When it comes to talent, 1091 Sheridan is no amateur

The USHWA Amateur Driver of the Year has found success in partnership with Team Tritton.

When Newton "Yogi" Sheridan was informed that he was chosen as the United States Harness Writers Association Amateur Driver of the Year, he got emotional and thanked God and his family — his wife, Nickeya, and four children, Naeem, Mekhi, Khalani, and Khalia — for being his support system.

Sheridan, 46, is a second-generation horseman and has been around harness racing from the time he could walk.

Sheridan's love of the game came from his father, Melvin, and although the senior Sheridan died when Yogi was in the first grade, a lasting impression was made on Yogi and his three older brothers, Nathaniel, Mark and MJ.

Unlike many of the amateur drivers that Yogi races against, harness racing is his sole profession. He has a small stable of four that he trains, one of which he owns. He also owns a piece of both Yayas Hot Spot N and Muscle Factory A with partners Team Tritton Inc.

The Trittons — Shane and his wife, Lauren — moved to the U.S. from Australia in 2020 and last year were looking to get Yayas Hot Spot N into some amateur races.

"We've had him since he was 2 years old and he's 14 now," Shane said of Yayas Hot Spot N. "Yoqi was a pretty accomplished driver...

so, we kind of sussed him out and asked if he'd be willing to drive a few of our horses if we had anything that fit.

"And after a while, we realized he's a good driver. One of the main things we love about him is that he cares a lot about the horses and he listens and he tries to help with improving them and lets you know what you can do to help them, which, you know, is a big thing for a driver, let alone an amateur driver."

Yogi was beyond appreciative talking about how he feels about the Trittons.

"They are nothing less than amazing, both of them," Yogi said of Shane and Lauren. "They gave me the opportunity of a lifetime. For me, somebody that, you know, is just struggling in the game and just trying to get a little something to work with, they gave me the opportunity.

"I never had that opportunity to have decent horses to drive and just to have them feel confident and feel secure to where they don't care what I do. And they let me learn on their horses and let me make mistakes and they're never mad. I can't thank them enough."

It was earlier this year that Yogi and the Trittons officially became partners.

"I soon realized that a lot of the amateur drivers own their own horses because they don't earn a living driving the horses," Shane said.

On the United States Trotting Association website, "a driver who has not received valuable compensation for his or her services as a driver," is how an amateur is defined.

"I approached Yogi and said, 'Look, I'd love for you to come on board and take a share in some of these horses because I want you to celebrate when we win; I know you love winning when you drive them," Shane said. "But these amateur drivers don't earn anything from a driver's point of view, and we wanted him to be on board so that when we did win, he won as well, financially... That was the main reason we wanted him to be part of the good times because he was doing a good job for us and we kind of felt like it was only fair that he got something out of it as much as we did. And, you know, it's been a great ride."

Yogi said that Muscle Factory A is a challenging horse for him to drive but he continues to do so because it's a learning experience. Shane also had a view on the pairing of Yogi with their horse.

"Put it this way, if it wasn't for Yogi, Muscle Factory probably would have been retired because no one could handle him," Shane said. "Dexter [Dunn] drove him, a lot of them drove him, and said he was too much. So, Yogi probably doesn't understand that; he thinks he's just driving him, but he's done better than what most drivers would have."

In addition to the Trittons, Yogi said that Izzy Estrada, Terry and Holly Morgan and Pete Pellegrino have all supported him with drives.

Yogi said if he were a younger man, without a wife and small children at home, trading in the amateur ranks for a pro career would make sense since he would have the time to travel to smaller tracks where more drives would be available.

"I wish I had enough power to where I can say, I want to drive in the professional races," Yogi said. "But we all know when you go to the professional races, it's another step, a bigger step.

"And you've got to prove yourself and you've got to come in the professionals with a barn, with a big barn, with a nice barn, and you've got to have power.

"Right now, I've got a little bit of power and I just like driving. There's no other thing. I just like driving."

Shane said he hopes that more trainers will consider giving Yoqi more opportunities in some professional races.

"We don't even see him as an amateur driver. I have great respect for him as a driver," Shane said. "I have no trouble using him on any horses I have. It doesn't matter if it's an amateur race or not.

"I just wish there was a way that he could make a living out of it, so I didn't feel so bad when he drives winners for me that he doesn't get as much as he should. "The God's honest truth is that there's horses I have that when I put them in the box, I would rather have Yogi driving them over some of the more accomplished drivers because there's some of these horses that need someone to work with them and push through the awkwardness of it. Yogi does that and he's willing to work with it, where a lot of other professional drivers, unfortunately, they're at that place where they don't like to do that; they would rather drive something else that they prefer.

"So, Yogi is probably underutilized for that point that he will work to the horse rather than just drive. It's probably one of the main reasons he's very successful in the amateurs and it's something that I'm sure a lot more trainers could utilize if they give him a chance.

"He does good for us, and if more people will give him a chance, I'm sure they'd be just as happy as we are."

Remembering Freehold, Part 3

It's starting to get real. VERY REAL. There are only single-digit days until the oldest pari-mutuel track in North America, Freehold Raceway, is closing its doors for good on Dec. 28.

This is a track, folks, that opened in 1853 as The Freehold Driving and Golf Club. It was at Freehold in 1967 that the 1-2-3 finishers in the Oct. 14 feature were Talent Show, Shannon Irishman, and Niagara Byrd. She, the latter, was the dam of none other than Niatross who 13 years later dominated in the fifth edition of the James Dancer for sophomore pacing colts and geldings. Niagara Byrd was the only broodmare retained by owner Elsie Berger when she was downsizing a few years prior!

It was at Freehold that "Roll Back the Prices Day" really was just that in October 1976 when everything was 10 cents!

The memories are plentiful. For example, I remember:

• Bobby Blum, Clark Malady, Rheo Filion, Ken Kalikow, Lou Telymonde, Otto Pisani, Lou Sperendi, Jim Larente, Dean Turcotte, Charlie Kavanagh, Steve Oliwa, Mario Merillo, Richard Tullo, Joe Lipari, Joe Andolpho, Mike Gubnitsky, Robert Campbell, John

Dekovitch, Pius Augustine, Ron Carbone, Tom D'Altrui, George Lutz, Phil McGee, Arthur Morris, Santo Merillo, Ray Baynes, Alex Kavoleff, James Rathbone, Tom Devitis, Robert Apice, Jim Tirone and Milton "Muggins" Feldman.

- Anthony Abbatiello driving (Farm Nibble), running a successful stable, with all kinds of future human stars crediting their time with Abbatiello as a huge turning point for them. Oh, Abbatiello was no doubt the most influential person for standardbred racing thriving in the Garden State with tireless efforts resulting in the new "Super Track," The Meadowlands.
- The Yonkers Trot coming to Freehold, NJ, in 2005 with Strong Yankee taking down the Triple Crown leg while construction at Yonkers was finalized.
- As a freshman at Rutgers in the fall of 1974 taking a fellow classmate, a couple of years ahead, by the name of Steve Katz, to a racetrack for the very first time. Katz catapulted that into a strong career/presence at both Lana Lobell and Walnut Hall.
- Often waiting eight-to-10 deep in line to get that day's program.
- Bernie (did he EVER miss a day?), Jersey Freeze, The Cardigan Bay Room, Speedo's picks and Lawton's too, on the bottom of every page.
- Loosh (Lucien Fontaine) telling me about Rum Customer and Hodgen Special going at it in the August 1969 invites.

Glenn Holland's unexpected love of trotters was a Drop The Hammer moment

The owner of Inter Dominion trotting champ The Locomotive wanted nothing to do with trotters until a pacing-bred yearling proved his prowess as a trotter.

Disappointment and frustration have spawned a love of the trotter for hugely successful Australian businessman Glenn Holland.

It's a love that has transcended Australia and saw Holland and his close friend, New South Wales (NSW) trainer/driver Darren Hancock, splurge on three yearlings — two Chapter Seven colts and a Tactical Landing filly — at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale just a few months ago.

Holland paid for a slice of those babies when the best horse he has raced, 4-year-old Muscle Mass entire The Locomotive, won last Saturday night's Group 1 Inter Dominion final at Menangle. Hancock was standing by his side.

The Hancock connection — one of Australian harness racing's most famous families — goes back over 30 years for Holland.

"I was in my early 20s and knew an old trainer at Condell Park, near where I grew-up, called Jack Kelly," Holland said. "I didn't know anything about horses, but Jack was struggling with his health, so I'd often help him carry the gear and fill the water buckets for him. That's where it started for me.

"Richard Hancock, Darren's father, was Jack's driver. And when Richard retired, Darren took over the driving and our friendship grew from there."

Then came a big pause.

"I had a long time out of the game while I built my business [Kinetic Sourcing Group]," Holland said. "It was a hard slog early and I spent five years in Shanghai really growing it."

Kinetic Sourcing Group was founded in 2000 and grew to have a supply chain network across 15 countries and over \$1 billion in annual turnover before Holland sold out six months ago.

"It's given me back the time to travel to places like Bathurst and Newcastle to watch The Locomotive race, and to get down to Goulburn for what turned out to be a huge celebration last Sunday of the Inter Dominion with Brad [Hewitt, trainer/driver] and the crew," Holland said. "I can really step things up now, but I did get back into the sport gradually from about 15 years ago.

"I played around with a few and had some success, but then I said to Darren before the 2016 Australian Gold Yearling Sale, I want to get serious and buy a proper pacer."

Holland spent \$105,000 on a Bettors Delight colt, out of the Christian Cullen mare Daniela Hantuchova, who raced as Drop The Hammer.

"He showed promise in some nice pacing races at 2, but when he came back at 3, Darren said he wasn't putting in as a pacer and all he wanted to do was trot," Holland said. "I was like, 'You're kidding me. I don't want a trotter. Fix it."

But trotting it was and Drop The Hammer finished third in the 2018 NSW Trotting Derby just three months after he had finished 10th in the NSW Pacers' Derby.

The gelding went on to a stellar trotting career with 26 wins, 28 placings and earnings of \$305,682.

"And that's how I got into the trotters," Holland said with a laugh.

Ironically, now that Holland is right back into harness racing and breeding horses at a lavish property at Bundanoon in the NSW Southern Highlands, trotters are passion and pacers are more business.

"Correct," he said. "I breed pacers to sell and keep the trotters to race as my hobby."

Back in February, Holland sold a three-quarter brother to Down Under's champion pacer Leap To Fame for a Melbourne Australian Gold sale-topping \$210,000 to leviathan owner Mick Boots, who races dual New Zealand Cup winner Swayzee.

Some of the earnings went towards the \$340,000 he spent on the three yearlings at Lexington. The Chapter Seven—Autumn Deo colt cost \$100,000, the Chapter Seven—Corazon Blue Chip went for \$80,000 and the Tactical Landing—Independencia filly topped them all at \$160,000, all in U.S. funds.

"Darren [Hancock] and I picked them out together and while we're thrilled with the two colts, it was that filly we really wanted," Holland said. "I think she was a bargain because much of her family had performed in Europe and she was perhaps a bit overlooked in the U.S."

The three yearlings arrived in Sydney this week and will be broken in by respected Menangle trainer Rickie Alchin before being dispersed.

"Darren will get one, Rickie will keep one and how can I not give one to Brad [Hewitt] now after what he's done with The Locomotive," Holland said.

"The whole idea around going to those sales was the discrepancies between the strength of the trotting breed compared to pacing in Australia. Our pacers go as fast as the best in the U.S., but our trotters, apart from a few exceptions, don't get anywhere near them.

"Pat Driscoll [Yabby Dams] and a few others have done a lot to bridge that gap, but I see an opportunity to do more. I'm hoping one of the colts become a leading stallion down here.

"That's why we bought Chapter Seven colts. We wanted a stallion who wasn't going to be available in Australia and

we're told he won't be. It then adds a new dimension to our trotting down here.

"Those Lexington sales were amazing, just so incredibly and professionally run. If you buy the wrong horse, it's your own fault. And what a city to have them. Darren and I found about 16 different Bourbon breweries in our few days there."

But for now, Holland is enjoying the wonderful ride with The Locomotive.

"I've got Wayne Potter to thank for being in on him," he said. "He liked the horse at the Nutrien Sales in Melbourne [2021]. It was passed-in and Wayne rang Darren [Hancock] and if we'd take a third each if he offered \$60,000. Darren said no, which we remind him of every day, so I ended up going halves with Wayne.

"He was superbly bred, being by Muscle Mass out of the former champion trotting mare La Coocaracha, who has been a wonderful mum, too.

"The Locomotive was a natural, a real goer from day one, so he went through all the big 2-year-old races for Wayne and won most of them. He was Australian 2-Year-Old Trotter of the Year.

"He had a lighter 3-year-old season, but still won the Vicbred final and was placed in a few other major races, but all along Wayne felt his future as an older horse should be in Sydney where he can bowl along in his races at that big [1,400 meter] Menangle track.

"So, Wayne arranged for him to go to Brad Hewitt. He did pop back to Wayne to win the Vicbred 4YO final in September [this year]. Before that series, Wayne asked if I'd buy his half and I did."

The Locomotive has won all eight starts since, including a clean sweep through the three heats and final of the recent **NSW Inter Dominion trotting series**.

With nine wins from 12 starts in 2024, The Locomotive has taken his record to 35 starts for 22 wins, five placings and \$485,758 in earnings with the promise of much more to come.

"He's having a couple of quiet weeks now and then Brad will take him back to Victoria for the Great Southern Star [Feb. 1 at Melton]," Holland said. "Then we'll look to get a slot in that \$650,000 TAB Trot race at Cambridge in April before we focus on defending his Inter Dominion title in Brisbane next July."

With champion trotter Just Believe's future uncertain and boom French import Callmethebreeze battling his issues, the door is open for The Locomotive to plunder some serious riches.

And that may just spark Holland to return to Lexington next year for another taste of Bourbon and buying.





No Prix d'Amérique for Jushua Tree

"The winter meeting is over for him this year." The words are Jean-Michel Bazire's and the horse he's referring to is Jushua Tree, named by many fans as one of the probable favorites in the Prix d'Amérique 2025.

Jushua Tree was found to be lame on Monday (Dec. 16) and Jean-Michel Bazire was quick to report the horse's condition to French media Paris-Turf.

Jushua Tree was supposed to race in the \$255,000 Prix Tenor de Baune for 5-year-olds Sunday (Dec. 22), and he will be missed, just like another big name, Joviality, who finished third in this year's Prix d'Amérique. Joviality is suffering from problems with her throat, but she is not, yet, out of the Prix d'Amérique in January.

Sunday's race card at Vincennes includes two races where the winner in each event will receive a ticket to the Prix d'Amérique and the 4-year-olds will battle in the \$255,000 Criterium Continental. American-bred trotters Crown and Kilmister will take on a tough bunch of French horses and other European trotters over 2,100 meters.

Koctel du Dain, Kilmister and Kana de Beylev are the most merited horses in the field of 18 trotters.

In the Prix Tenor de Baune, the field looks to be more even now when Jushua Tree out of the game. An open story waits and an upsetter can very well be a winner in this event over 2,700 meters.

Two tickets for the PdA this weekend and one week later it's time for the third B-race ahead of January's peak at Vincennes. The \$125,000 Prix de Bourgogne is the only B-race where the conditions are 2,100 meters and starting behind the gate. Top names like Go On Boy and Idao de Tillard are both still out of the Prix d'Amérique and it will be interesting to see how the entries list will shape up early next week. Among the already set horses for the Prix d'Amérique, there are some unexpected names and as earlier mentioned, there might be more upsets Sunday at Vincennes.

Bet365 first U.S. sportsbook offering fixed odds wagering on horse racing

When the door was opened across the USA to legal and regulated online sports betting in the spring of 2018, a decision was made that the oldest form of legal sports betting existing across the nation, horse racing, would remain an entity separate from wagering on all other sports.

That landscape, though, is slowly changing.

Bet365 is breaking new ground in terms of the relationship between horse racing and online sports betting sites in the state of Colorado. And plans are in the works to ultimately bring this new era of wagering on horse racing into the lucrative New Jersey market.

In partnership with BetMakers, British-owned Bet365 is now offering fixed odds wagering on horse racing from around the globe on their online sports betting site and sportsbook app in the Centennial State.

In Ontario, bet365 and the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) reached an agreement in 2023 to begin offering pari-mutuel wagering through the Woodbine pools. This latest agreement is certainly breaking new ground, however. By offering fixed odds wagering, you lock in your price at the moment you place your bet. There's no fluctuation from the pari-mutuel pool impacting your odds.

BetMakers is providing the technology to enable bet365 to offer fixed odds race betting. The two sides have entered into a two-year agreement.

Jake Henson, CEO of BetMakers, believes this is a factor that will resonate with horse bettors in the U.S. market. Fixed-odds wagering on horse racing in Canada still remains illegal.

"The sports betting market in the U.S. is starting to mature and the interest from operators in horse racing as a product is expected to become even stronger," Henson said in a statement. "The high frequency of horse racing can deliver high engagement and high margin returns to operators.

"We believe the opportunity for both BetMakers and the racing industry more broadly to be significant in the long term."

For the time being, BetMakers is focusing on thoroughbred racing. When we checked in with the bet365 online sportsbook site in Colorado, they were offering fixed odds wagering on racing from Philadelphia Park, as well as tracks in Australia, New Zealand, South America, Ireland and the United Kingdom.

At the present time, with fixed odds markets only being offered in one state, this doesn't figure to be making a difference in terms of wagering on horse racing product in the USA. Long range, though, this certainly is presenting the potential to be an impactful move in the world of betting on horse racing.

In Britain, where bet365 is based, there's long been a productive marriage between the betting sites and the racetracks. Online sportsbooks across the UK are offering fixed odds wagering on UK and international horse racing. In fact, many sites promote themselves as guaranteeing the best odds in the UK. If you can find another site offering a more lucrative betting line, that rival site will guarantee you that price.

Will we get to a point in the U.S. market where things are similar? Who can say? What is known for certain is that in the six years since widespread legal and regulated sports betting was launched across the nation, much has changed, and often those changes are coming in rapid fashion.



Sports betting apps, live betting, live streaming, same-game parlays. The betting market is ultra-competitive and all sites are always seeking an edge, a leg up on the competition. If fixed odds wagering on horse racing proves popular, it will only grow in scope and stature. And if that's resulting in more people wagering on horse racing, it just might not be such a bad thing for the industry.

BET365 LAUNCHES ADVANCE DEPOSIT WAGERING

At almost the same time as they were launching fixed odds wagering on horse racing at their Colorado online sportsbook, bet365 was also embarking upon another method to offer betting on the sport of kings. They were entering the advance deposit wagering realm.

The bet365 racing app is offering racing from all of the major horse racing tracks around the globe. Prominent North American tracks include Gulfstream Park, Santa Anita Park, Churchill Downs, Saratoga, Belmont Park, Del Mar, Keeneland and Oaklawn Park. There's also racing from the UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and Hong Kong, among other nations. They offer wagering on thoroughbreds, harness racing and even steeplechase racing.

You'll be able to bet on all of the major events in the horse racing world, such as the Kentucky Derby and all three legs of the Triple Crown, the Pegasus World Cup Invitational and the Breeders' Cup. Live streaming of all races is available on the bet365 racing app.

The bet365 racing app is currently being offered in 38 of the 50 U.S. states. Legal states include: Alabama, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Mexico, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Tennessee, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, Wisconsin and Wyoming.

In order to place a wager with the bet365 horse racing app, you must reside in one of the states where it is offered. You also must be 21 years of age to wager, unless you live in Kentucky. There it's legal to bet on racing at the age of 18.

Bet365 is the fourth online sportsbook in the U.S. market to move into the ADW realm. They are joining BetMGM Horse Racing, DK Horse (DraftKings) and FanDuel Racing.

TVG, the ADW owned by FanDuel, was rebranded in the majority of states as FanDuel Racing. It's offered in 28 states. Launched in partnership with the Churchill Downs-operated Twin Spires, DK Horse is available in 20 states. Working in tandem with NYRA Bets, BetMGM Horse Racing is operating in three states.

Scott McGinn has learned racing horses is a roller coaster

The humble horseman from Stony Plain knows just how humbling horse racing can be.

Scott McGinn is well versed in the unpredictability that comes with the territory, where each day and every race seems to deliver something new and typically unexpected.

That said, the trainer who hails from a small town found in the neighborhood of Edmonton, AB, has learned, over time,

to embrace the unplanned and unforeseen.

"It's a roller coaster," McGinn said.
"Even starting out as a groom, you watch your horses race, and you never know how it will turn out. This sport can be humbling. You really never know what is around the corner."

This year has taught McGinn exactly that.

After a career-best 2023 campaign, one in which he recorded 10 wins and three thirds from 15 starts, to go along with \$194,836 in earnings, he posted a 3-2-2 mark from 15 starts in 2024.

"It has definitely been different than last year," he said. "Last year, G TS Skyla was a dominant 3-year-old filly here. We raced a few more horses, but it wasn't necessarily as good a year as we hoped. I would say it was okay. But we had some nice 2-year-olds this year who showed potential."

One of them is G Ts Jukebox Jack.

The son of Captain Deo—G Ts Jukebox Angel made a splashy debut on Sept. 1 at The Track on 2, a one-mile oval in Lacombe, AR

Sent off as the 1-5 choice, the bay gelding notched a quarter-length score in 1:55.1.

"G Ts Jukebox Jack set a track record in that first start," McGinn said. "That was definitely a highlight this year."

Another memorable moment came with fellow rookie G Ts Captain Solo.

A bay son of Captain Deo—GTs Lady Katy, the gelding pulled off a 29-1 upset score in his Rocky Mountain Boys second division race.

"That was a great feeling, and it was a big-time effort from G Ts Captain Solo," McGinn said. "I am looking forward to what both these horses can do next year. It will be nice to get them

ready for our stakes season out here in Alberta. I think they will be near the top end of the 3-year-old class.

"We also have a full sister to G Ts Jukebox Jack — she's a yearling — and she'll be ready to race next year, hopefully. I am excited to see what she can do."

There is also G Ts Asher, a son of Santanna Blue Chip—GTs Lady Katy.

The bay, owned by the McGinn family, has been somewhat of a handful for his trainer.

"He is turning 4 and he is another one we are optimistic about," McGinn said. "He's not quite a stakes-caliber horse, but he has shown potential. He's a little bit of a pain in the butt, but you can see signs that he can be a good horse for us."

There is also the upcoming return of a familiar face to look forward to.

"Also, in the next week, we will be bringing G Ts Skyla back from her injury she suffered this year," he said. "So, we will start training her down and hopefully, she can make a comeback in 2025."

It was G Ts Skyla who gave McGinn his first official training win, the milestone coming on Sept. 9, 2022.

There would be no need for a photo at the finish of the race that took place at Century Downs in Calgary, AB.

In fact, McGinn could have started celebrating at the top of the turn for home – but he resisted the urge to do so.

"That was her first career start, and she won easily," he said. "It was a stakes race [ABSS Starlet 2-year-old first division] too. That was definitely an exciting moment. It was a great feeling. Once you saw her starting to separate herself from the pack, it was much easier to watch coming down the lane."

As it was for the entire McGinn clan.

"Everyone was so happy," he said. "My family has been in the business for quite a while now. My grandfather started it about 40 to 45 years ago. We are partners on all the horses now. By the end of the year, we will have five in training, plus a broodmare at home, G Ts Jukebox Angel, who is in foal."

McGinn, who has fashioned an impressive record of 15-8-2 over just 41 career starts, is looking forward to what 2025 has in store on the racetrack.

After a year of both triumph and disappointment — more of the former — McGinn found clarity when it came to an uneven 2024 season.

"I would say this year had a lot of hard tests compared to 2023," he said. "I think I have grown to be a lot more patient and a lot more realistic about everything."

McGinn, an avid golfer, also leaned on the helpful words he received from his family when he first started out in racing.

"You always get good advice," he said. "I think what has stuck with me is that you need to be patient in this game. You can't rush into things, and you can't rush your horses. You have to make sure you do things right, so that the horses can compete to the best of their ability. That is the biggest thing I have learned."

Rolling with the punches, whether it's taking one on the chin or finding a way to come out on top when the odds are not in your favor, has become second nature to McGinn.

With a stable full of possibilities, the trainer doesn't need to be reminded that there will be hurdles to overcome when the calendar turns to 2025.

After all, the humble horseman from Western Canada knows there is no such thing as a sure thing in racing.

And that suits him just fine.

"Whether you have a favorite or a longshot in the race, you never know what can happen," McGinn said. "But the greatest part of racing is when you win, whether you expect to or not. Every time you get that picture taken it is the best feeling in the world. It reminds you why this is such a great sport and what it takes to get there."

The laws of probability were not included in the mathematics Ralph Cotolo learned in order to become a plumber. He knew only the basics for hands-on trade work which was just enough to be competent. He choked when I tried to teach him enough math to understand pari-mutuels. He could not grasp the method. Perhaps because it lacked the physical elements ruled by widths and lengths and inches and feet, somewhat, but mostly because he never learned the values of percentages and certainly not how one applies them to all games of chance.

Sun Tzu was still my mentor in this battle but he offered nothing when it came to making my dad understand the accomplishment choosing three correct winners in a row at random from three number sets with eight choices each. Nor the improbability of such a streak continuing.

The mind boggles, right?

Prepare for mega-mind-boggling.

Ralph's luck was in play during the days before pari-mutuels offered any multi-race exotics beyond the Daily Double. Imagine in modern times constructing a Pick-3 wager using three singles. Or a Pick-4 using four singles or a Pick-5 using five singles or a Pick-6 using six singles. Take a breath. Any bettor would agree the concept was never an option.

Once these gimmick bets were created and grew in popularity it became common practice to build all multi-race exotic tickets by including multiple entries per race. Sometimes even using all entries in some race legs. Was there anyone in recorded history betting into these pari-mutuel pools playing — no less winning — a multi-race exotic with a ticket consisting of all singles? It is safe to say no.

But although it is moot in my dad's case you must consider if such wagers were available and he played each using his winning selections he would have hit four multi-race exotics by the time he finished betting on that afternoon's Belmont program. Because after his third-straight win he hit his fourth-straight.

Then his fifth.

And then his sixth. The hard way. With one-to-two-digit win prices.

I wanted to dig up Sun Tzu's remains and dance with them over one of his winning battlegrounds. And I wanted to lift my dad's bulky body from his grandstand seat and jump up and down with him until we were breathless.

After moments of successful betting, it was Andy Beyer who famously declared himself "king of the world." But on that day in one of the world's historic thoroughbred racetracks and regardless of what magical chances conspired to produce his sterling performances there was only one king of this and any other world when it came to betting pari-mutuels - Ralph Cotolo.

I was happy beyond cashing a Pick-anything ticket and most joyful for not allowing my victory to ignite a twinge of revenge. There was never the urge for me to say, "I told you so," or "See how unfair you were about me gambling on horses," or any other acerbic rebound. I was happy for my dad; a man with the least amount of fun and lively afternoons to his years as any a suppressed soul.

As for me...

I was also elated that I showed him I was not paving a path of perverse gambling habits which he believed promised a derelict future for myself.

The story does not end there.

Topping off my victory was an unexpected result. I had no intention of turning Ralph into a horse racing fan but thanks to luck — and not Sun Tzu — he was open to go to the races again. With me.

On the ride home that day he did not complain once about the rush-hour traffic we crawled through or his current unemployed status or my mother or his never-ending diet. He was a delightful passenger. He even showed signs of being a smart money manager.

"I got some money now to get a tire or two for the car," he said. "And I'll give your mother some to put away."

And this and that. He was a chatterbox; a characteristic he never exposed to me before. I told him again how lucky he was winning races as he did.

"I know. You think I don't know?" he said. "I see how you sit in the dining room and read that racing paper. I never saw you study school work like that."

"I'm still learning about the races myself, dad. And I'm doing all right in college."

"When are we going back to Belmont?"

"Soon. Look at this traffic. We're moving so slow."

"Hey, at least we're moving."





Jett Propelled soars to DSBF series sweep

from the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund

On the strength of open-length wins in both preliminary rounds of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) series for 3-year-old pacing fillies at Bally's Dover, **Jett Propelled** soared to a lifetime-best 1:53.3 win in the \$110,000 series championship on Wednesday (Dec. 18).

With Jason Thompson once again at the lines, the Roddy's Bags Again—Jett Away filly pushed to clear of Smalltown Bad Girl to assume the lead midway around the first turn and fended off sustained outside pressure from Amelia Maximus through a :56 first half before asserting herself to dismiss that challenger up the backstretch. After rating a :29 third sectional, Jett Propelled faced a stern challenge from Slipinsidewayz (driven by Victor Kirby), who vaulted three-wide around stalled cover on the far turn.

Jett Propelled never relinquished her lead, and after parrying Slipinsidewayz, she edged 2½ lengths clear of pocket rival and runner-up Smalltown Bad Girl (Tim Tetrick) to score her fifth consecutive win. Slipinsidewayz finished third after leveling off in the stretch.

Robert Shahan owns, trains and bred Jett Propelled, now a 12-time winner with \$251,609 in career earnings. Sent off as the 1-20 favorite in her third consecutive start, she paid \$2.10 to win.

The \$20,000 DSBF consolation saw Patricia Thorpe's **Sweet Bobbie Jo** yield the lead after a :28.1 quarter, retake to a :57.3 half, and speed away from Salma to win by 3½ lengths in 1:55.3. Corey Callahan drove the Badlands Nitro—Rusty's Winning filly, who paid \$6.20 to win, for trainer Brian Wright.

WORKSLIKEACHARM DOMINATES IN DSBF CHAMPIONSHIP

Brett MacDonald's **Workslikeacharm** braved a first-over journey en route to a lifetime-best 1:56.3 win in Tuesday's (Dec. 17) \$110,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) series championship for 3-year-old male trotters at Bally's Dover.

Tim Tetrick ensured a close early spot for Workslikeacharm, floating forward out of midfield as Ronnie Ridge (driven by Tony

Morgan) and Pretty Two (Cody Poliseno) alternated on the lead through a :27.4 first quarter. With nine-sixteenths to go, Tetrick angled Workslikeacharm off the pegs from third, and the pair began their ascent as Pretty Two clicked off a :57.1 half.

Workslikeacharm gained into second over a gapping Ronnie Ridge midway up the backstretch, reached Pretty Two's flank at three-quarters in 1:26.4, and pushed to the fore midway on the final turn. The E L Platinum—Charming Oaks gelding made easy work of Pretty Two and held off a three-wide rally from runner-up LG's Bluestone (Ross Wolfenden) to win by a diminishing 1¾ lengths. LG 's Jaxon (Jim Morand), who chased the winner's cover up the backstretch, finished third.

Workslikeacharm, who paid \$3.20 to win and is now an eighttime winner with \$197,560 in career earnings, is trained by Jim King, Jr.

Tetrick also won the \$20,000 DSBF consolation for sophomore male trotters, steering **Portnoy** to a 5¼-length, 1:58.1 victory over Daddy Wags and Jetsam. Deshawn Sample trains the Rolls Blue Chip—Mica colt, who paid \$2.40 to win, for owner/breeder Dawn Amiss.

PLATINUM PROPOSAL COMPLETES DSBF SERIES SWEEP

Platinum Proposal recovered from a mid-move break in stride to reel in 3-5 favorite and fellow dual preliminary winner Going Platinum for a 1:57.3 win in Monday's (Dec. 16) \$110,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) series championship for 3-year-old trotting fillies at Bally's Dover.

Jim Morand was unhurried early with the E L Platinum—Si's Proposal filly, retreating to fifth while Going Platinum (driven by Corey Callahan) and FD Pure Platinum (Justin Parker) disputed a :27.3 first quarter before angling off the pegs to begin a five-length ascent with nine-sixteenths to go. Platinum Proposal circled three-wide around a fading FD Pure Platinum after a :57.1 half and briefly headed Going Platinum before briefly breaking stride approaching the final turn, leaving Going Platinum three lengths clear at three-quarters in 1:26.3. Platinum Proposal quickly reset, however, and reengaged Going Platinum off the corner for home before defeating her by a half-length. Marino's Prize (Ross Wolfenden) rallied mildly for third over Daburg (Tony Morgan) after saving ground throughout the mile.

Les Givens trains Platinum Proposal, a 12-time winner with \$311,331 in career earnings, for Teresa Givens' Nanticoke Racing and Delbert Cain. As the 6-5 second choice, she paid \$4.40 to win.

The \$20,000 DSBF consolation for 3-year-old trotting fillies saw **Starfish** and trainer/driver David Rearic circle third-over cover and eclipse Luvyas Nugget to win by a length in 2:00.4. The Glidemaster—Miss Fairfax filly, who competes as a homebred for Rearic, paid \$20 in her maiden-breaking victory.

Canadian Hall of Famer Keith Clark dies at age 71

Keith Clark, a true Alberta legend in the world of standardbred horse racing, died peacefully on Saturday (Dec. 14) at the age of 71. Born in Stoughton, SK, Clark's life was marked by his incredible achievements and deep love for his family and horses.

He is survived by his beloved partner, Liz Davie, his children Kasey and Kerry Clark, and his siblings Lynda (Wayne Douglas), Collette (Rick Docking), Larry, Bill (Kathy McCaughan), Kelly (Holly Clark), Karen (Mike Van Rijn), Monica (Warren Grant), Bob (Becky Arnold), and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lorne and Helene Clark, and his brother Jackie.

Dave Landry Hall of Famer Keith Clark died on Saturday.

With over 50 years in the standardbred horse racing industry, Keith's career was nothing short of extraordinary. He achieved 6,620 driving wins and 4,302 training wins, was named Alberta Horseman of the Year 14 times, and received the prestigious O'Brien Award of Horsemanship in both 2004 and 2011. His contributions to the sport were recognized with his induction into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 2009.

In 2021, Keith retired and downsized his operation, selling his DeWinton farm and purchasing a new acreage in Foothills to focus on broodmares and raising young horses. This transition allowed him to spend winters in Arizona, where he discovered new passions, including riding his Harley and Indian motorcycles, lounging by the pool, enjoying happy hours, and dancing weekly.

"I knew I was nominated but I had no idea I would have won," said Booth. "I'm really, really excited about this. The last two years I cared for top 2-year-olds that won divisional awards and I didn't make it to either of those banquets. Now, this year I will be there, and I just hope the two I looked after get some awards as well."

New Zealand-bred **Typhoon Banner** backed up his victory in his division of the final preliminary round last week with a 1:58.3 win over the mile and a sixteenth distance of the inaugural \$250,000 MGM Grand Prix Pacing Series final on Monday night (Dec. 16) at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Harness Racing Update

Racing over a surface left sloppy by persistent showers, Typhoon Banner and driver Matt Kakaley left out quickly from post 5 and would be challenged on the outside by favored Coaches Corner (Jason Bartlett), who blasted out from the 7-hole. Typhoon Banner would relent and sit in the pocket, but not until he made Coaches Corner work past a fast :26.2 opening quarter.

Coaches Corner backed down the tempo to just 56 seconds at the half and then picked it back up to 1:24.1 at three-quarters as Seven Colors (Scott Zeron), who went first-over from sixth before the half, stalled out in third. Coaches Corner maintained command on the final bend also, but Typhoon Banner was poised right on Bartlett's helmet and ready to strike.

Kakaley wheeled Typhoon Banner off the pylons before they turned into the stretch, and Typhoon Banner and Coaches Corner were side-by-side at the 1:51.4 mile marker. From there to the wire, Typhoon Banner proved better than Coaches Corner, as he went by him and on to the victory by three-quarters-of-a-length. Coaches Corner and Adam Twelve, a pair of Per Engblom trainees, were second and third ahead of the Andrew Harris-trained duo of El Rey (Brett Beckwith) and Seven Colors who finished fourth and fifth.

An 8-year-old Bettors Delight gelding bred by Banner Bloodstock Ltd., Typhoon Banner is trained by Joe Bongiorno for owners Philip Steinberg, JB Racing and Barbara Bongiorno Stb LLC. This was his 25th career win, he has now earned \$466,735 and he paid \$12 to win as a 5-1 offering. He keyed a \$25.60 exacta and a \$121 trifecta.

Driver Anthony Napolitano was the other star on Monday night at Yonkers as he won the first race with **Caviart Sargent** and then the seventh with **Blue Hunt**, and the victory with Blue Hunt was the 4,000th of his career.

Napolitano, who joined the Yonkers colony as a regular in September, is closing in on a lifetime-best season in terms of both victories and earnings. He had 295 trips to the winner's circle in 2009 and has 271 thus far in 2024 and has banked \$3,440,237 this year, just shy of his 2018 sum of \$3,463,634.

This is closing week of the meet at MGM Yonkers Raceway. Racing will be conducted Tuesday through Friday to wrap up the calendar, with post time each night at 7 p.m. (EST).

Huge Pick-6 pool awaits Big M bettors tonight

If carryovers are great, then double carryovers are twice as nice, and a double carryover is exactly what Meadowlands players will be shooting for when racing resumes tonight (Dec. 20) at 6:20 p.m.

There were no winning tickets sold last weekend (Dec. 13-14) on the 20-cent Pick-6, meaning that a double carryover of \$15,667 will be up for grabs tonight when the wager takes place on races 8 through 13.

Remember, free past performances for every race of every Big M card are available by going to **playmeadowlands.com**.

A carryover of this size can make some serious noise.

For example, here are the numbers should the total pool be \$60,000:

Carryover: \$15,667New money: \$44,333Final pool: \$60,000

Takeout on new money: \$6,650

Net pool: \$53,350Surplus: \$9,017

• Return: If the wager is hit, the return to players with winning tickets will be 120 per cent, a remarkably high "negative takeout"

If the response is overwhelming and new money were to total \$100,000, there is still a big enough carryover to cover the low 15 per cent rake, leaving bettors swimming in a negative pool.

"These are the types of opportunities our players live for," said track chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "When you combine a low takeout with a big carryover, you get a scenario which brings the players out to play in a big way. In addition, we have been able to maintain carding our programs with full 10-horse fields, something else our customers really appreciate."

Remarkably, there are 14 races scheduled for both tonight and Saturday, and all 28 dashes will have 10 horses in behind the

gate, removing the need to figure out what the average field size will be (in the event there are no scratches).

Last week, there were a pair of eye-popping payouts.

Tonight, the Late 50-cent Pick-4 returned \$2,011, while on Saturday, the 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 came back \$2,293.

Big fields work.

"Our race office does a great job of interacting with our horsemen to provide the type of betting opportunities that exist here at The Big M," said Settlemoir. "Every winter, we try to deliver big fields for the player, and, for a vast majority of the races, we have been able to do just that."

JUST FOUR TO GO: There are just four programs remaining on The Meadowlands' 2024 calendar. Live racing will take place this week and next on the usual Friday and Saturday evenings at the usual post time of 6:20 p.m.

World champion Lucan Hanover leads an all-star cast of 14-year-old pensioners as First Tracks Cumberland hosts the fourth annual Au Revoir Retirement Showcase slated for Saturday (Dec. 21) of closing weekend, which runs from Friday (Dec. 20) through Sunday (Dec. 22). In addition, several pop-up series finals sprinkled around the three-day weekend boast purses well into the five figures.

photographed in the winner's circle with gifts and prizes. The Au Revoir Retirement Showcase includes a special \$6,000 Auld Lang Syne race, exclusively for 14-year-old pacers.

Lucan Hanover p, 3, 1:48f, a world champion and winner of an elimination heat of the Little Brown Jug, will lead the post parade, in the opener. The son of Western Ideal is now owned and trained by Aaron Hall, and has accrued \$1.4 million in purse earnings. During his storied career he was the first sub-1:49 standardbred on a five-eighths mile track, and also won an elimination of the Breeders Crown during his sophomore campaign.

The entire day is dedicated to these special horses, with the first race marked for the soon-to-be retirees. Overall, the 12 horses have combined earnings of \$4.9 million, which is an average of \$414,082. The combined start total is 3,692 with an average of 308 starts per horse. Total combined wins for these foals of 2010 is 561, which is an average of 47 victories per horse.

The fastest record belongs to the aforementioned Lucan Hanover, who is also the most decorated standardbred with 74 trips to the winner's circle. Eleven pacers and two trotters will parade in front of the stands individually, with the average win time of all the honorees an equally impressive 1:51.4.

A special commemorative program has been produced and contains biographies and photos of the equine stars. The additional 11 soon-to-be retirees are: Calvin B, Goin Manstyle, Heart Breaking, Ideal Rowan, Machtu N, R T Lange, Rockaholic, Rockin Rambaran, Scottish Blue, Ugly Stick and Urbana Bayama.

Sunday's (Dec. 22) final card of the year features two \$12,500 pop up finals, as well as five races with purses of \$10,000 each. There is also the \$8,000 Maine Amateur Driving Club final in race 8.
