Take Care

Sarah Lauren Scott is making it her mission to make sure caretakers are appreciated for the critical role they play.

"If something doesn't exist, create it," could be a motto for Sarah Lauren Scott.

Scott is the owner/operator of SLS equine, a leader in equine therapeutics and custom race equipment. She has worked on many champions, and has designed custom race equipment worn by Atlanta, Captaintreacherous and Wiggle It Jiggleit, among others, and is the sponsor for the Caretaker of the Month Award at The Meadowlands.

A former caretaker for Rocknroll Hanover and Syrinx Hanover, Scott moved to New Jersey from Canada in 2020 and was inspired to action when watching The Big M pregame show.

"I would see Trainer and Driver of the Week come up time and time again, but no mention of caretakers," said Scott. "The message was loud and clear for me that sponsorship was required for the caretakers, and I committed."

Wanting to recognize caretakers is not new for Scott, who helped to create the inaugural Caretaker Appreciation Day at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 2018.

Scott remembers reading an article in the winter of 2017 in *The Harness Edge* that inspired her to meet with Kathy Wade Vlaar, manager of industry marketing for Standardbred Canada.

"When I read that article, it wasn't sitting right with me because I wanted to find an answer to the question: Where have the caretakers gone?" said Scott. "I reached out to my own network on social media and I asked THE question directed to caretakers. What is missing? What do you need? How can we make the job more appealing?

"Of all the comments I got back, the number one comment constantly repeated was the caretakers would work the long hours in the weather elements, work seven days a week, they would do all of the extras and all they wanted was a little appreciation."

Scott's simple idea became much more when other Canadian tracks jumped onboard and has now grown into National Caretaker Appreciation Day.

Although the world may now know the great Bulldog Hanover's caretaker, Johnny Mallia, back in 2018, when Scott chose to honor him at Mohawk's Caretaker Appreciation Day, he was not so much of a household name.

"When I called Johnny and asked him if he would accept male Caretaker of the Year, at first he declined, he's so humble," said Scott. "He said, 'Oh no, I'm doing my job. I don't need the spotlight." Eventually Scott persuaded Mallia to accept the honor.

"He is everything a caretaker is to me," said Scott. "Someone who is dedicated and a true professional that puts his horse's needs above his own. You can rely on him. I was so pleased to see Bulldog Hanover in his care. He ended up with a special horse where he deserved to be."

Since starting The Big M's Caretaker of the Month sponsorship in June 2021, Scott has done her homework and spent a lot of time at the barns watching potential honorees interact with their horses.

"Once you've been a caretaker yourself, you understand what it takes," said Scott. "You watch someone with their horse and you know."

One of her biggest supporters at The Meadowlands was the late Dave Brower, who will be sorely missed by Scott.

"He was so excited to talk about the caretakers," said Scott. "He got as excited as I did talking about them. He would either reach out to me and look for some background or he knew a lot of the caretakers. He was so great at making sure that they had some airtime."

Scott's honoree for the month of December is Elvis Garcia, who is honored to be chosen.

"It feels great," said Garcia. "Last Saturday, I went

The Second-richest Son of World Champion Walner

Grand Circuit winner Temporal Hanover arrives at Premier Acres for the 2023 breeding season after two successful seasons on the track. Conditioned by Marcus Melander, the near-millionaire hit the board in 19 of 25 starts, with nine wins. His pedigree is filled with champions and black type winners. From the first crop of World Champion and leading sire Walner, the stallion is out of Think Twice, half-sister to 2006 Horse of the Year Glidemaster. Temporal Hanover's grandam, Cressida Hanover, is a half-sister to Cynara Hanover, grandam of dual hemisphere champion and Elitloppet winner Nuncio.

Garcia, a native of Guatemala who grew up working with horses, currently works for trainer Joe Holloway and takes care of 2021 Governor's Cup champ Early Action. He and his girlfriend, Bannessa Orantes, who also works for Holloway, have a 1-year-old baby boy, Nicholas, who will be growing up with the horses

Diane Lewis, who also works for Holloway, had nothing but praise for Garcia and Scott.

"He's such a good kid and a good worker," said Lewis. "And great with the horses, especially the babies.

"It's a great thing that Sarah Lauren has done and Jeff Gural has given her the opportunity to do. Little things go a long way and a lot of grooms don't expect a lot but they do like to have a little pat on the back saying, 'Thank you, we appreciate you."

People have reached out to Scott with some caretaker nominees in the past and she is open to receiving them in the future if people reach out to her on Facebook.

It's been Scott's goal, just as she did in Canada, to bring a Caretaker Appreciation Day to The Meadowlands in 2023, and on Wednesday [Dec. 14], she got the good news that it will

happen. But until everything is finalized for that big day, she will continue to have Caretaker of the Month.

"It's a starting point," said Scott. "I thought that it was extremely important to acknowledge and show appreciation to those caretakers that are there night after night, working so hard on their horses and definitely not just recognizing ones with a champion, because we all know it takes the same amount of care to take care of an overnight horse. I do believe from what I see there are caretakers that deserve recognition that just haven't found that horse yet to take them to the top.

"I am committed to ensuring Caretaker Appreciation Day at The Meadowlands will be a day to remember. The caretakers are the backbone to our industry. Appreciation and acknowledgement will go a long way in whatever you do. Each caretaker has responsibilities that deserve to be

So Much More: too much mare

One of the rarest animals in harness racing is the pacing mare who takes on and beats male rivals in the top class at a country's top track. Woodbine Mohawk Park is that top track for Canada. So Much More (p, 5, 1:49.2s; \$937,843) is that rare animal.

"We're having quite a ride with her," said co-owner Kenn Beatson, a few days after the 6-year-old mare's latest victory in the Dec. 10 preferred. It was also fellow owner/trainer Don Beaton's 81st birthday, giving the three-man stable something extra to celebrate.

"My dad's been doing this a long, long time, but to be 81 and still spry and doing what he loves, having a great time and having

a great horse as well, it's pretty awesome for him," Kenn told HRU. "We're just a small stable, a little family stable. It's really just the three of us who work on her: Cole and my dad [Don Beatson] and myself. Cole is my little sister's son, my nephew."

On the 2022 Breeders Crown nights at Mohawk, he said Team So Much More stood out: "You look down the row in the paddock and you've got the big stables like Burke and Takter and Brett Pelling, and then you've got our little stable."

But success isn't new to the Beatson family.

"This is going back to the late 1960s," said Kenn. "My dad was interested in horse racing – he'd grown up on a farm in Granton, Ontario, where he still lives. He was going to the track a lot, just to watch the races at London, and then he just started fooling around with them a little bit. Eventually, he got one and was just pretty much self-taught – he figured it out. He had another job, but then he started getting into the horses a little bit more. He eventually quit his other job and started doing it [racing] full time."

Kenn said he "kind of grew up my entire life under a horse.

"At the home farm where we lived, we have a little half-mile track there and a barn, and growing up, that was all I ever really knew, and we raced at all the little tracks around, Goderich and so many tracks, some that aren't even around anymore: Elmira, Woodstock, Dresden, Windsor, London, and Clinton."

Beatson horses raced at Greenwood and Mohawk when good enough, occasionally venturing stateside to Michigan's Hazel Park. Kenn obtained his driving license in his early 20s, but didn't remain a full-time participant in the sport.

"I had a lot of other interests so I actually went off and started working full-time in the corporate world, which I still do, but I spend all my spare time with the horses."

Don Beaton's stable fluctuated in numbers over the years.

"He had a public stable at one time," said Kenn. "I went to the University of Guelph and studied animal science, but then after I graduated, we ran the stable together for a while. We might've got up to eight or nine [horses] at one point, but he's cut back... We were back to just one and just had So Much More for a little bit there. Now we also have one young filly [Tymal Spectrum], so we have two that are racing. In the barn, we also have our stable pony and Monster in Law [p, 6, 1:50.3s; \$476,728], who's retired now. He was a great horse for us. He raced until he was 15 and made half a million.

winter, here and there, but not shut her down. If the weather gets real bad and the tracks get snowy, we might even give her three weeks off, but probably no more than that... We're going to take it week by week and see.

"When she's so good, we always come back and say, 'Why give her a break now? She just keeps getting stronger.' She's at her very best. The horse will always tell you if they need time off – she's not telling us that. She's basically saying the opposite."

So Much More did not win the 2022 Breeders Crown on home turf, but came impressively close in her elimination and the final.

"It was so exciting watching that [Breeders Crown elim] stretch drive," Kenn said. "We thought she maybe got there. It was so close at the wire, you could barely tell. They [Test of Faith and So Much More] were millimeters apart, it felt like. That was

"Our stable has had some really nice horses over the years, we had three horses before So Much More that won 50 races – that's an accomplishment. A lot of people probably don't realize that."

So Much More is currently in a dead-heat for second winningest horse in North America this year, with a 16-for-34 record in top-caliber competition, largely at Mohawk. She raced herself out of the fillies and mares preferred and into taking on males in her last two Saturday night starts.

"She's actually won that class [WMP mares preferred/open] the last nine times she was in it," said Kenn.

"We knew she's good and we thought she could go with them, but we were surprised she was the favorite in there; she had just got beat by Sintra the week before. There were four millionaires in the race. There was American History, who's not on his form right now, but he's a former Breeders Crown winner; Sintra; Desperate Man... The field was loaded, and then she went out there and raced like she should be the 6-5 favorite.

"She's won so many races, but it still has the same level of excitement as the first one. It's an adrenaline rush every time."

What's next for So Much More, who is a strong contender to repeat her 2020 title as O'Brien Older Pacing Mare of the Year?

"We've been talking about the plan, and we're still trying to figure it out," said the younger Beatson. "We basically think that we would like to give her a bit of a rest, but we probably won't give her a long stretch of time off. She races great in the winter. What we'll probably do is give her a week or two off in the

extremely exciting... but also the Milton elimination was, for me, one of the most exciting ones of the year. That was where she went out and cut the mile, went her mile in :48.3, and finished three across the track with Mikala and Test of Faith, and was right there with them. That was huge."

He added that broodmare life is definitely not in So Much More's immediate future.

"So many people have asked us, 'Well, are you going to breed her?' I guess we probably will, when she's done racing, but she just keeps getting better as a racehorse. Why shut her down?" He also ruled out ET, due to the many unknowns of embryo transfer's effects on mares who remain in competition.

While racing against top male pacers is often frustrating for mares and their connections, the Beatson family and So Much More have had a different experience.

"You look at her in the races and she almost always looks like she's the shortest horse out there," said Kenn. "Sintra's actually not a very tall horse either, but especially when she's racing against the boys, you see they're so much bigger than her. But her heart is just as big.

"Her mark is :49.2, which is very fast for a mare, but she's certainly paced faster than that a few times. At Mohawk, you don't get that many chances to go that fast, just because you kind of need a deep field to lay down some pretty good fractions to get that type of a mile. A lot of people have told us we should try racing

her at some point in her life at Meadowlands, because most people think that it's at least a second faster than Mohawk, and you might get in a race that had the fractions to give you a chance to get a mile like that. Maybe we will someday – we'll see."

The Crown and a sub-1:49 mark eluded So Much More last season.

"We had her entered in the Breeders Crown in 2021, and she was in the final, she had drawn the #3 hole, which was a great post position, and it was in a field where we thought she could have won that day, but she got sick and we had scratch her at the last minute... so we kind of lost an opportunity there."

Kenn said he expected to keep her eligible to the 2023 Breeders Crown at Hoosier Park, as well as the Roses Are Red and Milton Stakes for pacing mares at Mohawk.

Among her open/preferred level wins to date, Kenn said four of the 36 were over horses and geldings, "so those 4 are all special.

"If you go back to her very first one, it was also special, because she did it as a 3-year-old filly in December 2019. How many fillies ever even race in a fillies and mares preferred, let alone win one? She went her last quarter in :25.4; she came first-up and just wore down the favorite, Kendall Seelster, who was the reigning best mare at that time. So that was her first-ever preferred. That was an incredible race. It was only just shortly after that, in February 2020... She wasn't even really 4 based on her birthdate, and she raced against the boys in an open/preferred and won, sitting last the whole way and circling them in the stretch on a snowy night."

What sets So Much More apart in her capabilities? The Beatsons haven't sought out distaff races for her at other tracks, opting to keep her in the Mohawk preferred. Isn't it tough on a mare?

"I've heard a lot of people say that exact same thing," said Kenn. "I think that there is an element of truth to that: I think a lot of mares do struggle racing against fast boys, especially at the higher levels, because racing against fast boys, they're usually big, strong horses as well, and they've got a lot of depth. It's one thing to be able to go a mile in around 1:50; it's another to be able to do it sitting on the outside or having to do it all in the last three-eighths or something like that. It's a different thing from just going out there and cutting a mile in 1:50 and not having anybody around you...You have to be able to do it the tough way. She doesn't seem to mind it.

"I know sometimes James [MacDonald] has come in after driving her against the boys, saying it might not look a lot different, but he knows that it's tougher out there. Like two starts ago when she finished second to Sintra, the track was a little deeper that day – I think the track was even rated one second off, even though it was a clean, fast night...She was struggling to keep up, whereas the other horses like Wheels On Fire and Carbine are so big. Their feet are twice as big, so they can handle going through that muck a little bit better. But it doesn't seem to wear on her one bit."

Her success seems to come down to a competitive mindset that matches her small but powerful physique.

"She just has a heart unlike any horse I've seen. She thrives on looking other horses in the eye and getting up beside them and saying, 'Let's fight – let's do this,'" said Kenn. "It's not an ideal situation, but it doesn't bother her. Even when you warm her up, if there's nobody around and then she spots a horse that's say an eighth of a mile in front of her, she locks in and all she wants to do is catch it. She won't stop until you pretty much let her catch up to it.

"At the track, she locks into a zone, with her game face on, and it's all business. At home, especially turned out in the field, she loves to play and roll. She always has her ears up and she's friendly, and she's a pet. But at the track, she's all business."

Famously purchased off Standardbred Canada's Horses for Sale board for a negotiated \$50,000, So Much More has been a catalyst for a friendship between her PEI breeder and current connections.

"We didn't know Doug MacPhee at all at the time, but we've gotten to know him and his family really well because they're her biggest fans in the world," said Kenn. "He came out to visit her at our farm here in Ontario this summer, and he came up for the Breeders Crown final. We talk to him online all the time. We've become good friends.

"He still has her mother, Ladysai, who he breeds every year. He's just really thrilled with the way things turned out, because she was his little baby and he wanted her to go to a good home and have a great career racing."

Maturity has helped So Much More step up her already-strong game in 2022.

"I think its general knowledge that a horse grows until maybe they're about 5," said her 51-year-old co-owner. "She really grew throughout this year, even, which is partially why she's continued to get better-because she was always a little bit on the small side, and she's still not tall, but she really filled out in her back end this year.

"So many of them get retired when they're 3, 4, 5 and they haven't even reached their potential yet, in my opinion. She's proof of that. She's just getting better and setting up to have a great 7-year-old season."

If HRU readers happen to see a quick-moving free-legged pacer dashing along an unpaved road in Granton, ON this winter, it could be the famous mare, in line to a Beatson family member.

"When they get too much snow, she trains just going up and down the gravel road. A horse of her caliber and that's where she trains!" said Kenn, laughing. "It's a rural road, there's not much traffic, and you know your neighbors."





Kolton Hauser proud to be a fifth-generation horseman

Standardbred racing is no doubt a family affair for Kolton Hauser, but his love for the sport goes well beyond just his DNA.

The 17-year-old Iowan is in the early stages of his horse racing life, one that is, at least for right now, best described as a jack-of-all-trades career.

And while he represents the fifth generation of the sport on his mother's side, the teenager, in his final year of high school, never felt compelled to follow in the footsteps of others.

His love for the horses and horse racing is as genuine as can be.

"I guess you can say I was born into it," said Hauser. "Both sides of my family have been involved in it for a long time. My great-grandpa, Keith Carey, he's 101 now, and has been in racing for 80 years or so. My grandpa [Jeff] and my uncle [Curtis] also are in racing. In the summer, all of us together at the races. That's the story of my connection to the sport."

In the middle of the worldwide pandemic, Hauser had a chance, albeit brief, to really immerse himself in the standardbred scene.

For a two-week period, during a school break, he was at the family barn every day helping his grandfather, playing his part in readying the horses for the races.

Hauser, an aspiring driver, has done the same thing, although in the summers, ever since then.

"I haven't driven in a race yet, but I did compete in a race for grooms. I've done that twice and so far, and I'd say that's the biggest thrill. In lowa, we also have the championship weekend. When you have a horse that you've taken care of since it was a weanling and you see them race as part of that big event, that's pretty cool too."

There are two particular horses that come to mind when Hauser speaks of the bond he's forged with certain pacers and trotters he's been associated with so far.

Minnie Vinnie, a 7-year-old son of Millionaire Cam bred and co-owned by his grandfather, is one of them.

The pacer has won nearly half of his 90 starts, 43, to be exact, to go along with 12 seconds and 12 thirds, and just shy of \$270,000 in career earnings.

"He's been such a nice horse for us and he's a nice horse to be around. He's very talented at what he does."

And then there is Nat A Cam.


Co-bred by Hauser's great-grandfather (who also owns), grandfather and late great-grandmother, the six-year-old pacing daughter of Millionaire Cam sports a mark of 26-16-11 from 72 starts, coupled with nearly \$65,000 in earnings.


The bay mare has been a perfect teammate for Hauser.

"She's taught me pretty much everything I know when it comes to driving. She's my great-grandpa's mare. They bought the broodmare Nat A Tat Tat, and this is her daughter. One of those horses will probably be the first one I drive in a pari-mutuel race, so that will be something I am really looking forward to."

Hauser has already drawn a gameplan for the next five or so years, one that includes a combination of education and equines.

Next year, he'll attend college, where he will most likely pursue a degree in agricultural business. But his connection with horses won't be put on hold during those years in the classroom.

"I took my horse racing driver's test, which is a big step towards furthering that part of my life. The short-term goal is to drive and win a race. A long-term goal, that's tougher because I'm going to school. But I will still be training horses and hopefully, I will have a bigger role in Iowa harness racing than I do now."

Hauser is also looking to court success on the hardcourt with his high school basketball team.

After a tough start to the season, the squad has turned things around of late.

"I really enjoy basketball a lot. With racing, especially in the summer, there's not much time to really do anything outside of that. But I really like basketball. We struggled early after playing some really good teams to begin with, but we've got a nice stretch where we can get some wins and get things back on the winning track."

Not surprisingly, Hauser does see connections between hoops and horse racing.

"With basketball, you have to work as a team to reach your goals and you do the same with racing. Me, my grandfather and my uncle, if we disagree on an approach, we have to be able to talk about it, work together to solve problem and try to achieve success, just like in basketball."

And, just like when he's playing his sport of choice, Hauser is willing to do a little bit of everything to ensure everything runs smoothly at the barn.

It's why he is anything but a one-trick pony.

"In the summer, every morning, we have to train the horses, jog them, make sure they get their exercise every day, feed them, clean their stall, and just make sure they're doing well. Currently, me and my grandfather are working with the weanlings, getting them broke and doing all that. On race days, I help harness and help unharness, bath, and all that stuff."

None of the jobs are met with resistance. In fact, Hauser happily embraces every moment.

"It really nice to be able to work with your family. It makes everything so much easier. I don't know how to explain it, but when you have that opportunity to work with the people you are closest with, it makes every day a good one. And to see how happy my great-grandfather is, that always makes me happy. He gets around really well for his age. In the summer, he's at the barn every morning. If he doesn't make it, he apologizes and feels bad about it. But you can see how much racing and family means to him."

Just as it does any time Carey sees his great-grandson sitting behind Nat A Cam.

"My great-grandfather has taught me so much about racing and Nat A Cam, she's done the same. That's a really cool association to have. I love racing and to enjoy all of that with my family, that just makes it extra special."





Fresh names set for the 2023 Prix d'Amérique

Sunday's (Dec. 11) race card at Vincennes in Paris contained the second B-race ahead of 2023 edition of Prix d'Amérique and some well merited trotters were in the field of 16 trotters.

Elitloppet winner Etonnant and European top trotter Vivid Wise As were two of the best horses in the field and even if both of them, basically, are already in the Prix d'Amerique set for the last Sunday in January 2023, they needed to show some kind of condition in the \$125,000 Prix du Bourbonnais over 2,850 meters.

Etonnant opened quickly and hit the lead when the field showed up in front of the grandstand for the first time. The pace wasn't set at an excessively high level throughout the race and many factors pointed towards a pretty safe win for the leading Etonnant, but his power started to lessen at the top of the stretch and instead, Jean-Michel Bazire-trained 5-year-old **Hooker Berry** (Booster Winner), looked as the strongest horse when the stretch remained. Hooker Berry was served a perfect power saving trip as third on the inside, behind Vivid Wise As and when the latter showed signs of fatigue in the last turn, driver Nicolas Bazire opted to lift out Hooker Berry for an attack towards leader Etonnant.

Hooker Berry sailed away to a safe win in a mile rate of 1:57.1 over 1.7 miles and behind him, Hussard du Landret finished strongly as second. Etonnant held on to third place while Vivid Wise As became very tired and finished far back in the field.

TOUGH FIGHT IN PRIX DE L'ETOILE

Just A Gigolo (Boccador de Simm) has proved that he is in the top of the French "J-crop" (3-year-olds) and Philippe Allaire's trotter has collected several big trophies during his first two seasons on the track and in Sunday's (Dec. 11) \$210,000 Prix Ready Cash/Prix de l'Etoile for 3-year-olds, Just A Gigolo once again impressed.

Philippe Allaire's horse has many times solved his races on pure talent, being the horse in the crop that most effectively finds his way towards the wire. In Sunday's race, he had to pick out another tool from his box.

Franck Nivard sent Just A Gigolo to the lead a half mile into the 2,100 meters long race and the duo seemed unconcerned in front. But when Jack Tonic found room in the last turn after a pocket trip, Just A Gigolo seemed disarmed at the top of the stretch and Franck Nivard had to convince his horse that the race wasn't over yet. Just A Gigolo showed great morale as he came back on the inside, got advantage of the outside horse and even held on when quick finisher Juliet Papa Bravo attacked far outside on the stretch.

By a nose the win ended in Just A Gigolo's favor and he won in a mile rate of 1:57.1 over 1.3 miles.

Just A Gigolo has 14 wins in 19 starts so far and his bank account says that \$880,000 is his lifetime earnings.

CALGARY GAMES IS BACK

It's hard to tell how good horse Timo Nurmos' trained Calgary Games (Readly Express) is. After nine lifetime starts prior to Wednesday's (Dec. 14) show at Solvalla, the 5-year-old undefeated colt hasn't battled among the best older trotters in Europe. To be honest, the opponents in Wednesday's race at Solvalla are not comparable to what kind of horses Calgary Games will have to face when he travels to France and Vincennes in a couple of days, but anyway, the way he moves and the way he looks makes him to be the big favorite to win the 2023 Prix d'Amérique, if he enters the race.

Timo Nurmos' trotter hit the lead after 500 meters on a snowy track and driver Björn Goop was allowed to lower the pace dramatically during the race's first mile. But when he asked something more in terms of speed from Calgary Games in the last turn, the duo left the opponents behind with several lengths just in a few steps and Calgary Games cruised to superior win via a 26.3 last quarter.

Ten starts, 10 wins and it looks like Timo Nurmos once again will win the Prix d'Amérique, because there will be no other horses entering Prix d'Amérique looking as good as Calgary Games does right now.

Cinema standardbred: a plot to promote the sport of harness racing - Part 9

Alternative Actions (AA) launched this series offering a solution to the film industry's ambivalence towards harness racing: someone needs to write a screenplay that has nothing to do with harness racing.

The reimagined screenplay is not a gimmick. It gets the attention of producers because they know it is a powerhouse launching pad for a film project; they know the building blocks of a movie are the characters and their stories. They know "The Godfather" is a reimagined "King Lear."

Famous screenwriter Dalton Trumbo once pitched a movie to a producer. "The story of a gangster, his rise and fall." The producer said, "I've seen that a few times." Trumbo responded, "Because it always makes money." Even a moderately successful reimagined script-to-movie focusing on strong characters can introduce the sport to hordes of people continuing to ignore it.

The series' example, using "Frankenstein," more than suggests the literary world is lousy with examples for your "Frankenstein" model; it proves the perfect harness-racing promotional vehicle can get major attention. Sure, the script is only the beginning, but without one there is no movie. From experience, as well, I saw many screenwriters wasting their time looking to write "something new," only to witness rejection by producers worried to become involved with... something new.

A story driven by strong characters can work anywhere, any time. In a reimagined "Of Mice And Men" the setting does not matter; the era does not matter. Do some research. Make a list of possibilities. Shuffle the sources from one genre to another. Find a harness racing scenario that does not draw attention to itself. Be a writer first and a standardbred lover last. Another thing, while researching and writing, do not fall victim to using any of the source material, even when you have altered its facade. Stick to reimagining.

I was taught this lesson early in my career. I was a young writer in Hollywood trying to get to sell jokes to veteran performers. I submitted material to a long-time comedian. Expressionless, he read the jokes I typed on hotel stationary.

"Well?" I said.

"You're trying too hard," he said.

"What do you mean? Aren't my jokes funny?"

"Look, you're wet behind the ears. You don't get it, so let me put it to you straight. Amateurs imitate. Professionals steal."

I changed my approach to writing once I understood he meant what we call "reimagining."

Another professional comic came along and said, "Remember, there are only five jokes in the world."

Truth sunk in when I awoke to that comment. It was like Aristotle telling his philosophy students, "There is nothing new under the sun" years before the invention of the Whoopee cushion.

Do not call the process theft if that makes you feel better. Remember reimagining leaves plenty of room for creativity.

EPILOGUE

I am sure there are more than a few of you clever enough to take full advantage of reimagining a script where harness racing components come off naturally; one that does not intimidate potential investors because "it has that cart horse racing thing in it."

Gaitway Gal completes DSBF series sweep

Much like her little brother, Gaitway Guy, did in the November Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for rookie pacing colts and geldings, the GTY Stable's homebred **Gaitway Gal** swept through the fall DSBF series for 3-year-old pacing fillies, capping that sweep with a 1:55.3 win in Wednesday's (Dec. 14) \$100,000 divisional championship at Bally's Dover.

Pat Berry floated Gaitway Gal into third early while 36-1 long shot Odds On Surfer Gal (driven by Corey Callahan) strode clear from post seven to control a :27.3 first quarter. Gaitway Gal brushed to the fore with a lap to go and controlled a :56.1 half before fending off a stout first-over challenge from 2-5 favorite Shabby Chic (Tim Tetrick) through three-quarters in 1:25.4.

After shrugging off Shabby Chic's challenge through the far turn, Gaitway Gal asserted herself in the stretch and won by 3-1/2 widening lengths. Shabby Chic preserved second; Odds On Surfer Gal maintained third after gapping the pocket behind the backstretch duel.

Gaitway Gal has now won 11 of 18 career starts and has banked \$227,304. Jeff Smith trains the Delmarvalous—Brussels Hanover filly, who paid \$5.20 to win as the 8-5 second choice.

In the \$20,000 consolation, **Smokey's Passion** won gate-to-wire in 1:57.2, defeating Spin Girlfrin' by a widening three lengths. Tony Morgan drove the Roddy's Bags Again-Ash Larue filly, who paid \$3.60 to win, for owner Jeffery Clark and trainer Eric Davis.

NAVY BLUE COASTS TO DSBF TROT CHAMPIONSHIP

Navy Blue completed a sweep of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 3-year-old male trotters at Bally's Dover with a lifetime best 1:56.2 in Tuesday's (Dec. 13) \$100,000 championship event — but he was forced to employ new tactics to get the job done.

With fellow second-round winner Big Daddy D leaving aggressively to control the terms, trainer-driver Art Stafford Jr. rode the pocket with Navy Blue through almost the first half of the race before angling outside and dueling the pacesetter down through the home turn en route to a two-length victory.

Big Daddy D, driven by Cody Poliseno, burst clear through the first 100 yards. Navy Blue, who came away third, worked alongside Tua (driven by Montrell Teague) through the first turn before landing in the second spot before a :28.3 first quarter. Navy Blue drafted contently behind Big Daddy D through a measured :58.1





half before Stafford switched him off the pegs with just over three-eighths of the one-mile race remaining.

Navy Blue stuck his nose in front at the 1:27.1 three-quarter sectional, put away Big Daddy D on the final turn, and used a :29.1 closing quarter to edge away by a hand-driven two lengths. Big Daddy D was an isolated second, 4-1/4 lengths better than JAs Bluestone (Victor Kirby), who rallied gradually into third.

Stafford, who also bred Navy Blue, shares ownership in the Anders Bluestone—Overnight Hit gelding with Wyatt Starkey. Now a 12-time winner from 16 starts, Navy Blue has banked \$217,986 thus far in his career. He paid \$2.40 to win.

In the \$20,000 DSBF consolation, **Canoe Trip** outlasted a late challenge from Little Georgie to win by a half-length in 2:00.4. Allan Davis drove the Anders Bluestone—Political Starlet gelding for trainer Linda MacDonald. Owner Shirley Shand bred the four-time winner in partnership with late harness racing publicist Marv Bachrad's Serendipity Stable.

SHES ALL WOMAN CAPTURES THIRD DSBF CHAMPIONSHIP

Shes All Woman mounted a monstrous middle move and vanished from her seven foes in Monday's (Dec. 12) \$100,000

Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series final for 3-yearold trotting fillies at Bally's Dover, capping a series sweep with a decisive 1:58.3 win.

Saddled with the outside post in the field of eight, Victor Kirby took his time with the 2-5 favorite, floating her into midfield while Just Pump It (driven by Art Stafford Jr.) and Miss Timber Wolf (Kim Vincent) sparred for the lead through a :28.4 first quarter. As Just Pump It — who yielded on the first turn before retaking with a lap to go — backed the half to :59, Shes All Woman began her uncovered blitz to the fore, sweeping from fifth with a lap to go to a 2-1/2-length lead at three-quarters in 1:28.3.

The Anders Bluestone—Wark Woman filly steadily widened her advantage on the far turn, leading by 6-1/2 lengths at the eighth pole before Kirby geared her down to a 5-1/4-length score over Miss Timber Wolf, who re-rallied to save second from the tiring Just Pump It.

John Wagner trains 17-time winner Shes All Woman, who has banked \$294,780 in her career for owner/breeder Pamela Wagner. The win gave Shes All Woman her third DSBF series title; she swept the 2022 series for 3-year-olds at Harrington Raceway in the summer and also won the Dover series for 2-year-olds in November 2021.

Gulf Shores to stand in Minnesota, bonus available

Gulf Shores p,2,1:51.3f; 3,1:50.3f (\$653,270) will stand his first season in 2023, at Bluff Country Equine in Minnesota. He represents one of the first sons of the young pacing supersire Downbytheseaside to go to stud, and is one of his most accomplished offspring. Racing from the Brian Brown stable his freshman and sophomore seasons, he showed outstanding early talent, winning nearly \$500,000 as a 2 year old. As a freshman he won Ohio's Triple Crown going undefeated in the Buckeye state, and showed his national-level talent capping off his season finishing second by a nose in both his elimination and the final of the Breeders Crown at The Meadowlands.

The former \$100,000 yearling represents a stallion that can be crossed on many different maternal lines, being from a Dragon Again dam. According to trainer Brian Brown, "Gulf Shores was a perfect horse to be around and to race. He had a great gait, and overcame some issues at times; he always tried very hard."

A bonus program will be available as an added feature for those breeding to Gulf Shores. For mares bred to the stallion in 2023 (2024 foals), a \$5,000 bonus will be paid to the breeder of the highest money earning two year old in 2026, a \$2,500 bonus will be paid to breeder of the second highest earner, and a \$1,000 bonus will be paid to the breeder of the third highest earner.

Owner Jeff Fought had this to say regarding the decision to stand Gulf Shores in Minnesota.

"I feel the Minnesota program is one of most underrated programs nationally. The opportunity for both sire stake funds and breeder's awards, as well as Minnesota-sired bonuses is something that should not be overlooked by national breeders. There were farms from Ohio, Indiana and Ontario that called about standing the horse, but at the end of the day Minnesota is a perfect fit."

Gulf Shores will stand at the premier breeding facility in Minnesota, Bluff Country Equine, for a fee of \$2,000 with shipped semen available. Tetrick, George successfully defend <u>Harrah's Hoosier</u> Park titles

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino brought to a close its 29th season of live harness racing on Saturday (Dec. 10). In addition to a 13-race card, the leading driver and leading trainer honors were awarded. Driver Trace Tetrick took home his 11th leading driver title and trainer Tyler George brought home his third consecutive leading trainer trophy.

The all-time leading driver at Harrah's Hoosier Park, Tetrick picked up right where he left off following a record breaking season in 2021. Hopping in the bike 1,750 times this season, Tetrick visited the winner's circle 387 times in 2022, the second highest win total in any season recorded by a driver at Harrah's Hoosier Park behind only Tetrick's 2021 total of 403 wins. As it has been in seasons past, the top three drivers consisted of Tetrick, John DeLong and Sam Widger. DeLong held the silver title with a record breaking season of his own with 276 wins from 1,635 starts, with Widger completing the podium picking up 232 wins from 1,531 starts at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

Taking home his ninth consecutive leading driver title, Tetrick currently resides once more in the top-5 nationally in driving wins, sitting fourth with 536 victories nationwide. Since picking up his first \$1 million dollar season in 2007, Tetrick has continually earned at least \$2 million every season since, and in 2022 scored his first \$7 million season. Tetrick surged over the \$75 million mark for his career in 2022 and rapidly approaches 7,000 career victories with 6,848 career trips to the winner's circle thus far. With the Breeders Crown set to return to his home track in 2023, Tetrick won't only be looking for his 12th driving title, but also to his Breeders Crown total which currently stands at three with crown victories coming with Freaky Feet Pete in 2015, and Blazin Britches and Fiftydallarbill in the Breeders Crown debut at Hoosier Park in 2017.

"I'm just very fortunate to get to drive a lot of great racehorses," Tetrick said. "I'm so grateful to the trainers and owners that put me up on such great horses, as well as the grooms and caretakers that do such an incredible job caring for these horses, I'm incredibly fortunate to get to drive great horses for great people."

After winning his first Harrah's Hoosier Park leading trainer title in 2020, Tyler George hasn't relinquished the training title since, picking up his third consecutive title in 2022. George smashed the all-time single season wins record for a trainer, with his pupils scoring 126 wins in 2022, breaking the previous record of 119 shared by George's 2021 and originally set in 2018 by Jeff Cullipher. Across all tracks in 2022, it was also a record breaking earnings year for the George stable with his first ever \$2 million dollar season in 2022 headlined by two Indiana Sire Stakes Super Final winners in Need To Breathe and Adamsville Road, as well as standout freshman pacing filly Rollin Rosie. George is no stranger to Indiana Sire Stakes success, having trained the likes of

Indiana Sire Stakes champs, Golden Paradise and Always A Prince, the latter of which garnered national attention with a romp in the \$350,000 TVG Final in 2019 at The Meadowlands for George.

"It's a really special accomplishment for our stable," George said.
"I couldn't do it alone, I'm so thankful for Cassy and the great team of people we work with each and every day, wonderful owners and Trace Tetrick always does such a good job driving, it's a total team effort."

The 2023 season kicks off on Friday, March 24 at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino and will feature the 30th edition of the track's signature race, The Dan Patch Stakes, as well as the long-awaited return of the Breeders Crown on Oct. 27 and 28.

The incident occurred when Beback was out fishing on Aug. 31 at Horseshoe Lake at the De Witt Recreation area in Batavia, NY. As he was taking his fishing gear to the water, he was approached by a man who was yelling, "She fell out of the kayak!" The man's friend was an older woman who was unfamiliar with the currents in the lake on a windy day, tipped over and was unable to get back upright.

Beback dashed to his truck to get his kayak, paddled out to the middle of the lake and was able to get the woman back in her kayak before dragging her to the center island where they waited for authorities to come in a boat and get her back to shore. The event was well documented in the local news and Beback was greeted as a hero when he arrived to race at Batavia Downs that night.

Ever humble, Beback didn't want any notoriety for his heroics and simply said in an interview, "I'm just glad I ended up there that day and was able to help."

Beback's actions were representative of the caring and helpful nature harness racing horsemen and women are known for and as such, not only helped bring someone in dire straits to safety, but also put the sport in a very positive light nationally. And UNY-USHWA and Batavia Downs are pleased to present him with this award.


OHHA names winner of 2023 Stallion Directory Photo Contest
