Dexter Dunn that is. He put the capper on a season for the ages with a breathtaking Fall Final Four/FanDuel Night blitz at The Meadowlands never quite seen before.

Consider just some of his best moments from Nov. 30 at The Meadowlands:

1. He won over 33 per cent of every dollar offered on the better than \$2.5 million card; \$863G to be exact.

2. He was less than \$2,500 from being favored in every race. His Nelsonbriteagle NO (1st) was the same 9-5 that Call Me Goo (4th) was just a couple hundred dollars off in the opener for the best female trotters. In the Goldsmith Maid he was 3-2 and finished third beaten less than half a foot for it all with Luna Lovegood, the slight choice and winner What A Bid Hanover was 7-5. In all others, Dunn was favored.

3. The closest margin in any of Dunn's five pack was a length and a half (Miki And Minnie (1½ lengths); Nelsonbriteagle

4. He entered the night at \$15.782 million and exited at \$16.645 million. His 1,394 drives are the second lowest total of any of the top 30 money-winning drivers in North America in 2024 (Scott Zeron has 1,324).

5. He's about to unanimously wrap up "Driver of the Year" for the fifth time in the six years he's been here in North America full time.

6. He's averaging \$11,900 per drive for 2024, far and away the best ever for any driver past \$10 million in any season.

• Gallo Blue Chip ran the table as a freshman in New York going eight-for-eight. Still, no one expected his season that followed, when he reset the single season earnings mark to past \$2.4 million.

• Self Possessed waited until the very end of the century, in the 74th edition of the Hambletonian, to post the most explosive victory, a 1:51.3 world record.

• Eternal Camnation steps onto the track for the very first time. Six racing seasons and a bankroll over \$3.7 million; her money mark still stands over two decades later

• Art Major and Kadabra were foaled. Both would go on to be stars on and off the track with their impact evident today.

"SWEET" AND "TREACHEROUS"

No matter what you do, it's tough to separate these two fellas, Sweet Lou and Captaintreacherous.

Born a year apart, Sweet Lou a 2009 foal and Captaintreacherous a 2010 baby, they both were outstanding freshmen.

Sweet Lou dominated the Breeders Crown by a city block in Canada in world record time while Captaintreacherous exploded to win the Wilson in sub 1:50 by the largest margin in that storied race's history.

Both made seven figures at 3.


They both raced last in 2014 when Sweet Lou was on his way to a Pacer of the Year title. Care to guess who was Pacer of the Year the two previous seasons? That's right, Captaintreacherous.

Today they are still as close as ever with both a fixture in the siring ranks behind Bettors Delight. Sweet Lou in 2024 is past \$18.6 million in the runner up spot and Captaintreacherous No. 3 at \$17.3 million.

Oh, and even lifetime, they can hardly be separated with Sweet Lou (1:47) at \$3,479,894 and "The Captain" (1:47 1) at \$3,148,657.

Sophomore fillies Allegiant, My Girl EJ hope they earned votes by taking on FanDuel elders

Each filly finished second racing against older mares in last Saturday's Championships at The Meadowlands.

Allegiant and My Girl EJ may not have won a FanDuel Championship last week at The Meadowlands, but both 3-yearolds showed up and showed out, finishing second in their respective fields of older female competition. Their reasons for taking on more seasoned competition was somewhat different.

With a tight race for Dan Patch divisional honors among the sophomore filly trotters, the connections of Allegiant took a chance in the FanDuel Open Mares Trot, knowing the leader in that division, Jiggy Jog S, would not be competing.

"[Allegiant] got the invite and because she was in the running for divisional honors, and because I knew R Melina was possibly going to go also, and 'Jiggy Jog' is retired, that also played a big part in it, [Allegiant] really had nothing to lose," said Allegiant's trainer, Linda Toscano.

R Melina is Allegiant's main competition for divisional honors.

"I know that [the voting is] probably going to be close as far as R Melina and Allegiant and I thought [competing in the FanDuel] might tip the scale," Toscano said. "And [Allegiant's] so sharp right now... and then add to that she does sell at that Mount Hope sale in two weeks in Ohio.

"So, this could only look even better, for anyone that would be considering buying her, on her resume to possibly bring her back as a 4-year-old because, you know, if she could go with them as a 3-year-old, I would have to think that she can go with them as a 4-year-old."

The fillies went head-to-head on seven occasions this year: Allegiant won three and R Melina took two. In the two faceoffs where neither was the victor, Allegiant finished in front of R Melina in both races.





Of the four top races in their division, Allegiant won the Breeders Crown, while R Melina added the Kentucky Filly Futurity to her resume. The Hambletonian Oaks and Elegantimage were won by Warrawee Michelle and French Champagne, respectively.

R Melina has a record of 8-5-1 from 18 starts with \$817,469 in earnings, while Allegiant's record is 6-4-2 in 17 starts with \$748,027 in the bank.

The FanDuel was the last opportunity this season for R Melina, owned by M And L of Delaware LLC and Alabama Harness Associates LLC, and Allegiant, owned by Ryan Smith, to face off before year-end voting takes place. Unfortunately, R Melina went off-stride at the start of the race won by Nelsonbriteagle NO over Allegiant. "I trained for them and they're good people," said Toscano of the owners of R Melina. "That's not the way I wanted it to happen. I would have rather seen a really good race, you know."

Toscano said you have to weigh out all your options whenever you consider putting a filly up against mares.

"Ryan left it to me this time," Toscano said. "I threw it up to him and he said, 'Don't hurt her, first and foremost, and don't do it unless you think she can be competitive.' We kept her in training, and after training her last Saturday, I had a conversation with him and also with Vernon [Beachy], who trained her, her whole life. And I said, 'I just don't think in this particular case, you have anything to lose, you have more to gain than you do to lose here.' And it worked out well. Everything worked out well.

"I hope it will tip the scale... and she might be 3-year-old trotting filly. She deserves it. She's done everything a horse can do. I know they took turns a little bit during the course of the year, but she's finished up so strong and she's such a nice horse that I really believe she deserves it."

My Girl EJ also left an impression with voters finishing a good second to the presumptive Horse of the Year Twin B Joe Fresh in the FanDuel Open Mares Pace.

The reason for owners Bill Pollock, Bruce Areman and Andrew Harris choosing to race "EJ" in the FanDuel was simple, it was their only option if they wanted to race her this year.

The partnership of Pollock, Areman and Harris just acquired the 3-year-old daughter of Sweet Lou–Lucy's Pearl for \$758,000 in a Preferred Equine Online Mixed Sale on Nov. 18 who was sold as part of a partnership dissolution. She was previously owned by trainer Ron Burke with breeders Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi and Elizabeth Novak.

"That was the only available race for her to race in," said Harris, who also trains the filly. "And, you know, when you pay that kind of money for one, you kind of like to get one start into her and see what she is and for us to get a little bit of excitement with her, and it was really the only option we had.

"And I think that if Burke had had her, they would have done it, too. I think that when you've got one that's racing that exceptionally, and been the boss of her own division, you take a chance. It's not like you're racing for no money... There are not enough opportunities in horse racing to not go for those types of races."

The connections of My Girl EJ, a two-time Breeders Crown champ, who set an all-age female world record of 1:49.1 on a halfmile track winning an elimination of the Jugette earlier this year, knew it wasn't going to be easy facing Twin B Joe Fresh and mostly older competition in the FanDuel, but felt their filly represented herself well.

"I think we all knew that we were just racing for second," Harris said. "I mean, nobody can beat Twin B Joe Fresh right now and it would be unfair to even have those expectations for EJ. So, I told them before we even entered, we'd be racing for second, but we're going to have five other ones up there, we might as well put in a little bit more power and have extra power there to watch race." Just as Harris had told his partners, they were racing for second and that's where she finished.

"I was very happy with her," Harris said. "To me, she was the clear second-best one in the race and I think that that was the hope going into it and I think she proved it coming out of it."

The opportunity for 3-year-olds to be invited to take on older competition was made possible when Meadowlands president/ chief executive officer Jeff Gural created these Championships, then known as the TVG.

"I saw that the Breeders' Cup allowed their biggest race to include 3-year-olds, so I thought we would try it in the TVG and it has made it more interesting," Gural said. "We raced Six Pack in it at 3 and he finished second to Tactical Landing, who was also 3. Last year, we raced Bond and she finished second to Jiggy Jog S and we had three enter this year and two finished second."

Toscano said of Gural's idea to invite 3-year-olds to take on their elders, "Jeff is all about trying to figure out a way to get the public back interested in the horse races again and, you know, that's commendable. That's why he has the Gural Rule. He really believes that if you bring them back at 4 that the public might get interested in it again. Unfortunately, it's too easy to turn on the TV these days, then it is to show up at the races."







Second Prix d'Amérique qualifier on tap for Sunday at Vincennes

The second qualification race for the 2025 Prix d'Amérique will be held at Vincennes on Sunday (Dec. 8) and this race appears to be tougher than the previous Prix de Bretagne.

The \$125,000 Prix du Bourbonnais over 2,850 meters includes 18 trotters and among them, the most recent Prix d'Amérique winner – 2024 champ Idao de Tillard – will try to secure his spot in the big race set for January 2025.

An even bigger race is also on the menu in Paris on Sunday. The \$220,000 Prix Ready Cash for 3-year-old trotters looks to be a spectacular event with horses like Liza Josselyn, Lombok Jiel, Frank Gio and First Of Mind behind the gate.

The most notable thing about the race is probably the fact that Lovino Bello is one of the 12 trotters competing for \$220,000. Lovino Bello is suspended from racing due to a doping case in Italy (from the Orsi Mangelli race in November) and according to the rules of U.E.T, the European harness racing federation, a suspension is a suspension everywhere. Still, the U.E.T. has allowed Lovino Bello to race Sunday, even if the suspension extends between Nov. 28 and Dec. 27. It's a sad story and let's just hope that the human factor is behind this error in the system.

Anyway, there are some nice races to look forward to at Vincennes on Sunday and the hunt for Prix d'Amérique spots will be the highlight.

ANOTHER STEP TOWARDS PDA FOR JUSHUA TREE

A small-but-strong field of well-merited 5-year-old trotters gathered when the \$125,000 Prix Doynel de Saint-Quentin was held on Saturday (Nov. 30) at Vincennes. Nicolas Bazire's **Jushua Tree** (Bold Eagle) was one of the stars in the event and Jean-Michel Bazire was surely confident in the bike when he opted a trip outside of leader J'aime le Foot with a kilometer remaining.

But there were horses eager to challenge the big favorite and when Jushua Tree created the advantage at the top of the stretch, it all looked safe for Bazire's horse. Strong finishers Justin Bold and Jack Tonic got closer in the end, but Jushua Tree showed great morale as he held off the chasers.

Jushua Tree won in a mile rate of 1:56.4 over 1.7 miles. Joviality made her comeback at the track after nearly five months away from competition and she showed that this race was very much needed before she reaches a level required for the tough races in Paris.

The next day, Sunday (Dec. 1), Vincennes played host to the final of Grand National du Trot, GNT and the race included horses that had collected points throughout the season, at different tracks all around France.

Sébastien Guarato-trained **It's A Dollarmaker** (Saxo de Vandel) proved best in the \$165,000 GNT final. Driver Eric Raffin really got the 6-year-old fired up in the stretch and just before the

wire It's A Dollarmaker disarmed a brave Iroise de la Noe. The mile rate for It's A Dollarmaker was 1:54.3 over 1.7 miles.

INEXESS BLEU STRONGEST IN PRIX DE BLOIS

The \$100,000 Prix de Blois for older trotters held on Thursday (Dec. 5) at Vincennes ended with a safe win for Laurent-Claude Abrivard trained **Inexess Bleu** (Vittel de Brevol), paired with Alexandre Abrivard.

Inexess Bleu proved strongest on a sloppy Vincennes track after finishing the final half-mile first over. Alexandre Abrivard let Inexess Bleu sprint home in great style in the stretch and the 6-year-old won in a mile rate of 1:54.4 over 1.3 miles.

Christmas comes early at Western Fair

Racing community steps up for Holiday Drivers' Challenge in support of Toys for Tots.

Tradition, both old and new, is at the core of every holiday celebration.

For the folks at The Raceway at the Western Fair District, their yearly holiday custom involves uniting Ontario's top reinsmen for a night dedicated to assisting families less fortunate.

On Tuesday (Dec. 10), the London, ON oval will hold its 5th Annual Holiday Drivers' Challenge in support of Toys for Tots.

As Greg Blanchard recalls, the event first imagined by his former colleague Greg Gangle four years ago was an instant hit.

"It was an idea that went over very well and made a lot of sense," said Blanchard, the director of equine programming at Western Fair. "It was just a great fit for this time of year and partnering with a charity like for 'Tots' was a fantastic match.

"The day has grown each year since, and it's become a real highlight on our annual racing calendar."

The Raceway hosted its maiden edition of the Holiday Drivers' Challenge in December of 2020 – a time that was made especially trying by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Despite the constraints caused by the coronavirus, more than \$5,700 was raised during the inaugural occasion.

That output later boomed across the second, third, and fourth running of the HDC.

Altogether, the seasonal staple has generated in excess of \$50,000 for Toys for Tots.

"It's very important; it means a lot to us to be able to give back to our local community, and not only us here at The Raceway, but all of our horsepeople and customers as well," said Blanchard. "The HDC has become one of our biggest events of the racing season." •• Our racing [at Western Fair] is pretty spirited every day as it is, but when there's a drivers' competition, it's at a different level. These stars are competing for charity, but they're ultra-competitive at the same time. They want the bragging rights of saying they're the Holiday Drivers' Challenge Champion. ?? ~ Greg Blanchard

Over the years, several standout performers have passed through its ranks, including 2022 Ontario Women's Driving Champion Natasha Day and Canada's second-leading driver in 2023 (413 wins), Tyler Borth.

A native of Australia's Gold Coast, Day piloted her way atop the leaderboard to claim the 2022 HDC by two points over Borth (64-62).

The versatile horsewoman is eager to spread more holiday cheer again this year.

"It's always great to try and put some good karma out in the world, and if we can do that while having some fun then it never feels like work," said Day. "Christmas is about sharing, and helping, and celebrating. So, through collecting and donating to Toys for Tots, the HDC does all of the above and I think the drivers enjoy it just as much as the kids."

Alongside Day, past HDC champions include Bob McClure and Marc St. Louis, Jr., who shared the 2020 title, and two-time O'Brien Award recipient James MacDonald, victor of the 2021 and 2023 editions.

Borth is equally excited to draw in for another HDC.

Being at Western Fair, the charitable contest carries added meaning for the Ingersoll, ON-based reinsman, who notched his first career score at the half-mile track in 2012.

"Competing in the drivers' challenge at Western Fair is very important to me because it's the track that started me off and helped me have a great career so far," said Borth. "I'm grateful for that, so any time I can give back to a great charity event that Western Fair is putting on I will." It's always great to try and put some good karma out in the world, and if we can do that while having some fun then it never feels like work. Christmas is about sharing, and helping, and celebrating. Joining Day, Borth and McClure for the 5th Annual Holiday Drivers' Challenge are local standouts Garrett Rooney (Western Fair's leading driver as of Dec. 4) and Lorne House, as well as Canada's second-leading driver Travis Henry (363 wins as of Dec. 1), and rising stars Samuel Fillion and Daryl Thiessen.

Blanchard says his team is eternally grateful for the unwavering support that Ontario's driving colony has shown throughout the HDC's brief, but impactful existence.

"We really appreciate, especially the non-regular drivers who take time out of their schedules over the holiday season to come down and support the event," said Blanchard. "WEG drivers, in particular, they're always willing to make time for it. We don't want to lean on the same names every year, we want to spread that around.

"Our local drivers are more than happy to step up and take part."

Interest and advocacy remain in abundant supply outside the driving contingent, as well.

As Blanchard noted, the horse racing community has rallied around Western Fair in a united effort to uplift the HDC and its yield for Toys for Tots.

"The overall support of the industry is outstanding, and we can't thank them enough," said Blanchard.

On the home front, Blanchard said Kelly McNiven deserves a moment in the spotlight for her consistent presence in championing the HDC.

"Kelly's stepped up and become a huge part of our team, putting this together each year," he said. "She took it upon herself a couple of years back to collect donations and organize that part of it for us.

"We couldn't do it without her. It speaks volumes to her character, and it's wonderful that she helps us out and has played an integral role as we aim to elevate the event to new heights each year." Between Gangle's imagination and Blanchard and McNiven's motivation to see the concept through, the title of Holiday Drivers' Challenge Champion is an illustrious label for the eight drivers that compete each year.

"Our racing is pretty spirited every day as it is, but when there's a drivers' competition, it's at a different level," said Blanchard. "These stars are competing for charity, but they're ultracompetitive at the same time. They want the bragging rights of saying they're the Holiday Drivers' Challenge Champion."

Top honors will go to the pilot who collects the most points across the HDC card.

Drivers will be rewarded 15 points for a win, with the subsequent finishing positions returning 10-7-5-4-3-2-1 in that order.

In the event of a scratch, the driver will automatically receive five points.

While winning is the name of the game, the true measure of the HDC's success is giving as many children the kind of holiday celebration they deserve.

"The drivers realize how important it is for families less fortunate to have a charity like this that they can rely on this time of year," said Blanchard. "For us to be able to support that is fantastic."

First post time for Western Fair's Dec. 10 program is scheduled for 5:50 p.m.

Cameron Kina gives his all to the horses that do the same for him

Cameron Kina looked the part long before his wheels touched the racetrack for the first time.

The path to a life in horse racing began, of all places, in front of the television in his parents' house.

"I would sit in the house and play with the racing whips and pretend I was driving," Kina said. "Ever since I was old enough, my dad would take me out on the jog cart, and I loved it. Racing has been a dream of mine for as long I can remember."

In 2023, that long-held dream became a reality when Kina made his first two starts in the sulky.

This year, he added the role of trainer to his resume.

On April 29, Kina recorded his first training win, the victory coming at Miami Valley in Lebanon, OH.

Threefiftytwo, a trotting son of Royalty For Life—Two Damsals, was sent on his way as the 5-1 fourth choice in the field of 10 for the evening's 13th dash.

In rein to Samuel Widger, the brown gelding was two lengths behind the leader after three-quarters in 1:26.

"I had a lot of people in my corner, hoping to get me that first training win," Kina said. "I thought he could win the race when I first looked at the program. He's a hard-trying horse and he gives his heart out there. We had a perfect 2-hole trip. Sam pulled him out and he just wouldn't go by the leader. I kept urging him on from where I was standing. Sam was telling him, 'We've got to do this for Cameron."

And they did, by a scant head, in 1:55.3.

"My grandmother [Barb Carpenter] was there — she drove down with me to the track — so the win was even more special," Kina said. "She was so happy."

There was more elation to come less than three months later.

On July 15, at Oak Harbor, the half-mile Ohio oval, Kina was in the sulky for the 10th race, a pace with a purse of \$3,562 and six starters.

The pacer he partnered that evening, Catch Me Conrad, was a familiar face.

"I have been around this horse since I was a young kid," he said. "Greg Cook, a great family friend who is like an uncle to me, would say, 'When you are old enough to drive, I'll let you drive him."

Kina was determined to make his first race with Cook's bay gelding a winning one.

The 2-5 odds showing beside their number on the infield tote board suggested it was well within their grasp.

Floating off the gate to settle into second through an opening panel in :27.4, Kina then gave Catch Me Conrad his cue.

"I knew there was no way we were going to lose," he said. "I knew this horse inside and out. It was amazing. Once I got to the front on the backside, I looked back and I felt his strength in my hands and I said, 'We're not losing this.' As soon as we turned for home, he kept going."

At the wire, the pair was seven lengths clear of their closest pursuer. They stopped the clock in 1:56.1.

"He's a great horse," Kina said. "He wants to do all the work for me. It was the best feeling. It really was a dream come true."

Although his milestone first training and driving wins could not have been more different, Kina's work ethic, approach to racing, and care of his stable of four horses has remained unchanged.

His knowledge of the sport and passion for it continues to expand by the day.

"I wanted to be a driver, but my dad always told me that I needed to know the horses, how to take care of them, what they need – so I did that, and I fell in love with the horses," Kina said. "They are wonderful animals. I learned more and more about them, the equipment, what to look for. I started leaning more towards training than driving, but I still love to drive."

Support is always close at hand.

"I got a ton, not just from my family," Kina said. "My mom [Jennifer Carpenter], my dad, [John Kina], and grandma – they are there to encourage me."

Each one provides Cameron with invaluable, albeit different, advice.

"My dad is the smartest person I know," Cameron said. "He was in the business but got out of it a little while ago. He's like an encyclopedia – if I need to know something, I go to him. My mom is always there for me. If I had a bad day training or driving, she's there to tell me it's alright."

As for his grandmother, hands-on help and straight-forward encouragement are always in ample supply.

"My grandma is there to kick my butt if I need it," he said. "She helps out in the barn. She's going to be 78, but she is going strong and does everything."

In a year of firsts, Cameron has found his best stride, finding himself more comfortable than he has ever been in his career, and eager to hone his craft.

Looking back on his first full season, the 19-year-old horseman - he celebrated his birthday on Dec. 2 - is grateful for what he has accomplished in 2024.

"I learned that I could do more than I thought I could," he said. "I have four horses and help my mom with hers. I just know more now than I ever did. There is still more to learn, and I am ready to do that. It started out slow, but I understand I am young, and I appreciated any drive I got. On the training side, the horses have been very good lately, which has been nice.

"The more horses I have been working with, the more my dad has taught me. I am doing more each day without going to him, but if I do have questions, I know he will have the answers."

Cameron, who excelled at basketball, baseball, and football, is also working on achieving some personal goals, including adding a few more pacers and trotters to his operation.

"I have two more qualifiers for my pari-mutuel license, so I'm looking forward to having that first race," he said. "I also want to have a bigger stable. Right now, I have four of my own, so I would like to get a few more. Those are my goals for now.

"So far, it's going well, and I hope it gets even better."

And while he is part of an industry he was perhaps destined to be in, Cameron hasn't taken any of his good fortune for granted.

It is something he is reminded of the moment he sets foot in the barn each morning.

"I love the horses," he said. "They go out and give you everything they've got. Why wouldn't you do the same for them? They deserve the greatest care you can give them."





Jett Propelled soars to third straight in DSBF prelim

Jett Propelled lived up to 1-20 billing in the second of two \$20,000 first-round preliminary divisions of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) series for 3-year-old pacing fillies at Bally's Dover, extending her win streak to three with a 1:55.3 score on Wednesday (Dec. 4).

In line to Jason Thompson, the Roddy's Bags Again—Jett Away filly seated 22-1 third choice Bad Nella Monella (driven by Montrell Teague) in the pocket through a :27 first quarter before backing the tempo down dramatically through a :58 half. After picking up the pace to three-quarters in 1:26.2 under mild first-over pressure from American Marvel (Tony Morgan), Jett Propelled sped away to defeat Bad Nella Monella by 31/4 lengths. Slipinsidewayz (Victor Kirby) made a mild late bid to narrowly miss the runner-up spot.

Jett Propelled, now a 10-time winner with \$186,609 in career earnings, competes as a homebred for owner/trainer Robert Shahan. She paid \$2.10 to win.

In the first division, **Amelia Maximus** and driver Barton Dalious brushed to the fore after Smalltown Bad Girl (Tim Tetrick) clicked off a :28.1 first quarter, and then rated middle splits of :59.2 and 1:28.2 before keeping her pocket rival a nose at bay for a 1:57.3 score. Makemymommaproud (Allan Davis) finished third, 3½ lengths behind.

Garey Jump trains Amelia Maximus, an Emeritus Maximus— Ellen's Beach Babe filly with four career wins and \$54,529 in the bank, for owner/breeder Katsiaryna Vaitsiakhovich-Jump. She paid \$5 to win as the 3-2 favorite.

WORKSLIKEACHARM MUCH THE BEST IN DSBF PRELIM

After claiming a divisional Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) title this summer at Harrington Raceway, **Workslikeacharm** kicked off the December DSBF series at Bally's Dover in victorious fashion, posting a 1:58.3 win over seven rivals in the first of two \$20,000 first-round divisions for 3-year-old male trotters on Tuesday (Dec. 3).

The gelded son of E L Platinum–Charming Oaks was in no hurry early, content to stalk from midfield as LG's Bluestone (driven by Ross Wolfenden) soared to the front from post 8 through a :28.4 first quarter. With a circuit to go, Tim Tetrick angled Workslikeacharm first-over, and the pair gained stoutly into a :59.4 half before dueling to the lead with just over five-sixteenths of the mile remaining. Workslikeacharm pushed clear of LG's Bluestone past three-quarters in 1:28.2 and repelled a late challenge from runner-up Ronnie Ridge (Tony Morgan) by a measured length. LG's Bluestone was a beaten third.

Jim King, Jr. trains Workslikeacharm, now a seven-time winner with \$137,560 in earnings, for Brett MacDonald. As the prohibitive 1-9 favorite, he paid \$2.20 to win.

The second division saw 3-2 choice **LG 's Jaxon** and driver Jim Morand follow second-over cover up the backstretch into the pocket behind Pretty Two before inheriting the lead as that rival broke in upper stretch. The Rolls Blue Chip—Miss Jocelyn gelding evaded 51-1 runner-up Platinum Max (Troy Beyer) by 2¼ lengths to win in 1:58.4. Trout Master (Jason Green) rallied from far back to just miss second.

LG 's Jaxon, a Nanticoke Racing homebred with 12 career wins and \$193,312 in earnings, is trained by Les Givens. He paid \$5 to win.

PLATINUM PROPOSAL POWERFUL DSBF PRELIM WINNER

After taking top honors in the Virginia Breeders' Fund championship in October, **Platinum Proposal** delivered a statement 1:59 win in her \$20,000 first-round Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund division for 3-year-old trotting fillies on Monday (Dec. 2) at Bally's Dover.

After getting away last in the field of five, Platinum Proposal and driver Jim Morand mounted a last-to-first brush to overpower early pacesetter Daburg on the backstretch and then fend off a sustained first-over challenge from runner-up Marino's Prize (driven by Ross Wolfenden) to score by 2½ lengths. Little Silver (Troy Beyer) rallied for third.

Les Givens trains Platinum Proposal, an E L Platinum–SJ's Proposal filly with 10 career wins and \$246,311 in earnings, for Nanticoke Racing and Delbert Cain.

Going Platinum and driver Corey Callahan posted a front-end 1:59.1 win in the third division, leading 1-2 favorite Lovie's Place (Art Stafford, Jr.) through splits of :28.2, :58.2 and 1:28.3 before speeding off to a 2½-length victory. Royal Robin (Tony Morgan) was third.

Nick Callahan trains Going Platinum, a daughter of E L Platinum – Nitroglide Hanover who paid \$4.60 to win, for Breakaway Racing.

The second division saw 4-5 favorite **Chinco Mayo** recover from an early break to circle her five rivals and nab FD Pure Platinum in the final strides of a 2:00.2 mile. Pat Berry drove the E L Platinum–Silence Is Bliss filly, who paid \$3.60, for trainer Jason Skinner and owner Tracy Bradshaw.

Jessica Otten is Phil Pines Award honoree

Jessica Otten is a nationally recognized, award-winning journalist and television personality who burst onto the harness racing broadcast scene a decade ago and has grown exponentially ever since.

Once again, Otten will be in front of the cameras as the recipient of the United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA) Monticello-Goshen Chapter's Phil Pines Award at their annual awards banquet, presented by the New York Sire Stakes, on Dec. 8 in Campbell Hall, NY.

A third-generation horseperson, Otten has continued to build upon a strong family work ethic instilled in her by her father, Peter Otten, at their Michigan-based standardbred stable.

While she credits being a caretaker as her first paying job, Jessica jogged her first horse at the family farm in Lennon, MI, which is just outside of Flint, long before she had reached working age.

"I have been in the barn since the day I was born," Jessica said.

But few in racing have come as far, as fast, and as successfully as Jessica has.

An early adopter of social media while working at her home track of Northville Downs in 2015, Jessica was scooped up by the Post Time with Mike and Mike podcast team to assist with their stakes coverage.

In 2018, while assisting with the television broadcast at Lexington's Red Mile, her work caught the eye of The Meadowlands general manager Jason Settlemoir. Jessica was put to work interviewing drivers and trainers from the paddock for the in-house show and ultimately providing analysis as a host on the broadcast desk at The Big M.

Her inside knowledge of harness racing, along with her pleasant and genuine demeanor, was evident immediately and she was brought on to the flagship track as the full-time marketing coordinator, in addition to her role in the TV department.

But the opportunities didn't stop there. Jessica worked with famed PA Harness Week host Heather Vitale on the Philadelphia-NBC affiliate, and was a co-host of that longrunning harness news feature show. Not only is she a fixture on the harness racing side of the nationally televised America's Day at the Races on FOX Television, but Jessica routinely juggles on-track and live broadcast duties on Hambletonian Day and the Breeders Crown.

But much of that is the in front of the camera Jessica that the public sees. What happened behind the scenes that helped Jessica ascend to such lofty heights in such a relatively short period of time?

"I didn't realize how much Dave Brower was teaching me without me even knowing it," Jessica said. "He always pushed me to do the hard interview and be better. He was always the first person to tell me, 'Good job.' He always had my back and always had my best interest in mind. I miss him every day and he is a huge part of why I am who I am."

Aside from the late Brower, Jessica also credits Moira Fanning, Gabe Prewitt and Emily Gaskin as inspirational.

"I think Moira Fanning is the wonder woman of harness racing," Jessica said.

Jessica is also quick to recognize her mom and dad as helping to pave the way.

"Without them I wouldn't be where I am today, and I wouldn't love the horses the way I do," she said. "They have supported everything I do and I couldn't be more thankful for them."

While family is important to Jessica, she often doesn't have to look too hard to find her sister Jenna, who has been working alongside her on many broadcasts in a variety of locations this season.

"Having her around has been a lot of fun," Jessica said. "It's not something any of us thought she would pursue, but she is killing it. Her role at Scioto has opened up a lot of doors for her on the management side and she is learning so much. I truly am proud of her. Believe it or not we don't always agree on a lot of things and I think that brings a new outlook when people are watching."

Jessica has resided in the State of New Jersey for the last five years. Although it seems like she is always working, she does find time to go back home to Michigan and to Northfield Park where she owns a few horses with her dad, and her harness driver boyfriend, Justin Irvine.

"It just so happens to work where my off days they are racing," Jessica said. "So, I travel there and help them in the barn. That way I can spend time with my dad, my boyfriend and my horses! It's a win-win-win situation for me."

When asked what advice she would give her successors, she said indisputably, "Work hard. Don't ever think you already know

everything. Be like a sponge and absorb everything. There is always room to improve and learn something new."

Jessica is the third member of The Meadowlands broadcast team to receive the Phil Pines Award as the aforementioned Brower won it in 2019 and her current partner on the desk, Dave Little, was honored in 2016.

Tetrick, George secure top honors at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Saturday night (Nov. 30) brought the 2024 racing season at Harrah's Hoosier Park to a close, seeing familiar names take home the titles of Leading Driver and Leading Trainer. Trace Tetrick secured his 11th consecutive driving title and 13th overall, while Tyler George utilized a record-breaking season to nab his fifth straight training title.

Tetrick, Harrah's Hoosier Park's all-time leading driver, added one more victory on closing night to bring his total on the season to 281 through 1,614 starts. For the third-consecutive season, John De Long finished second with 233 victories, while Kyle Wilfong rounded out the podium for a second-consecutive year, winning 212 races in 2024 including his second-consecutive Dan Patch Stakes.

"I'm fortunate to have great people behind me and drive a lot of fantastic athletes each year," said Tetrick during his trophy presentation. "I try to just take it one race at a time and hope to continue to maintain where we've been."

Tetrick heads into the winter months currently sitting 10th in all of North America in driving victories, earning over \$5.6 million on the track this year. Tetrick will enter 2025 knocking on the door of 8,000 driving victories with 7,787 currently and career earnings of over \$87.6 million.

After winning his first Harrah's Hoosier Park leading trainer title in 2020, George hasn't relinquished the training title since, picking up his fifth consecutive title in 2024. George smashed his own all-time single season wins record of 126 which he established in 2022, conditioning 138 winners on the season and batting at .409 UTRS on the year at Hoosier Park.

"We're very fortunate to continue to have great support from a lot of people, it's a team effort." George said, "There isn't really one moment or horse that stands out because they are all significant to us, it's what it is all about for us."

Beyond his record-breaking season at Harrah's Hoosier Park, George is on pace to surpass his personal record for victories in a year of 190 (2016), with 188 on the year at the end of November. Banking over \$2.1 million on the season, George currently sits 11th nationally in training victories, batting the second highest UTRS of trainers with 500+ starts of .410. Over the course of his training career, George has conditioned horses to 1,763 victories and banked over \$17.8 million.

In addition to Leading Driver and Trainer ceremonies, a trio of 14-year-olds were honored who have been staples at Harrah's Hoosier Park over the last several years as they approach mandatory retirement at the end of the year.

Major Crocker A has been the winningest horse at Hoosier Park since he arrived in Anderson in November of 2022. Visiting the winner's circle at the track 28 times since then, 10 more times than the next closest horse over that span (Gruesome Twosome – 18). A career earner of over \$1.1 million, Major Crocker A made the move to North America in 2019 after a successful career Down Under. Aging like a fine wine, Major Crocker A has won 13 times in each of the last two seasons and 73 times overall for his career. Major Crocker A retired under the care of owners Matthew and Darin Miller.

Forty-five-time career winner Sadies Art arrived at Hoosier Park one final time with the Tetrick family in tow. Bred by Marie Alice and the late Tom D Tetrick, the son of Party At Artsplace was trained for the vast majority of his career by Tom, often with Trace in the sulky. Hitting the board 110 times in his 308 start career, Sadies Art saved his best for last as his two winningest seasons came at ages 12 and 14. Taking a mark of 1:51.4 at Hoosier Park in 2020, he matched that career best this season at age 14 in a season that saw him win six times. A career earner of \$240,948, Sadies Art has been a model of consistency, winning at least once in each year of his career.

Quarter-million-dollar earner Why Don't U Stay was also honored with owners Mariah and Darrel Wright who have had the 14-year-old son of Santanna Bluechip for much the last five years. Making 338 starts over 38 different racetracks, Why Don't U Stay was a 31-time winner, banking \$250,973 over the course of his career. His final victory came at Hoosier Park last summer, scoring in 1:54 with driver Brandon Bates in the bike.

The Saturday night program wrapped up an extremely successful season at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing and Casino. Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing and Casino would like to thank all of the fans, bettors and horsemen who helped make the 2024 season at Hoosier Park an overwhelming success. Racing returns to Harrah's Hoosier Park in 2025, with the 160-day meet slated to get underway on Friday (March 14).

Ray Cable to receive Lifetime Achievement from UNY USHWA at Batavia

The Upstate New York Chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association is proud to announce that longtime western New York blacksmith, Ray Cable, will be given their 2024 Lifetime Achievement Award for his over 60-years of work and dedication to the horses who raced at Batavia Downs.

Cable was born on March 12, 1945 in Effingham, IL, and followed his father Phillip's footsteps into the farrier business. He started shoeing at age 12 as an apprentice with his father, who shod horses at racetracks on the Grand Circuit along with many county fairs across the country from their mobile truck shop before coming to Batavia to set up permanently in 1960. Since then, Ray has run his blacksmith shop on the grounds of Batavia Downs ever since.

Ray has shod thousands of horses over the years and from every class ranging from the bottom claimers to the top competing in the open, from the barns of trainers across the U.S. as well as Canada. Cable has shod some of the best in the business including the locally owned Bay's Fella (1:51.1, \$805,234) who won the \$273,458 Breeders Crown Open Pace in 1990.

Ray is one of four brothers that included Chuck, Phillip and Leon, who all became outstanding farriers. Ray's son, Ray Jr. is also an accomplished farrier and his grandsons Kelly and Chris, who are now both shoeing as well, make up the fourth generation of "Cable shoers."

Ray will be presented his award trackside during the UNY USHWA Night of Distinction that will be held at Batavia Downs on the closing night of the meet, Saturday (Dec. 7).

Beckwith, Ranger and Nickerson top Plainridge horsemen

After the final numbers for the 2024 Plainridge Park meet that ended last Friday (Nov. 29) were updated in the United States Trotting Association's database on Monday (Dec. 2), the top drivers and trainer of the year were determined. After a long driving battle between the rising star, Brett Beckwith, and the veteran, Bruce Ranger, finally wrapped up, the two rival reinsmen ended in a tie with both posting 166 wins for the meet.

On the training side, Jimmy Nickerson stood well ahead of his competition with a total of 78 conditioning victories to add yet another title to his resume.

This is the first Plainridge Park driving title for the 21-year-old Beckwith, who really came into his own at The Ridge in 2022 before taking the sport by storm at many major venues in the northeast. Beckwith finished third in the Plainridge standings last year before jumping to the top spot this season that saw him drive 888 starts with 166 wins, 162 seconds and 130 thirds, that earned his connections just over \$2.5 million in purses.

Beckwith will also win the driving title at Saratoga Raceway this year where he has a commanding 51-win lead, plus he sits third overall for dash wins among all drivers in North America with currently 577, behind only Jason Bartlett in second and the leading Aaron Merriman. Those wins have helped boost his 2024 earnings to just under \$6 million to date.

Ranger racked up his fourth consecutive driving title at Plainridge after jumping back into the sulky after a brief retirement in 2015. In his previous titles, Ranger posted a track record high 181 wins in 2021, 163 in 2022, and 152 wins last year. This season, Ranger drove 875 races at Plainridge with 166 wins, 137 seconds and 114 thirds with \$2,224,903 in purses. This is also the third year Ranger has surpassed the \$2 million mark in earnings, making him the only driver to ever accomplish that.

Ranger also drove full time in Maine all summer and all told, posted 218 wins, 173 seconds and 140 thirds with just under \$2.5 million in purses for the year.

Nickerson notched his fourth consecutive — and fifth overall — Plainridge training title this year after sending 78 winners postward which was 27 more than his nearest competitor, and earned over \$1.1 million in purses.

This is the third time Nickerson has surpassed \$1 million in purses at Plainridge and he remains the only trainer to ever cross that threshold in the history of the track.

For the entire year including starts at other tracks, Nickerson has won 102 races, which is his highest total since 2019, and \$1,320,241 in earnings, which is his highest one-year bank deposit ever.

Live racing returns to Plainridge Park on Monday (April 14), 2025 at 4 p.m.

Need a little extra green for the holiday season?

Well, you're in luck, as opportunities to walk away with an increased Christmas bankroll will expand next week at The Meadowlands, as the mile oval will add Thursday to its usual Friday-Saturday schedule, and race on Dec. 12. The Meadowlands also held a 10-race card on Thursday (Dec. 5).

Post time is unchanged for all live racing nights, with the first race heading to the gate at 6:20 p.m.

"We'll still be offering our usual Friday and Saturday programs," said track chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "At this time of year, the Thursday cards afford those who are busy with holiday obligations on the weekend to come out and enjoy a night at the races."

SLIP ME FIVE: Last Saturday (Nov. 30) saw the last major racing program of 2024 at The Meadowlands – as well as the entire industry – on Fall Final Four/FanDuel Championships Night, and, as usual, the card saw some incredible performances.

But one performer stood out from the rest.

Dexter Dunn, the native of New Zealand, completed his sixth full season of racing in the United States, and it is certain to result in the 35-year-old taking home the Dan Patch Driver of the Year Award for a fifth time in the last half-dozen years.

After winning a Breeders Crown single-season record six races over the weekend of Oct. 25-26, Dunn hit the bullseye five times Saturday on FF4/FDC Night to move his seasonal earnings past the \$16.5-million mark, over \$2 million more than his closest pursuer.

Here's a look at Dunn's five-bagger:

• Dunn put **Nelsonbriteagle NO** on the lead and the daughter of Bold Eagle—Lindy's Holiday responded with a wire-to-wire win in the FanDuel Open Mares Trot in a lifetime-best 1:49.4 on a night when the real-feel temperature was 27 degrees.

• Miki And Minnie had to race three-wide with cover, but the daughter of Always B Miki—That's The Ticket powered home nonetheless to win a second-straight major, taking the Three Diamonds for 2-year-old pacing fillies five weeks after wearing the Breeders Crown.

• The presumptive Horse of the Year **Twin B Joe Fresh** added yet another big victory to her stocked resume, completing a season in which she went 11-for-13 after winning the FanDuel Open Mares Pace.

• After going a trip that was less than opportunistic, **Captain Optimistic** prevailed in the Governor's Cup for 2-year-old colt and gelding pacers.

• In the final big race of the night, **Abuckabett Hanover** likely locked up older male pacing divisional honors after sitting a perfect pocket trip before going on to take the FanDuel Open Pace.

How did Dunn fare when he wasn't winning?

• Super Chapter almost went all the way on the lead, but in a three-way photo at the wire, it was Monserrate and driver Dave Miller prevailing in the Valley Victory for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters. Dunn and Super Chapter were just a half-length back, nudging out third-place finisher Go Dog Go.

• Luna Lovegood led to the top of the lane, but Dunn and "Luna" settled for third after What A Bid Hanover and Voguish finished 1-2 in the Goldsmith Maid for 2-year-old trotting fillies in what was the evening's most exciting finish.

• In the night's biggest upset, Logan Park went all the way on the lead for driver Doug McNair in the FanDuel Open Trot. Dunn, driving 1-9 favorite Winner's Bet, came calling first-over down the backside, but never really threatened, finishing third.

Thus, Dunn hit the board in all eight of the major events on the card. His light burned brightest on harness racing's biggest days during 2024, as his six-winner Breeders Crown and five-winner FF4/FDC proves. In addition, only one driver this year has won six races on a Meadowlands card, and that pilot was Dunn, who turned the trick on Hambletonian Day (Aug. 3), when he was in the winner's circle at the conclusion of the John Cashman Memorial (with Jiggy Jog S), New Jersey Sire Stakes 2-year-old filly trot final (Champagne Problems) and Lady Liberty (Twin B Joe Fresh).

Drew Monti and Sam Smith take titles at Batavia Downs

The Upstate New York Chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association and Batavia Downs have announced that Drew Monti and Sam Smith are the top driver and trainer for the summer/fall race meet at the Genesee County oval whose season will conclude on Saturday (Dec. 7).

Monti entered the final week of racing at Batavia with an insurmountable lead in the dash driving race with 117 wins, 19 ahead of Joe Chindano, Jr. (98) and 24 ahead of Kevin Cummings (93). He also has had 86 seconds and 79 thirds from 562 starts that gives him a .340 UDR, the highest among all drivers at the current meet who have started 150 times or more. And those starts have earned the horses he has driven \$790,221 in purses with two race days left in the meet.

Monti also hit two career milestones during the Batavia meet. He scored his 2,500th win and surpassed \$20 million in lifetime earnings.

While he also drives full time at Plainridge Park, Monti has posted one of the best overall years of his career to date. After 1,606 starts he has won a total of 235 races with 234 seconds and 196 thirds with \$2,211,936 in purses, a total which by the end of the meet will be his third highest haul ever.

This is the third driving title Monti has won at Batavia Downs after taking it in 2016 and 2018.

Similarly, Smith came into the last two days of racing well in front of his competition after already having posted 67 wins, which is 24 ahead of Chris Petrelli (43) and 40 ahead of Shawn McDonough (27) and Maria Rice (27). Smith also had 42 seconds and 53 thirds giving him a .302 UTR and \$469,988 in purses.

For all of 2024 including starts at other tracks, Smith has put up career numbers across the board. His horses have made 803 starts with 151 wins, 118 seconds and 115 thirds, giving him a UTR of .317 and earnings of \$1,158,721. It's the single best year in Smith's training tenure.

This is the second consecutive training title for Smith at Batavia Downs.
