Thoroughbreds to get a bigger piece of Ontario's pie

Ontario Racing announced Friday that the Horse Improvement Program (HIP) that funds standardbreds' Ontario Sires Stakes, among other programs, will move from a 50/50 split to one that is 55/45 in favor of thoroughbreds in three years.

Over the next three years, Ontario's thoroughbred industry will increasingly get a bigger cut of the \$25 million provincial pie that funds such programs as standardbred racing's Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS), but Walter Parkinson said the change in splits on the Horse Improvement Program (HIP) is simply a return to what the distribution historically has been.


Parkinson, the president of the Standardbred Breeders of Ontario Association (SBOA) and a board member at Ontario Racing (OR) that made the announcement on Friday, said the HIP money has been shared 50/50 between the breeds in the years since the Slots at Racetracks Program (SARP) ended in 2013. However, the announcement that the splits would now move to be in favor of the thoroughbreds -51/49 in year one (2018-19), 53/47 in year two (2020-21) and 55/45 in year three (2021-22) - is a return to the 55/45 advantage the thoroughbreds had in the SARP era.


The reason? HIP splits are determined by wagering and betting on thoroughbred racing is higher in the province where the runners hold a roughly 55/45 advantage.

"I definitely think it is representative of where the industry is at and it was representative of where it was," Parkinson said. "Prior to the ending of SARP there was a 55-45 (HIP) split on the betting dollar. That was always the traditional way... there's really no background as to why it got switched post-SARP (to 50/50), so now it has been felt – and I agree with it – that it does need to go back to the actual split, the 55-45, which is representative of the betting here in Ontario... I think it's the fair way to allocate the money and the reasonable way, as well."

Parkinson added that the change will also be phased in over three years to cushion the blow on standardbred

breeders.

Bill O'Donnell, president of the Central Ontario Standardbred Association (COSA) that represents those that race at Woodbine Mohawk Park, is also on the board at Ontario Racing. He said HIP funding has also been on the decline recently because the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) no longer adds in some \$3 million per year that it had been contributing to HIP.

After SARP ended, HIP funding was some \$30 million thanks, in part, to WEG's contribution. O'Donnell said, at the time, the thoroughbreds agreed to split that \$30 million evenly, but challenges in the thoroughbred breeding industry and low horse supply numbers no longer make that acceptable to the runners.

"All I can say is that I'm on the board," O'Donnell said. "I'm one of 10 people there. Did everybody vote for it? I can't say that. Did I vote for it? I can't say that either. I'm not saying either way because we have a non-disclosure, confidentiality agreement. You win some, you lose some, but I suppose (the thoroughbreds) felt they were losing before with (a 50/50 split)."

Ontario is an interesting case study. Though wagering is higher on thoroughbred racing, the standardbred industry is significantly larger in terms of number of horses, breeders, participants and racetracks (12 compared to two thoroughbred tracks).

What will happen to HIP funding if the wagering gap continues to grow?

"You can't take aspirin today for a headache you're going to have tomorrow," O'Donnell said. "If the handle goes to 60/40 or something we'll have to address that at another time. I don't see that happening, but who knows?"

Parkinson said he's concerned about a slippery slope that could mean even less money for the OSS and other incentive programs in the years ahead, "but I think you've got to look at it objectively and try to make everything go as smoothly as possible... going forward we're going to have to keep an eye on it.

"Every breeder has experienced hardships over the years, so anything we can do to try to make all sectors of the industry, whether it's standardbred, thoroughbred or quarter horse, as strong as possible (is important) and I think this is one of the steps to do that."

Parkinson said the split changes hopefully would strengthen the resolve of the industry to try to drive handle.

"I think that's everyone's goal to grow that wagering, whether it's gaining additional markets, international markets and finding bettors that are interested in the product that we are offering here in Ontario and just horse racing product in general. I know it's on OR's agenda and WEG's agenda and every racetrack in North America wants to increase their wagering," Parkinson said. "It's a hard thing to

do. It's a hard industry to create a new gambler, then to transition existing gamblers over to this sport from whatever other industries they are gambling on is hard as well."

Year end odds and ends

Looking back on the year in racing.

Gimpanzee won his nine races by a combined 27 3/4 lengths — with only one photo, a half-length decision in the New York Sires Stakes. He was 9 9-0-0 \$591,358

Shartin N was 24 19-1-0, \$1,053,236. It was a record-setting year for a Down Under horse in North America and for a pacing mare. But she didn't rub it in. Her 19 wins were by a combined 29 1/4 lengths, with eight of those wins by less than a full length. She won in each of the first 11 months — January (twice), February (twice), March (three times), April (once), May (twice), June (once), July (once), August (twice), September (once), October (three times) and November (once). The only time she was not favored all year was Oct. 20 at 1.20-1.

McWicked's 7-year-old season (19 12-3-2) was good for \$1,575,365 and hiked him to \$3,896,876 lifetime. This after two winless seasons:

Age 4: 10 0-3-2 \$90,283

Age 5: 4 0-0-2 \$18,650

What a month for **Jules Siegel**. He was inducted into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame in July and four weekends later, his Crystal Fashion set the world record for a gelded sophomore trotter with a 1:50.1 Hambletonian elim win.

Two-thirds of the pacing Triple Crown went to **Stay Hungry**, driven by 28-year-old Doug McNair and trained by Tony Alagna. Stay Hungry was not favored in either Triple Crown-winning race. He was \$9.40 in the Cane Pace and \$7.60 in the Messenger.

Two-thirds of the trotting Triple Crown went to **Six Pack** and his 58-year-old trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt. Six Pack won the two races by a combined 9 and a half lengths.

Mets Hall was a longshot players (almost) dream on

Hambletonian Day. He was third in his Hambletonian elimination at 40.50-1 and second in the final at 29.70-1.

Dorsudoro Hanover was involved in a 'neck' decision five times:

5/19/18 PASS - winner

6/23/18 Hempt – winner

9/20/18 Jug — runnerup

11/21/18 Progress - runnerup

11/15/18 Matron - fourth

Jimmy Freight was 20-for-21 on the board this year with a record of 11-5-4. Those 11 wins came by a combined 35 and 3/4 lengths.

— and he did it early, winning on June 29 over Hayden

Tara Ellen Taylor – Executive director Harness Horse Youth Foundation

How many people can say that their birth 'was paid for' by bartering training services for the obstetrician's racehorse? Tara Ellen Taylor, the executive director of Harness Horse Youth Foundation (HHYF), is one person who can.

Though she goes by Ellen today, she was named "Tara" after the only mare to ever beat the great Greyhound in a race. Ellen's father, mother and grandfather were all trainers and drivers of standardbreds.

"When I was 6, I was given an orphan foal named Dew. There was never a prouder owner than me when she won a matinee race at Muncie, Indiana. When her racing career was over, Dew produced some very nice state bred champions," Taylor said.

"I started out by helping my parents grooming and foaling mares. Our family preferred trotters, but the fastest horse I ever took care of was 'Gold', an Illinois-bred pacing colt. In my early 20's I was runner-up as Harness Tracks of America' Caretaker of the Year.'

"My mother served on the Harness Horse Youth Foundation (HHYF) board and I tagged along to the events. I started out as camp coordinator at the age of 16 and in 1990 I became executive director. That means I've been involved with HHYF for more than half of my life.

"In 1998, Stan Bergstein approached me about a writing curriculum for a "little league" idea and the first camp of its kind was held at Hoosier Park in 1999. Because I have been 5' ½" most of my life, I realized how intimidating average sized horses are — especially to children with little experience.

"For the first two years of the "new" format, HHYF borrowed Trottingbreds. (A 'pony-size' breed of horse that races mainly in Indiana, Quebec, Spain and Bermuda). We realized that if our program was going to grow we needed to have our own equipment, so we purchased the stable members first, a truck a few years later and then a trailer. For the past 19 summers I have been on the road non-stop for 30 to 60 days at a time, and it's now time to replace the truck."

The Harness Horse Youth Foundation is a charitable 501 ©3 organization dedicated to providing young people and their families educational opportunities with harness horses. Their goal is to foster the next generation of fans and participants.

HHYF is fortunate to have generous summer sponsors, great backing from horsemen volunteers, and a dedicated board who wants the program to grow and diversify. Because of the temperament of even the gentlest racehorse, HHYF programs are for ages 10 and up. Our five-day camps are designed for the ages of 12 to 14.

Attendees wanted even more involvement, so HHYF developed a leadership level camp for older teenagers. In keeping with the "young at heart" idea, HHYF welcomes adults to listen in at its events, too.

"One interesting informal statistic about HHYF programs is that 65-70 per cent of attendees are not from racing families," Taylor said. "My personal philosophy is if we simply provide the opportunity to expose and educate harness racing to potential new fans, then we have achieved an

important goal. However, it is extremely gratifying to see a young person develop his/her interest level to the point of being active in the business.

"Much of the success of HHYF programs is due to the horses for they are excellent teachers of many important life lessons, such as getting along with others, perseverance and gaining confidence. We are the instructors are who merely the conduits."

After the death of Ellen's father in 2016 the family farm was sold.

"I needed to heal from the emotional trauma of care-giving and had to adjust to a new lifestyle. I feel confident though that there will always be horses to curry and the chance to help a friend muck a stall, but I will not miss cracking ice from water buckets in the winter," she said, adding that, "as long as there are horses and competitive individuals, harness racing will exist in some form. I am a trainer's daughter first and foremost and believe that the 'love of the horse' should remain paramount."

Former USHWA president Maury May dead at 92

Maurice J. "Maury" May, former president of the United States Harness Writers Association and a member of the organization for 55 years, passed away Dec. 8 in Amherst NY at the age of 92.

A high school graduate at age 14, May began a 47-year career at the Buffalo News in 1942; he is remembered by colleagues as "the aide who ripped the news flash of the D-Day Invasion off the teletype machine." After serving in the Navy, he returned to the News and rose through the ranks to become assistant sports editor.

Among his several "beats" during his News career was the strong harness racing circuit of Buffalo-Batavia in Western New York, where he chronicled the local racing and also kept his readers abreast of area horses and horsemen who did well on the national harness racing scene. "Maury's Picks" were a longtime feature in the News.

May served the first of his 24 years as an USHWA director in 1966, representing the Western New York Chapter, of which he would become president. He was elected national president of USHWA for the 1985-1986 term, and received a key to the city from Buffalo mayor James Griffin. He was the Buffalo Area Bowling Council's Man of the Year in 1983, and in 1997 he was one of the first inductees into the Western New York Baseball Hall of Fame.

May is survived by two sons, Maurice Jr. and Michael; a daughter, Marcia May Farley; a brother, Richard; four grandchildren; and a great-grandchild. He was preceded in death by his wife, the former Mary Kurch.

Helpisontheway to stand in Indiana

Limited shares will be available at a price of \$15,000 and those paying cash will be eligible to a separate pool in which they may be accorded a second breeding to the stallion

Monti explodes for seven wins in Batavia finale

On a night when Drew Monti was to be honored as the top driver of the 2018 Batavia Downs meet, he put on a clinic and showed why he toted home the hardware again as he won seven races on Saturday night (Dec. 15).

Also, it was no surprise that trainer JD Perrin, who Monti regularly drives for and was also honored as the top conditioner of the session, sent out six winners of his own.

Those winning connections put the exclamation point on their stellar season as they watched Cheyenne Louie cruise to the easiest of victories in the \$20,000 Dash for the Holiday Cash late closer final, which was the feature race of the night.

Cheyenne Louie (Drew Monti) left strong and grabbed the lead past the eighth pole and from there the race was history. Cruising along in level fractions of :28.2, :58.2 and 1:27.4, Monti had the field stacked up behind as he sat chilly in the bike. At the top of the stretch several horses fanned wide to try and close the gap but Cheyenne Louie was four-lengths gone and under wraps when he hit the wire first in 1:57.

It was the seventh win of the year for Cheyenne Louie (\$3.20) whose share of the purse pushed him to \$26,983 for 2018. Cheryle Perrin owns the winner that is trained by JD Perrin.

Then the same driver/trainer pair hooked up to win the \$11,000 overnight featured open handicap pace with Lucky McTrucky.

Getting away fifth in the short field of five, Lucky McTrucky tracked the early pace before pulling past the half, tipping three deep at three-quarters and clearing the front at the top of the lane to win by three in 1:55.2.

It was the 56th career win and 14th tally of the year for Lucky McTrucky (\$5.70) who is now only \$1,095 shy of \$100,000 in earnings for 2018. Tessa Roland owns the 9-year-old McCardle gelding.

Other winners Monti steered besides the aforementioned Cheyenne Louie and Lucky McTrucky were with Cobble Beach (1:57.2, \$4.70), Rock To Glory (1:56.4, \$3.10), RM Hawk (1:55.3, \$4.10), Heaven Rocks (1:56.3, \$3.70) and OK Galahad (1:57, \$4.10).

Perrin's training double Hat Trick consisted of five that Monti drove (Cheyenne Louie, Lucky McTrucky, Rock To Glory, RM Hawk and Heaven Rocks) along with Foreign Officer (1:56.4, \$7.70) who was driven by Ray Fisher Jr.

After the 11th race this dynamic duo was named top driver and trainer of the Batavia Downs meet by the Upstate New York Chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA).

This is the second driving title for Drew Monti at Batavia Downs and third overall of his career. The 24-year-old Monti put together another stellar year in the bike; to date starting 572 times, winning 122 races, finishing second 90 times and third 72 times. Those starts earned his connections \$724,805 in purses and earned himself a Universal Driver Rating (UDR) of .337.

JD Perrin won the training title at the Downs three straight years from 2014-2016 making this his fourth title at the track. With 208 starts, Perrin trainees have won 61 times with 31 seconds and 19 thirds giving him a Universal Trainer Rating (UTR) of .409. His stable banked \$333,648 for the session.

Batavia Downs will resume live racing in 2019 on Wednesday (July 24) and is the host track of the New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) Night Of Champions, which will be held on Saturday (Sept. 14).

Reggie Raider, a 4-year-old McArdle—Miss JC Raider gelding, made up 7 lengths over the back half to triumph in 1:55.2 for Dave Palone, trainer Spencer Kahrig and owner Kahrig Racing Stable. Lyons King was 2 lengths back in second, with Class Six third.

Also kicking off Saturday was a Holiday Claiming Series for \$10,000 claiming colt, horse and gelding pacers. Doctor RJ and Fairytale Prince captured the \$8,000 splits.

The Meadows this week launched six Holiday Claiming Series that conclude on a special New Year's Eve card that also features the career finale of Foiled Again, the richest Standardbred all time with earnings exceeding \$7.5 million. First post Dec. 31 is 5:30 PM.




Why is Black Chevron N allowed to race?

He obviously had a medical issue and was basically pulled up beaten more than 40 lengths. The reason I bring this up is because he did the same thing at Yonkers two months ago. He took a ton of money and basically had to pull up before the half. So this horse has some medical problems. Why are the officials allowing him to race? I tried to call the New York Racing commission today to get an answer, but after I was transferred a couple times, I just got to leave a message on a machine. No one has gotten back to me. With all the problems with harness racing today, this appears to just be ignored. As a lifetime race-tracker, I am very concerned with the black-eye on the integrity of the sport that these types of issues bring.
