BEST ADVICE

GARNET BARNSDALE: Look at any horses sent out by connections that excel in big stakes finals; trainers Takter, Burke, Alagna, Pelling and Blais are some examples. Don't be afraid to use their horses in your wagers if they are offering big prices.

DAVE BROWER: Find your one "cinch" on the card and play every wager you can! The Pk4's, Pk5's, doubles, exactors, etc. IF you are right, you can clean up with just one great selection.

DERICK GIWNER: Pick three horses and play an exacta box for \$1 (\$6 total). Best bang for your money.

ASHLEY MAILLOUX: There are some heavy favourites throughout the card. Look for value in your exotic wagers — there are some talented horses that will be big prices on the tote.

MARK MCKELVIE: Don't get too high or too low. It's a long night of great racing!

KEN MIDDLETON, JR.: A number of horses racing in last week's eliminations fell short after missing time. Expect them to be much better tonight.

MONIQUE VAG: If you like a horse at low odds and seem to have found a "lock" maximize value by singling that horse in a multi-leg wager. With huge pools on stakes days, that's my favorite way to assure maximum value on a short-priced winner.

GORDON WATERSTONE: Play Pick 3s where you can single one horse in one race and spread out with some longshots you might not normally in the other two legs and hope for a nice-priced winner.

MARK MCKELVIE: RACE 3 – 4 VENERABLE "We could be looking at harness racing's next Trotting Queen!"

KEN MIDDLETON, JR.: RACE 3 – 4 VENERABLE

MONIQUE VAG: RACE 3 – 4 VENERABLE "She's the best 2-year old trotter overall and has looked picturesque every start."

GORDON WATERSTONE: RACE 3 – 4 VENERABLE

GARNET BARNSDALE: RACE 10 — 8 PRETENDER

DAVE BROWER: RACE 5 – 3 BETTORBUCKLEUP "IF he's not a price, get back to me and I'll pick another."

DERICK GIWNER: RACE 11 – 8 ABUCKABETT HANOVER "is unlikely to win but could be in the exotics at a big price."

ASHLEY MAILLOUX: RACE 4 – 1 ATLAS HANOVER "has yet to graduate, but in his last race he overcame a bad post to finish third in the Nassagaweya. Post position could help him improve."

MARK MCKELVIE: RACE 7 – 1 ON A STREAK "The Blais trainee has stepped up before in big moments."

KEN MIDDLETON, JR.: RACE 5 – 8 HAIL CHRISTIAN N

MONIQUE VAG: RACE 9 – 7 BIG BETTOR HANOVER "She's been steadily improving. If the fav feels pressure upfront early, it could set up well for this filly to pick up the pieces late."

GORDON WATERSTONE: RACE 1 – 7 CHIEFS BEACH "After coming up short in three starts at Georgian Downs, returns to Mohawk where he faced better earlier."

GARNET BARNSDALE: Bet a \$20 straight Trifecta in RACE 3: 4 Venerable/ 3 Adare Castle/ 6 American Beauty

DAVE BROWER: 10th race: \$10 exacta box: 2 KING OF THE NORTH, 5 TEMPORAL HANOVER

DERICK GIWNER: 10th race: \$20 to win on 2 KING OF THE NORTH "should double your money."

ASHLEY MAILLOUX: I'd bet an exactor and tri in RACE 4. \$4 exactor 5,8/1 and \$1 tri 5,8/1,5,8/1,4,5,7,8.

MARK MCKELVIE: RACE 11 - \$10 Exacta - 4/6,8

KEN MIDDLETON, JR.: RACE 4 - \$20 win on 4 BOB LOBLAW

MONIQUE VAG: Find a race with a vulnerable favorite. For me, RACE 1. \$10 WIN, \$10 PLACE on 10 MAJOR CUSTARD. He's getting close. Should show some speed.

GORDON WATERSTONE: In RACE 3, play 4/3/all and 4/all/3 for \$1 trifecta tickets, and bet the remaining \$4 on 4-3 exacta.

PICK 5 & Jackpot Hi-5 Tickets

On tonight's card, there is **Jackpot Hi-5** with a mandatory payout (Race 13, pool estimated to exceed \$1 million), as well as two **Pick-5** wagers: Races 1-5 (guaranteed at \$100,000) and an **All-Stakes** one that is Races 7-11 (guaranteed at \$100,000).

GARNET BARNSDALE

SELECTIONS: 4 - 3 - 9 - 6

4 VENERABLE – toyed with her opponents while keeping her perfect record intact last week and she will be very tough to beat here as she can race and win from anywhere.

3 ADARE CASTLE – is the local undefeated filly and while she is a very good racehorse, she comes up against a very tough rival tonight who might be a generational filly. She likely completes a chalky Exacta.

9 DABRA DAY – has hit her best stride as a sophomore recently but she was no match for Venerable in the elimination. Her good gate speed should help her take a share.

6 AMERICAN BEAUTY – is worth a look on connections alone as trainer Takter is deadly in finals of big stakes races.



GORDON WATERSTONE

SELECTIONS: 4 - 3 - 6 - 1

4 VENERABLE – is a sensational filly trotter that has cruised to six straight wins and should have no trouble getting her seventh. She has the makings of one of the all-time greats.

3 ADARE CASTLE – She has done nothing wrong in her career as she hasn't lost in five starts, but it seems a daunting task for her to reverse fortunes with Venerable.

6 AMERICAN BEAUTY – Has shown some closing kick, look for her late in the stretch. Her dam, All The Time, is a full sister to Ariana G, who won the 2016 Peaceful Way.

1 MISSY TRIX – She is still looking for her first win after eight attempts, this likely won't be her maiden-breaking night but from the inside post can certainly hold her ground along the pylons and take home a nice check.

MONIQUE VAG

SELECTIONS: 4 - 3 - 1 - 6

4 PUBLICITY SEEKER – didn't win his elim, but could not ask for a better post to flaunt early speed. Took advantage of a good pocket trip in the elim, but couldn't hold off Locatelli late. A similar trip could be the winning one this time around.

3 LOCATELLI – first over bid in the first elim, and looked like he was going to make it quite the finish between leader Sonofamistry who went off stride late. Expecting this gelding to float away and driver Andrew McCarthy to put him in a nice covered up trip.

1 ON A STREAK – Sylvain Filion picked up the drive when Bob McClure chose the other Determination horse Macho Martini. I think On A Streak has the best chance of the two. He should be positioned close to the pace early on to track down the speed late.

6 DANCINGINTHEDARK M – Fractions were not favorable for him when race leader Fashion Frenzie was able to steal a second half. In that elim, he had a difficult first over bid. Good shot, but he will need to mind his manners and is likely to be over-bet again.



ASHLEY MAILLOUX

SELECTIONS: 5 - 6 - 3 - 8

5 FASHION FRENZIE – seems to be improving with each race this year. In his elimination, he controlled the pace and had everything go his way. He's been quite comfortable and game up front in his last two starts.

6 DANCINGINTHEDARK M – won a division of the Stanley Dancer Memorial at the Meadowlands and looked excellent doing so in 1:50.1. Since then, he's been a bit inconsistent, but his elimination was solid.

3 LOCATELLI – won his elimination after the 1-5 favourite Sonofamistry broke stride in the stretch. He looked to be moving quite well and driver Andy McCarthy has mentioned they've had some hard luck. He's trending in the right direction.

8 LOGAN PARK – has been consistent this season, posting a 4-1-1 record from 8 starts. This year in Gold Series action, he's won three of four. In his elimination, he was simply unable to catch Fashion Frenzie, who set the tempo.

KEN MIDDLETON JR.

SELECTIONS: 4 - 3 - 8 - 2

4 FIRE START HANOVER – has been a runner-up more often than a winner this year, but it's not a troubling stat. She was on point in winning her elim last week, and I'll expect trainer Pelling to have her even better tonight. She gets a slight edge.

3 HOT MESS EXPRESS – bounced back to win last week's elim after finishing out of the money in her previous outing. She's been a winning machine this season for trainer Alagna, and there's no reason to believe she can't win again.

8 SCARLETT HANOVER – was a solid runner-up to Hot Mess Express in the elim round. If there's such a thing as home field advantage, then she certainly has it. She's one I'd use on the bottom of exotic wagers.

2 BEST HEAD WEST – is a better filly than her 0-for-10 record would indicate. She has a tendency to get away slowly, and often it's left her with too much to do in the late stages of her miles. If she's close turning for home she'll be heard from.



DAVE BROWER

SELECTIONS: 3 - 9 - 4 - 1

3 HOT MESS EXPRESS – was back into extreme top shape in last week's elim! That spells trouble for the rest. She's had only one clunker all season for the Alagna Armada, Sam B. Loved the post-race comments from Andy Mac. Speed edge on Fire.

9 VOELZ DELIGHT – surprised me last week with a monster two-move try at almost 20-1. I know the post stinks, but I don't see Sylvain taking back from a spot like this. Plots for a nice trip and can easily add value to the equation.

4 FIRE START HANOVER – is finding her championship freshman form again, after a rather slow start to the stakes season. Deserves plenty of respect and it sure sounded like Dexter felt she was "good again." But, she wants to stalk and finish, giving Mess the speed edge.

1 MACKIE HANOVER – turned in a strong elim effort too! Tim T knows her well and will somehow work out a smooth journey from pole position. Packs a pretty nice late punch, so, IF things get western, she has a chance to upset the applecart.

MARK MCKELVIE

SELECTIONS: 2 - 3 - 4 - 5

2 KING OF THE NORTH – The Schnittker trainee is back on a regular routine after having nearly a month off before last week's elimination. Expect him to bring his 'A' game and driver MacDonald will be locked in to score a big win at his former home track.

3 DULY RESOLVED – Five wins in six starts and his only loss he just didn't get racetrack until too late. It's very hard to go against this Bax trainee. MacDonell has had great success in this race.

4 PERICULUM – Confidence is high for this youngster after a strong maiden-breaking score last week. The \$340,000 yearling purchase should build off last week's effort and contend for the gold.

5 TEMPORAL HANOVER – seems to love the Canadian air with two wins in two starts since arriving at Mohawk Park. Expect him to be in play very early.



DERICK GIWNER

SELECTIONS: 2 - 4 - 3 - 5

2 KING OF THE NORTH – is a better horse from off the pace and notice he came on again when passed in his elimination. Plus, he missed nearly four weeks prior to last week. Price will improve here after his first loss.

4 PERICULUM – stepped up in his elimination, not just because he beat #2, but that he displayed the ability to trot a big quarter at both ends of the mile. He could be peaking at the right time.

3 DULY RESOLVED – Son of Resolve clearly has talent and showed guts in victory last week. He's probably worth about 5-2 in this spot if those odds are available.

5 TEMPORAL HANOVER – rarely throws in a bad race. He's a must-use in the exotics and has some win potential.

SELECTIONS: 4 - 8 - 3 - 6

4 BULLDOG HANOVER – He has been top dog all year and won his elim convincingly allowing connections the luxury of choosing their post. We've seen him overcome adversity already notching numerous OSS Gold wins. Top call.

8 ABUCKABETT HANOVER – Does have numerous wins at WMP all in different ways, and draws a good post to work out a rallying effort. If on his game, he could give any of them a run for their money, but he's a risky option with his lingering gait issues.

3 PERFECT STING – Won the other NA Cup elim last week and looked very strong down the lane. He should have a tactical advantage on many with his early speed and is primed to pick up a big piece of the purse.

6 DESPERATE MAN – Strong 2020 campaign with numerous OSS Gold victories. Although he only has one win in 2021 thus far, he's been very consistent in picking up cheques. Expecting the same on Saturday once again.



ASHLEY MAILLOUX

SELECTIONS: 4 - 3 - 8 - 9

4 BULLDOG HANOVER – has been sensational this year and overcame a less than ideal trip in his elimination. He dueled Rockyroad Hanover through a wicked third quarter and was able to find another gear. Hard to name any flaws.

3 PERFECT STING – looked as though he was going to be passed at the top of the stretch in his elimination, but he was gritty on the inside and found more. His resume combined with his elimination stamps him as a major threat.

8 ABUCKABETT HANOVER – has been inconsistent in 2021, but when he's primed to go, he's recorded big performances, such as his win in PA where he beat Perfect Sting. He paced home nicely in his elimination to round out the tri.

9 ROCKYROAD HANOVER – set the tempo in his elimination and was moving quite well, but the blazing third quarter that he raced evenly with Bulldog Hanover caused him to tire. The Cane Pace winner is worthy in the exotics.

LEGEND STATUS: Tall Dark Stranger captures 37th Pepsi North America Cup

Tall Dark Stranger looked like a million dollars in taking the 37th edition of the \$1 million Pepsi North America Cup on Saturday, Aug. 29, 2020 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Trained by Nancy Takter, Tall Dark Stranger and Yannick Gingras were content to let Tattoo Artist make his mark on the lead, as the latter powered from post seven to strike the front early in the proceedings.

With Bob McClure in the bike, Tattoo Artist took his nine rivals through an opening mile carved out in a snappy :25.4, with Tall Dark Stranger settling in second. Longshots Moneyman Hill, in third, and Mayhem Hanover, sitting fourth, watched the pacesetting duo set the tone early.

Soon after the quarter-mile mark, Gingras, contesting his ninth Cup, powered his 3-5 favourite to the outside and to the lead, as they cut a half in :53.3.

It was Tall Dark Stranger still calling the shots as the field geared up for the stretch drive. McClure pulled Tattoo Artist to the outside looking to track down the frontrunner. For a brief moment, it appeared as though they were cutting into the lead of Tall Dark Stranger, but he pulled away down the lane for another impressive score.

Tattoo Artist was second, while 127-1 Moneyman Hill finished third. Odds On Osiris, leaving from post 10, rallied to take fourth.

There was plenty of emotion in the aftermath of the victory, including a teary-eyed Gingras, and an elated Marvin Katz, who co-owns Tall Dark Stranger with Crawford Farms Racing, Caviart Farms and Howard Taylor.

It was the second straight Cup title for Takter, who won in 2019 with Captain Crunch.

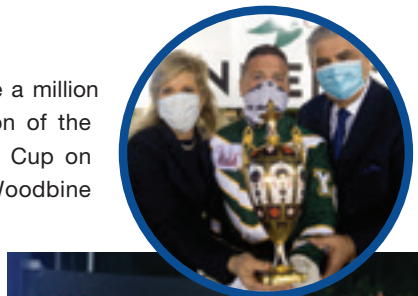
And it was also a historic triumph.

"I'm overjoyed, I really am," said Katz. "I've been doing this for a very long time and I've been fortunate to have many great horses, but I think this guy really rates up with some of the greatest horses we've ever seen. This is historic. What he's done tonight has never been done before. He won the Metro as a two-year-old, he won the Breeders Crown – he's come back to win the Meadowlands Pace and he's won the North America Cup. Somebeachsomewhere, Captaintreacheraus... they couldn't do it, but he's done it."

The enormity of the accomplishment wasn't lost on Takter, who wasn't able to watch the race in-person.

"This is an extra-special colt in extraordinary circumstances, I'm so proud of the horse and my team."

Gingras had ample praise for the competitive spirit shown

"I rolled him to three-quarters pretty hard but he just never quits. He's just a tremendous horse – the best pacing colt I've ever driven, there's no doubt in my mind. He's just an amazing animal. I feel awesome, there's no doubt about it. This means so much. I couldn't be any happier right now."

Tall Dark Stranger would finish his three-year-old season with 11 wins and \$1.4 million earned from 13 starts and was named the U.S. Horse of the Year for 2020. The son of 2001 Cup winner Bettors Delight out of Precocious Beauty was retired following the 2020

season having won 19 of 22 career starts, earning over \$2.3 million and holding a mark of 1:47.1. He now stands stud at Hanover Shoe Farms in Pennsylvania.

The payouts for the 37th Pepsi North America Cup saw Tall Dark Stranger return \$3.20, \$2.40 and \$2.40, combining with Tattoo Artist (\$4.30, \$3.50) for a \$16.20 exactor. Moneyman Hill (\$20.70) completed a \$2 triactor worth \$476.40. Odds On Osiris rounded out a \$1 superfecta worth \$2,596.30.

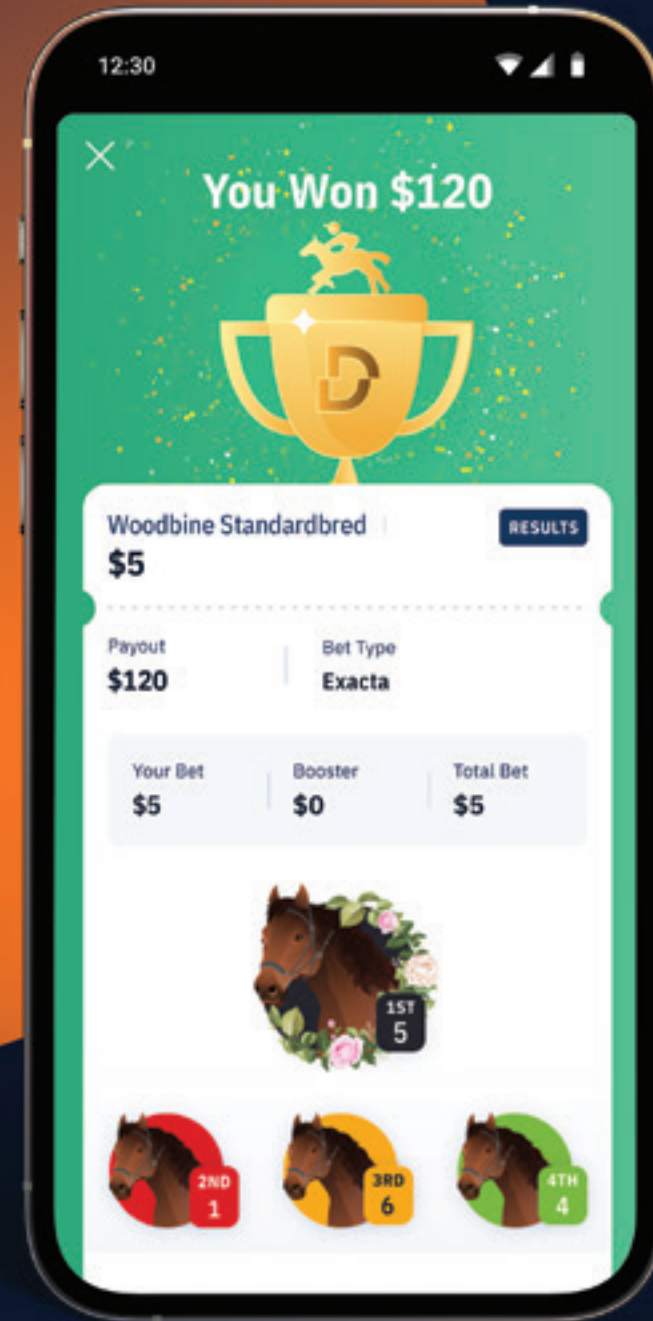

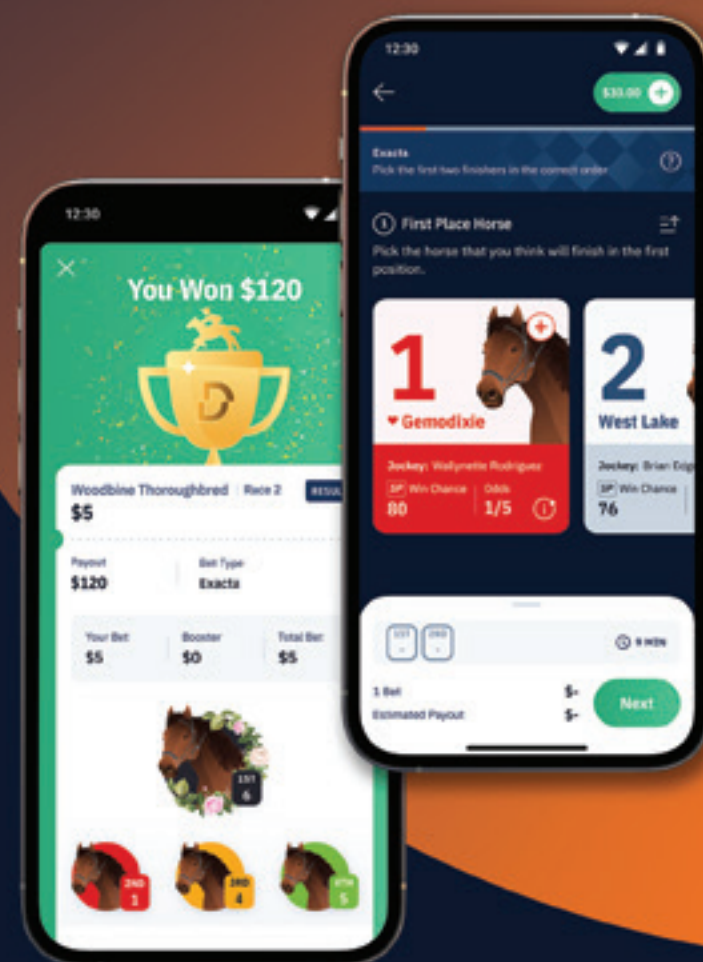
