great a horseman as you are, you are an even better husband and father.

"If that were true, in order to be a good husband, you would need to have a good wife. I was lucky enough to have the very best one ever. Sherry and I were married for 58 1/2 years before we lost her. She has now been gone six years. I still miss her so much, every single day. We raised four great children in order of their ages, Lorrie, Lisa, Mark and Jade. If any credit is given to how good those kids became, it would all belong to Sherry."

What is life like for you today?

"For an old guy like me, I suppose it's okay. I try to keep as busy as I am able to. I live in my own house on the farm that has been so big a part of my life. My son, Mark, who has grown into as good a horseman and maybe more importantly as great a person as there ever was, lives here with his family as well. That in itself is a great blessing. Mark takes as good care of me, as his mother took care of him and his sisters when they were growing up. He keeps me out of trouble and really looks out for what is best for me. What else could a person wish for?"

In the end, I follow Dr. Johnson

First, an old friend from New Jersey, Phil Sporn, pointed out an egregious oversight in my piece about Earl Teater and Bret's Romance. Apart from being a foundational mare, in her own right she produced B.G.'s Bunny.

Before he broke a bone in the process of winning an elimination of the Meadowlands Pace, B.G.'s Bunny was a top stakes colt. He then went on to be a successful sire, and his name still appears from time to time in the pedigrees of stakes winning pacers.

As a footnote, B.G.'s Bunny's name was a grand celebration of the name of his owner, Bob Greenberg aka Bunny Greenberg. So B.G. for Bob Greenberg, and Bunny for Bunny. By day, Greenberg operated a fleet of school buses, if memory serves, but he also was a powerful figure in New Jersey politics.

I got a snapshot view of that through my friend and frequent partner, Phil Tully. Phil had started his own sales company, and he desperately wanted to hold sales at The Meadowlands, then owned and operated by the state of New Jersey.

He was getting nowhere until he happened to mention his plight to Bunny Greenberg. Nobody rides free, as we all know, so in exchange for a piece of the action, namely an interest in Phil's sales company, Greenberg arranged a meeting for Phil with the main man at the track complex.

By the time they had finished their first cup of coffee, Phil had gotten the exclusive right to hold horse sales at The Meadowlands. His sales there prospered, and Greenberg silently collected his piece of the proceeds after every one of them, and then went merrily on his way.

I've recently heard from an interesting young man, Enos Garber, who by the age of 29 has collected a small group of enticing pacing mares. Enos is a one man band, doing everything himself including all the aspects of equine reproduction. There are not many civilians who can claim that kind of expertise, but clearly Enos is one of that select few.



He wanted my opinion about breeding two of his mares, Terror At Night and Art Frenzy, to Always B Miki.

Terror At Night is by Western Terror, and out of Enhance The Night, by Western Ideal.

Art Frenzy is by Art Major, and out of Lislea Sophia, by Lislea.

Both of them are ideal to Always B Miki. For Terror At Night, the foal would be 3×3 to Western Ideal, $3 \times 4 \times 4$ to Western Hanover, and 4×4 to Big Towner.

In case you've forgotten, those numbers represent the generations in which each particular horse's name appears. The technical definitions of those terms are these: When the sum of the generations in which the same name appears is six, or less, the horse so bred is defined as *inbred*. When the sum of the generations in which the same name appears is seven or eight, the horse so bred is defined as *linebred*. When the sum of the generations in which any name appears is nine or higher, a horse so bred is defined as an *outcross*.

Back to Enos Garber's mares, Art Frenzy to Always B Miki would produce a foal inbred to Artsplace, plus being linebred to Abercrombie and Big Towner. As far as this kid's breeding philosophy goes, that kind of close breeding is ideal. Two hits of blood from an outstanding horse is the way to produce an outstanding horse.

As a lifelong yearling seller, I also think that a good looking colt or filly with this kind of close, but not too close, pedigree, would have an enhanced value in the sales ring.

Enos also told me the story of how he acquired a third mare, Thrillonthebeach. She's by Somebeachsomewhere, and out of Tutu Hanover, by Western Ideal. She was offered for sale on OnGait, the province of Maurice Chodash, who is the living proof that a man can be very good at what he does and still be a great guy.

Thrillonthebeach was put up with a starting price of \$80,000. There were no takers, so Enos contacted her owner to get the scoops. The guy said the \$80,000 was actually his reserve, but it was clear that was now irrelevant, since there were no bids at any level.

Thereupon some traditional horse trading ensued and when



it was over, Garber owned the mare, but for a price well below \$80,000. What makes the story interesting is that Thrillonthebeach is a half sister to Lyons Sentinel p, 4, 1:48, with \$2,003,594 in earnings, and counting.

Parenthetically, I've recently been flattered to learn that I have a regular reader in Carter Duer. Duer is one of the top horsemen who learned his trade early on at Castleton Farm. The line started with Francis McKinzie, whom Francis Dodge Johnson Van Lennep hired as her first farm manager when she bought Castleton. McKinzie had been a farming neighbor of Sep Palin in Indiana, and Palin was Francis Dodge's longtime standard-bred trainer.

Sep Palin also had written his name indelibly into the record books of our sport when he bought a grey, yearling gelding at the Indianapolis yearling sale for \$900 in 1933. That was Greyhound, the greatest trotter who ever lived, and he was driven to all of his victories and world records by Sep Palin.

In any case, McKinzie went on to manage both Walnut Hall Stud and Almahurst Farm after his stint at Castleton. His place there was taken by Bill Brown, a great horseman and a great guy. Today, this tradition is carried on by his daughter, Jean Brown, who manages Blue Chip Farm. I've known Jeanie since she was in the fourth grade, and she's a delightful person.

While Francis McKinzie was running Almahurst Farm, His understudy there was Albert Adams. He's also a top horseman, and well respected by everyone fortunate enough to know him.

Duer also learned his early trade at Castleton, and for years now he has successfully operated his own farm, Peninsula. I believe the name derives from Duer's childhood on the Eastern Shore of Virginia. There is no better horseman in our business today than Carter Duer, and he also has a great, dry sense of humor that I could listen to for hours.

Finally, I noticed recently that Standardbred Canada was offering a contest featuring a number of millionaire race mares, and asking contestants to pick the one they'd most want the first foal from.

This, again, is the classic confusion about the total and absolute differences between a mare's phenotype, or visible, physical self, and her genotype, which is her genetic makeup. Again, and again, and again, the fact that a mare can win a million dollars on the racetrack tells us nothing about her ability to reproduce big-money winners.

But even more finally, let me quote Dr. Samuel Johnson, who in 1757 said these words which I try to follow: "The only end of writing is to enable the readers better to enjoy life, or better to endure it."

Christi Noble – Trainer

In the sport of harness racing there's a family who comes from Ohio that warrants respect and admiration for their continued success in the sport — and that name is Noble.

Most horsemen knew Sam "Chip" Noble III, a member of the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame who learned the sport from his father, and then Chip passed on the success to his son, Dan.

And that legacy would continue when in 2012 while driving at Buffalo Raceway, Dan would meet met his future wife, Christi Pokornowski, a female trainer, who also came from a long line of horsemen.

"I have been in the sport of harness racing for as long as I can remember. My parents were always involved in the sport," Christi said. "I'm a fifth generation as my paternal grandfather, Ray Pokornowski ,and maternal great-grandfather, Lester Snyder, were also actively involved up until their passing.

"Many of my cousins, aunts, and uncles are involved to some degree. It's definitely what you would call a family affair.

"I was born in Batavia, New York, and my husband, Dan, and I now live in Xenia, Ohio. When I met Dan I was training a stable of eight at Buffalo Raceway. He started helping me out and the rest is history.

"Dan wanted to move back home to Ohio, to be closer to his family. I'm so glad we did because his father, Chip, got sick shortly thereafter. Unfortunately, I never really got to know my father-in-law before he passed. He was only 60 years old. He was quite a horseman and I would have loved to pick his brain and learn from him.

"The entire Noble family is still involved in the business, as Dan's mother, Debbie, brother Sam, sister Meredith, and older children, Koltin and Sophia, all have a hand in it to some degree.

"Dan and I work together in the barn and make a good team. We make decisions together, but he doesn't question me on what I do and why I do it. I think that is why we get along. We bounce ideas off of each other and it works.

"We have a farm of our own with a few stalls outside of town, but currently stable our 30 horses at Greene County Fairgrounds in Xenia, Ohio. We have two broodmares: one pacer and one trotter, and a combination of aged horses, 3-year-olds, and yearlings — all are Ohio bred: three trotters and seven pacers — but we have been slowly transitioning to focusing on stake horses and top older horses, specifically.

"Primarily, we race at Scioto Downs, Miami Valley, Dayton and the Ohio fairs. In 2021, during stake season, we traveled to Kentucky, Indiana, Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York.

"We recently bought seven yearlings between the Ohio Select and Lexington Sale, and have three homebreds — one is a Western Vintage colt who is a ½ brother to Ocean Rock."

Yes, THE Ocean Rock who surprised many fans and bettors when he won the Breeders Crown. The 4-year-old gelding by Rockin Amadeus was one of three horses who received a bye from the elimination.

Winning the prestigious race gave Ocean Rock millionaire status —totaling his earnings to \$1,209,522

"Going into the race I felt very good about his chances with a little luck from the racing Gods. Ocean Rock felt great, trained great, and I thought he was ready to perform his best.

"He beat some very good horses — Allywag Hanover and Cattlewash — but Ocean Rock is a very good horse himself.

"Dan gave him a perfect drive and Ocean Rock gave his all, and it paid off with a win. I was speechless, to say the least. The horse hadn't got the respect he deserved all year long, so I'm so happy he got a chance to shine on the big stage."

The Nobles have had Ocean Rock since the day he was born. The pacer is a homebred owned by the Nobles' good friends the Burnett family. There is a long history between the two families that stretches over 40 years.

"Dan's father, Chip, and the late Jack Burnett bred, raised, trained and raced the dam of Ocean Rock — Ocean Pearl. Ocean Rock is her first foal.

"Jack's wife, Sandra, and their children, Jim and Susan, elected to keep their horses with Dan and I, and it has all worked out great. I hope Chip and Jack (Burnett) are smiling down on us all, for we have formed into a big family ourselves.

"Ocean has taken us on quite a journey. Winning the Breeders Crown is every horseman's dream. Some people are in the business for 50 years and never get to experience this. It is so exciting to have a horse you have had since he was a youngster and go on to win one of harness racing's top races.

"I feel very blessed, but couldn't have accomplished this without my husband, Dan, and our team. It was not my fastest win as a trainer, for Ocean won in 1:48 at Dayton, and again at 1:48.1 at Northfield last year.... but it is by far the most exciting!"

"This year we bought seven yearlings between the Ohio Select Sale and Lexington, and have three homebred yearlings to break. In fact, Ocean Rock has a Western Vintage half-brother who we are excited about, but we know that it is a hard act to follow stepping in his brother's hoof steps."

Dan and Christi are hoping to take their one-year-old son, Nash Samuel, and train their stable in sunny Florida this winter. Presently, they train at the fairgrounds in Ohio and the winters can get pretty tough with the weather and track conditions. But obviously the frigid winter temperatures didn't hurt Ocean Rock.

The above is a brilliant plan that I co-opted (full story here).

Consider the implications and the efficiency. After all, I already bought the yearling and changed the name to Festivus Miracle. The cost of staking for Miracle will be minimal. The whole ride will be approximately \$20,000. Gifting or not, I am on the hook for this amount. My bottom line does not change.

This gifting plan is beautiful on many levels.

First, and most obvious, if the horse is a dud, the gifts do not cost me a dime. Second, if the horse is excellent, I will be thrilled to hand over money to the giftees, and I will actually have the purse money to turn over to the one percent giftees. Third, no shopping. Fourth, the gift serves as a potential recruiting entrée to our sport. And fifth, no more Super Bowl wine hangovers for me.

No wrapping. No returns. No malls. No bottles of wine in my trunk. The Festivus Miracle gift brings the allusion of being very valuable and has a longer shelf life than a fruitcake.

Frank Costanza would be proud.

Perfect Sting granted exemption from "Gural Rule"

Perfect Sting has been retired to stand stud at Deo Volente Farms of New Jersey. His ownership of Brittany Farms and Val D'Or Farm, represented by trainer Joe Holloway, have applied for a waiver from the Stallion Restriction Condition (SRC), better known as the "Gural Rule" which would have prohibited his first crop of foals from being eligible for nomination to any Meadowlands stakes.

The SRC does permit that a waiver may be granted to a stallion who retires after the 3-year-old season if a physical condition would compromise their performance and/or health should they continue to be raced.

Mr. Holloway submitted documentation from a veterinarian accredited in equine cardiology indicating that Perfect Sting was afflicted with a heart condition that could affect his performance and health if the horse should continue to be raced.

In response, Jeff Gural requested that the horse be examined by a veterinarian at New Bolton Center to confirm that diagnosis.

The findings from the examination at New Bolton did confirm the earlier diagnosis. Mr. Gural then asked the veterinarians who examined the horse for an opinion on the potential of harm should he continue to train and race.

The response from the attending veterinarian was as follows:

"This horse very likely had these cardiac changes and risk factors 3 weeks ago based on the changes we see on the ultrasound. Therefore there was some increased risk when they raced him in the Breeders Crown. That risk will likely increase next year as this disease is progressive, although it is typically very slowly progressive and the increase in risk is likely small and very hard to quantify."

With this information and the unacceptable risk to the horse should he be raced in the future, a waiver has been granted from the SRC for Perfect Sting.

SRF response to Joe Faraldo

In response to Joe Faraldo (full story here) and the freeze brand controversy, there is no program in the U.S., and likely anywhere, for any breed that is of the magnitude, or possesses the experience of standardbred aftercare like the Standardbred Retirement Foundation, (SRF). This organization currently pulls between 600-800 trotters and pacers off the slaughter line every year.

If there is sincerity regarding the welfare of these horses, then reinstating the requirement of freeze brands should be done now. It's a freeze brand. There is nothing to lose by having two identifications, and Mr. Faraldo's reference to the cost of \$400,000 more requires clarification.

Every year, nearly 20 per cent of standardbreds SRF pulls off these slaughter-lines are re-united with their breeders, owners, trainers, and grooms. In the last few weeks Ron Burke, Lizette Waples, Jeff Gural, David Yarock, and George Millar have taken in the horses they bred or raced, or just cared about. When they were called about the situation, they were horrified. They stepped up without pause.

If more support of freeze brands is needed, from a humane standpoint, I ask Mr. Faraldo and everyone who voted against them (I mean this in the most genuine way) to join me to witness the problems of removing freeze brand requirements. I will show you in Pennsylvania; Ohio; Tennessee; Virginia; Texas; Arkansas; North Carolina; Louisiana, Kansas; Oklahoma; or any place of your convenience, there are many other "kill pens". Stallions, mares, mares in foal, yearlings, and babies of all breeds and sizes fight for their lives. If a pen owner would even agree to permit someone in, in order to use a microchip scanner a horse would need to be restrained; other horses in the immediate area moved; the area must have light; the microchip scanner would need to be placed close enough by the pol, neck, and crest of the neck to search for a microchip. If identification is made, one would likely want to mark with a brand, should the horse need to be located again among the herd. This process is not feasible.
